DESCRIPTION

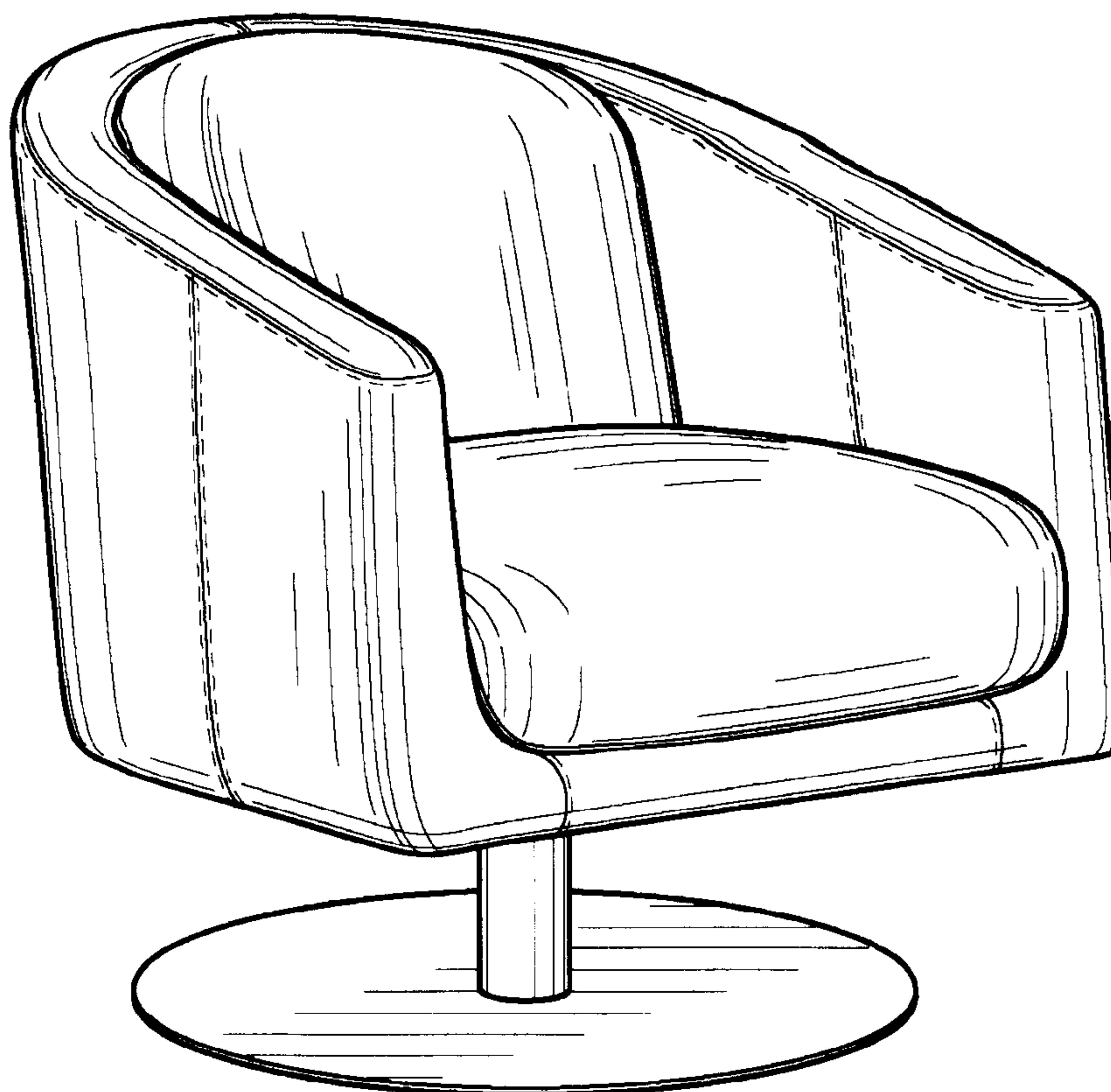
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the chair showing my design.

