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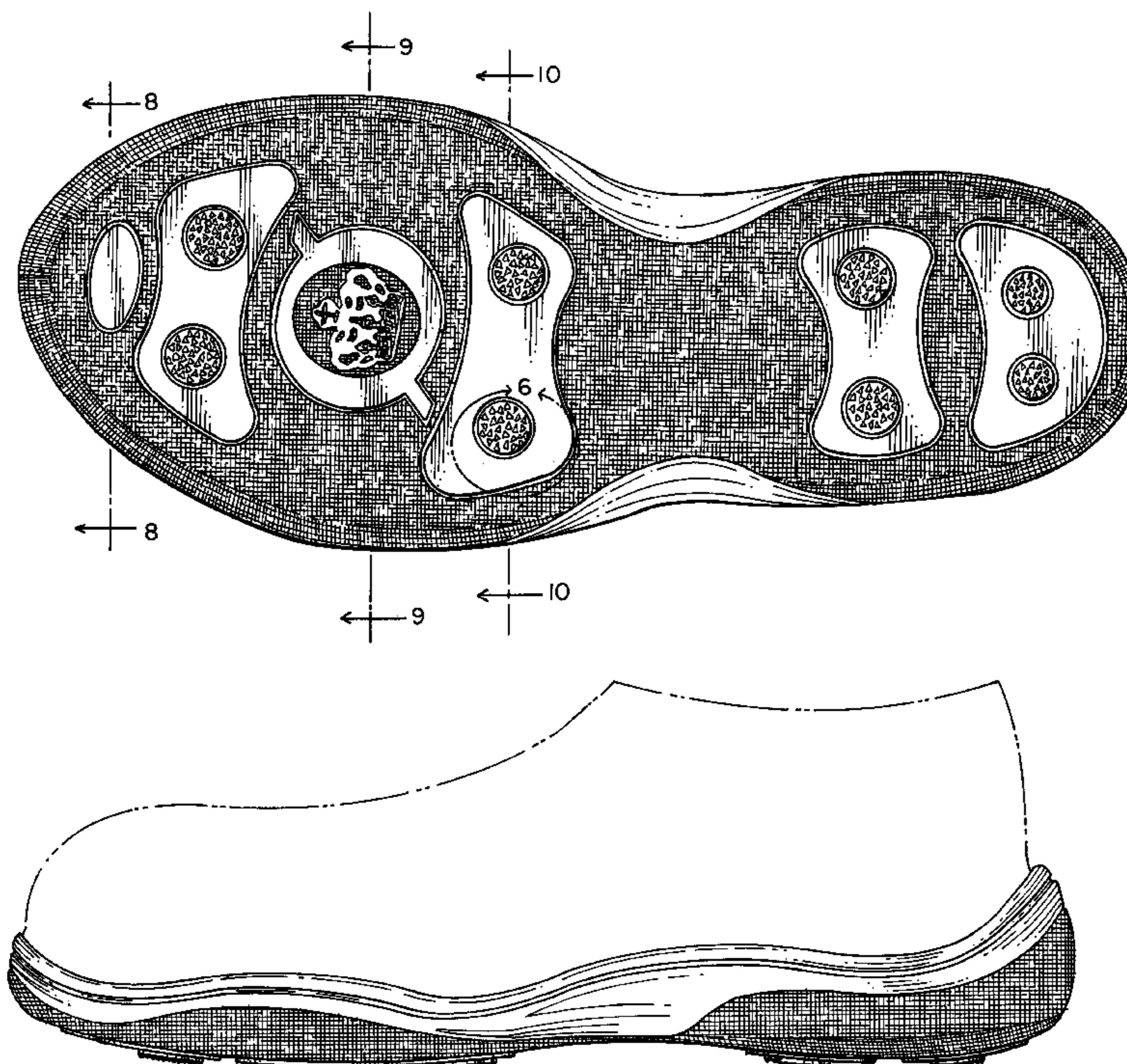
