FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the spinner bait box, in accordance with the invention;

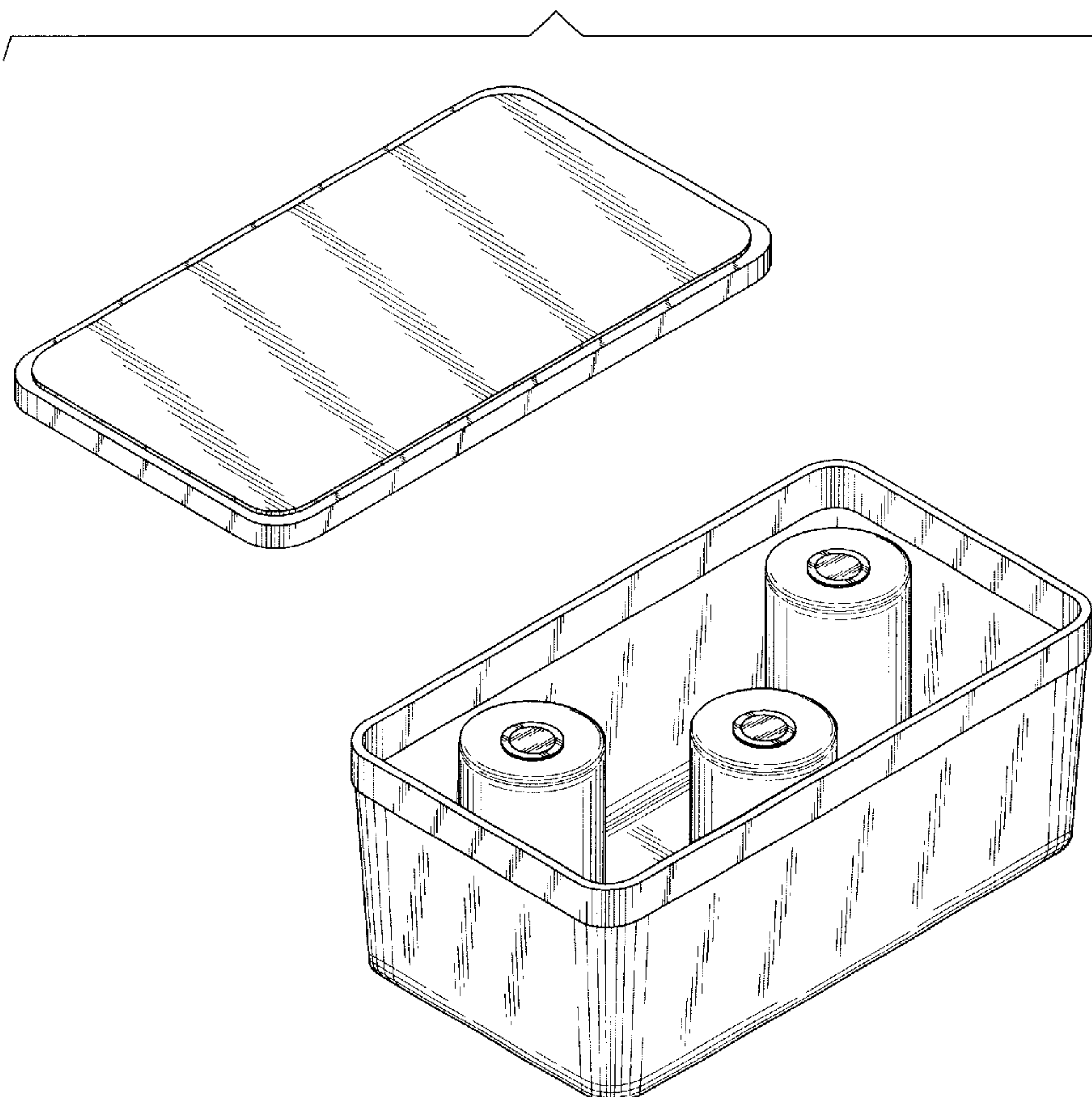
