view thereof;

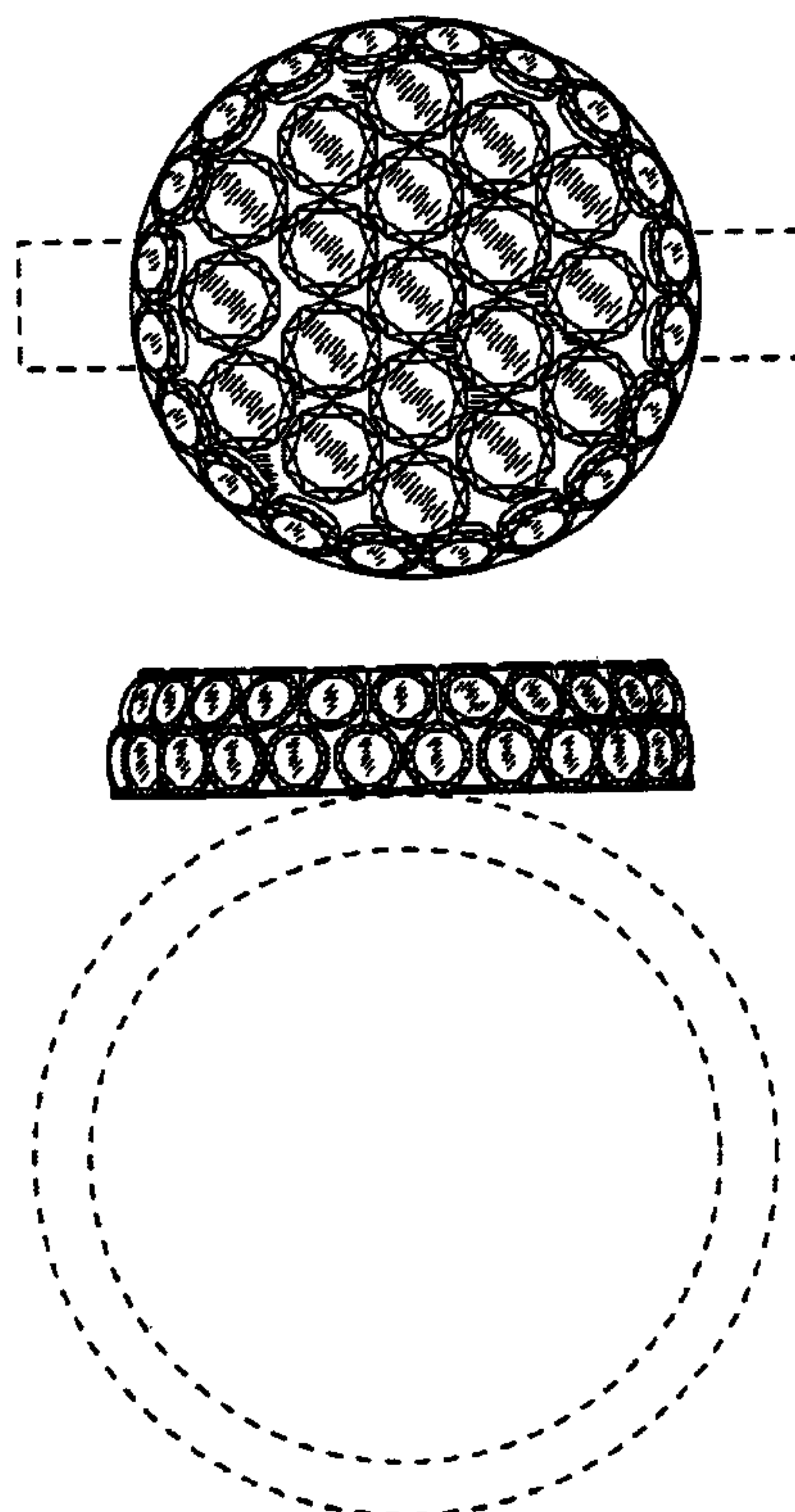
