**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sideboard showing my new design;

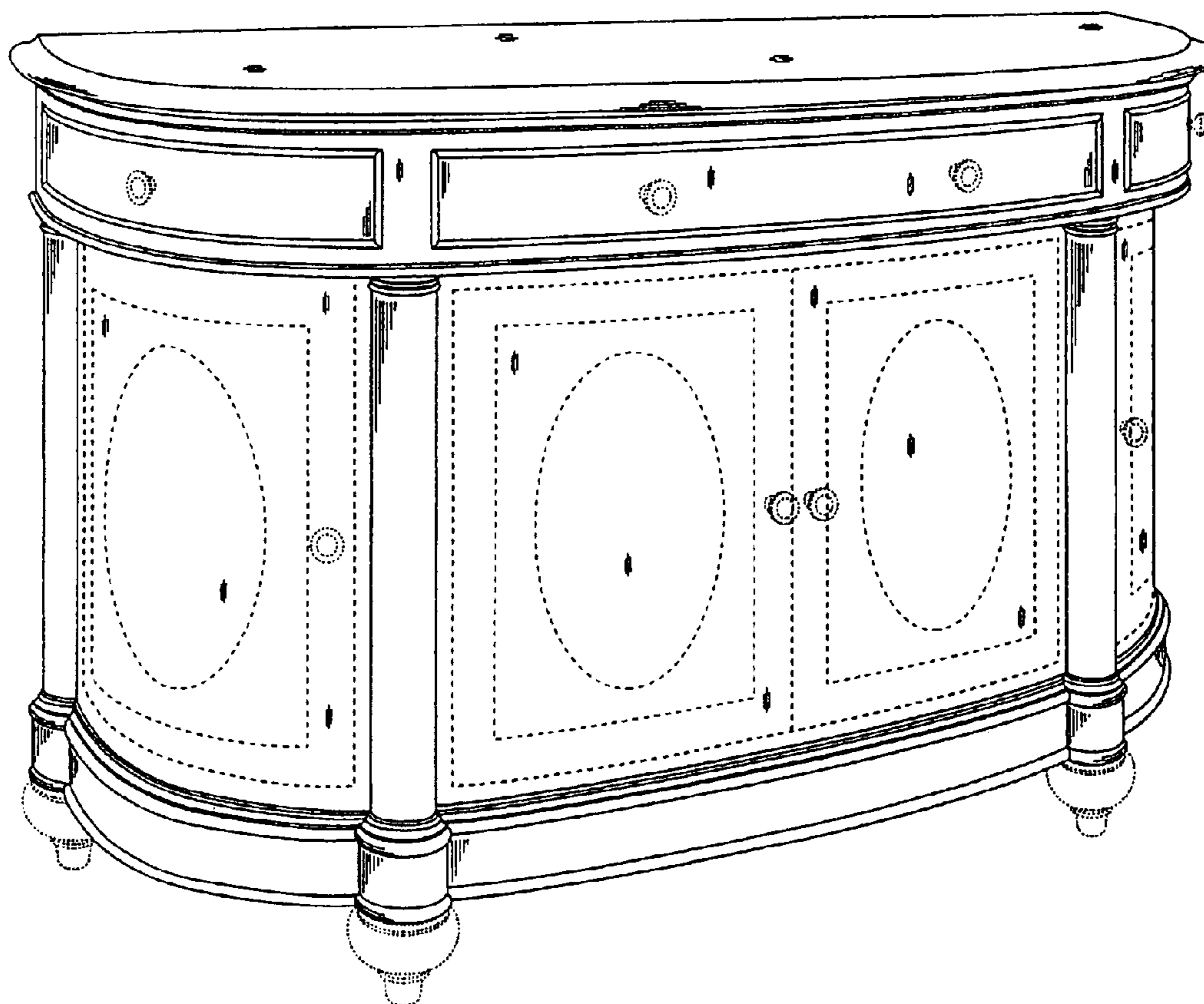
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

