(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a child's toilet training step and footrest, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the child's toilet training step and footrest with a child and a toilet shown in dash lines using the invention as a step in accordance with this invention;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the child's toilet training step and footrest in accordance with this invention with a child and a toilet shown in dashed lines using the invention as a footrest;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the invention of FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the invention of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the invention in FIG. 3, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a back elevational view of the invention in FIG. 3; FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the invention of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of an alternate embodiment of this invention;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of the invention in FIG. 8, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;

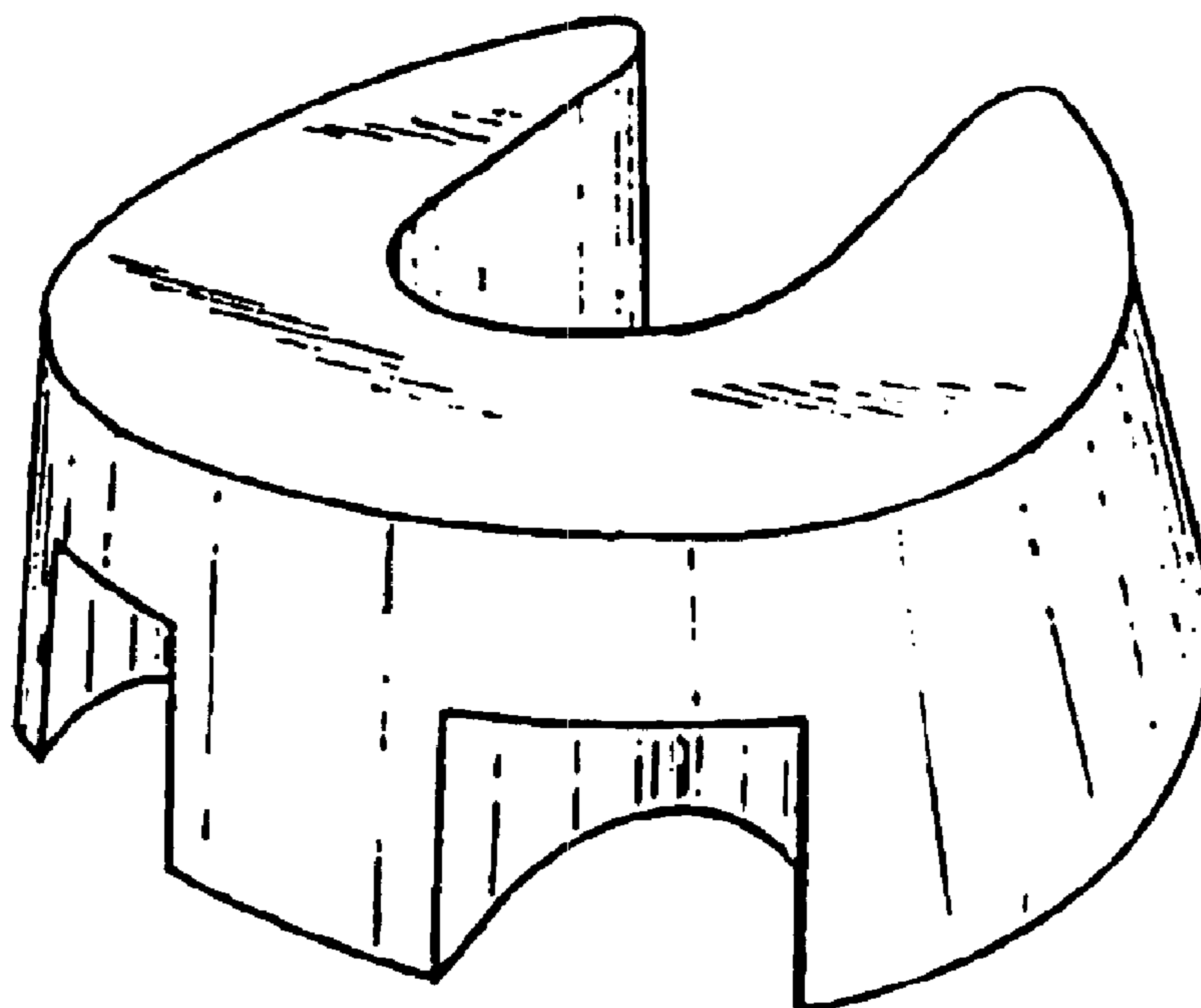
FIG. 10 is a back elevational view of the invention in FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the invention in FIG. 8.

