FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, shown in its environment.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged perspective view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, shown in its environment.

FIG. 4 is an enlarged side elevation view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, shown in its environment, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown.

FIG. 5 is an enlarged top plan view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, shown in its environment.

FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, shown in its environment.

FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, shown in its environment.

FIG. 8 is a distal end view of an enlarged ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design.

FIG. 9 is an enlarged side elevation view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown.

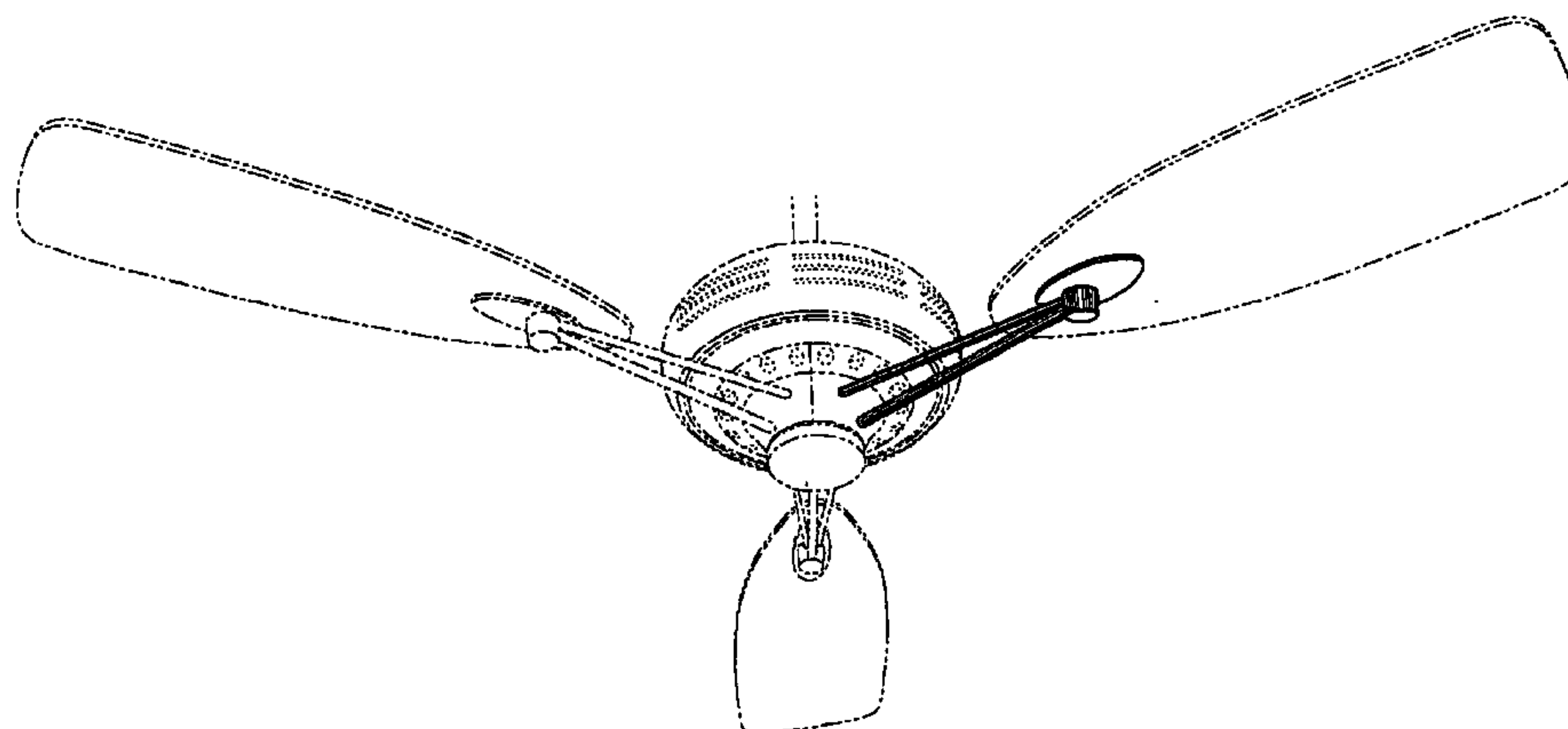
