DESCRIPTION

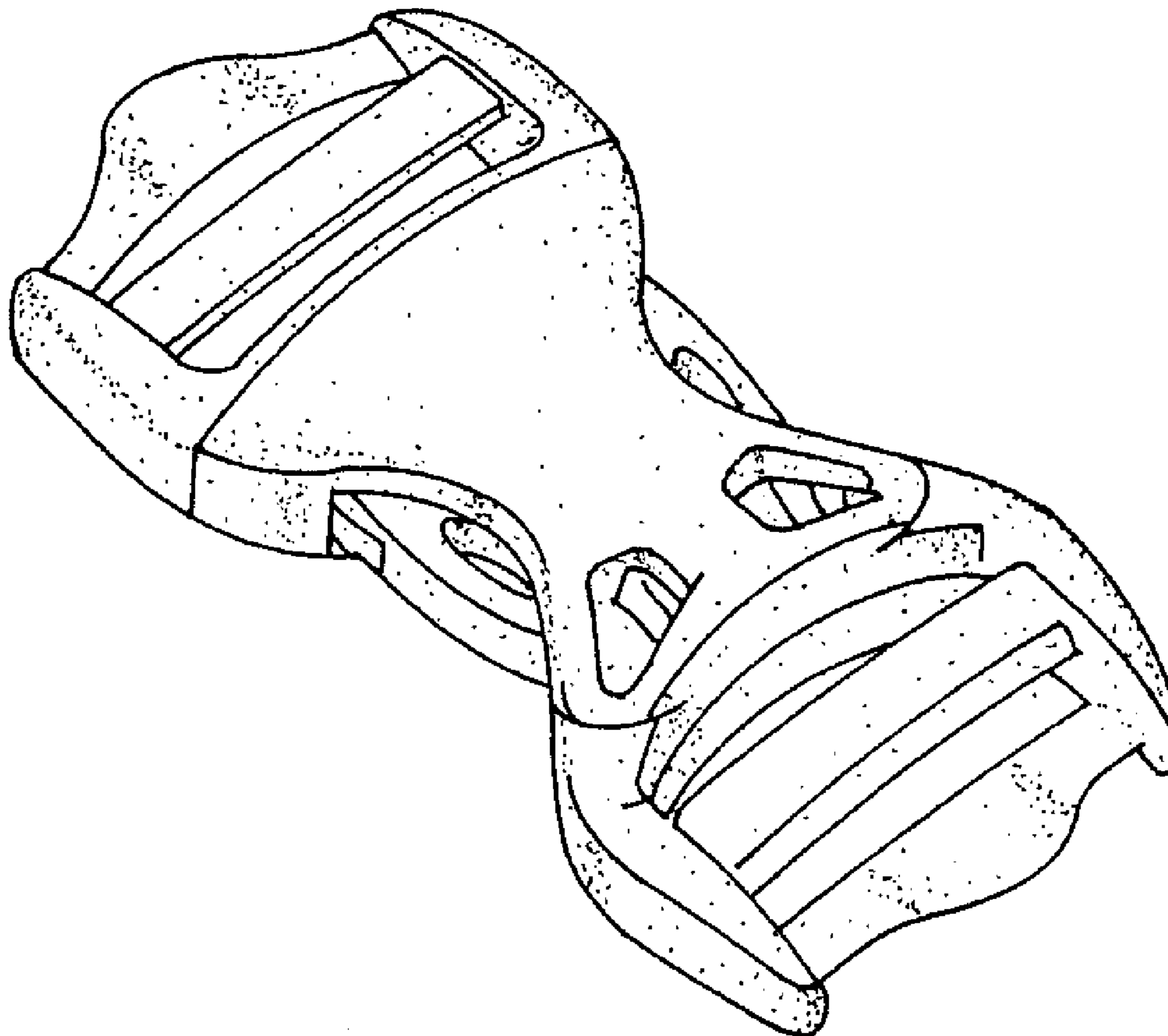