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of my new

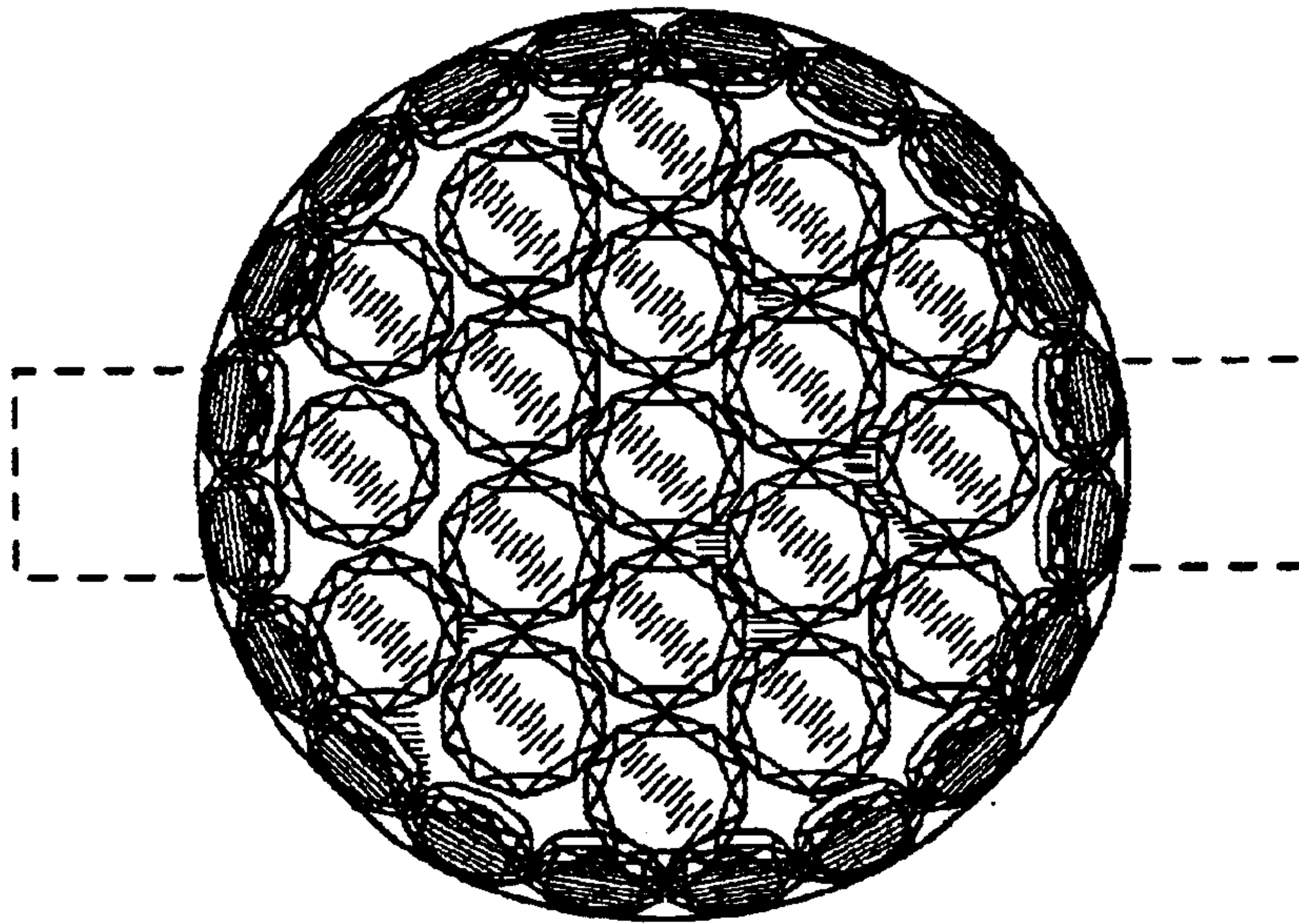

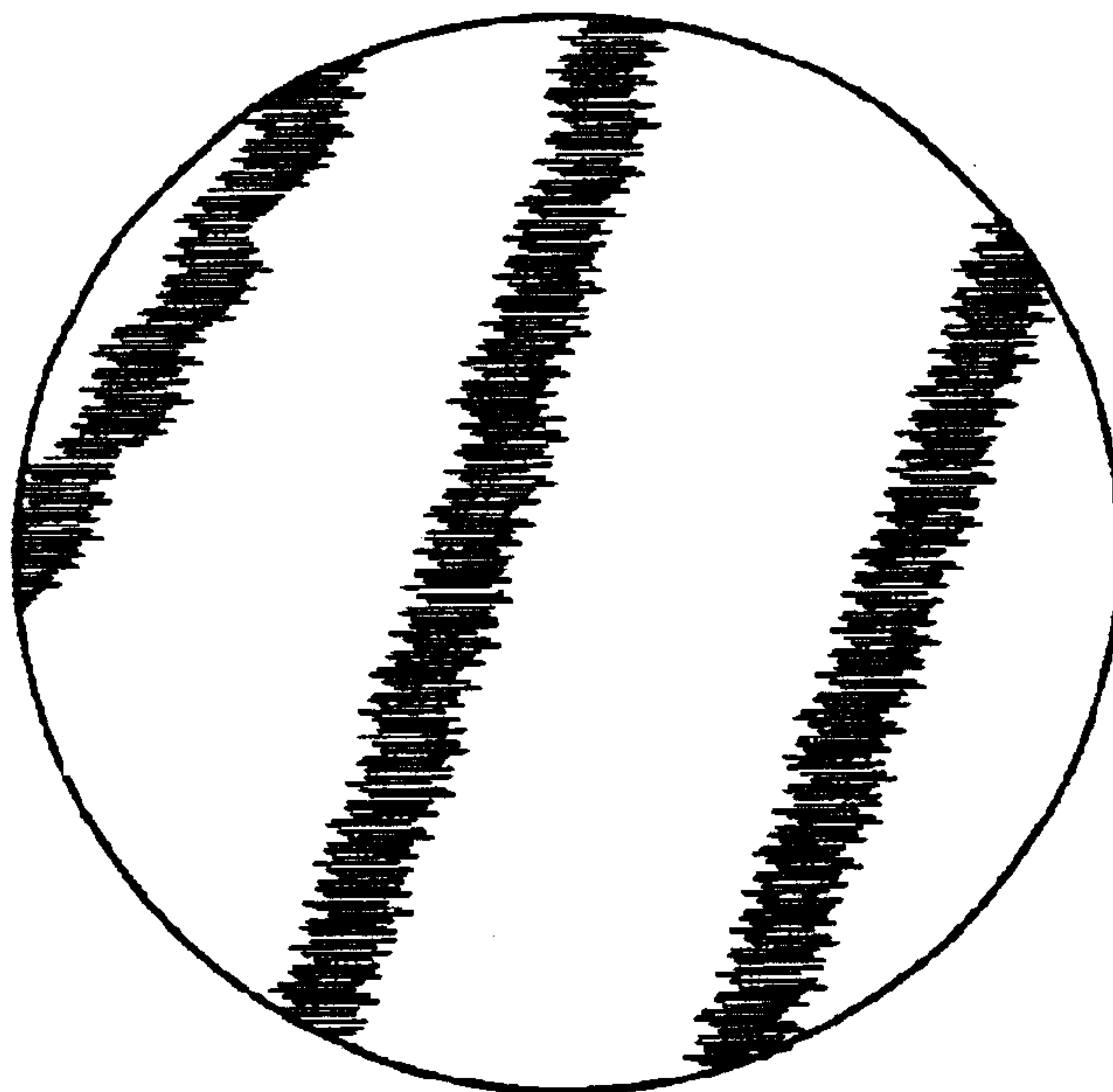

