FIG. 5 is a left side view of FIG. 1;

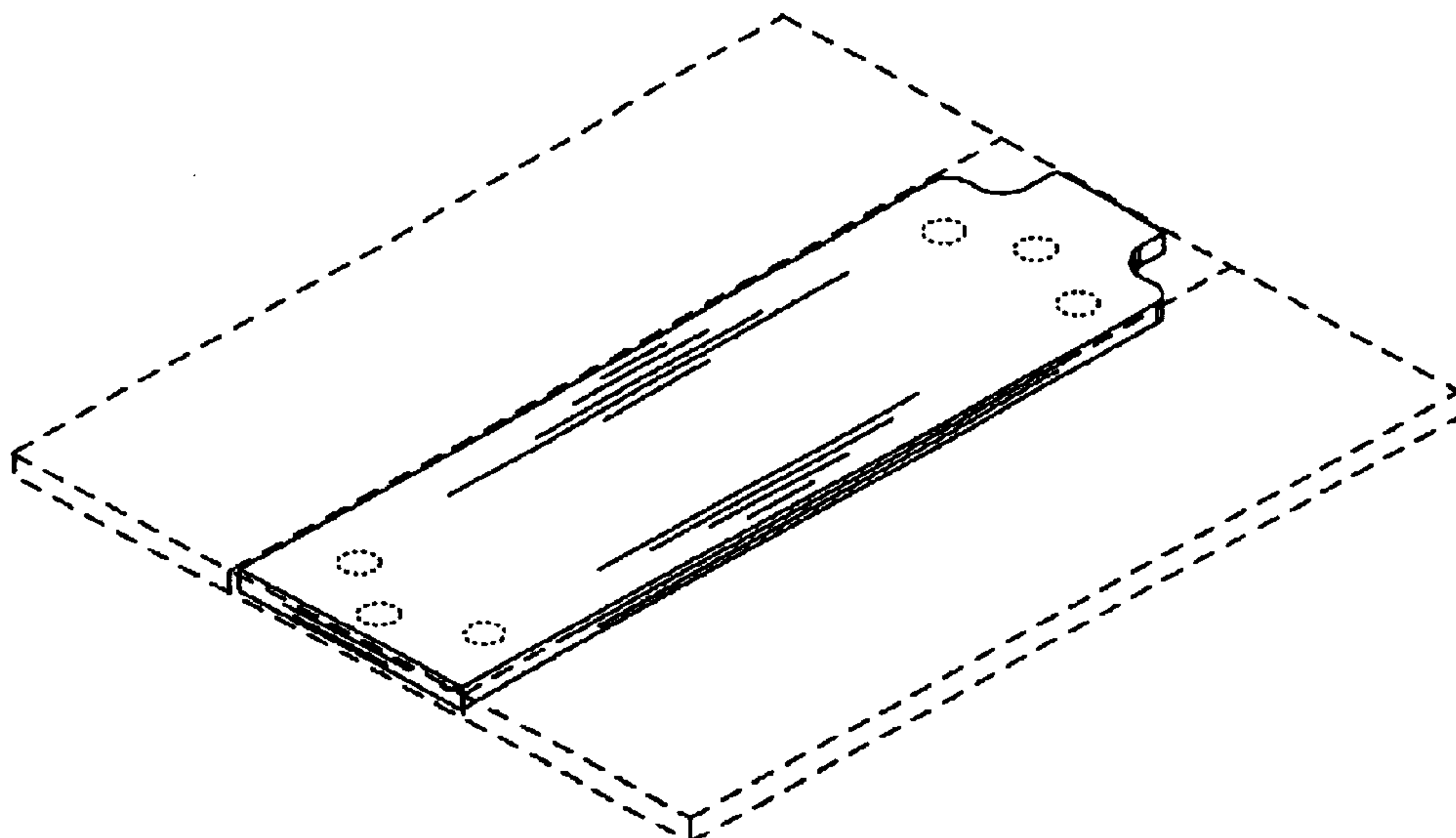
