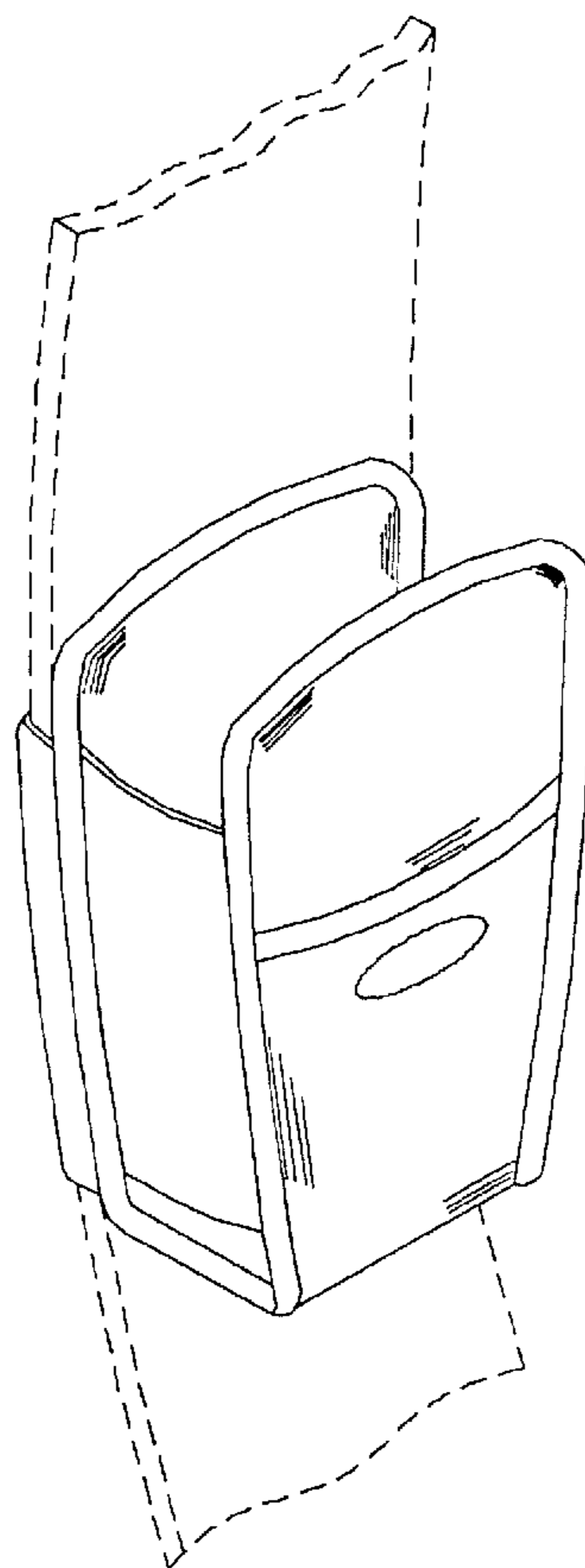
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the cell phone