DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

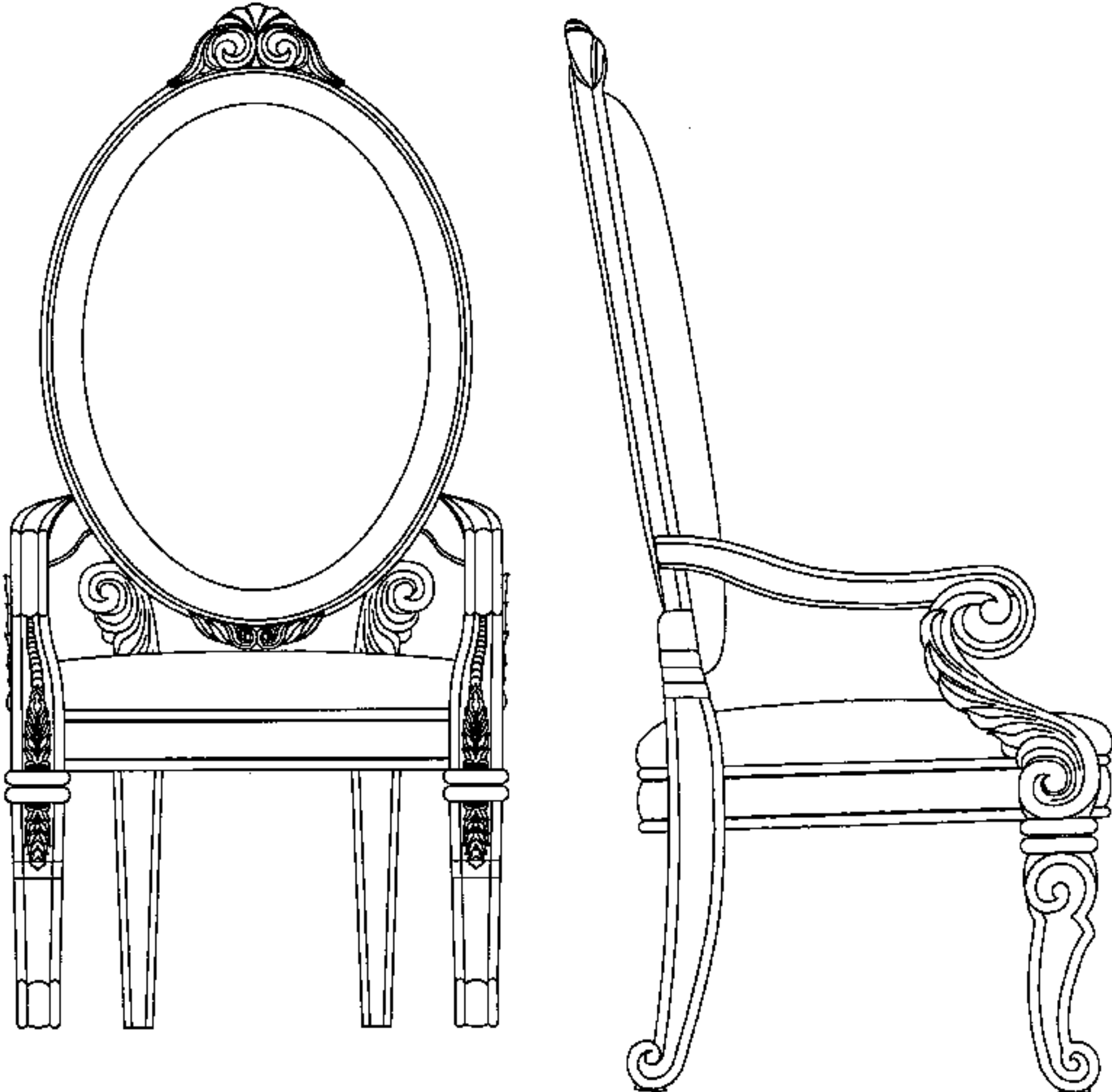
FIG. 6 is front elevational detail of the top of the back of the chair illustrating the ornamentation thereon in enlarged detail;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational detail of the bottom of the back of the chair illustrating the ornamentation thereon in enlarged detail; and,

FIG. 8 is a front elevation detail view of the knee of the chair illustrating the ornamentation thereon in enlarged detail.

