FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom plan view of my motor mount for a motorcycle frame.

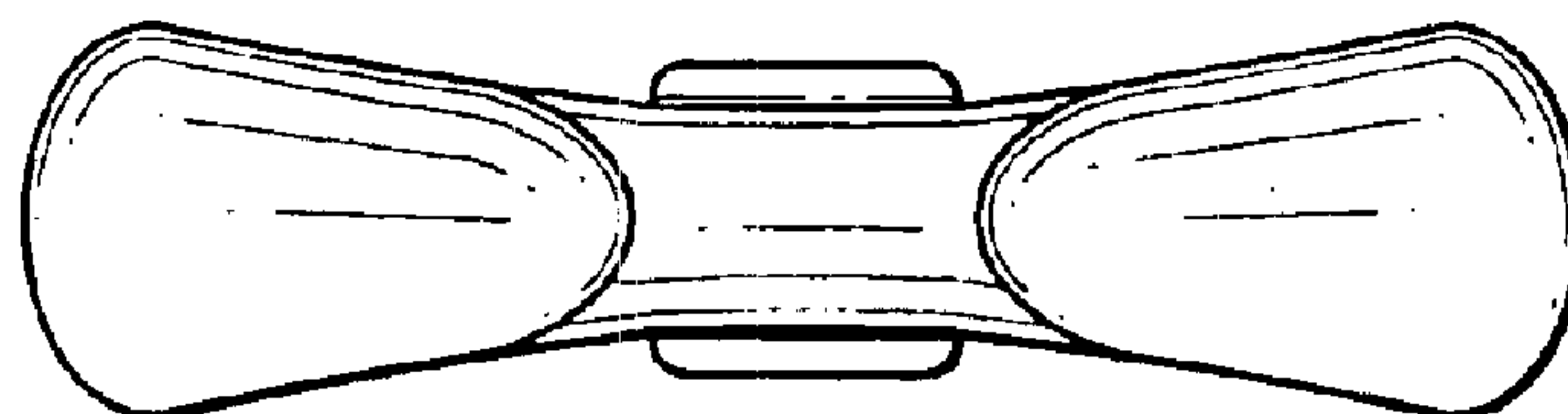