FIG. 8 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken on line 8—8 of FIG. 1;

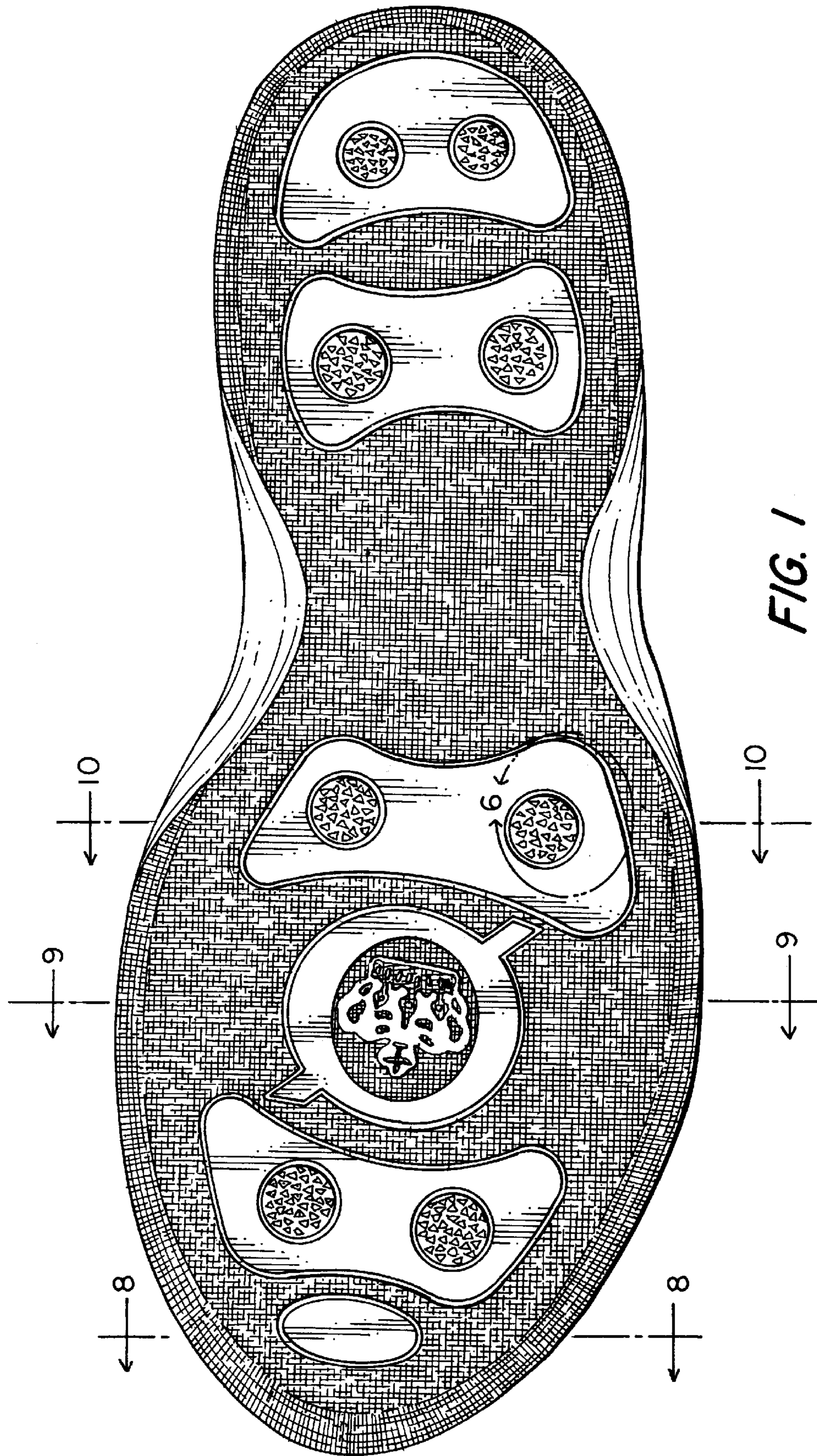

