The ornamental design for a novelty hat and wig, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

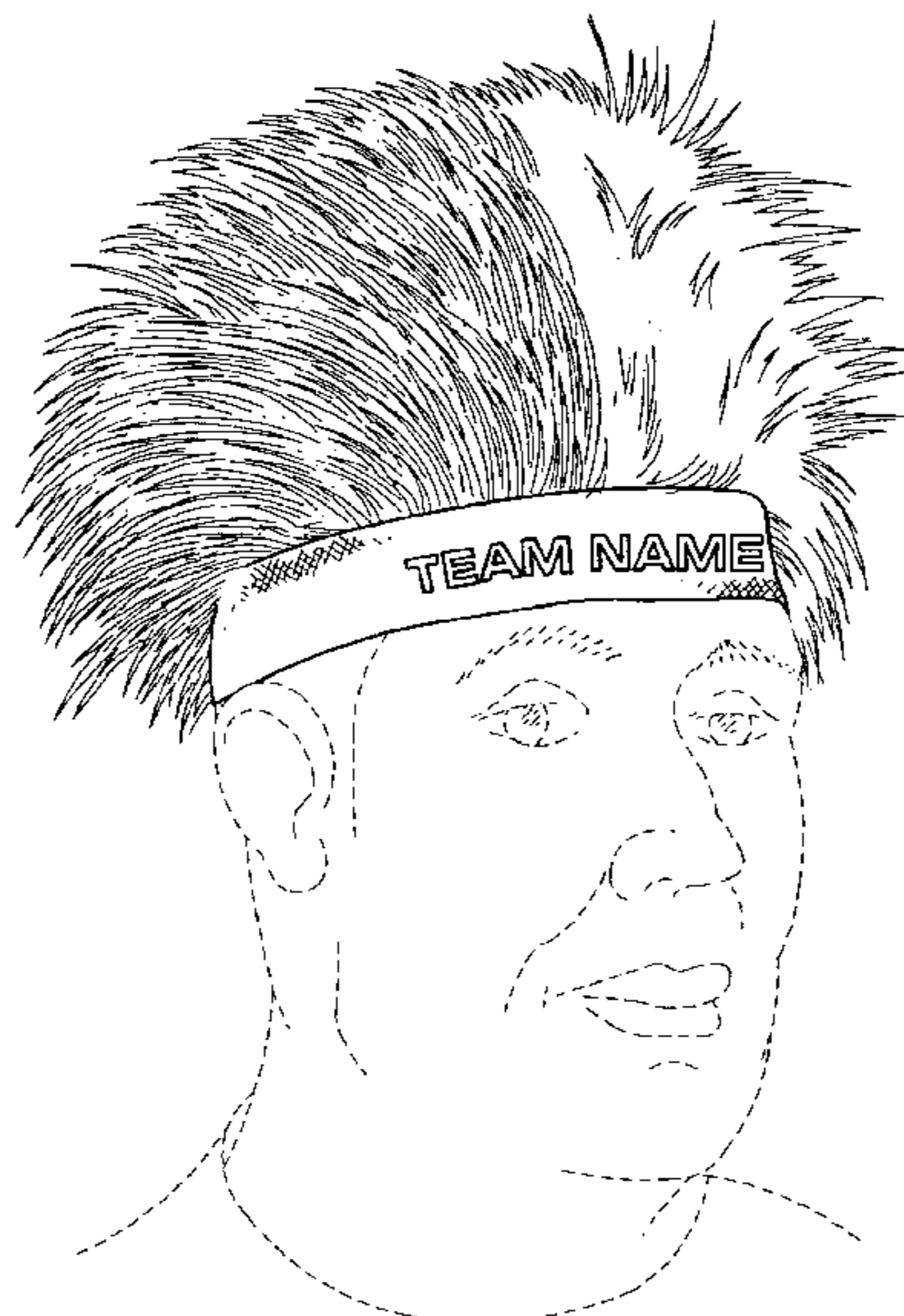
FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment of my novelty hat and wig of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a right side view of the novelty hat and wig in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the novelty hat and wig in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a back view of the novelty hat and wig in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the novelty hat and wig in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top view of the novelty hat and wig in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of the novelty hat and wig in FIG. 1, the broken lines showing the human being are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
The crisscross pattern shown intermittently on the band of the hat and wig represents material and is understood to be distributed uniformly over the surfaces on which it is represented.