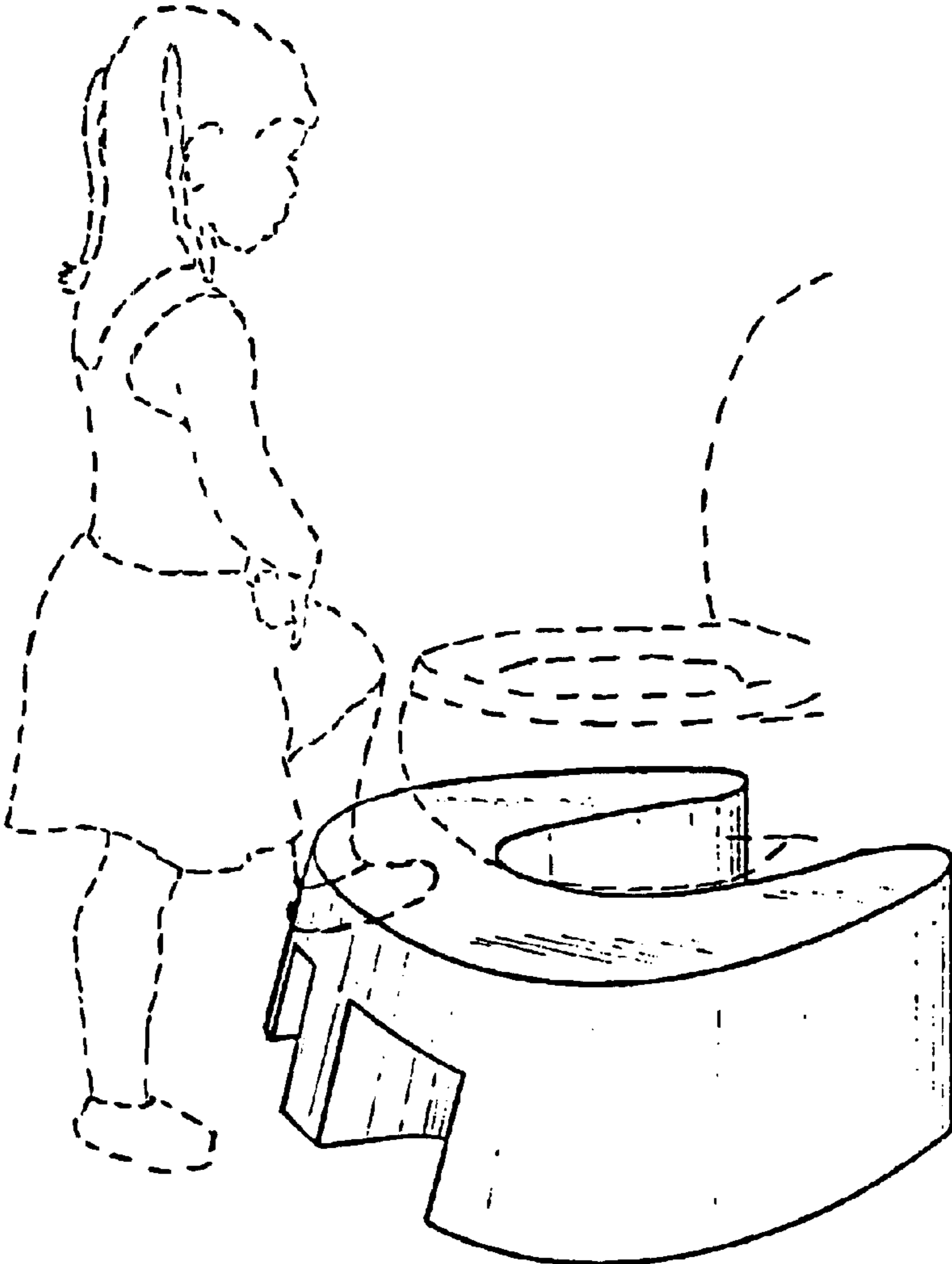

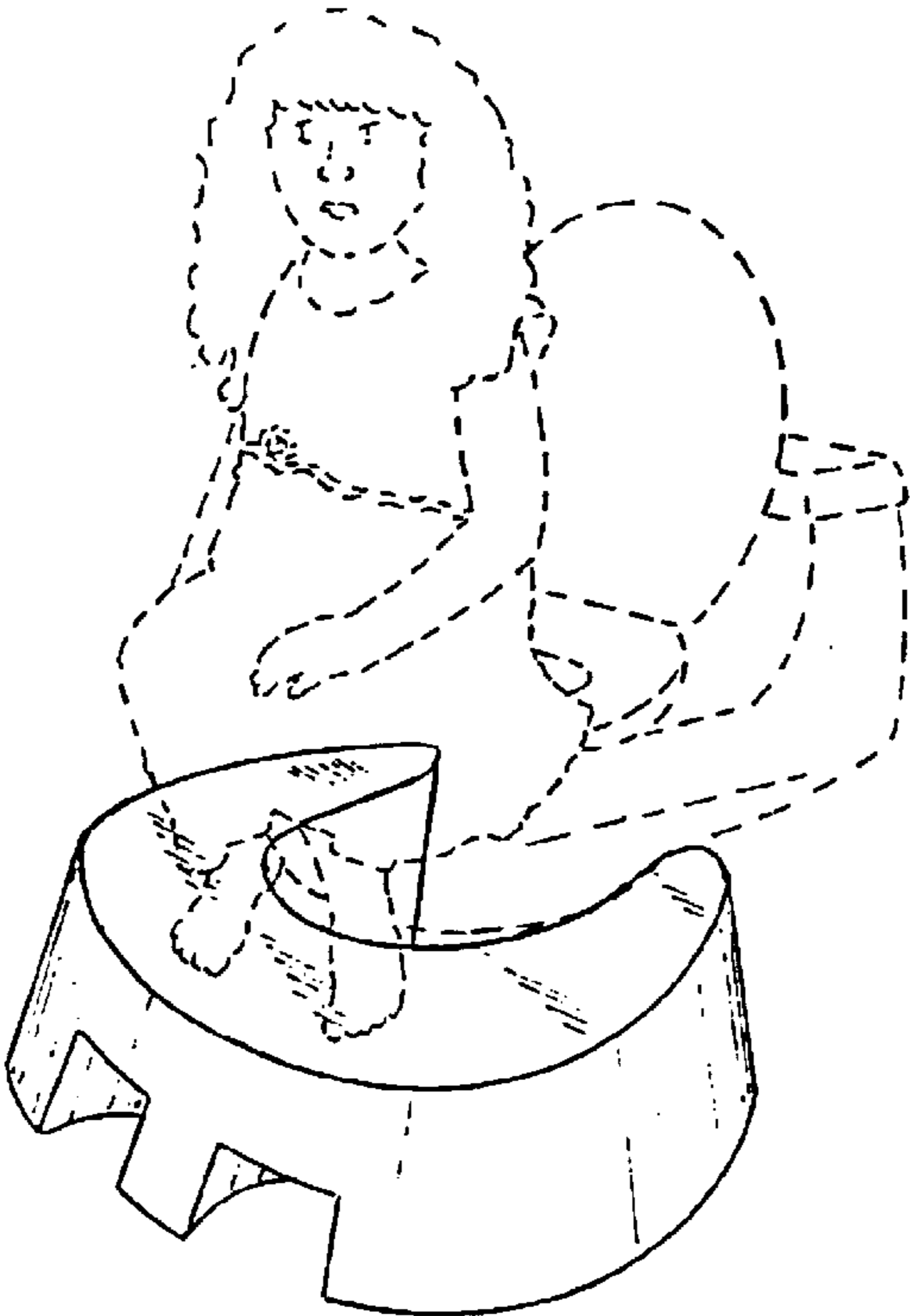