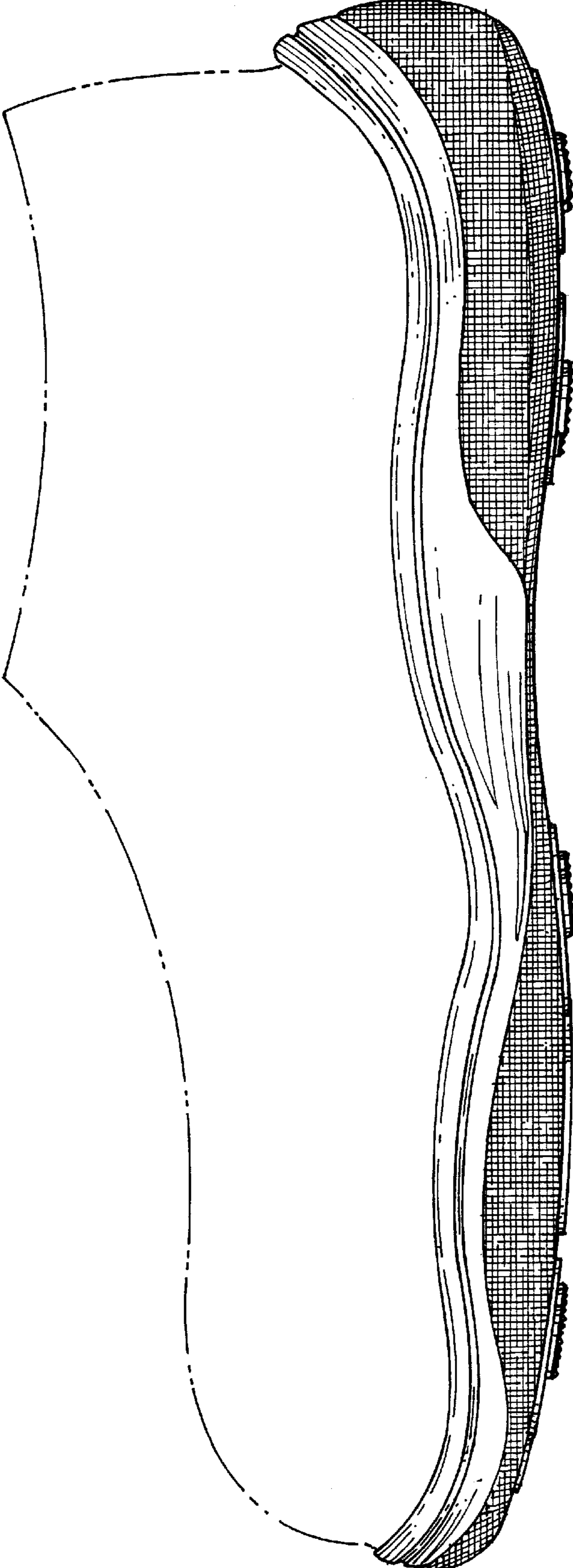

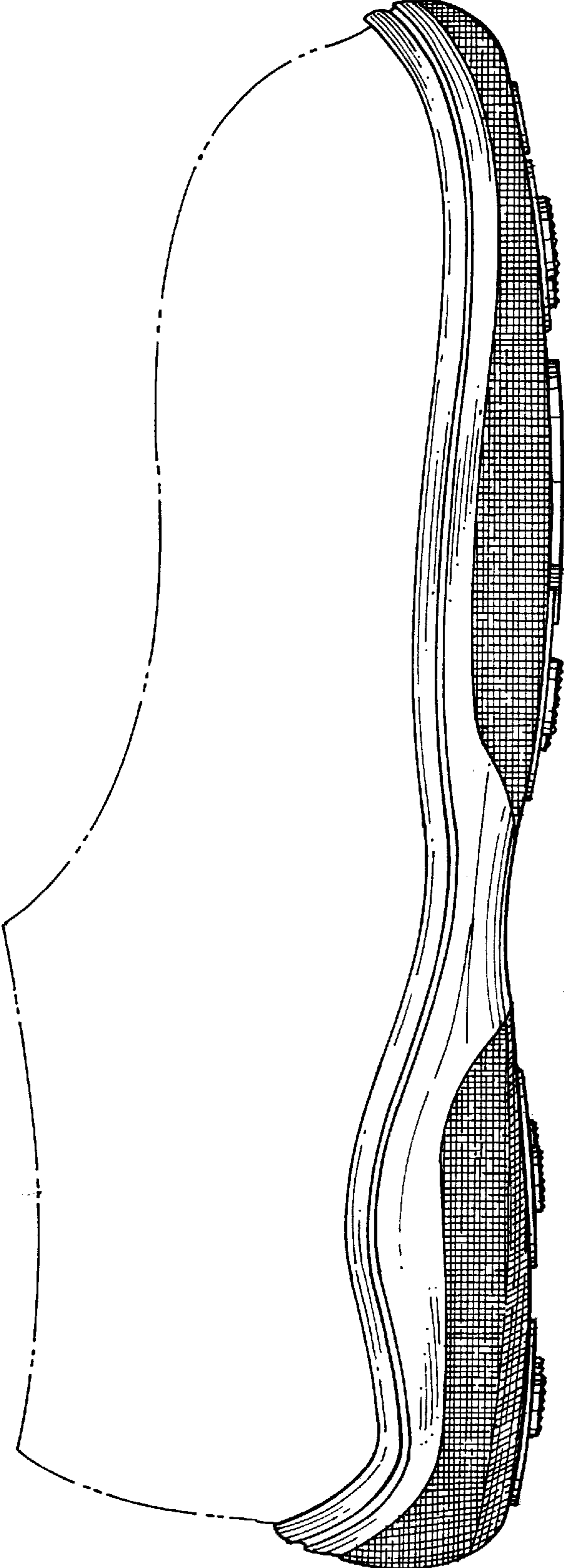

