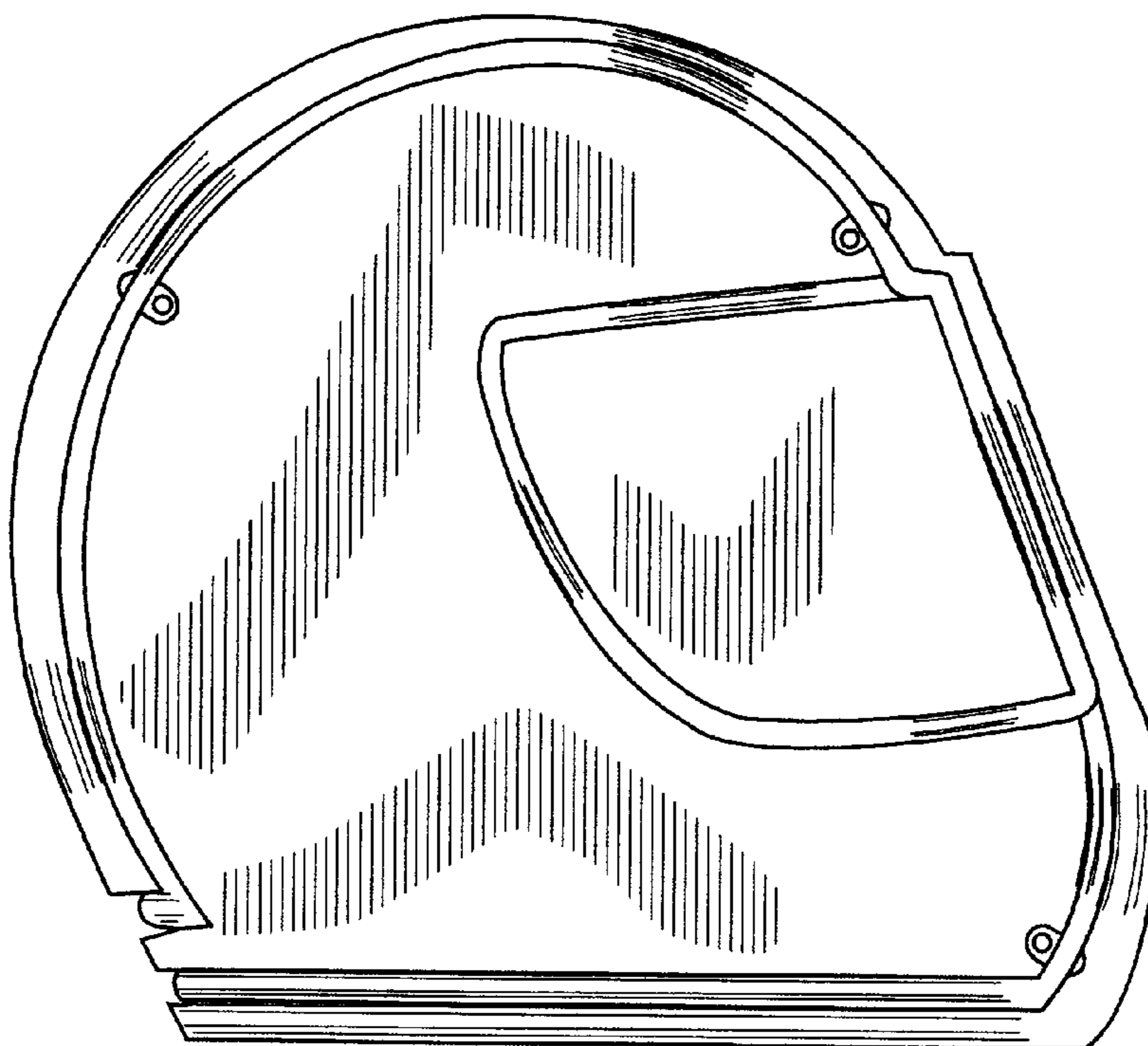
(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a racing helmet illuminated display, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a back elevational view of a racing helmet illuminated display, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged bottom perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an enlarged top perspective view thereof; FIG. 5 is an enlarged side perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is an enlarged opposite side perspective view thereof. The broken lines in the drawings represent environmental structure only and form no part of the claimed design.

