The ornamental design for a housing portion of a power inverter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view of the new design for a housing portion of a power inverter.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the new design of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the new design of FIG. 1.

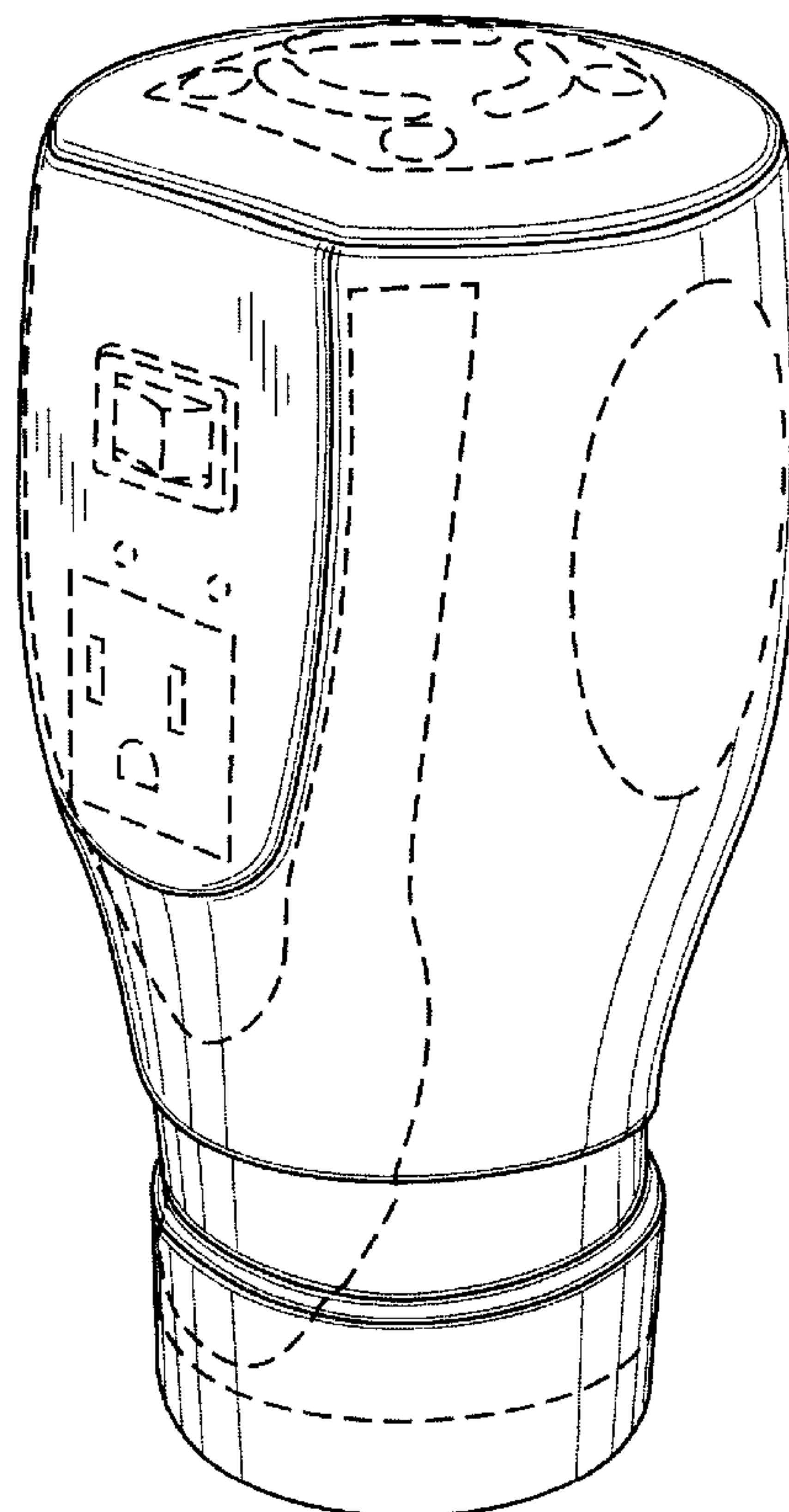
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the new design of FIG. 1.