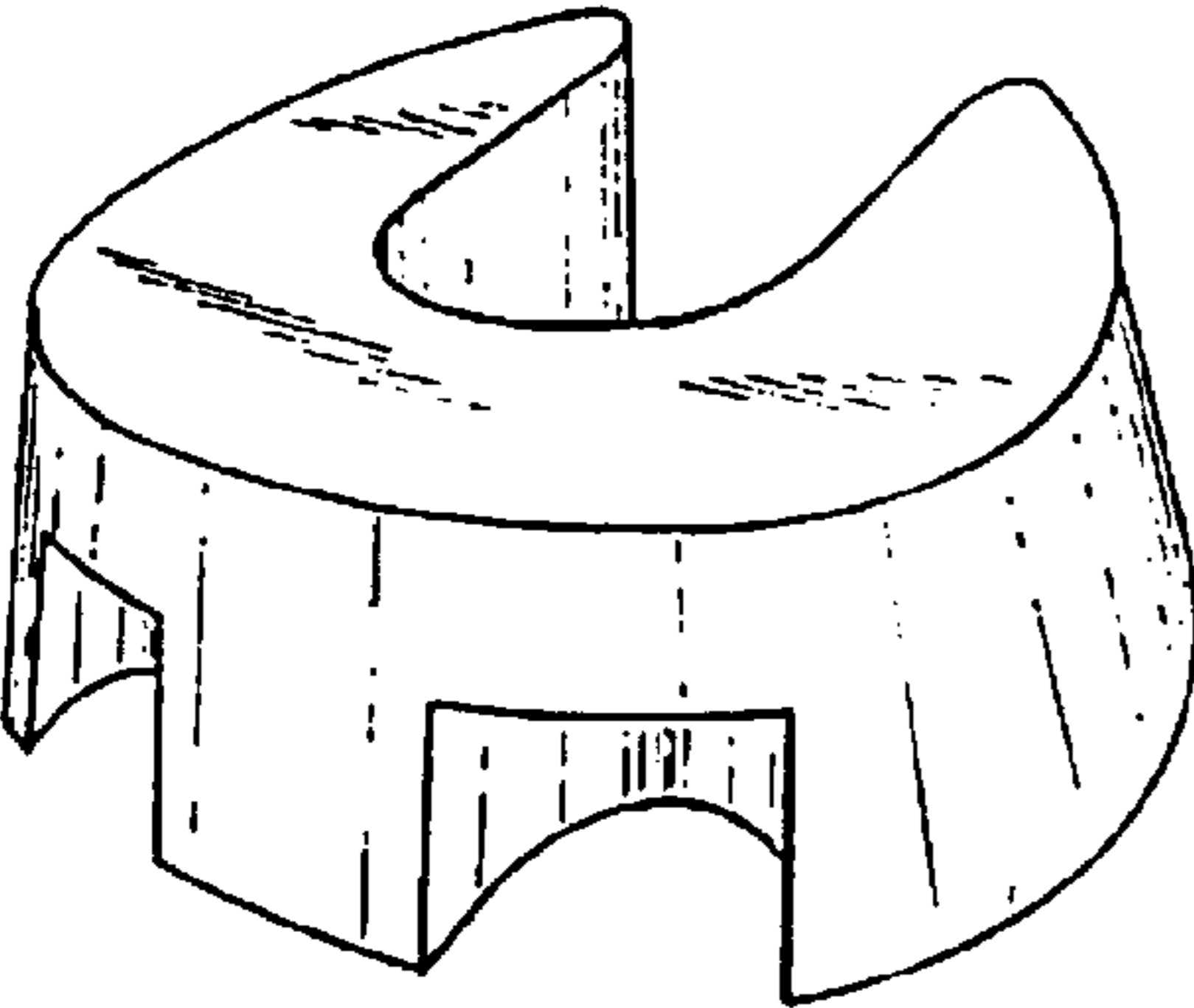