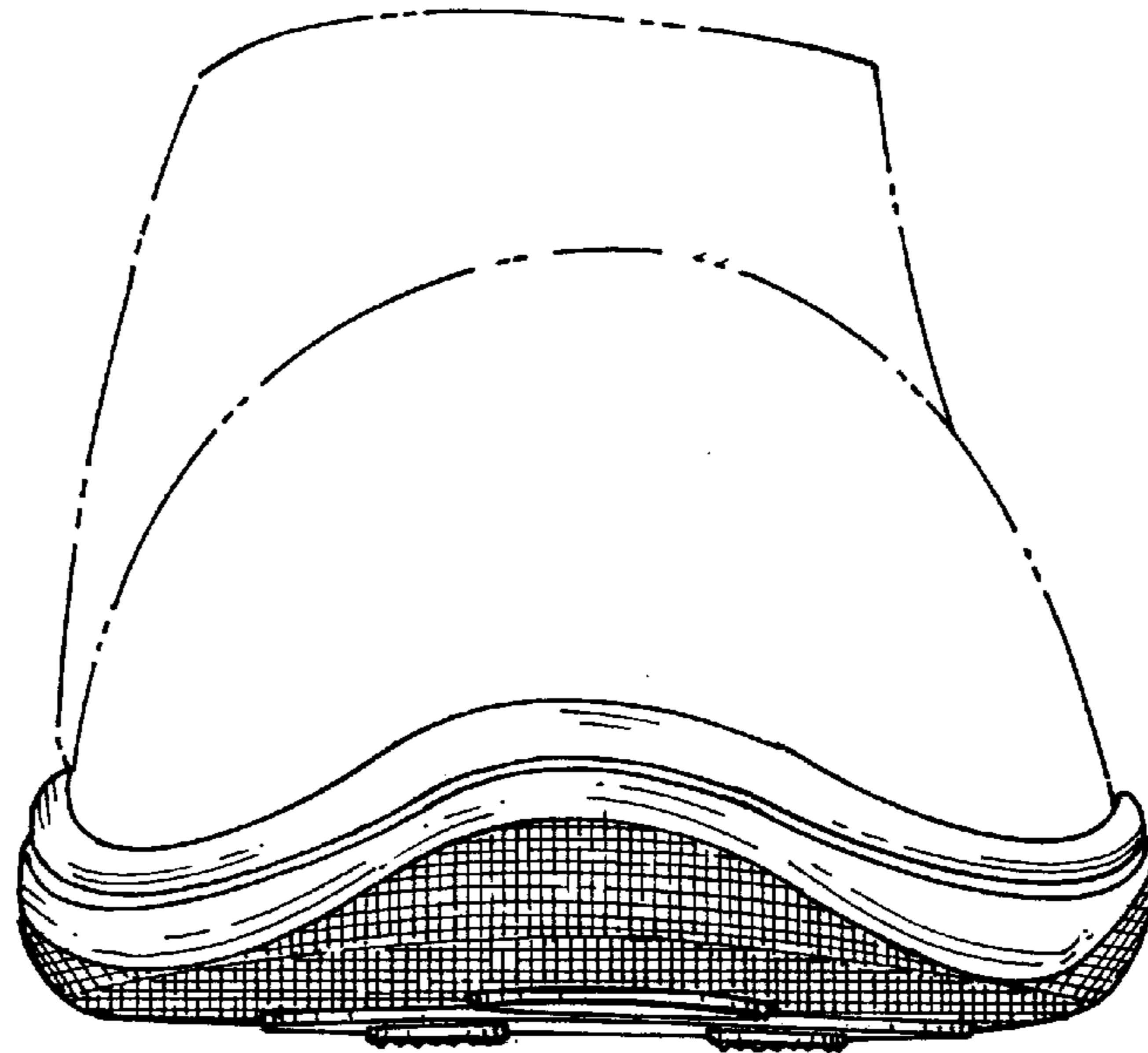

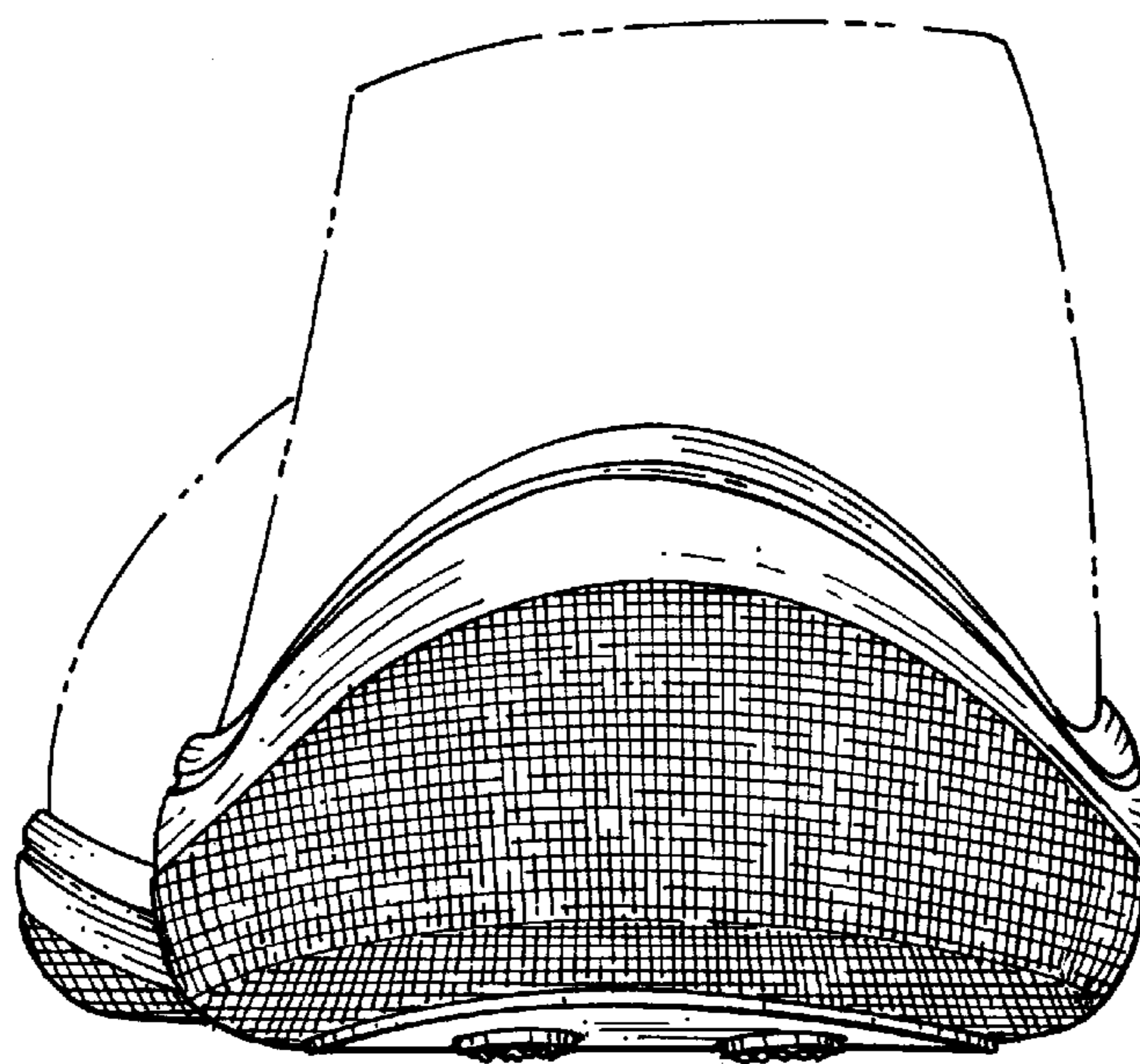