FIG. 6 is a top, left side and front perspective view of FIG. 1 shown in a condition of use;

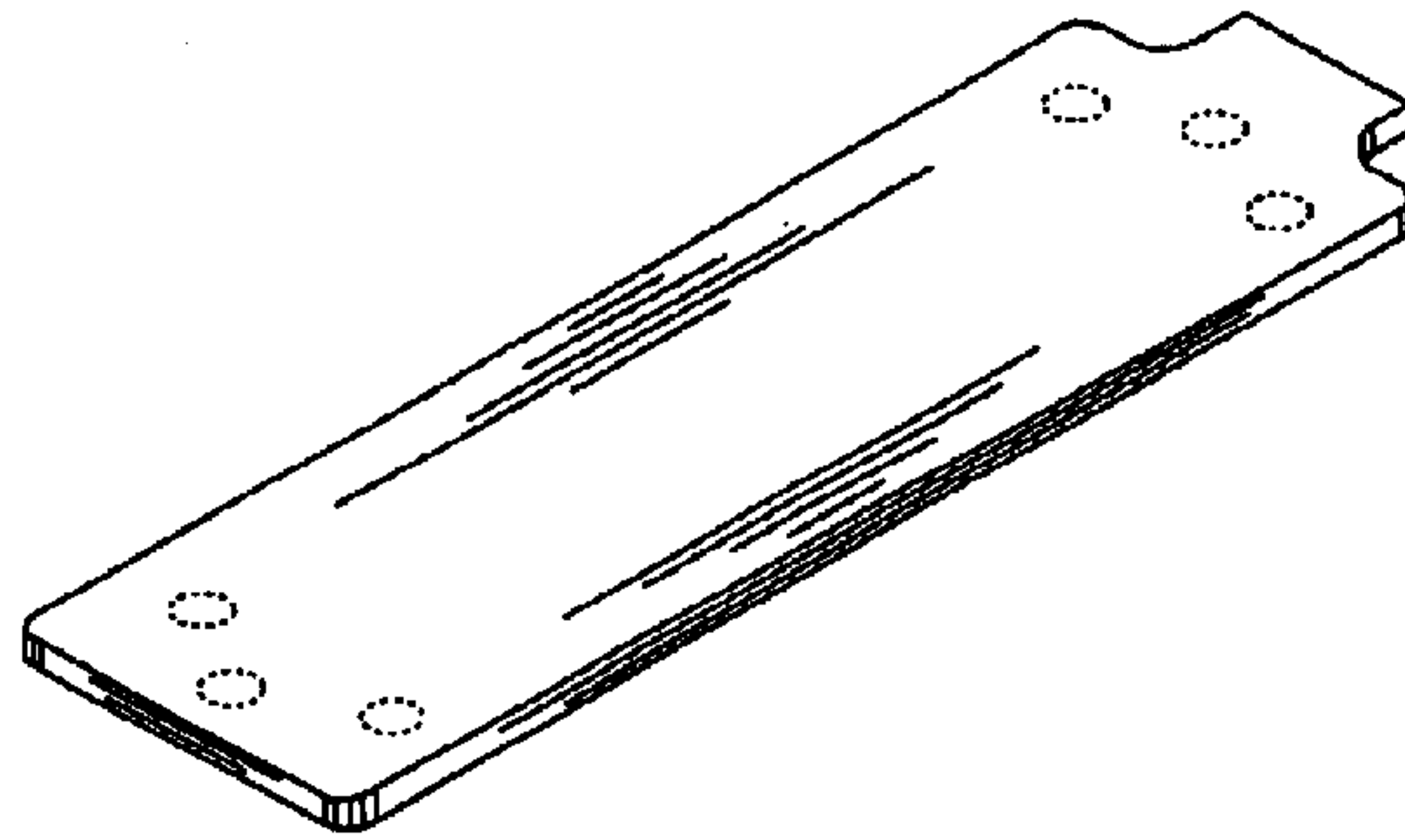