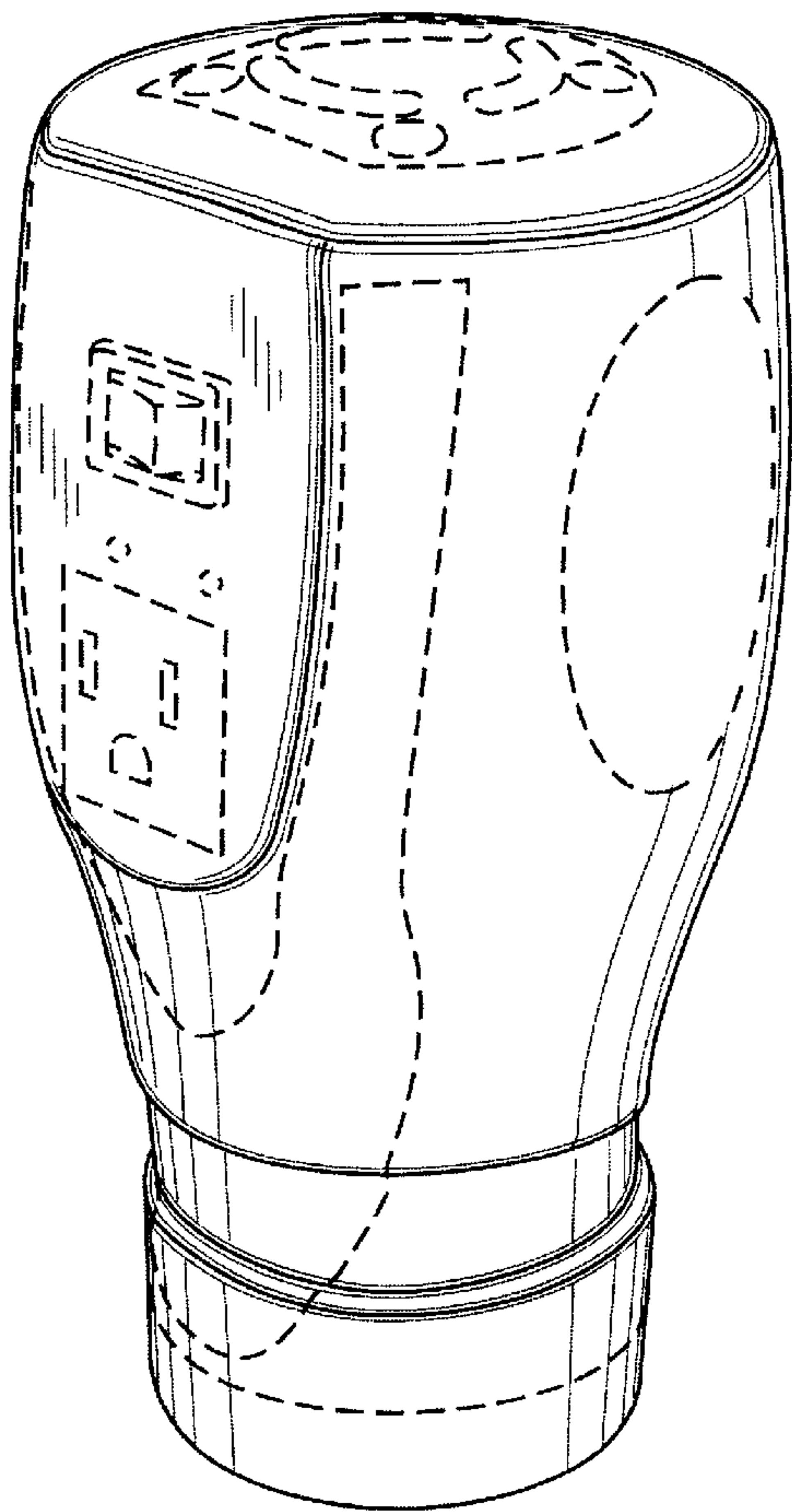

