**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 3 is a top view of FIG. 1;

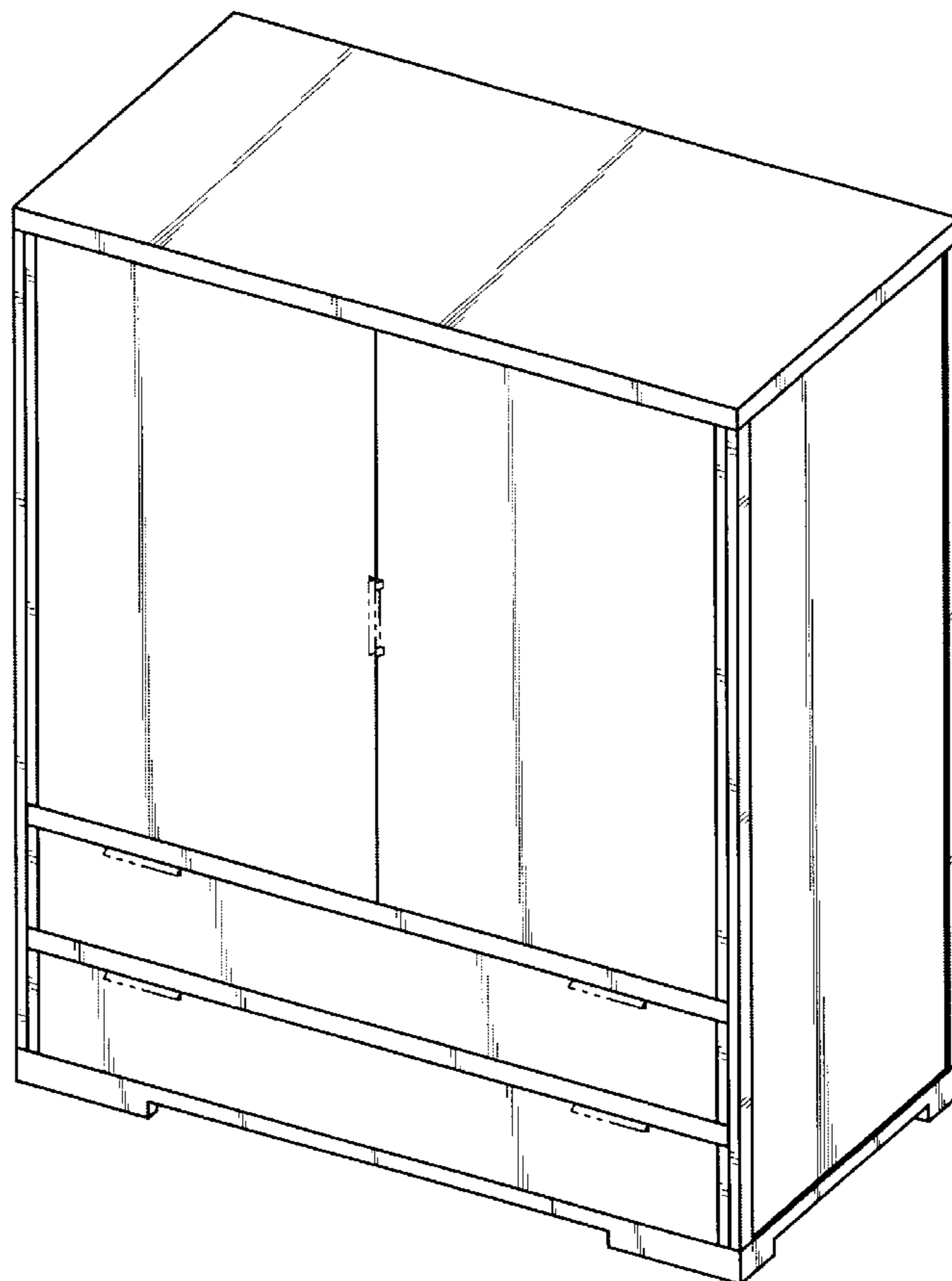
FIG. 4 is a front view of FIG. 1;

