I claim the ornamental design for a tic-tac-toe game, as shown and described.

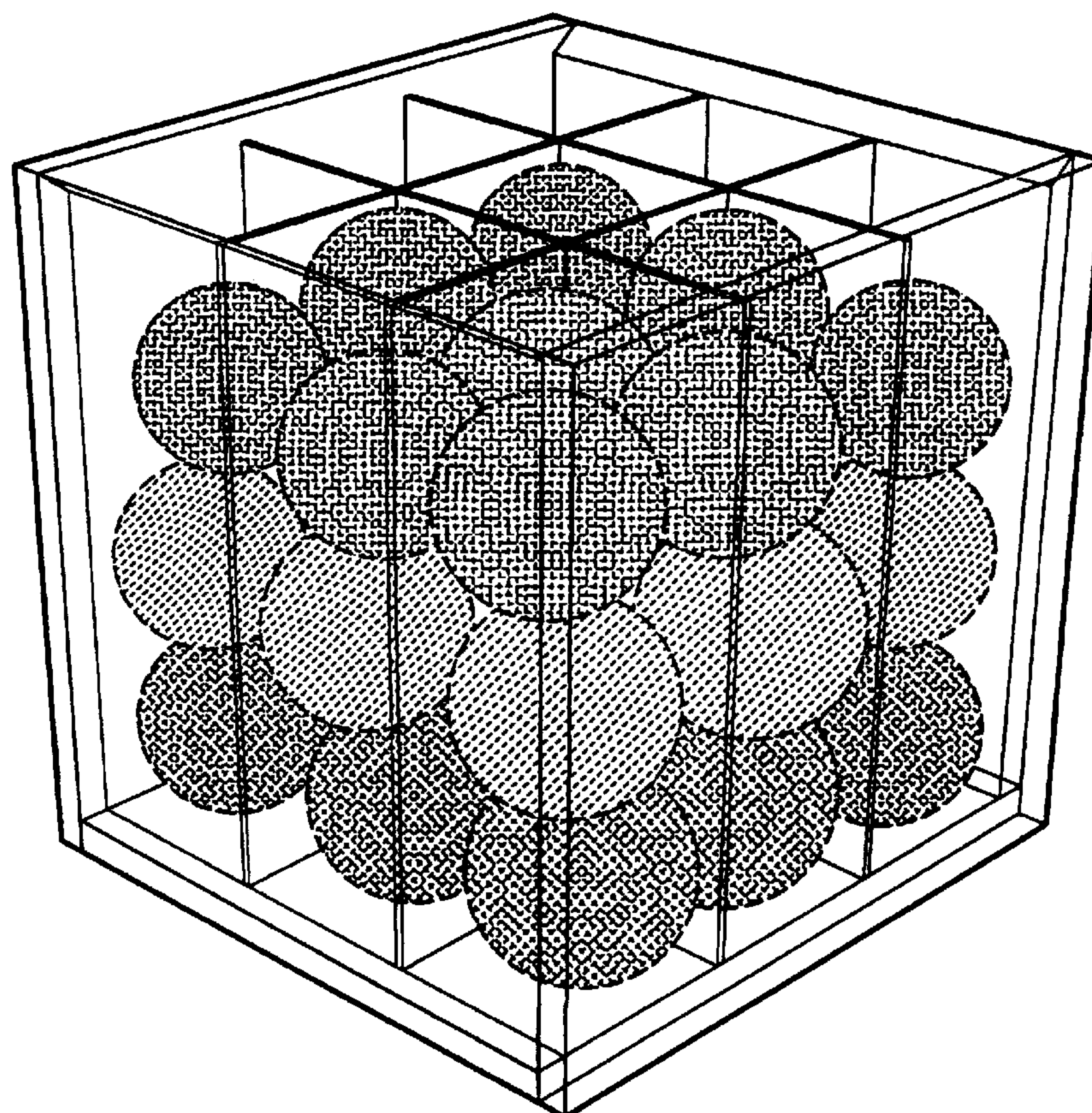
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tic-tac-toe game showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one of the sides of the game of FIG. 1, the other four sides being identical; and, FIG. 3 is a top perspective view of the game of FIGS. 1 and 2, viewed from a location slightly offset from the plane of the side of the game shown at the right of FIG. 3.

