(57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lens covering for communications headset, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper front left perspective view of a lens covering for communications headset showing my new design, the broken line drawings of an illustrative headset body and earloop are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is an upper front left perspective view of the lens covering for communications headset.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the lens covering for communications headset.


FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the lens covering for communications headset, the left side elevational view of the lens covering for communications headset being a mirror image thereof.


FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the lens covering for communications headset; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The rear and bottom surfaces of the lens covering are unornamented and hidden from view during normal use and form no part of the claimed design.