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a buckle showing my new design;

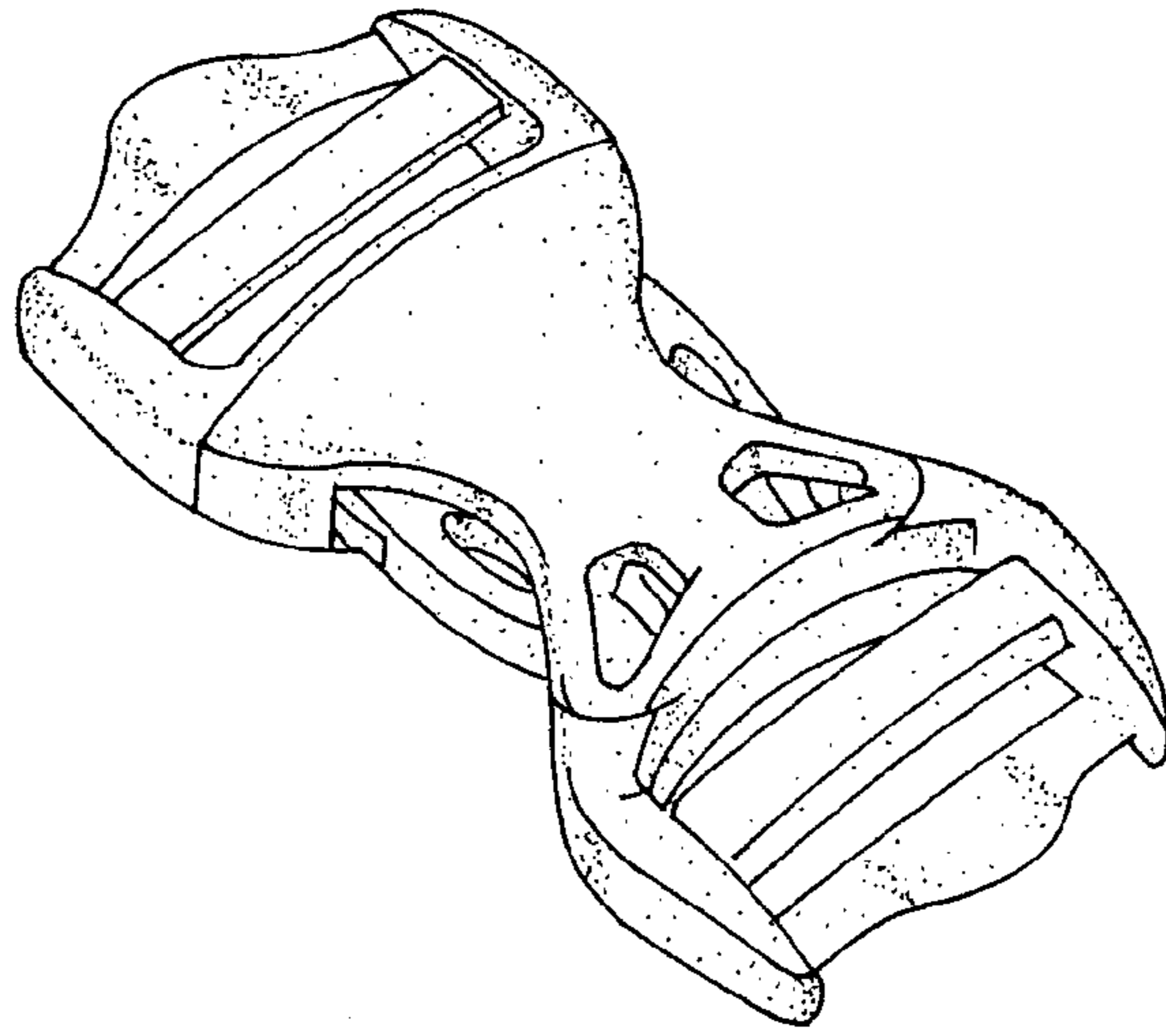

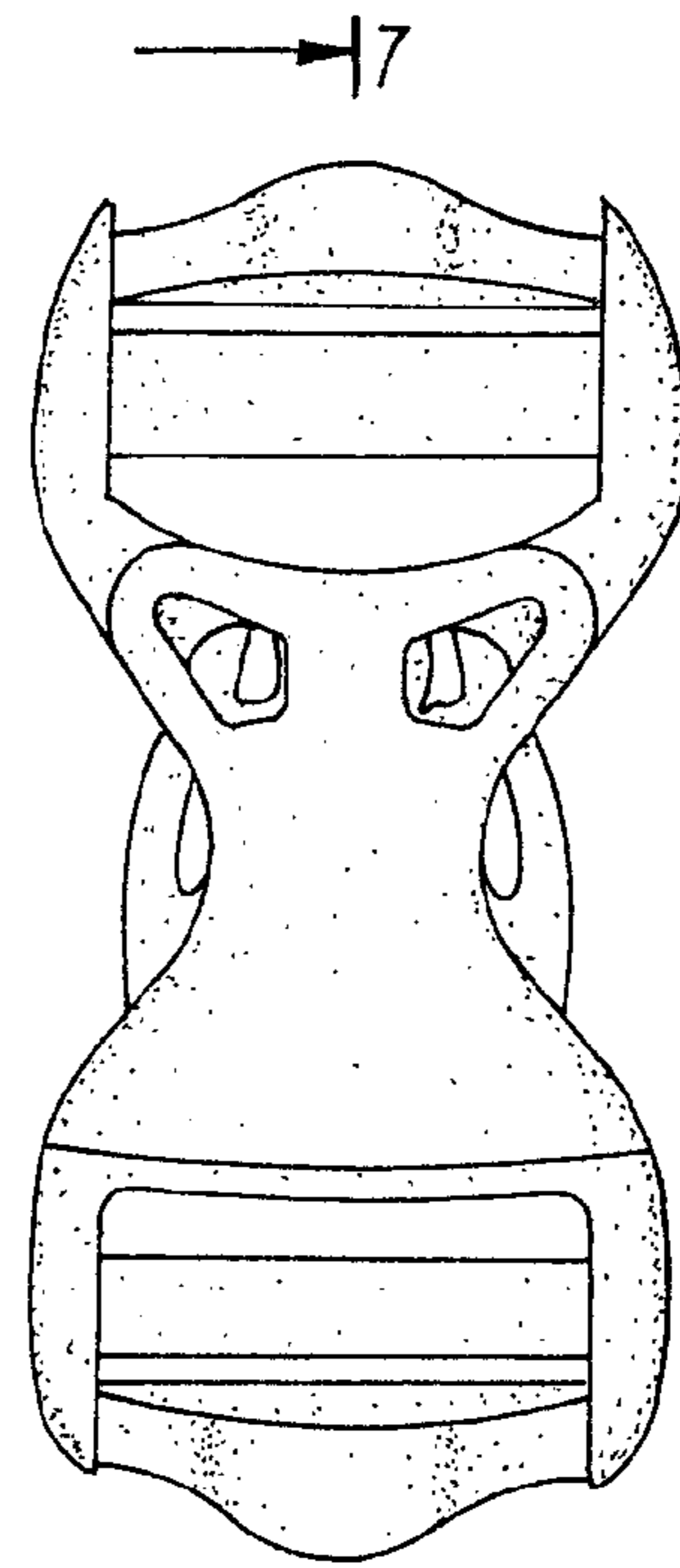