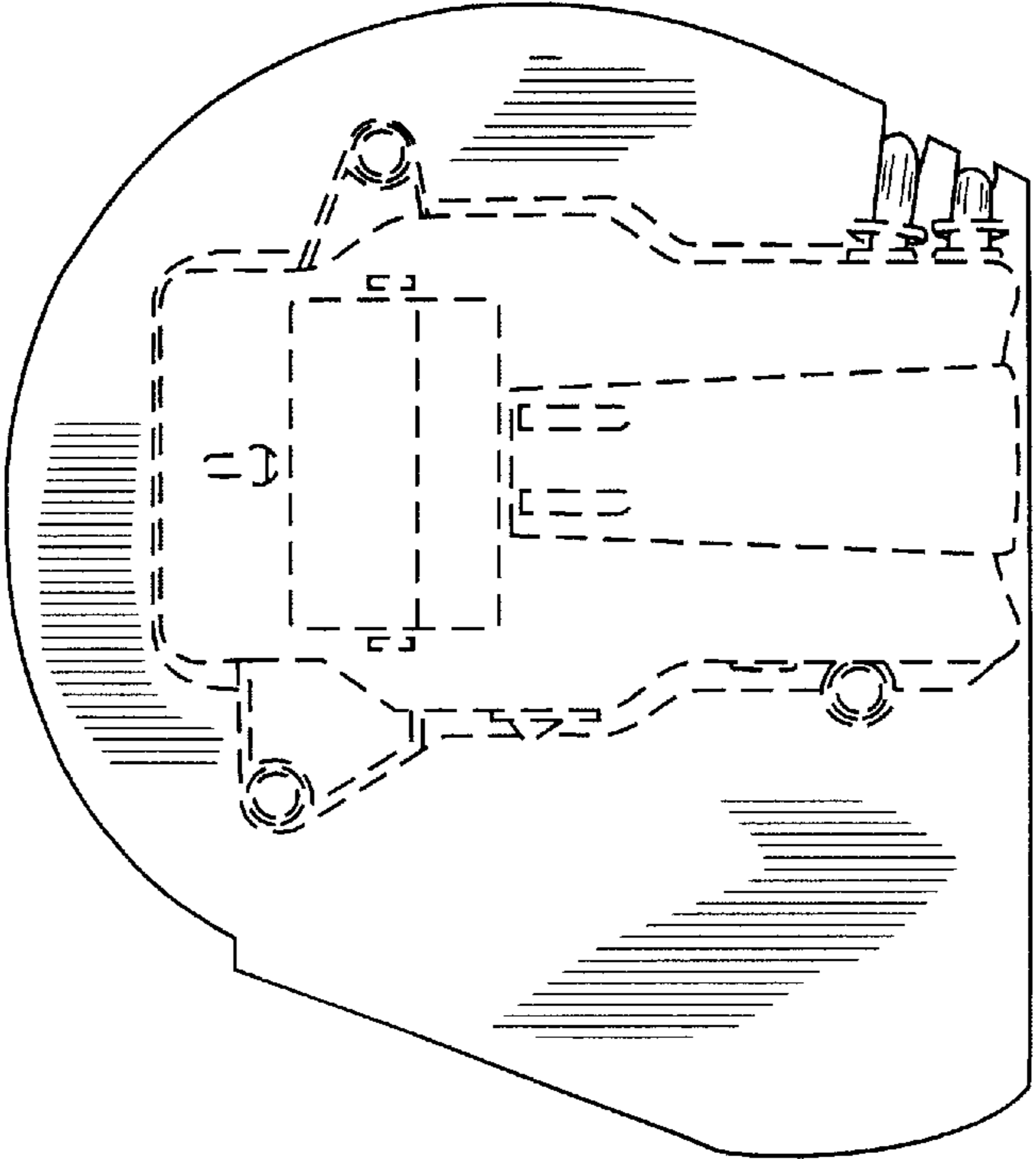