FIG. 2 is a elevation front view thereof; the rear view being a mirror image thereof;

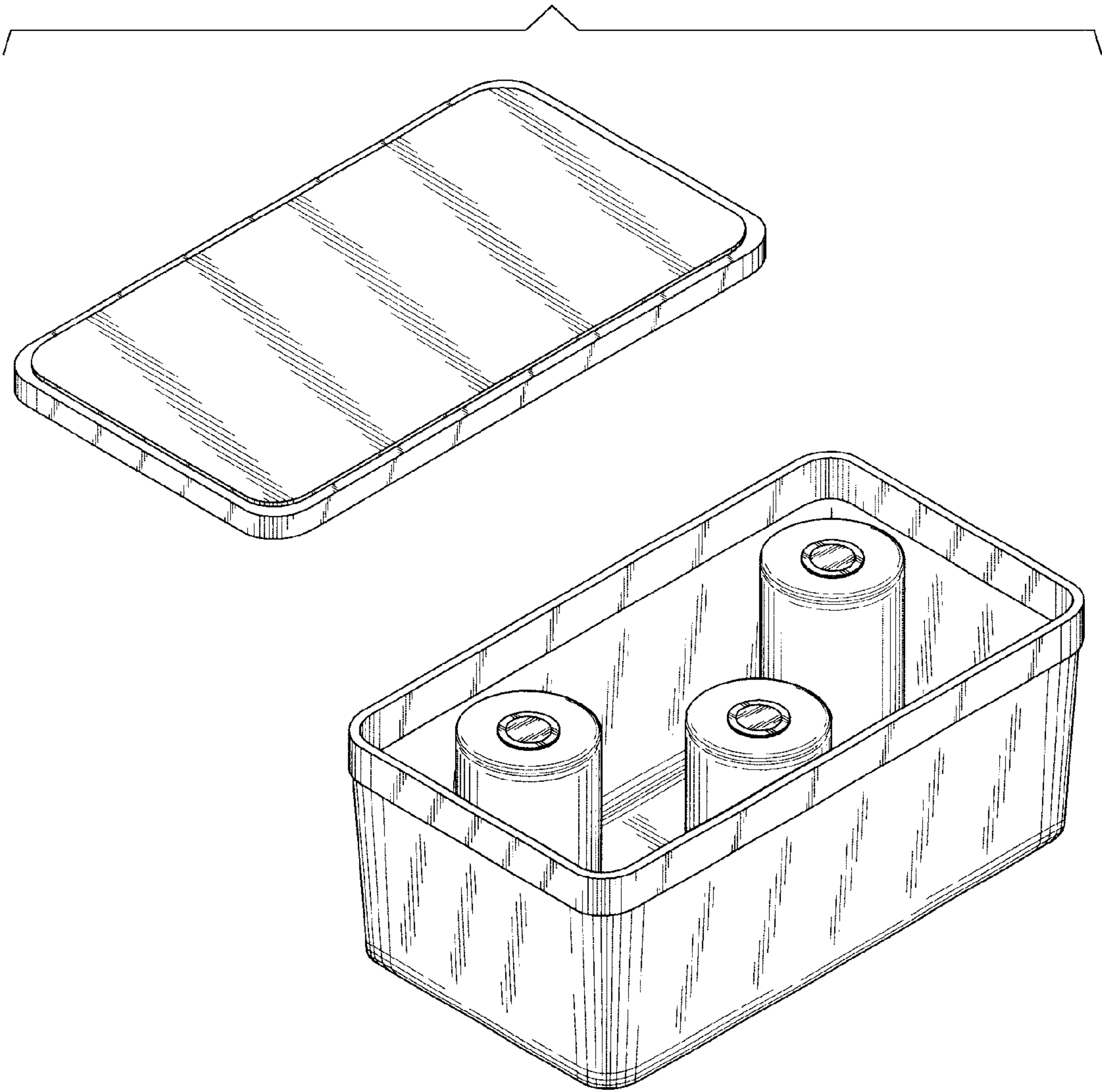

