**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of our holster holder device of FIG. 1;

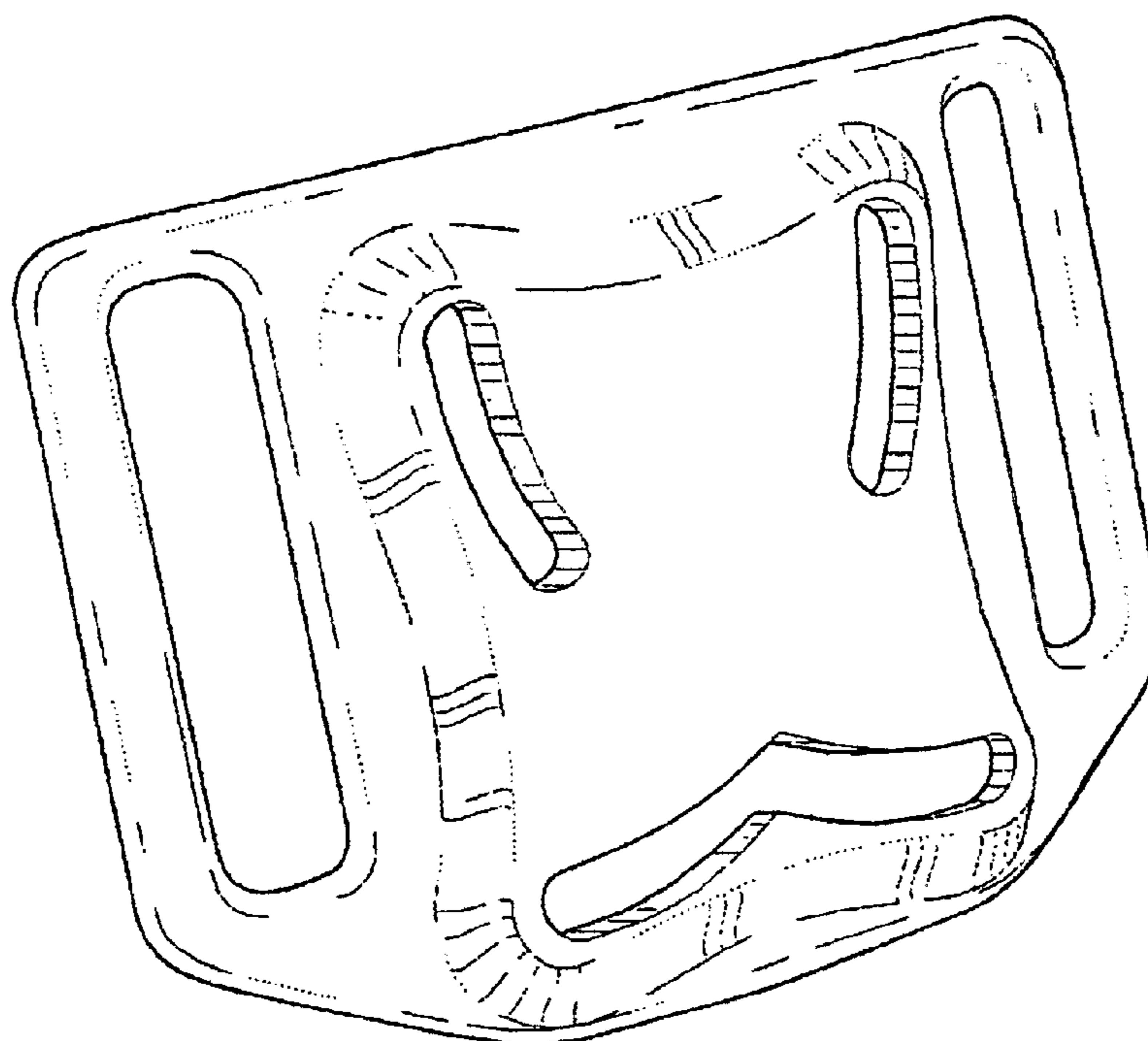
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