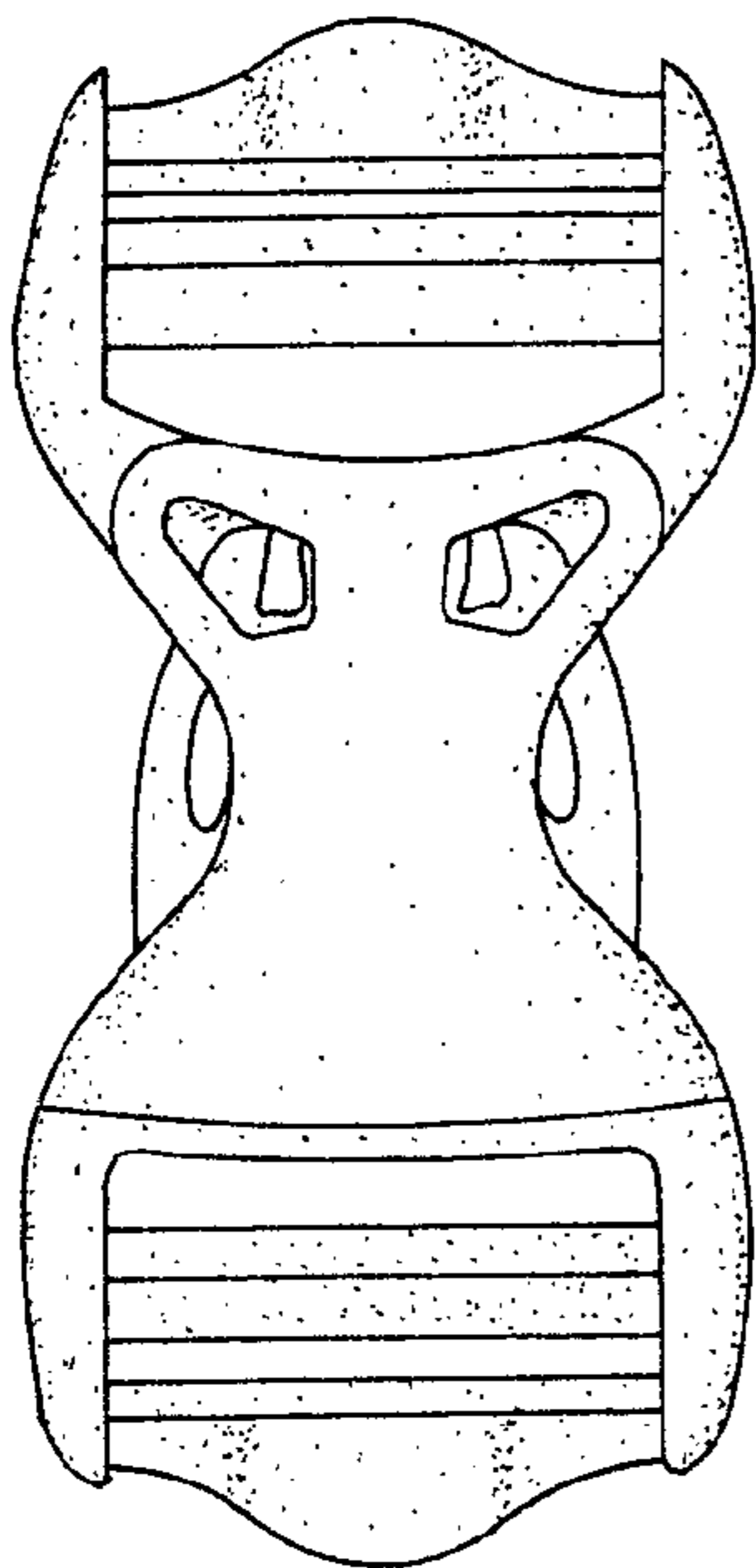

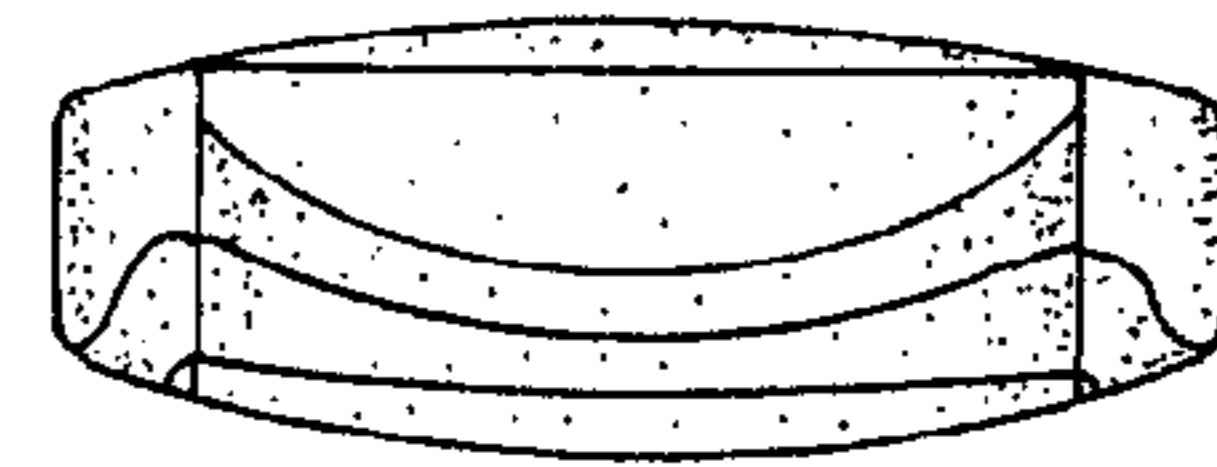