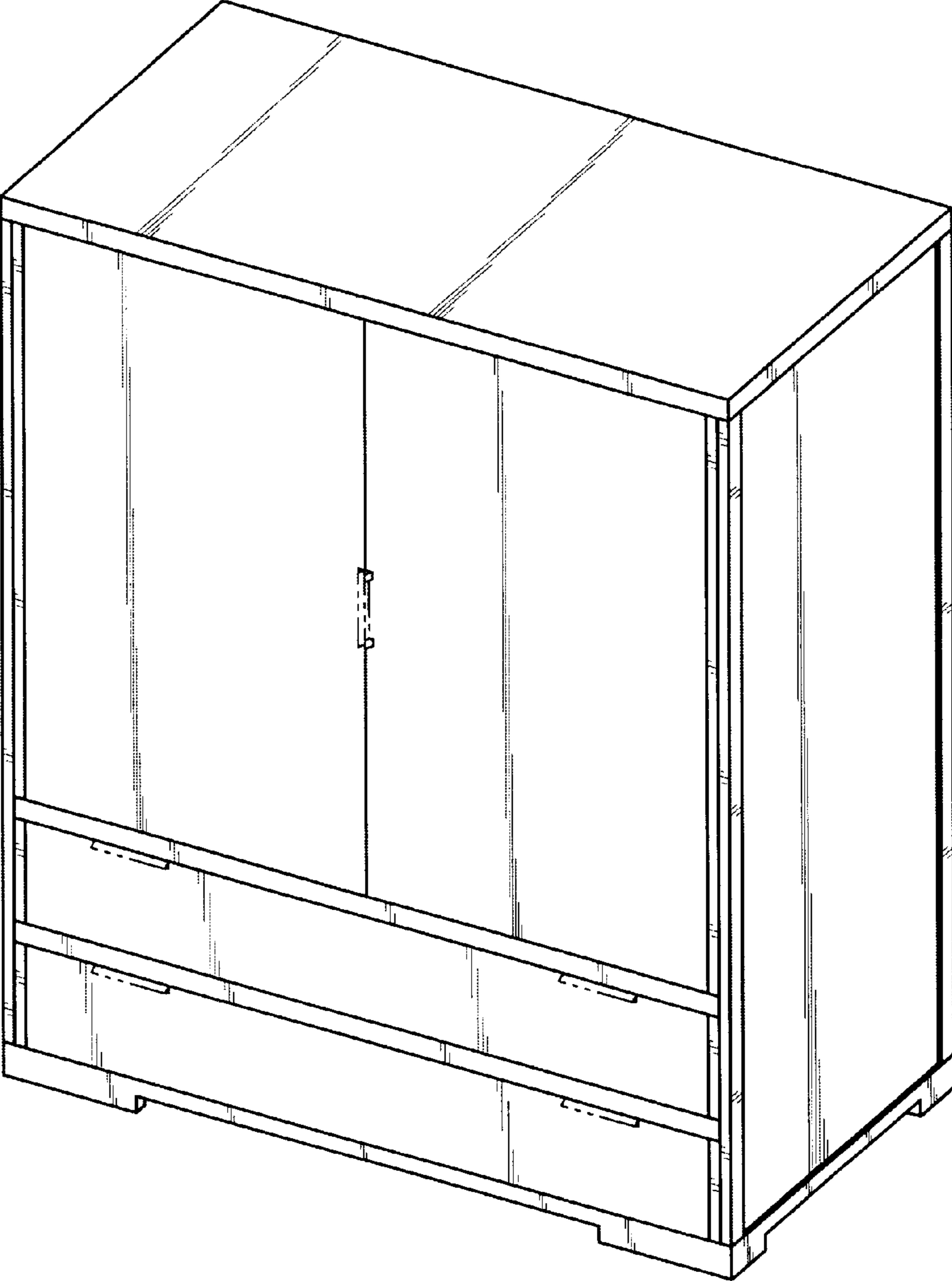
FIG. 5 is a front view of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 6 is a right-side view of FIG. 1, the left-side view being a mirror image.

