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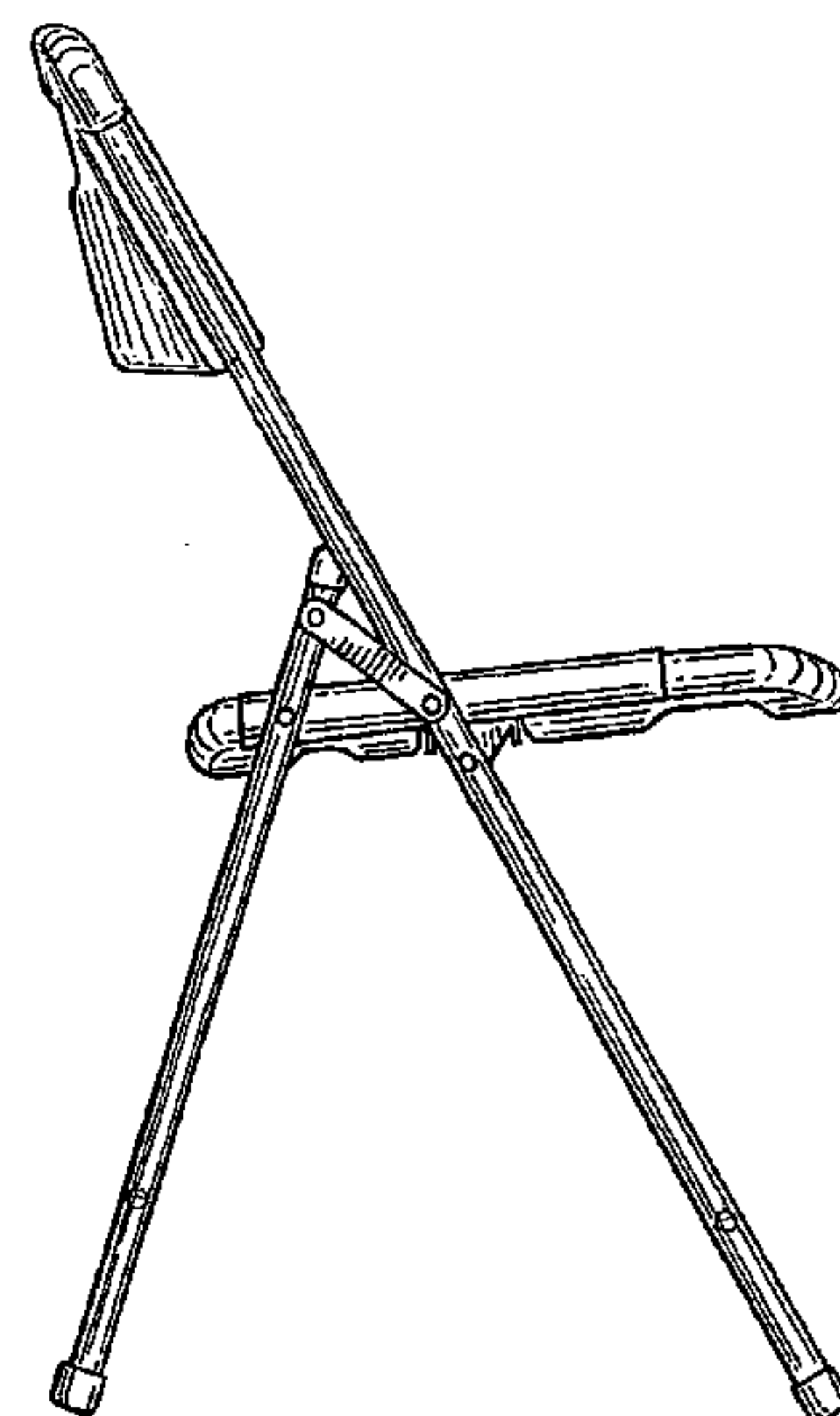
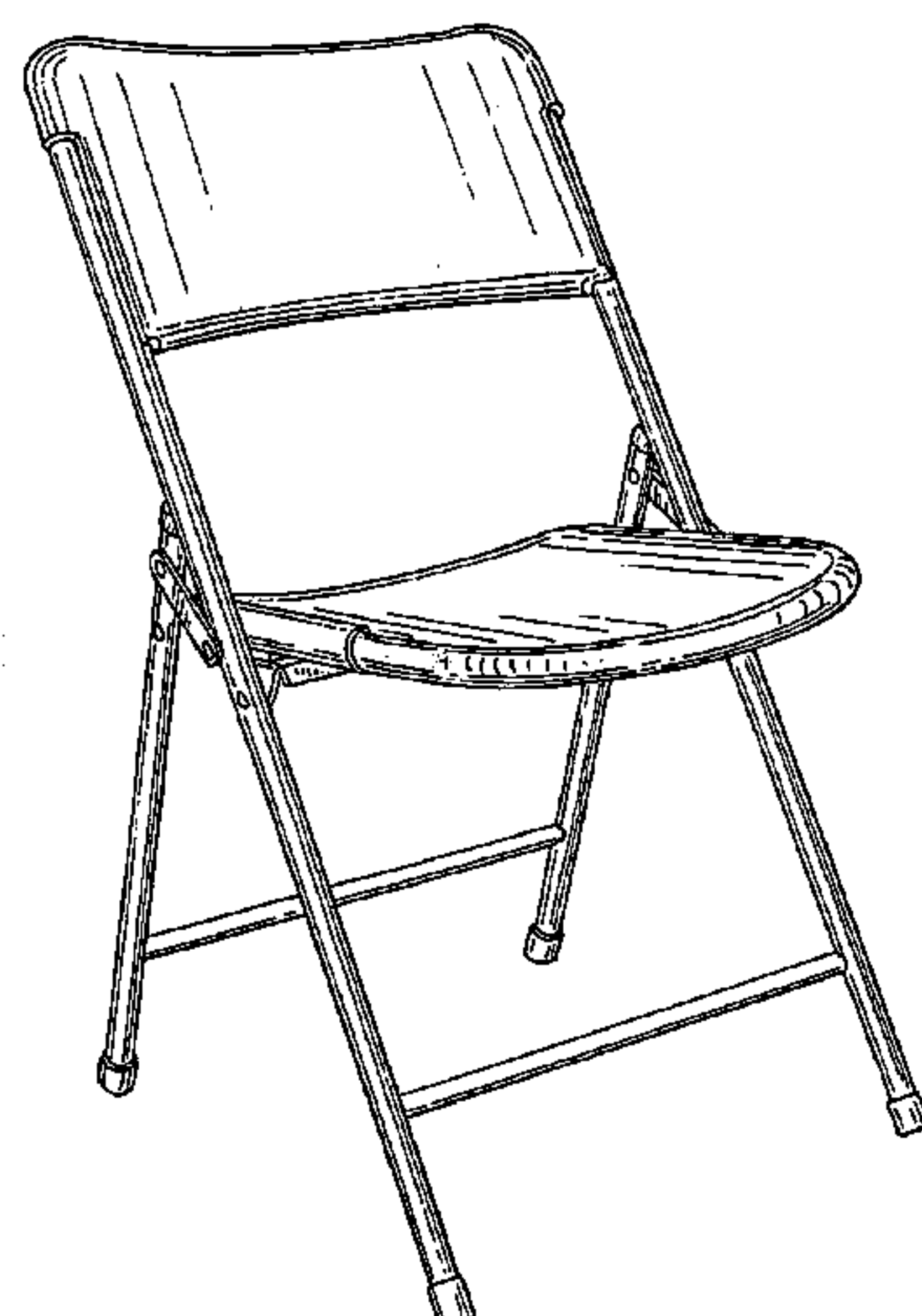
(57) **CLAIM**

The broken lines in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the invention.

