(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a heart-shaped keepsake urn, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plain view of a heart-shaped keepsake urn.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plain view of a heart-shaped keepsake urn.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of a heart-shaped keepsake urn.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a heart-shaped keepsake urn.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of a heart-shaped keepsake urn; and,

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of a heart-shaped keepsake urn.

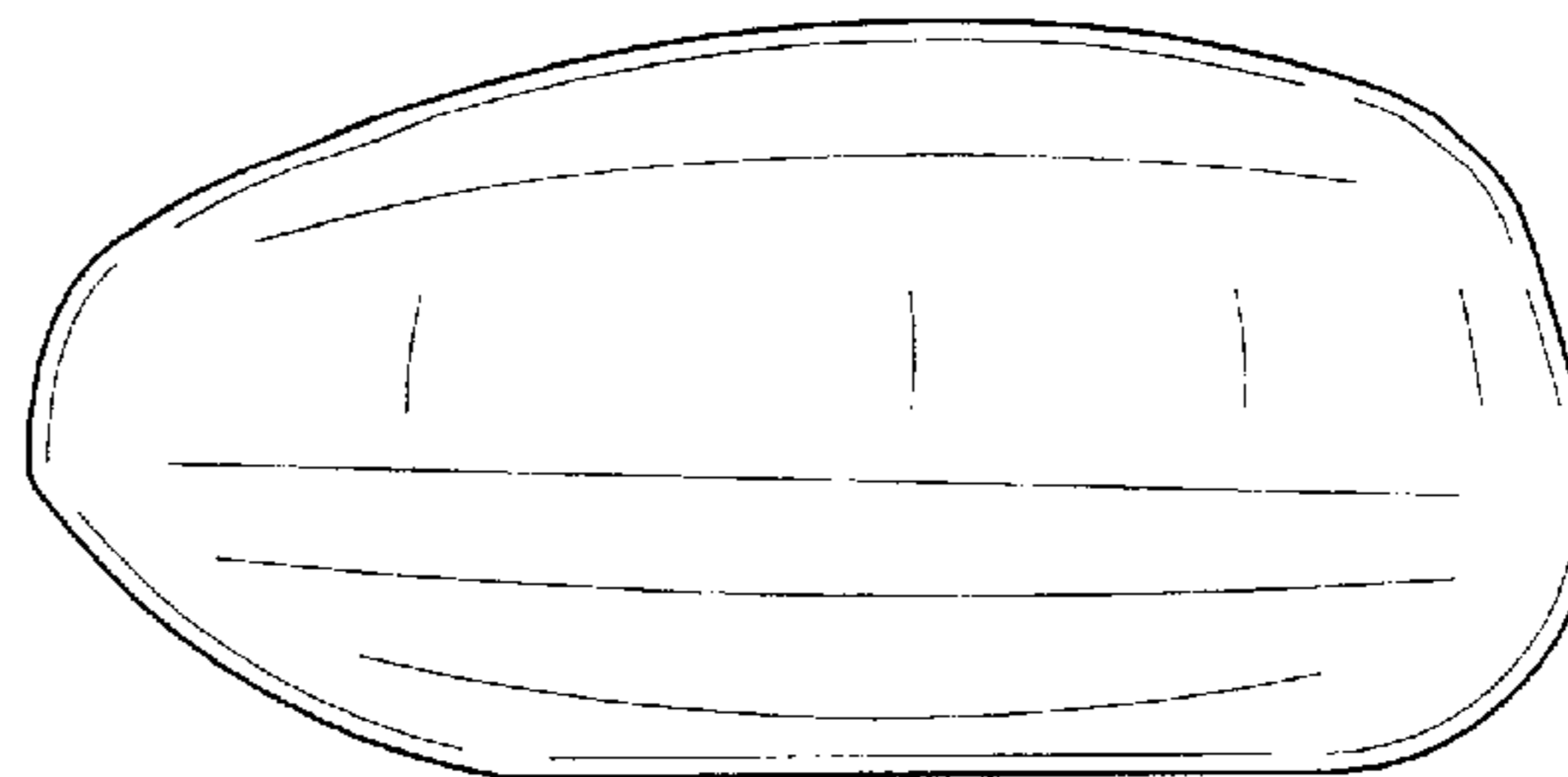