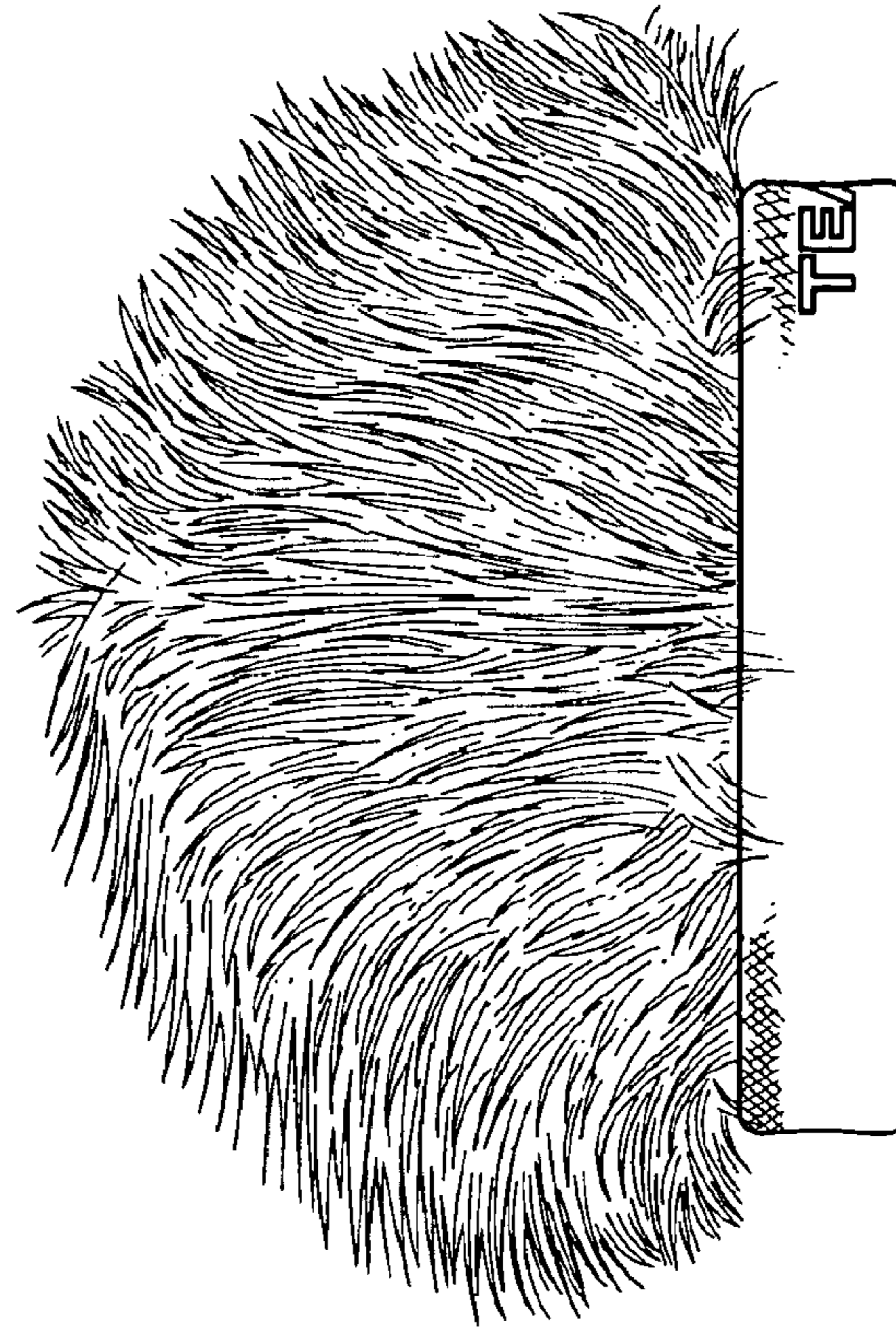