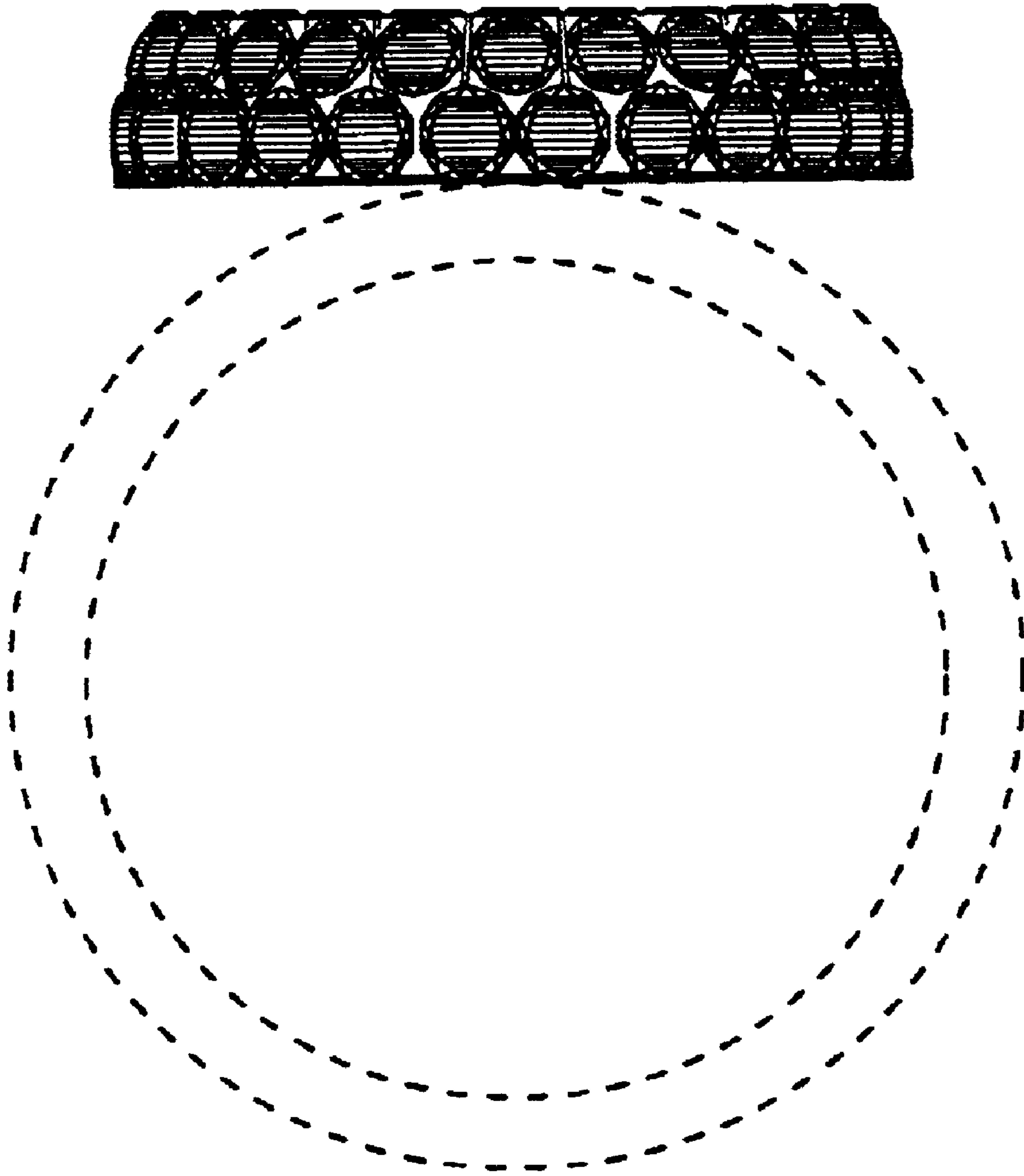