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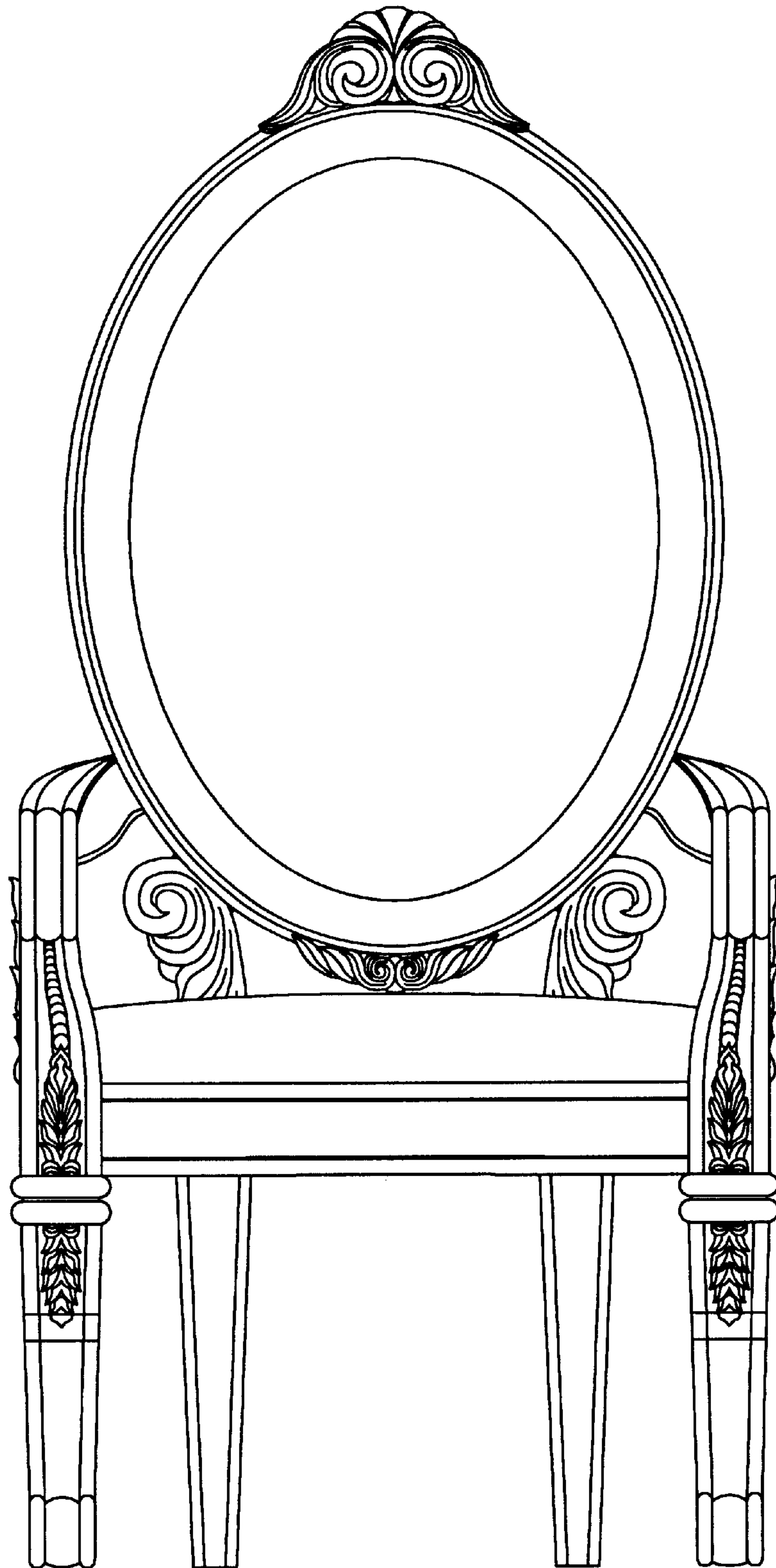