 The broken lines shown on the sofa are understood to represent stitching.

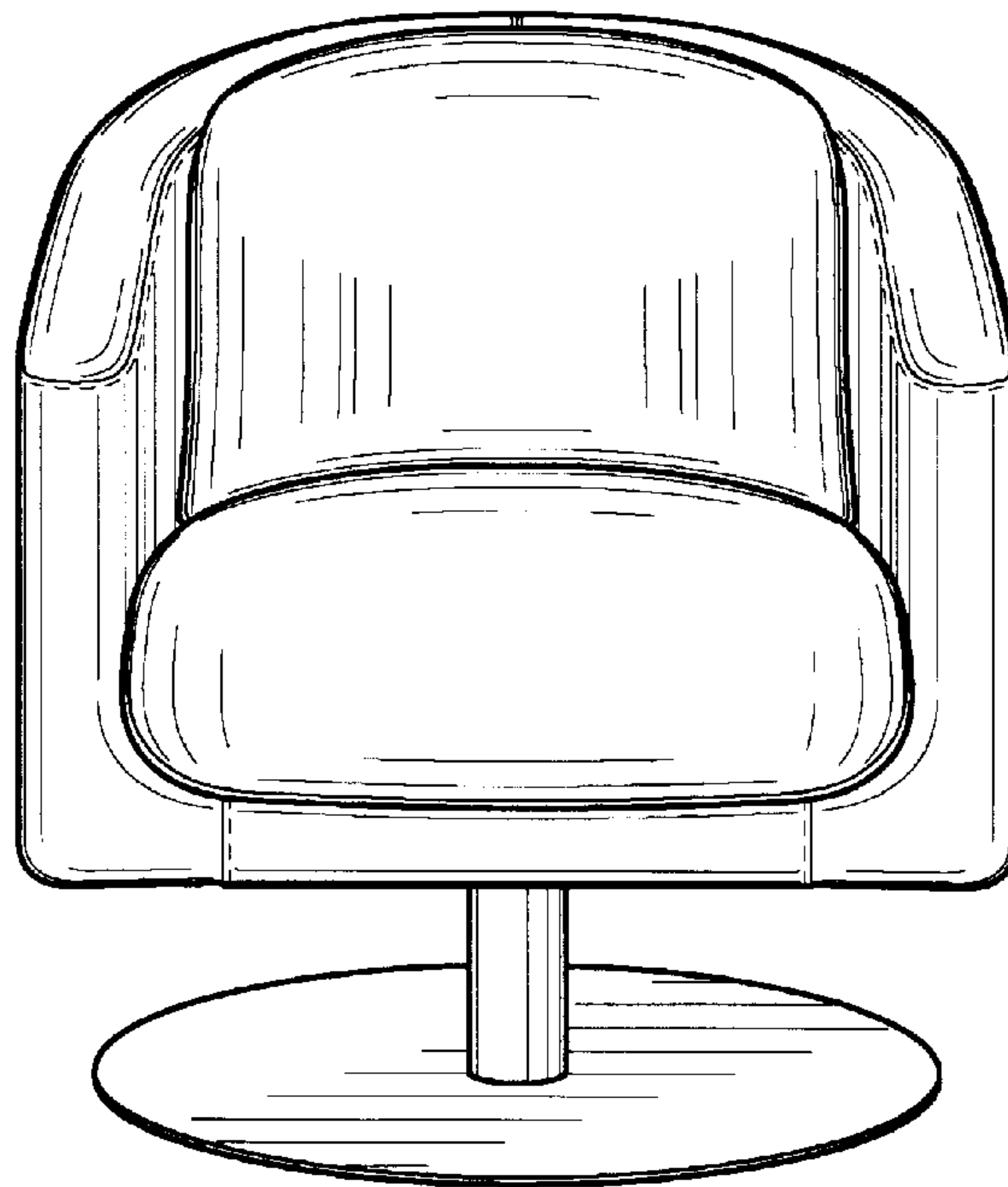