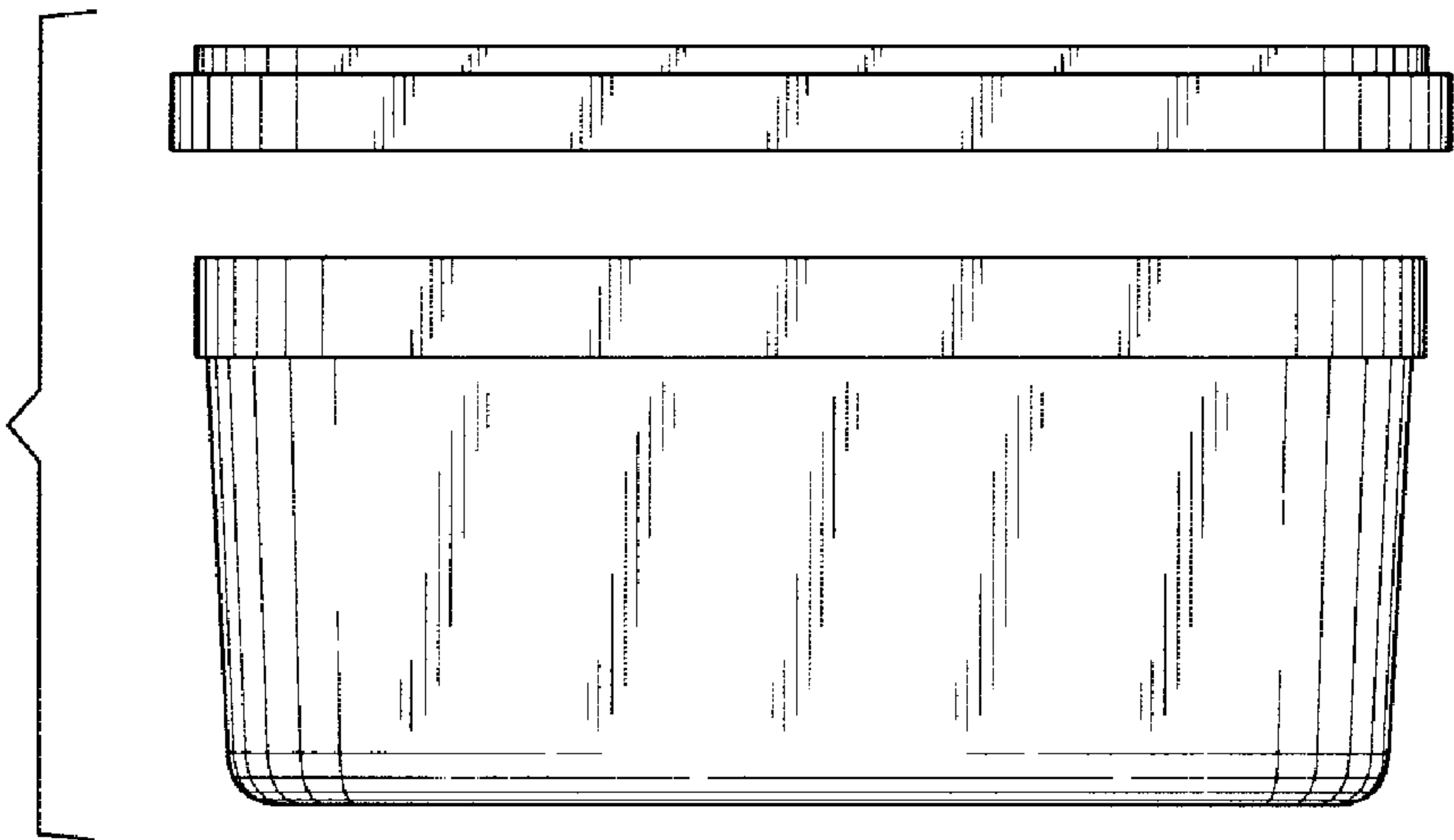

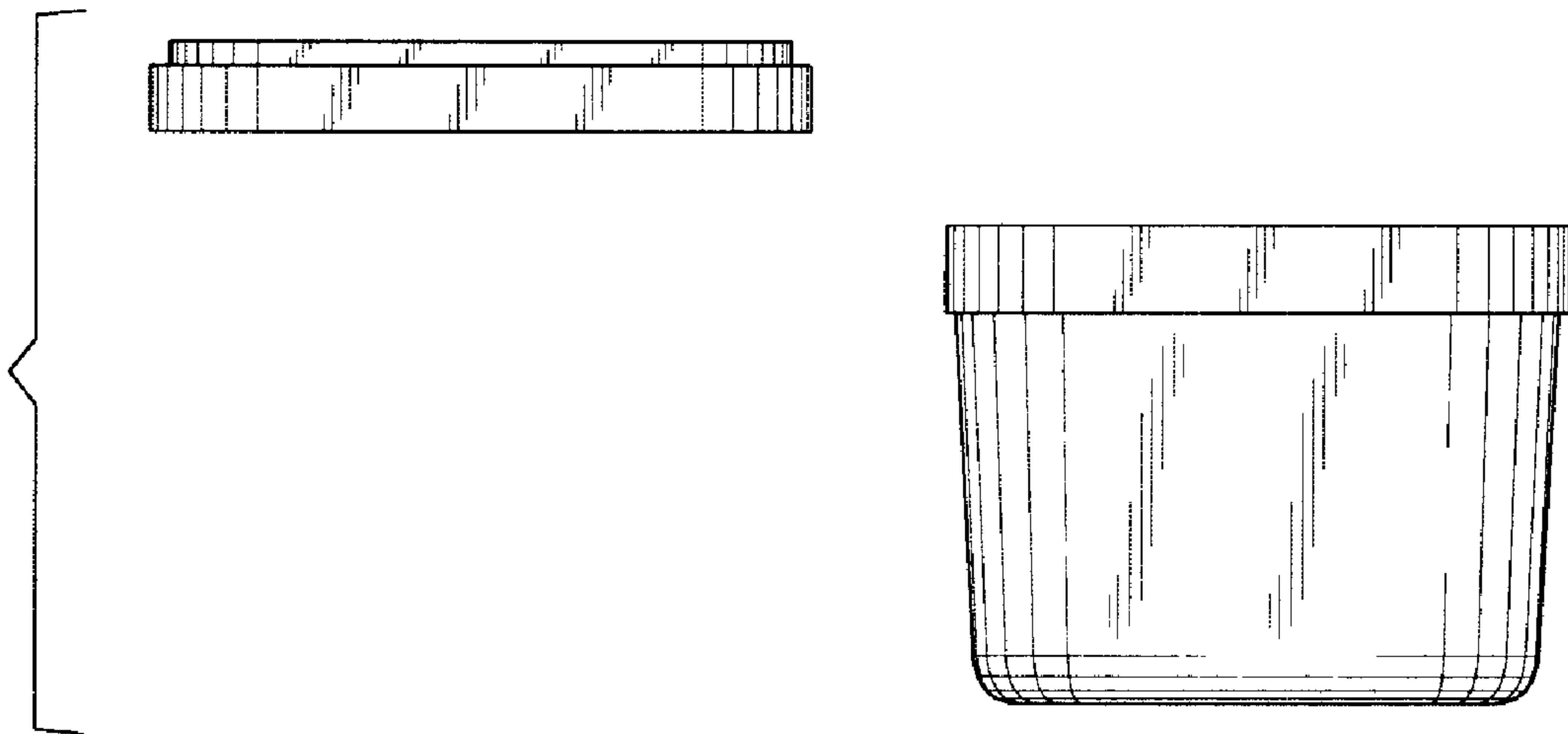