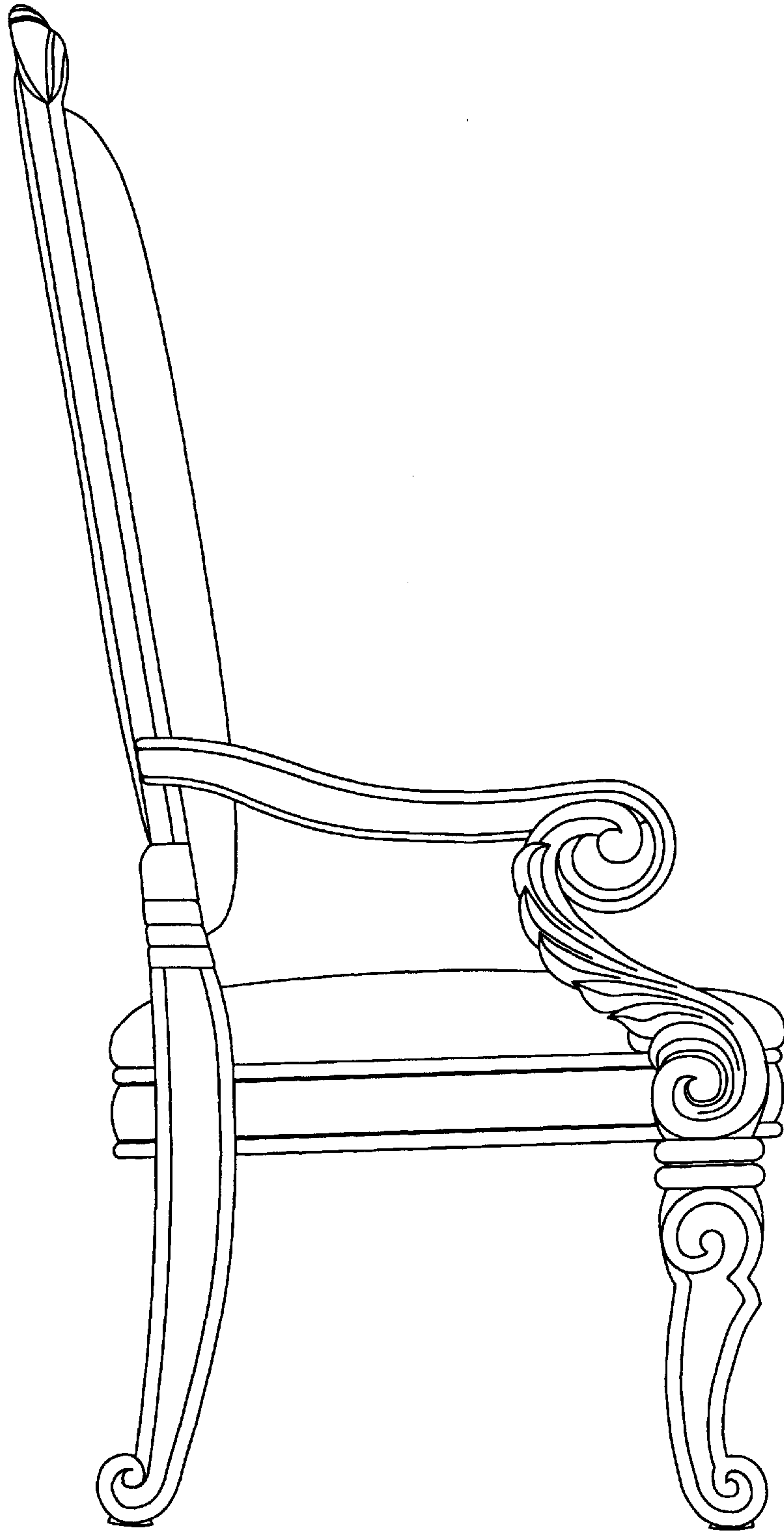

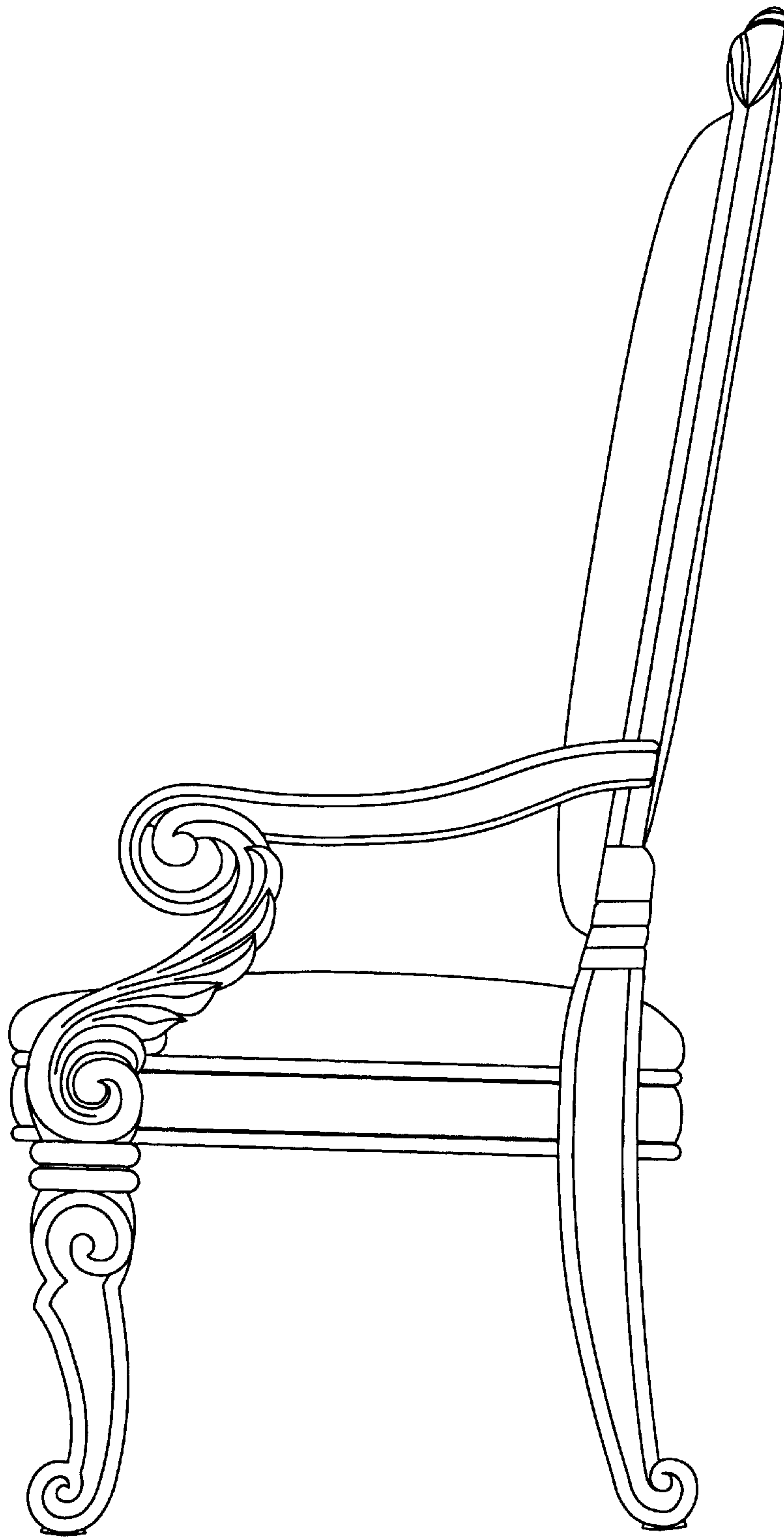