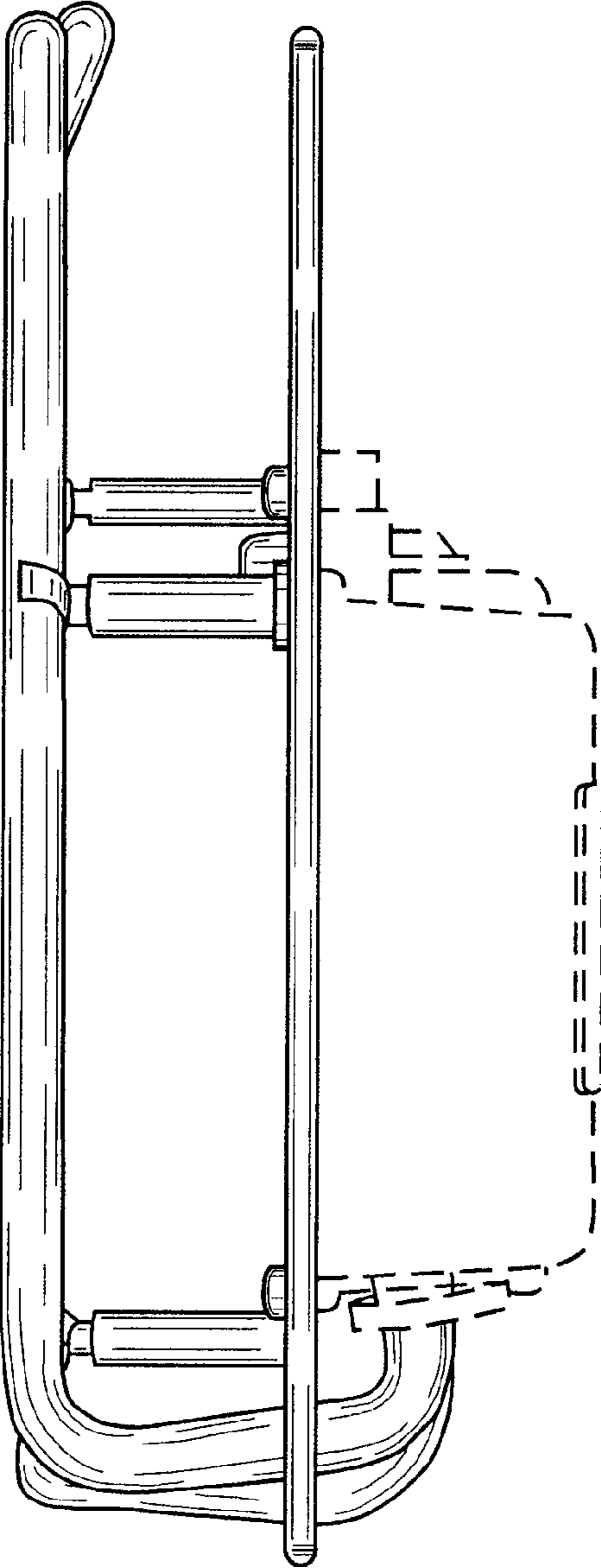