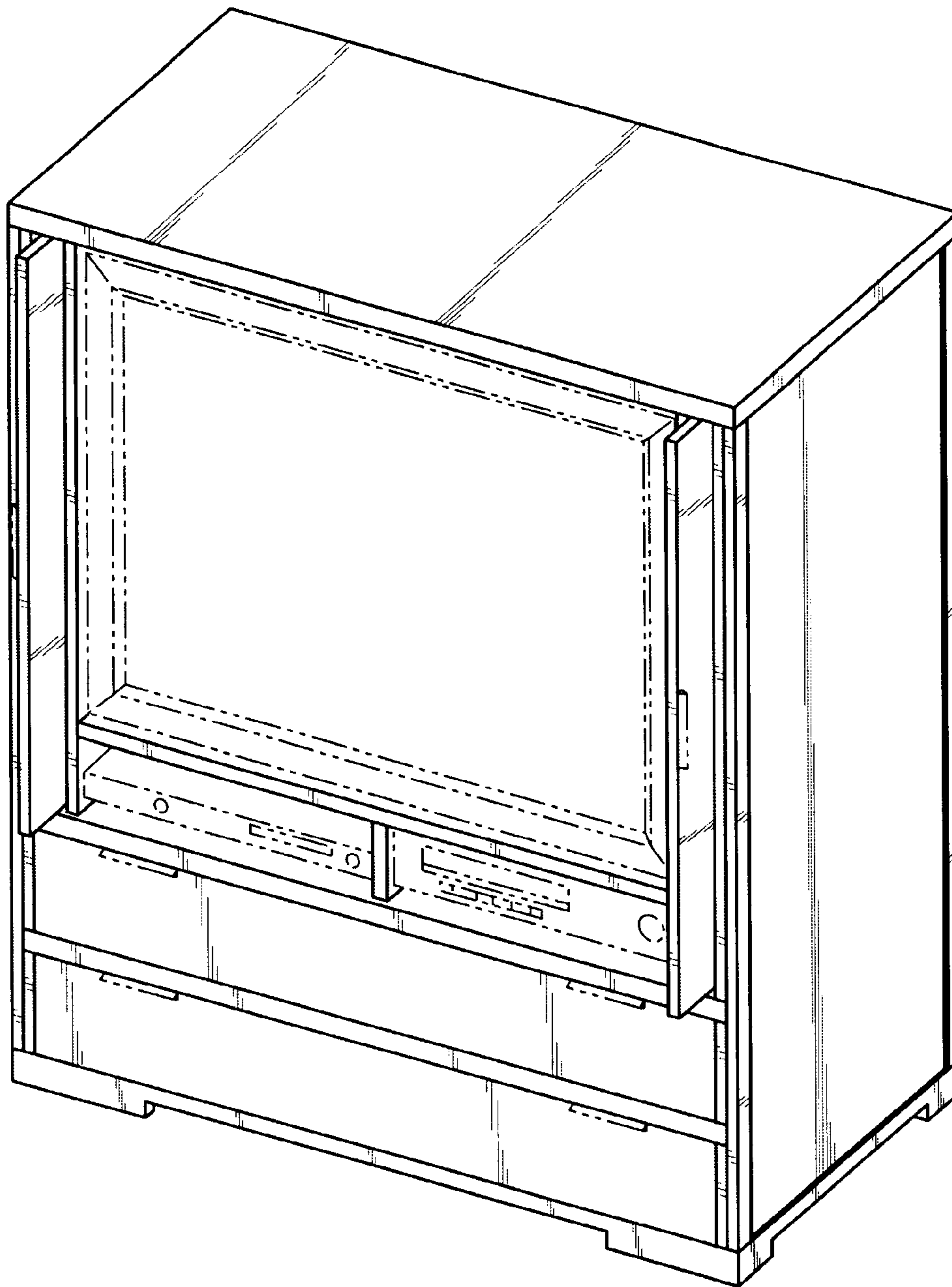
The broken lines showing electronic equipment and handles are illustrative and form no part of the claimed design.