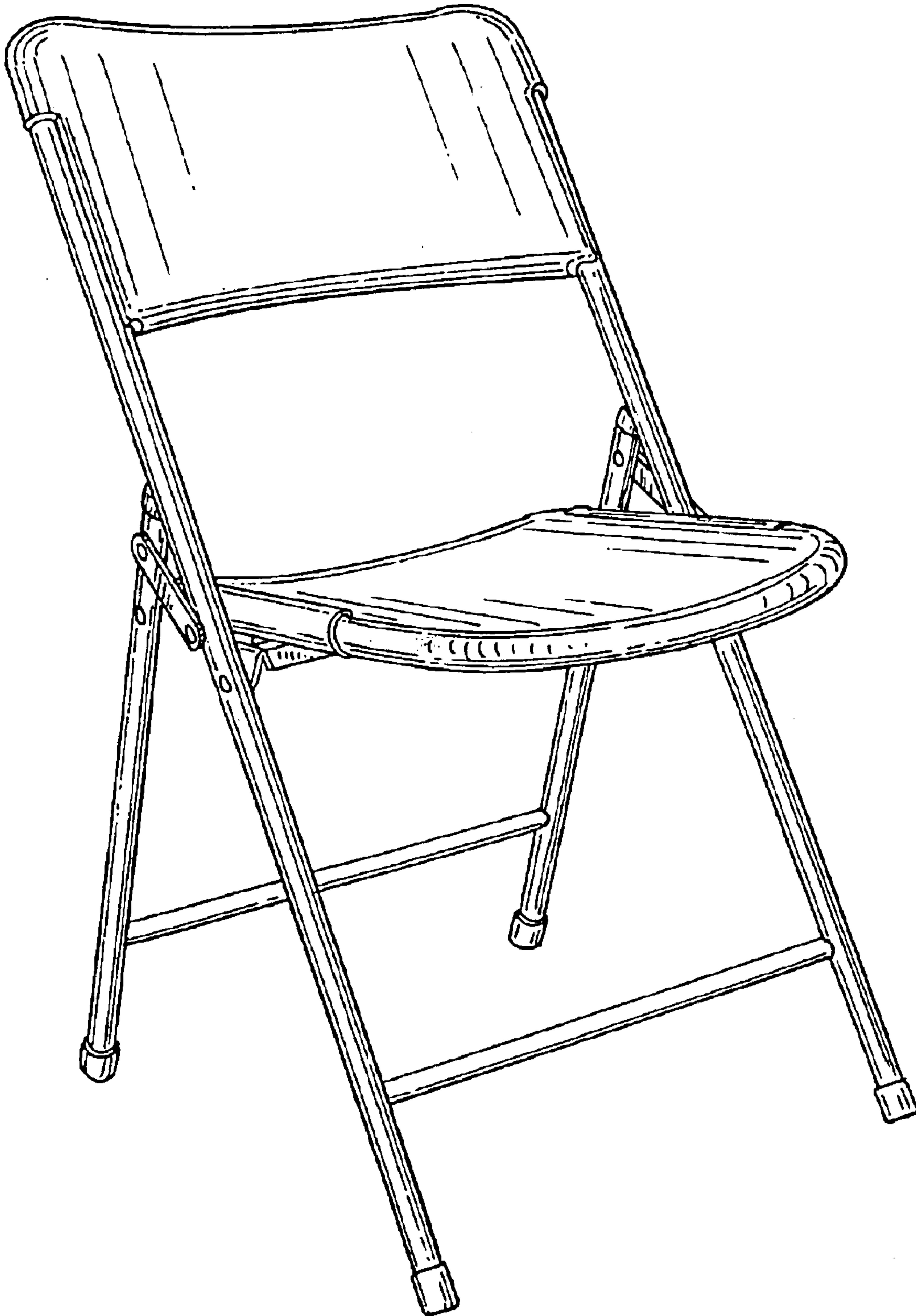

