FIG. 2 is top plan view thereof;

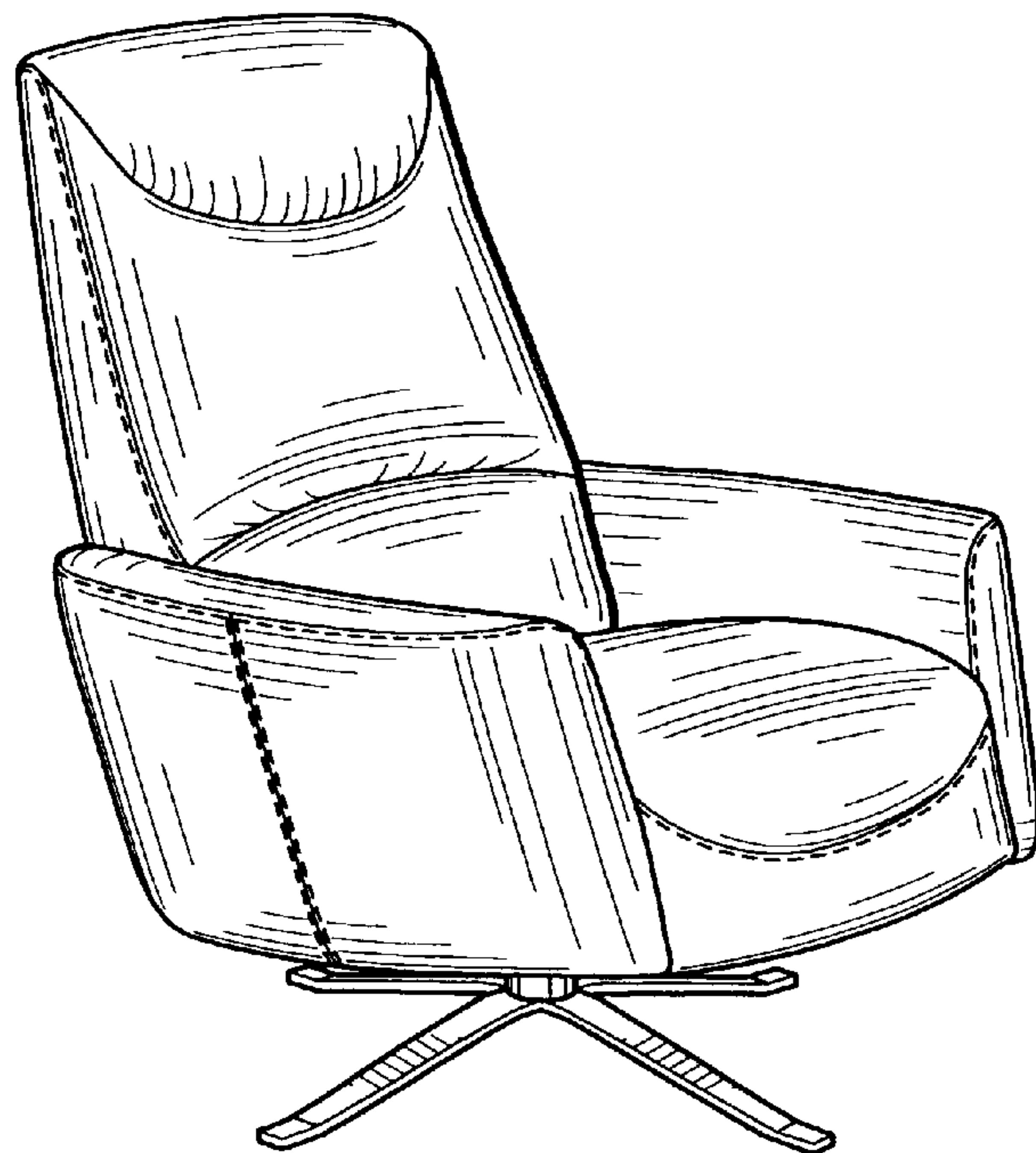
