DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the invention showing the representation of a facial expression indicating a specific mood.

FIG. 2 is a top view of the invention.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the invention.

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the invention; the left side view being a mirror image.

FIG. 5 is a back side view of the invention.

FIG. 6 is a front view of a second embodiment of the invention showing an alternative design of the face.

FIG. 7 is a front view of a third embodiment of the invention showing an alternative design of the face.

FIG. 8 is a front view of a fourth embodiment of the invention showing an alternative design of the face; and,

FIG. 9 is a front view of a fifth embodiment of the invention showing an alternative design of the face.