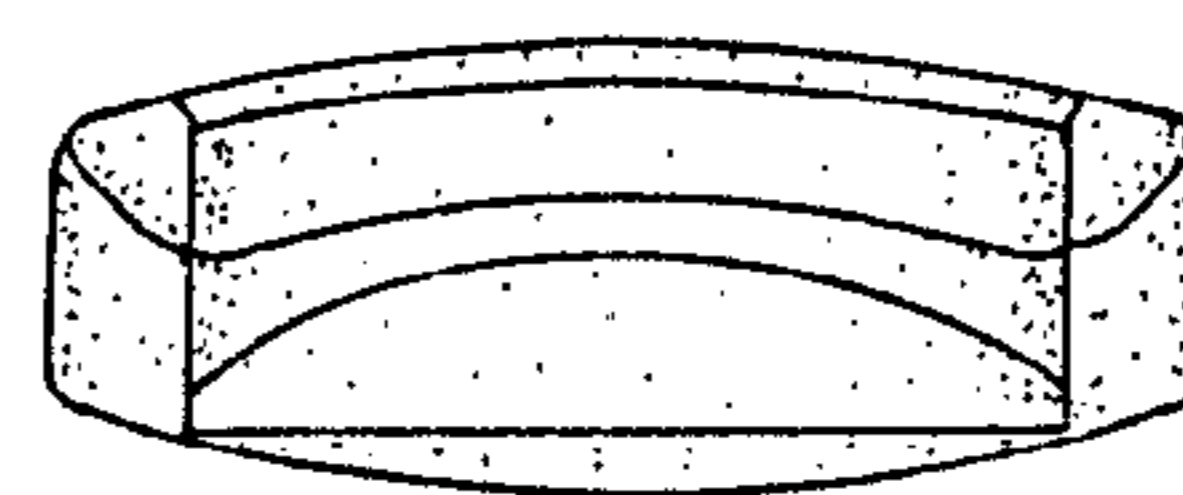