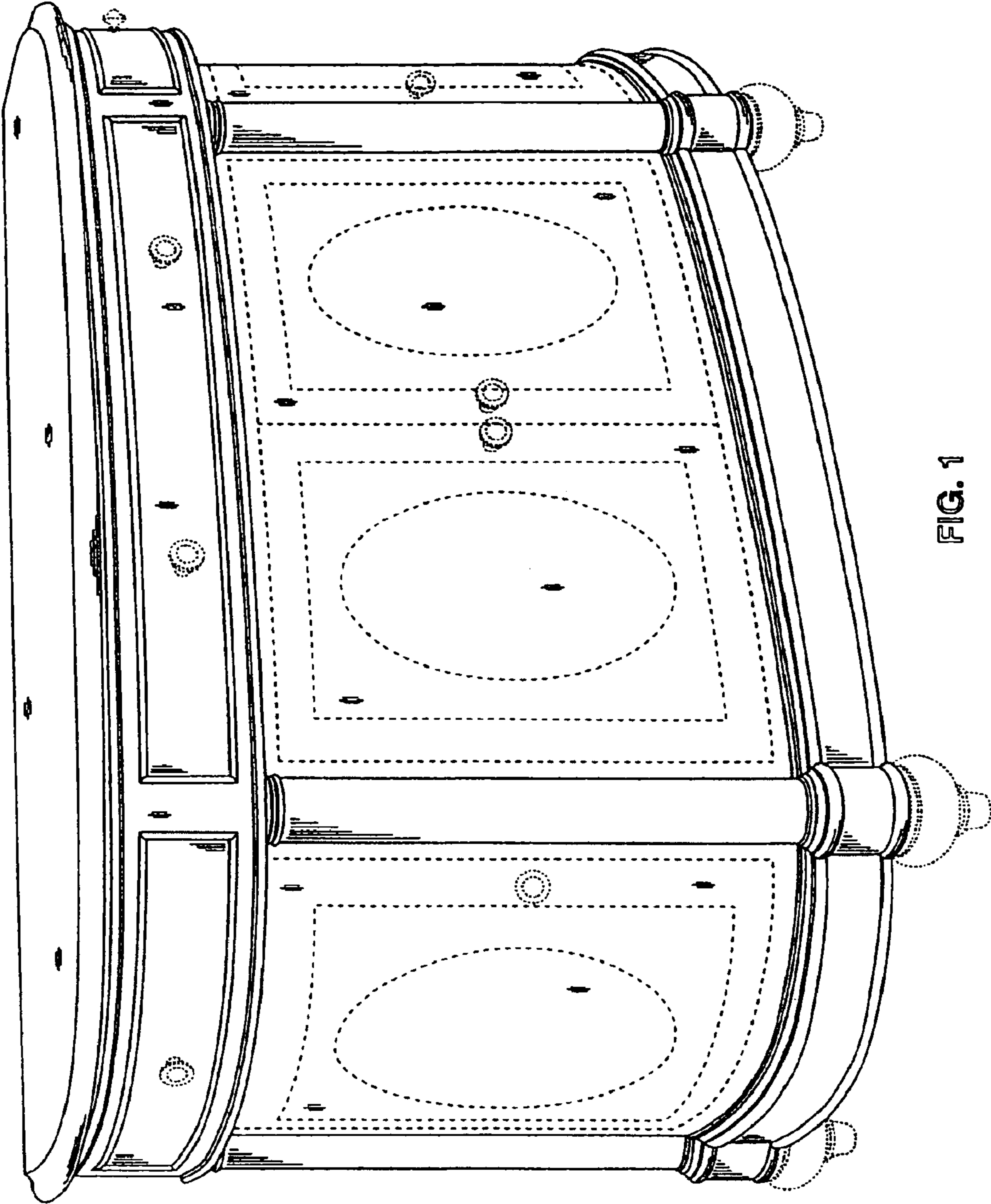

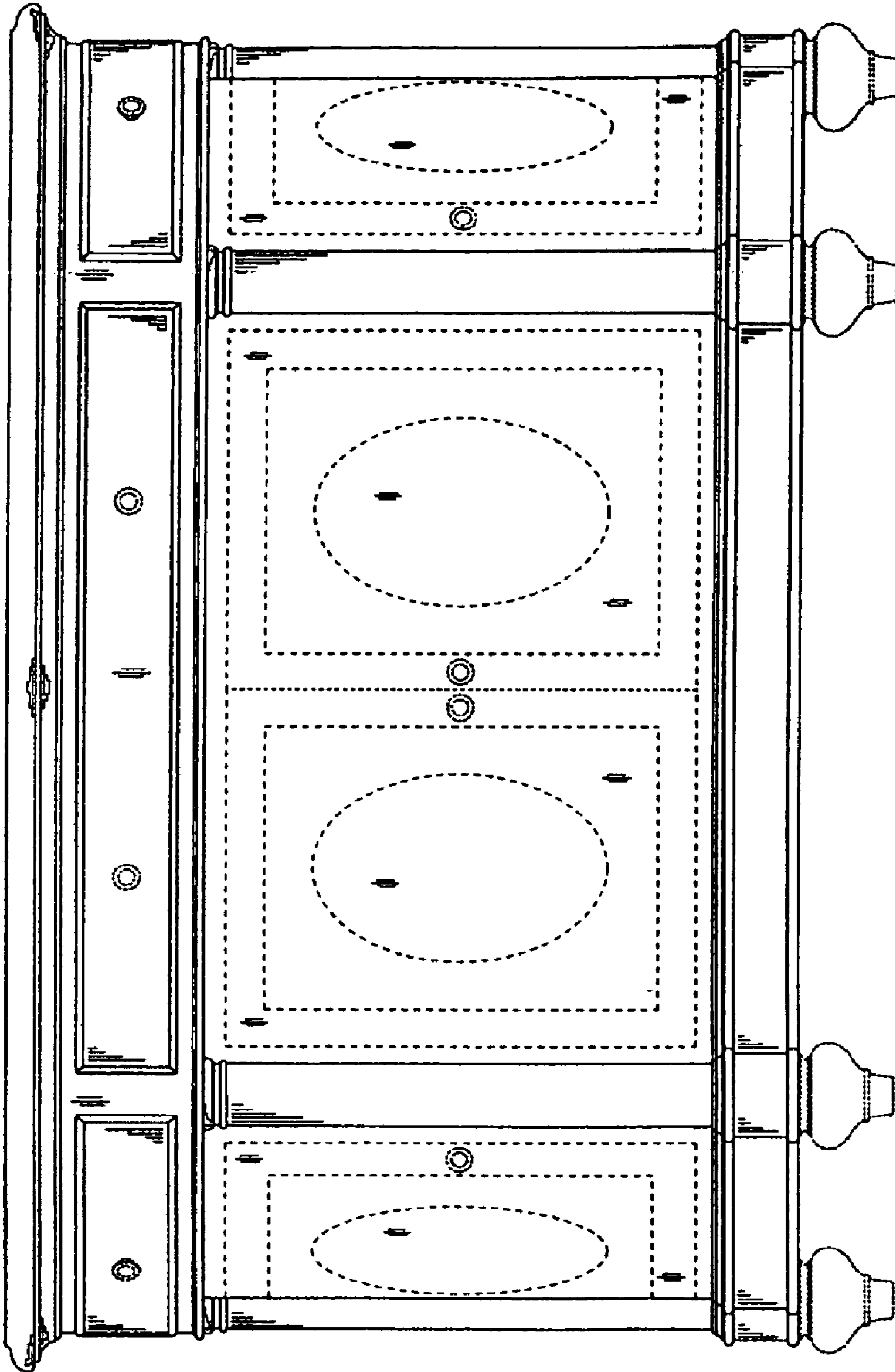

