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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a footwear outsole lug, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a footwear outsole lug showing my new design within the environment it resides. The broken lines showing the remainder of the outsole being understood to represent the portion of the design that forms no part of the claim;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view of the footwear outsole lug showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 3, the right side being a mirror image;

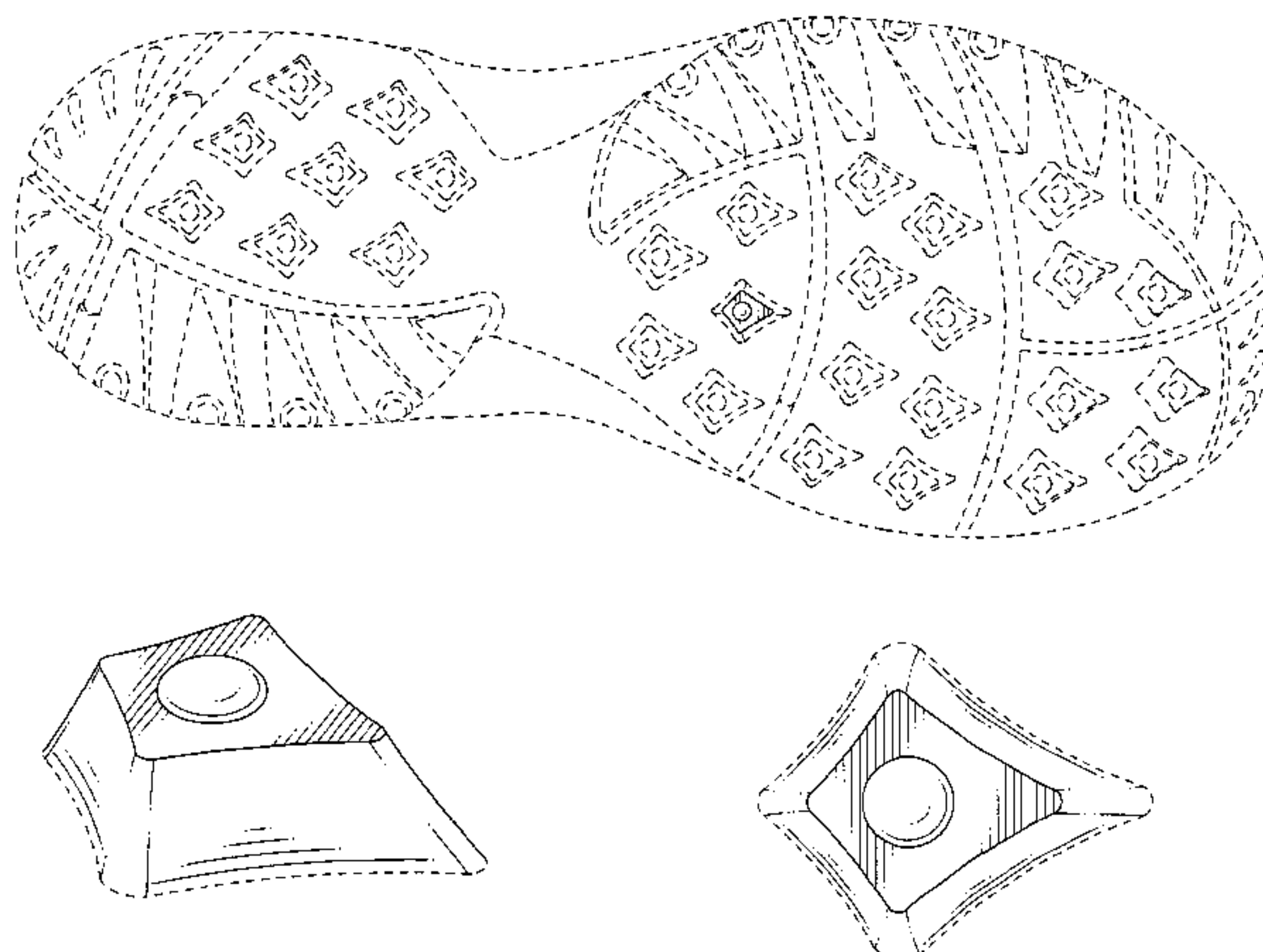
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