
(57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a carrying case, as shown and described in the drawings.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a carrying case of the present invention in the upright position;
- FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a carrying case of the present invention in an open position, facing downward;
- FIG. 3 is a top plan view of a carrying case of the present invention;
- FIG. 4 is a first side elevational view of the carrying case of the present invention;
- FIG. 5 is a second side elevational view of the carrying case of the present invention;
- FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of a carrying case of the present invention;
- FIG. 7 is a third side elevational view of the carrying case of the present invention; and,
- FIG. 8 is a fourth side elevational view of the carrying case of the present invention.