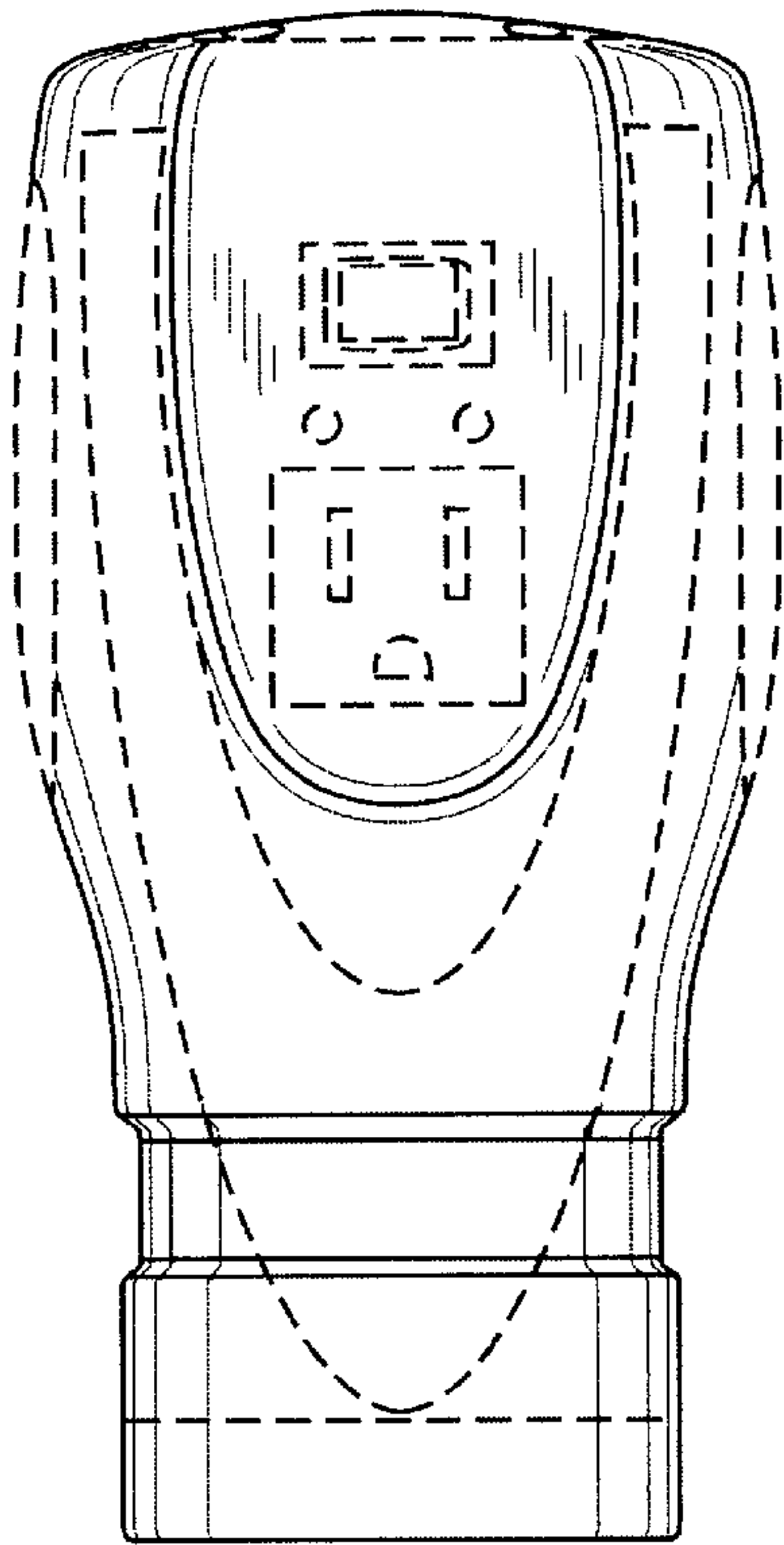