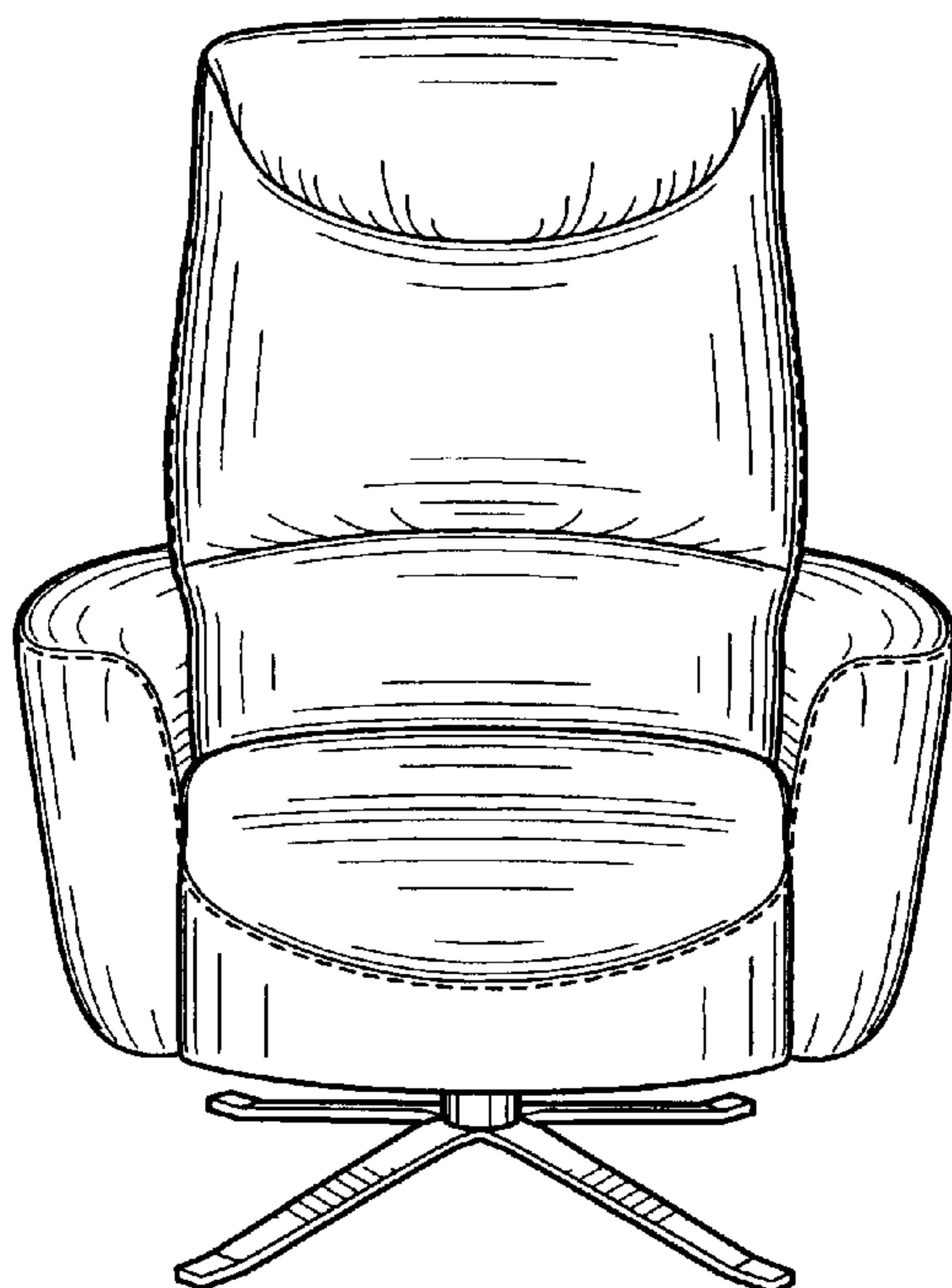