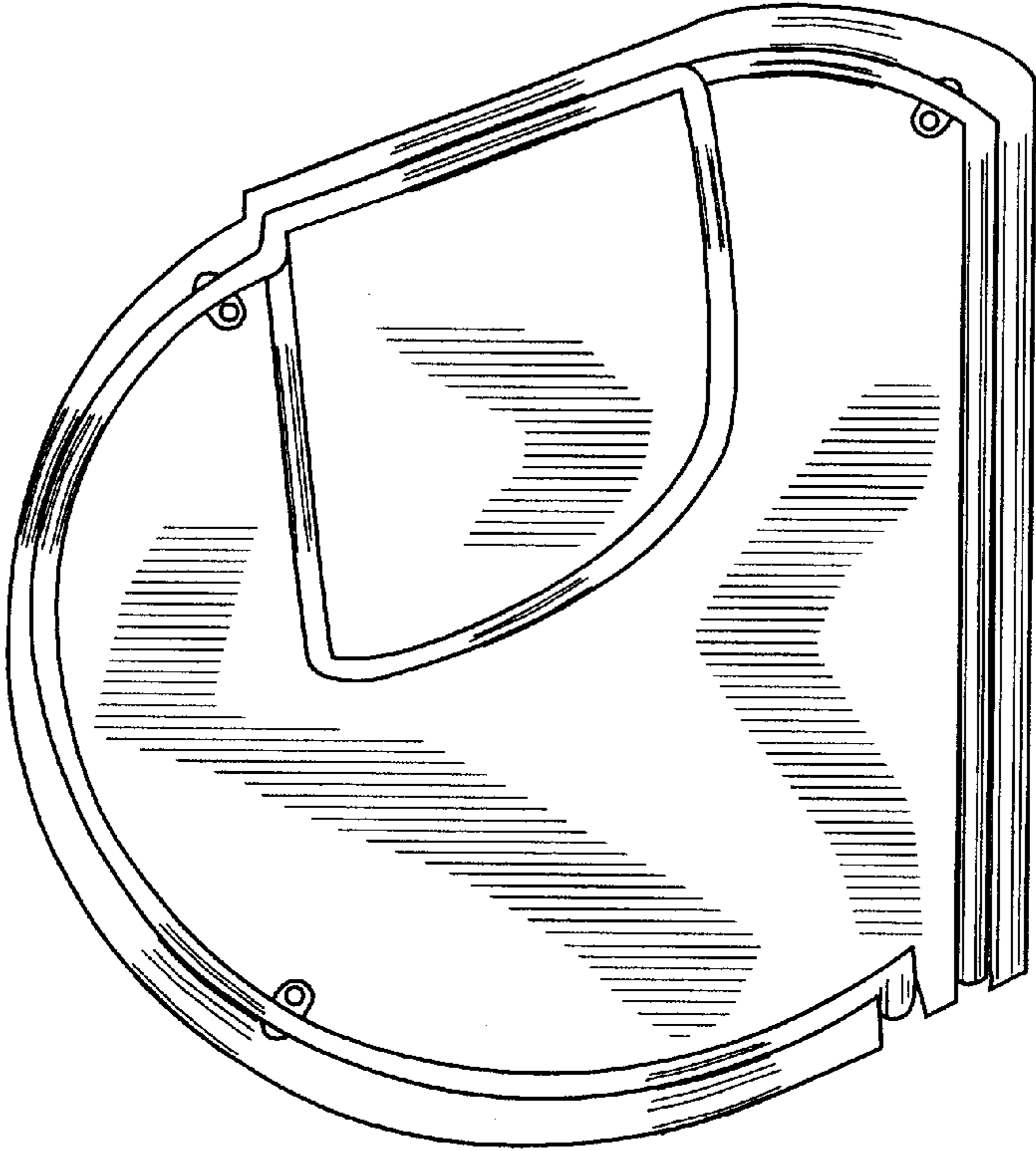

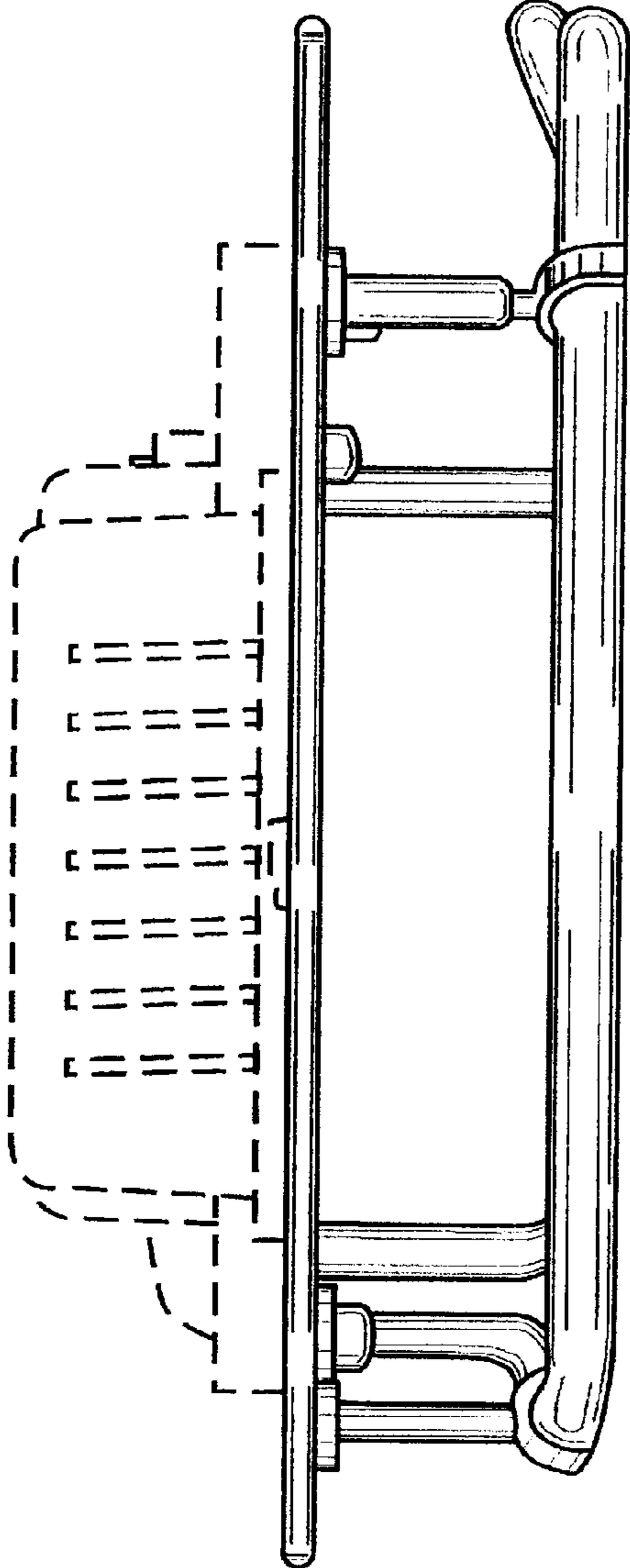