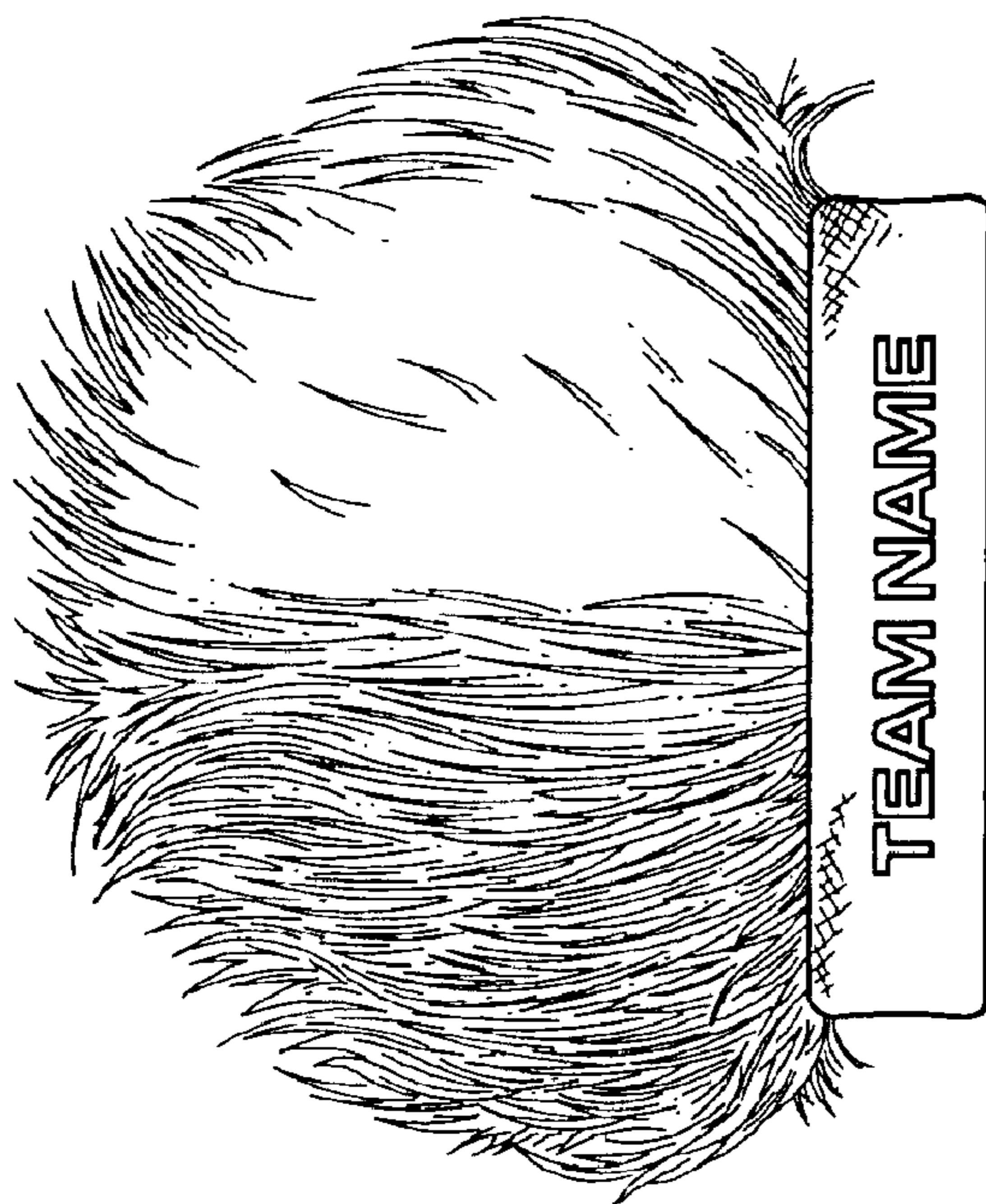