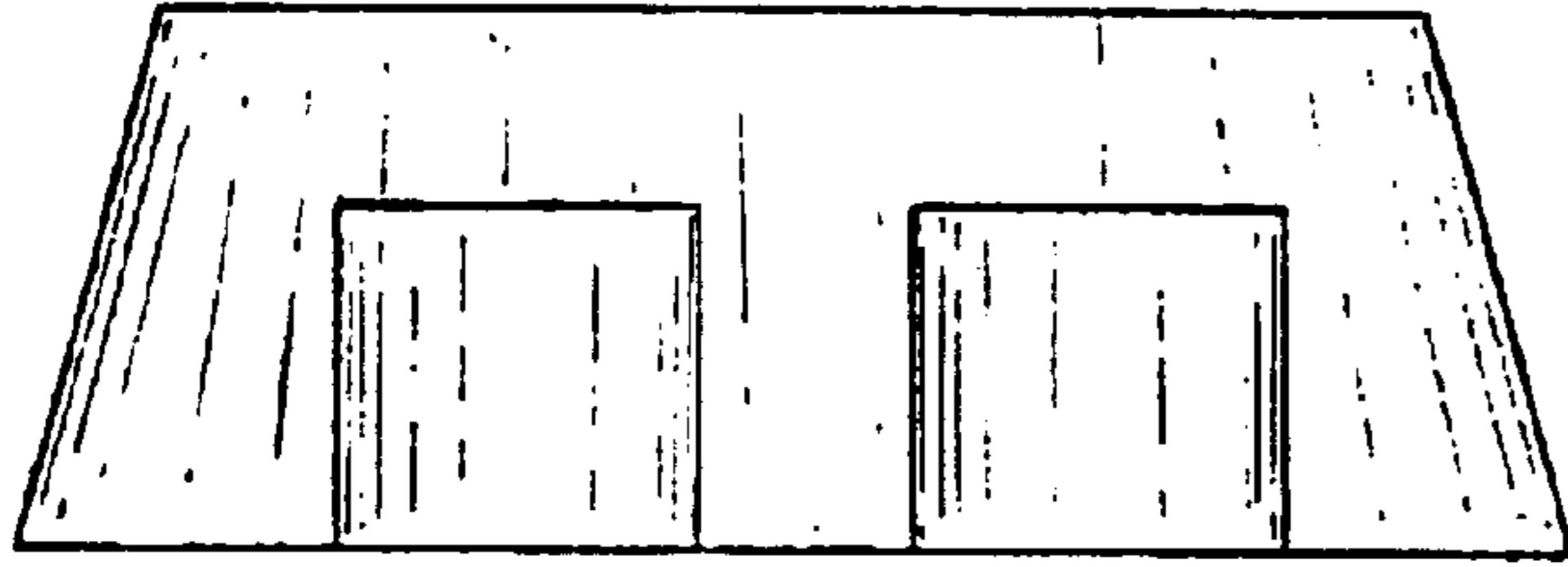

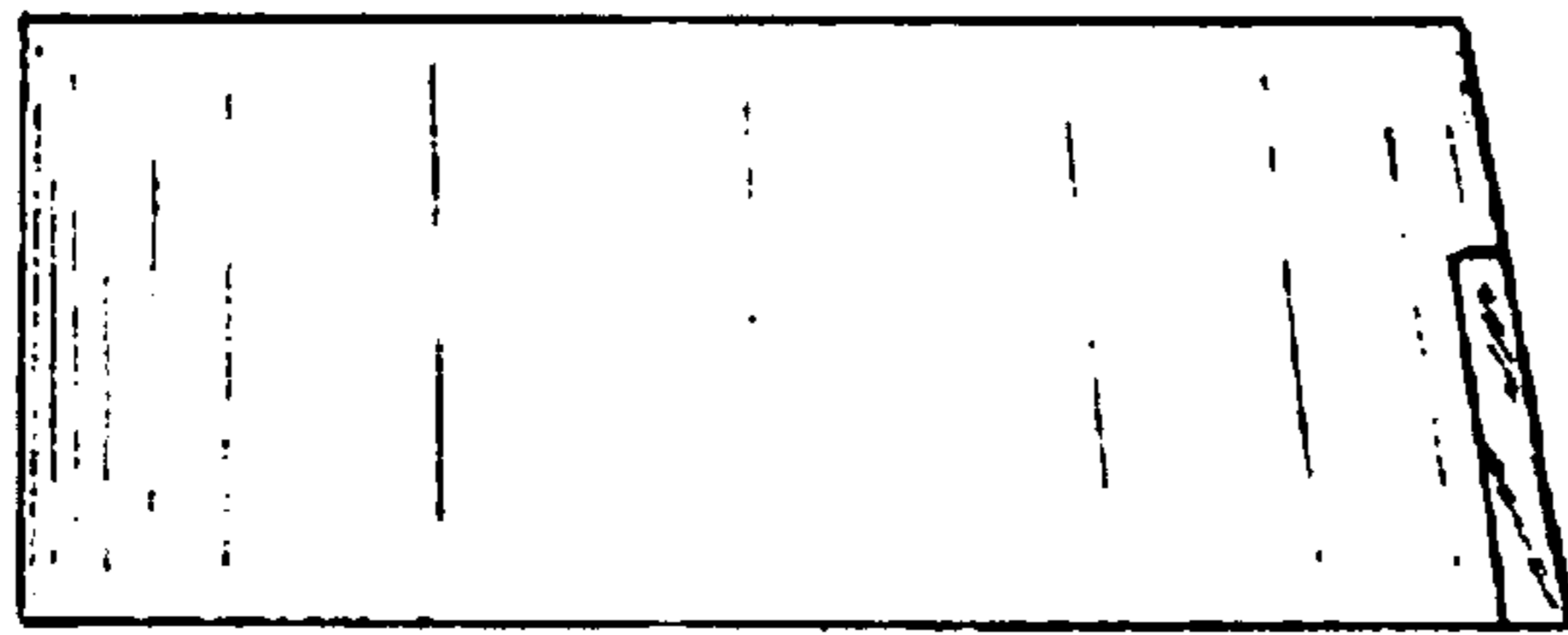