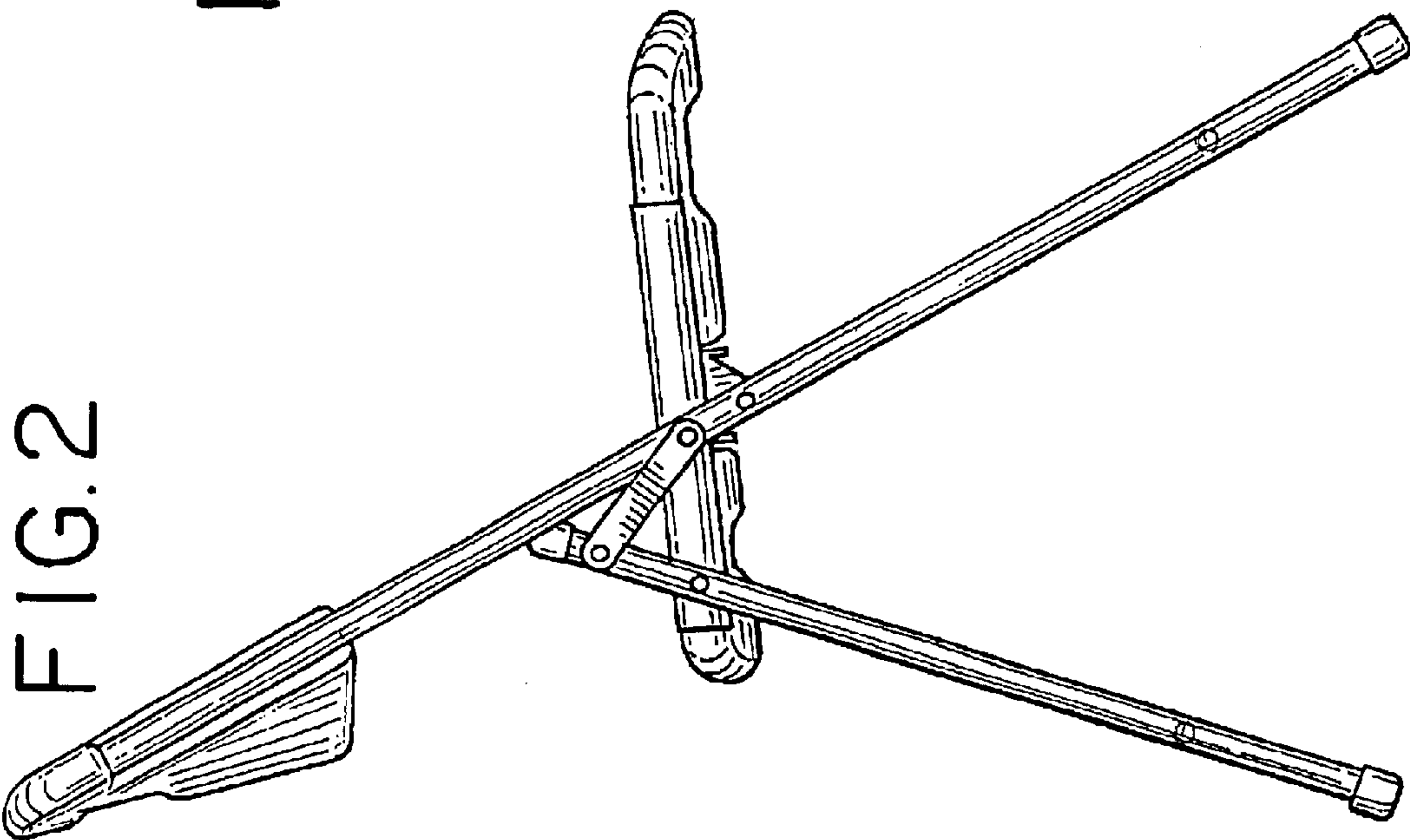