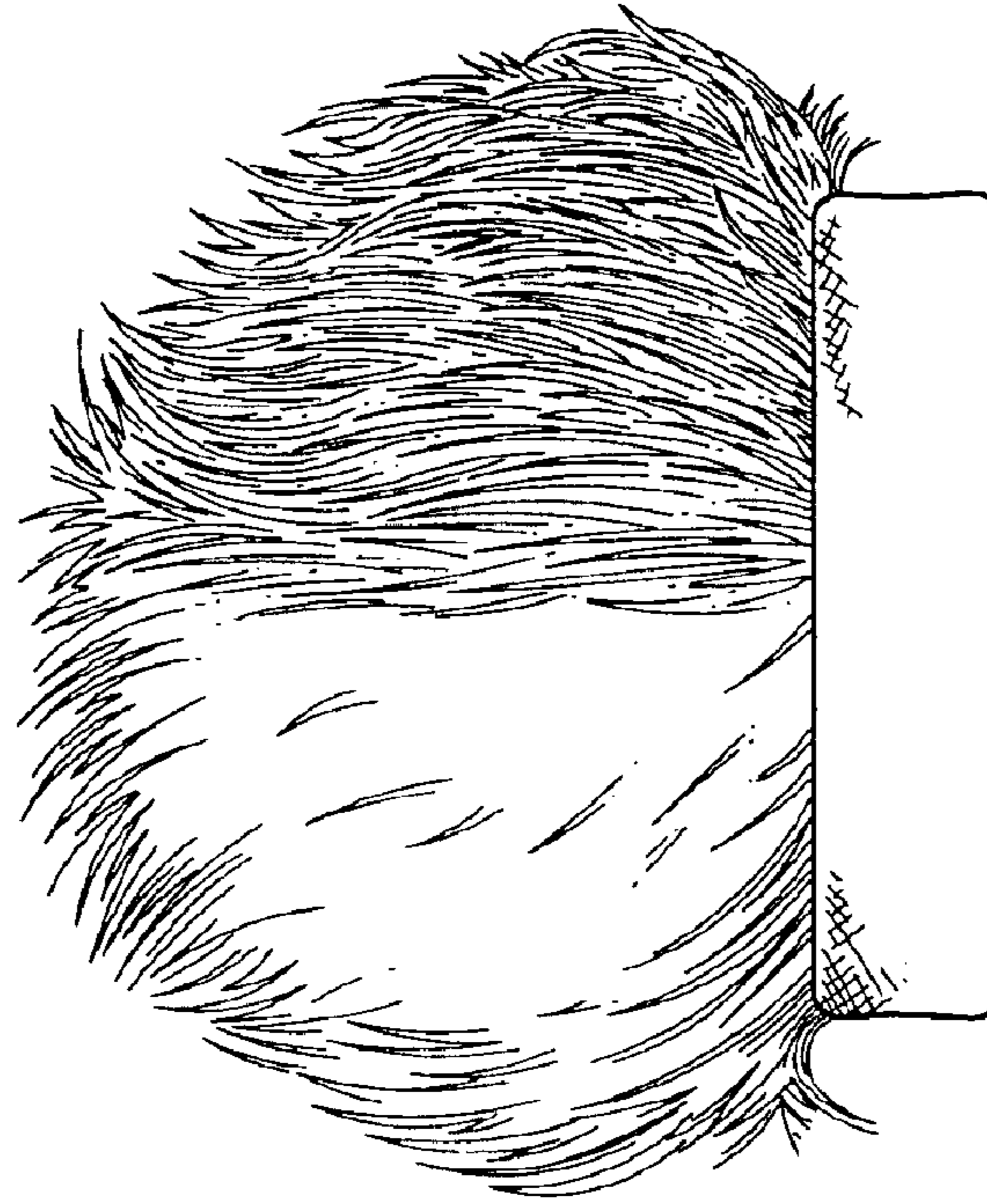