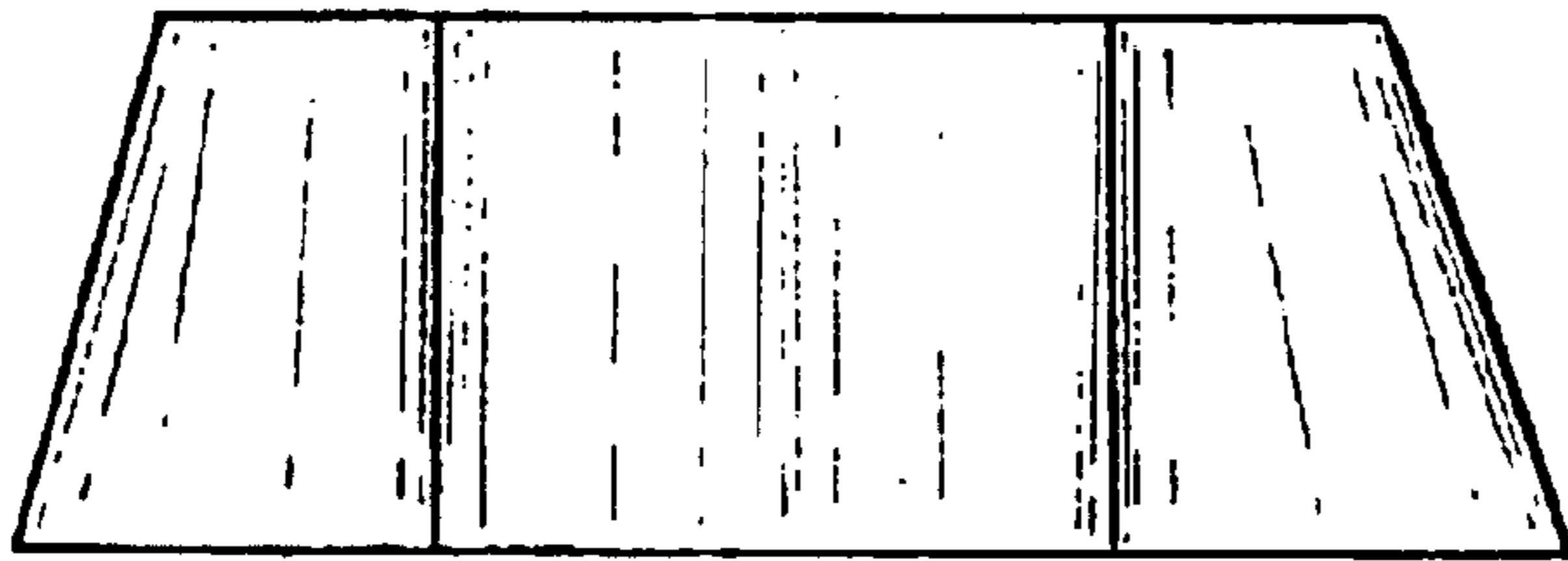