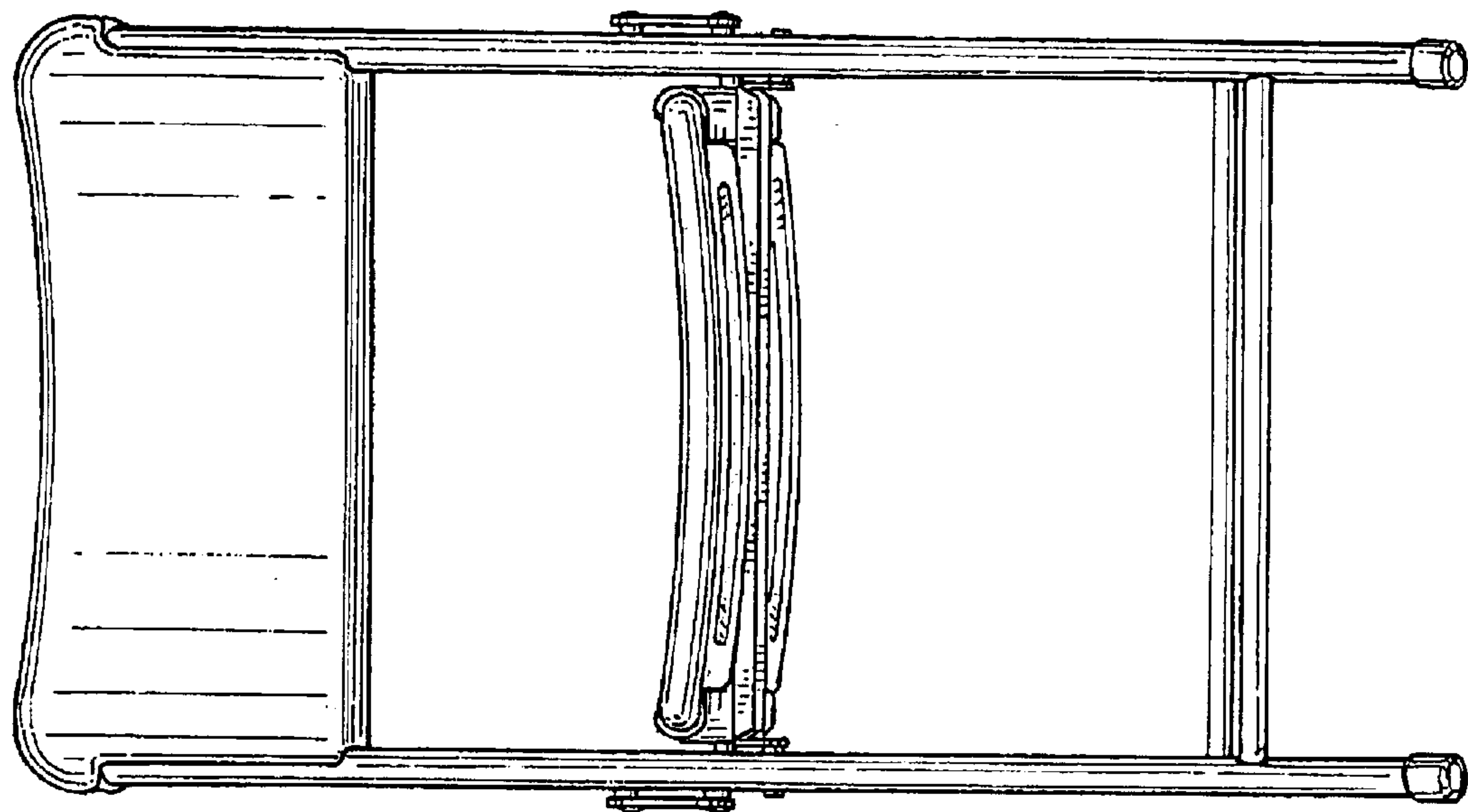