3; and,

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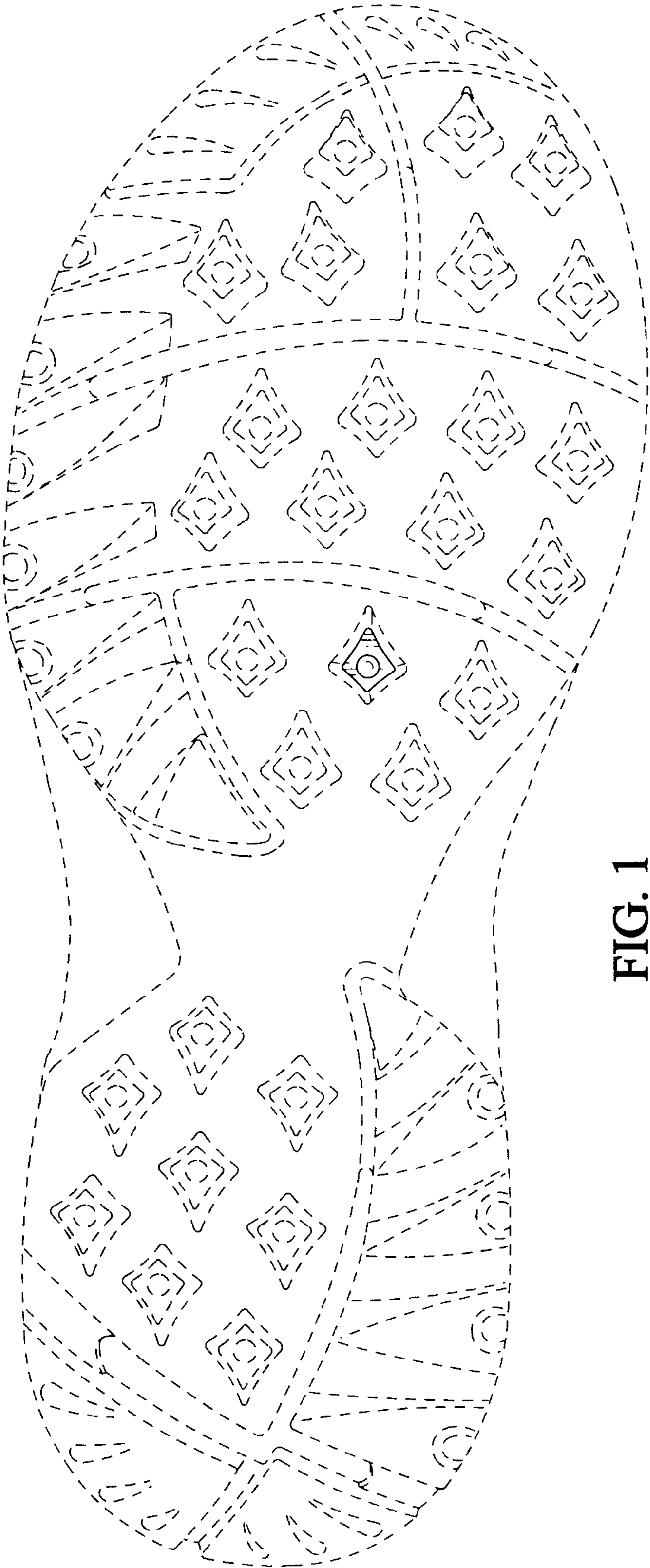

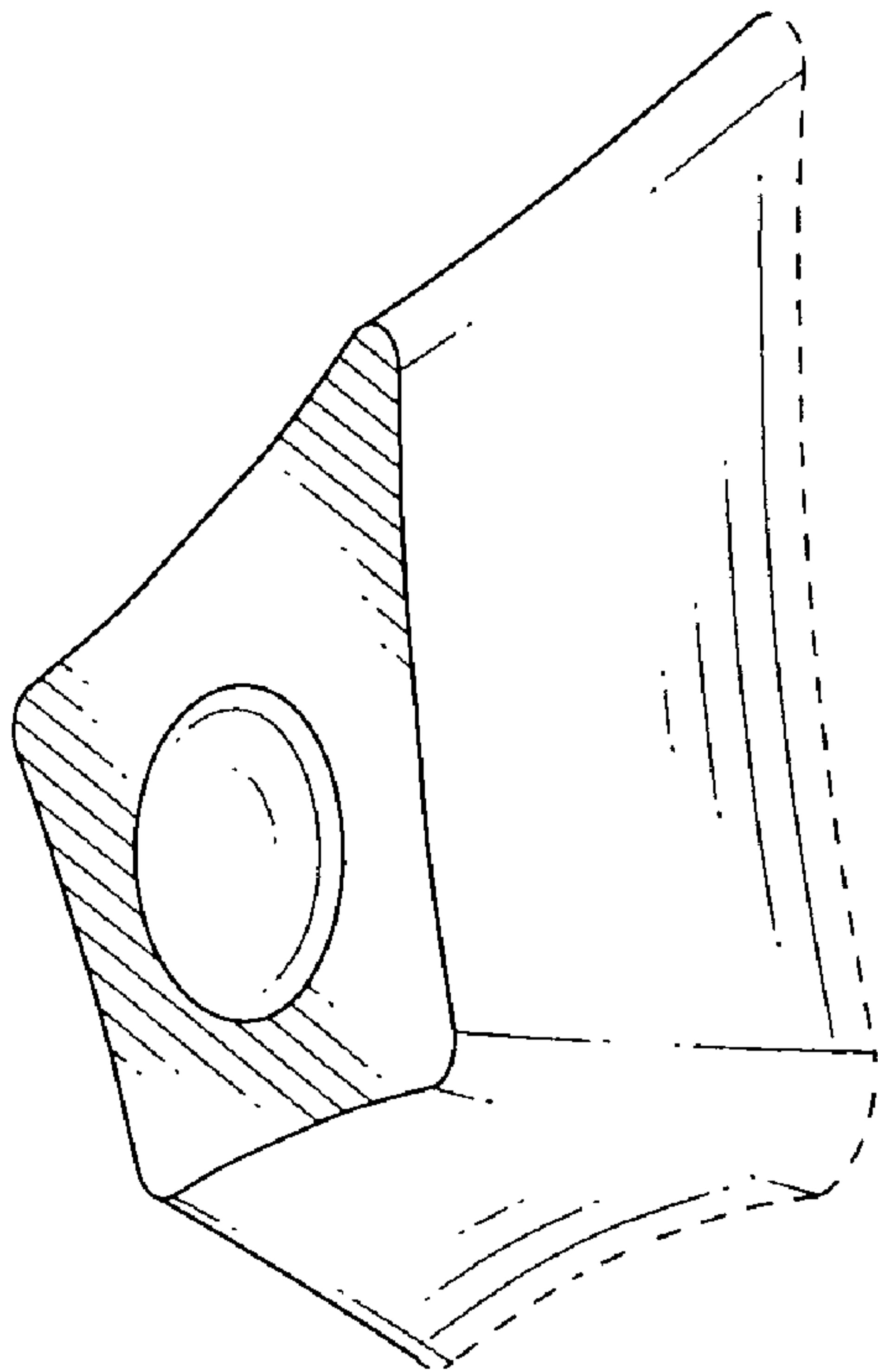