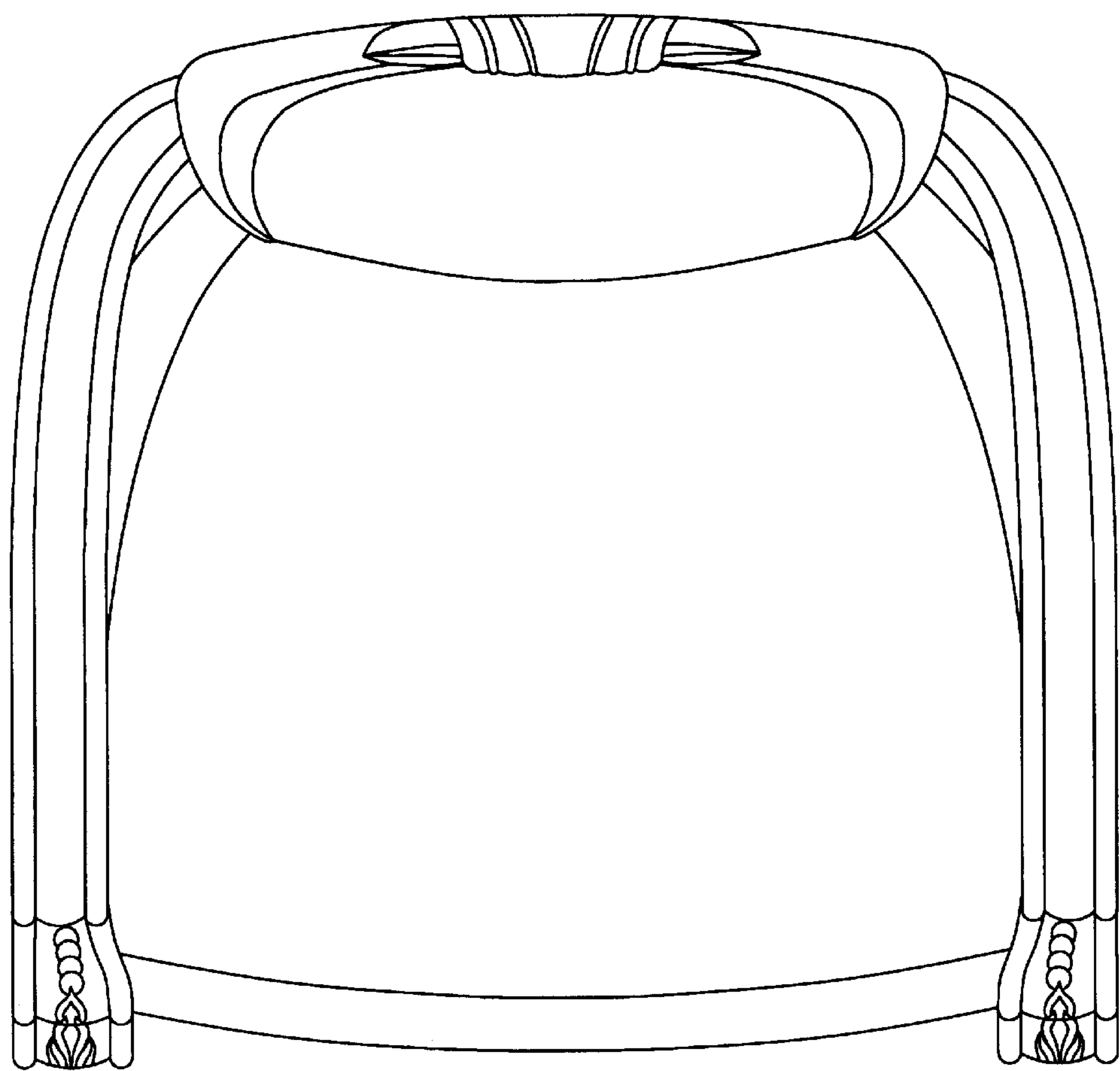