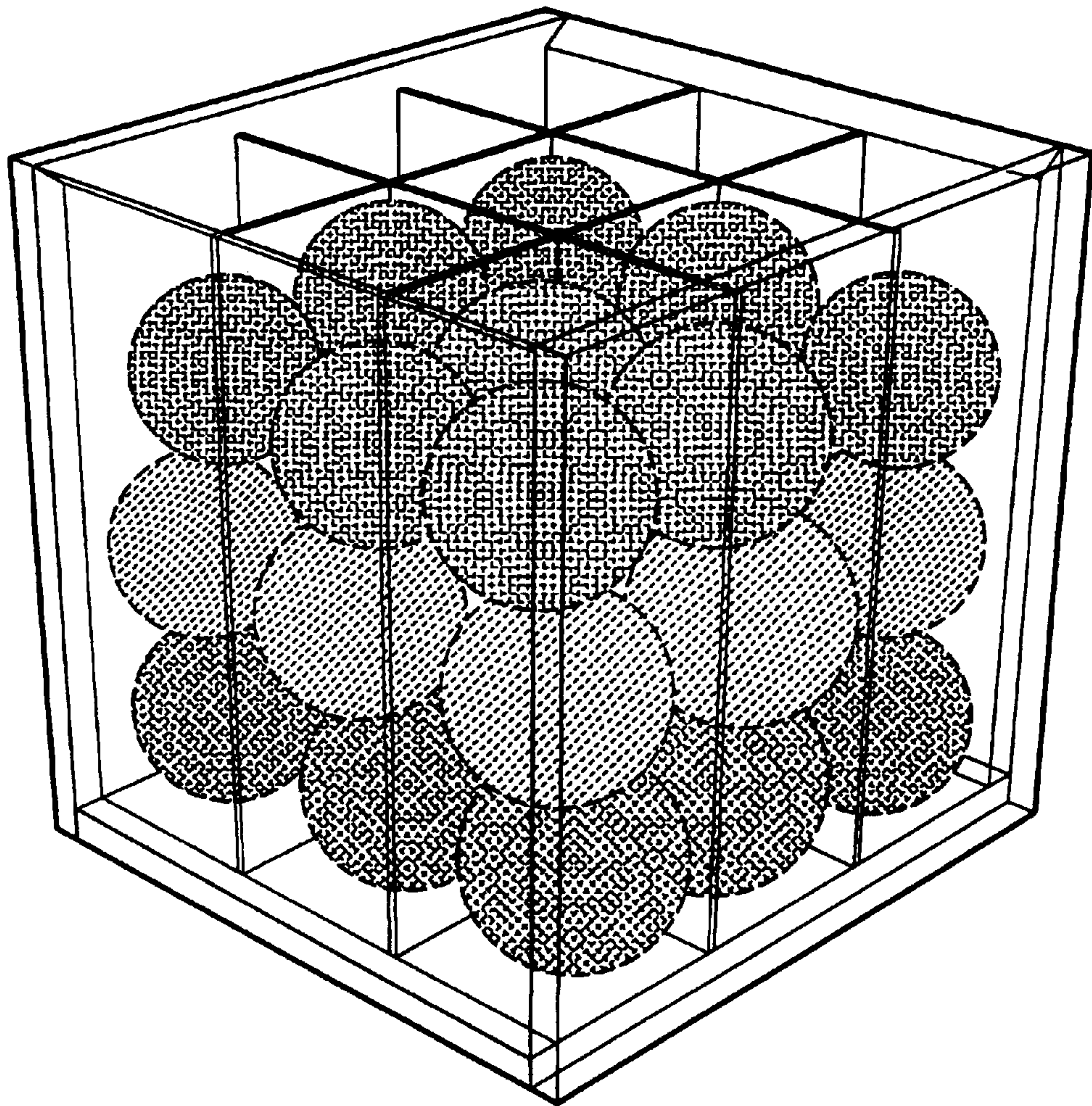