holder for a seat belt strap in accordance with my design;

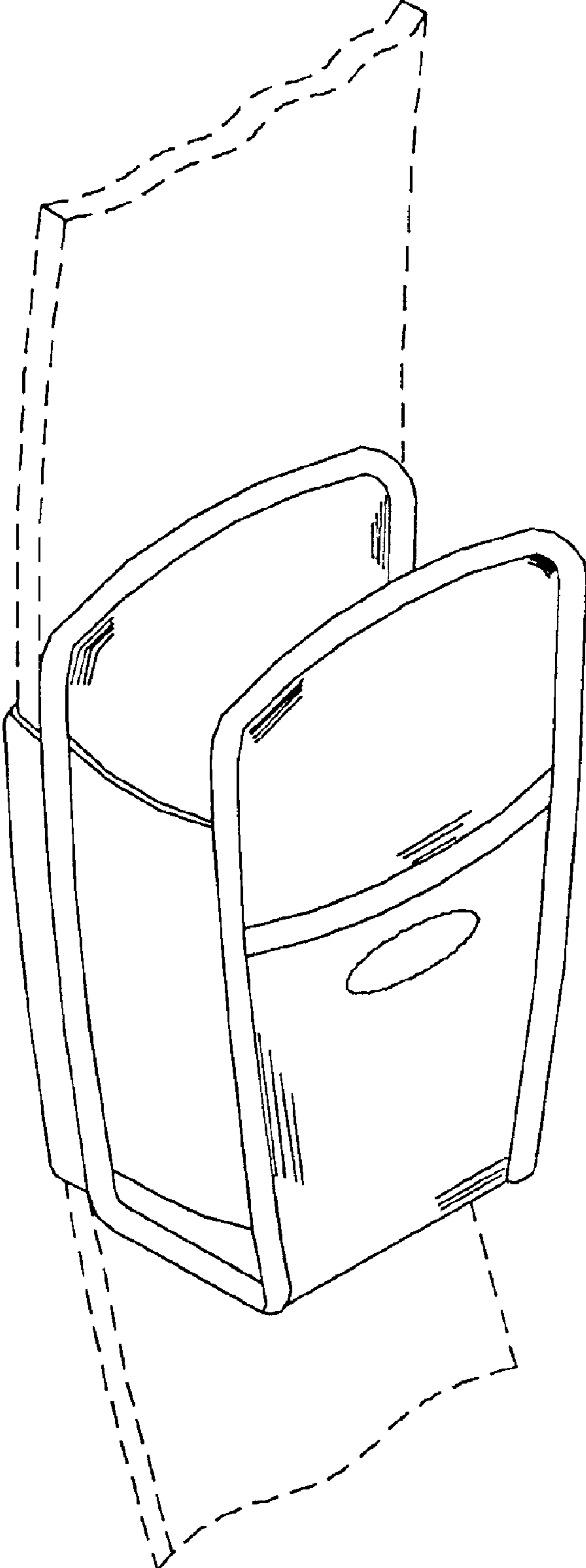