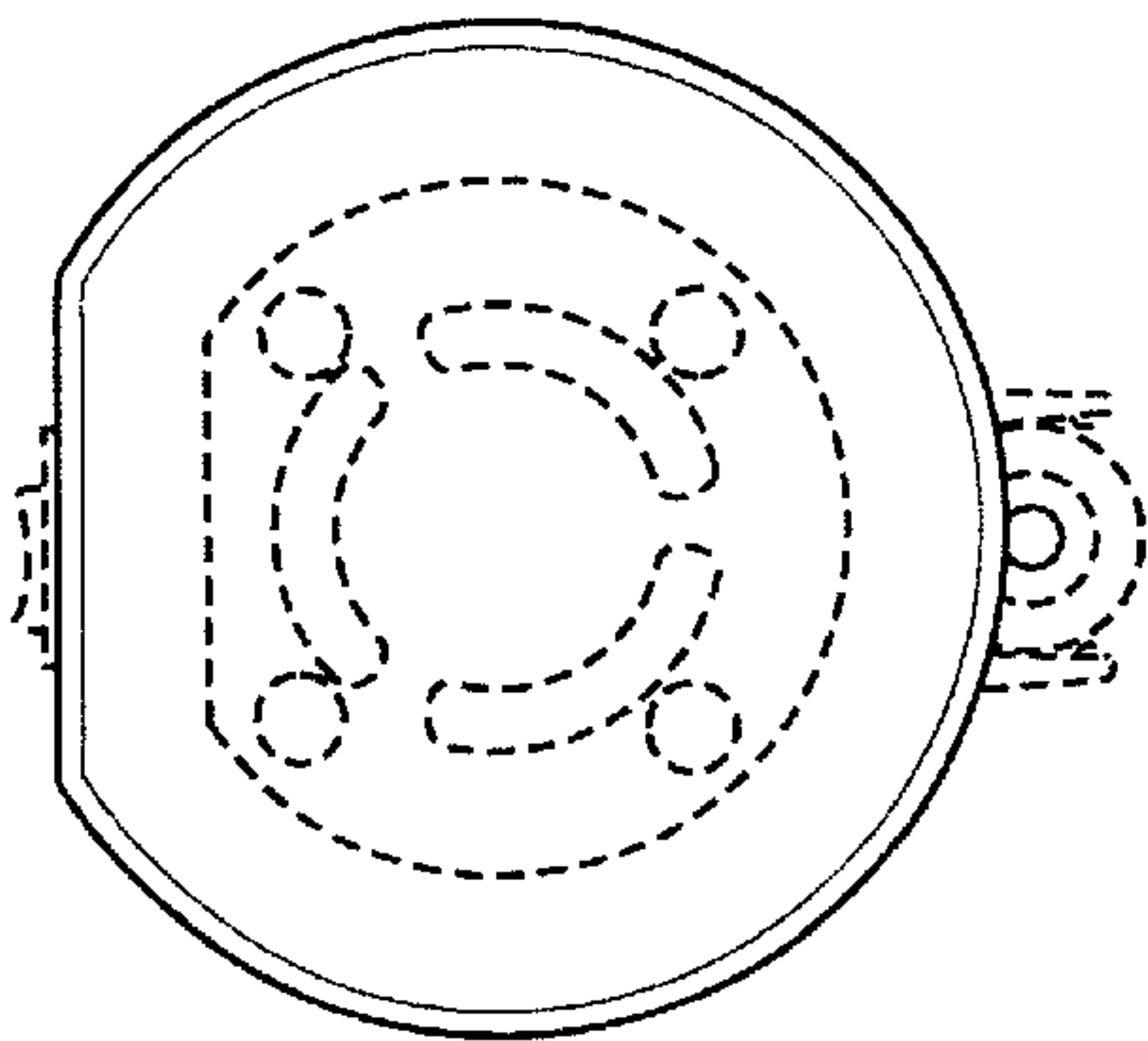