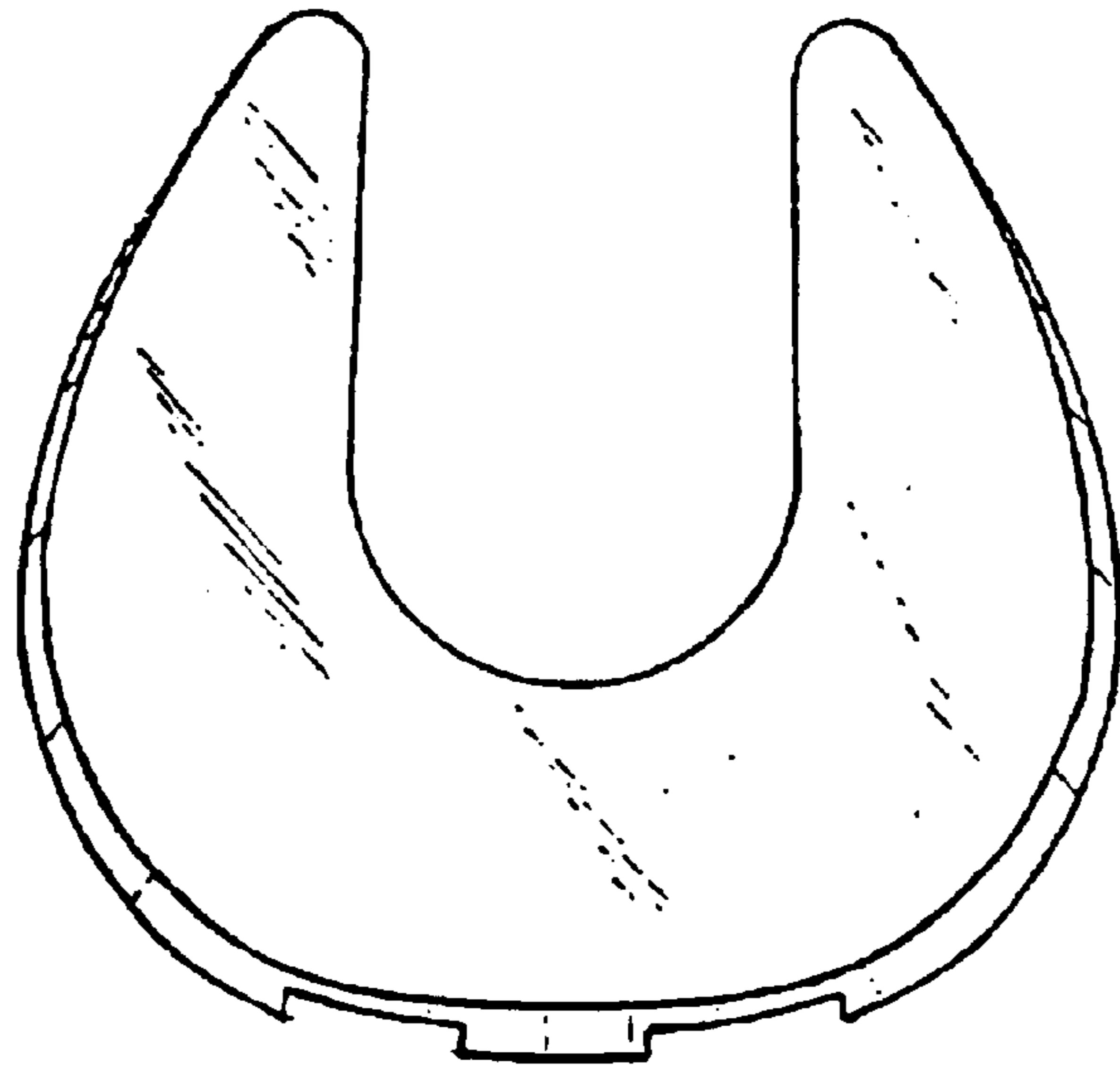
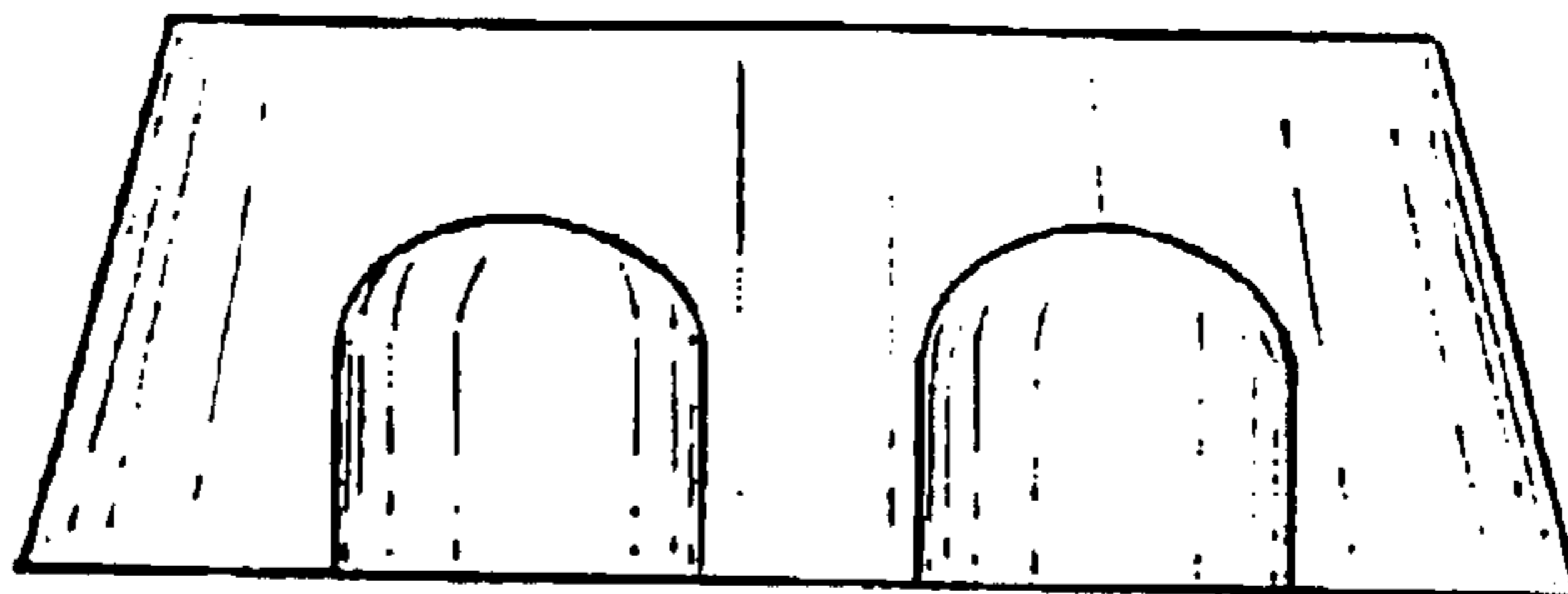