FIG. 10 is an enlarged perspective view of the ceiling fan blade iron in accordance with my design; and,

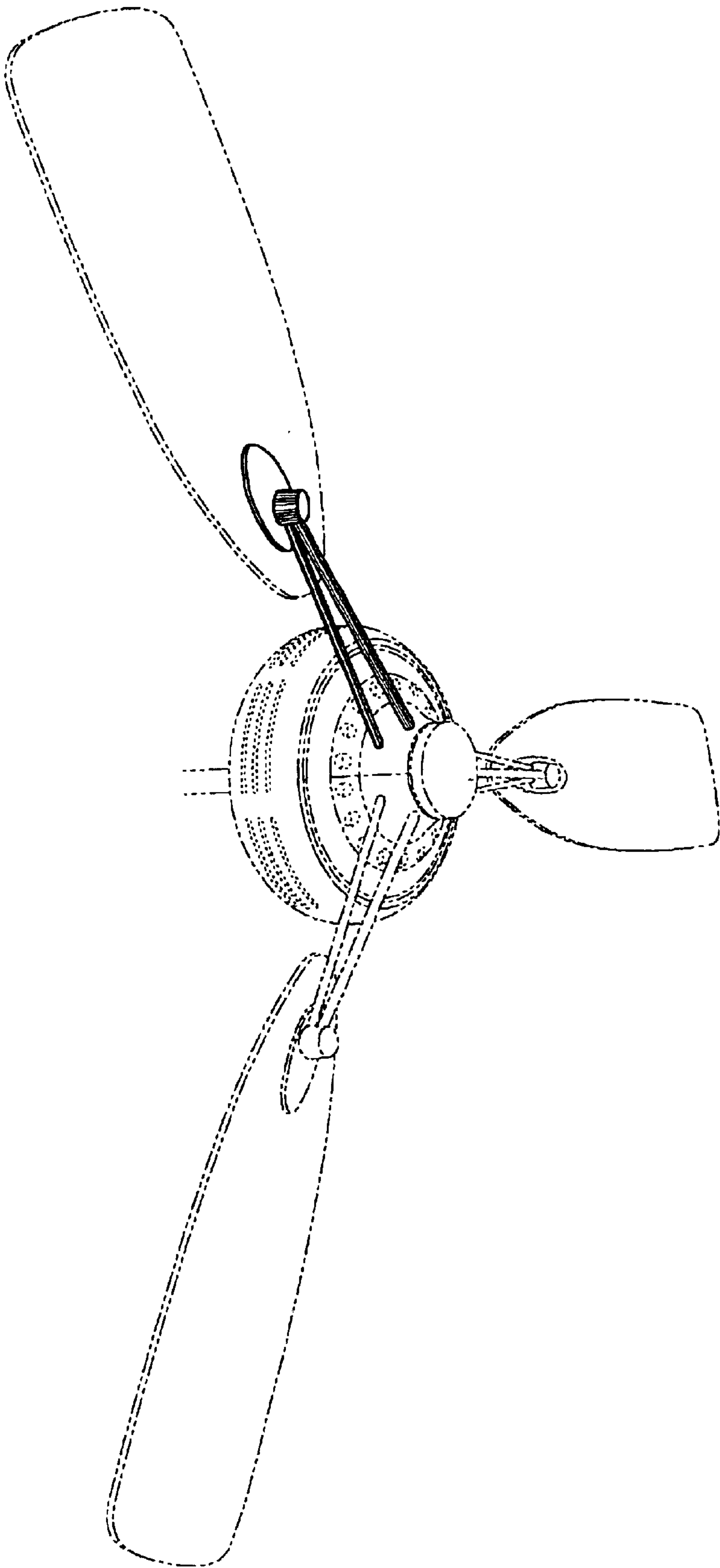
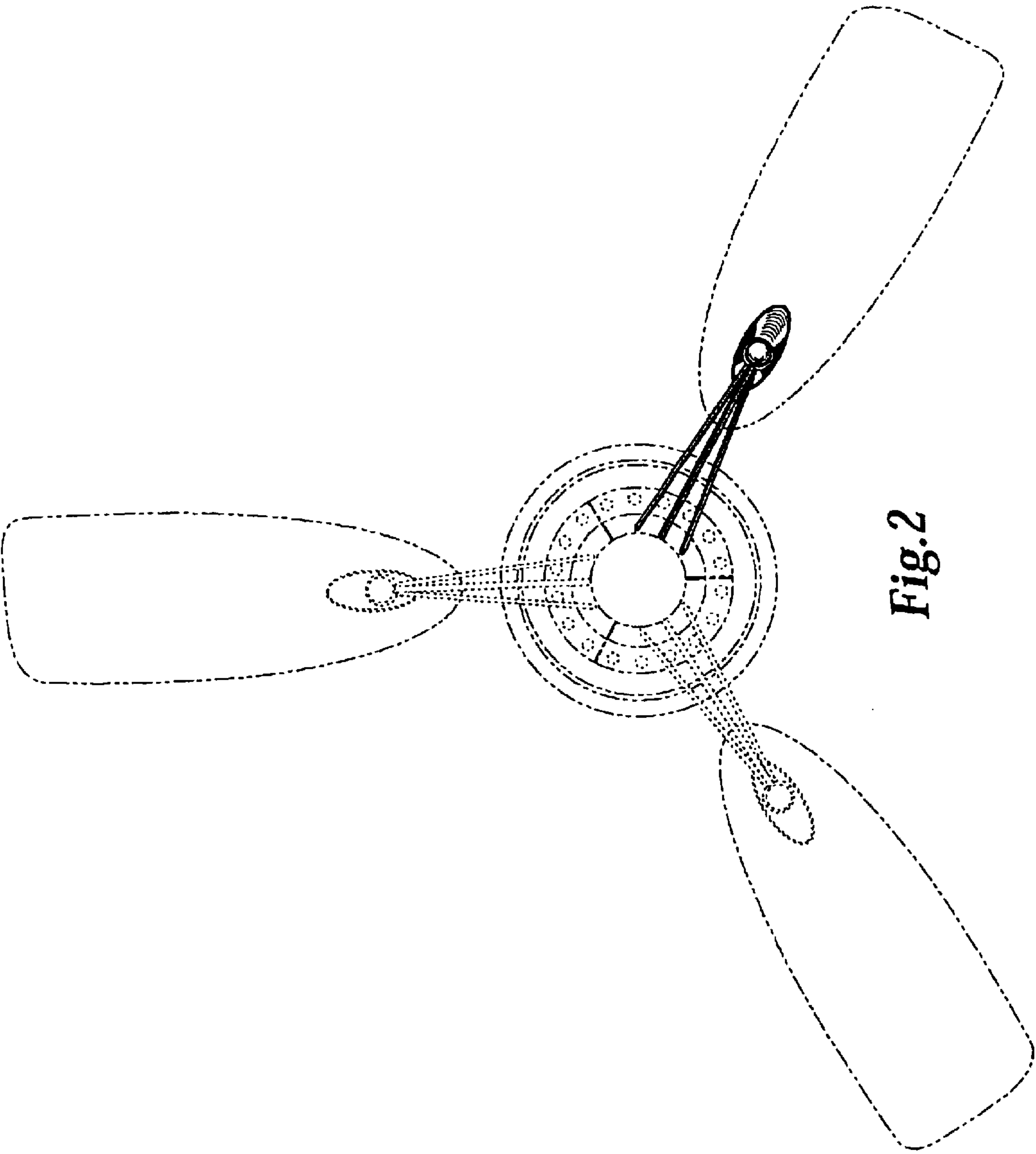
