DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a knife showing my new design, with the blades in the closed position;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the knife, with the blades in the closed position;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the knife, with the blades in the closed position;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the knife, with the blades in the closed position;

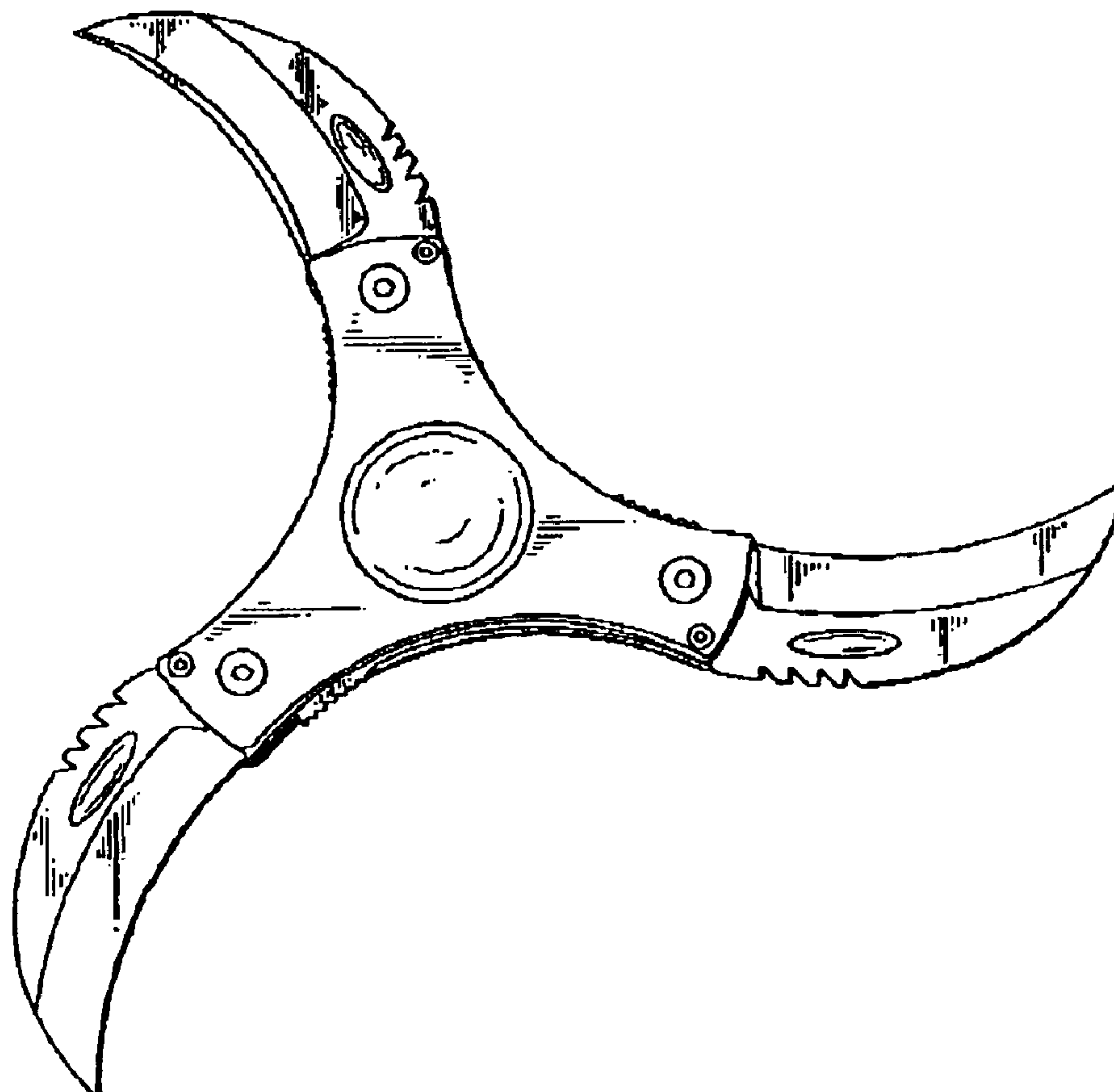
FIG. 5 is a top view of the knife, with the blades in the open position;