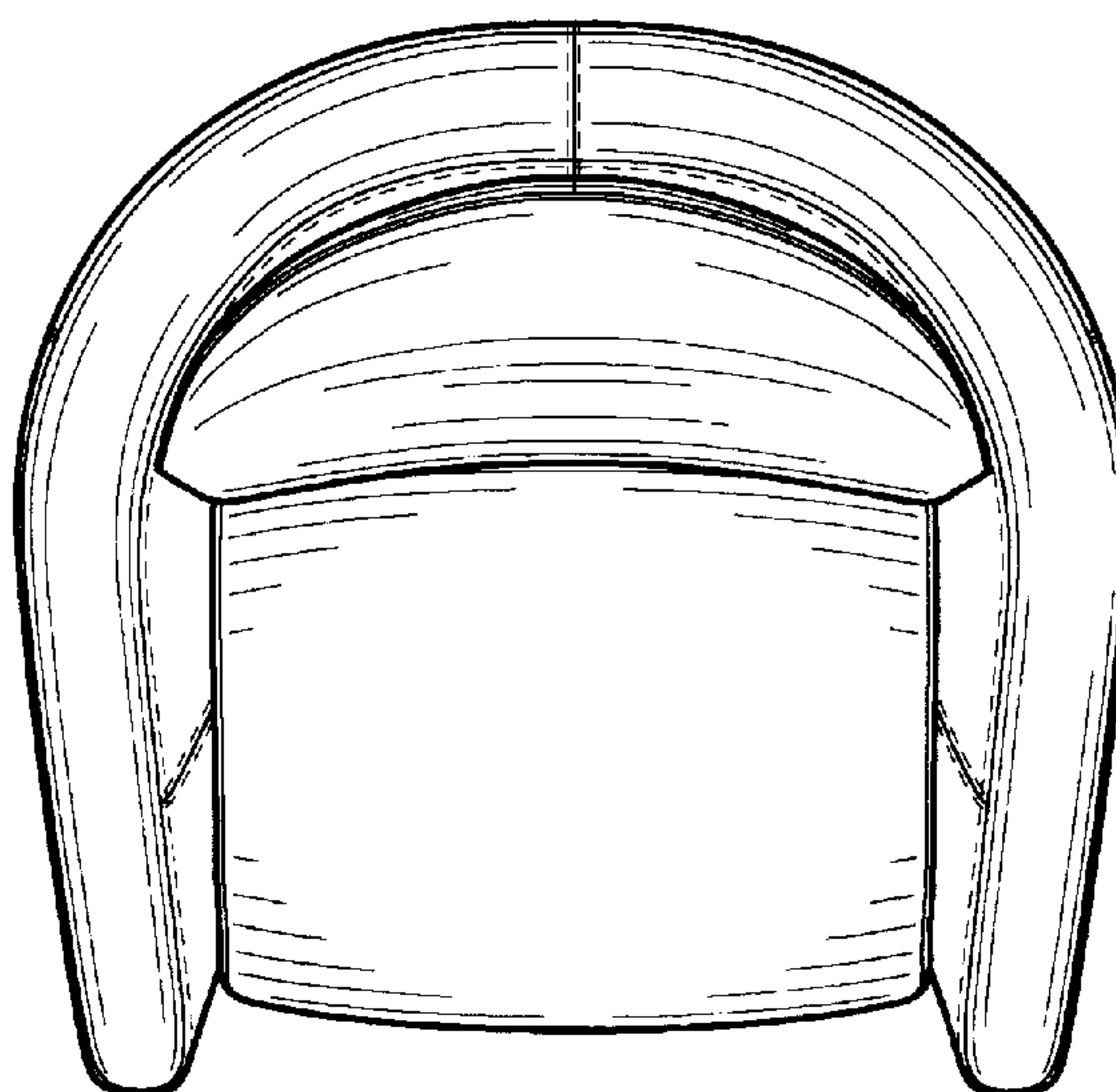