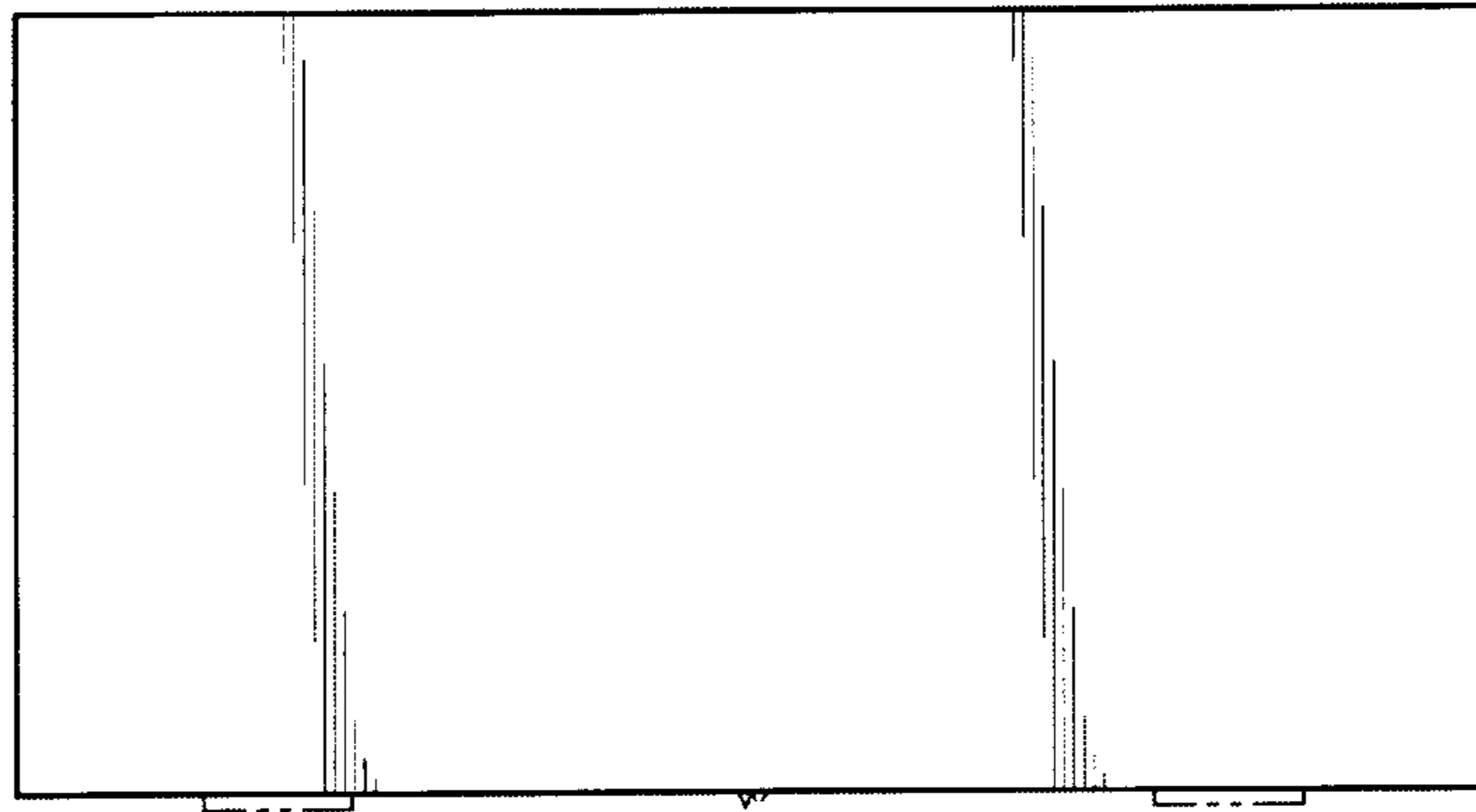