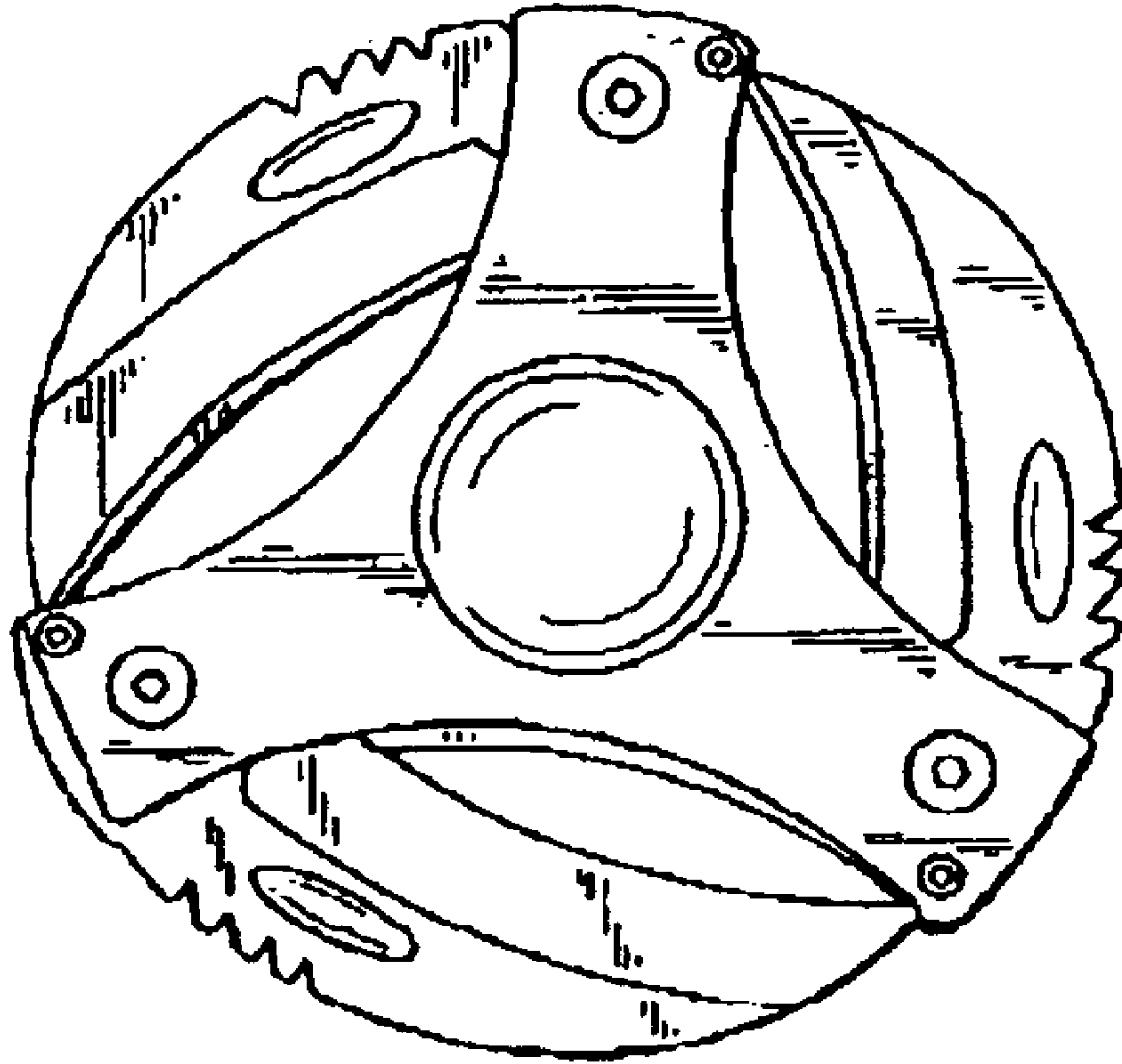

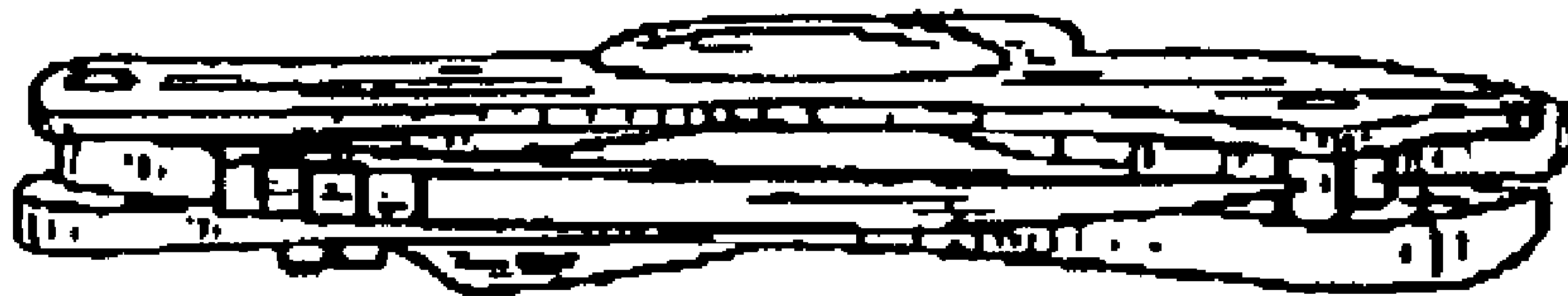

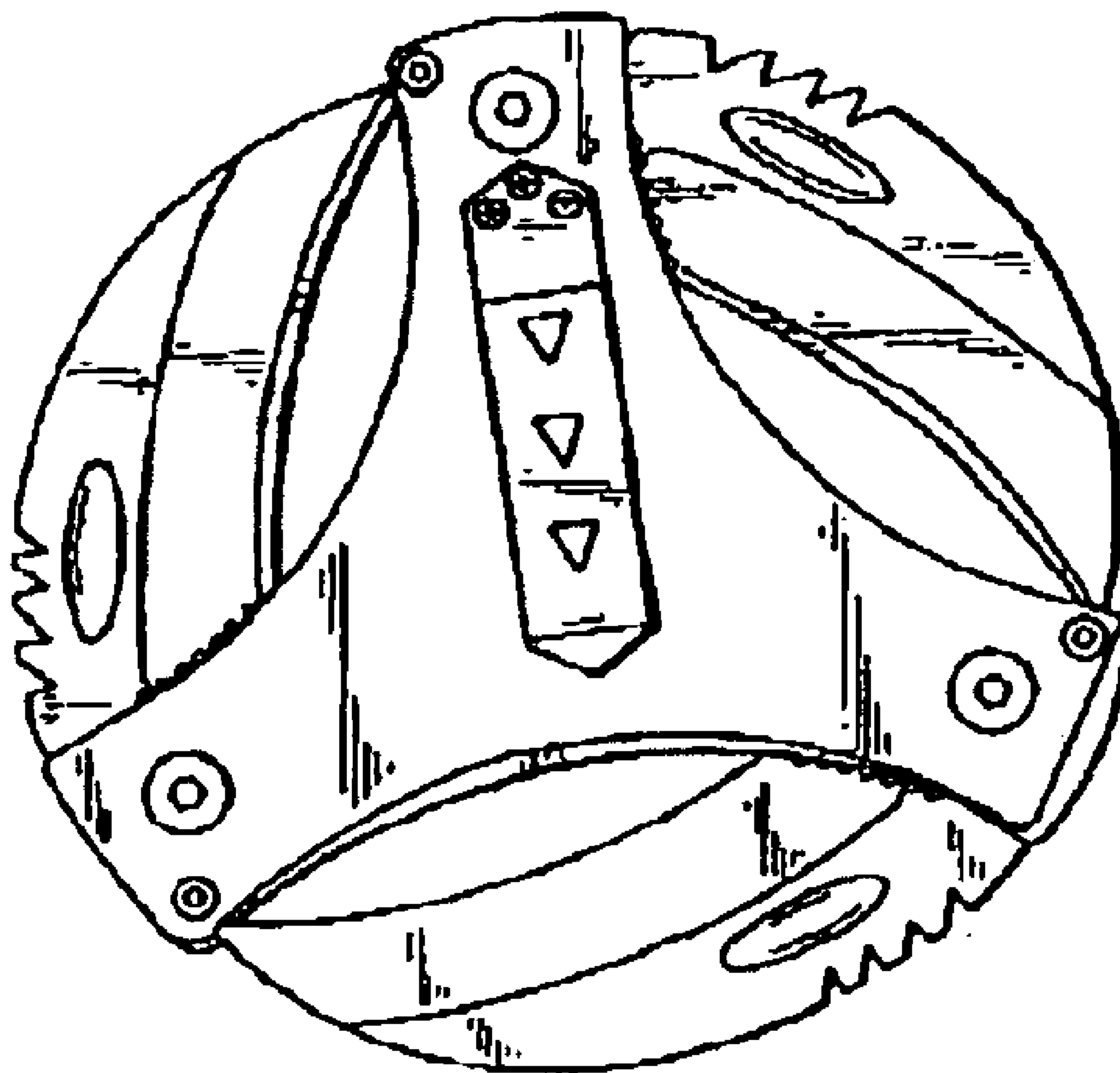

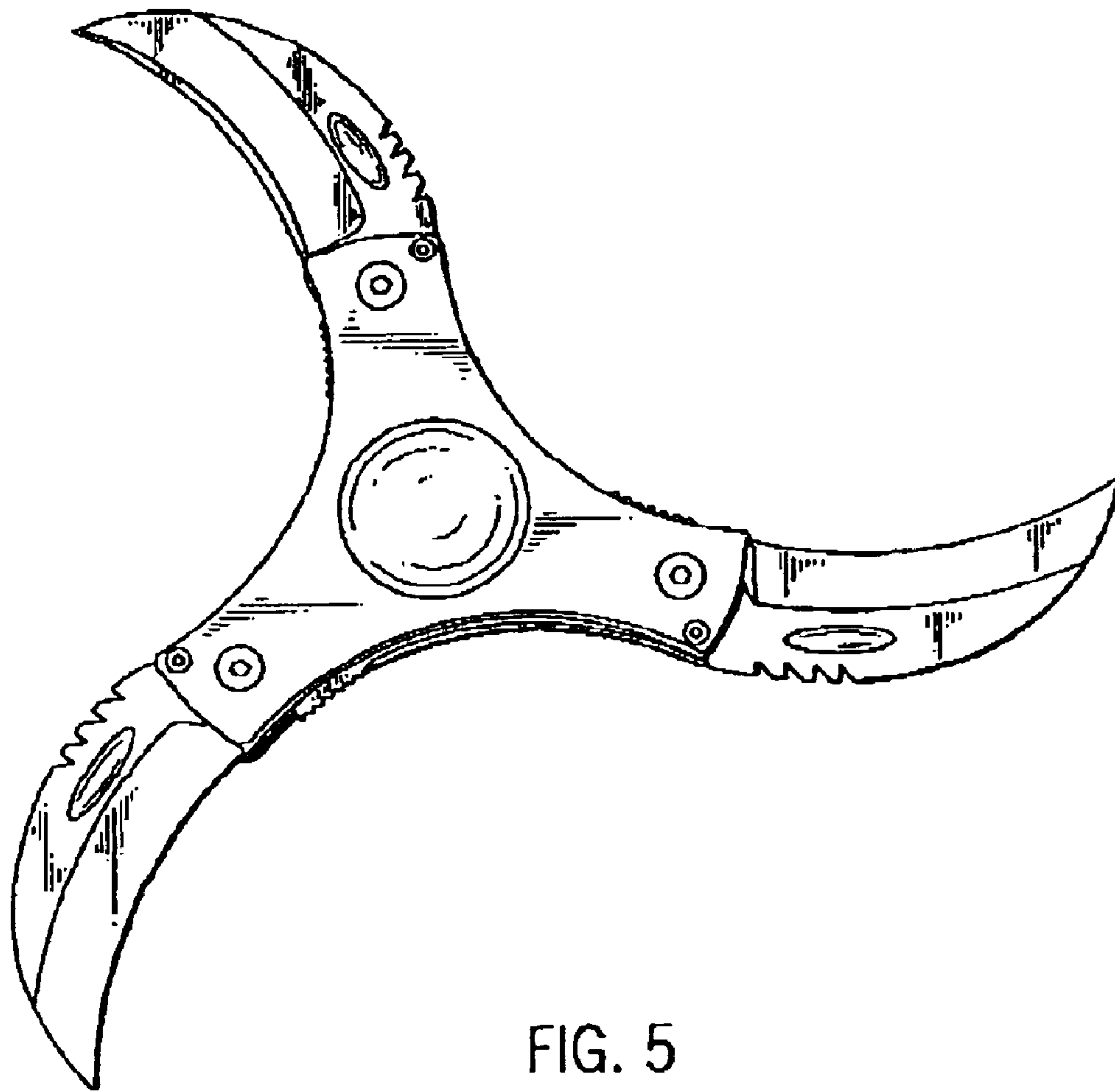