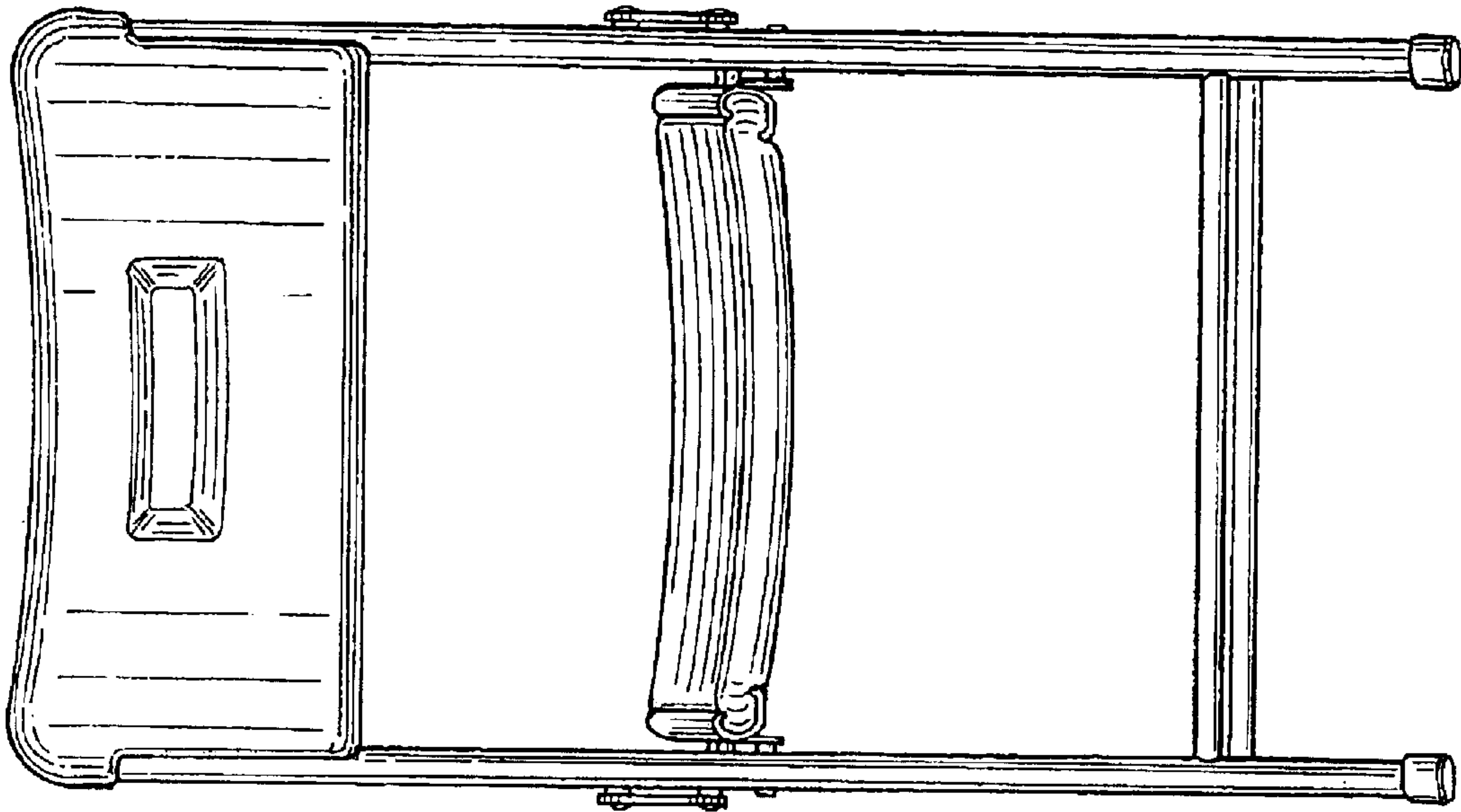

