I claim the ornamental design for mat for golf training, as
shown and described in the drawings.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a mat for golf training
in accordance with the new design, the mat including a circle
mark for placing a ball thereon and a triangular or indication
mark for aiding aiming of a golf shot;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a plan view thereof;

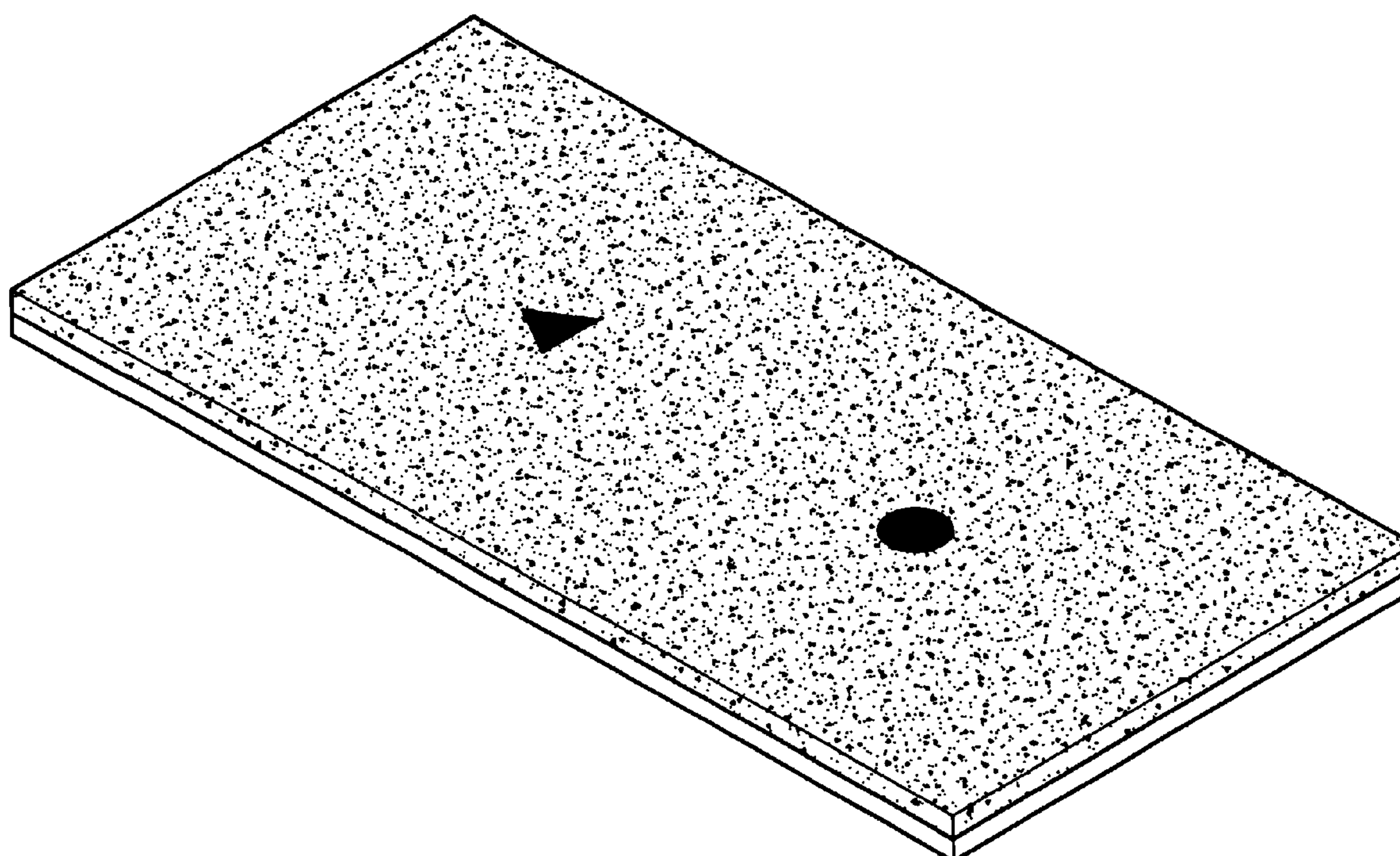

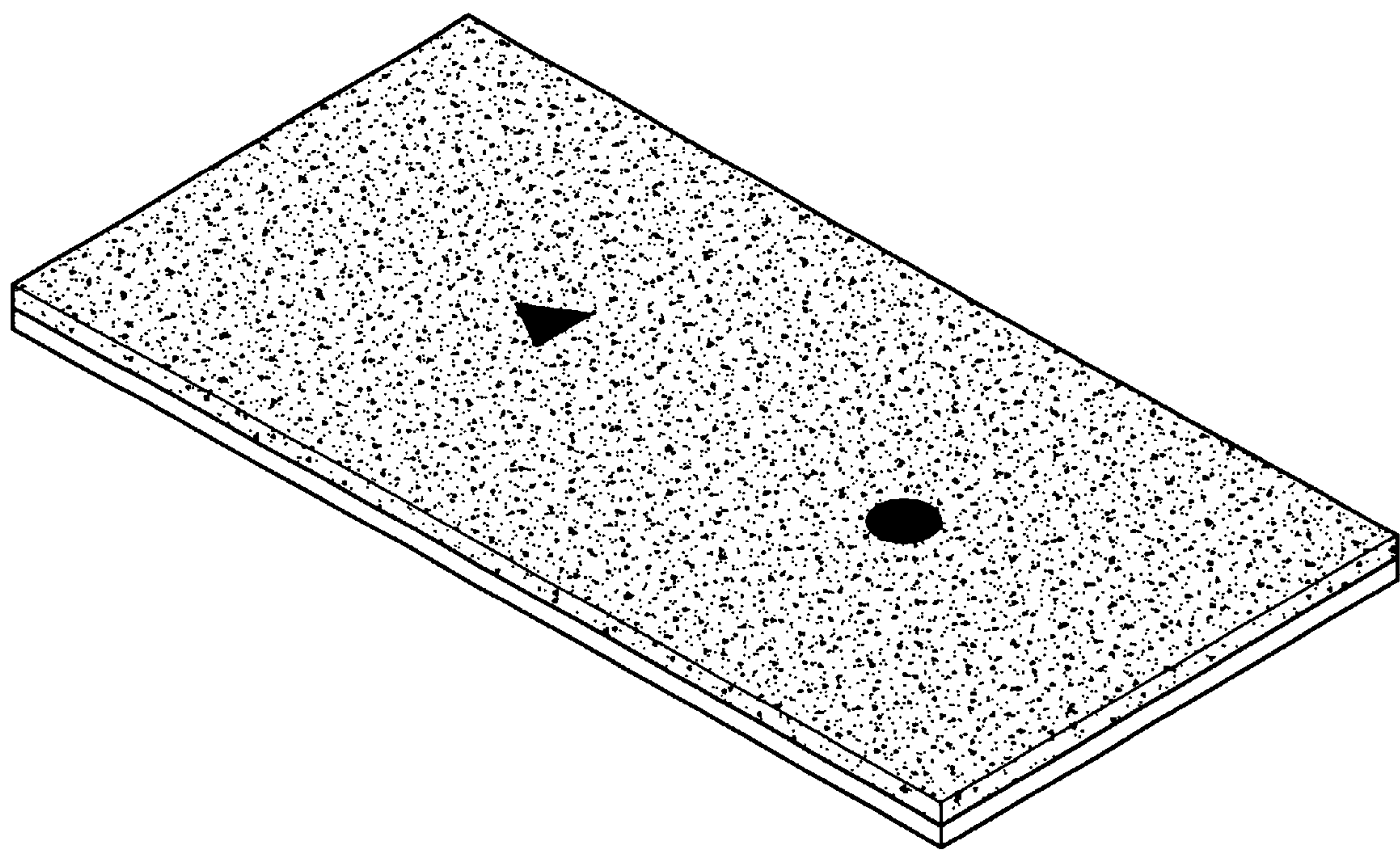