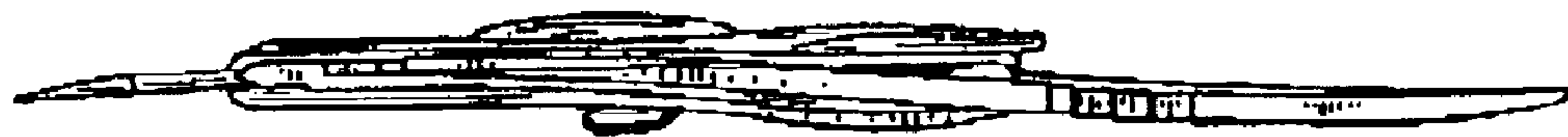

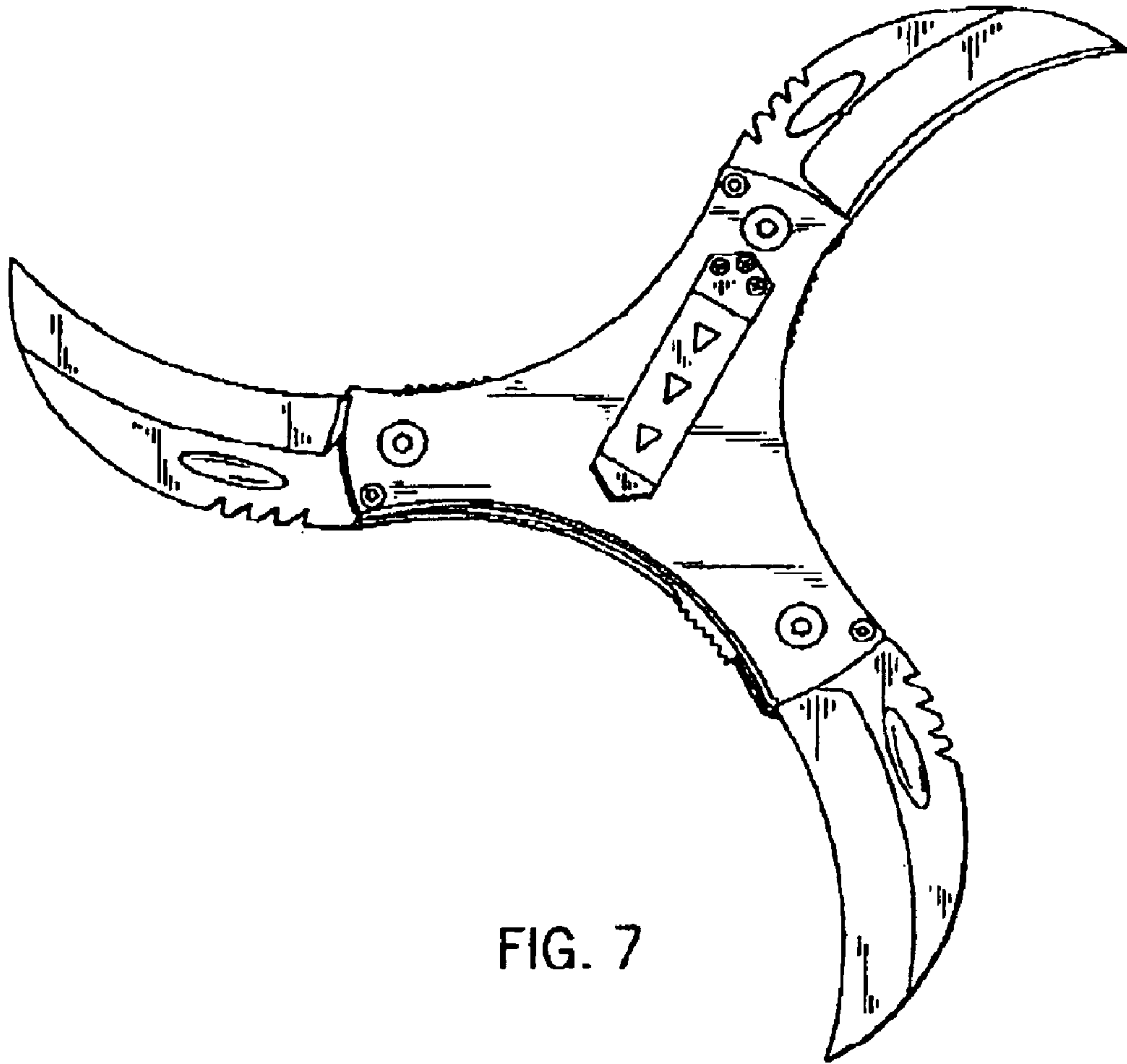

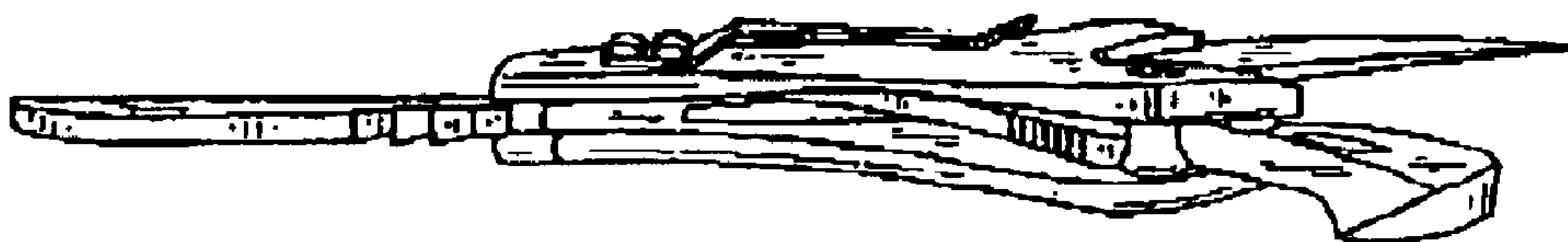