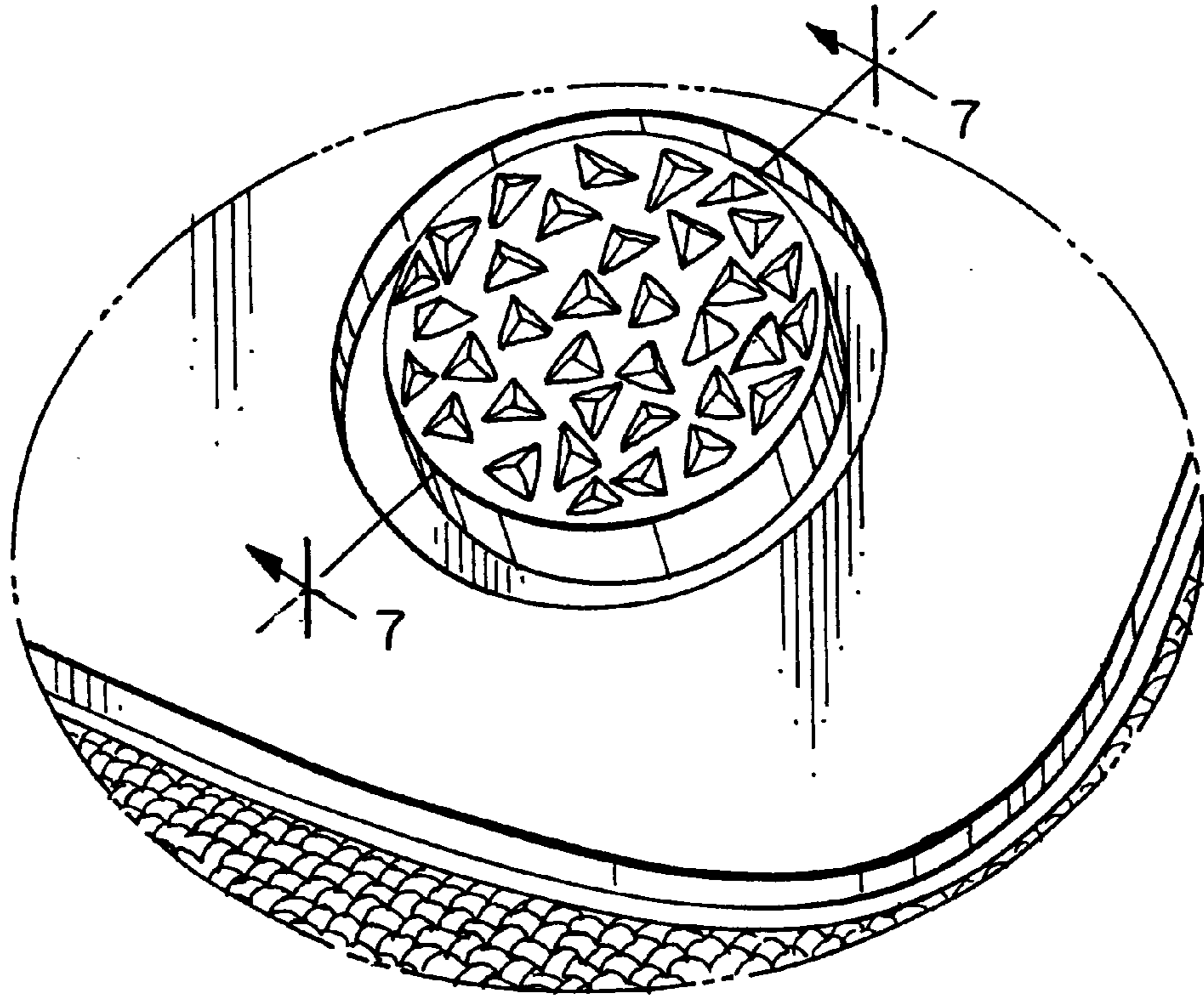

