DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a decorative bowl of the present invention showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the decorative bowl of FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the decorative bowl of FIG. 1;