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the cell phone holder for a seat belt strap in accordance with my design; and,

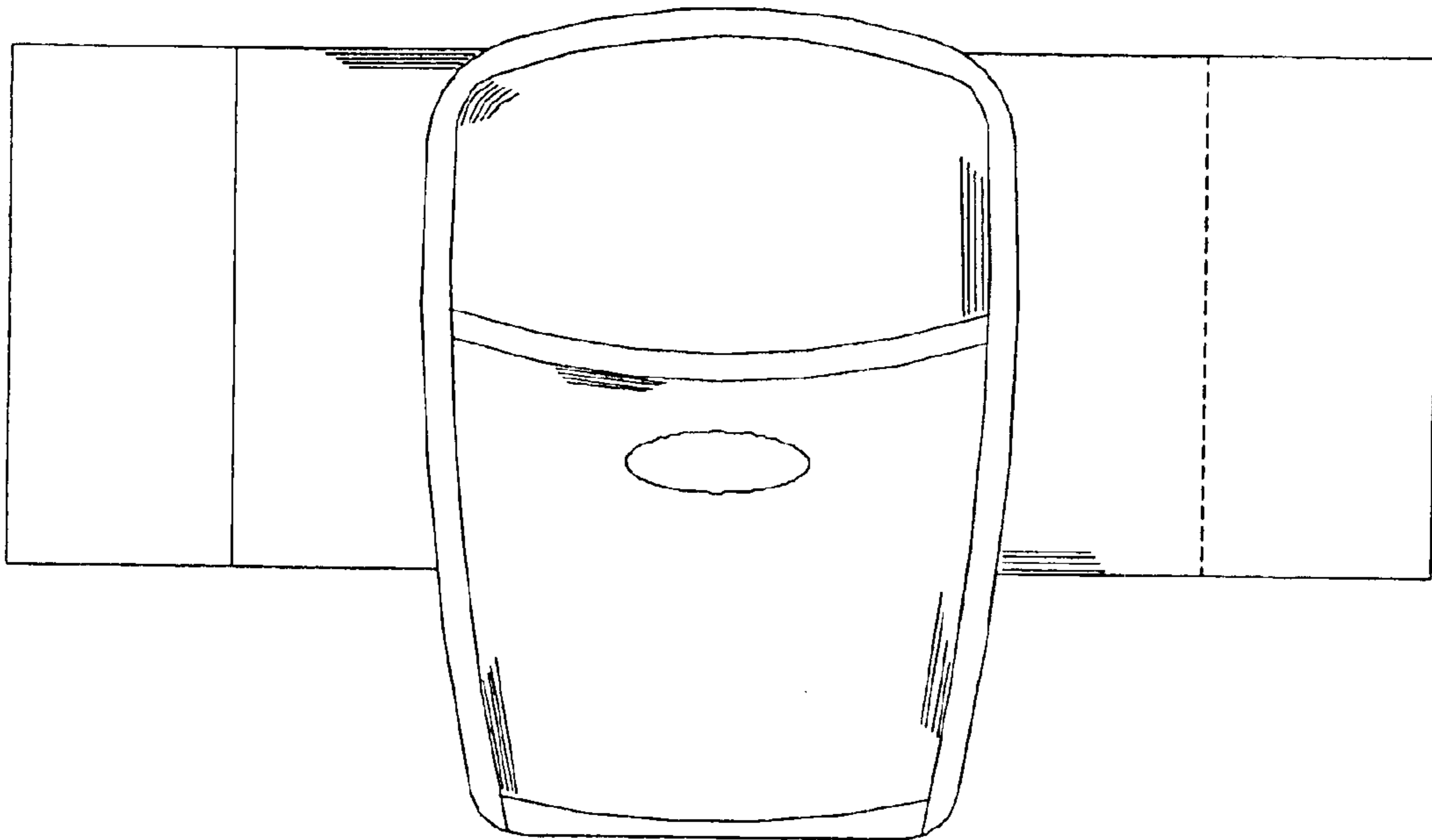

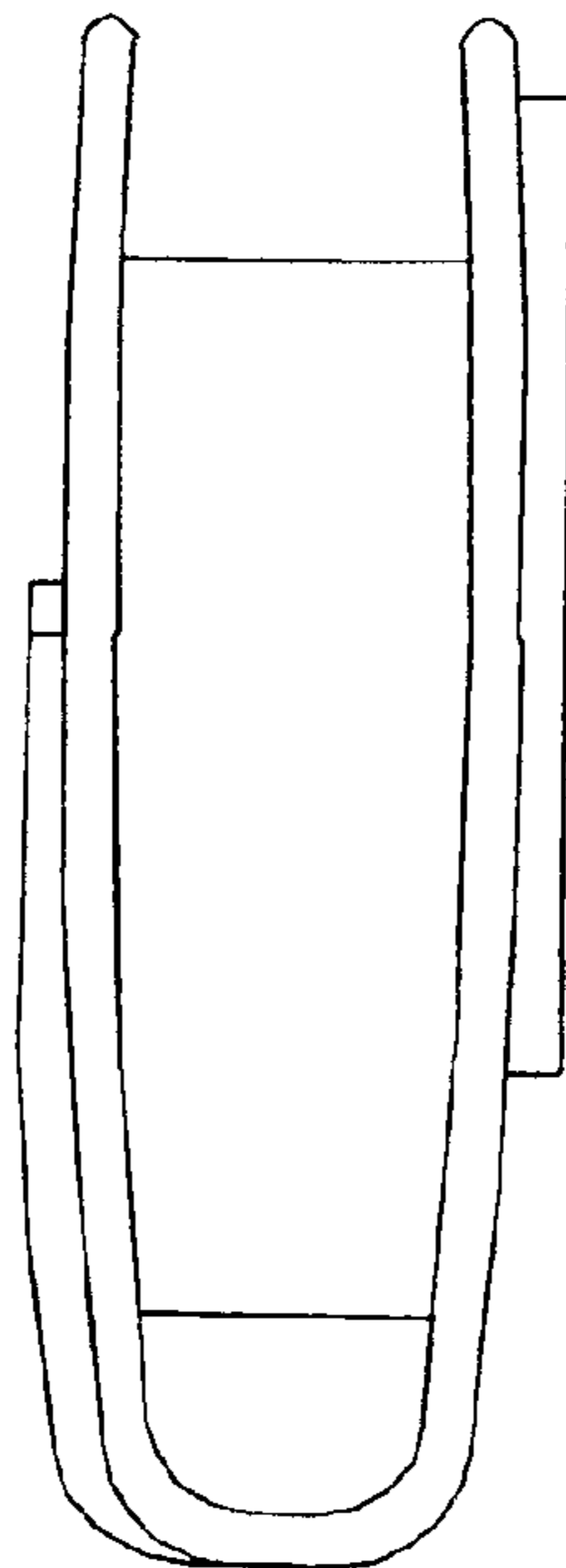