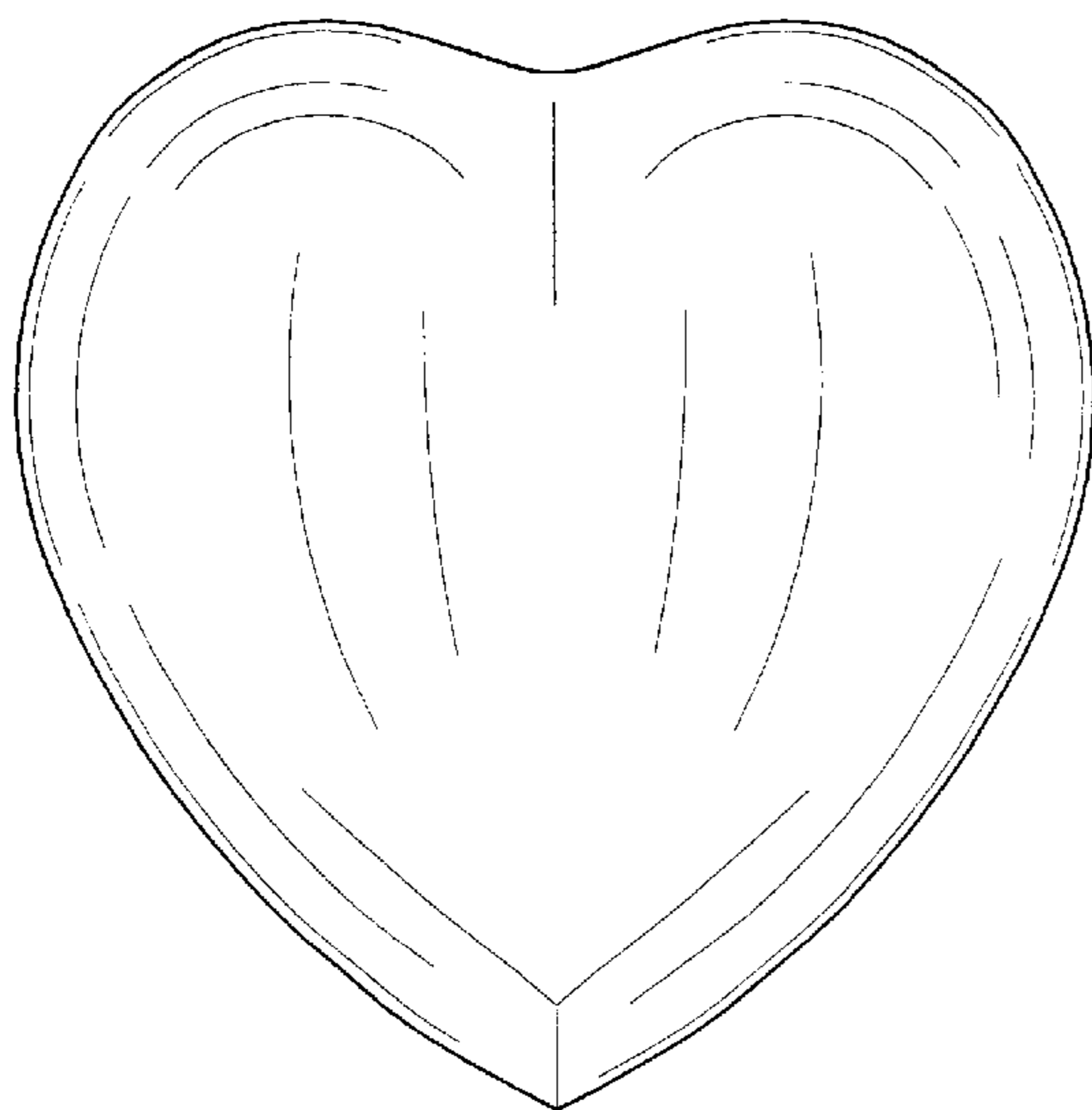

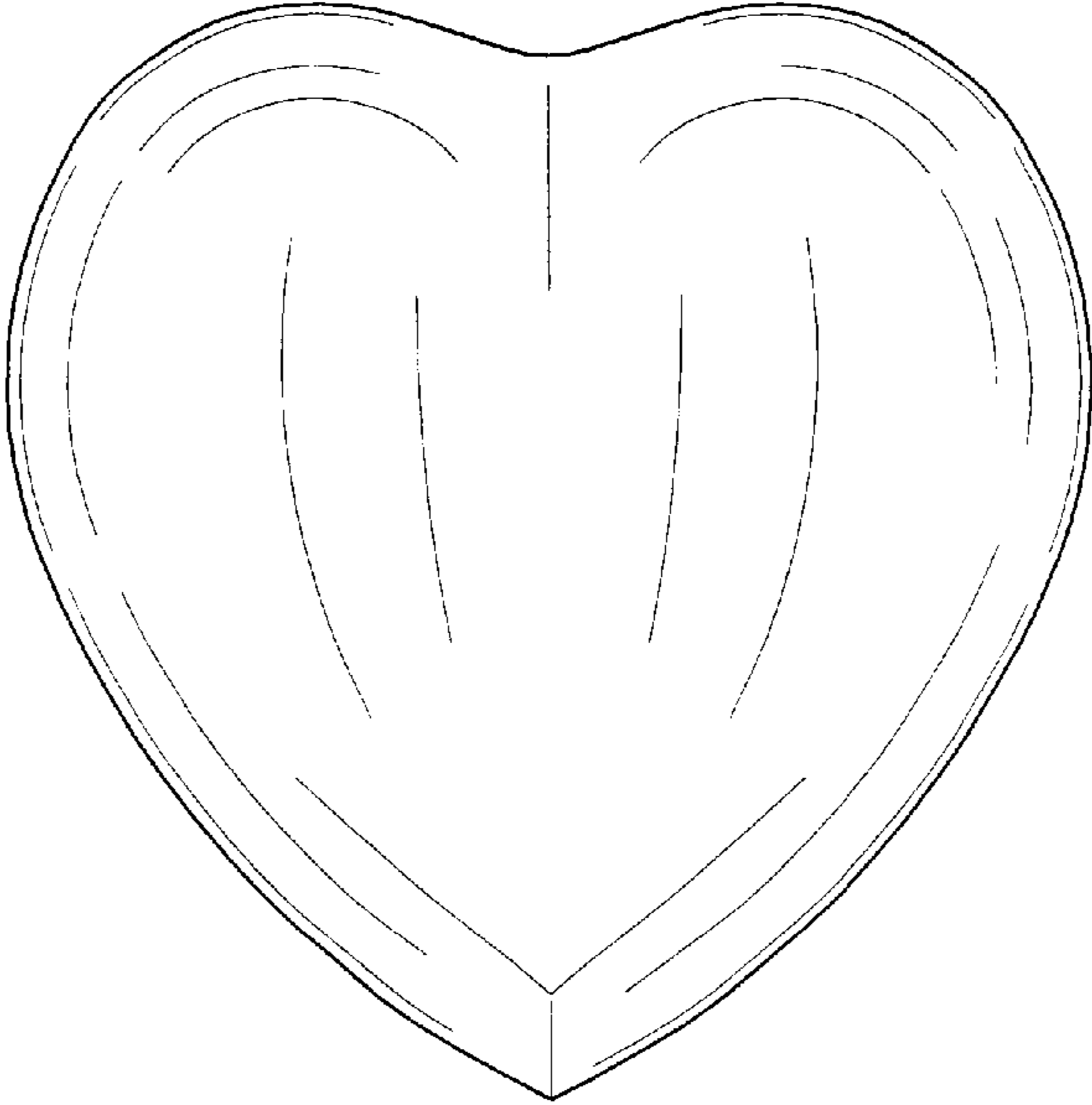

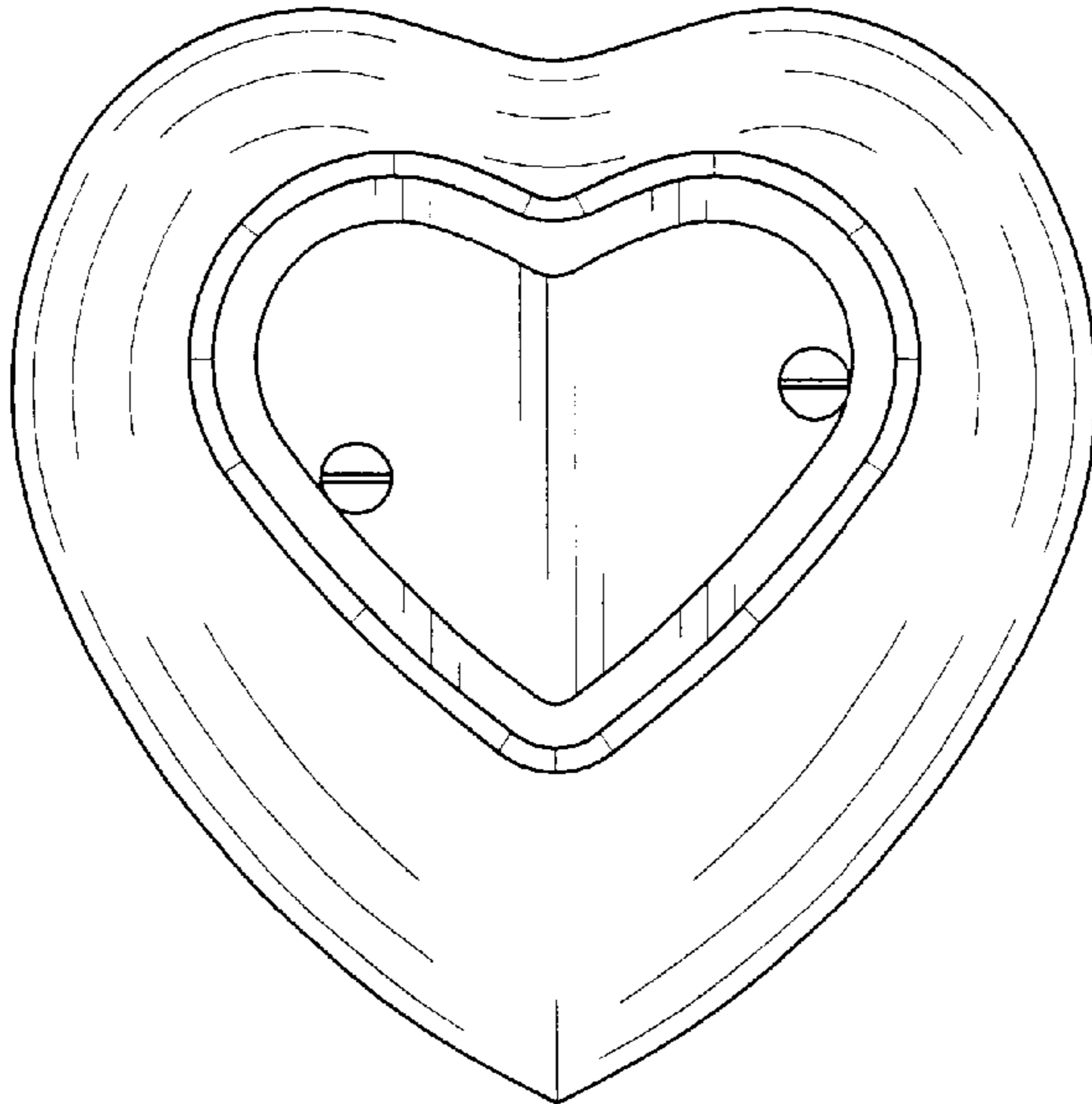