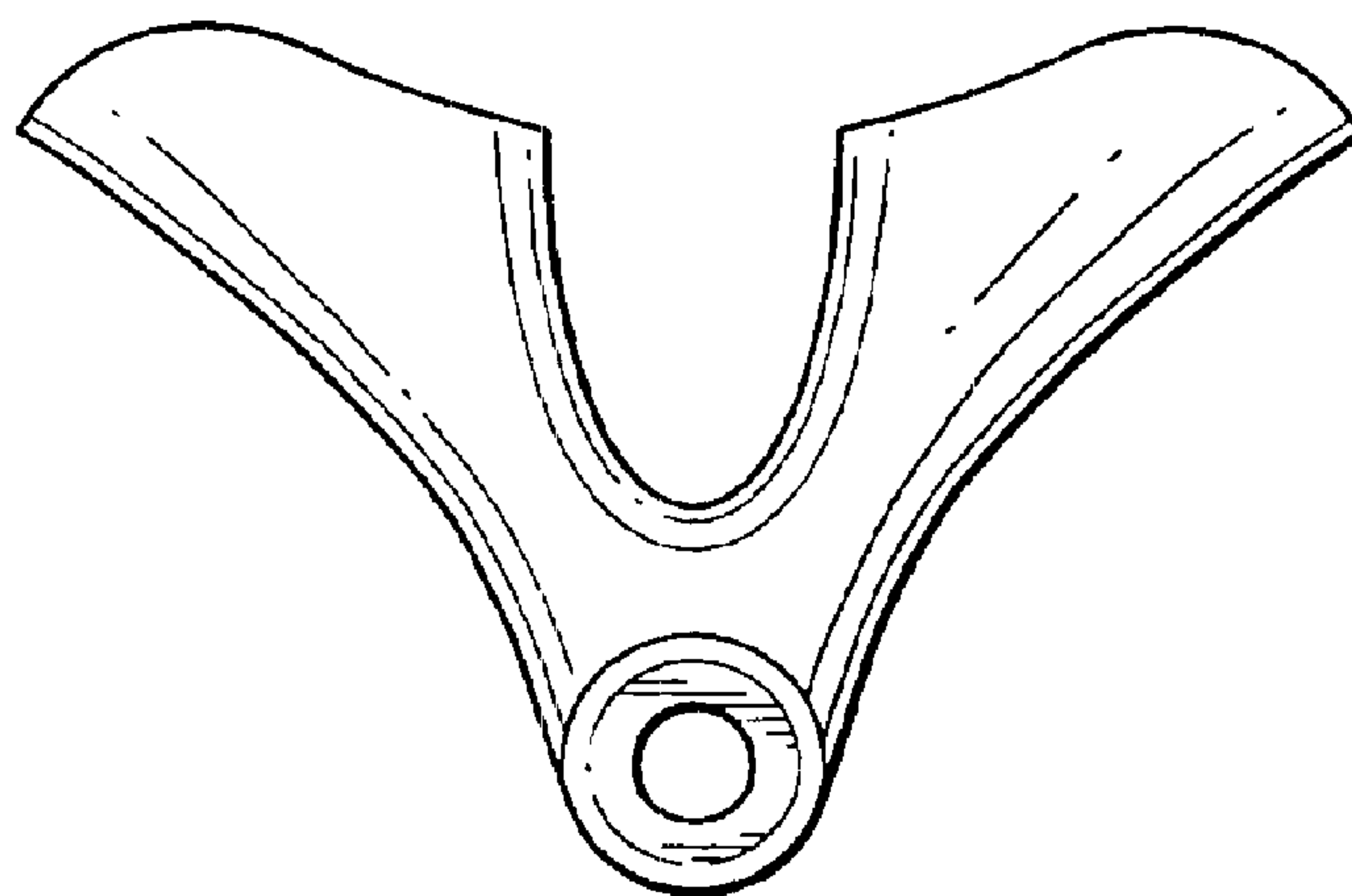

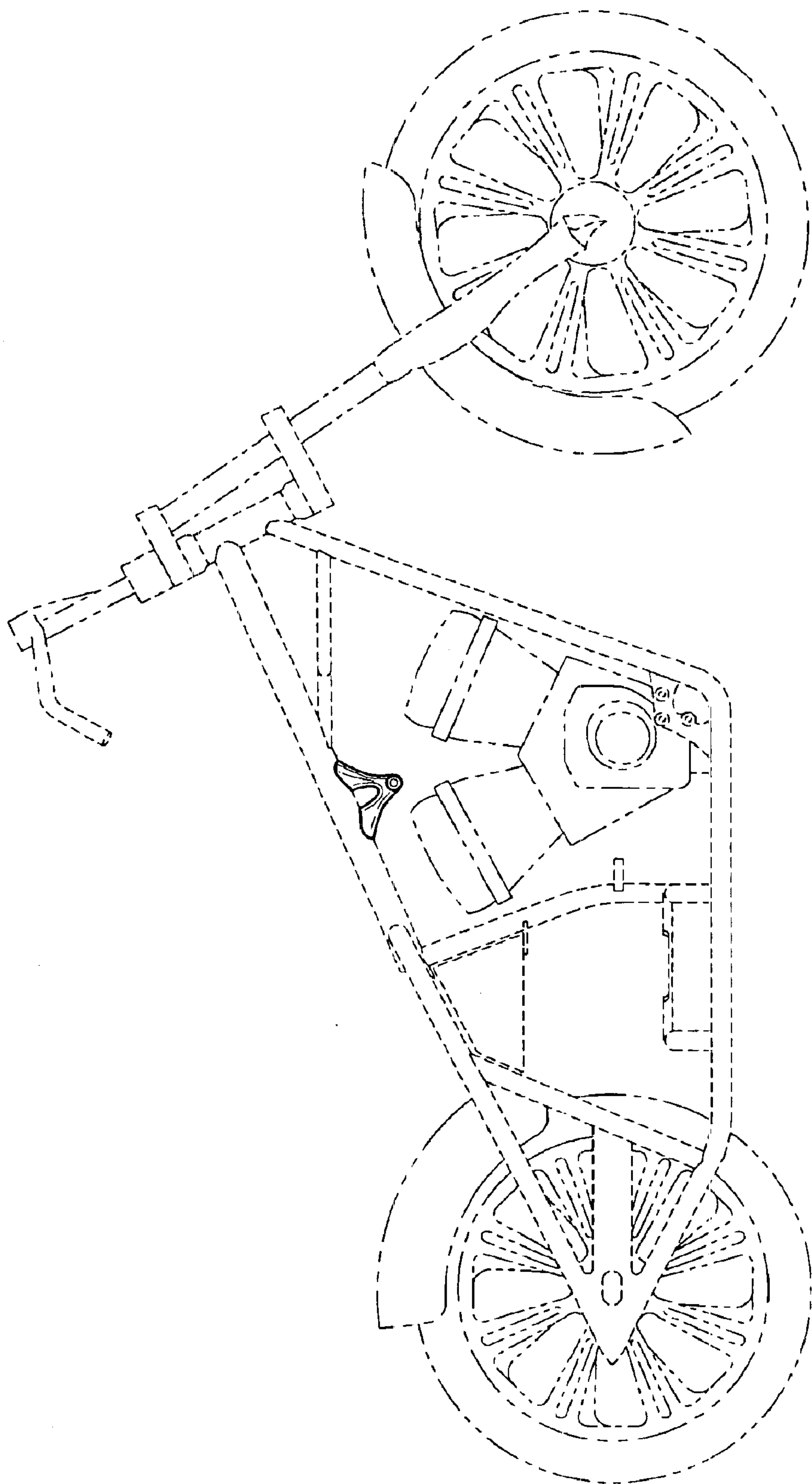

