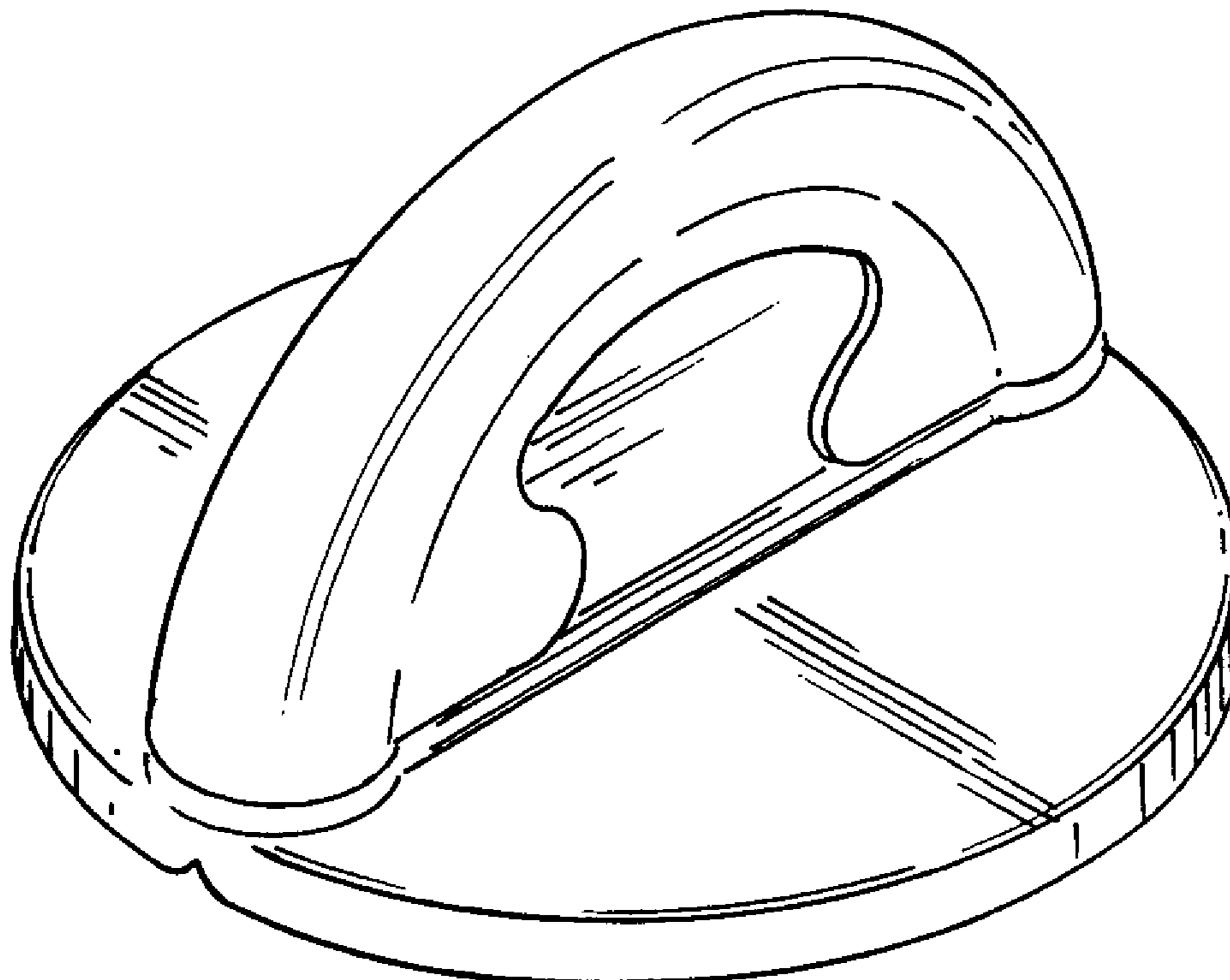

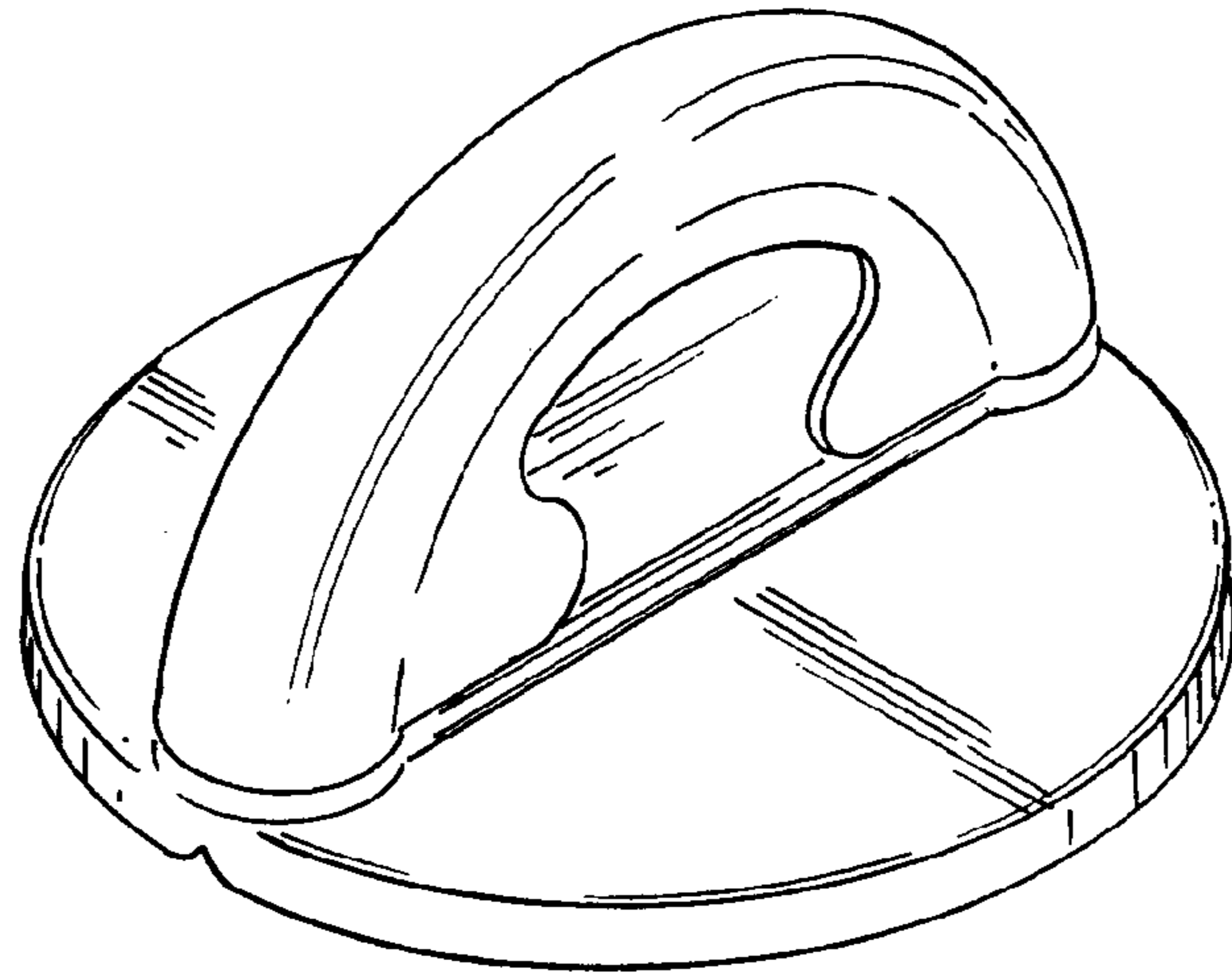