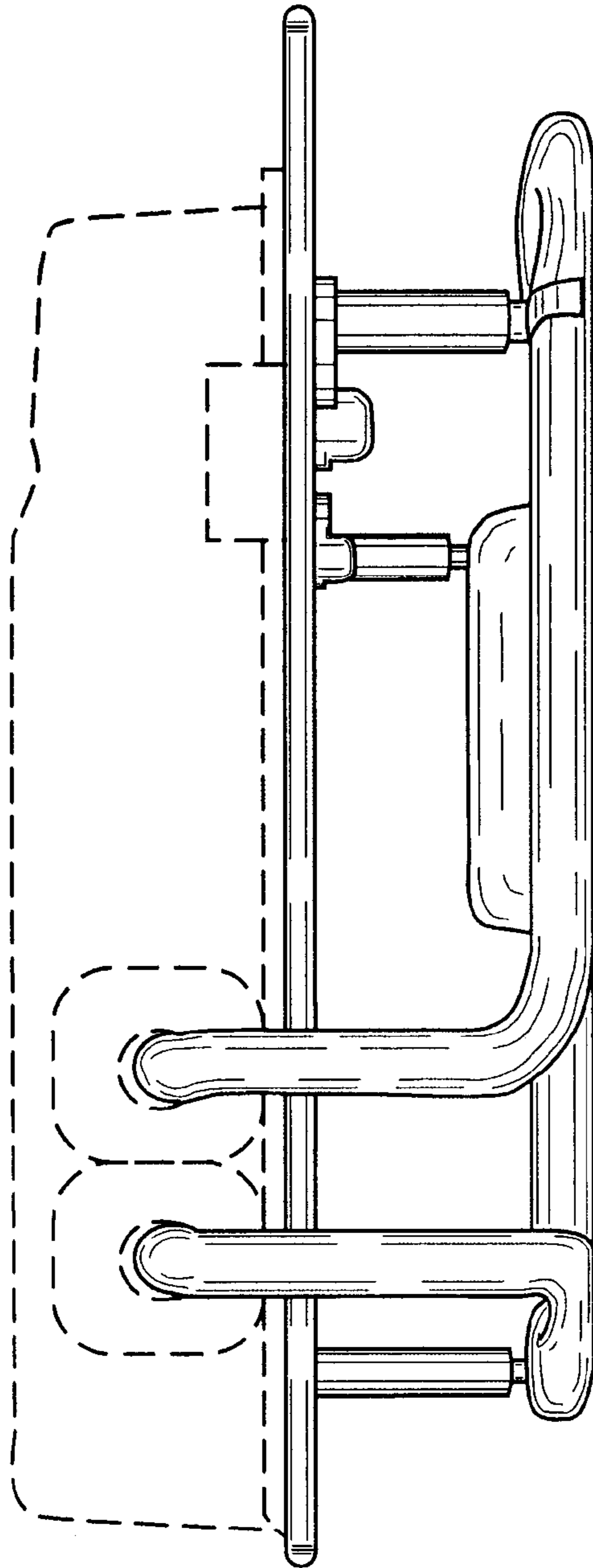