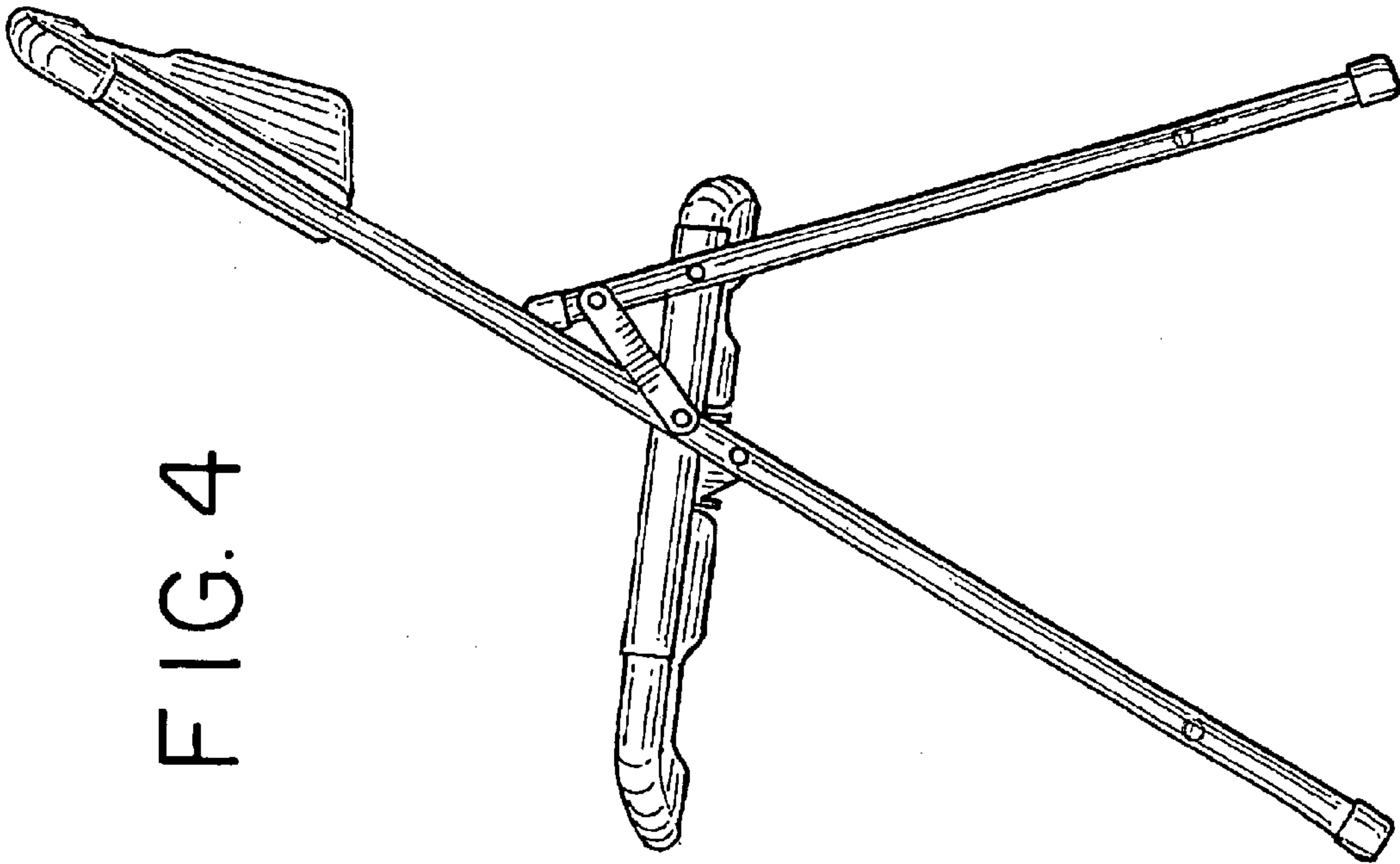

