The ornamental design for a mobile headset with a pivoting microphone boom, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-right perspective view of a mobile headset with a pivoting microphone boom according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a front-left perspective view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left elevation view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right elevation view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is rear elevation view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

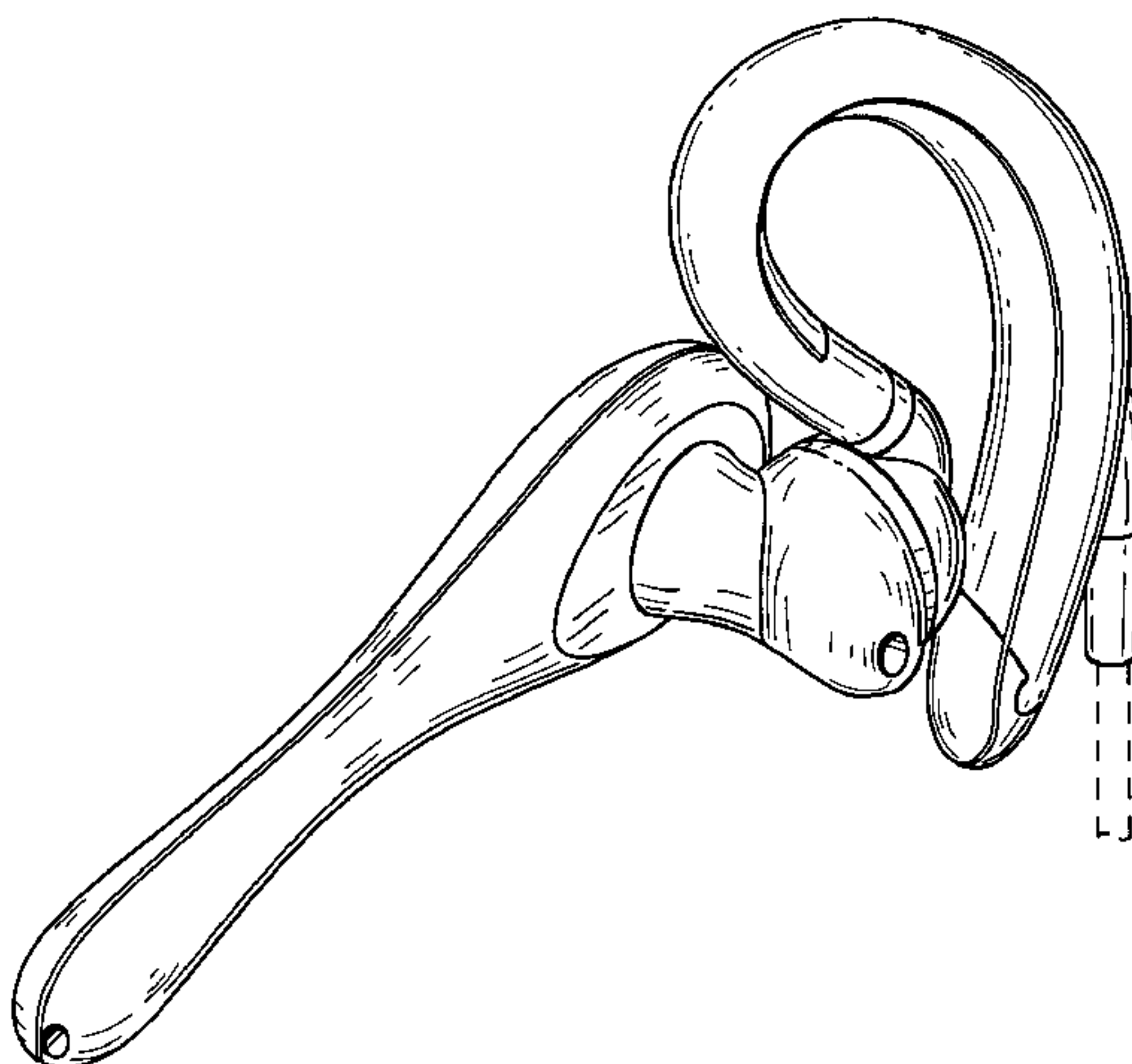
FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of the headset shown in FIG. 1;

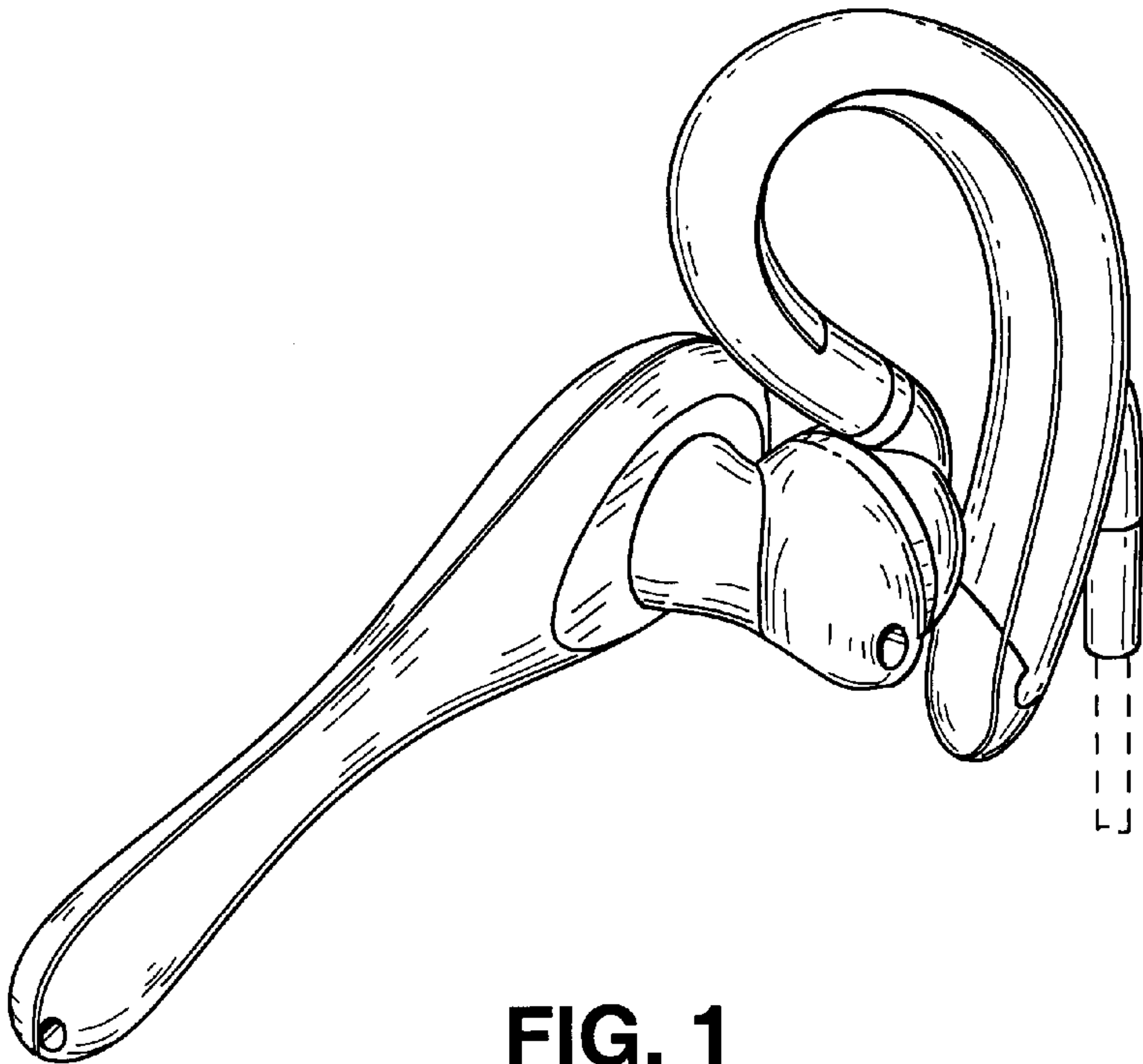

