(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for the shoe midsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shoe midsole of this invention as seen from the rear, top and left sides, wherein the broken lines do not constitute a part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the shoe midsole of this invention;

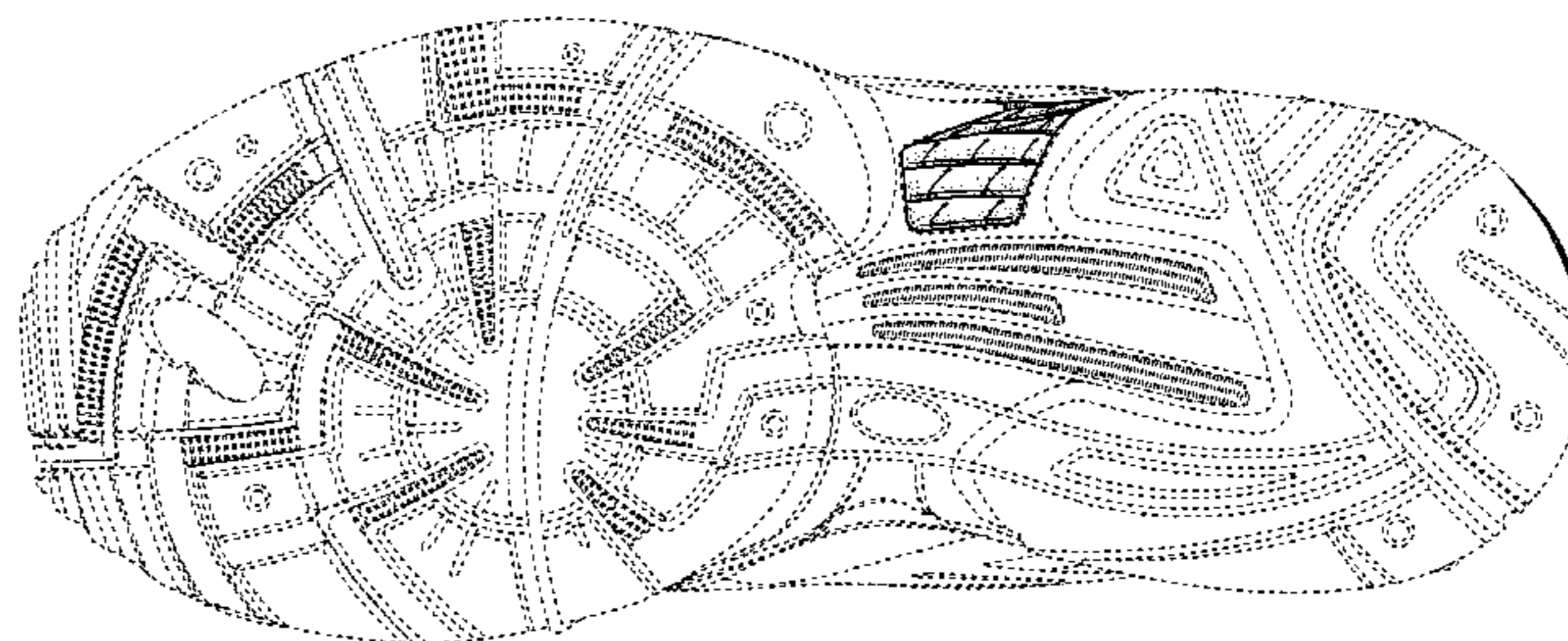
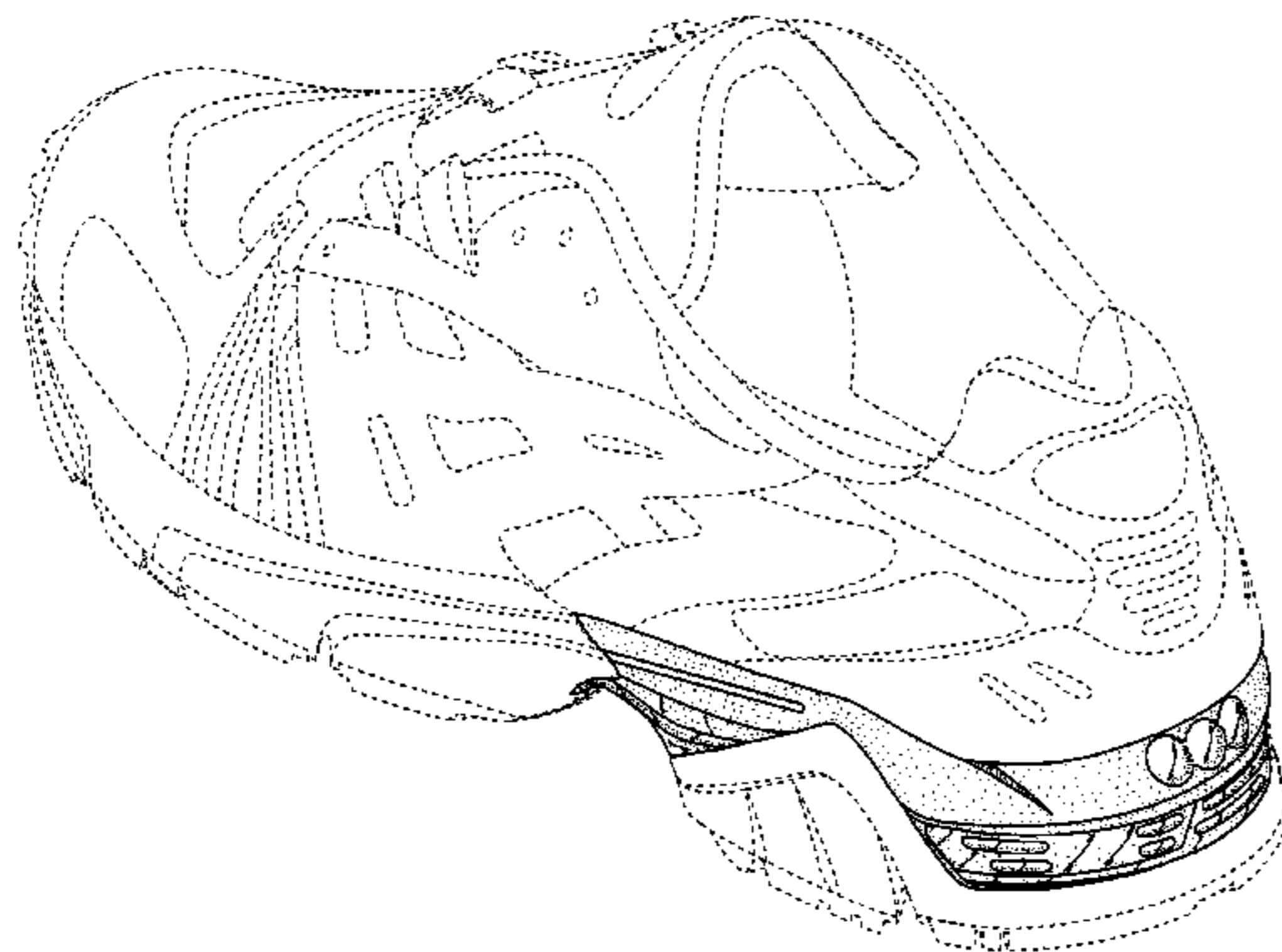
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the shoe midsole of this