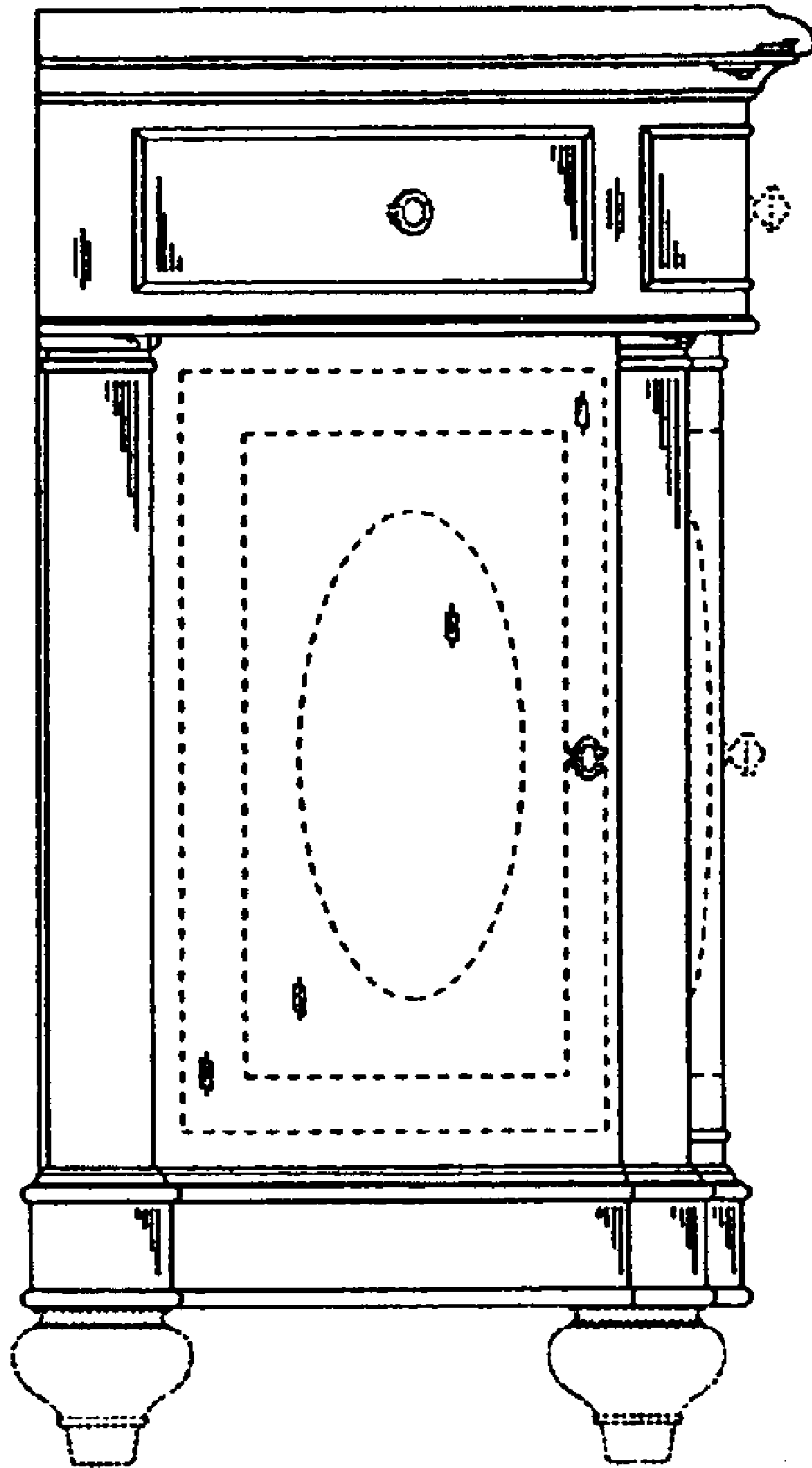

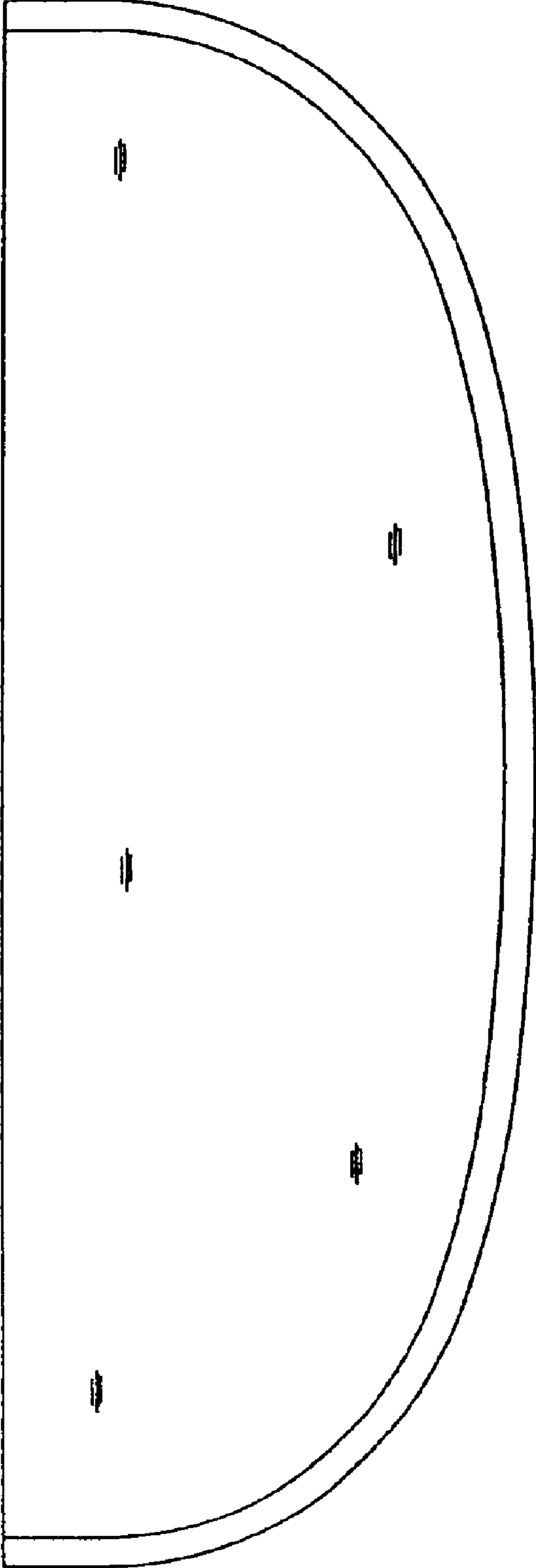