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof;

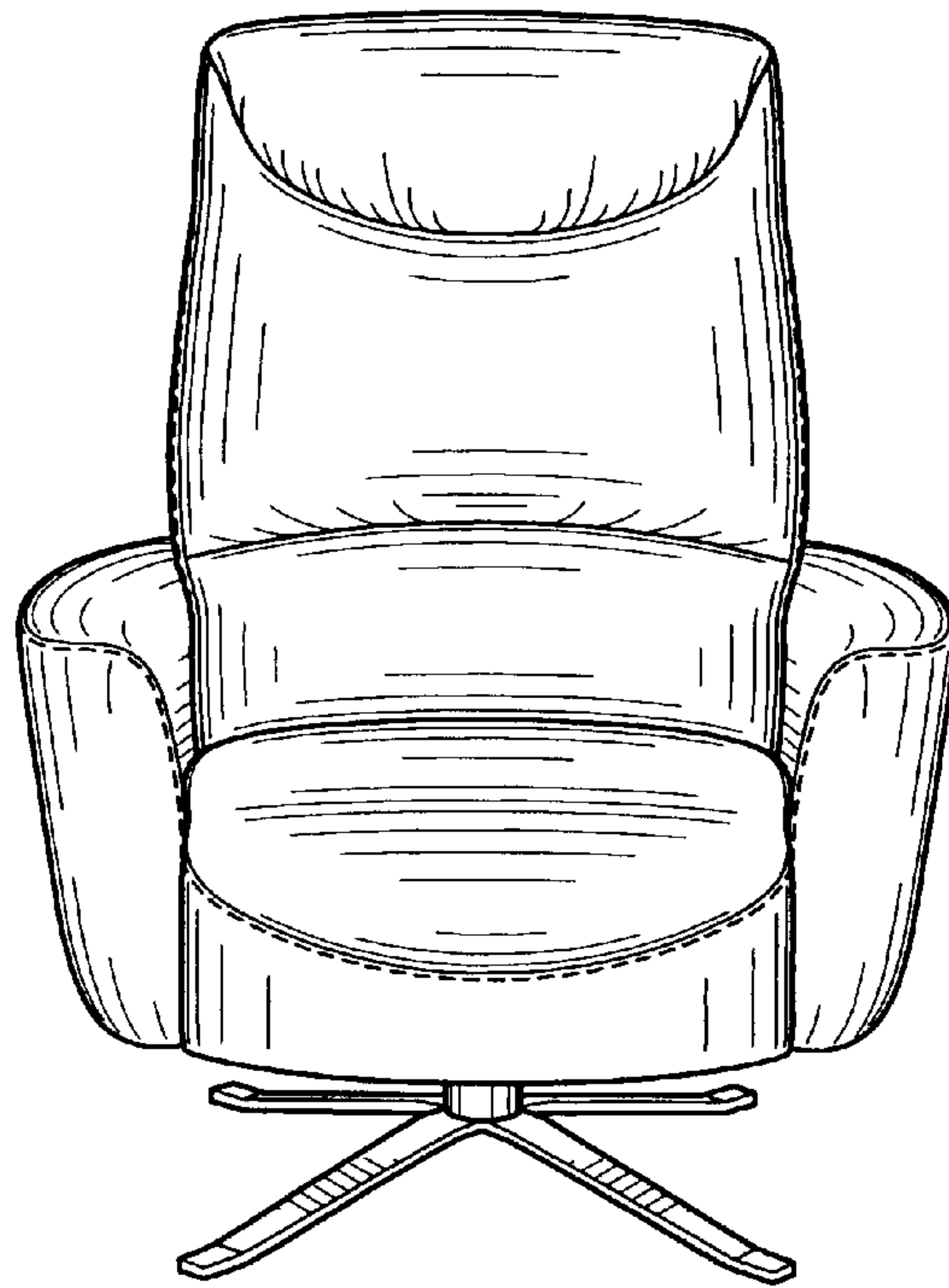