invention;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the shoe midsole of this invention; and,

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the shoe midsole of this invention.

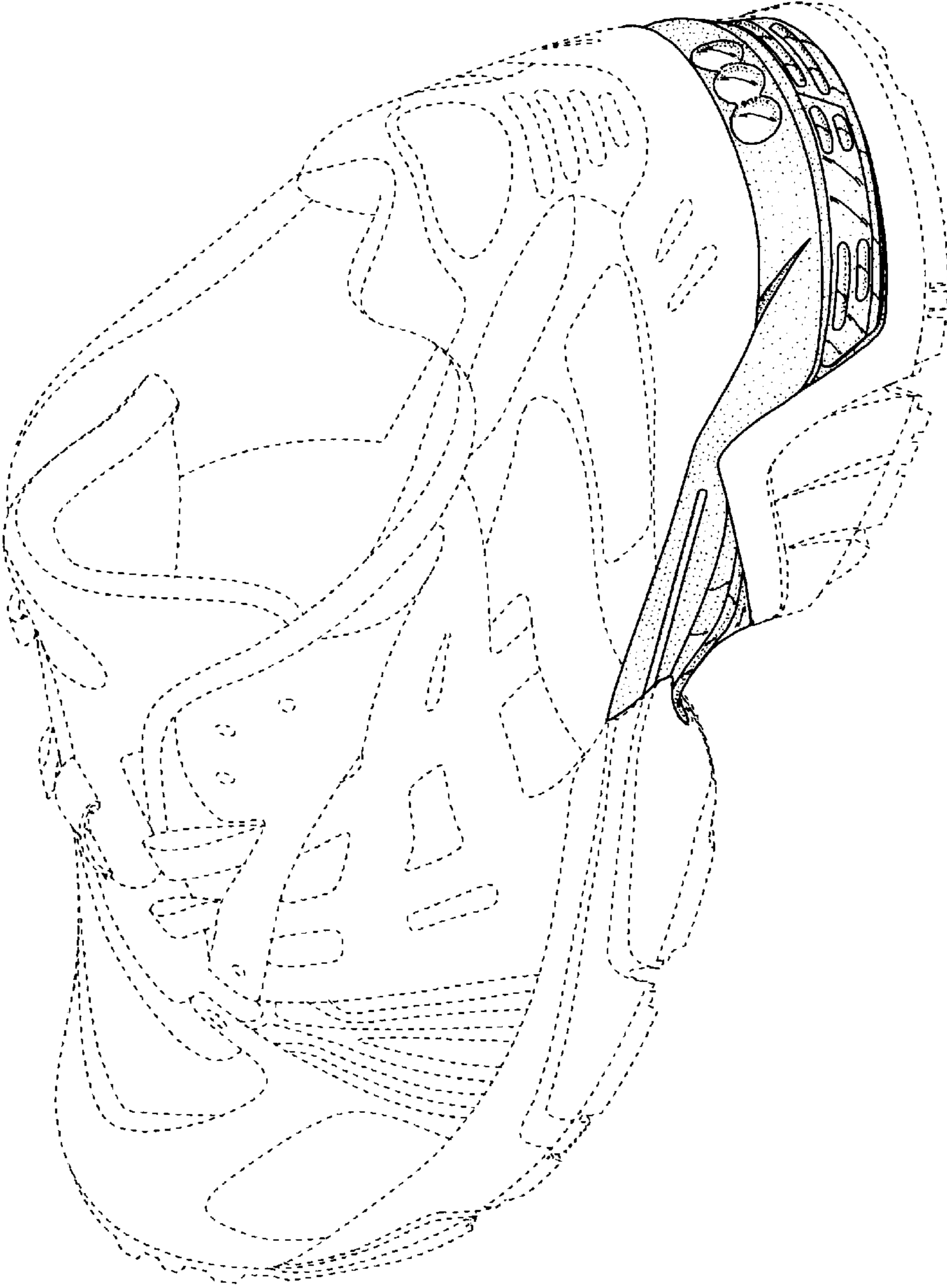

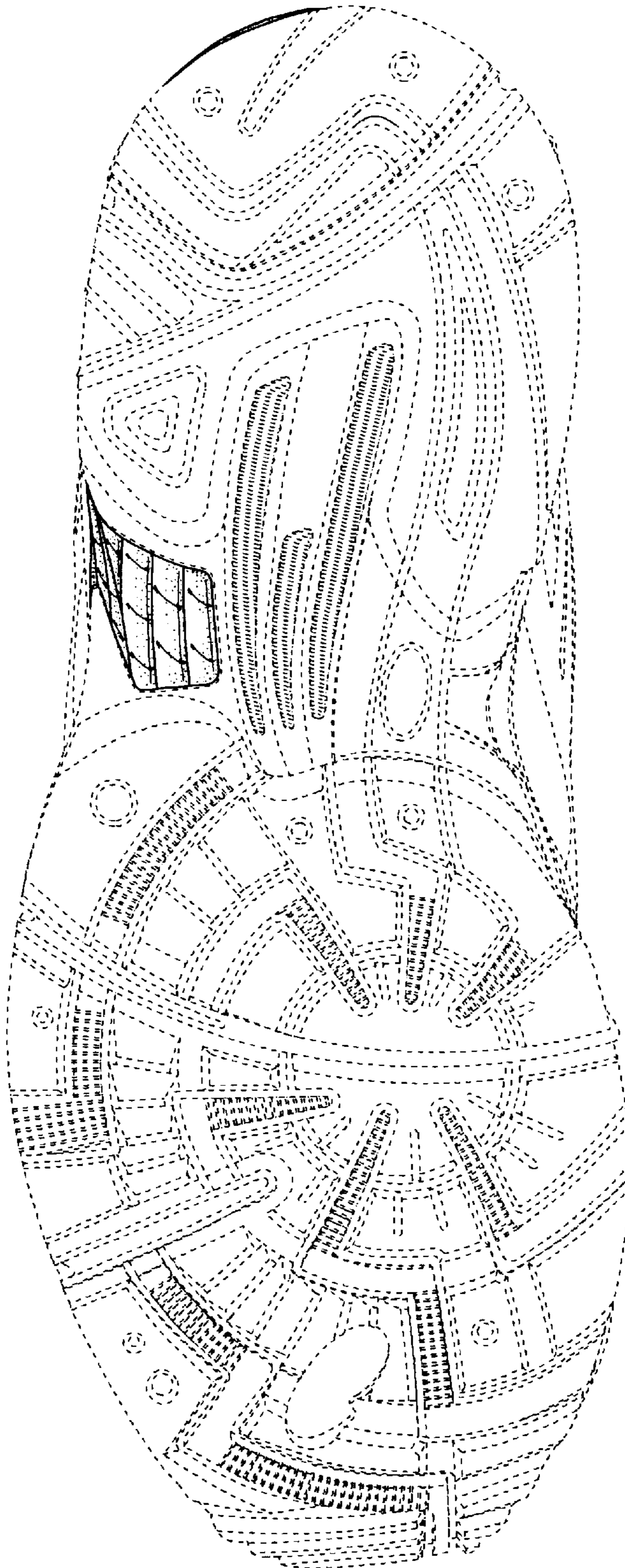

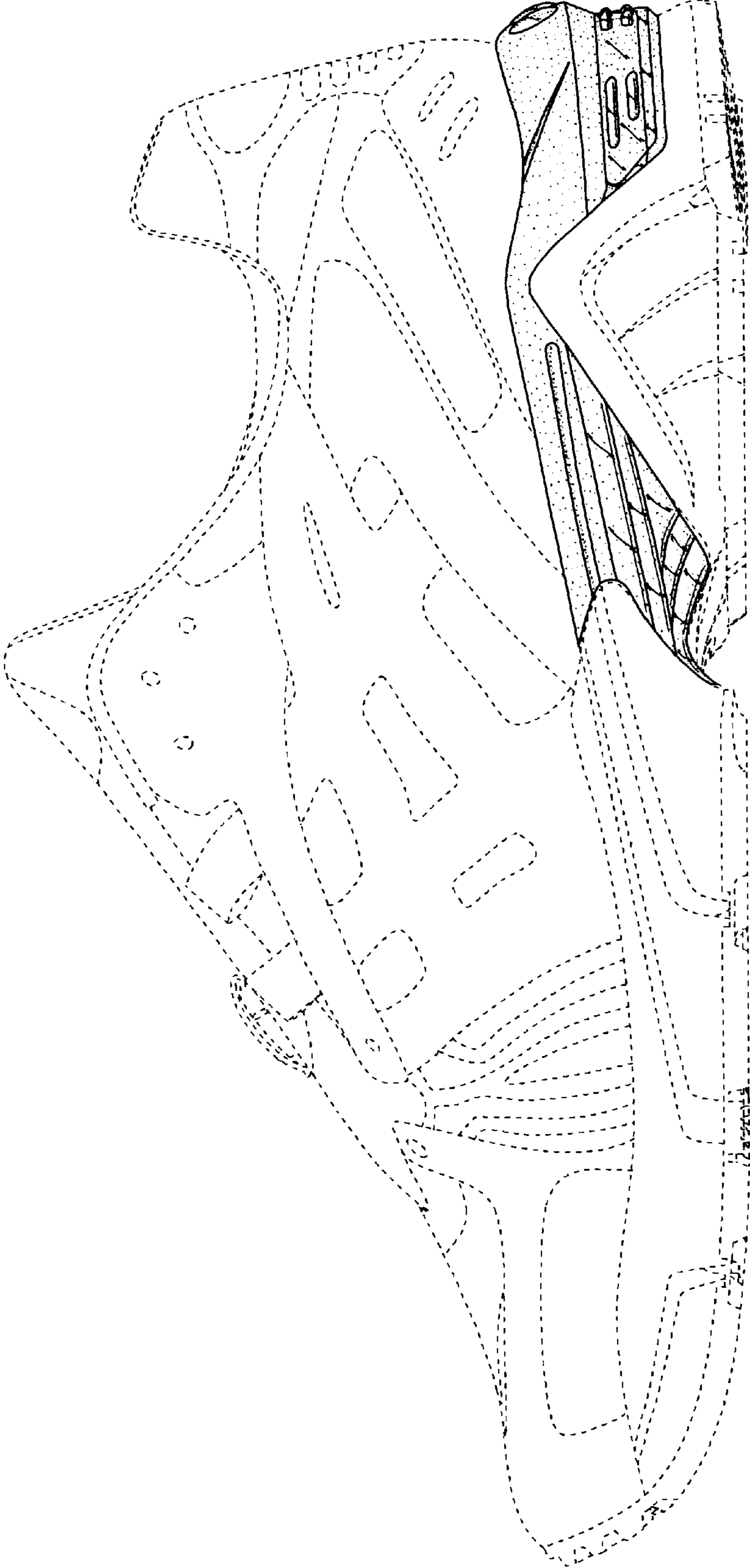

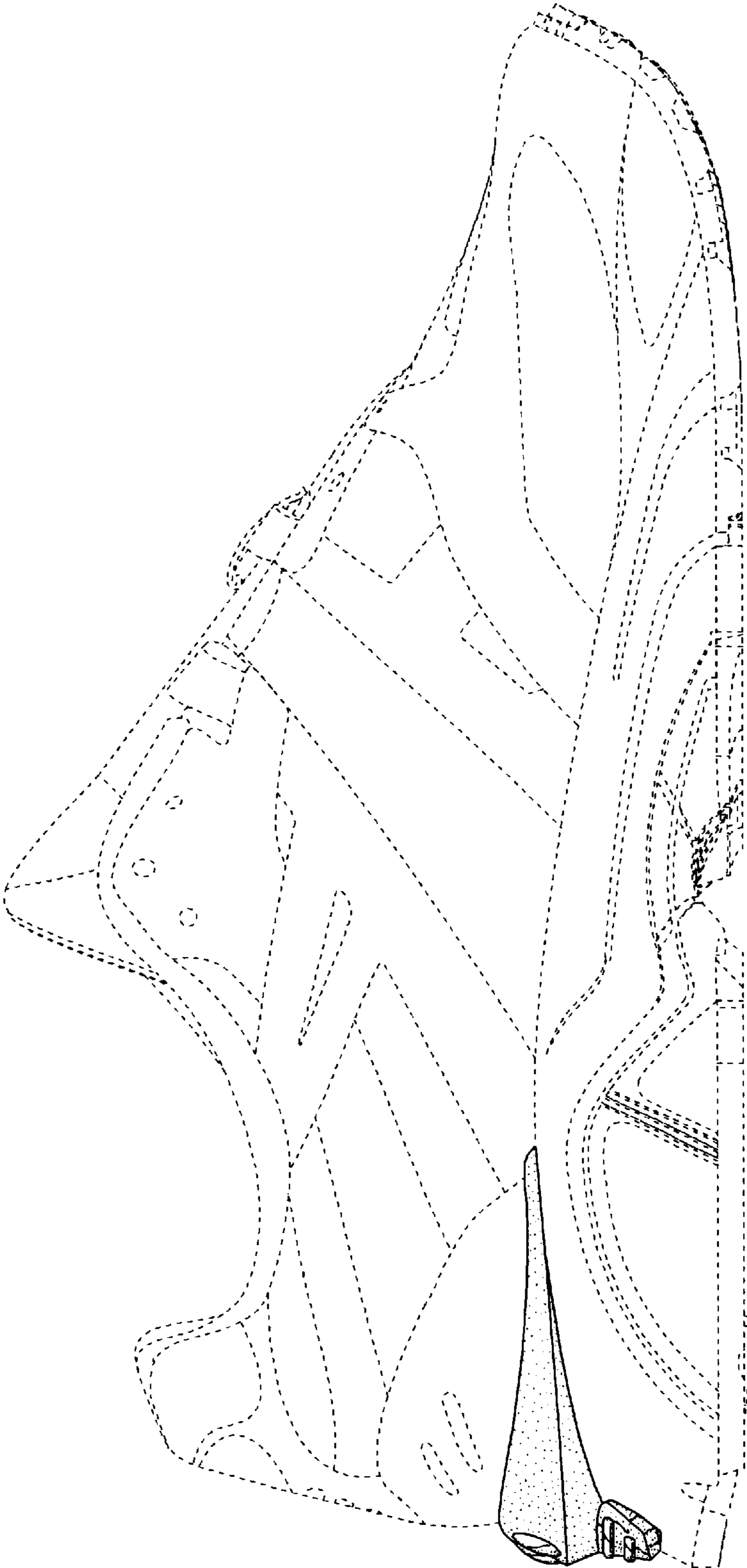