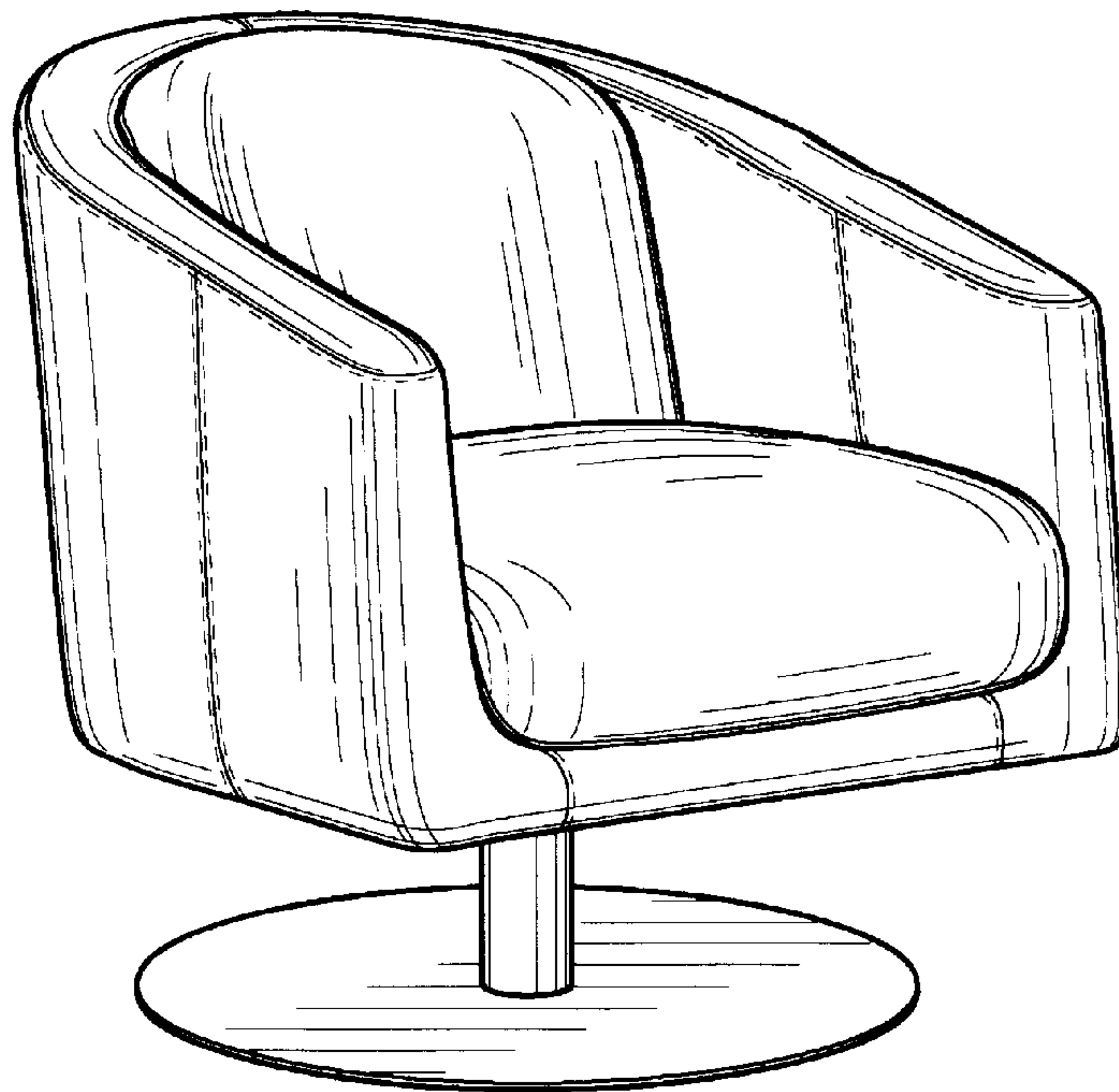

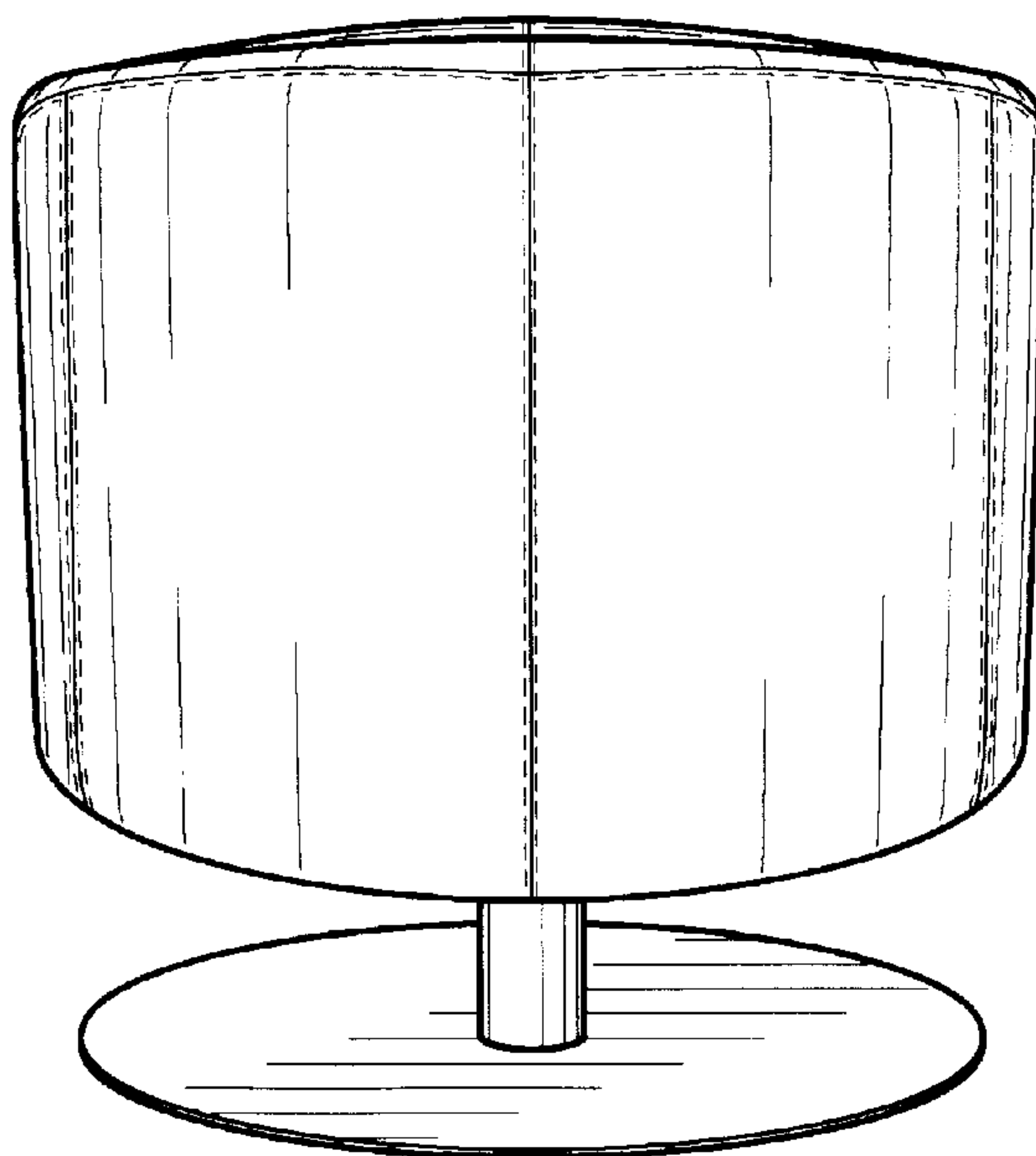