The ornamental design for a duster holder, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

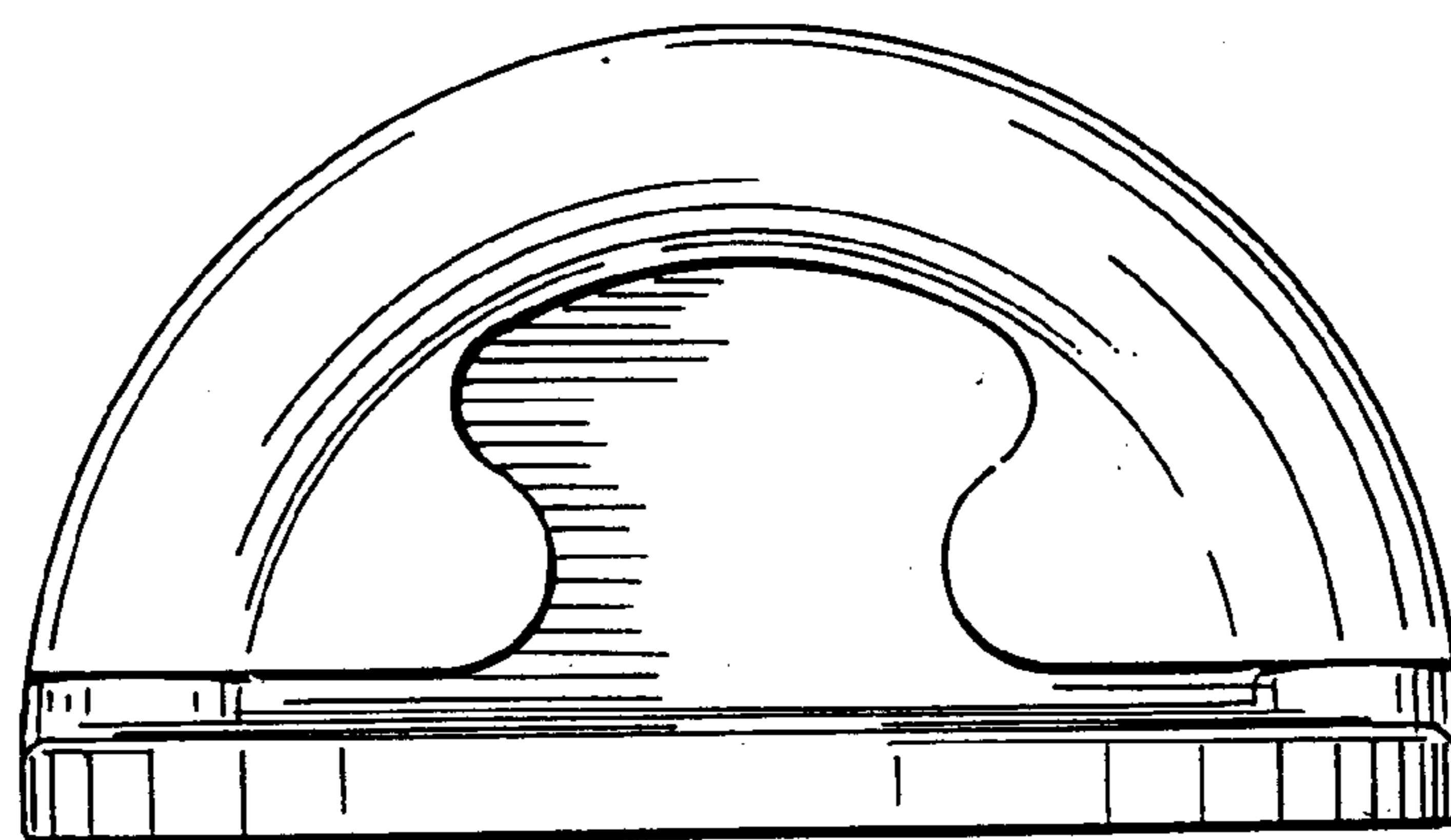
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