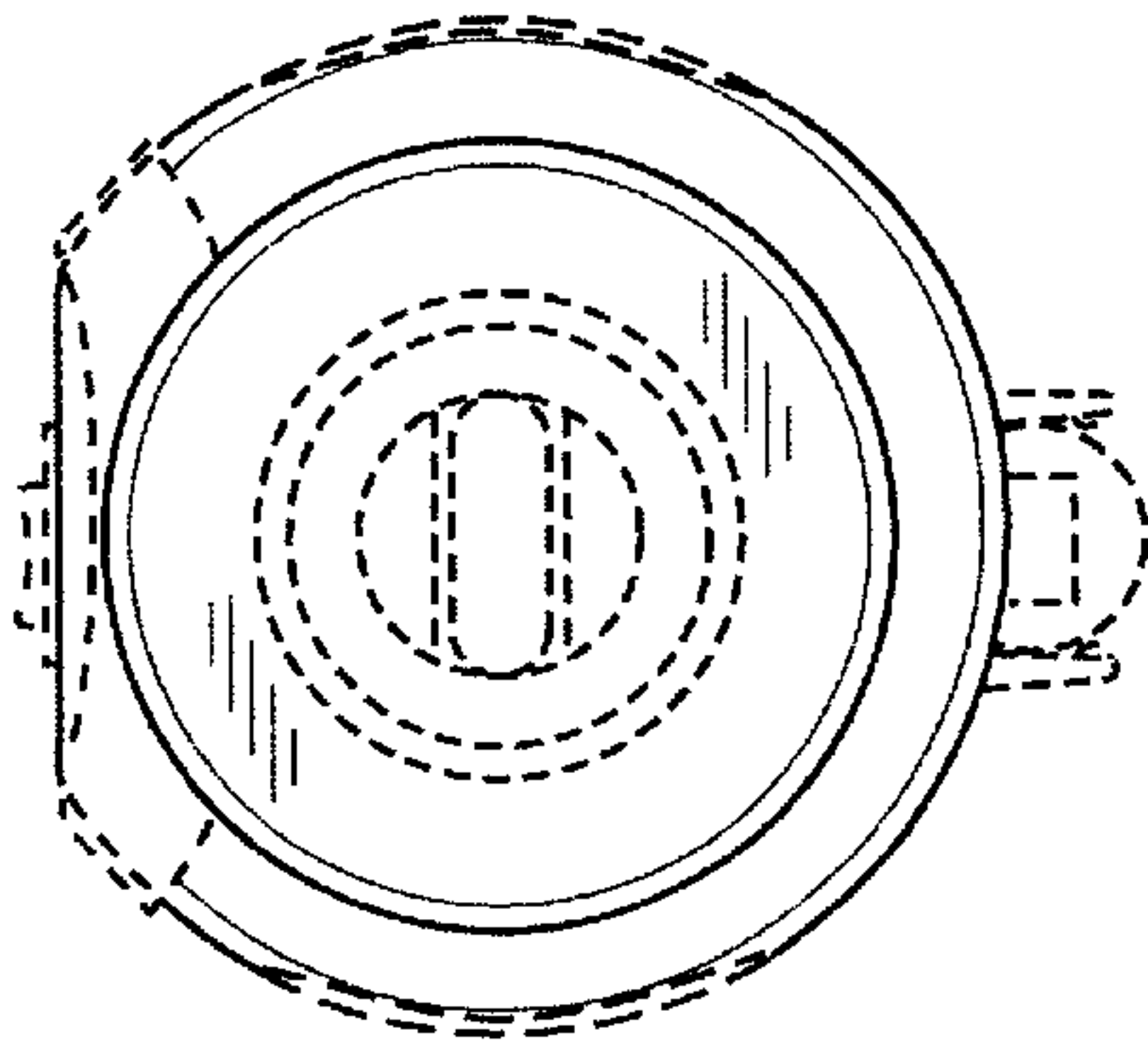