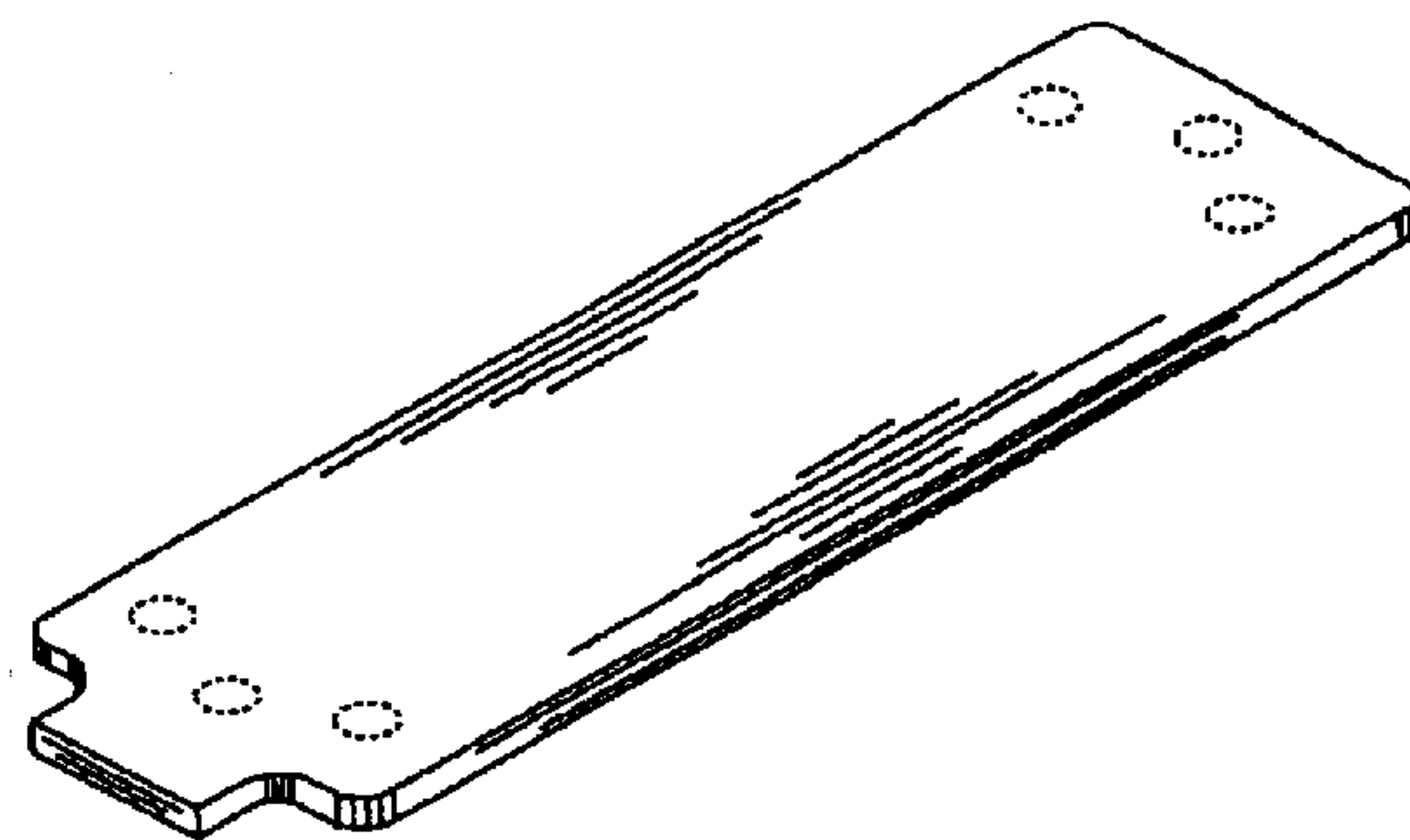

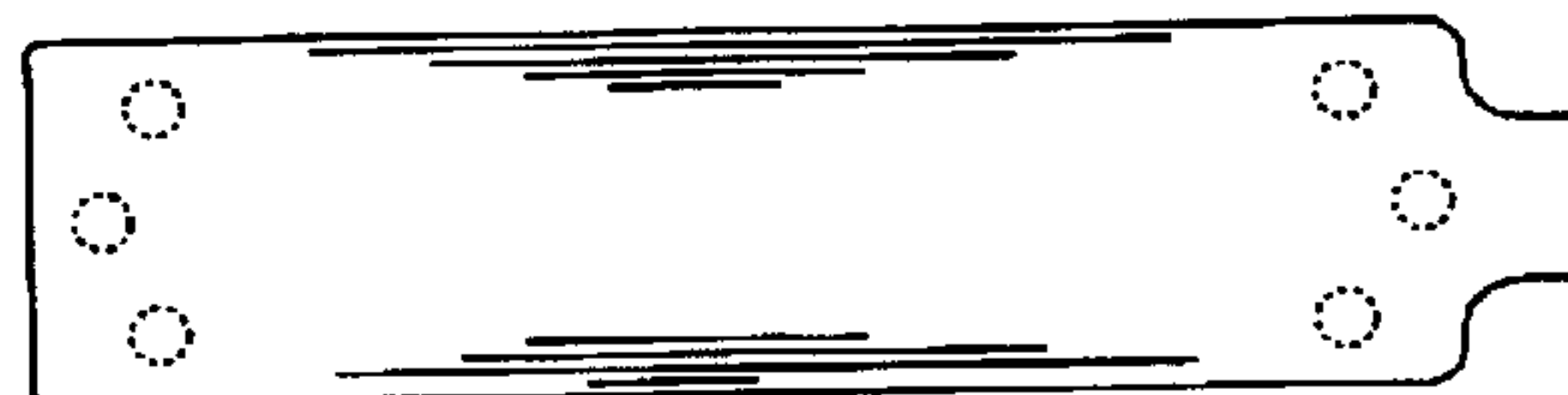

