FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

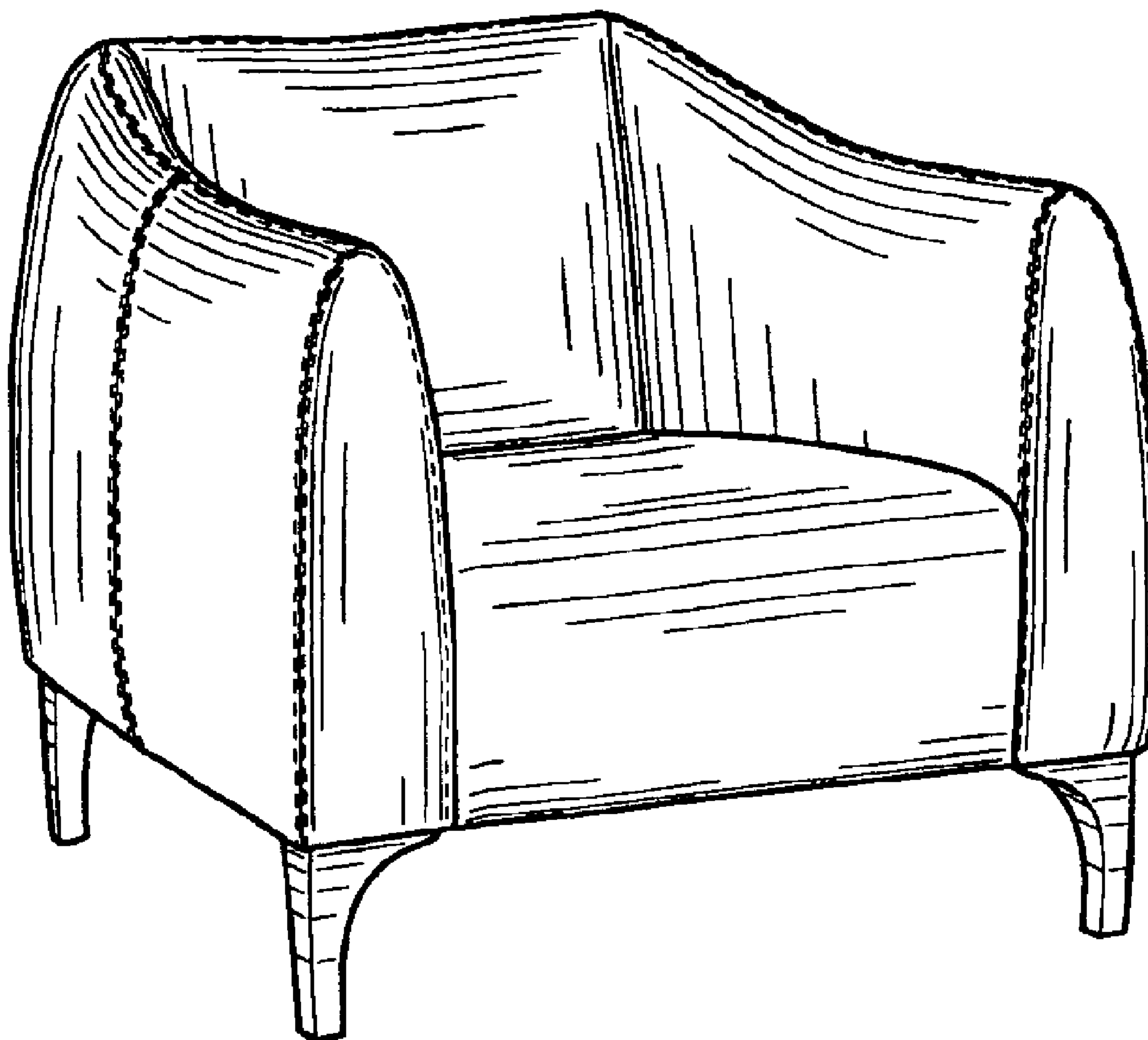
FIG. 3 is front