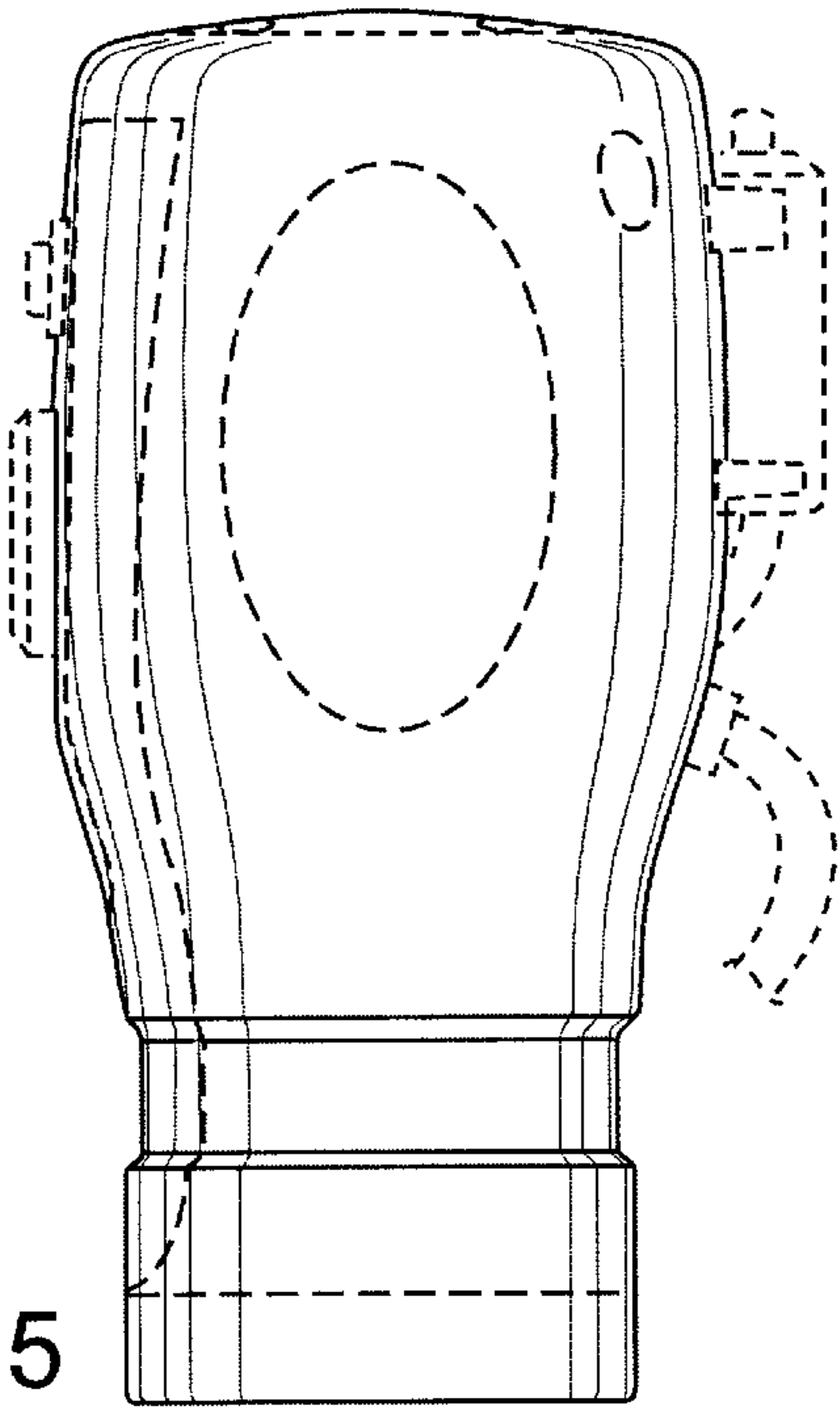