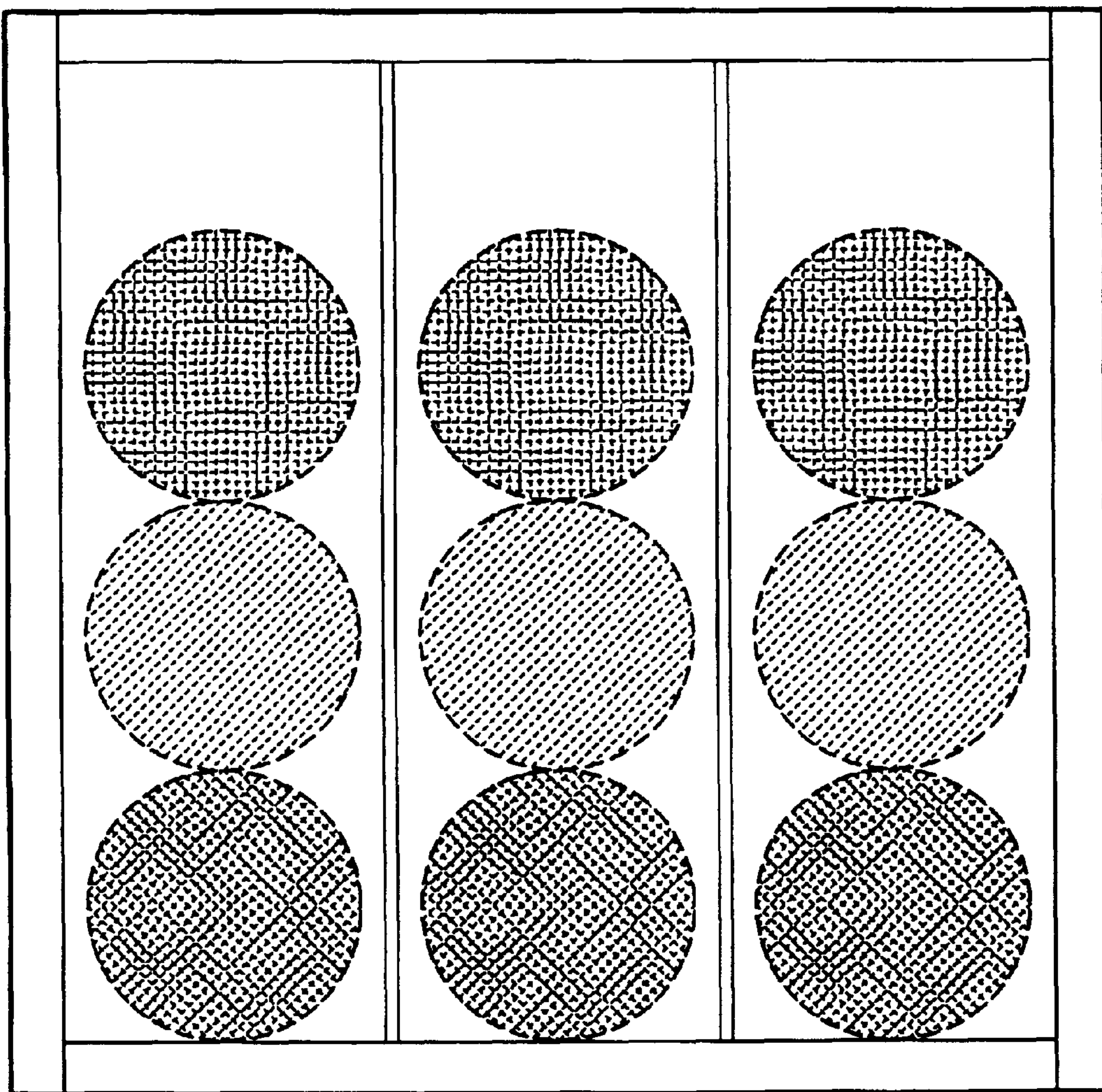