a duster holder showing my new design;

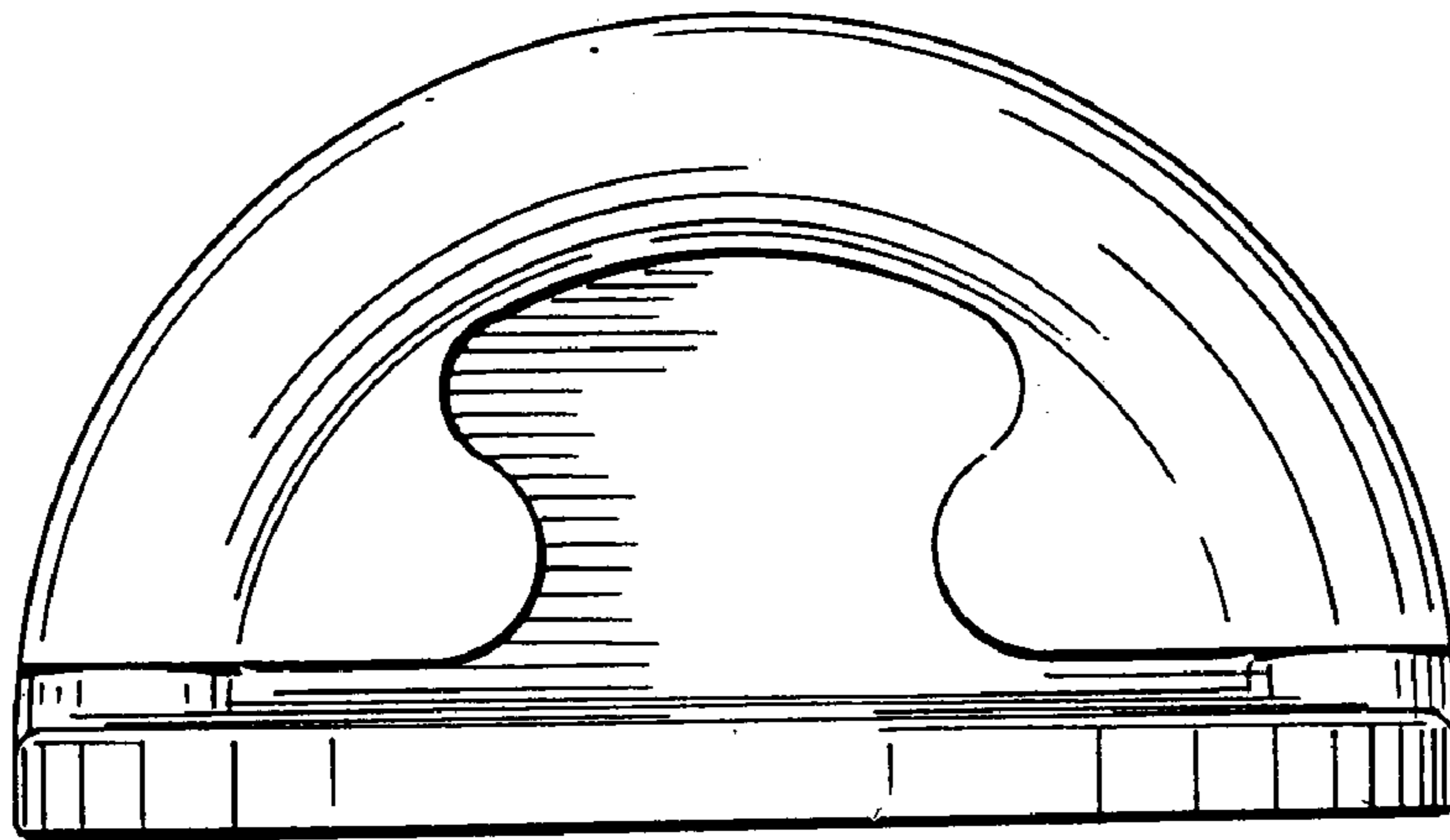




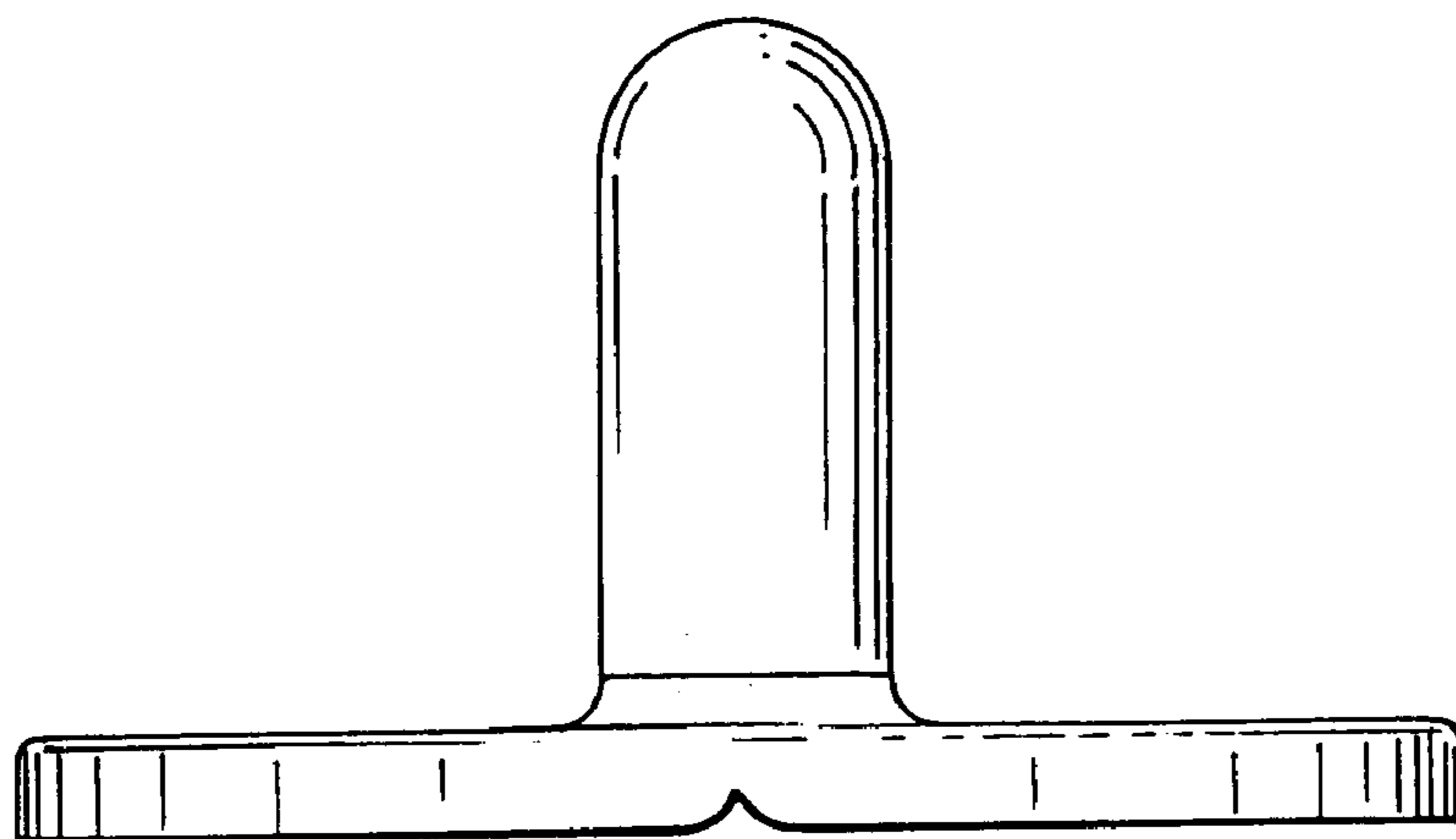