of our holster holder device of FIG. 1;

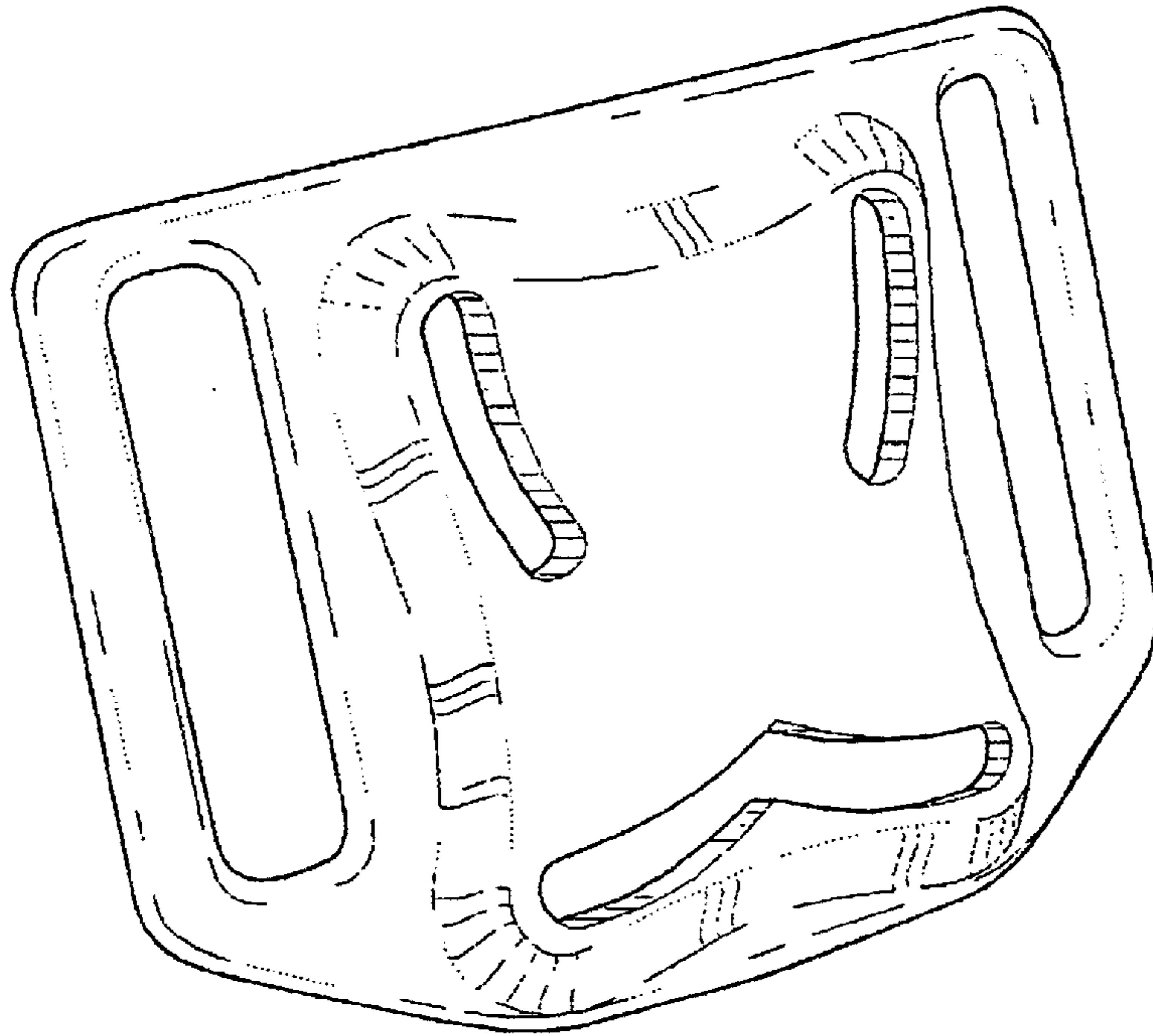