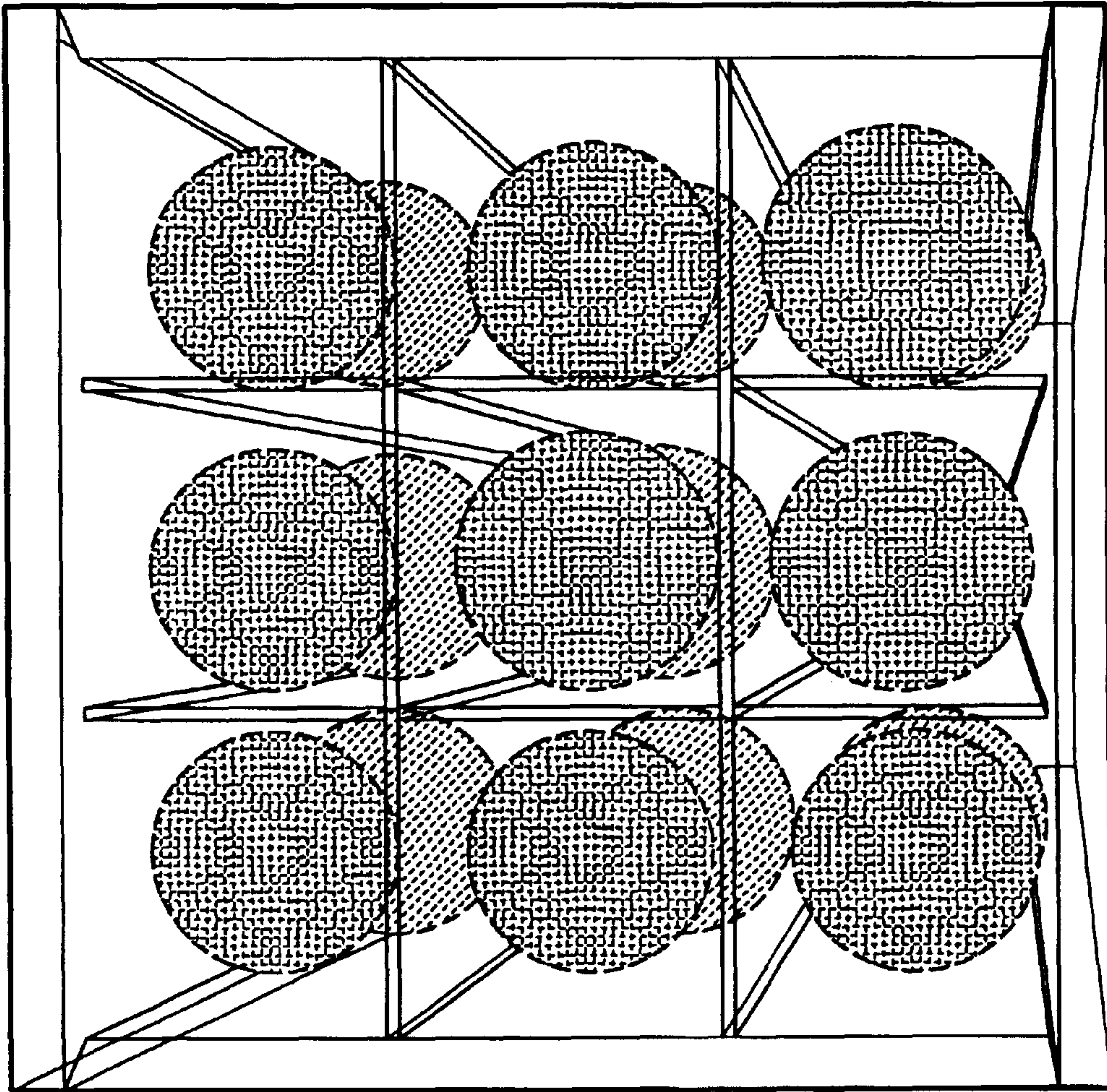