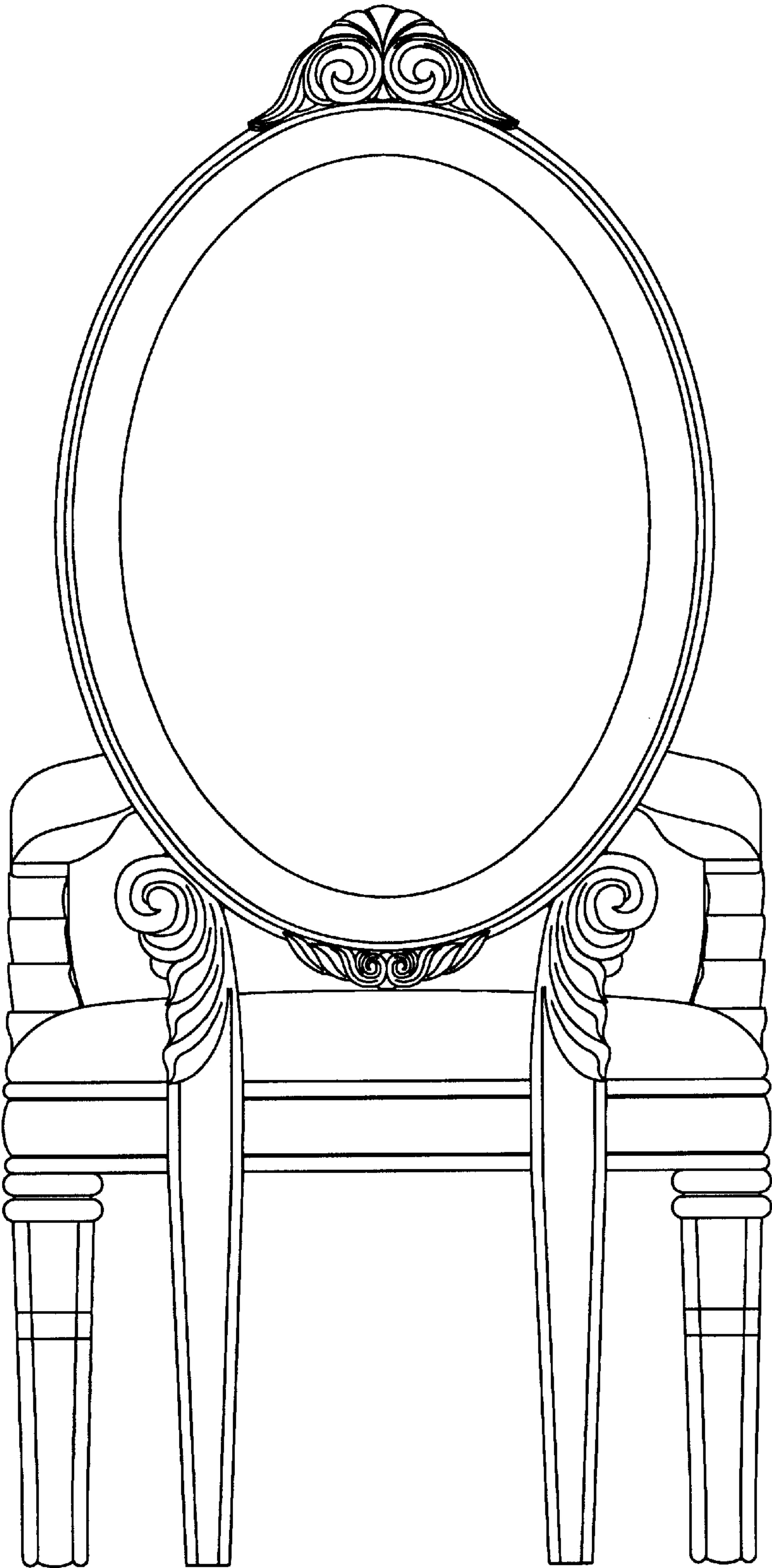