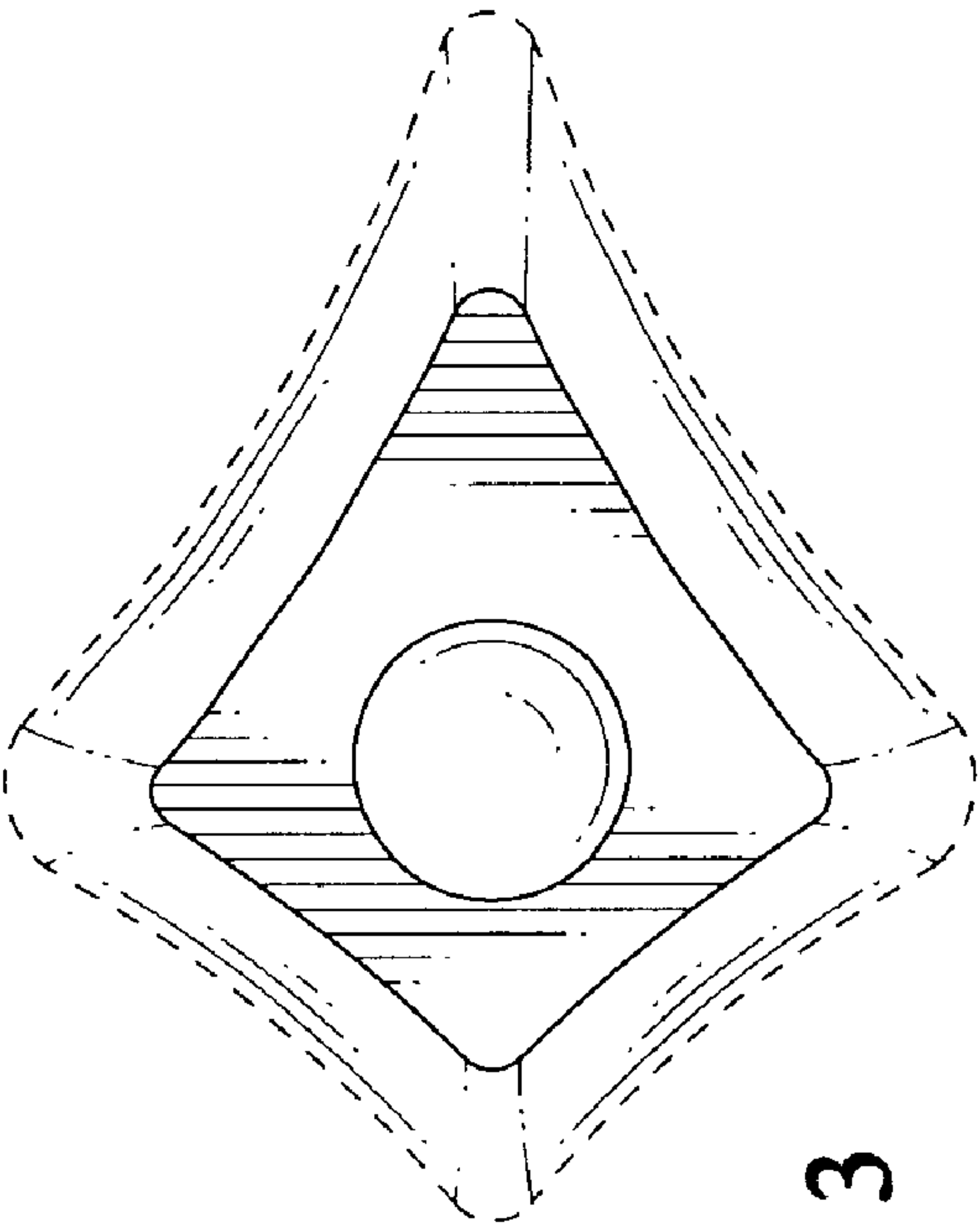

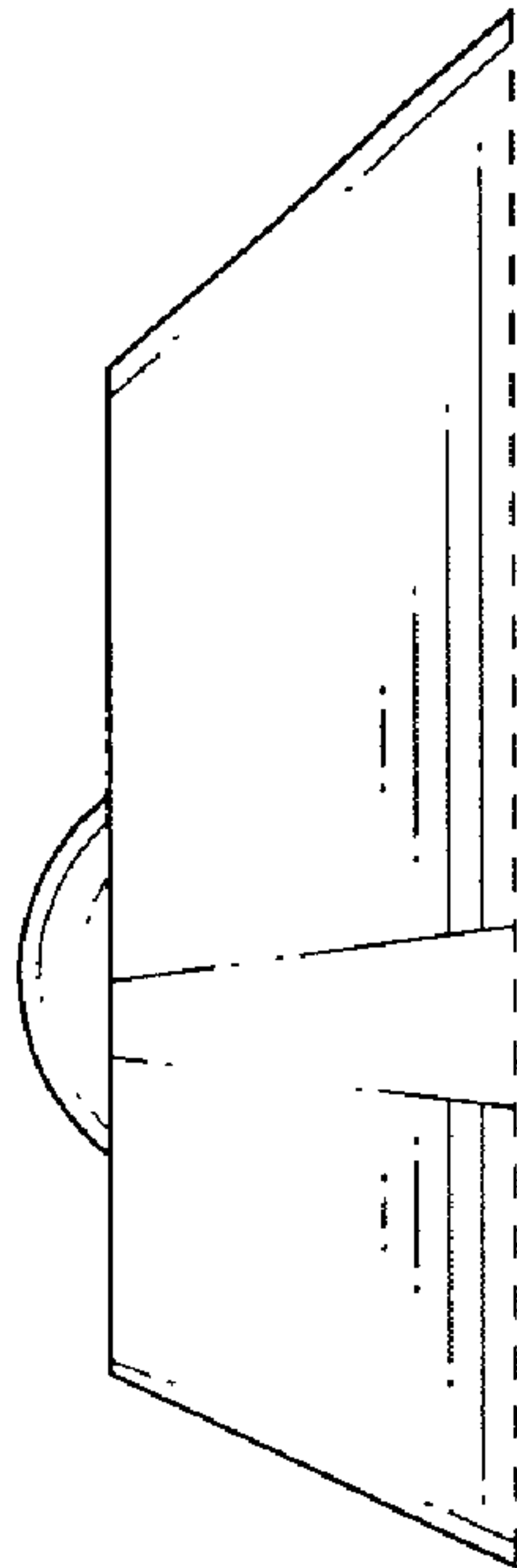

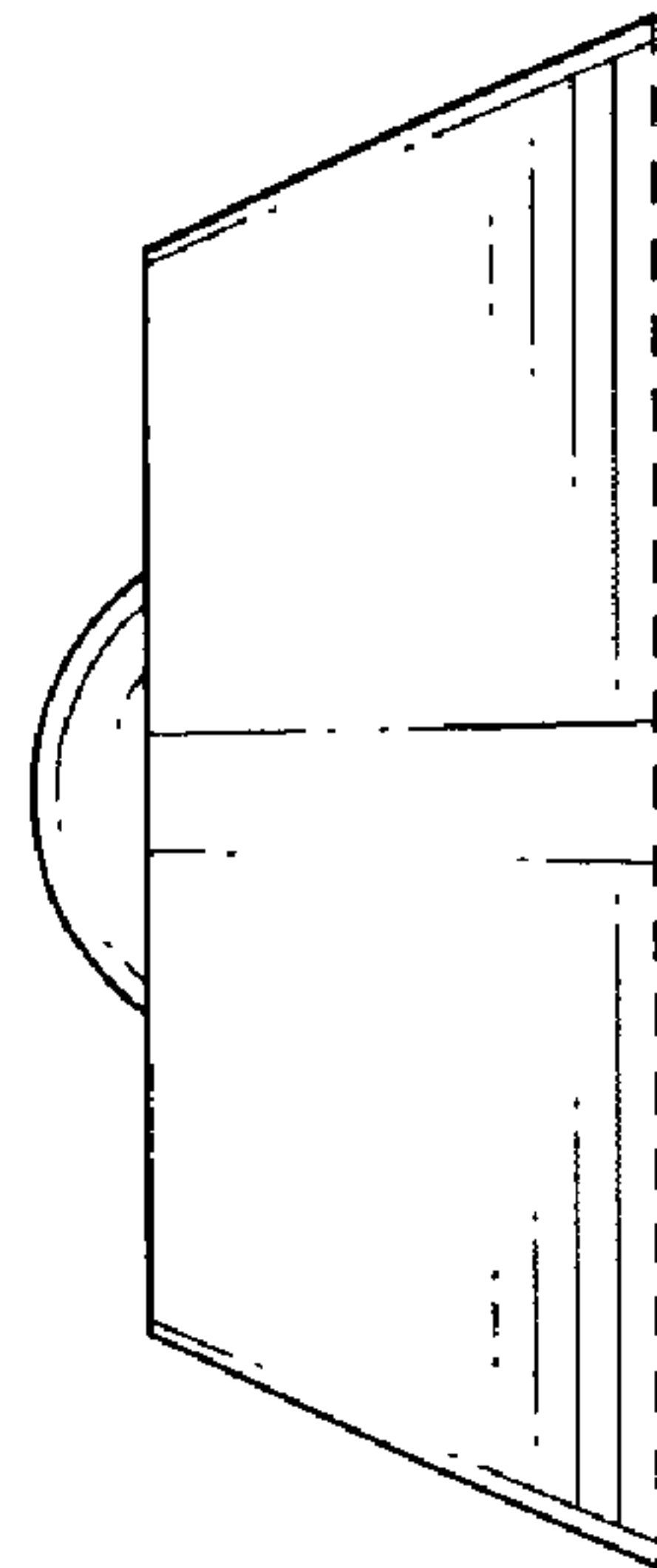

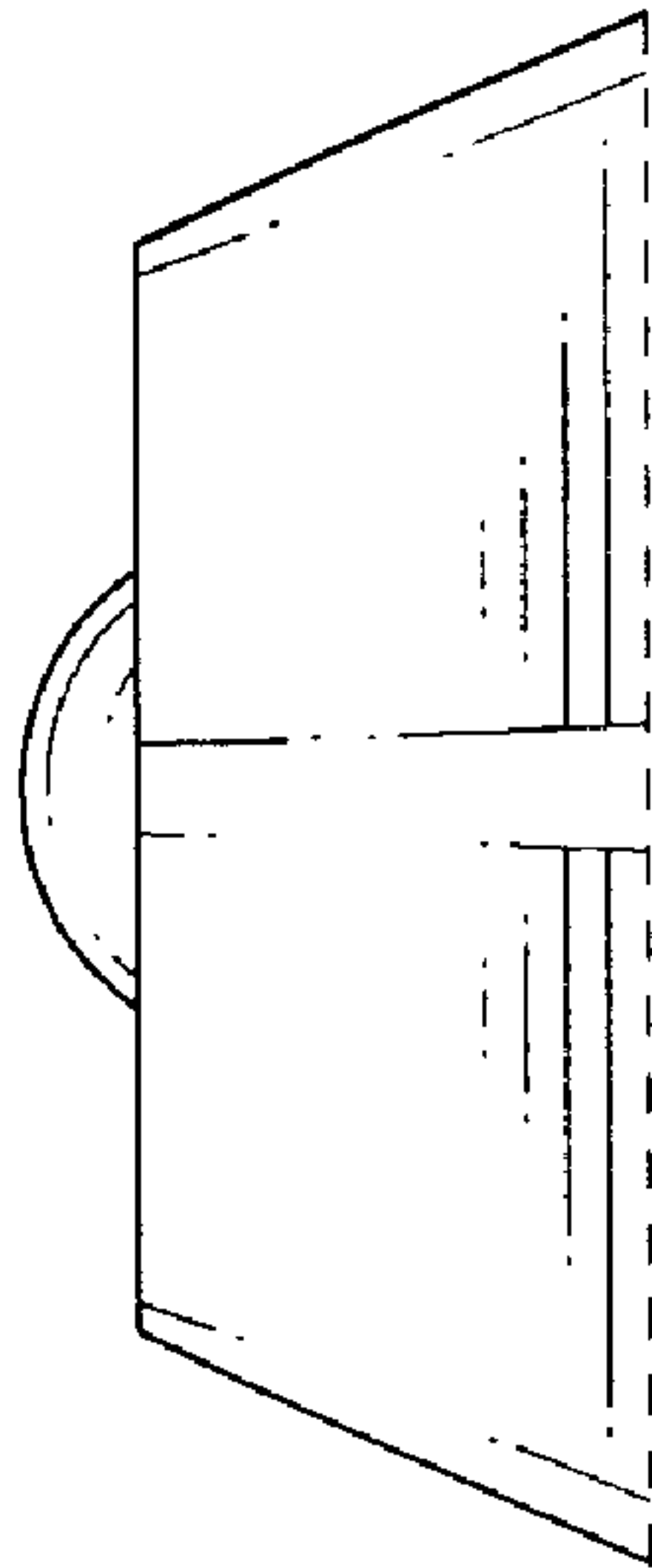