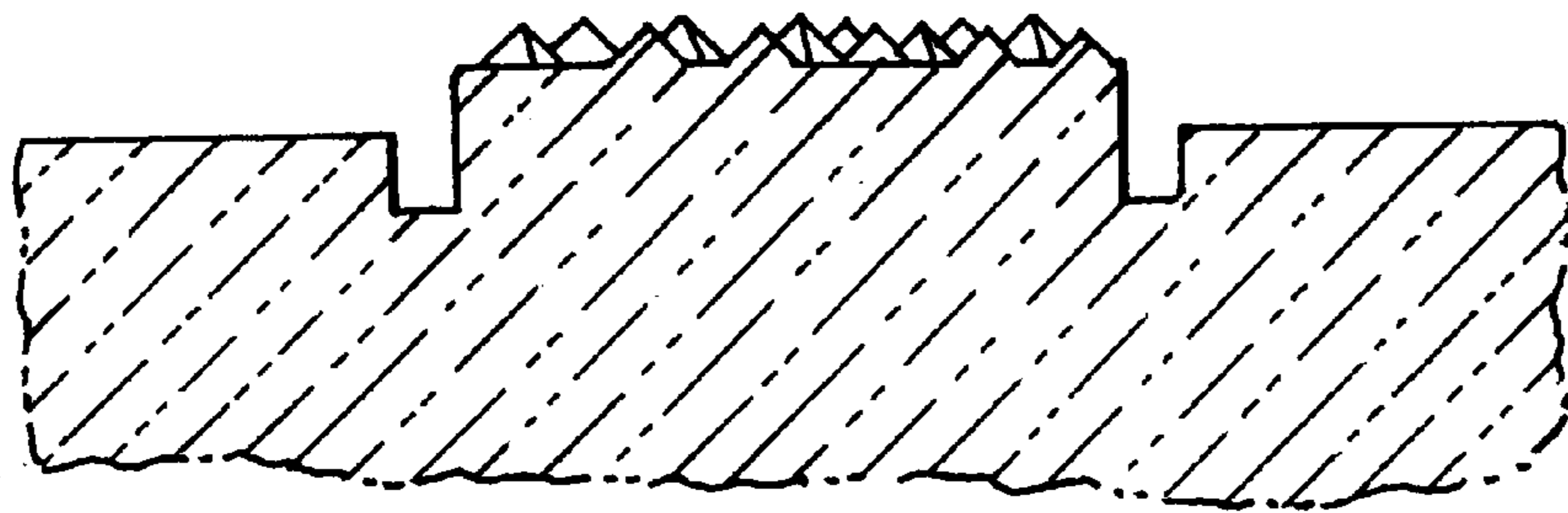

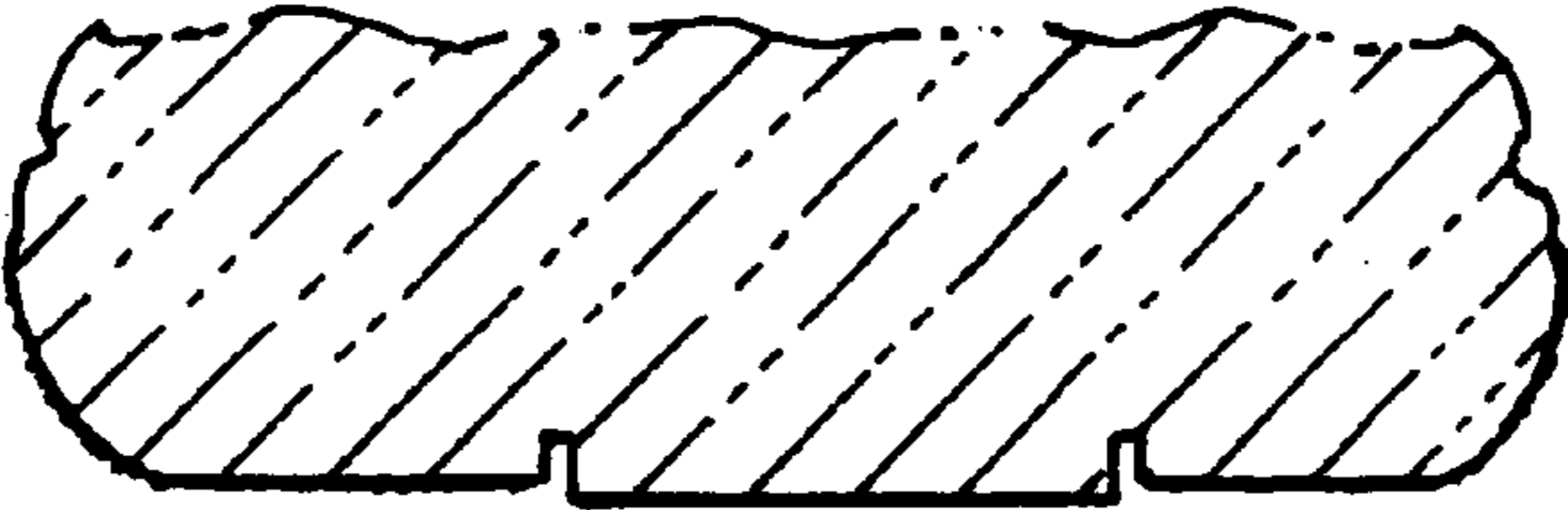

