DESCRIPTION

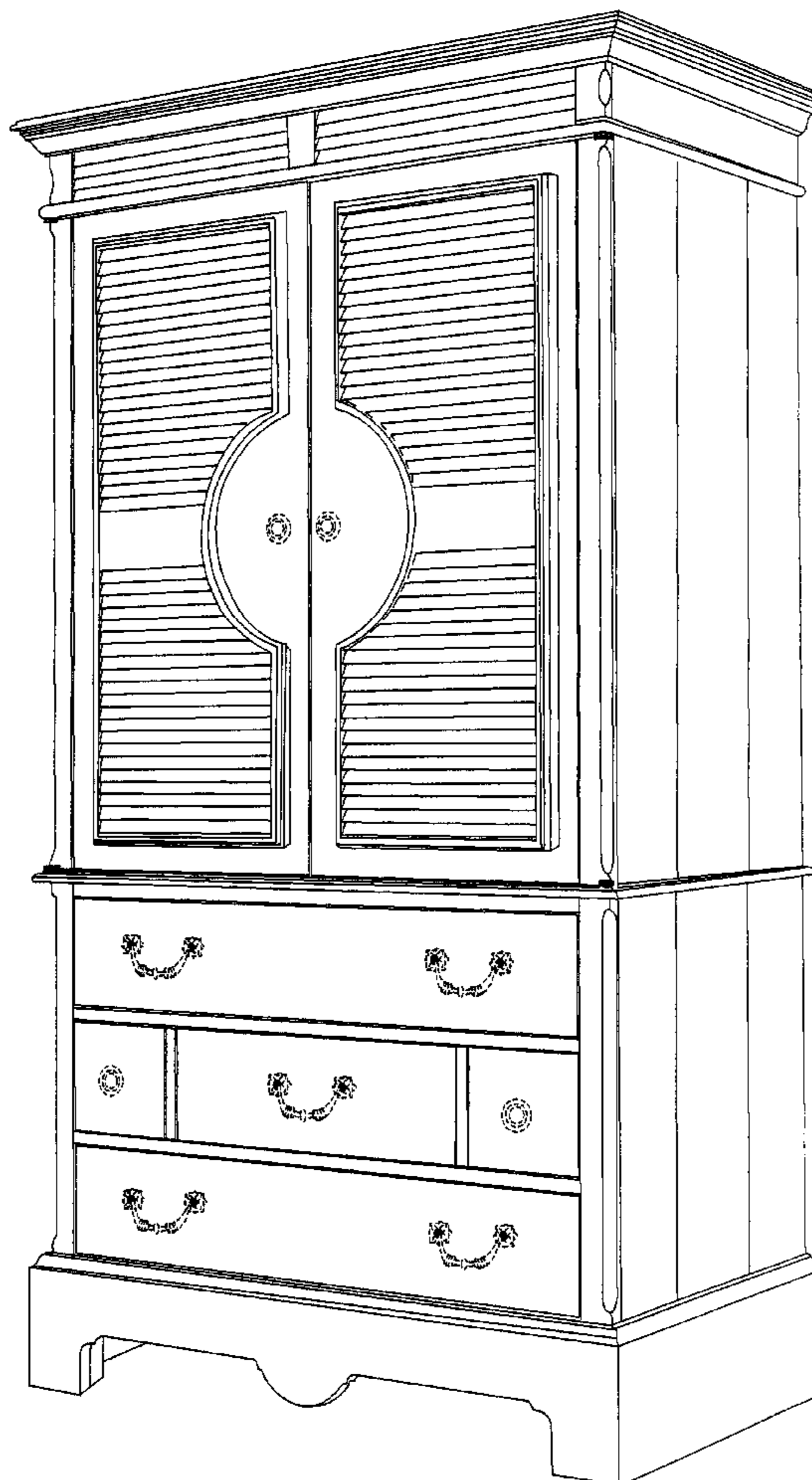
FIG. 1 is a front view of an armoire of an embodiment the present invention.