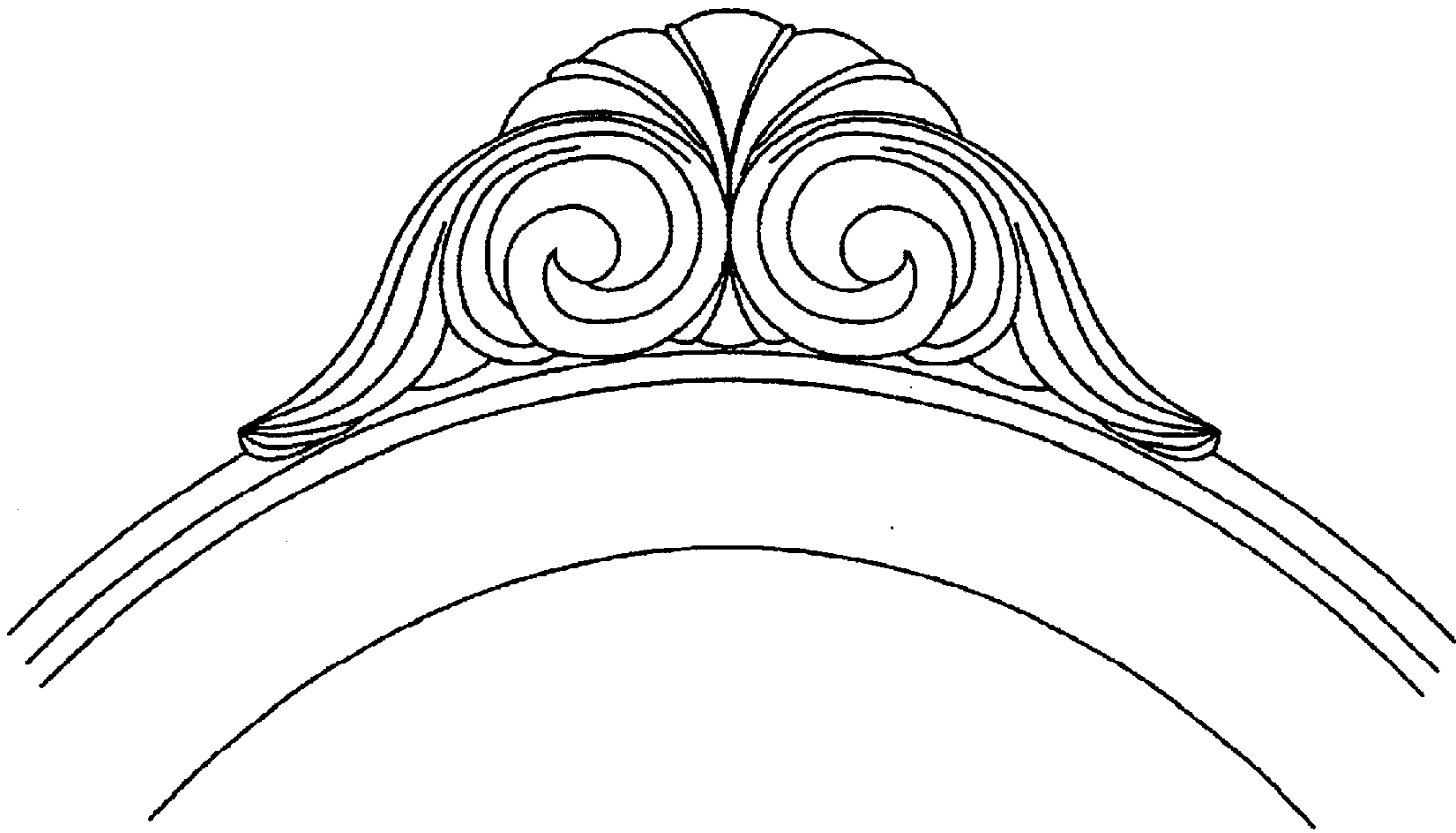

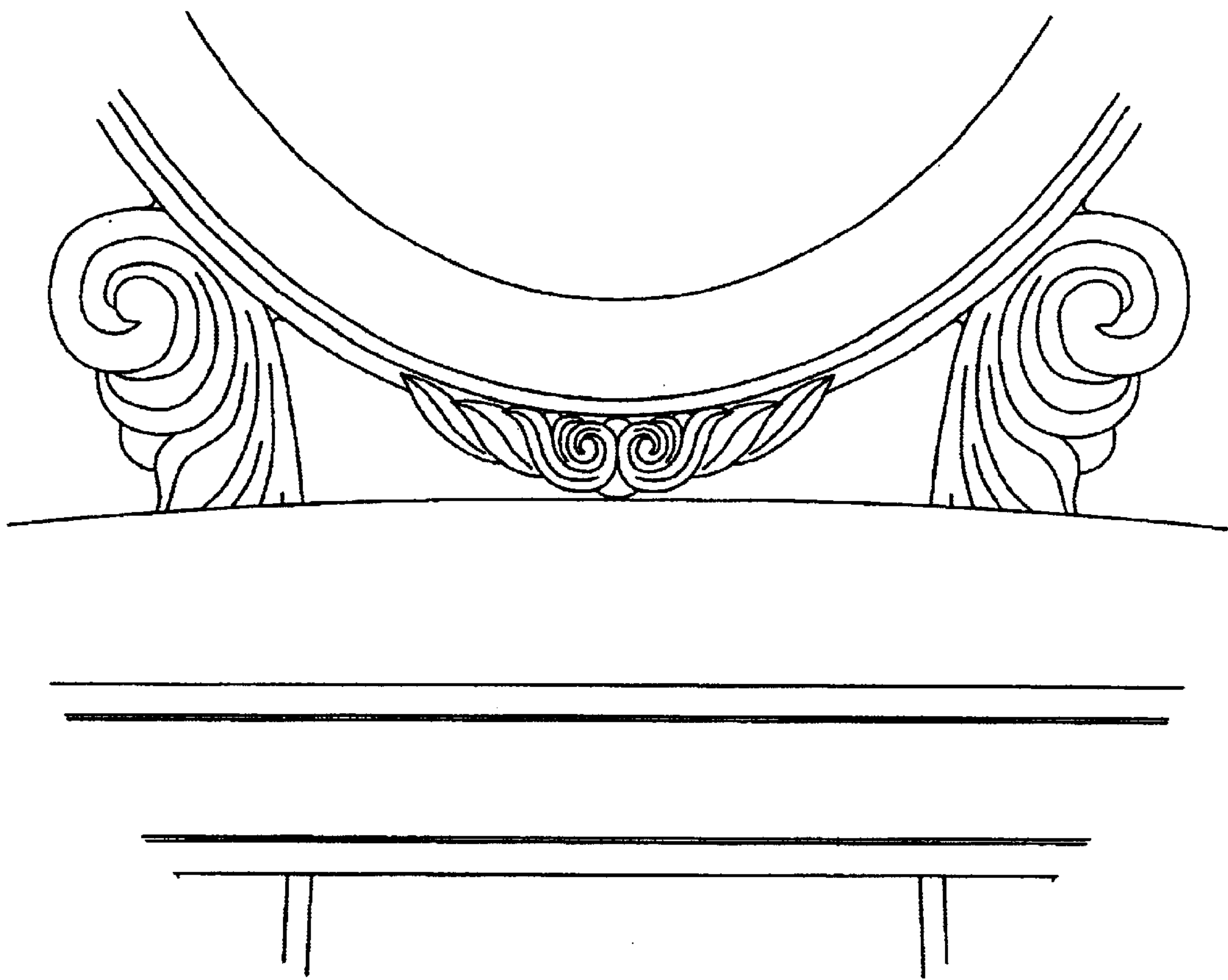