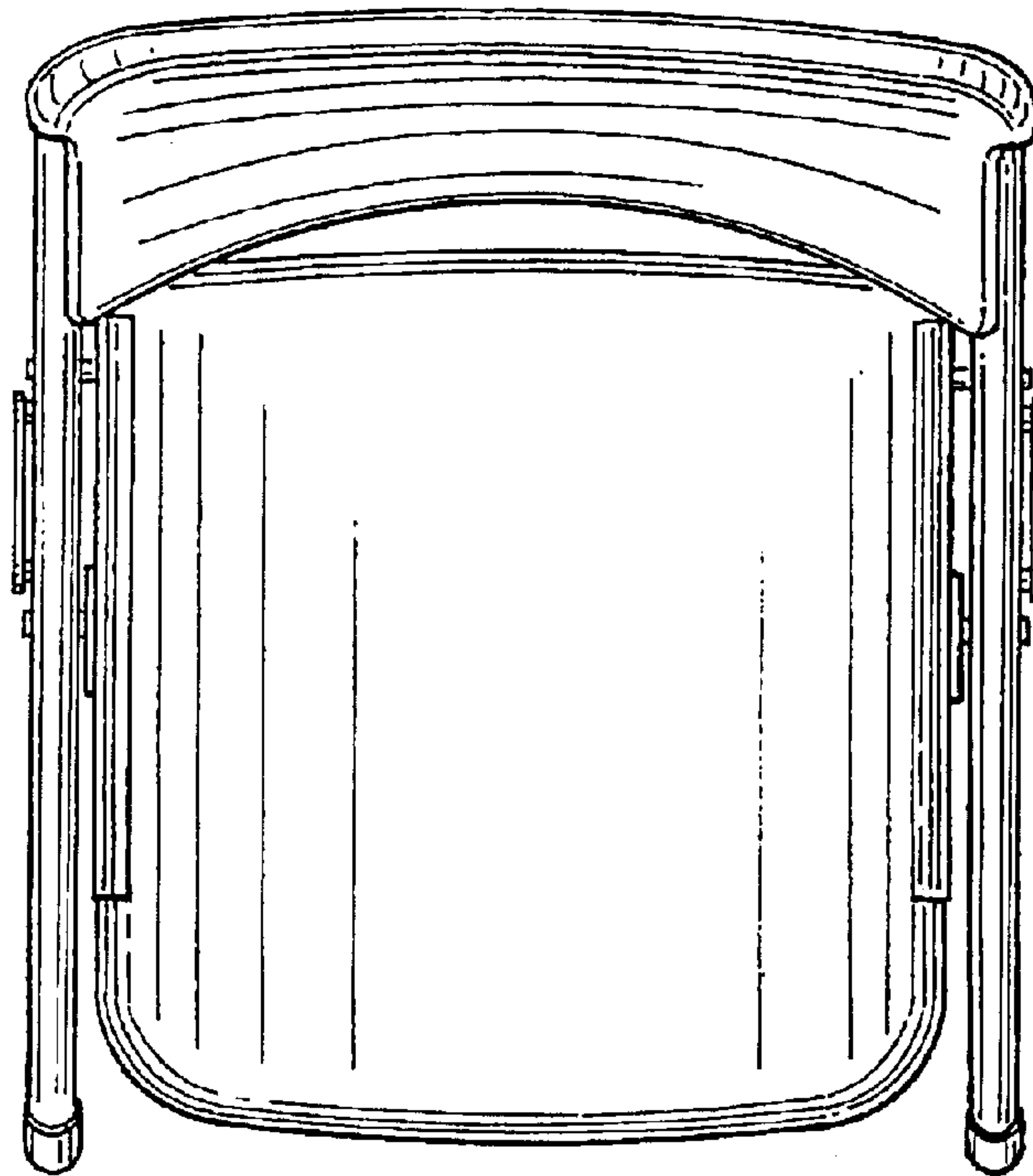