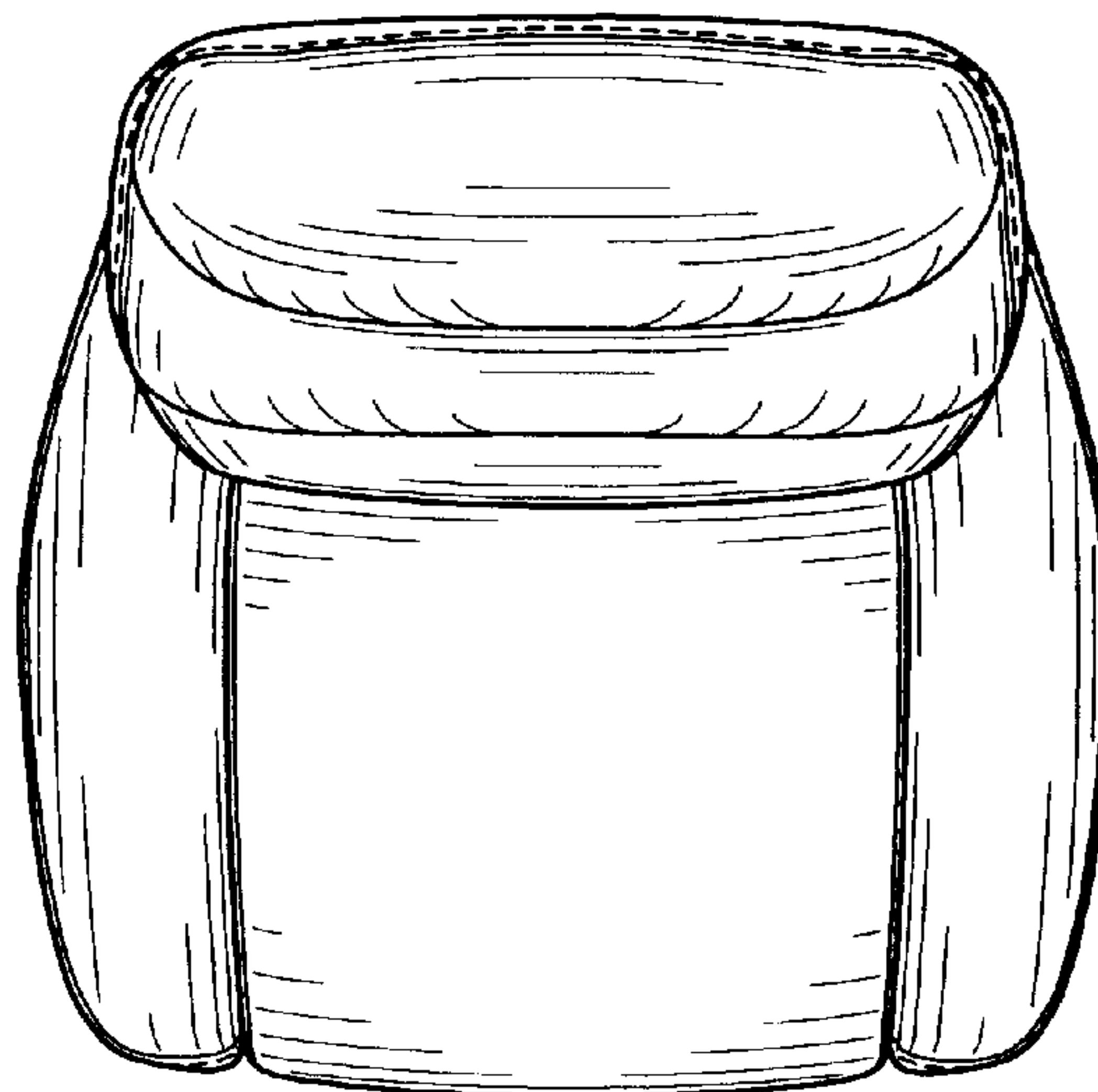

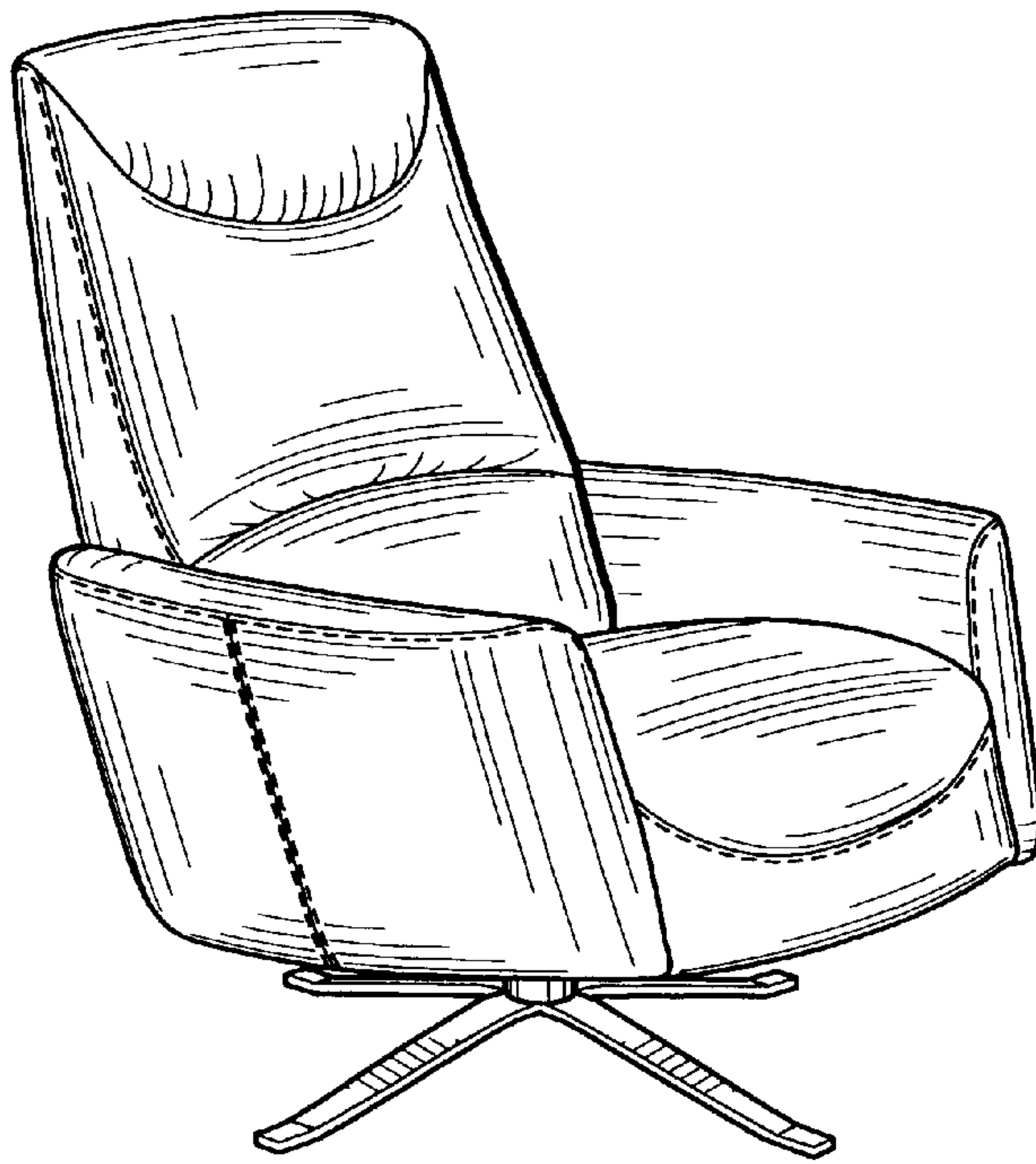