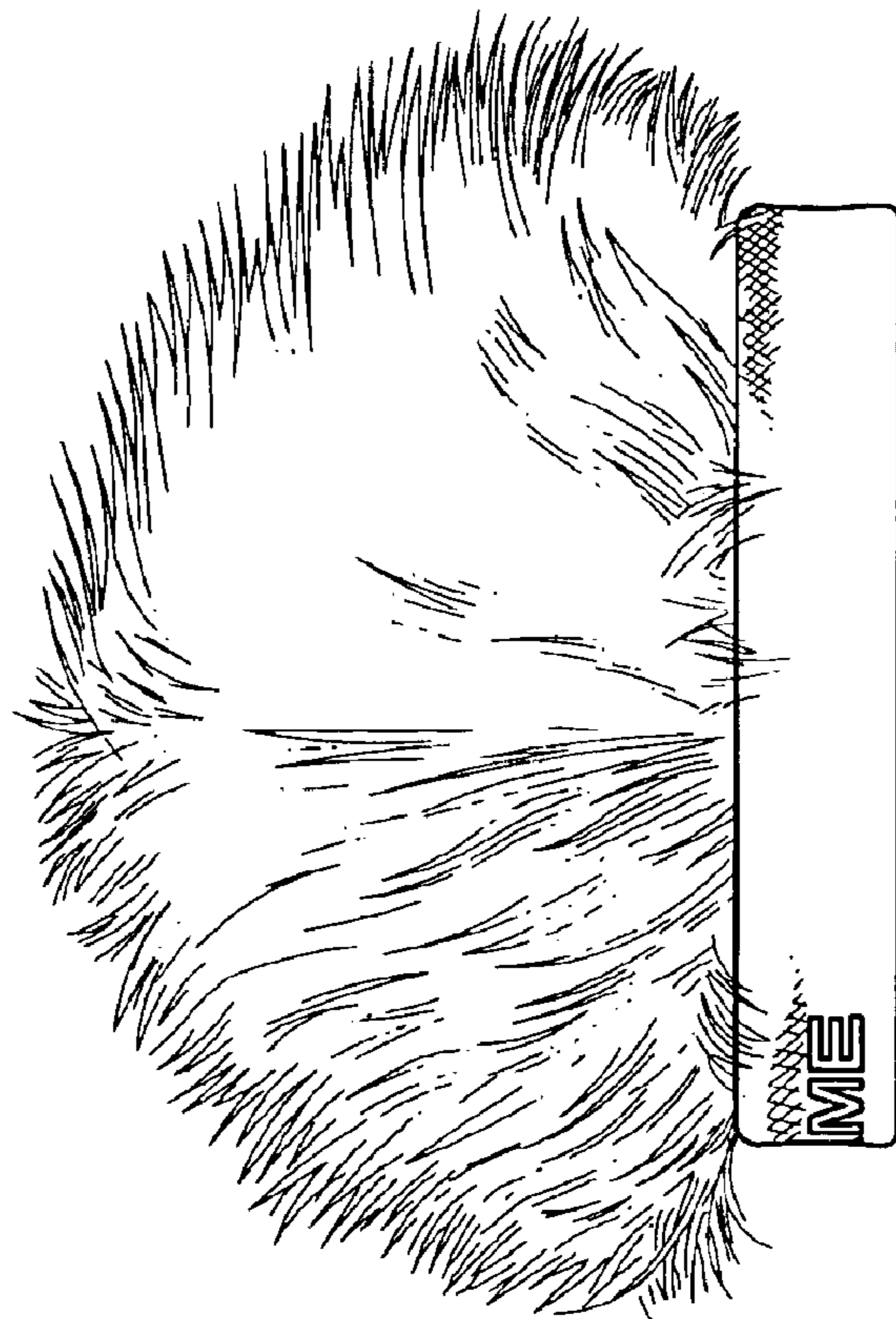