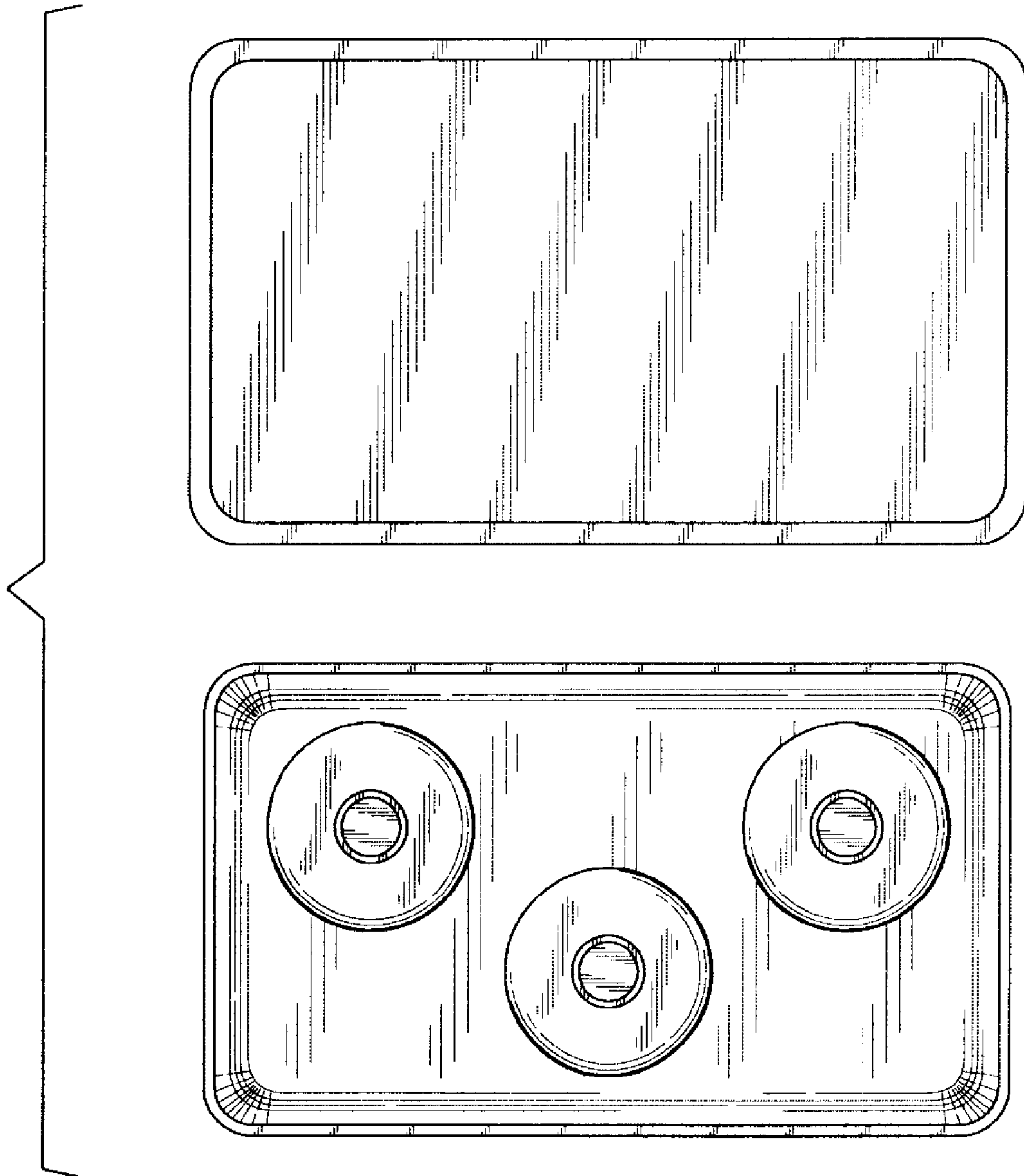
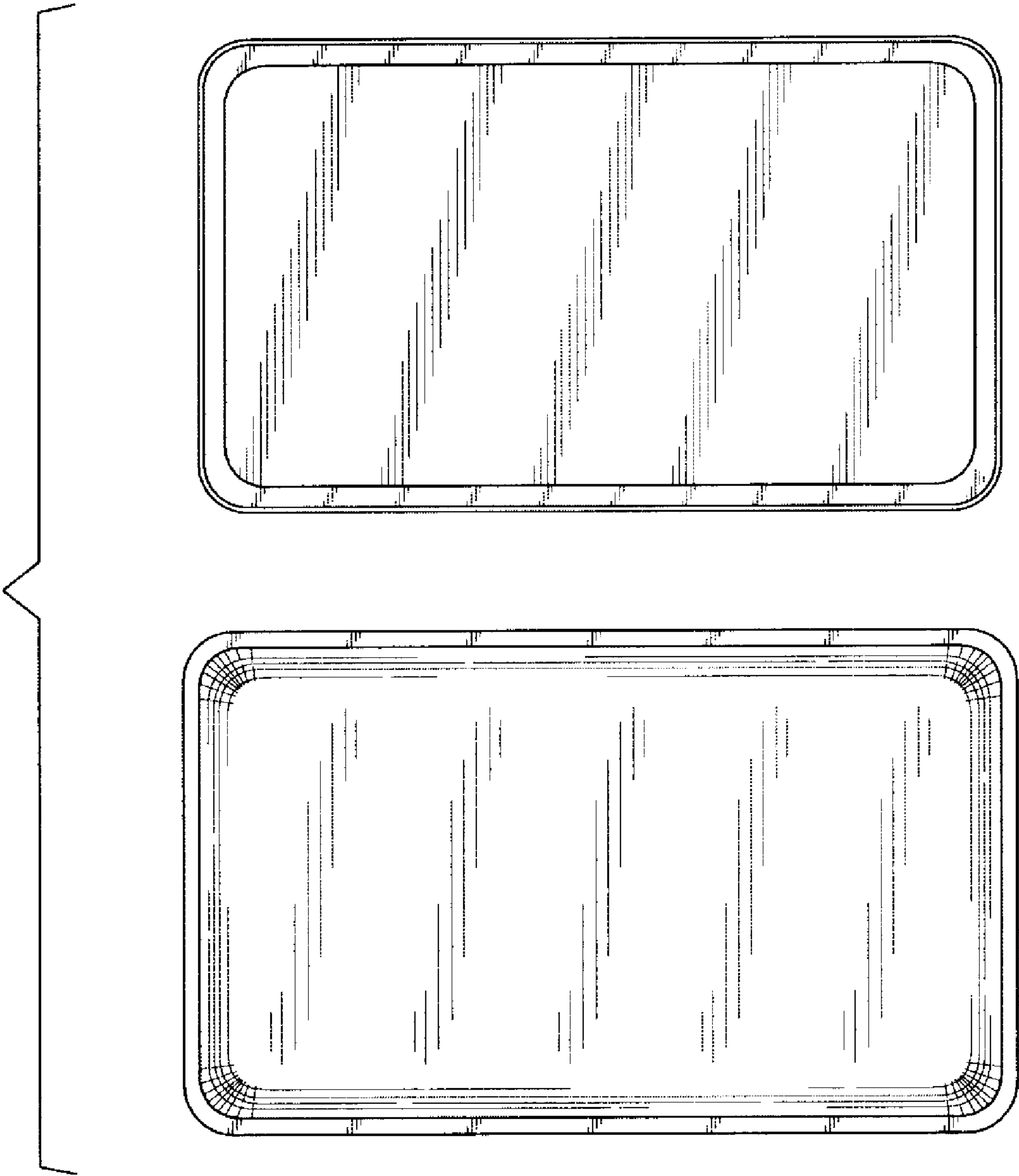