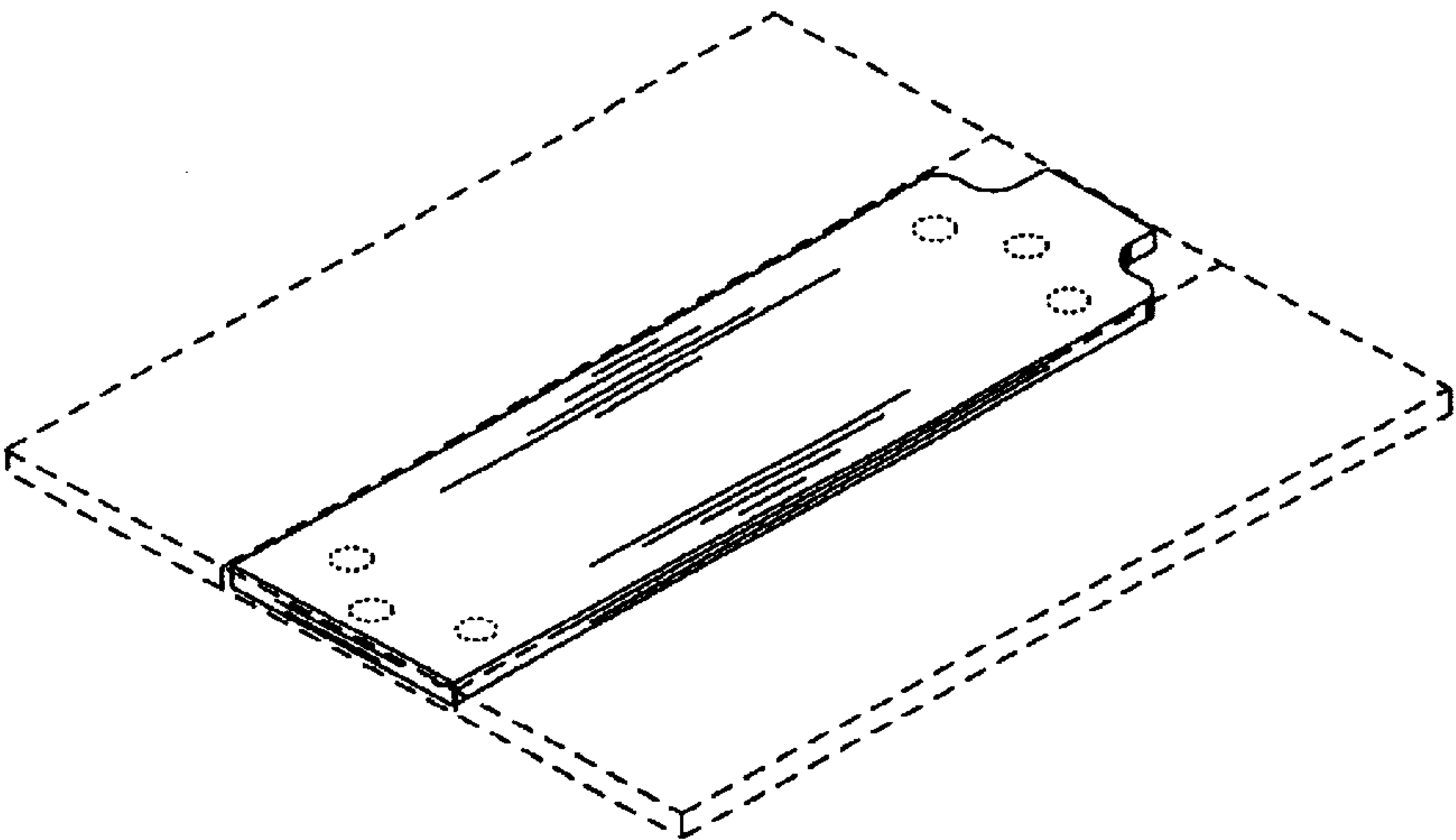

