FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view, the rear elevation view being a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 3 is an enlarged right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view; and,


FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom plan view of my motor mount for a motorcycle frame.


The dotted lines showing a motorcycle in FIG. 1 are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.