FIG. 7 is a side elevation view of our holster holder device of FIG. 1;

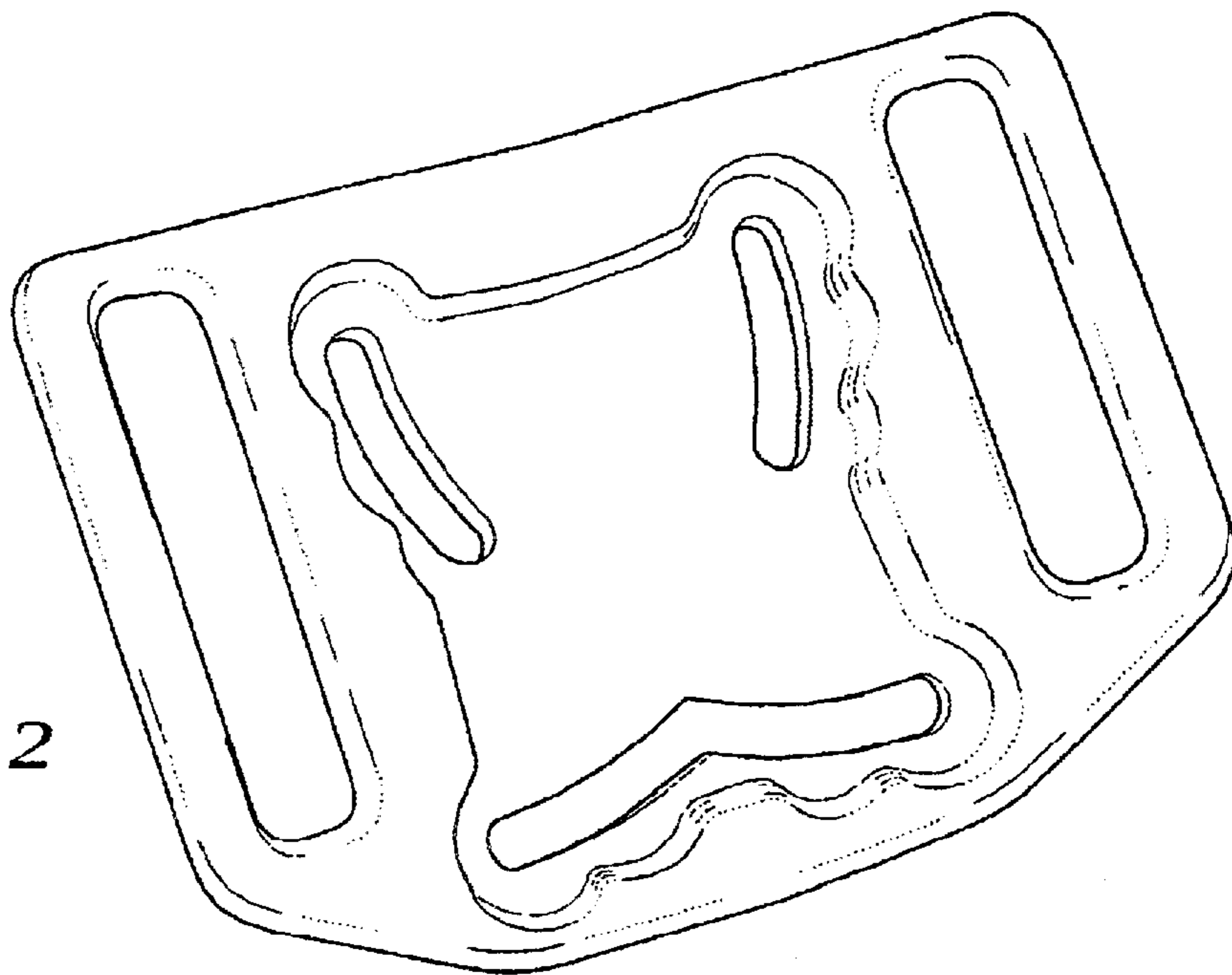

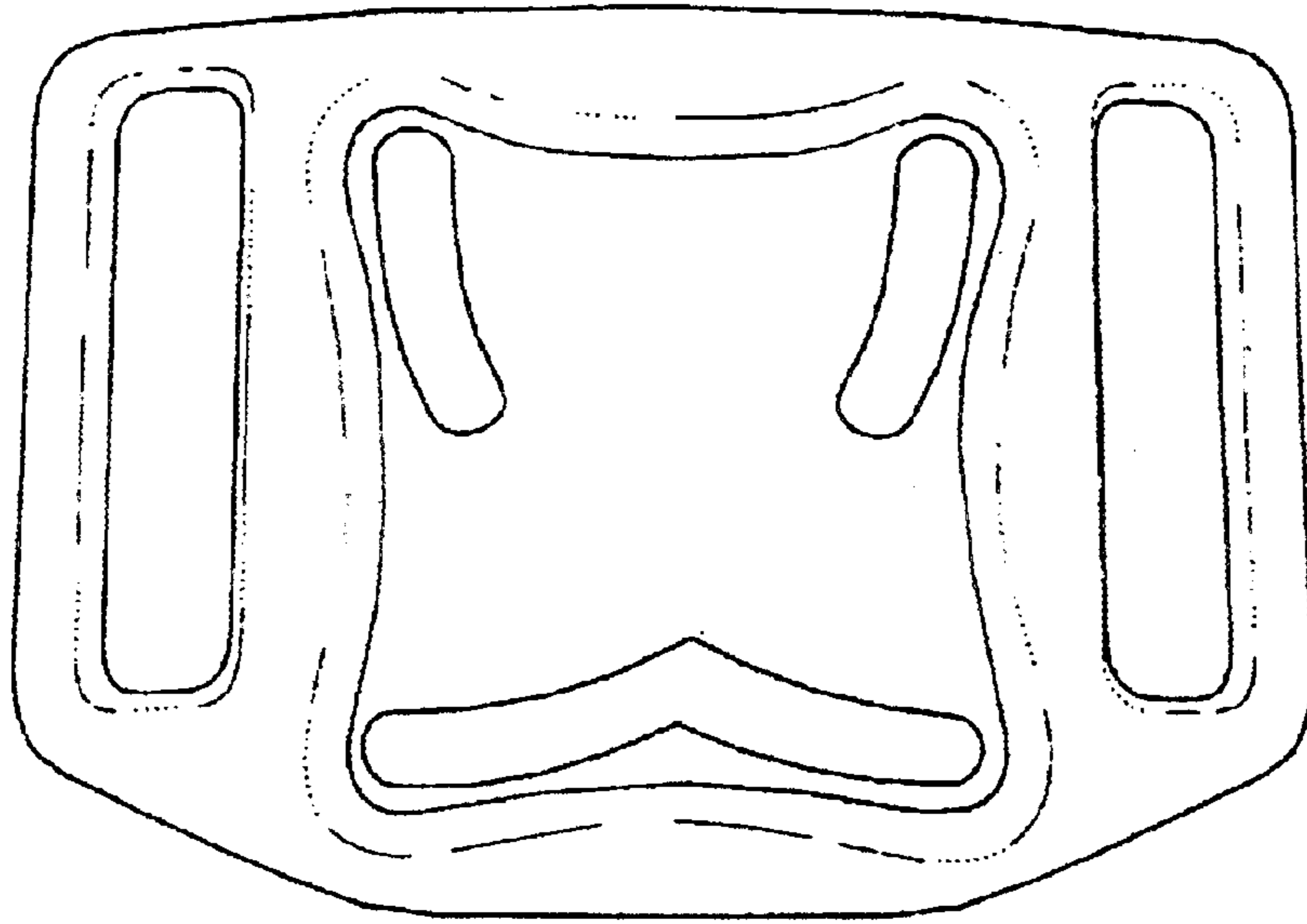