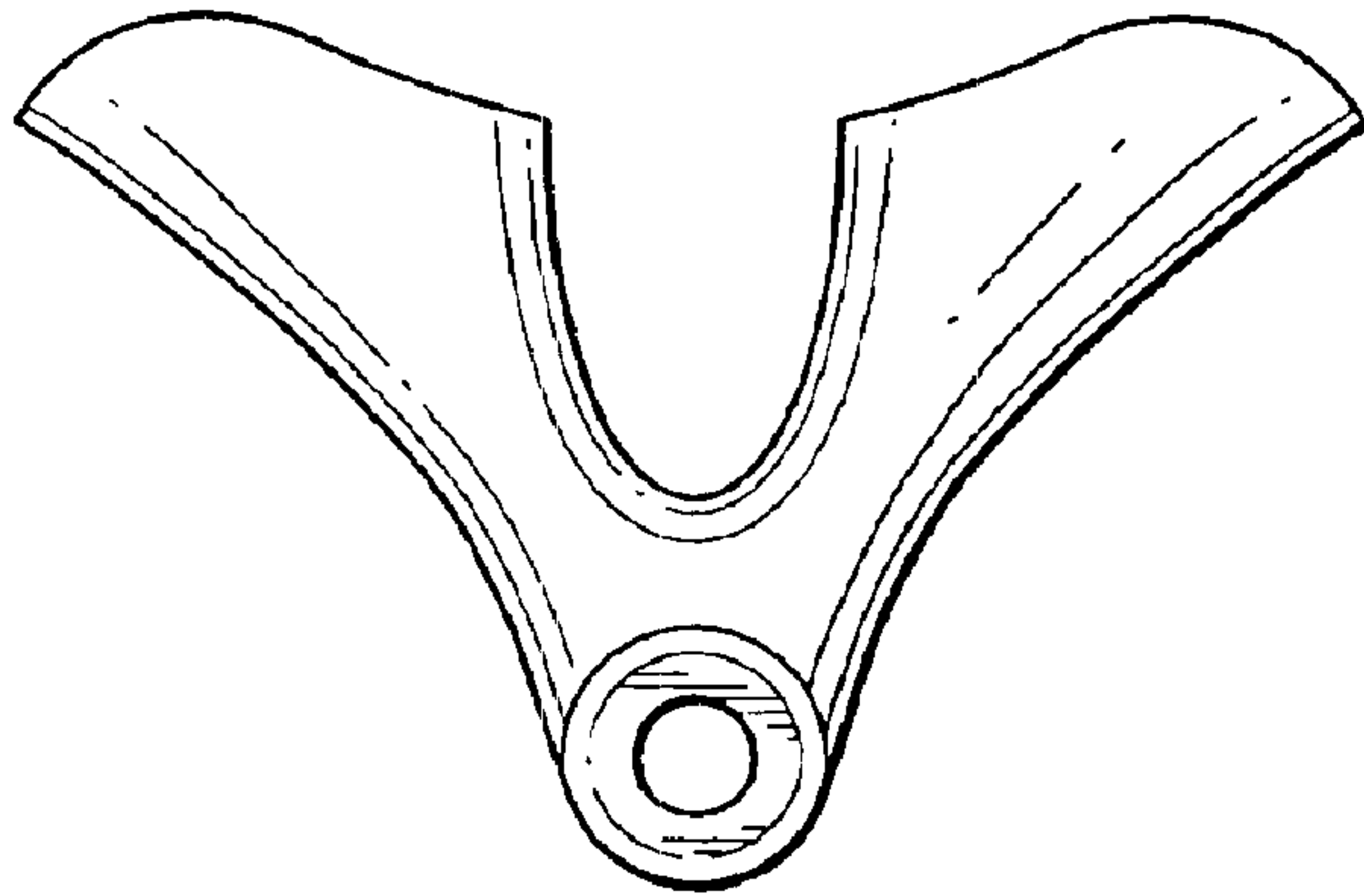

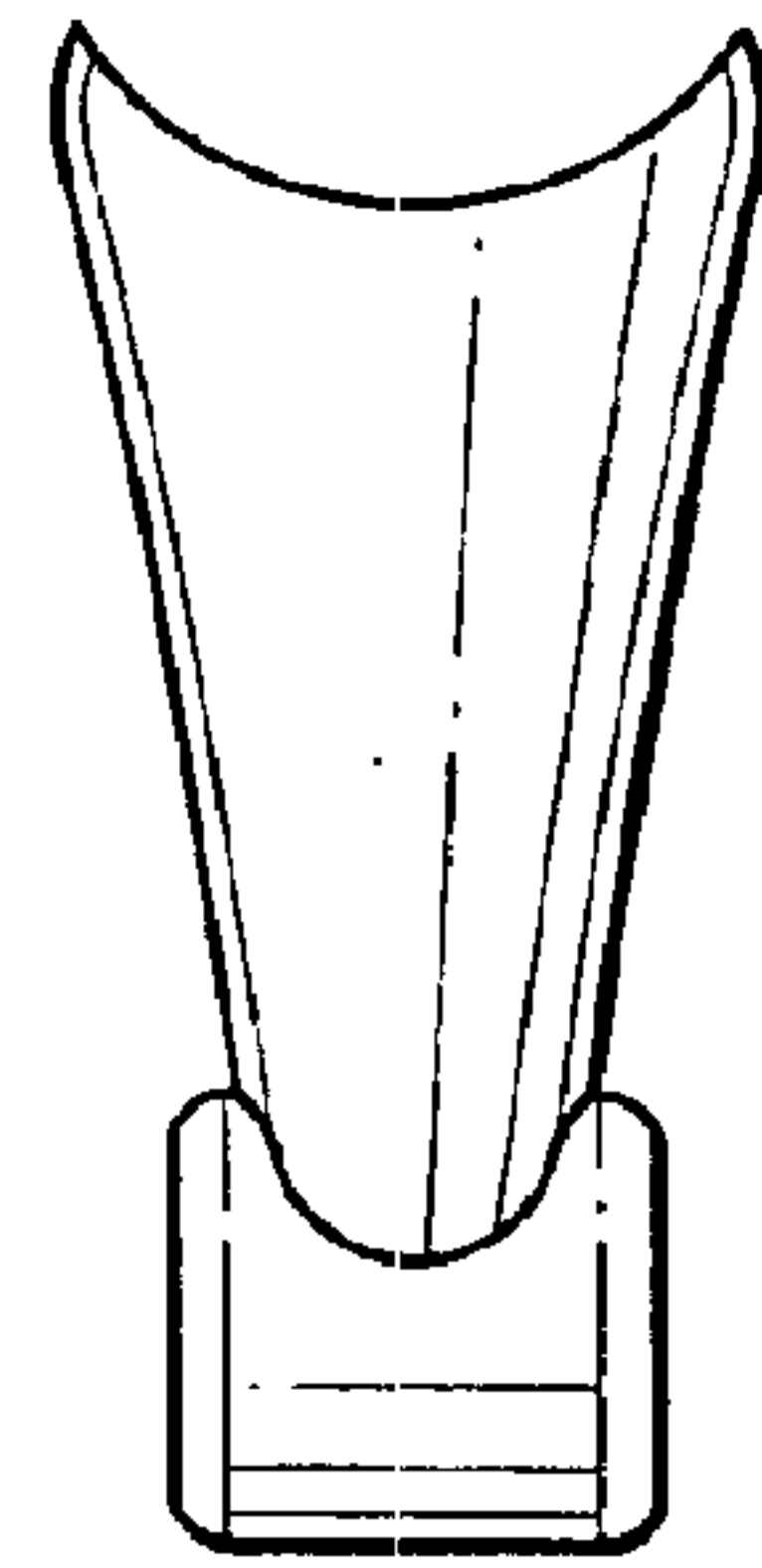