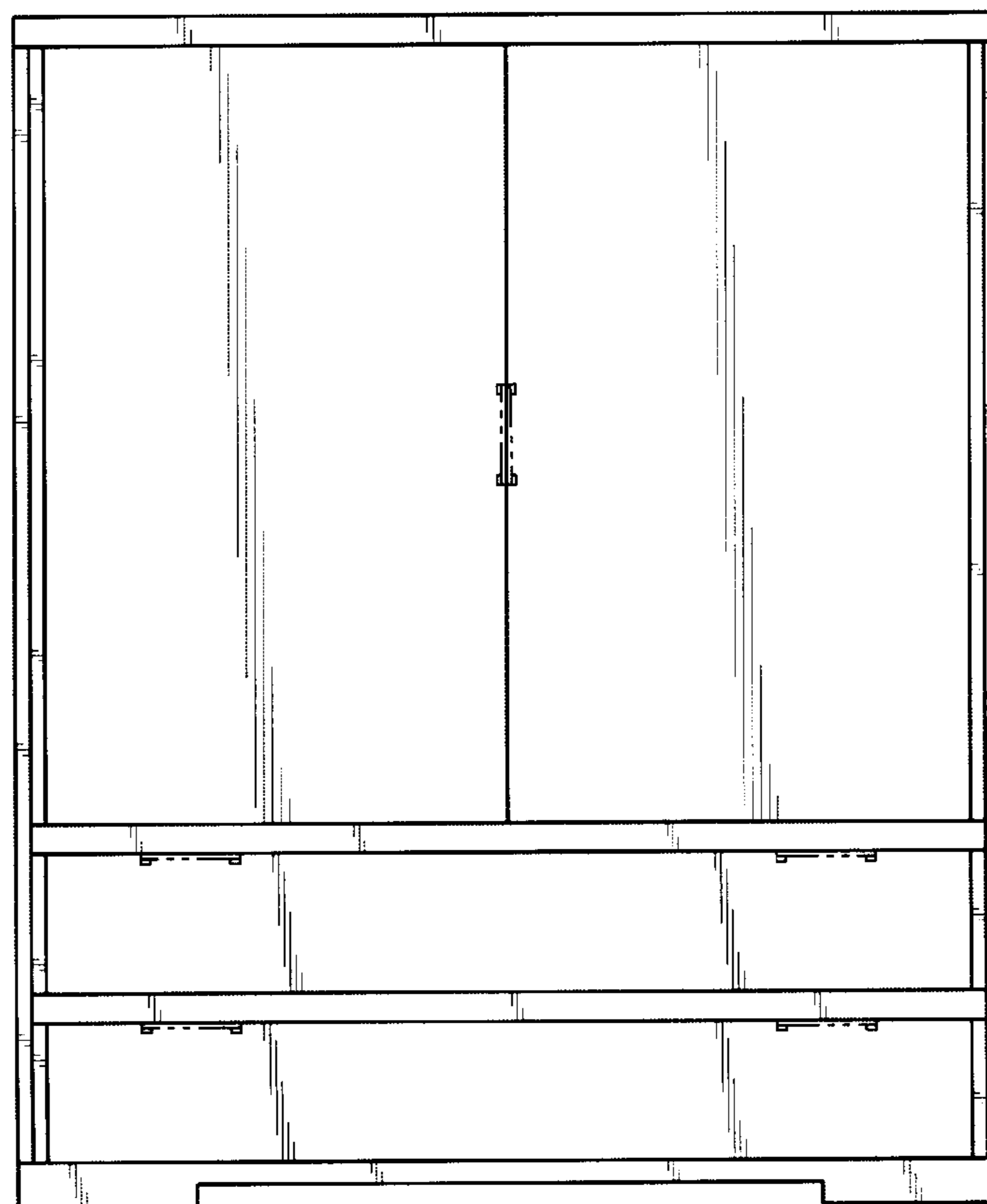