perspective view thereof;

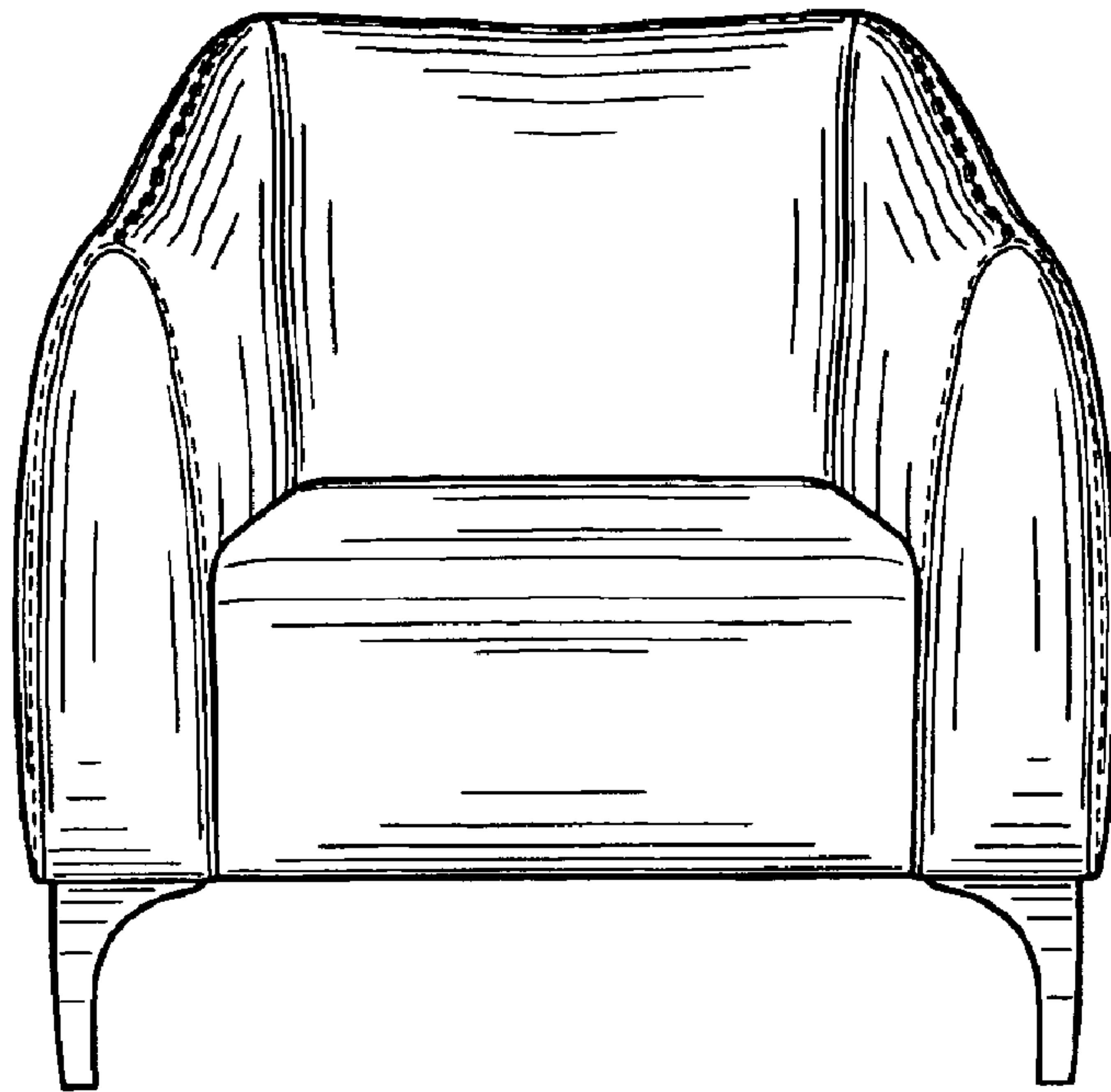