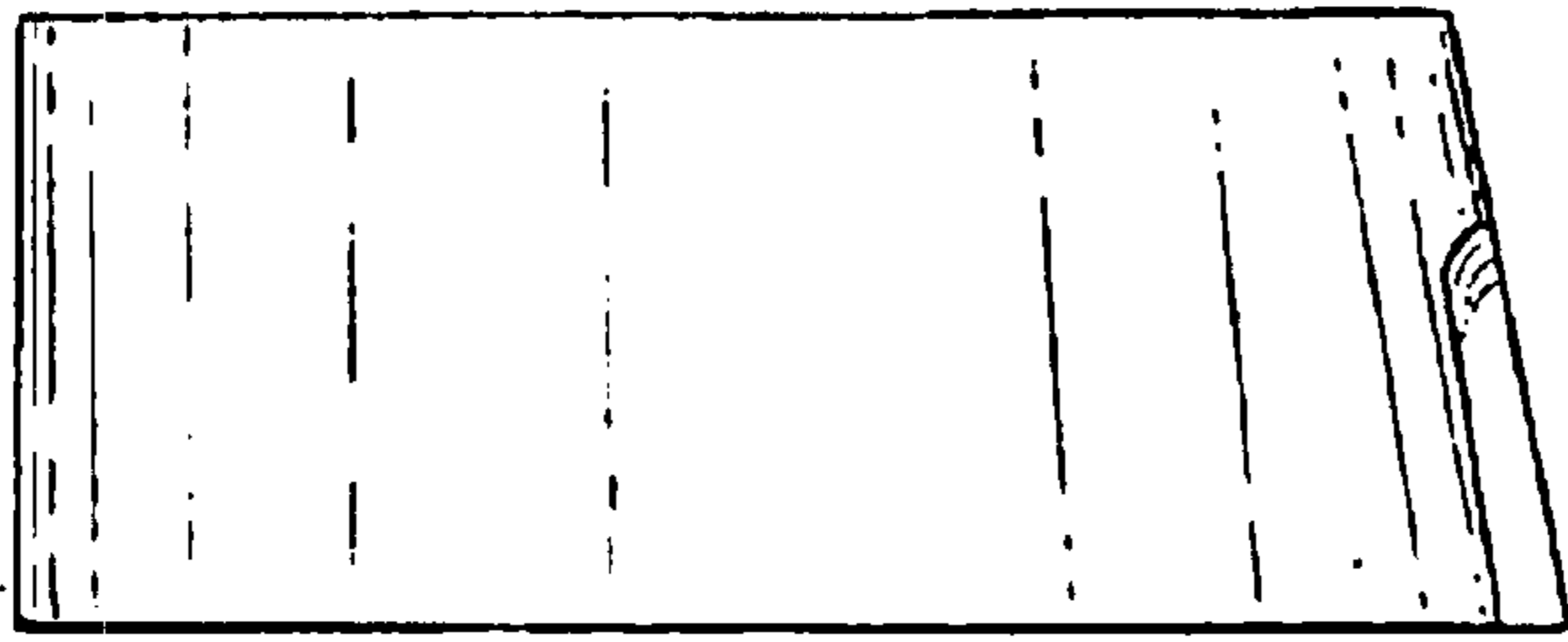