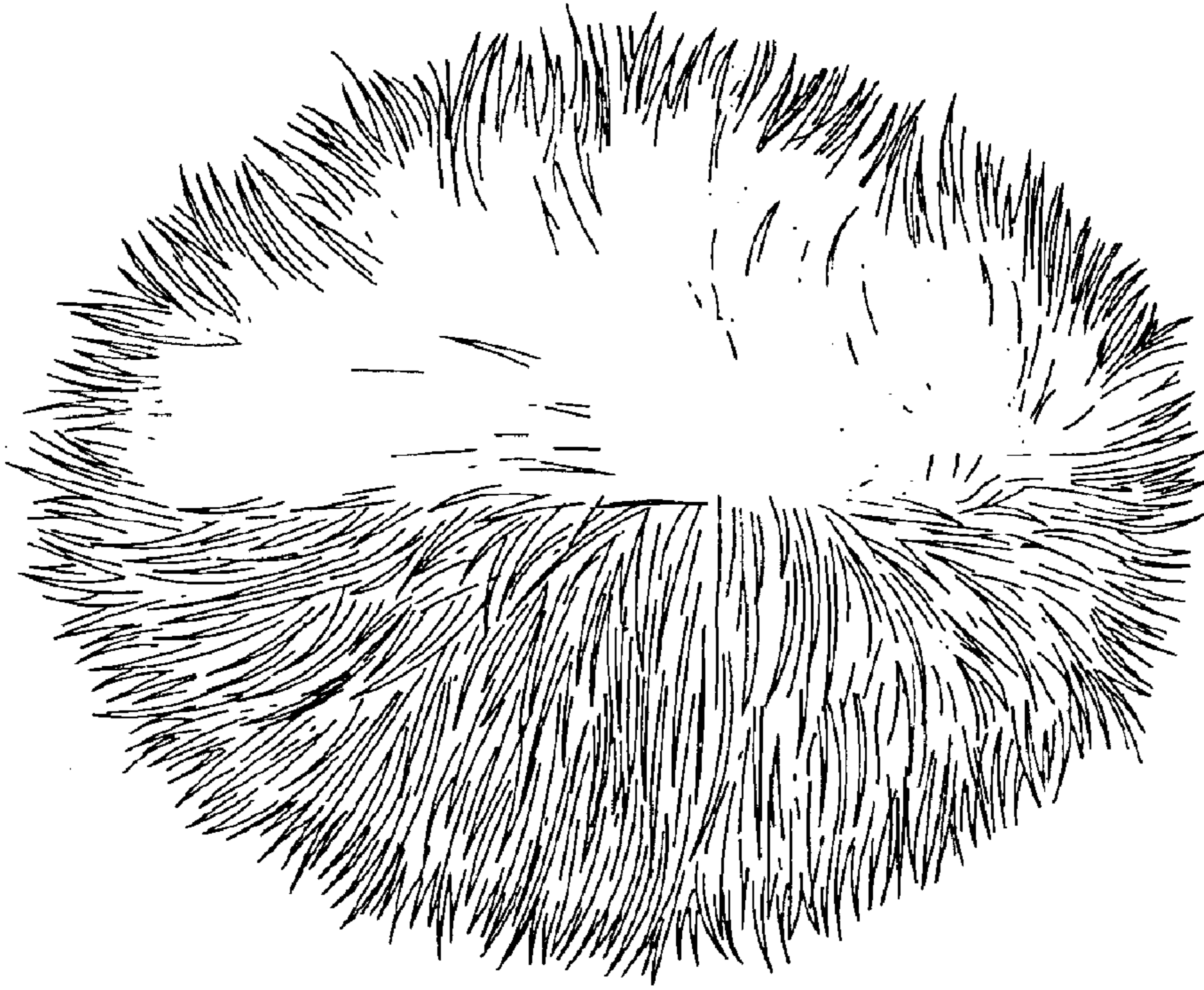

