DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a garment liner, the rear elevation forming no part of the design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation of the garment liner of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation of the garment liner of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a top plan of the garment liner of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan of the garment liner of FIG. 1.

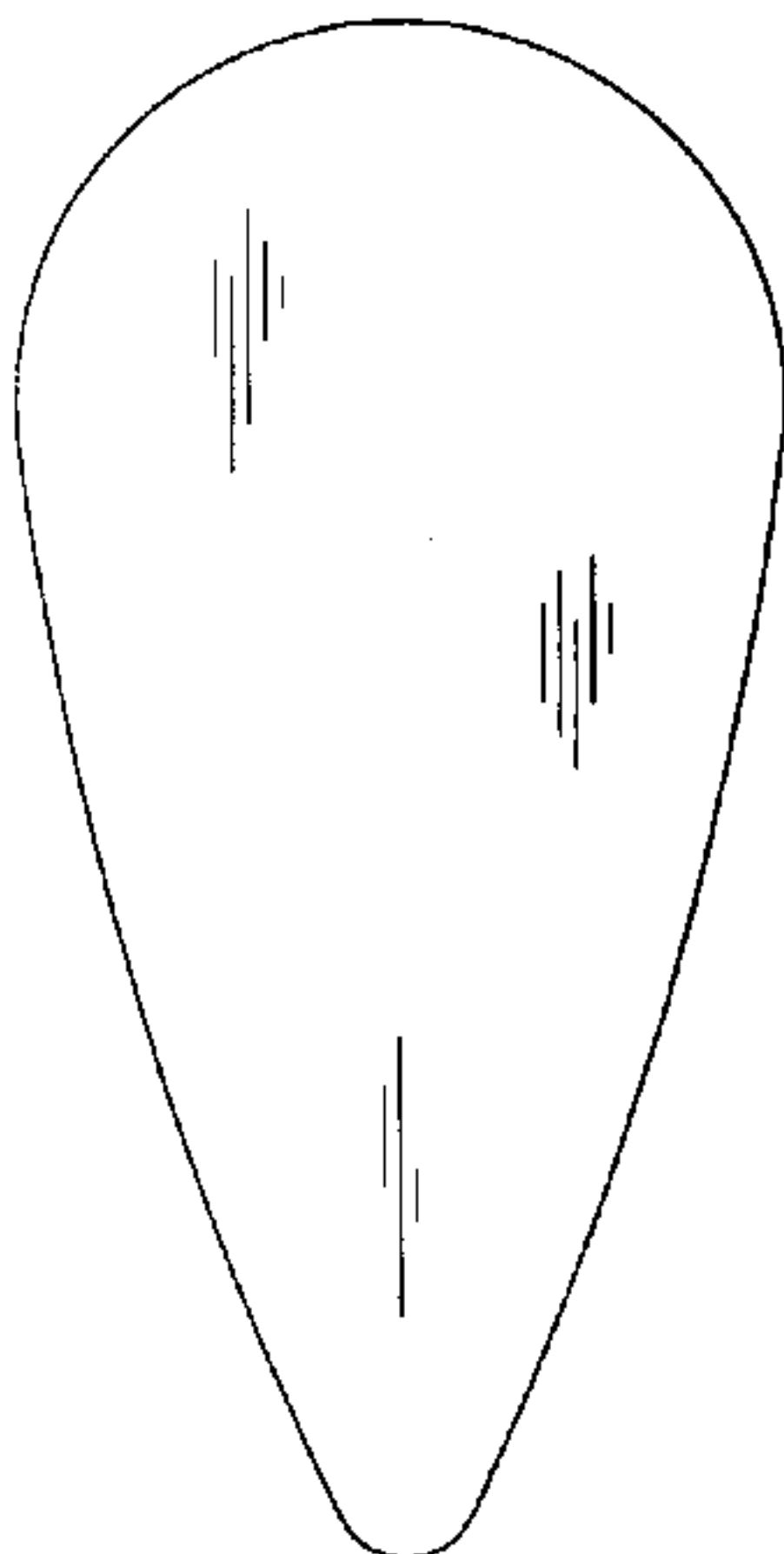

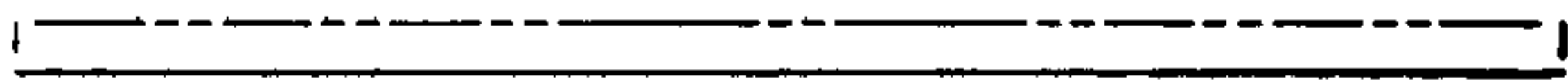

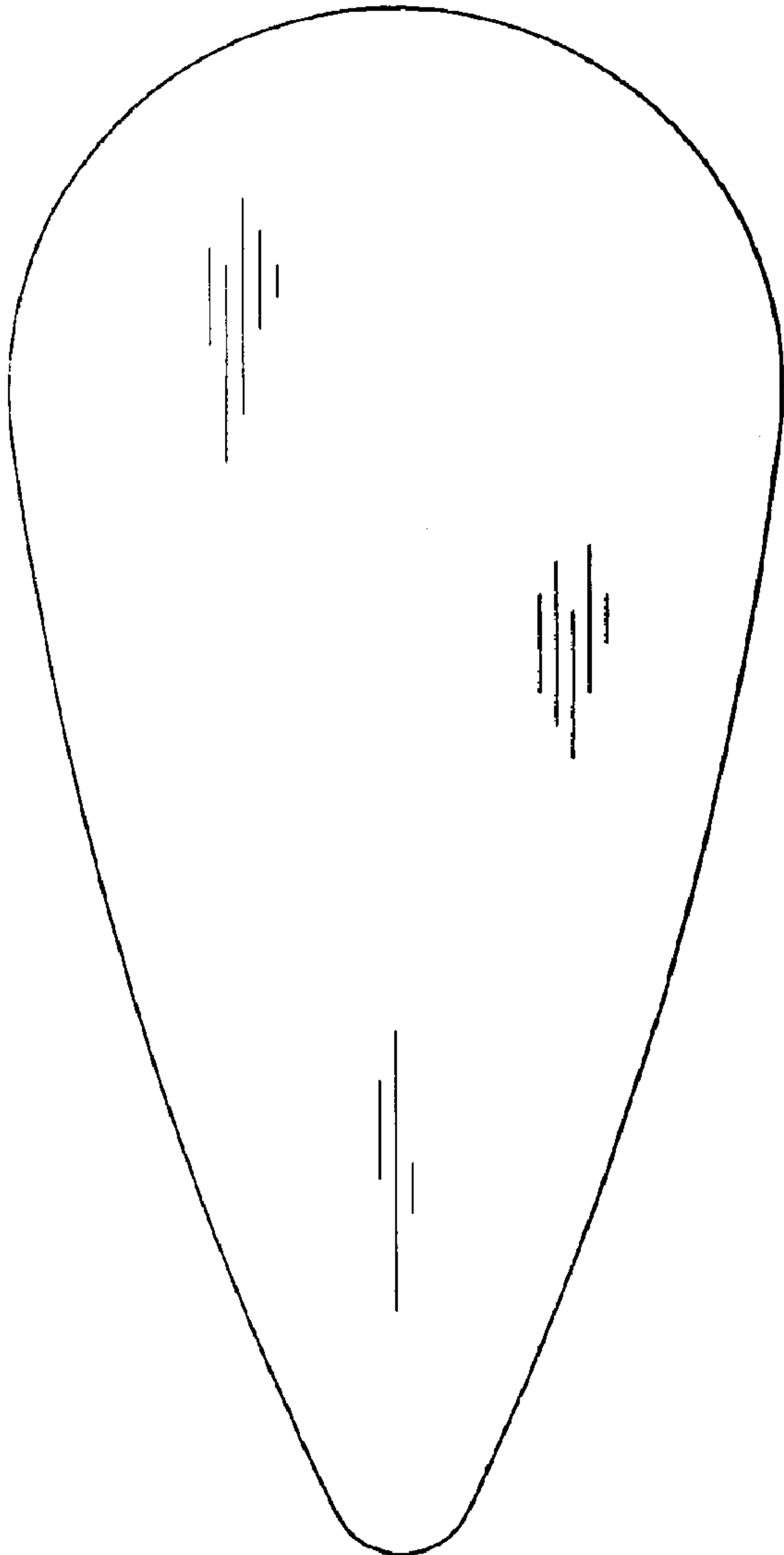