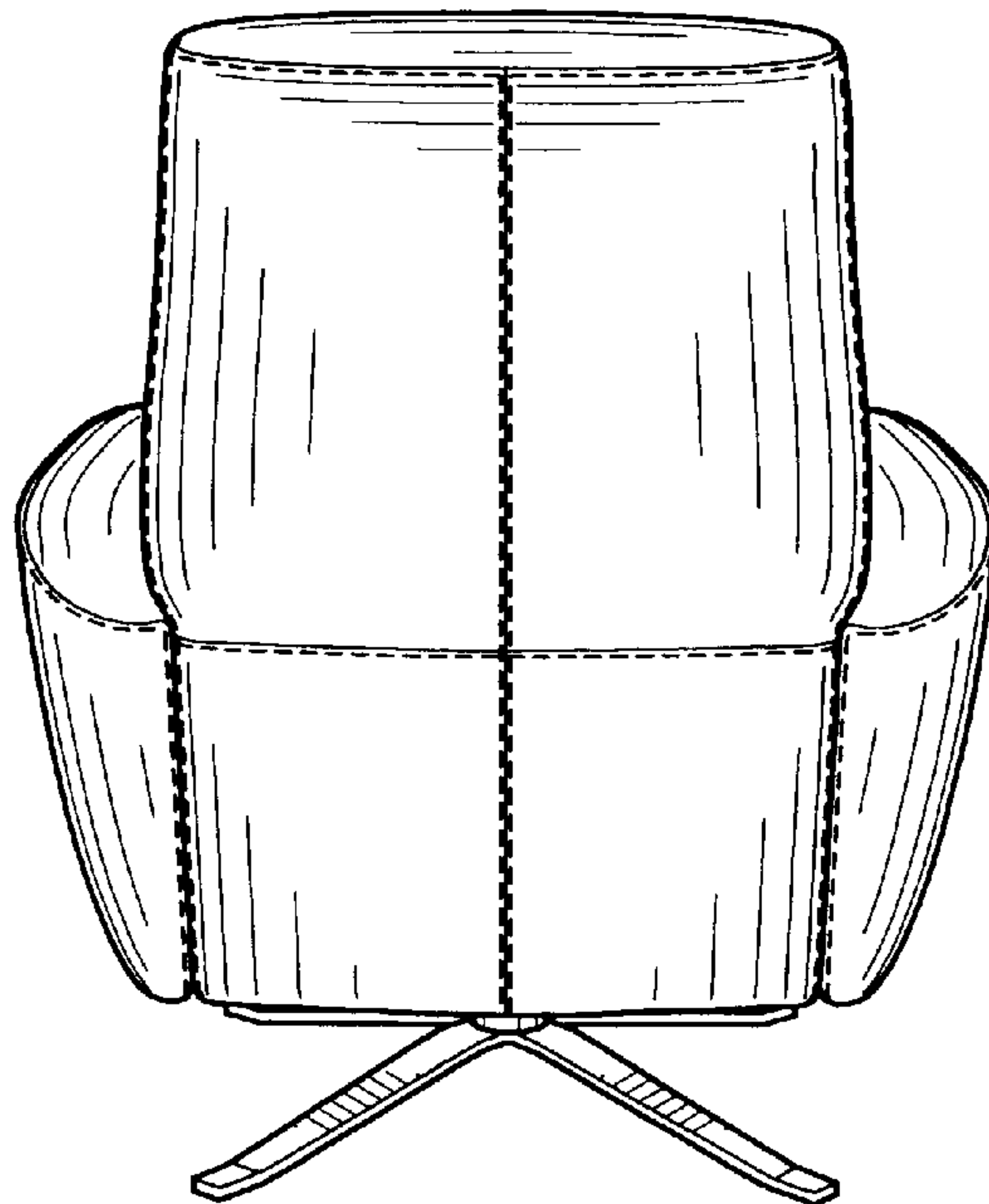