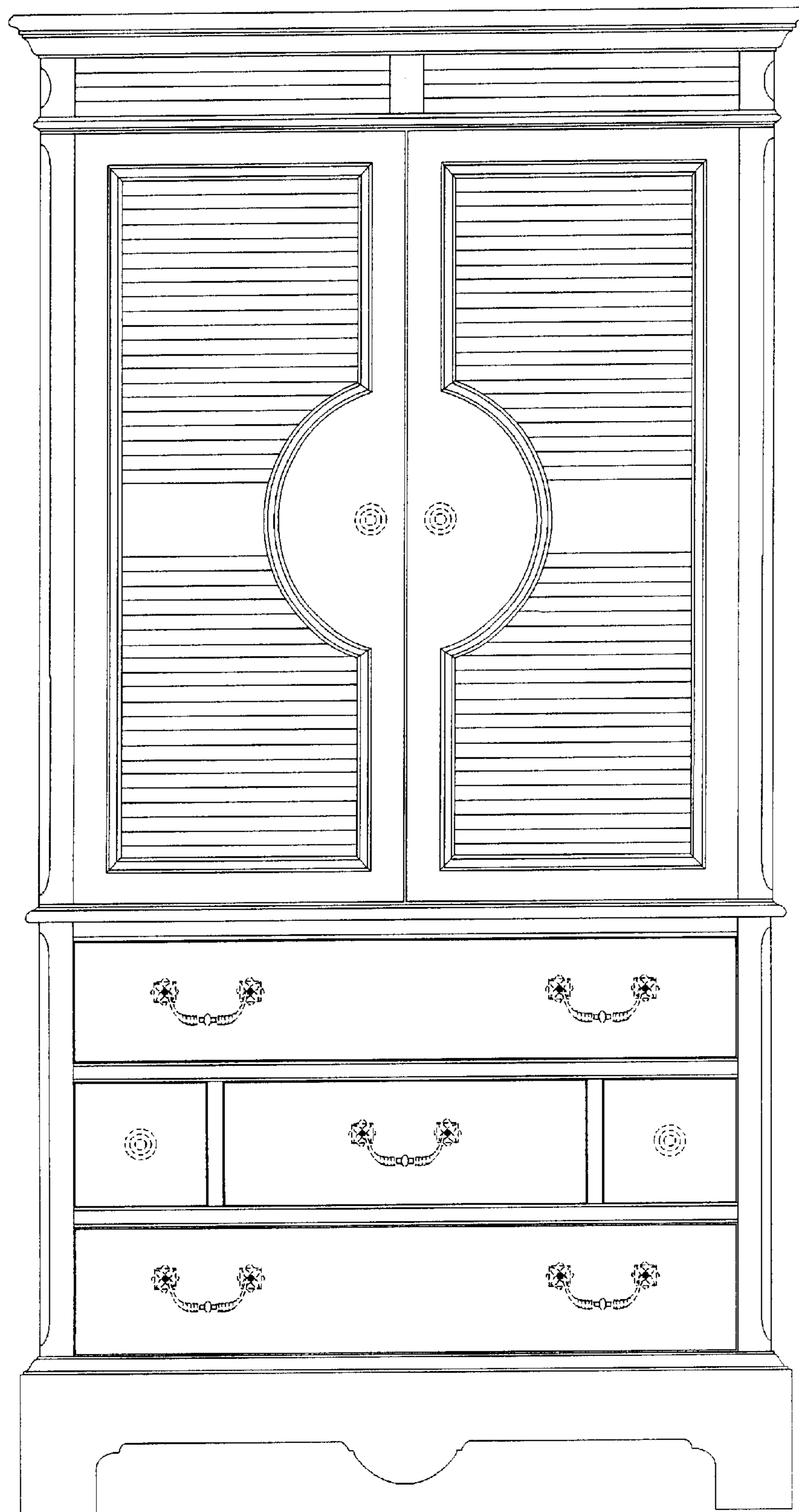