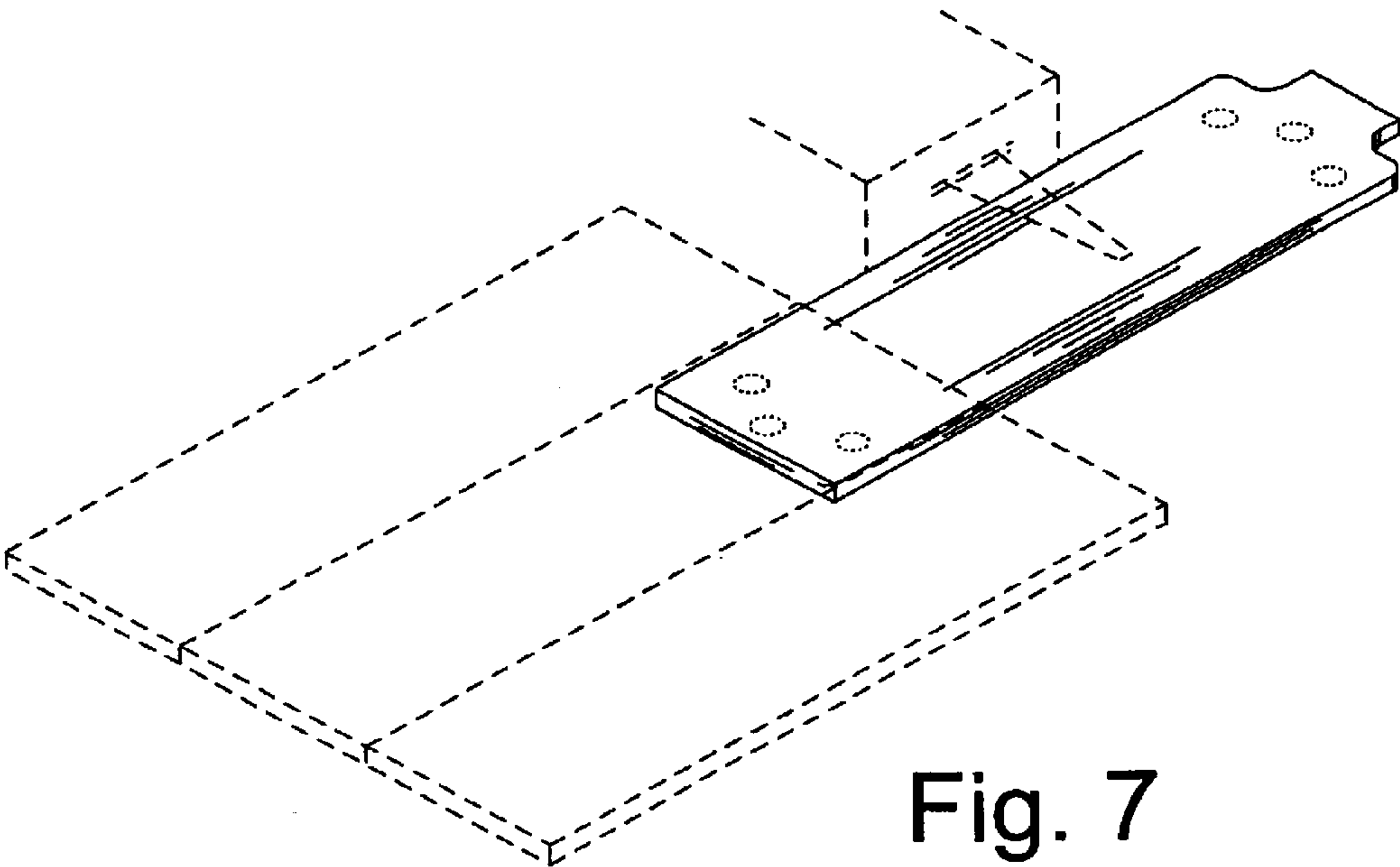

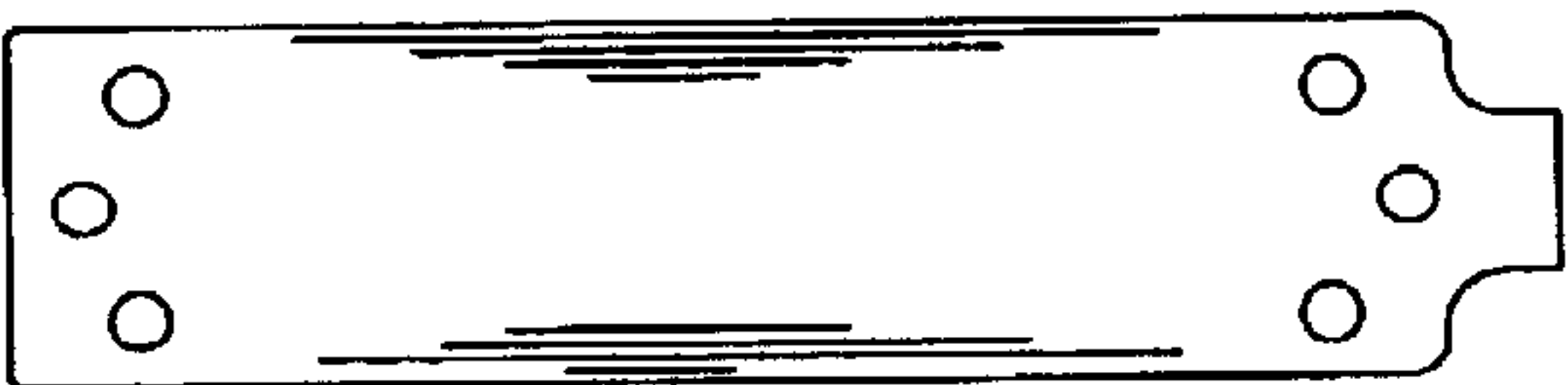