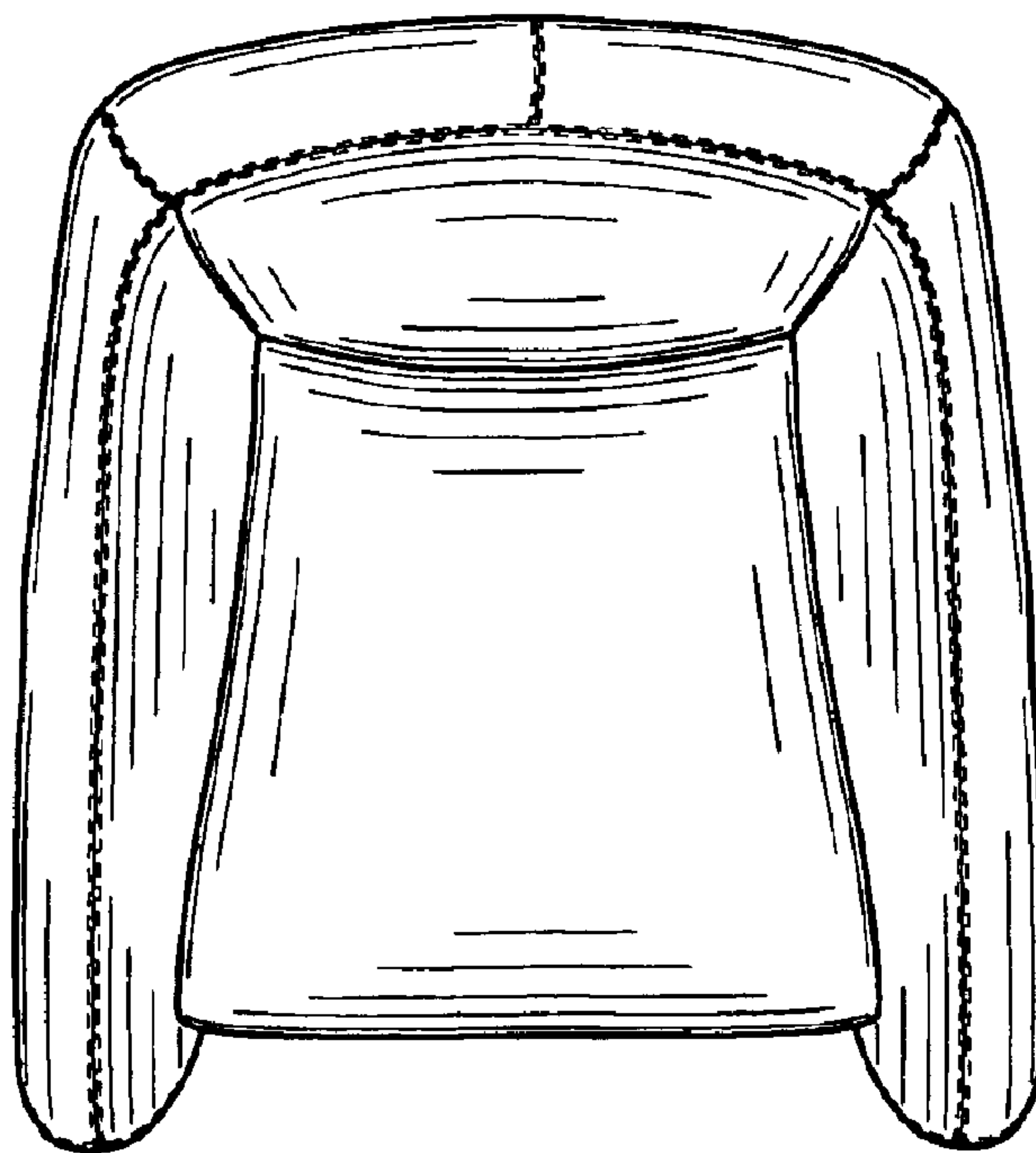