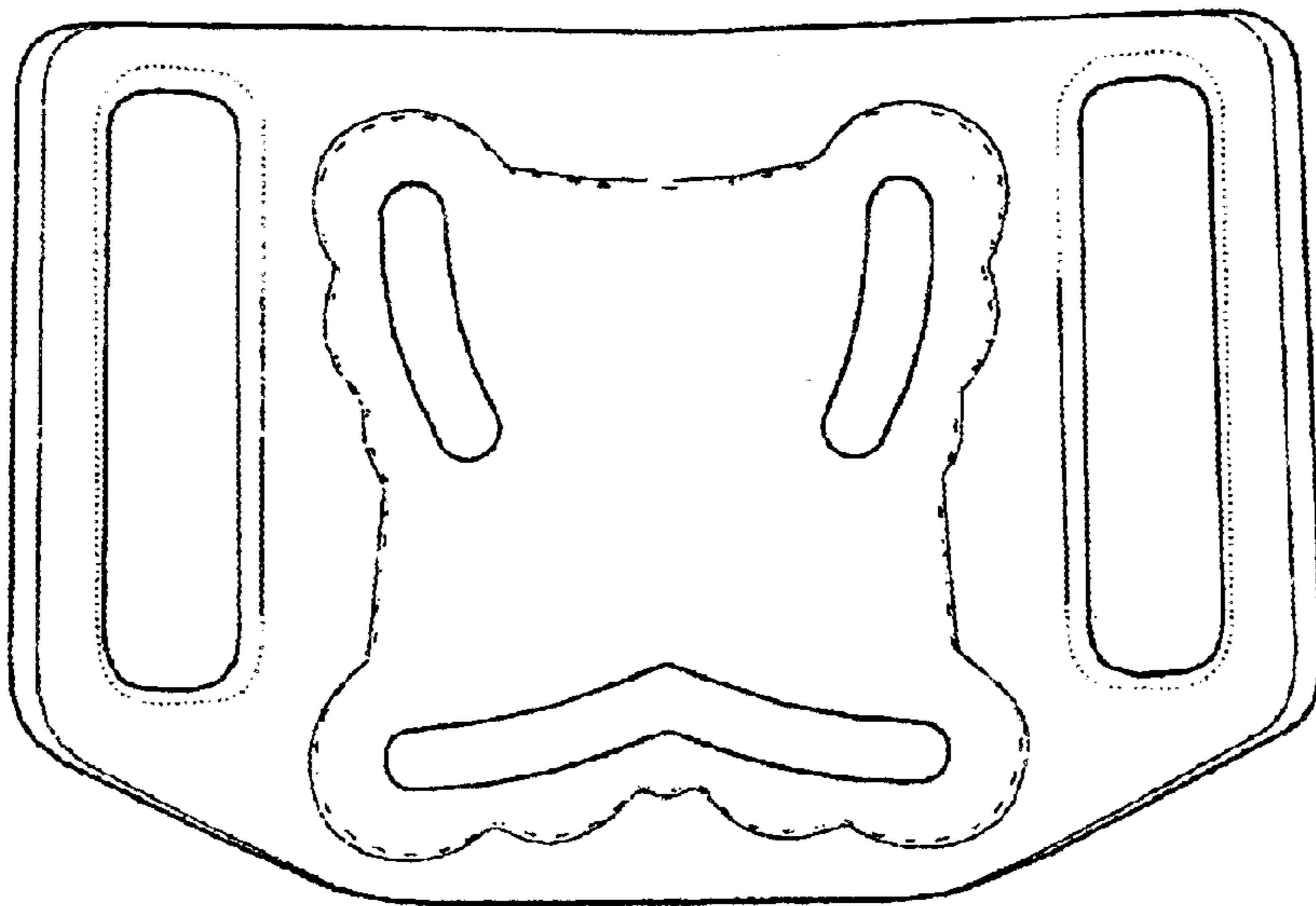

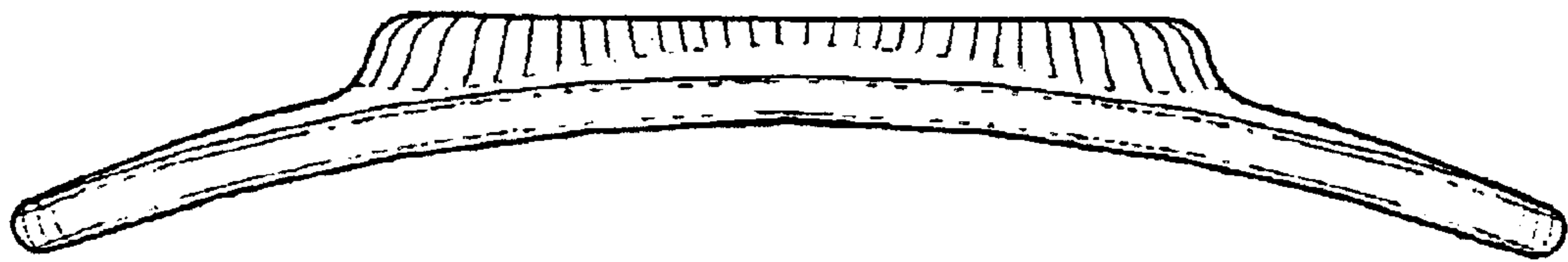