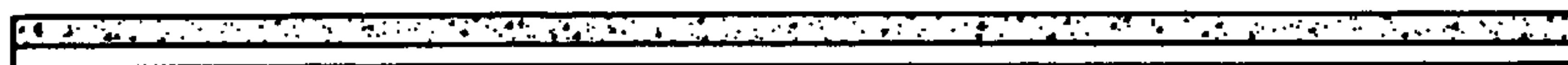

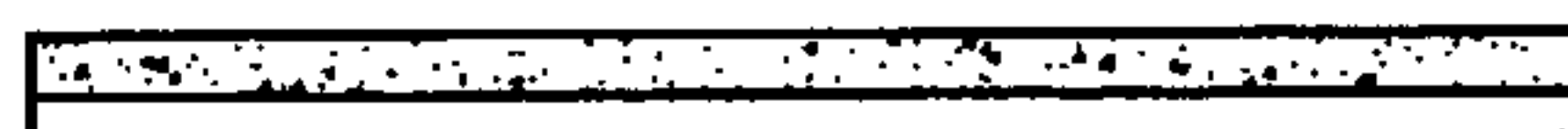

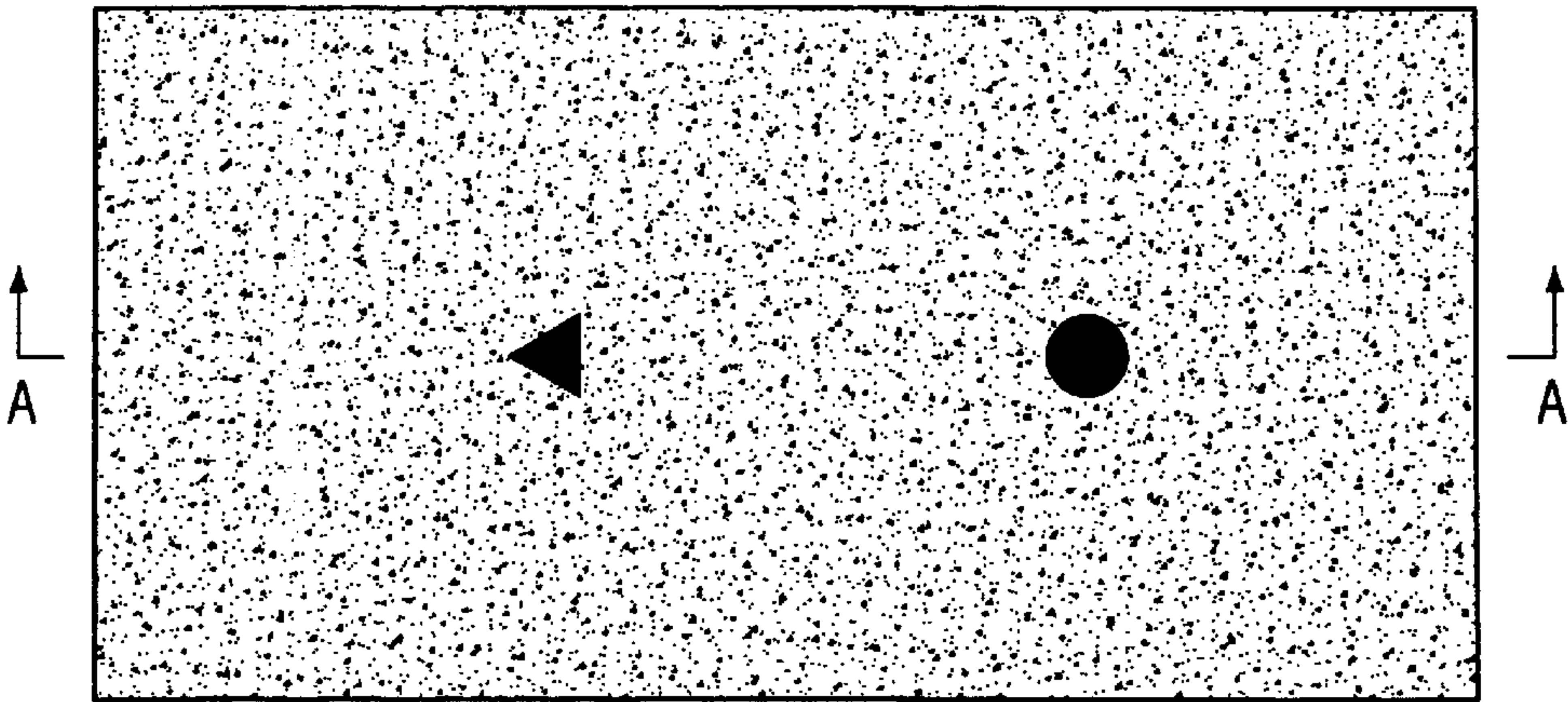

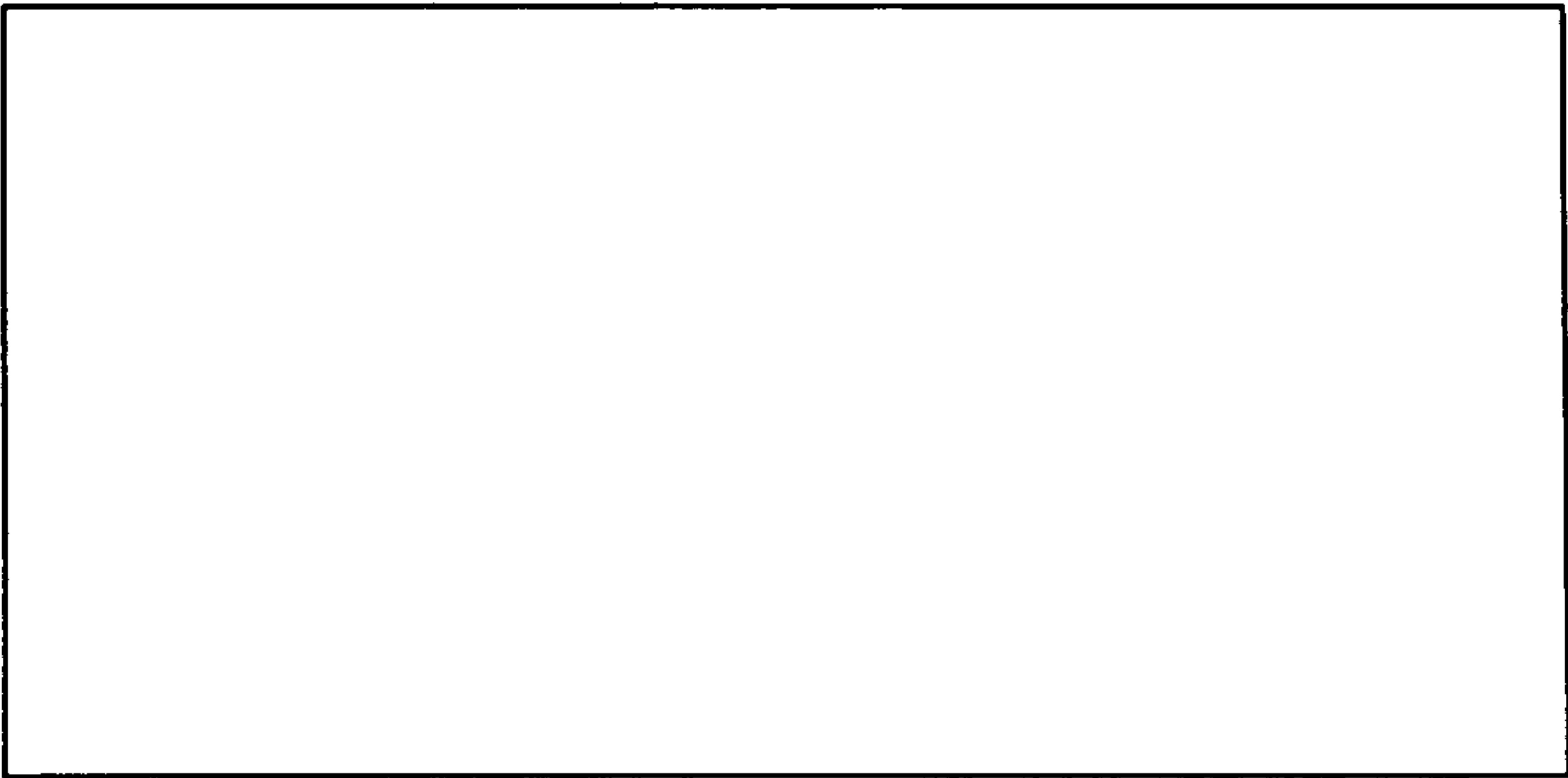