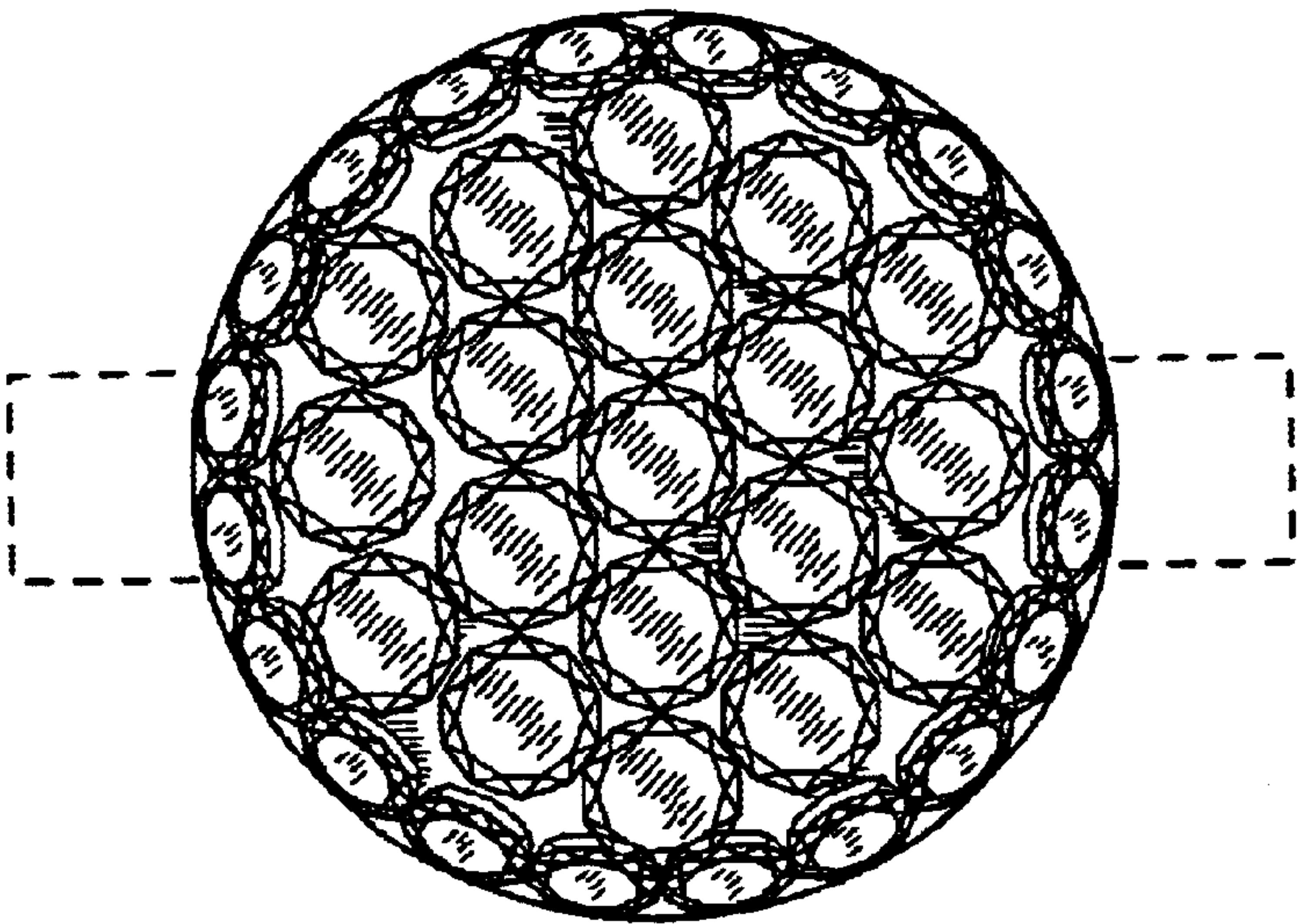

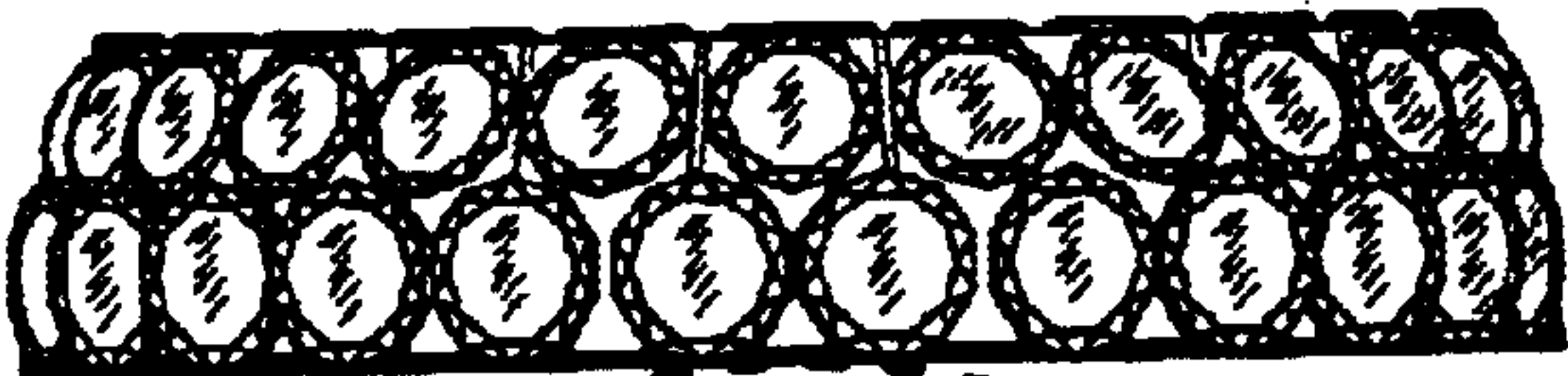