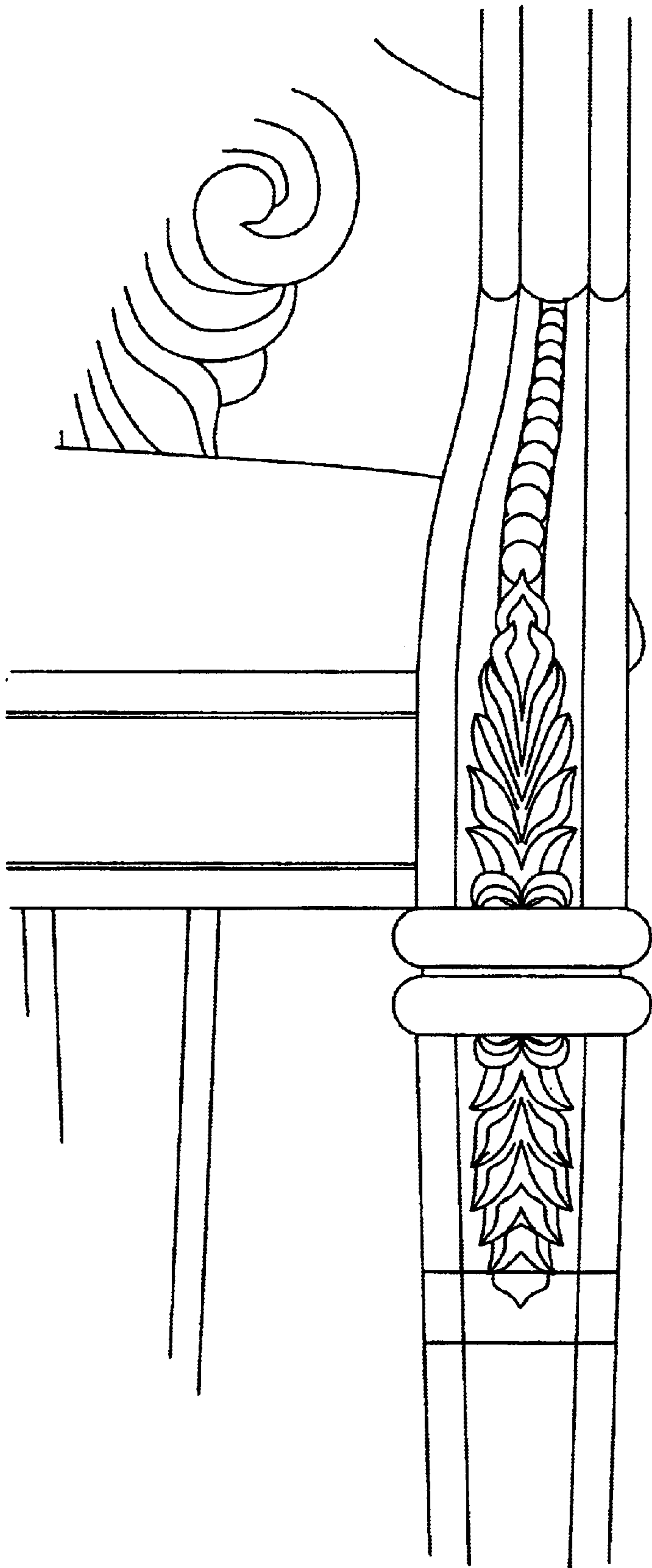