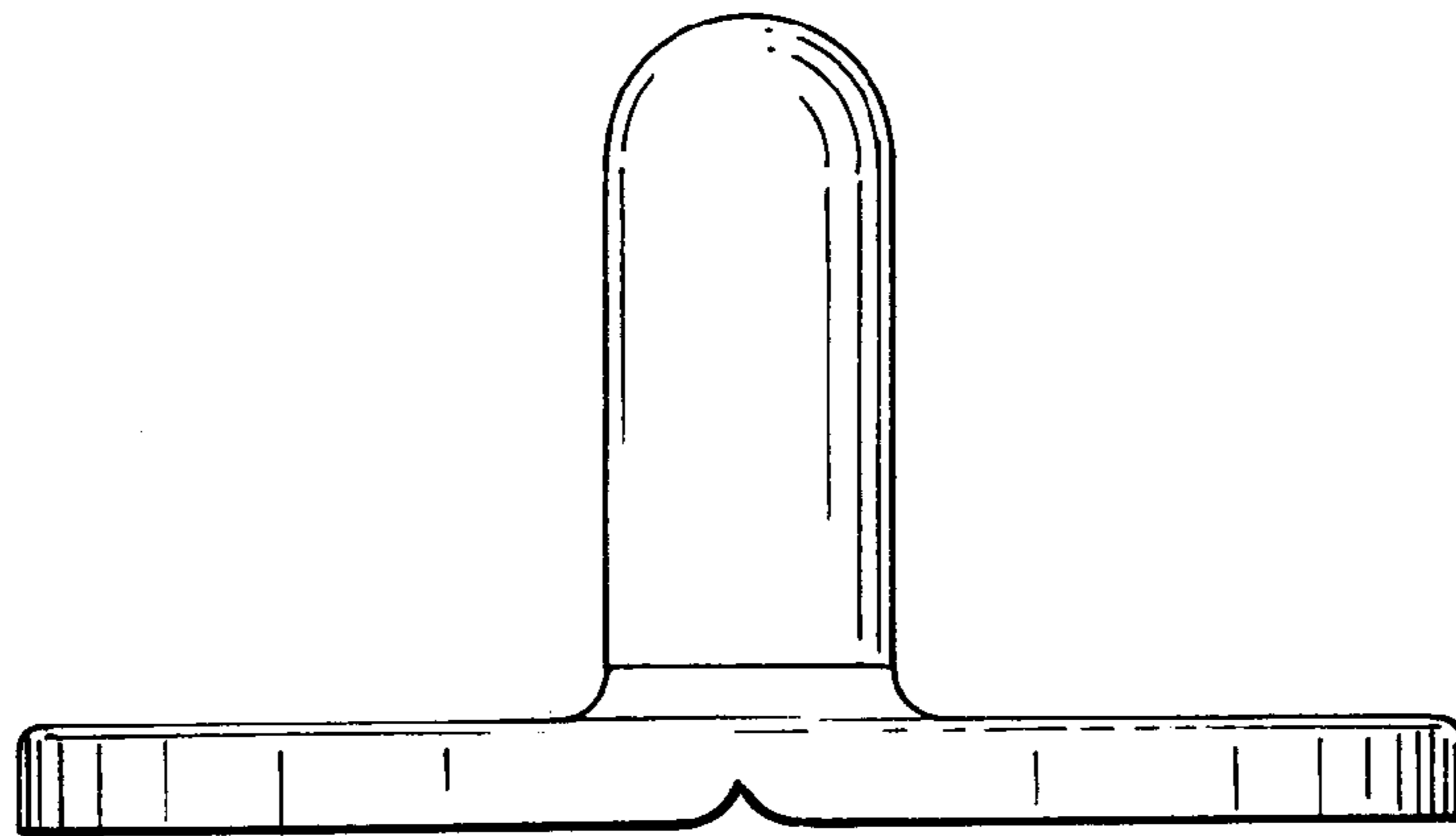