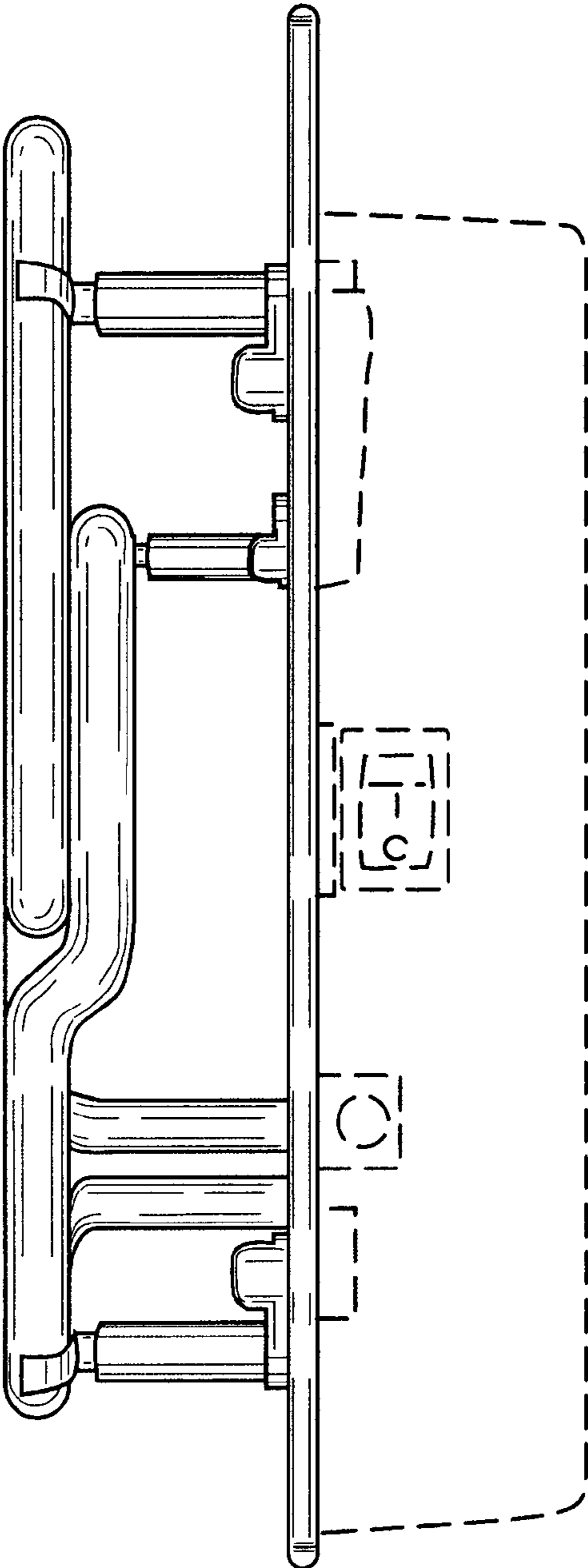