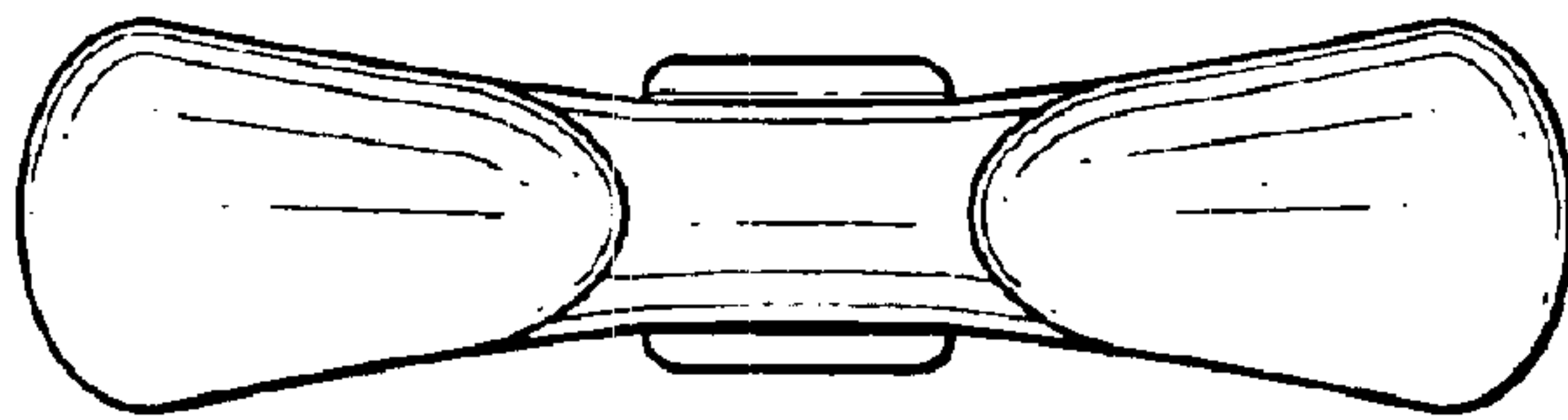

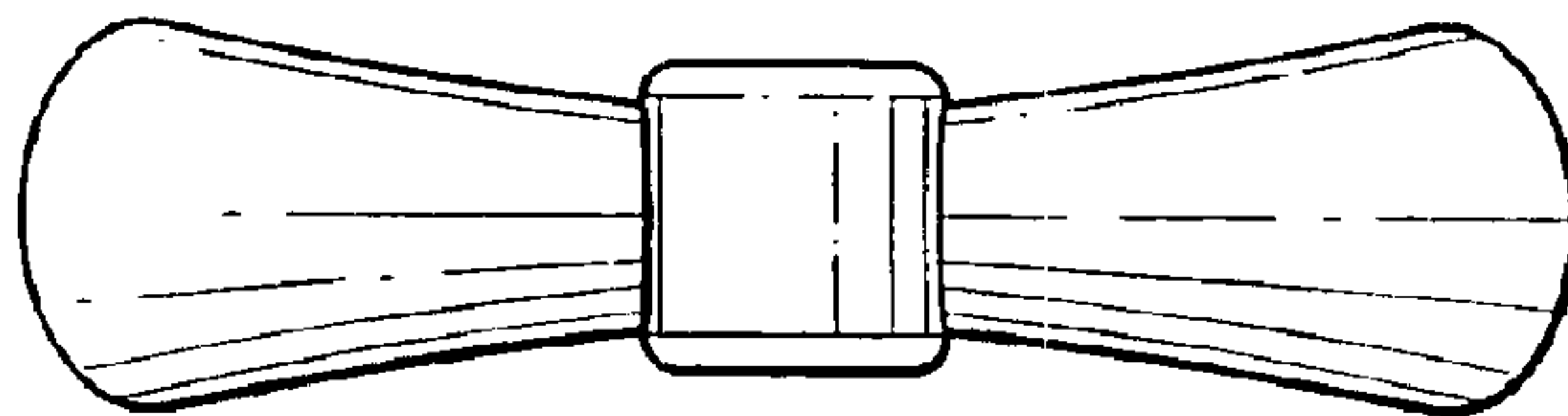