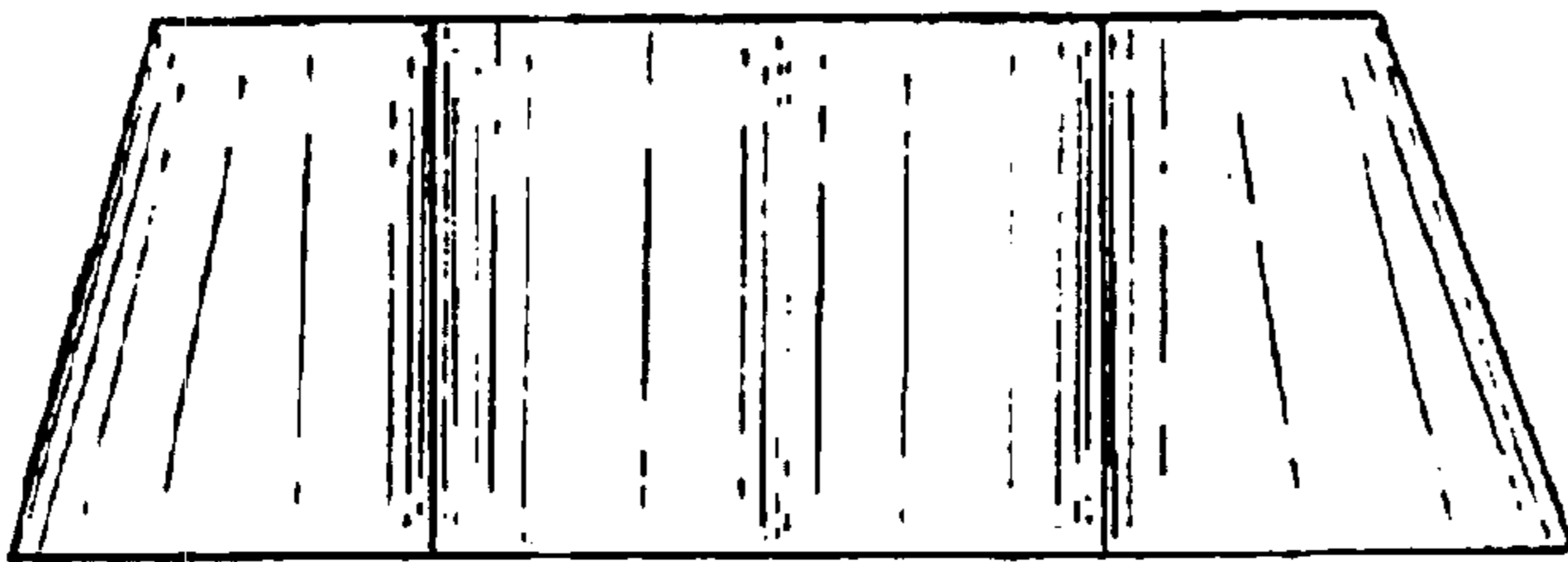

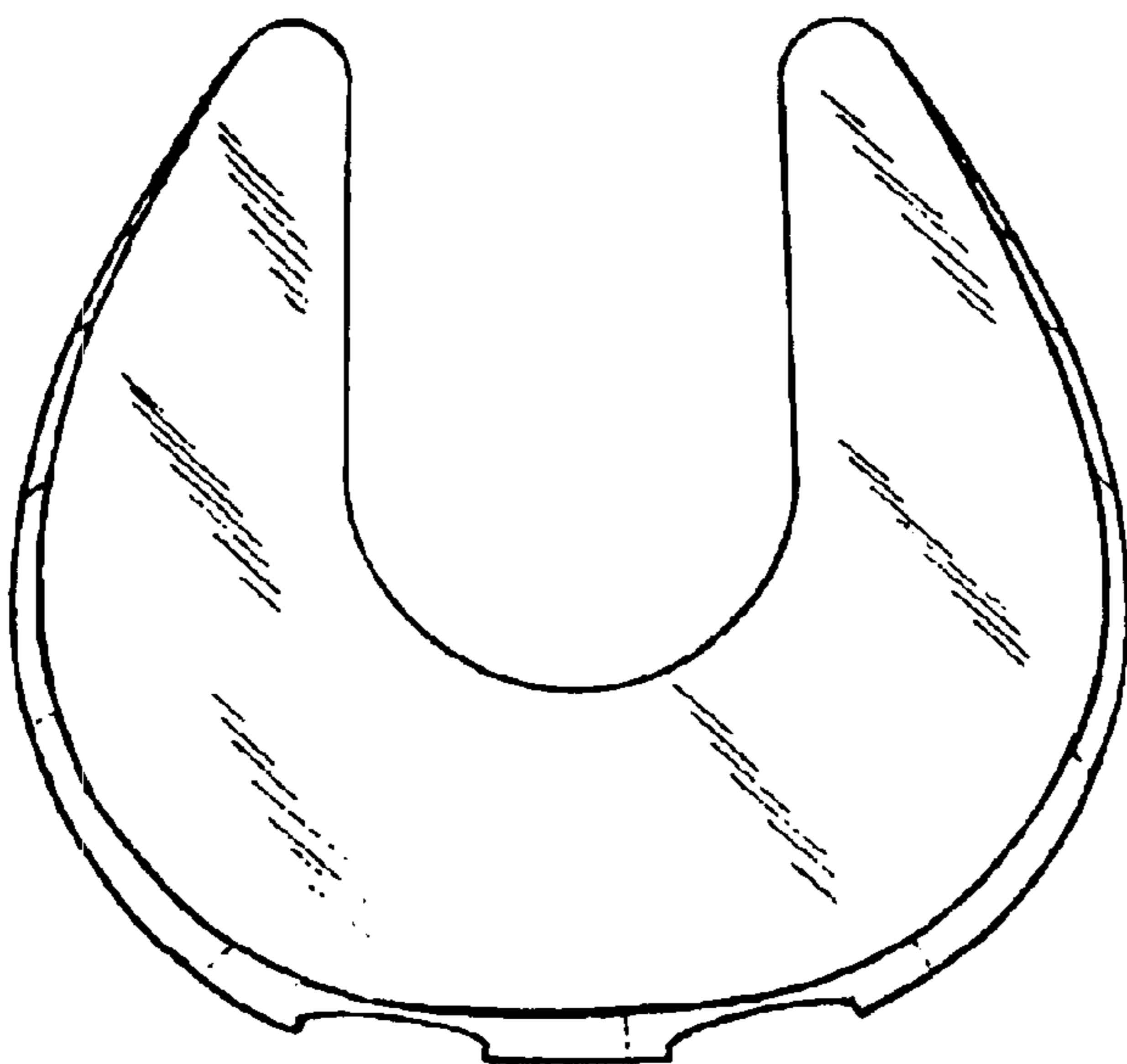
