FIG. 1 is a top right perspective view of the window component extrusion which is broken in the center indicating indefinite length; and,

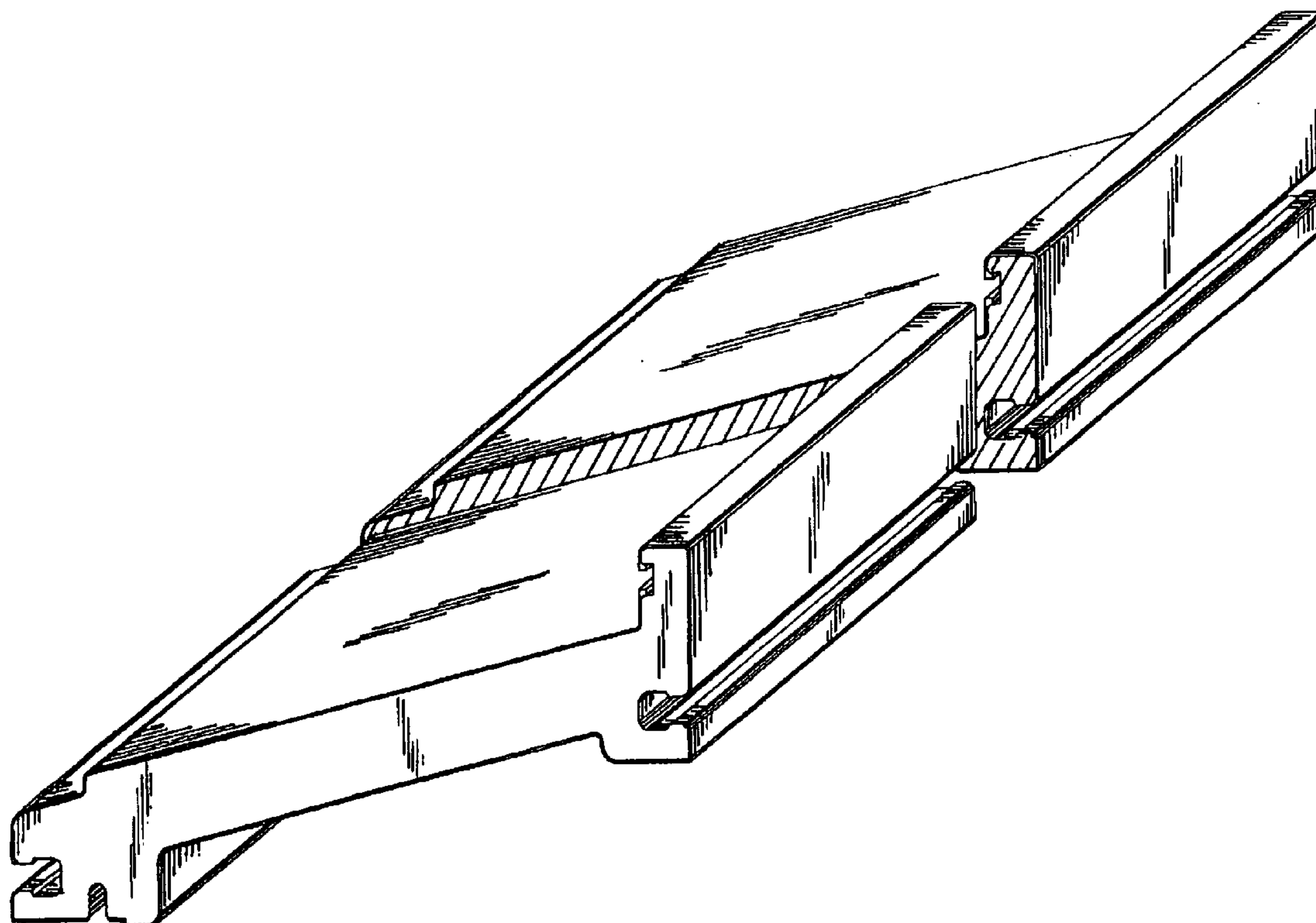