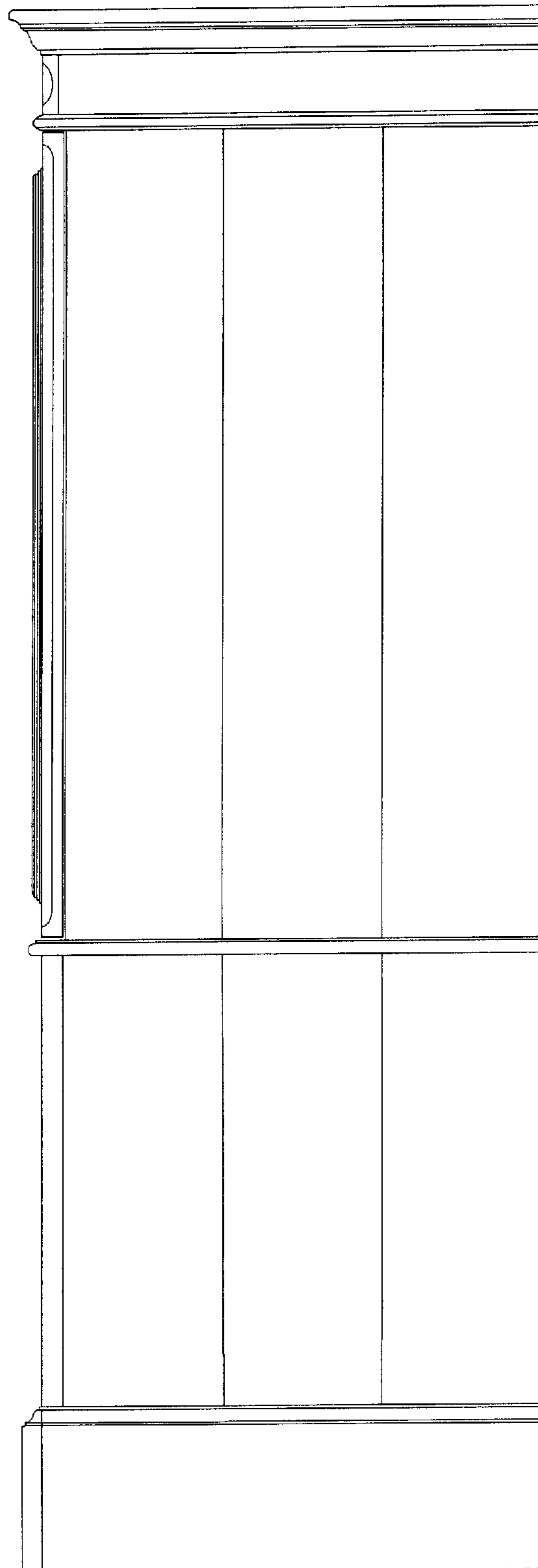

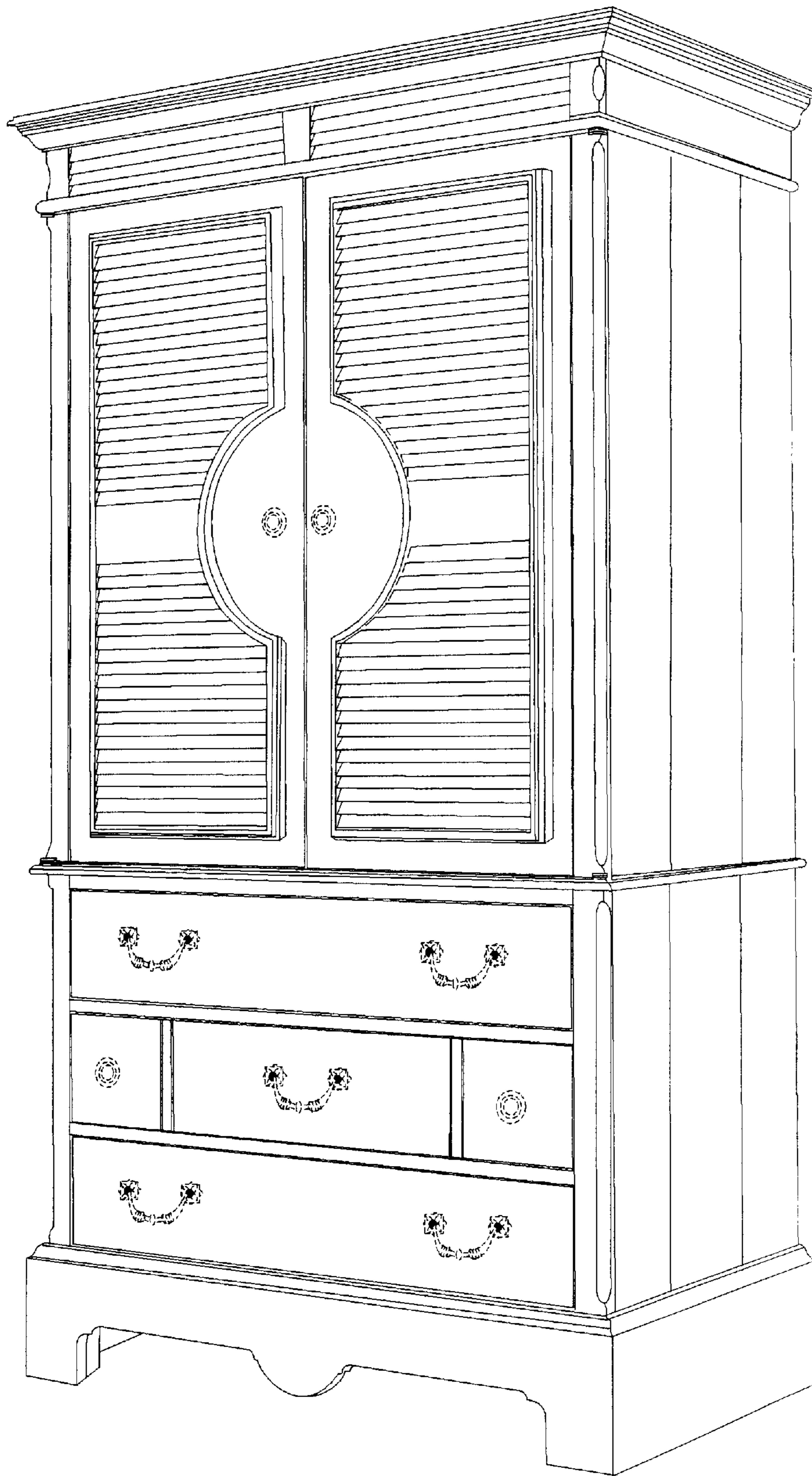