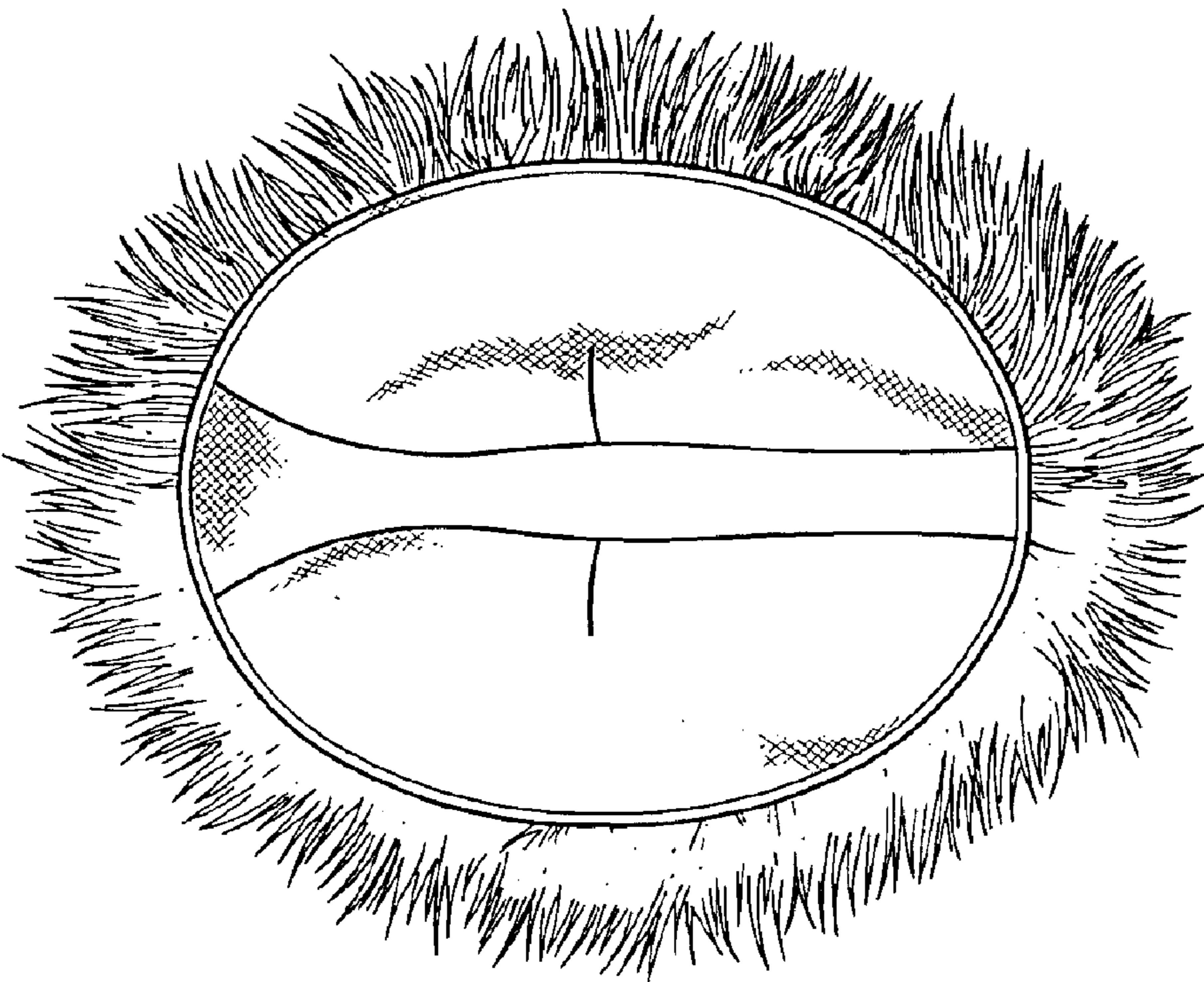