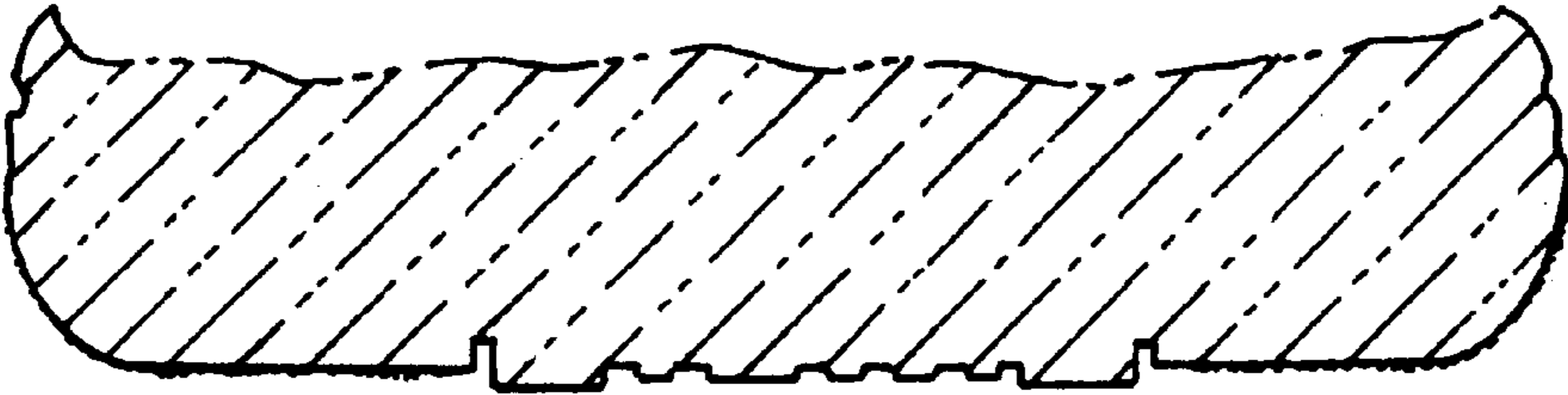

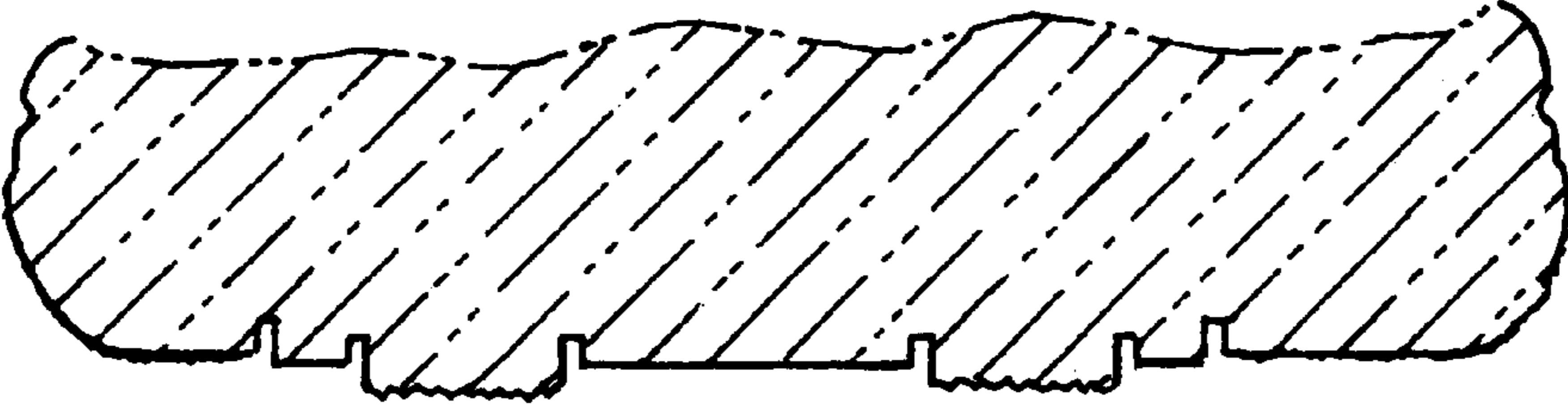