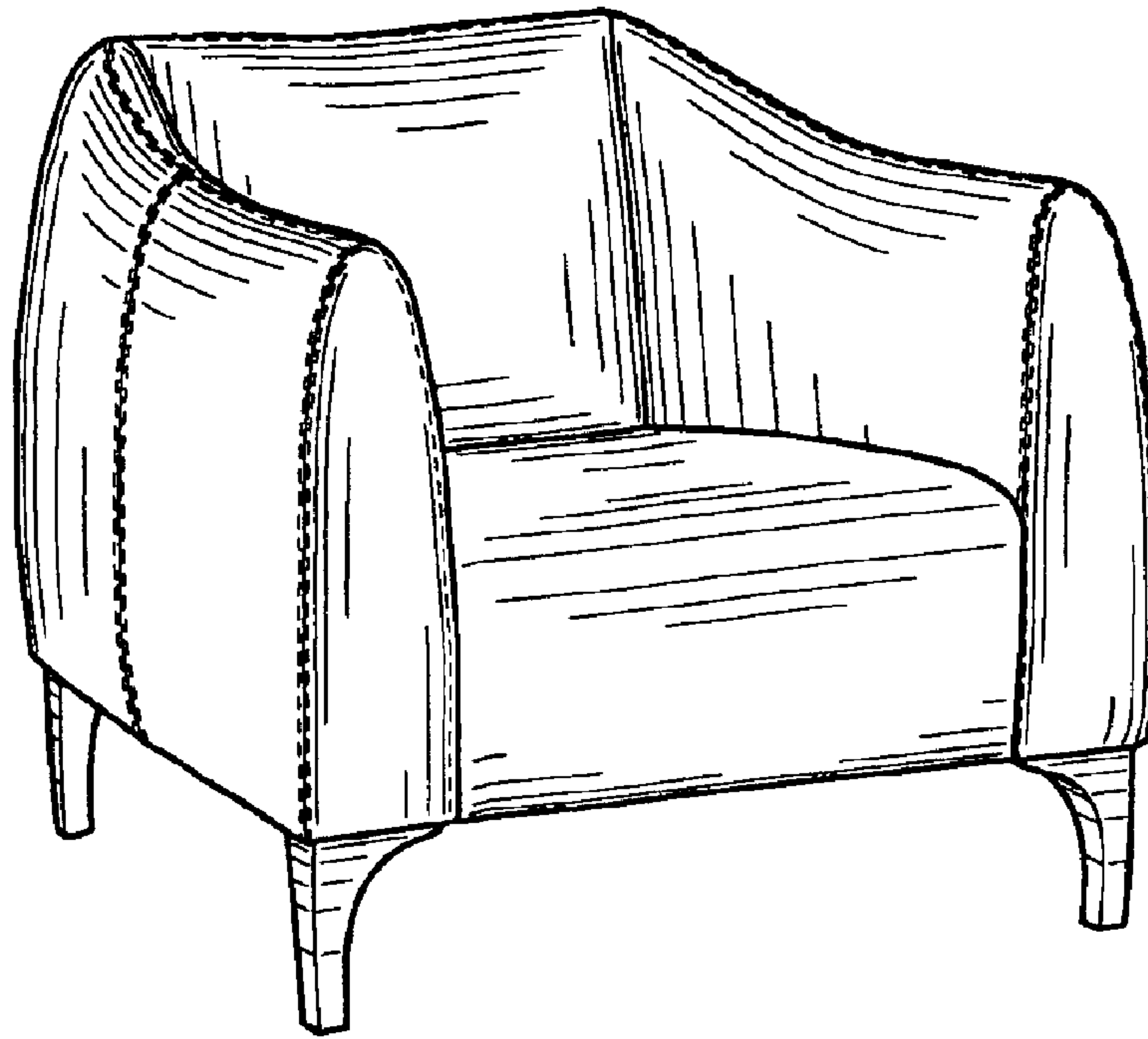

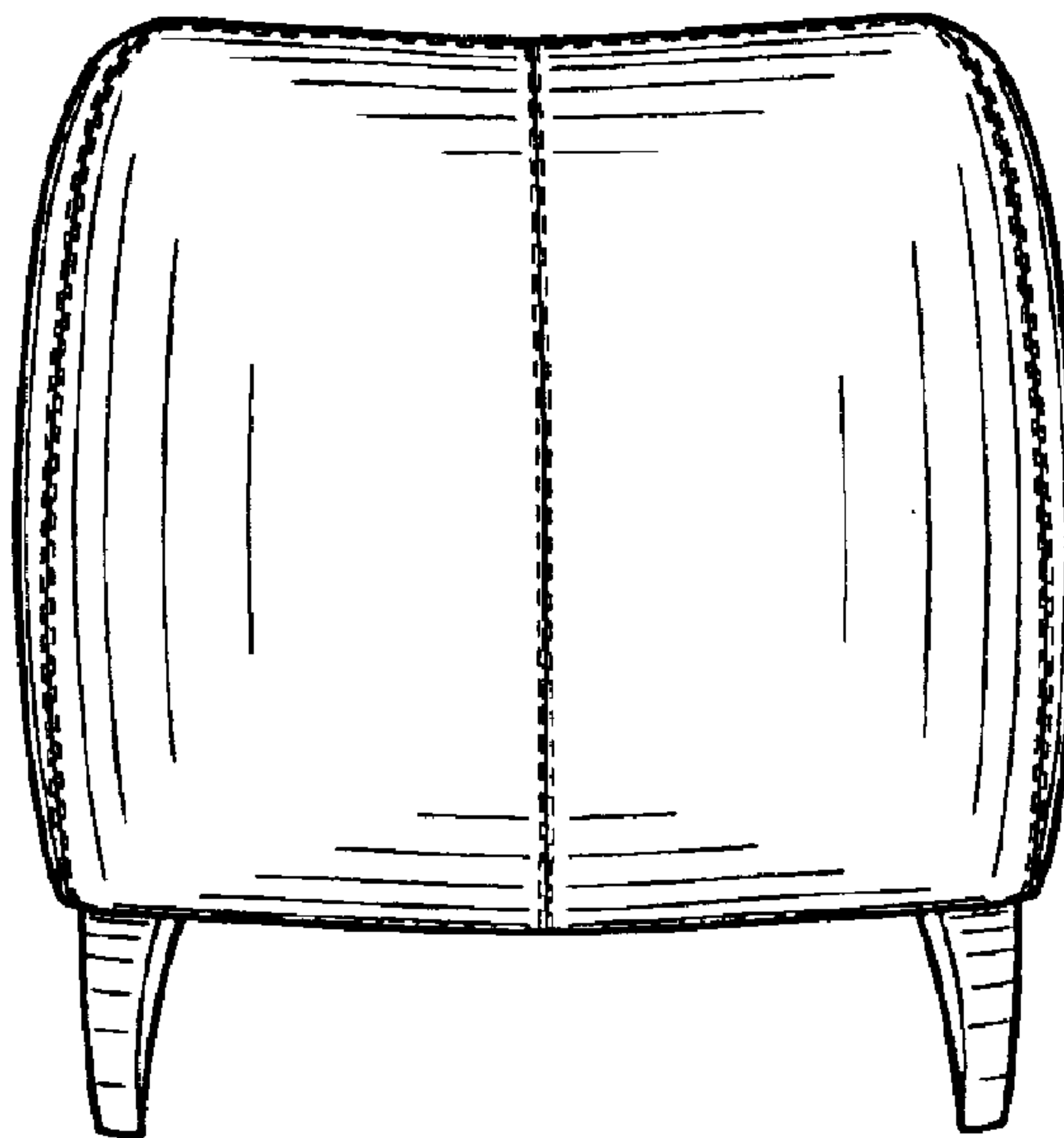