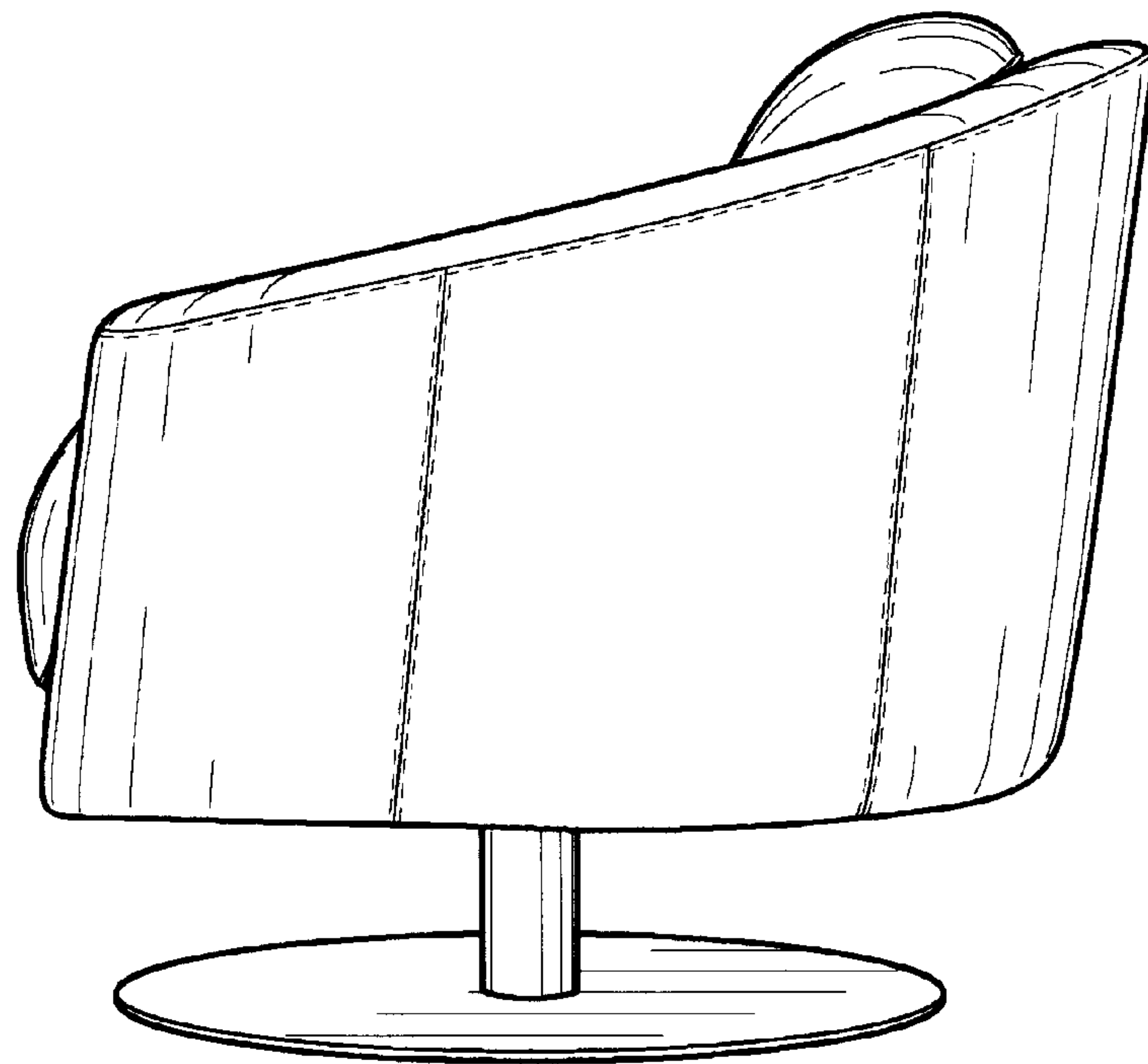