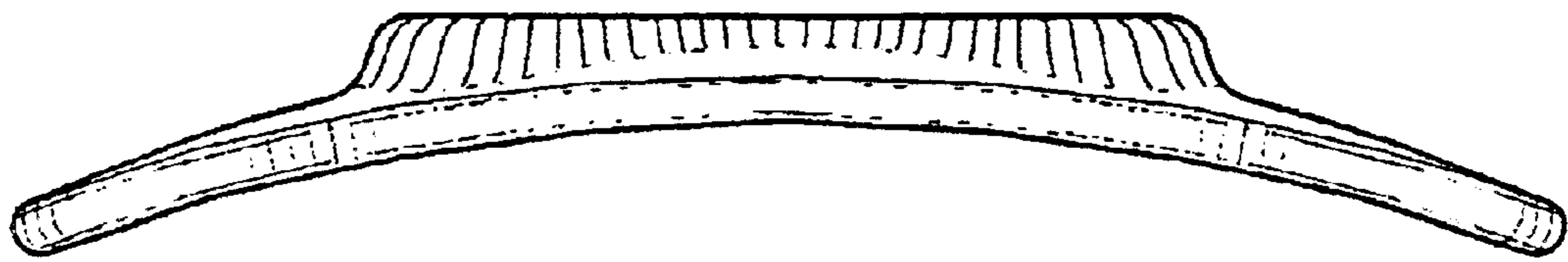

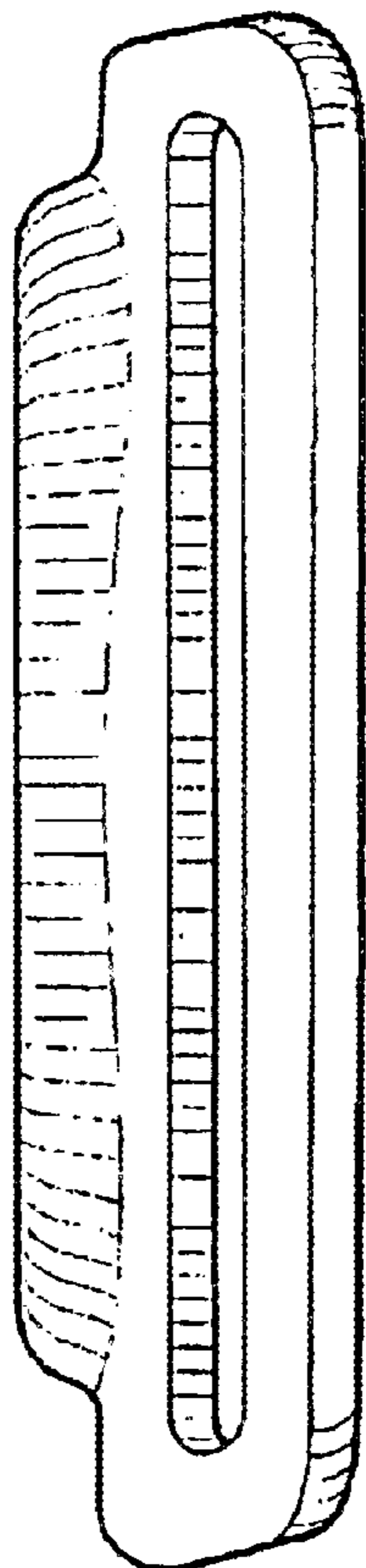