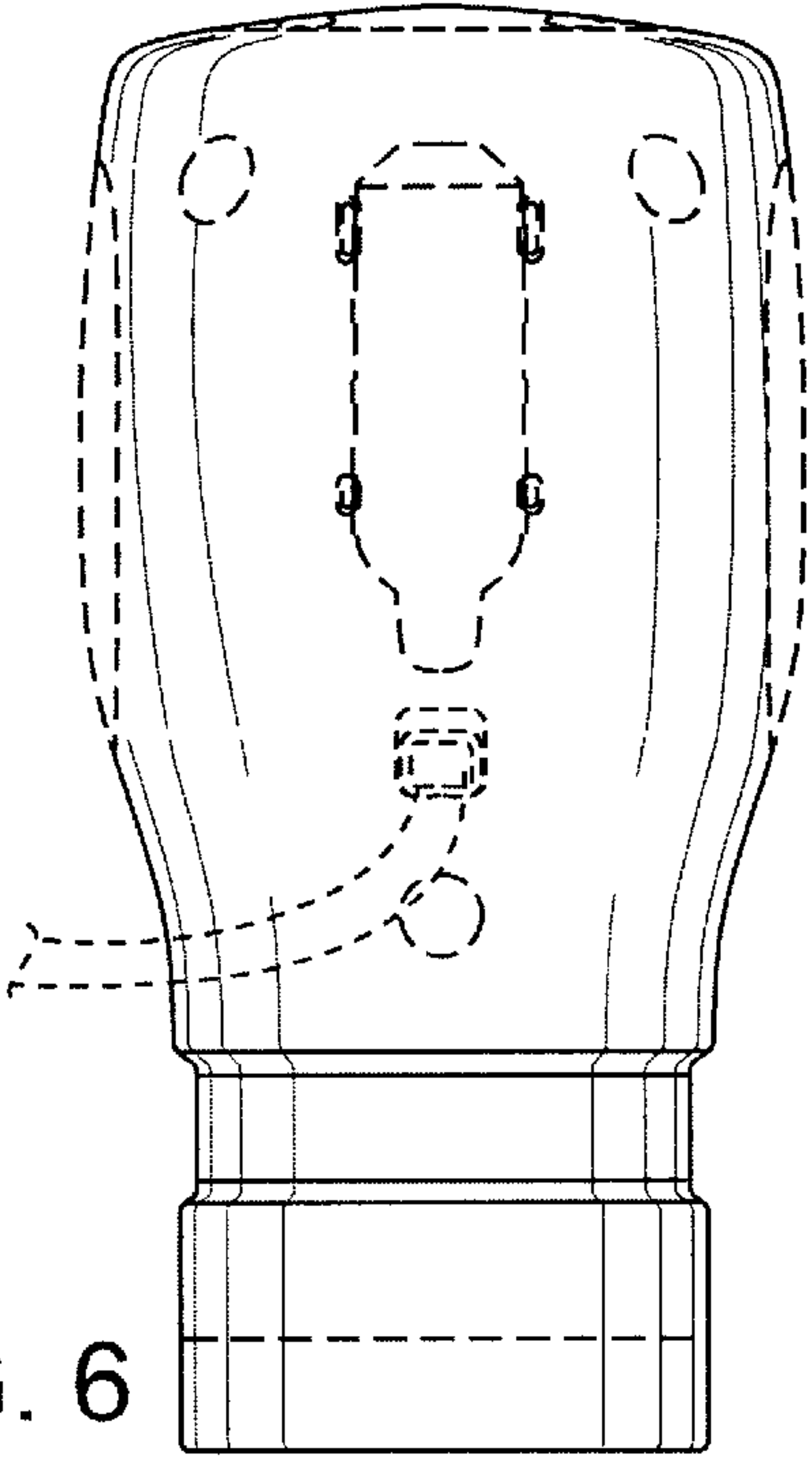