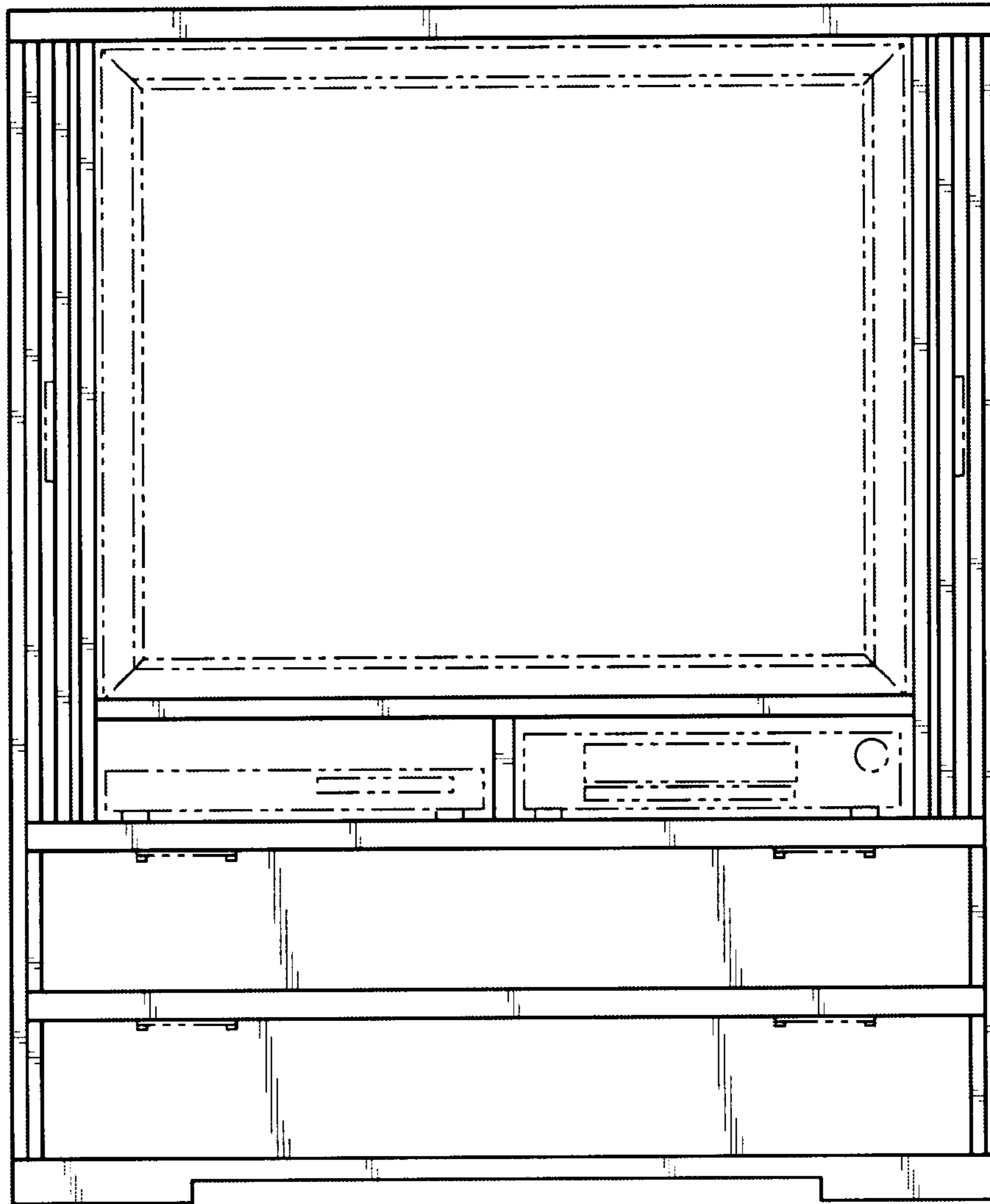