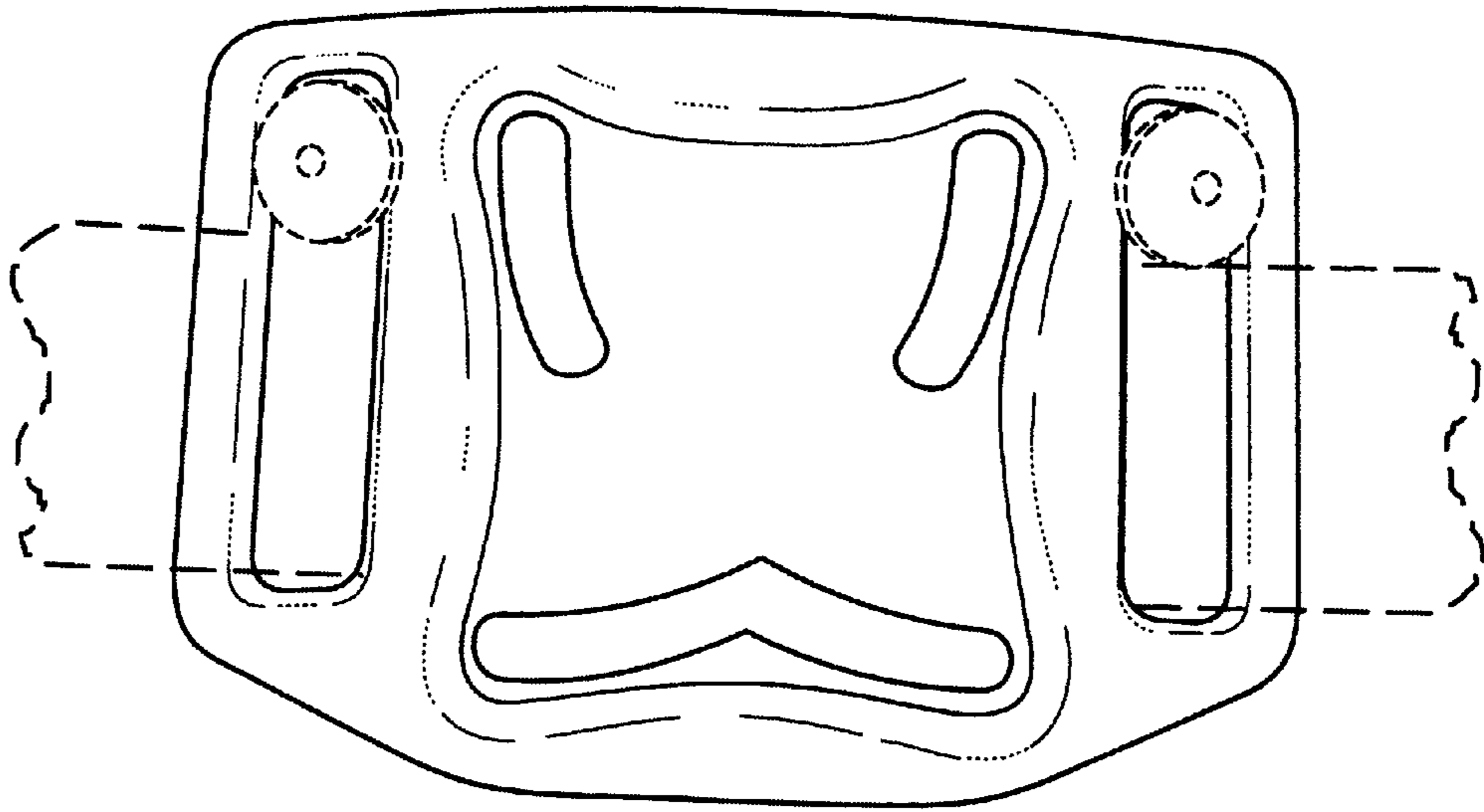

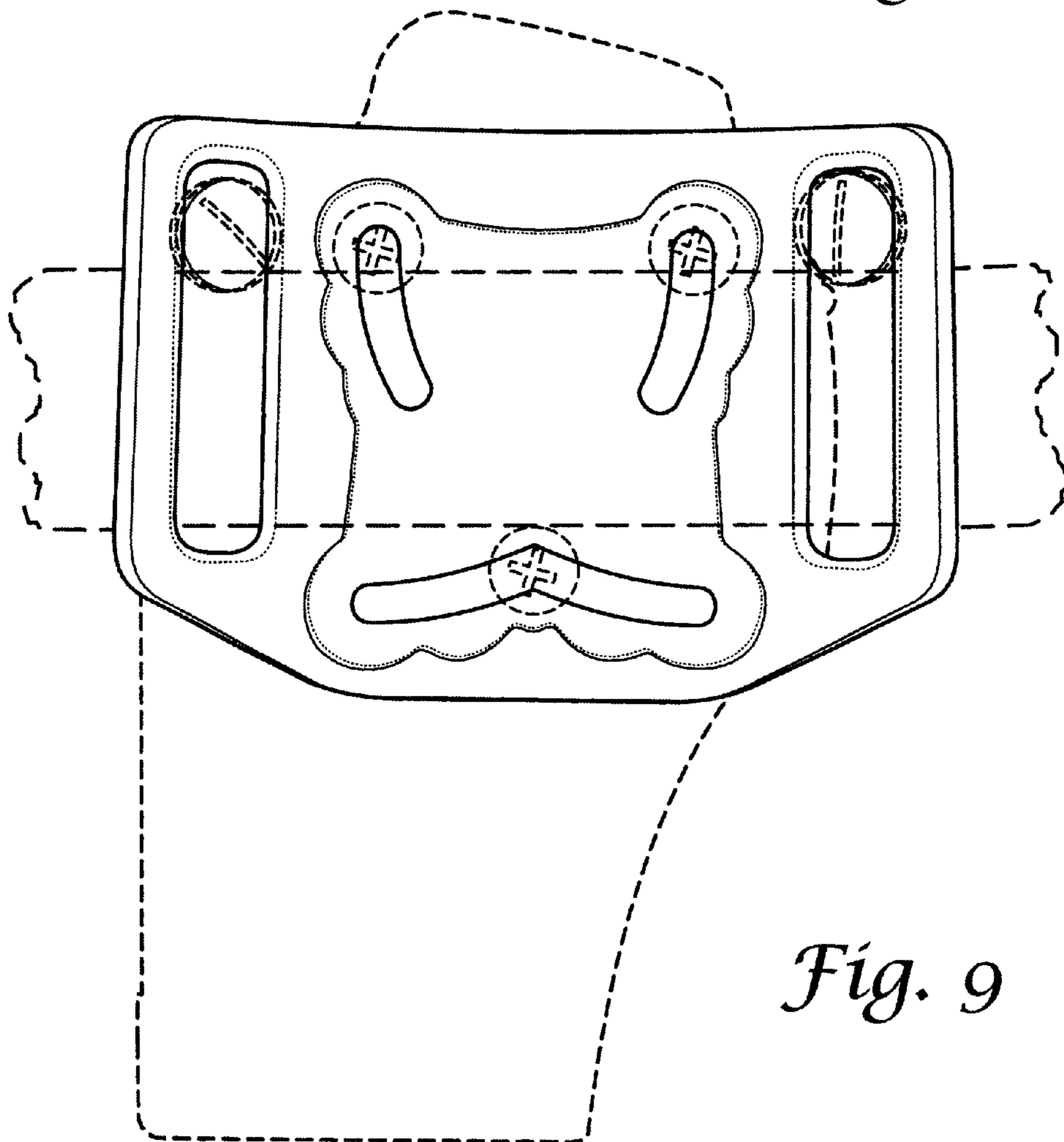