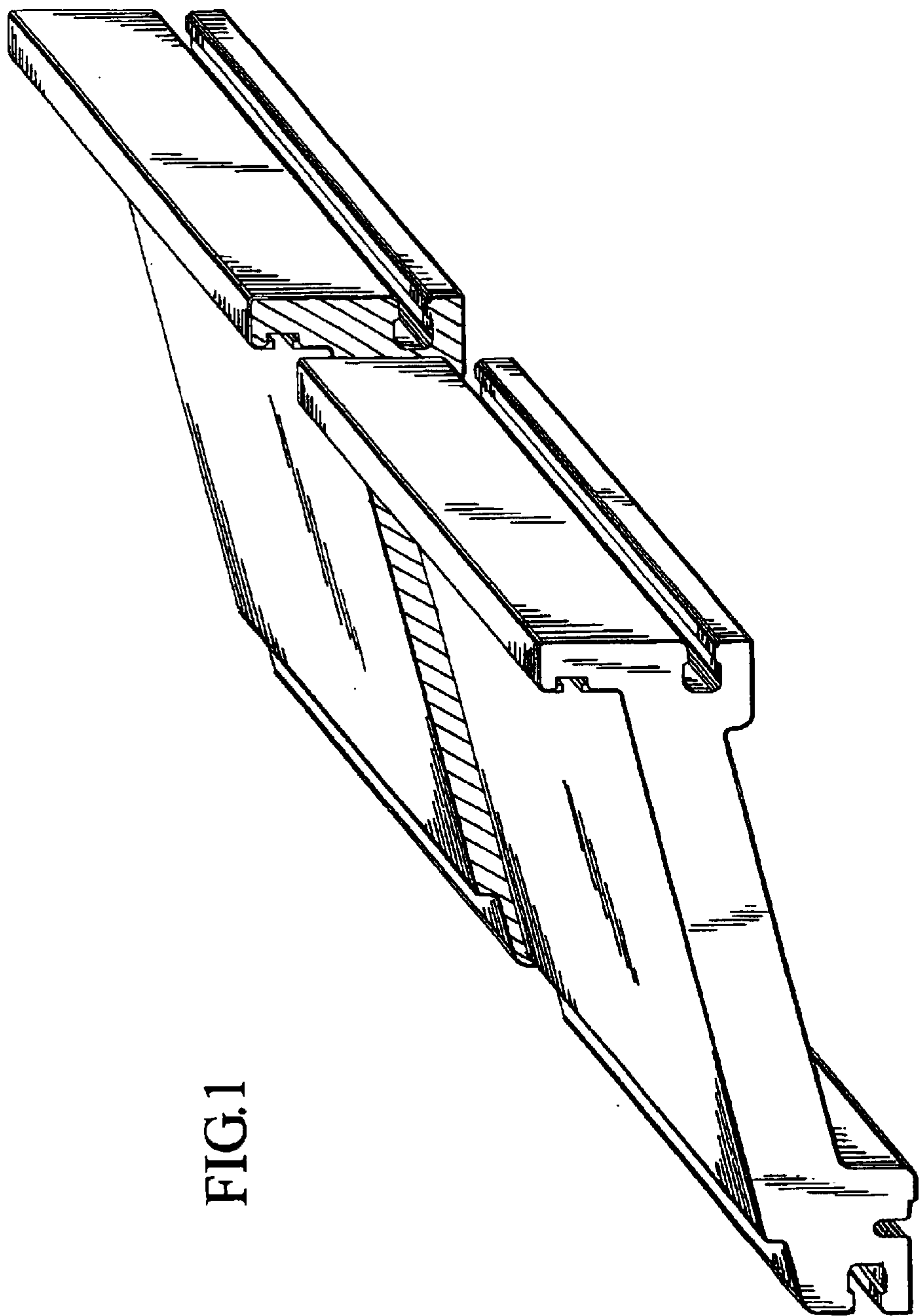

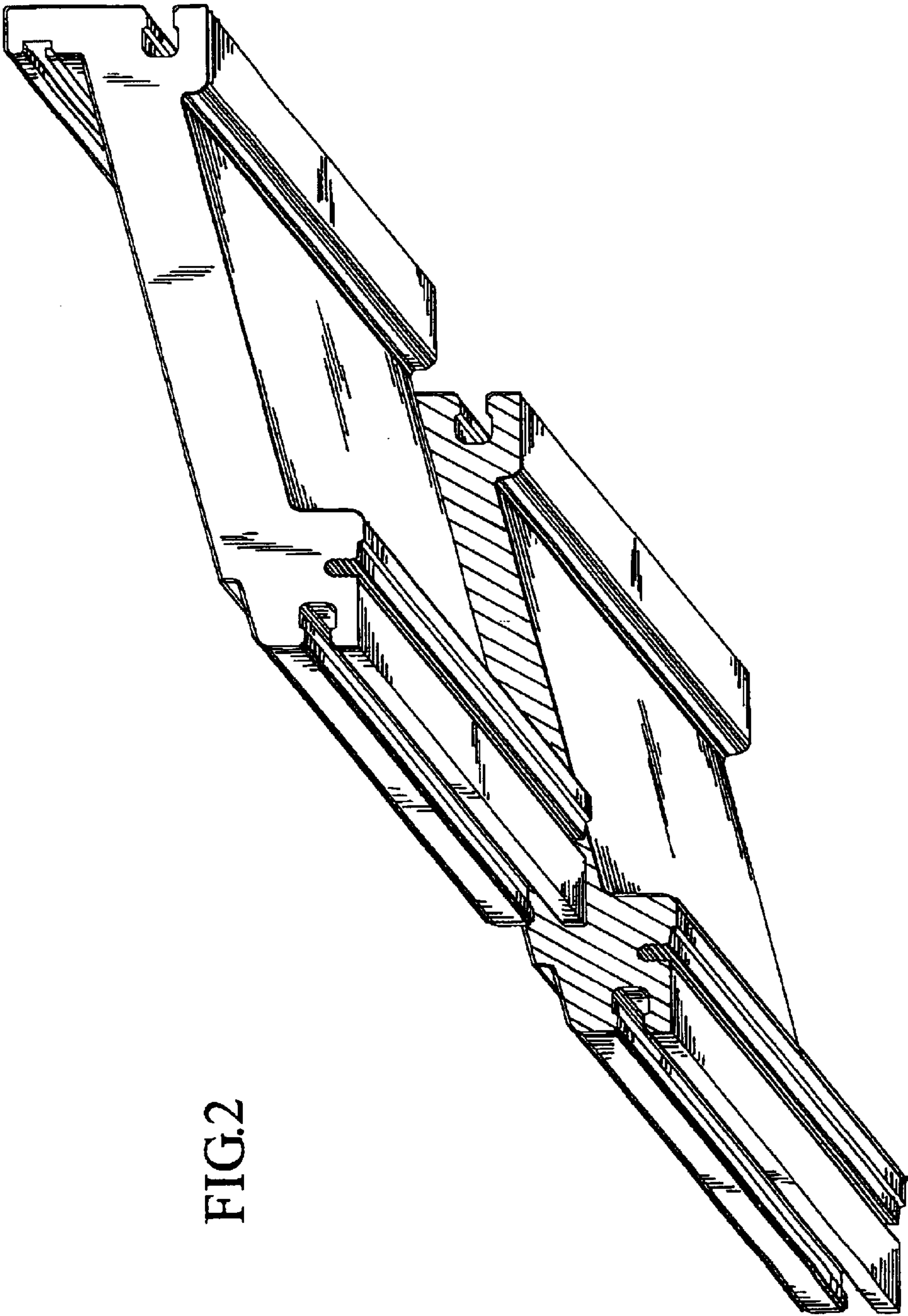