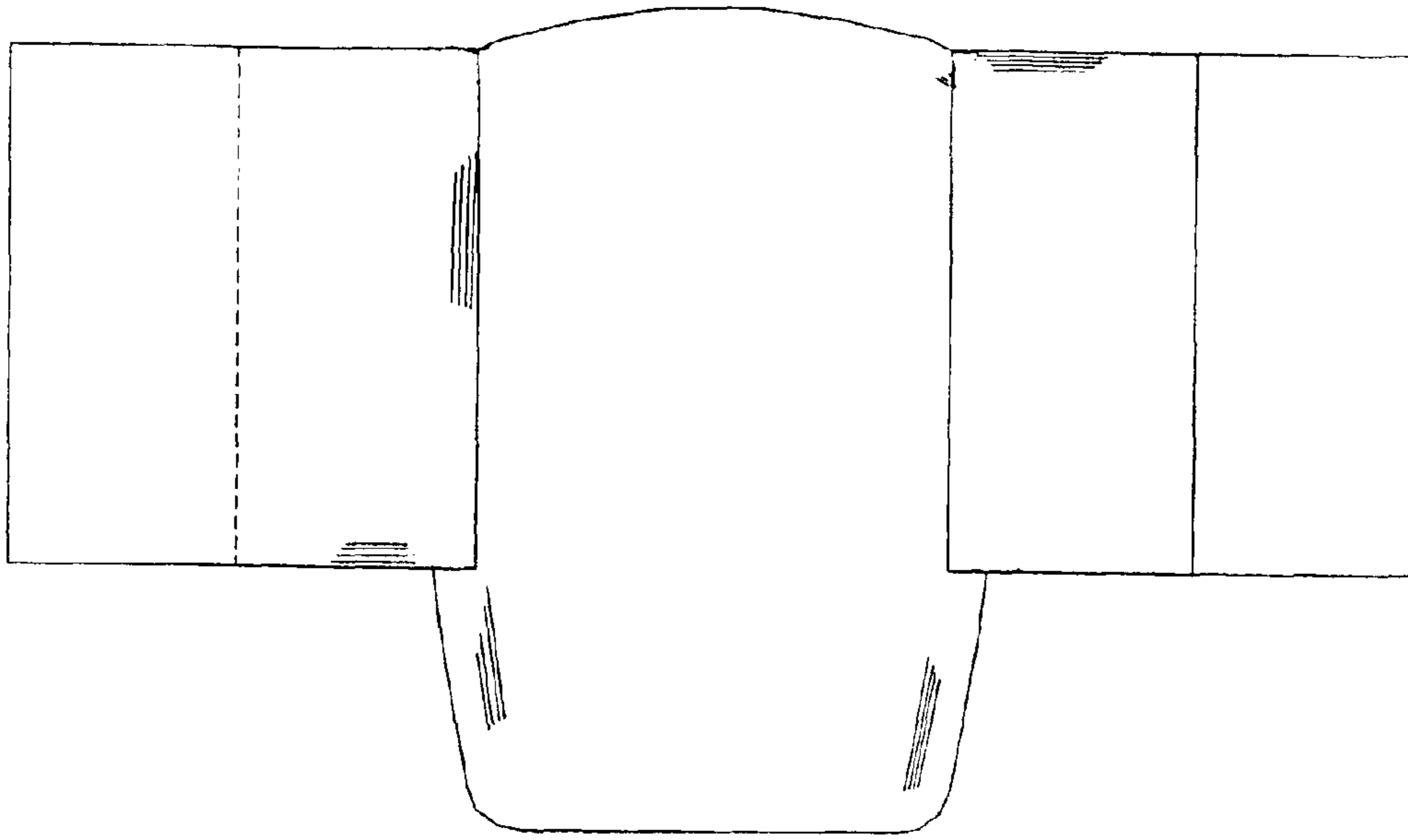

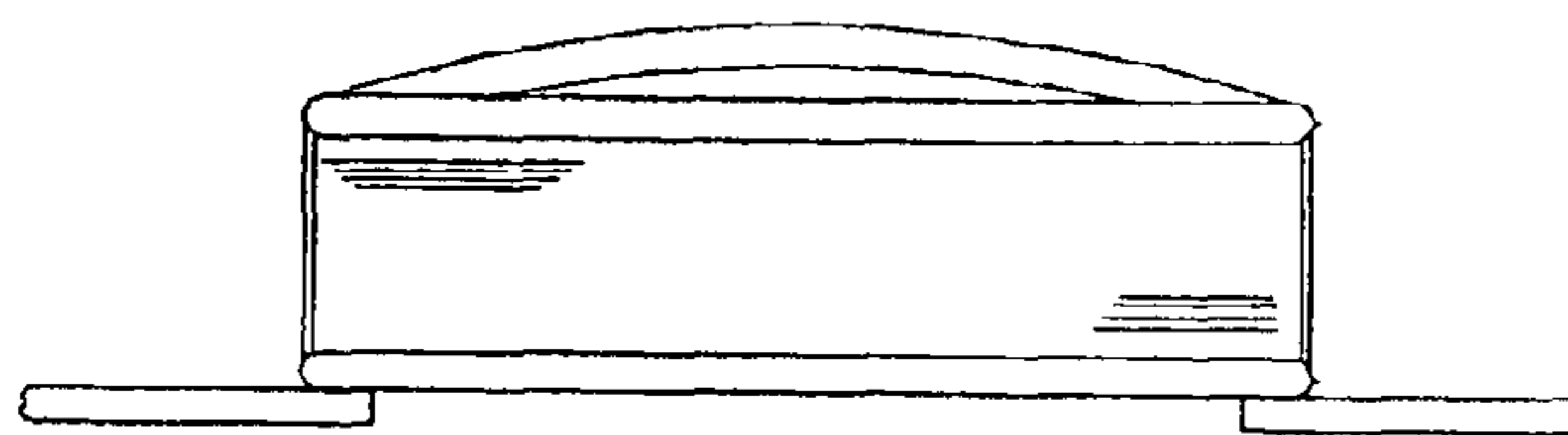

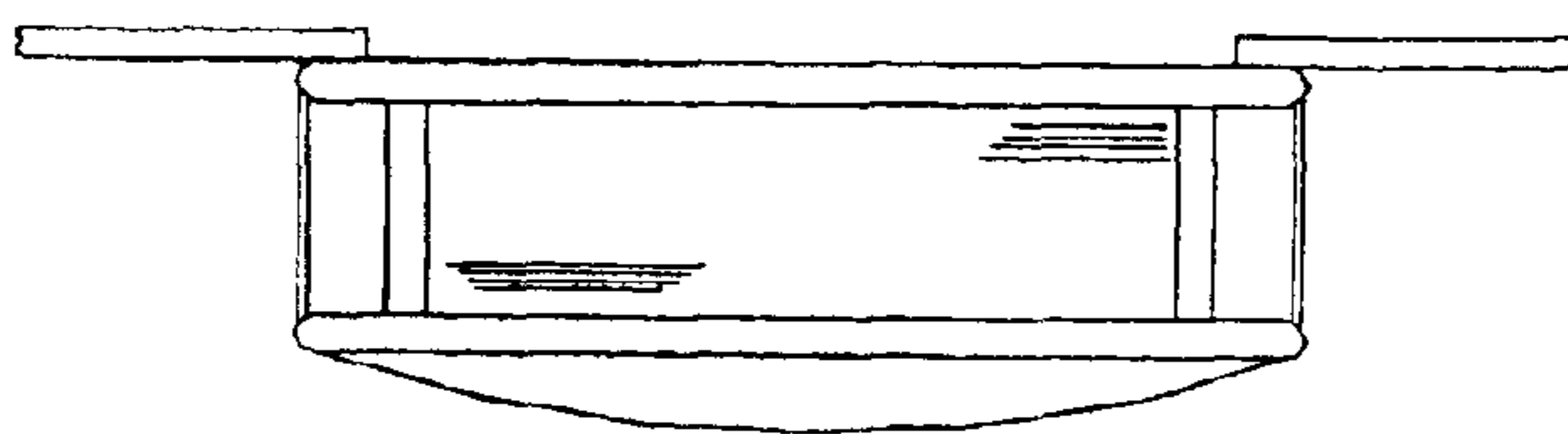