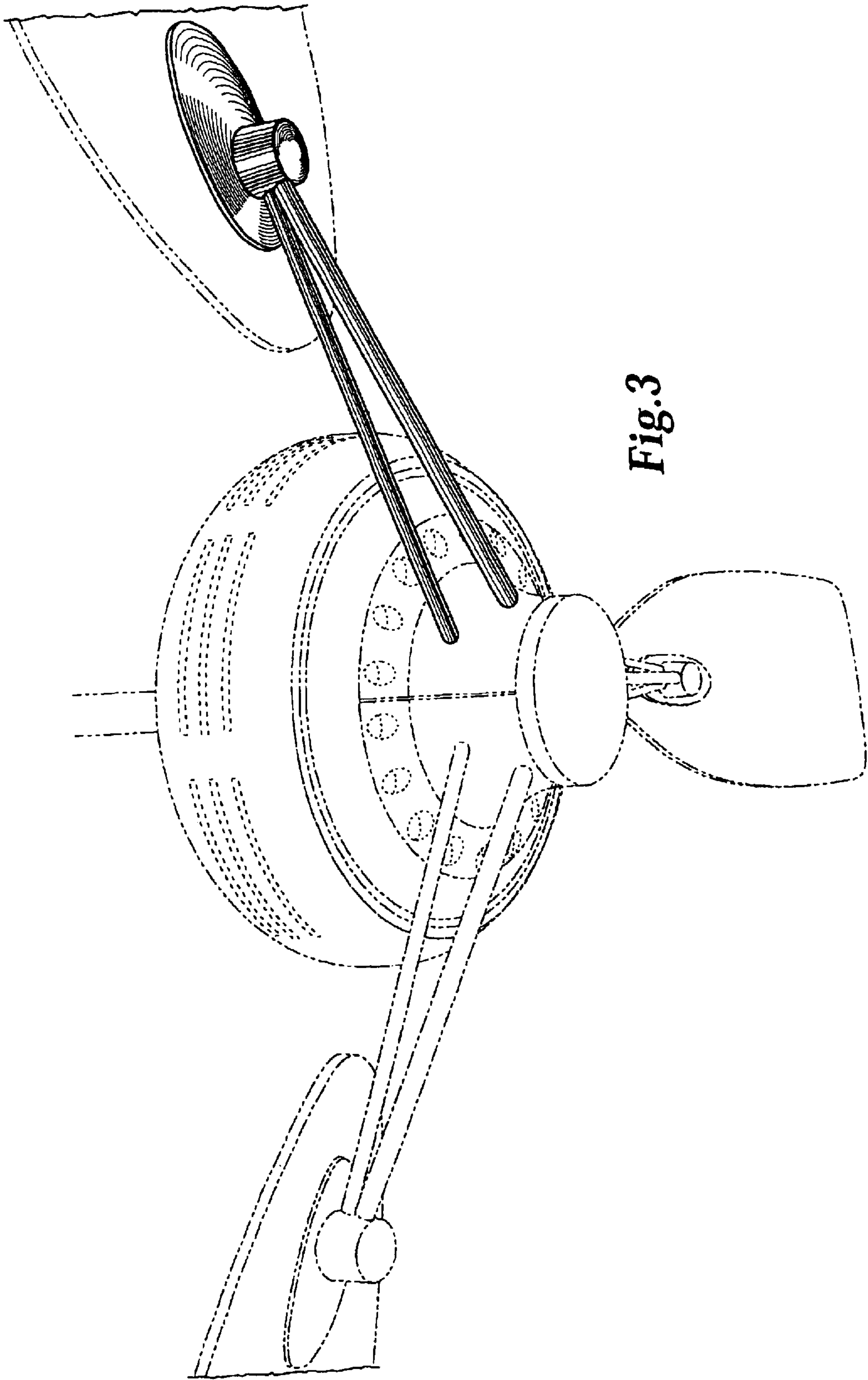
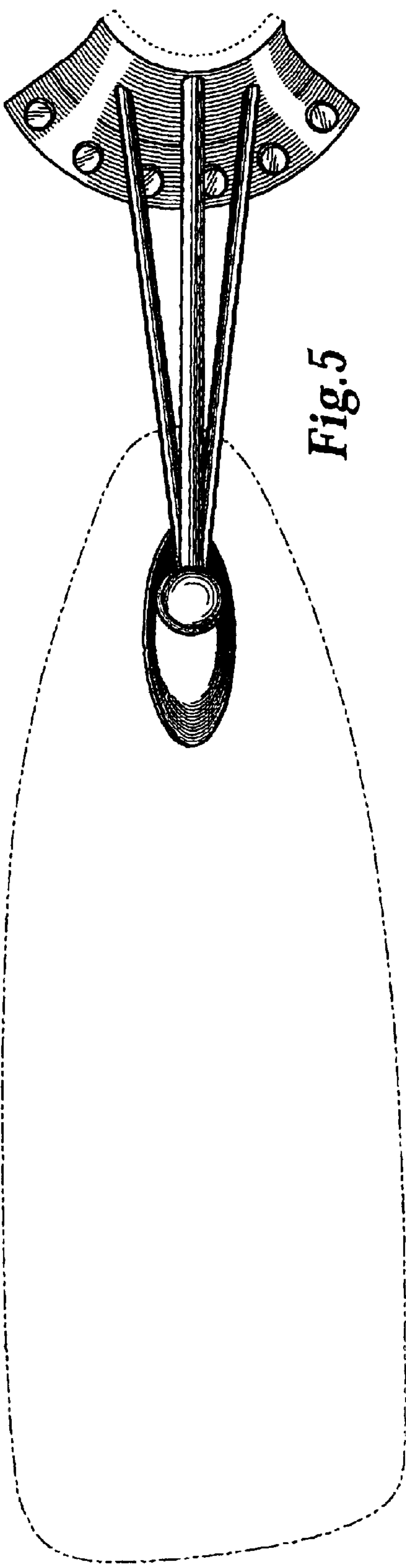
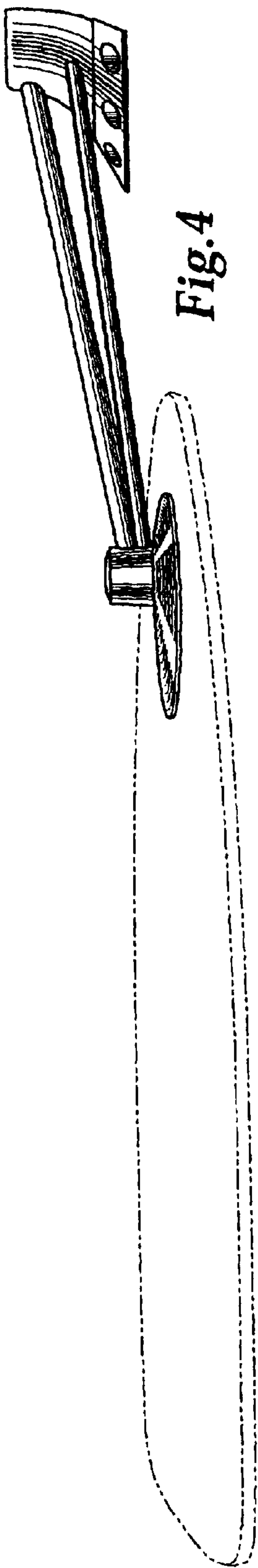
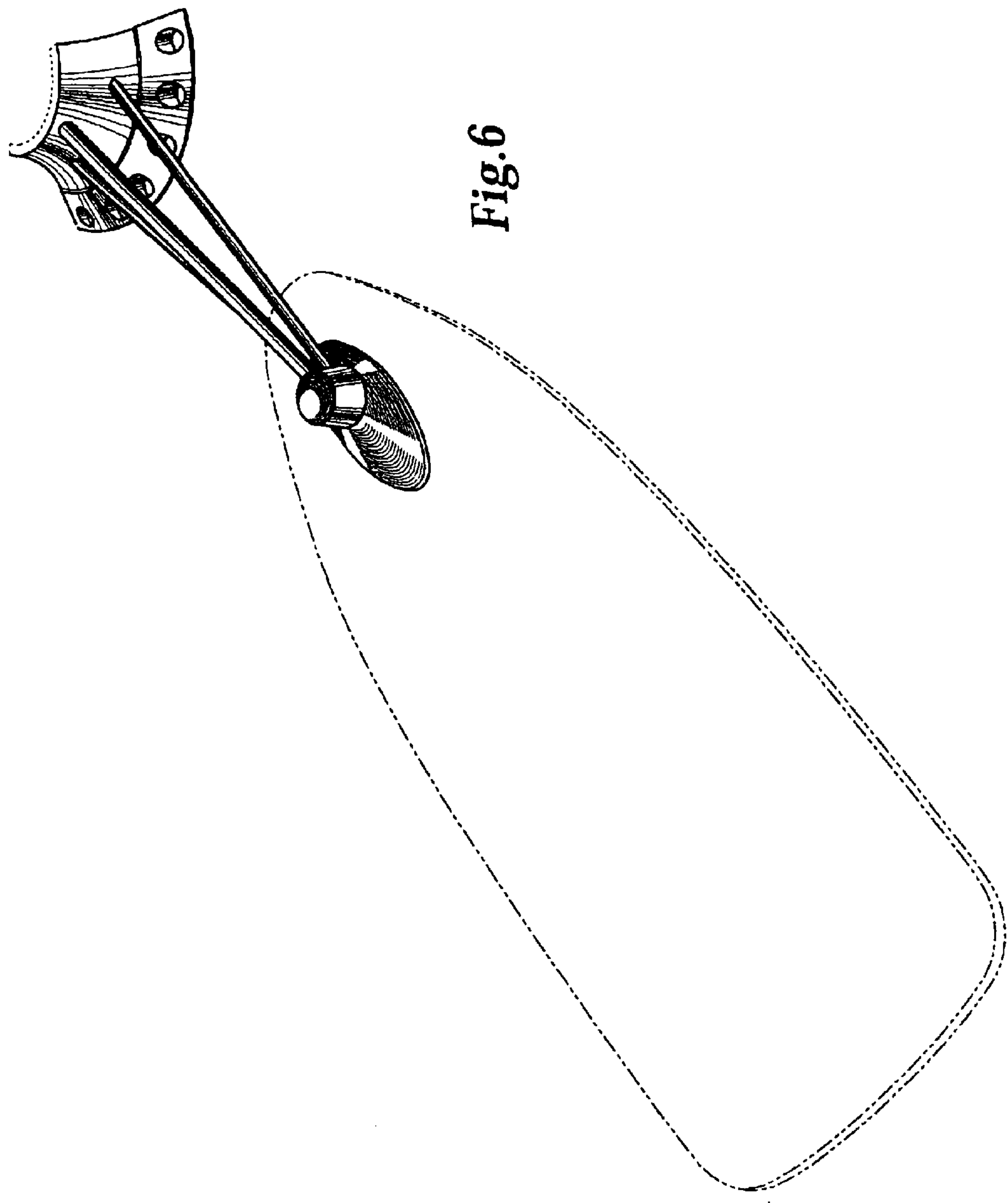