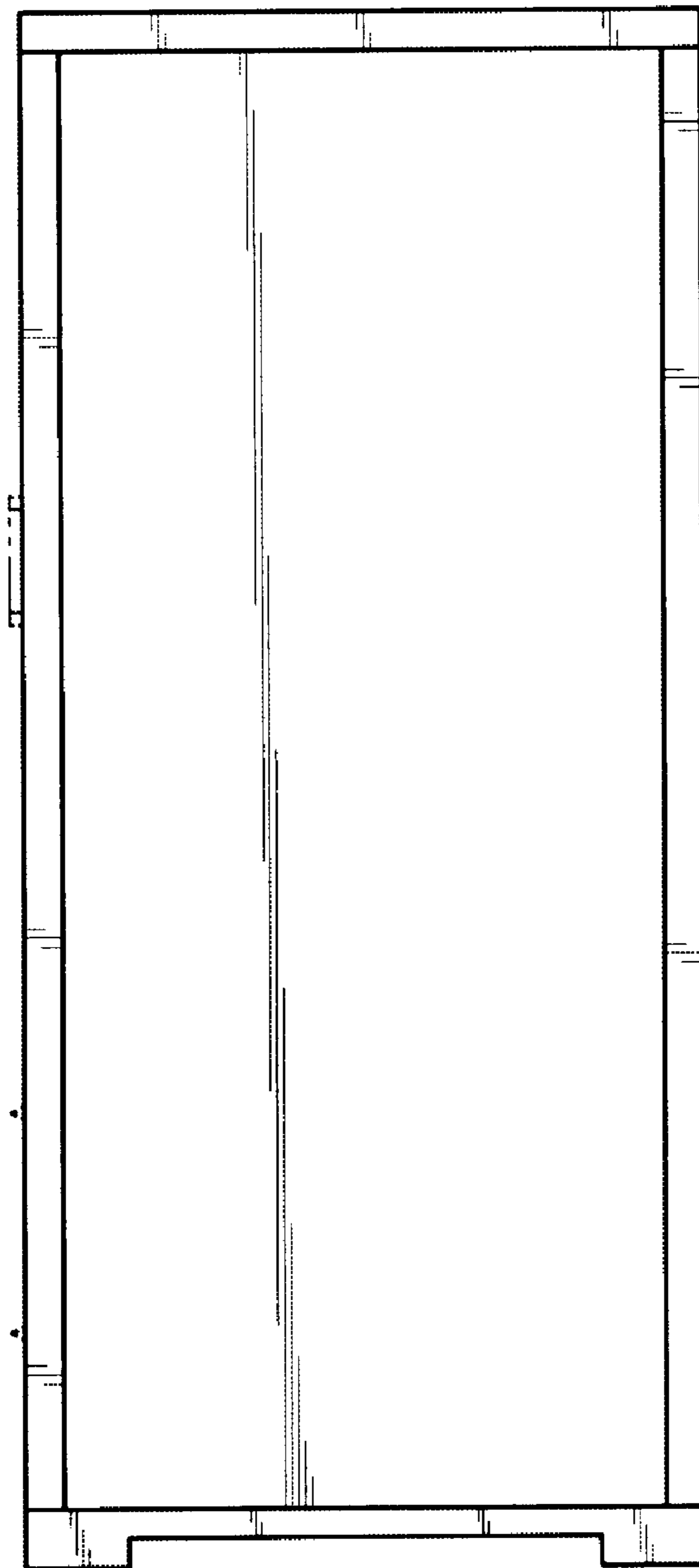