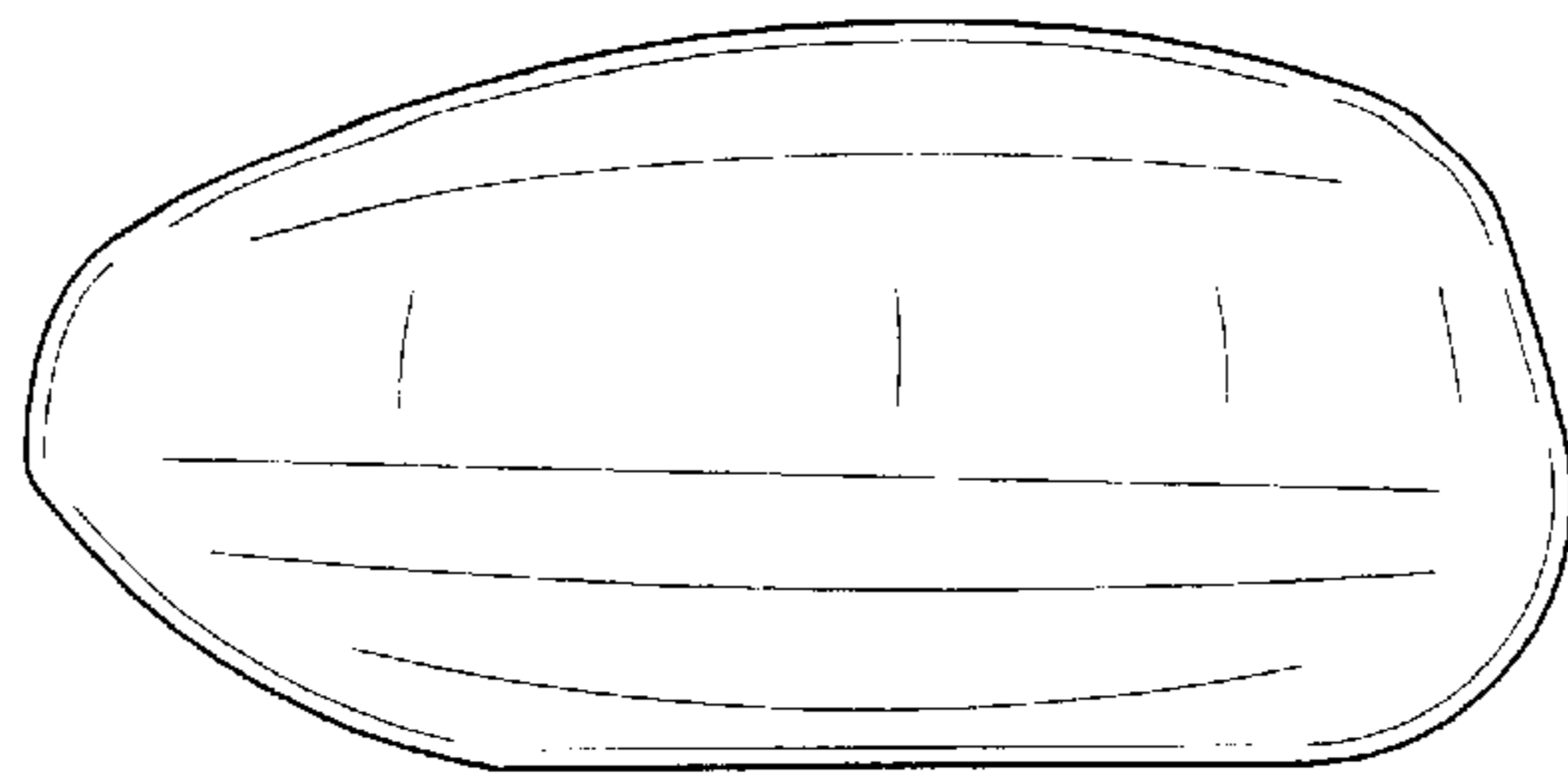

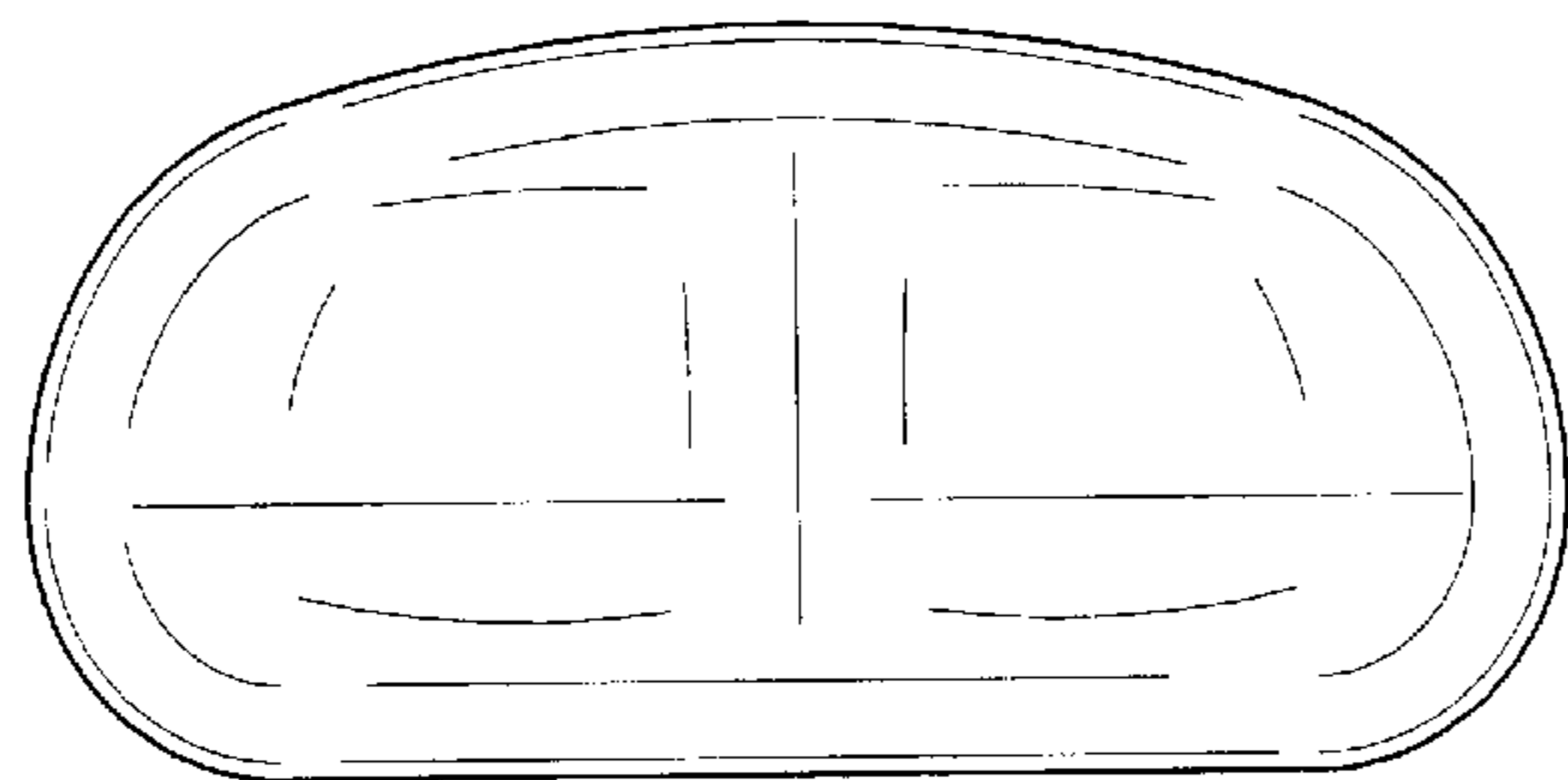

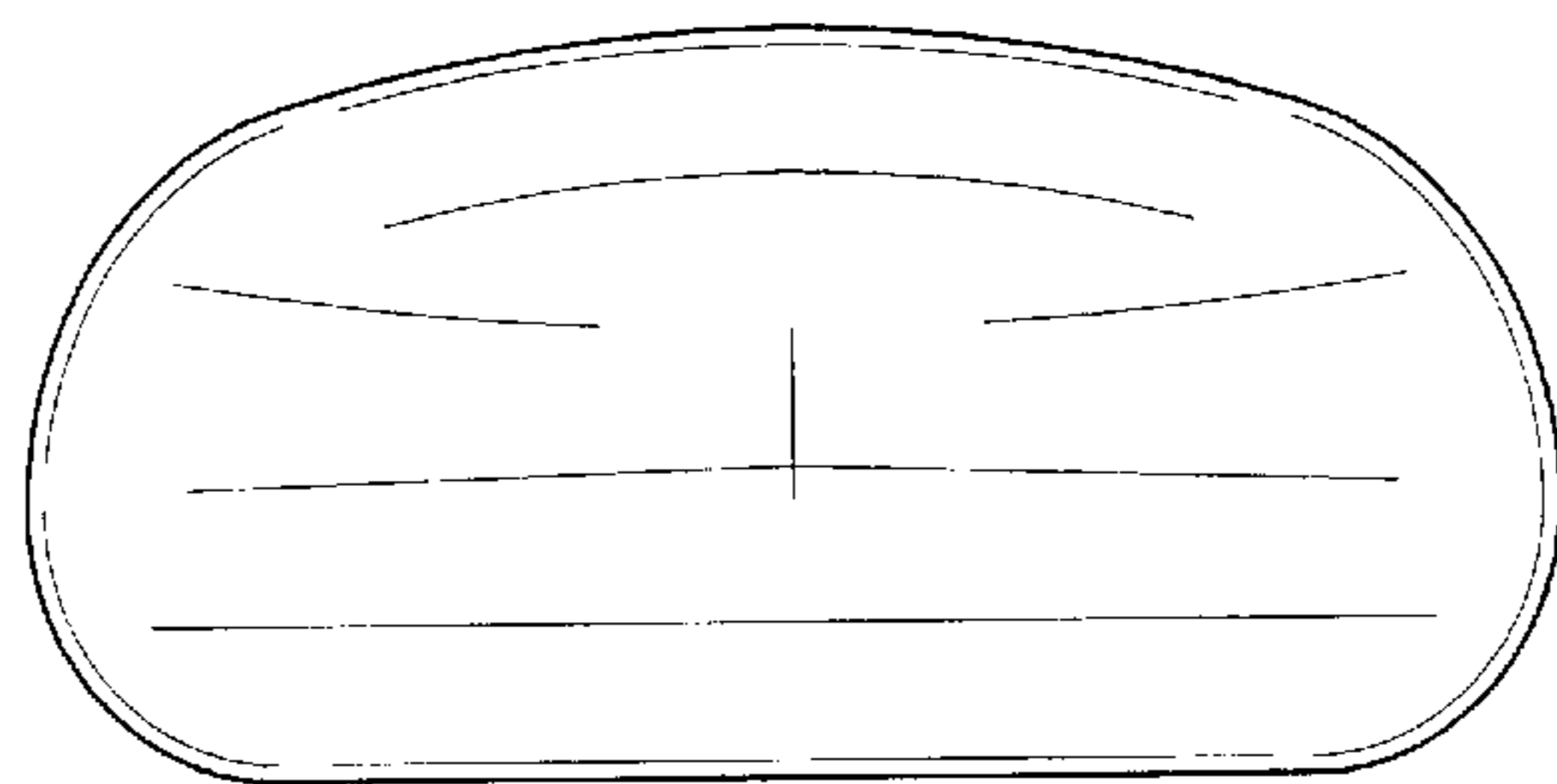