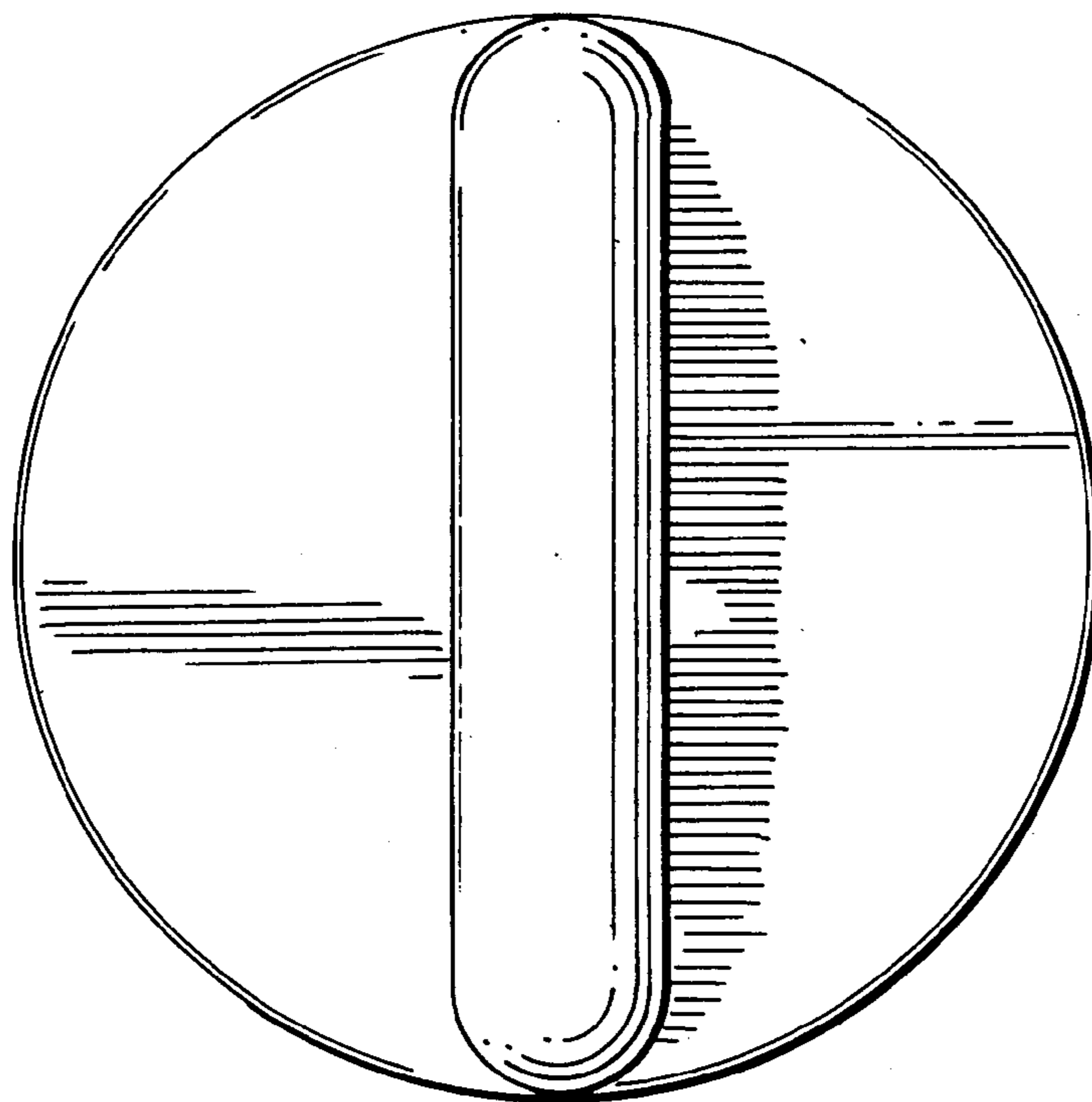

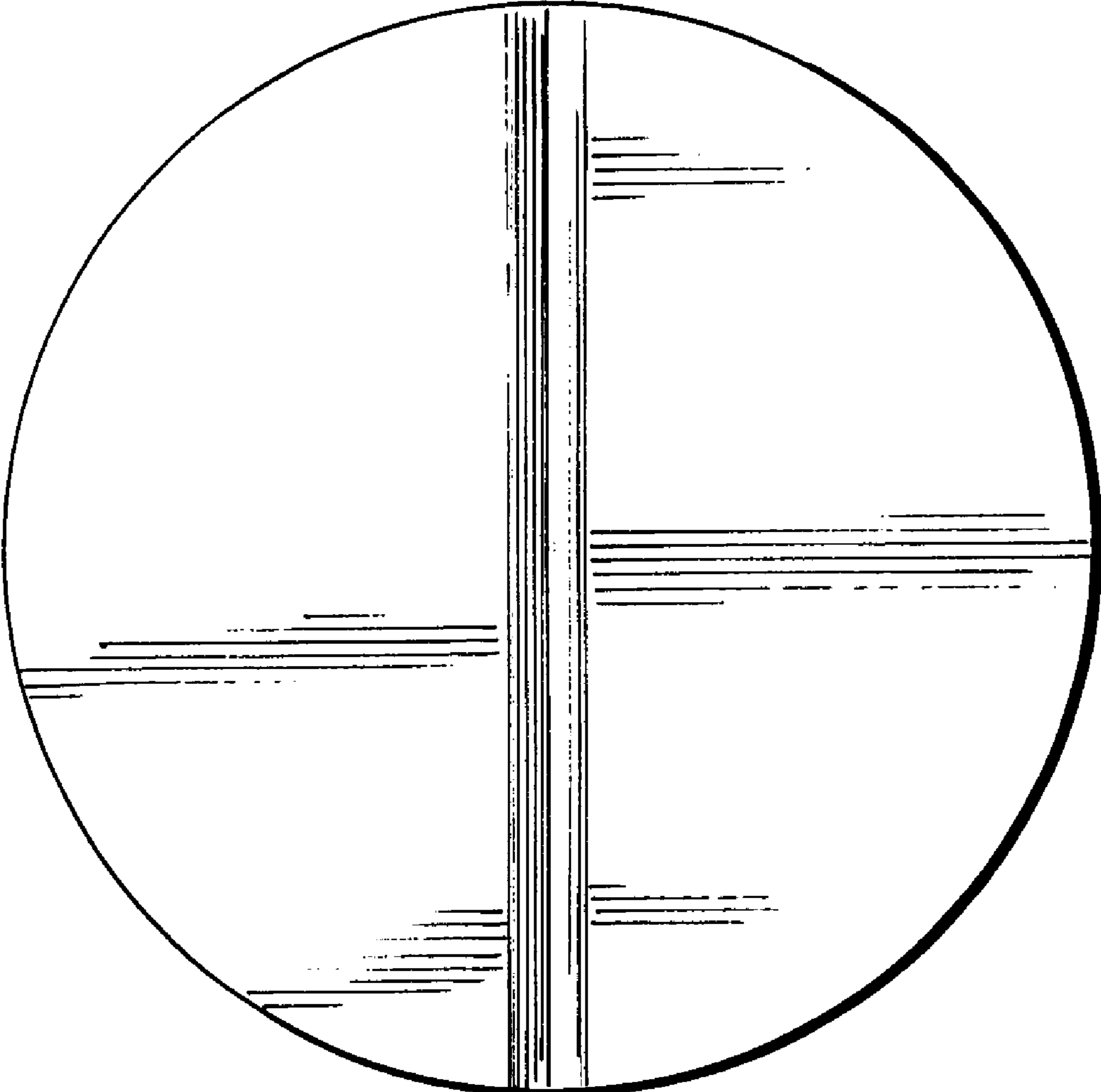