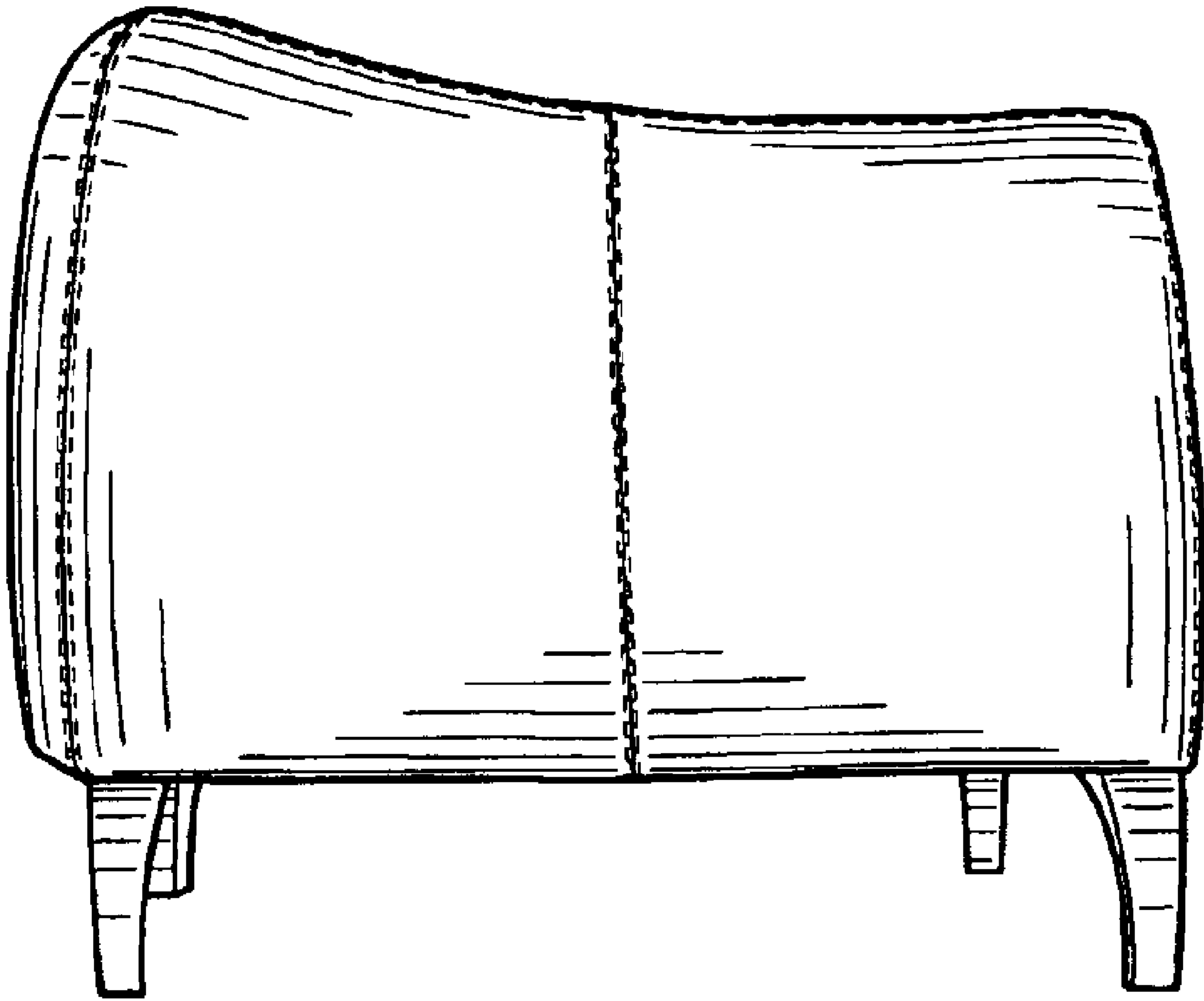