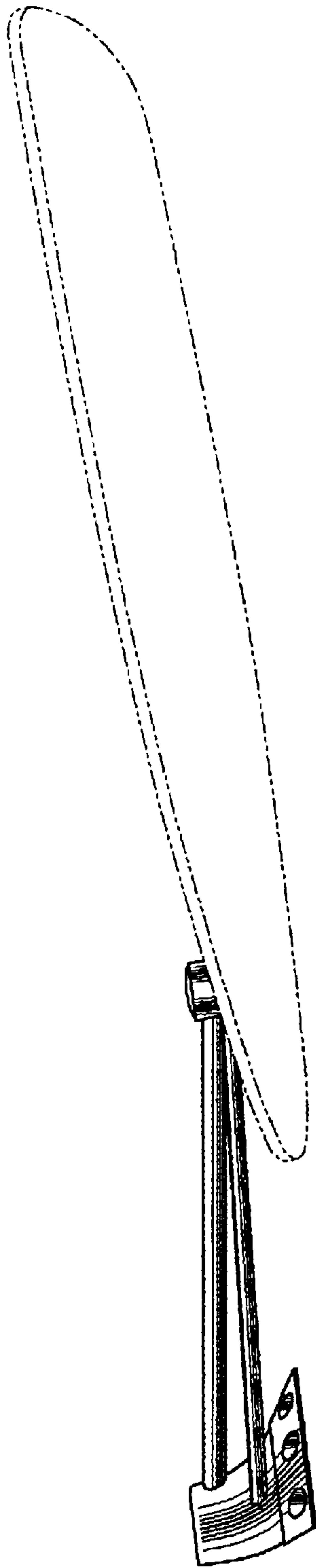

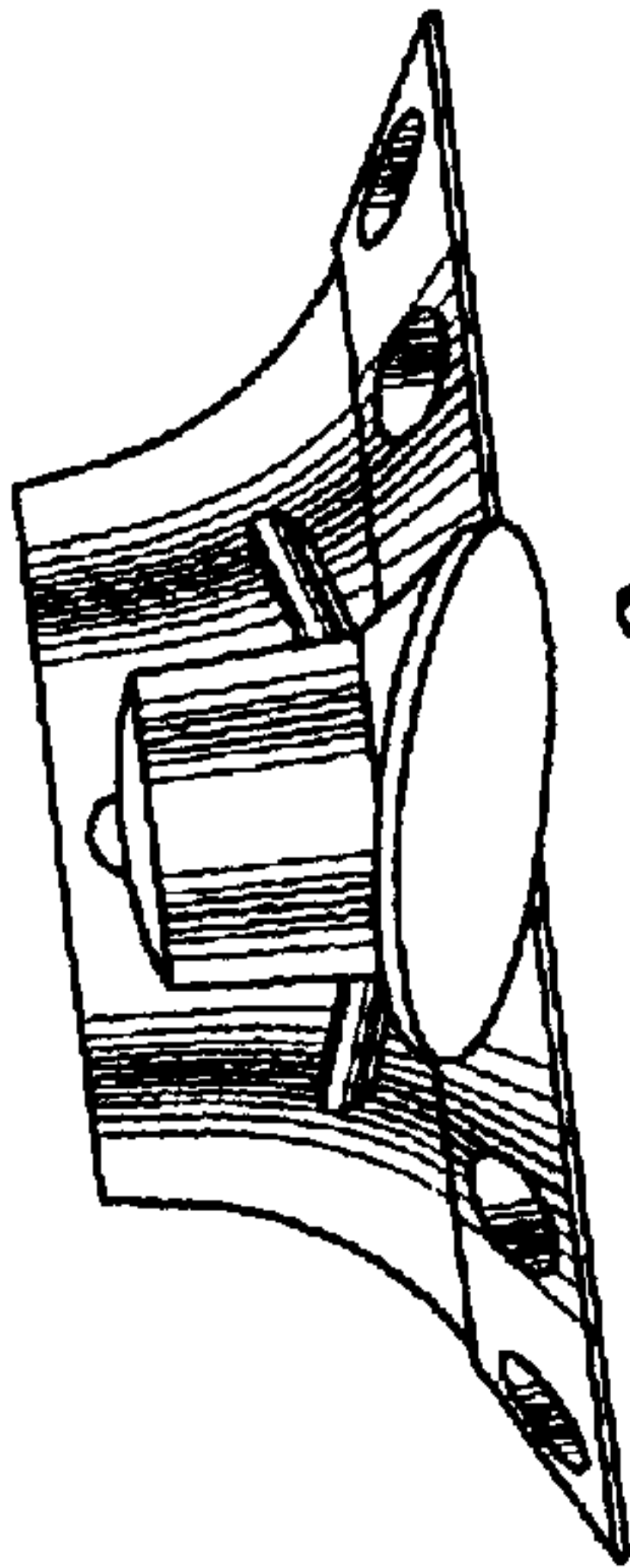

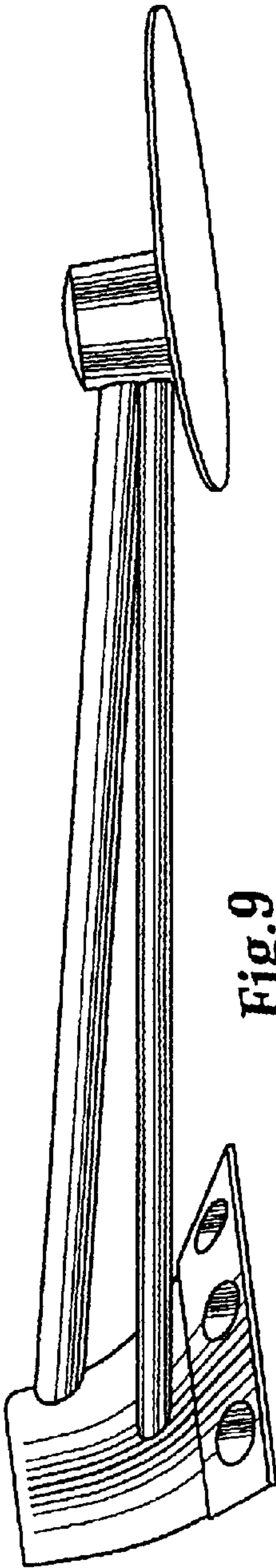

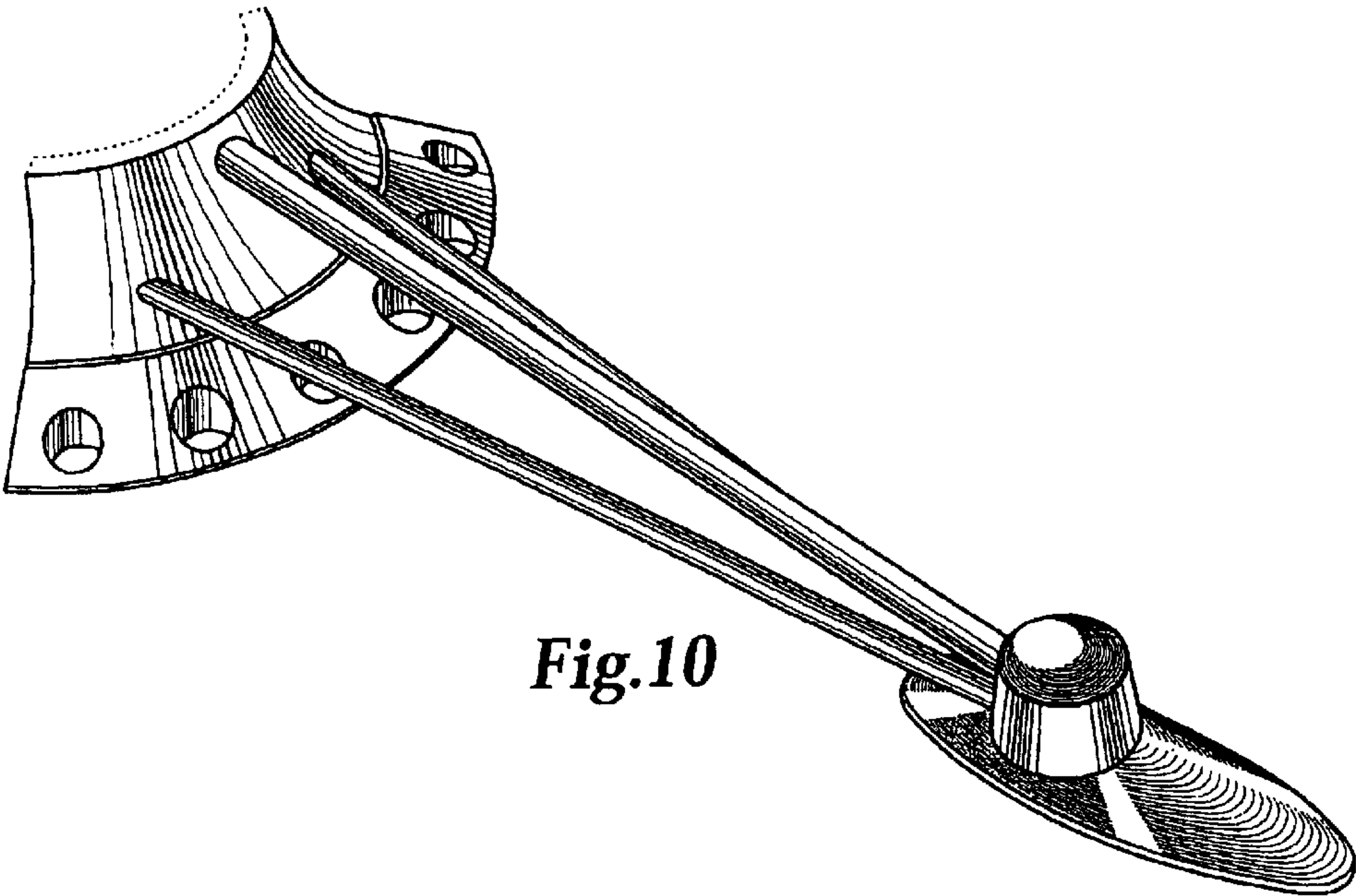

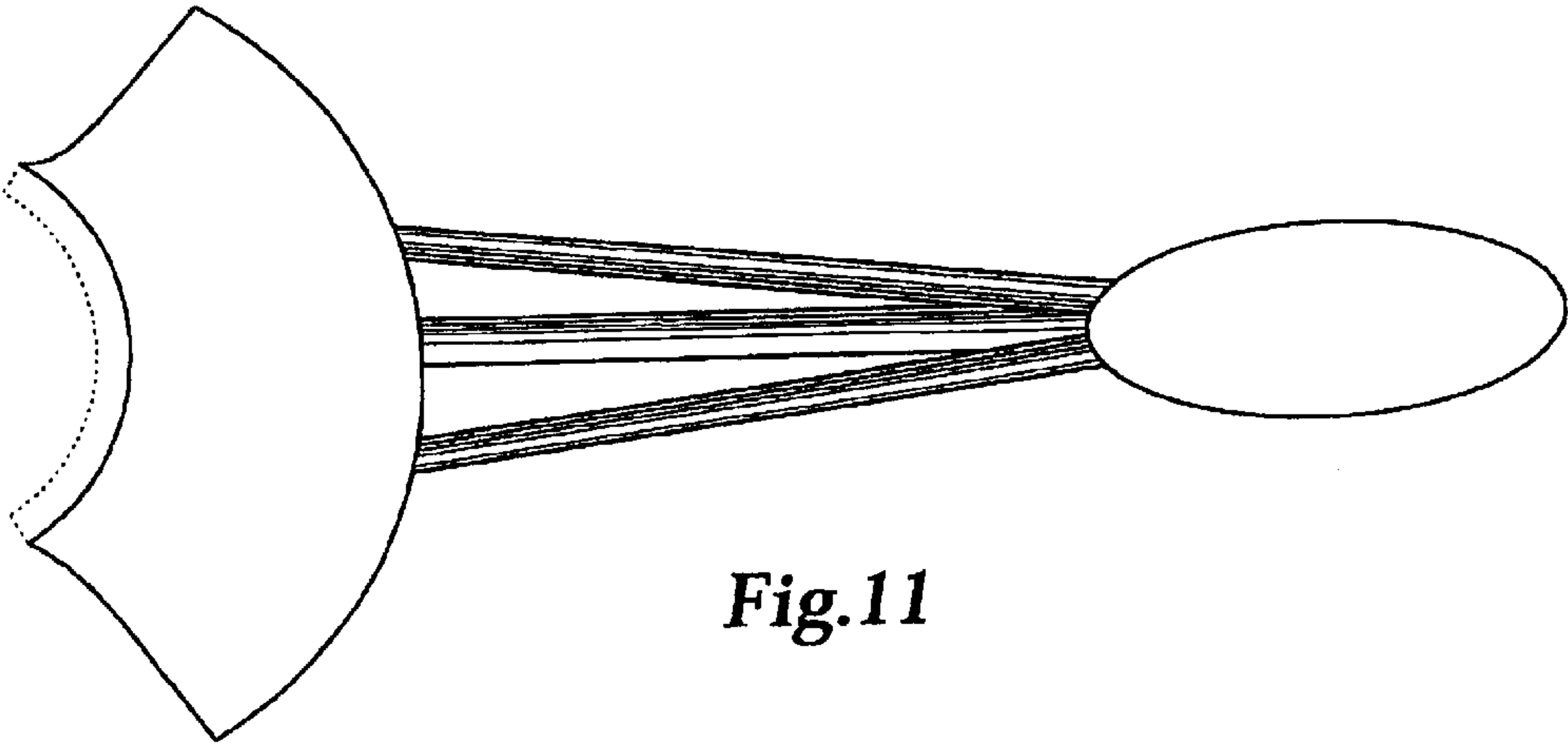