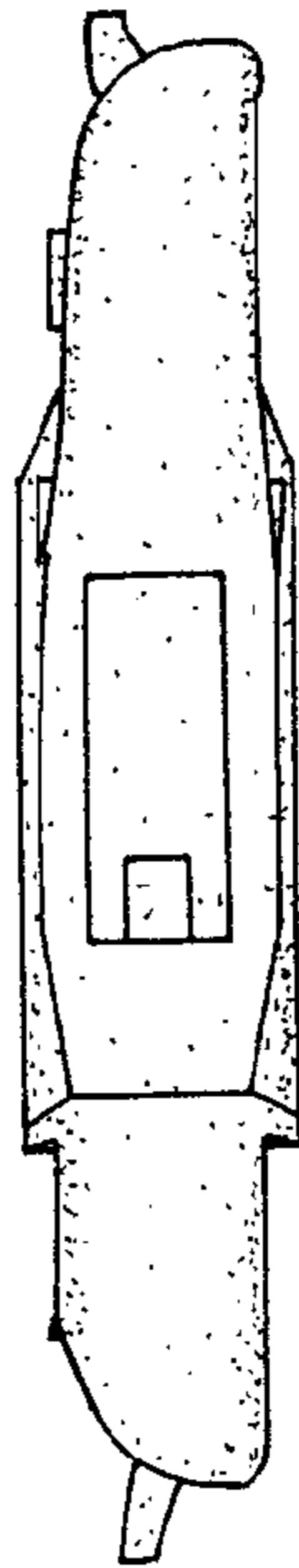

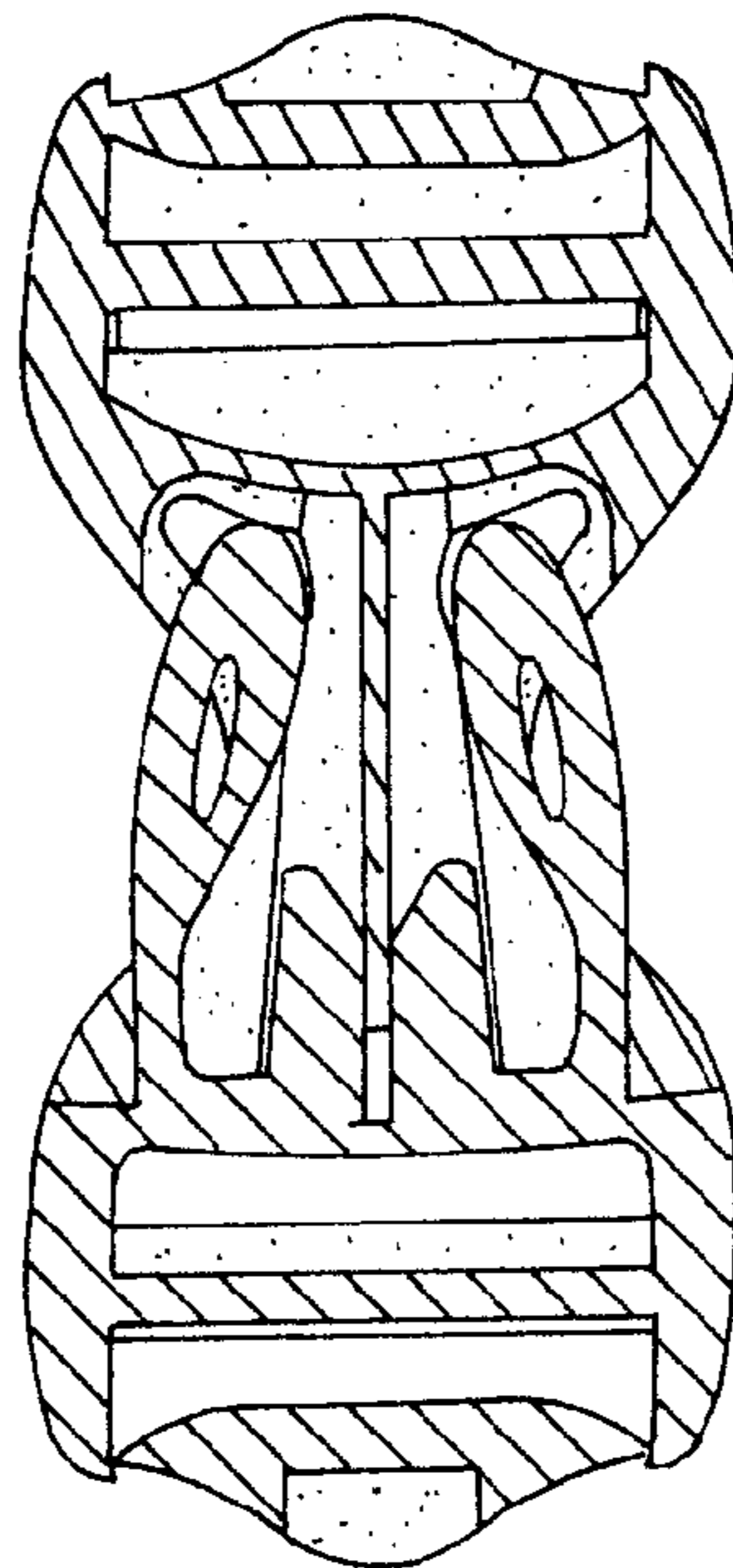