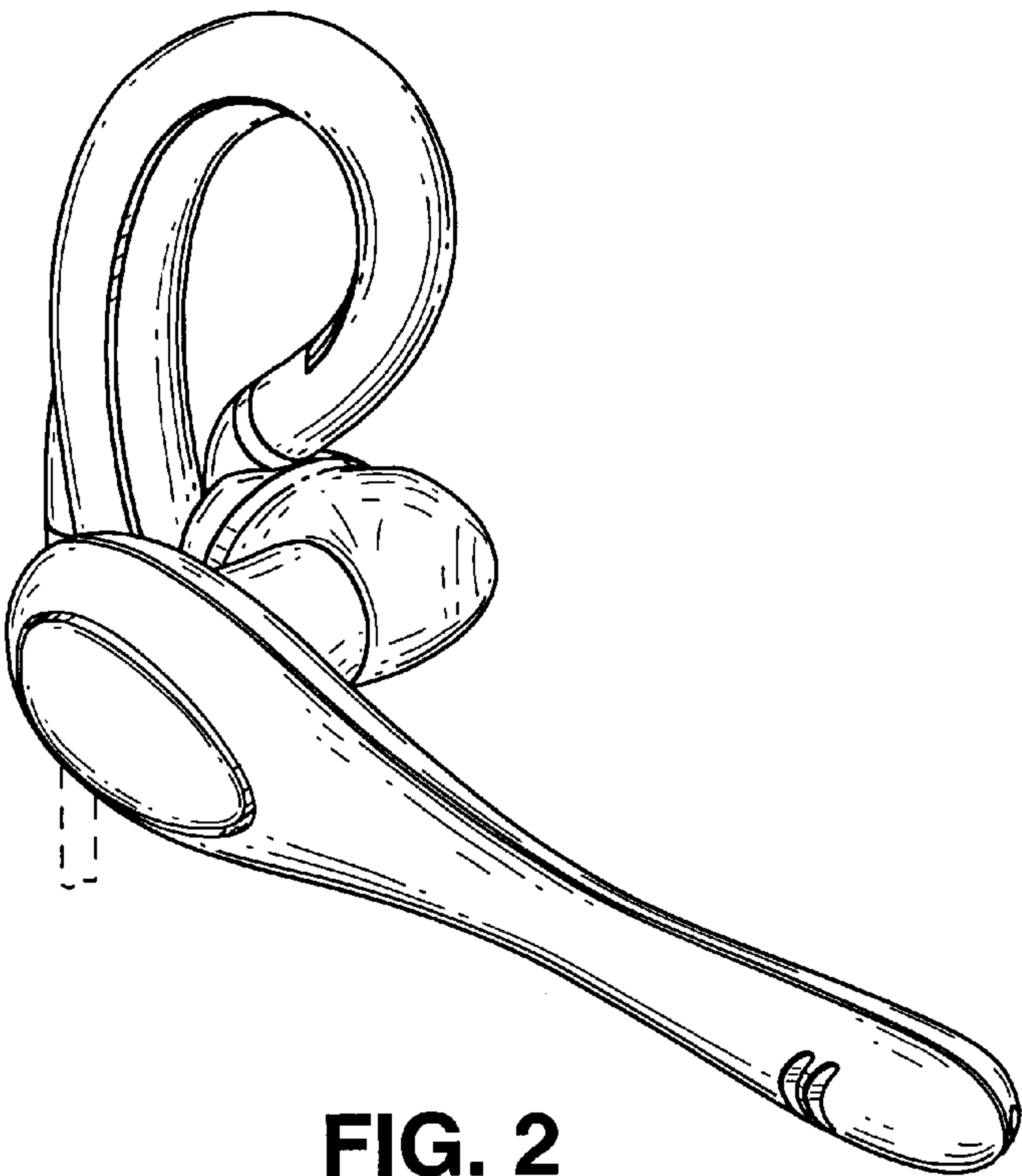

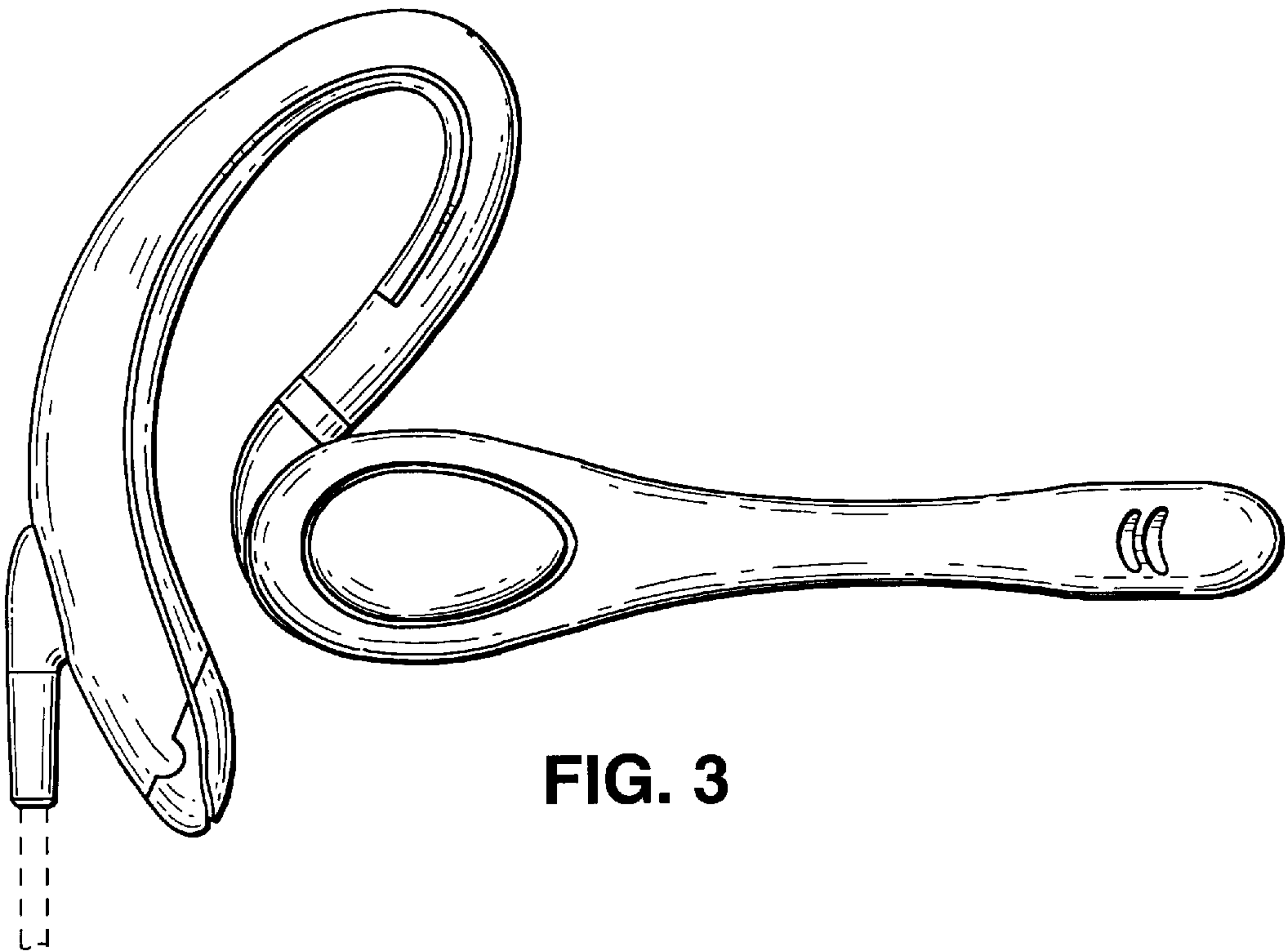

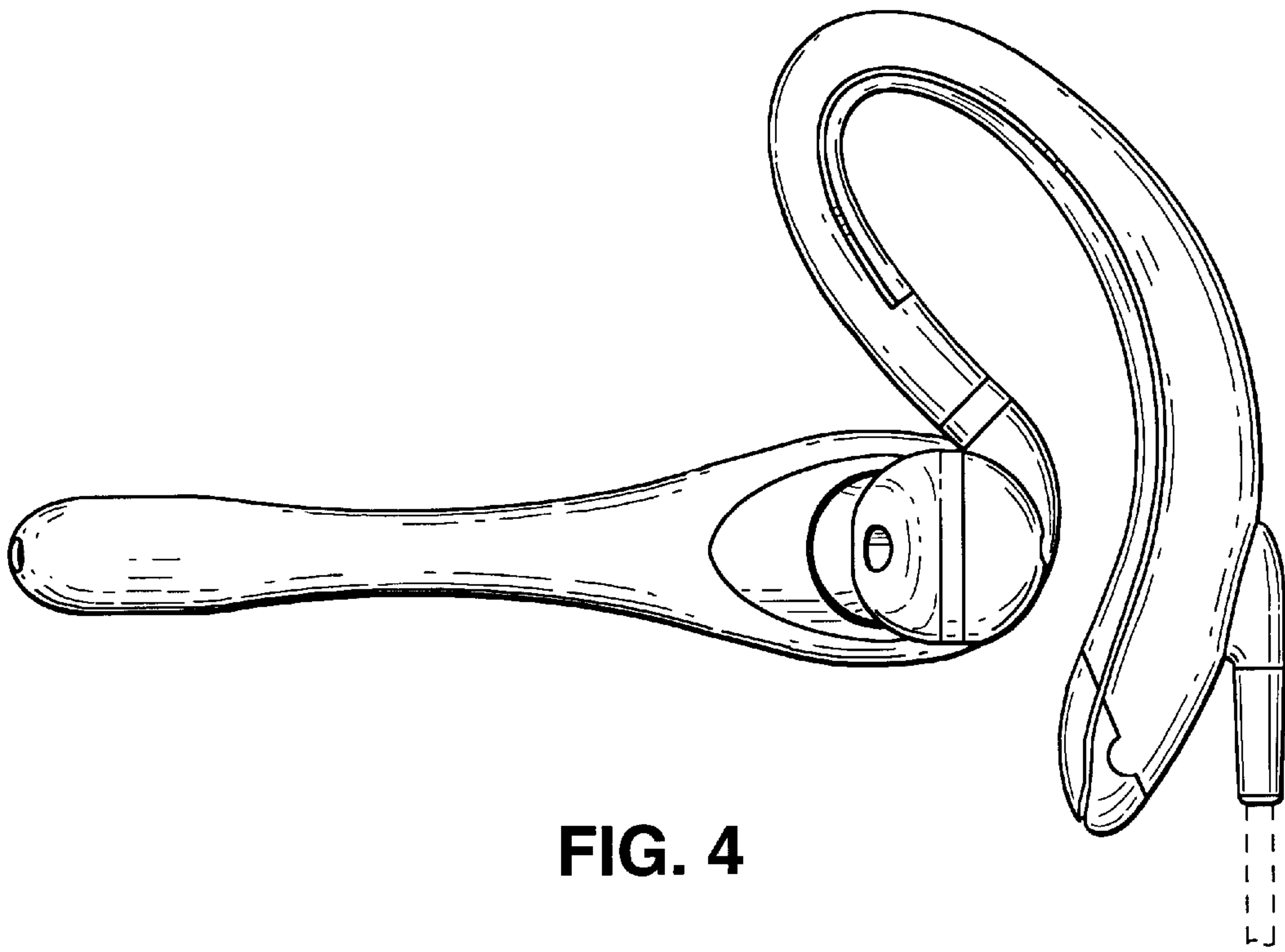

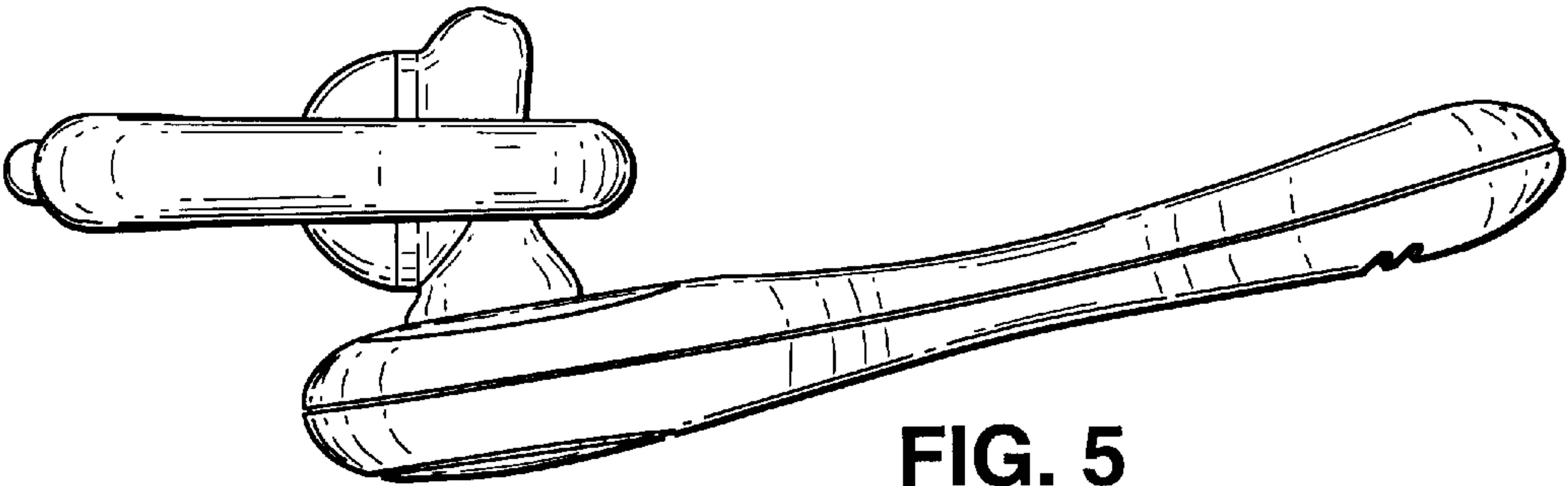

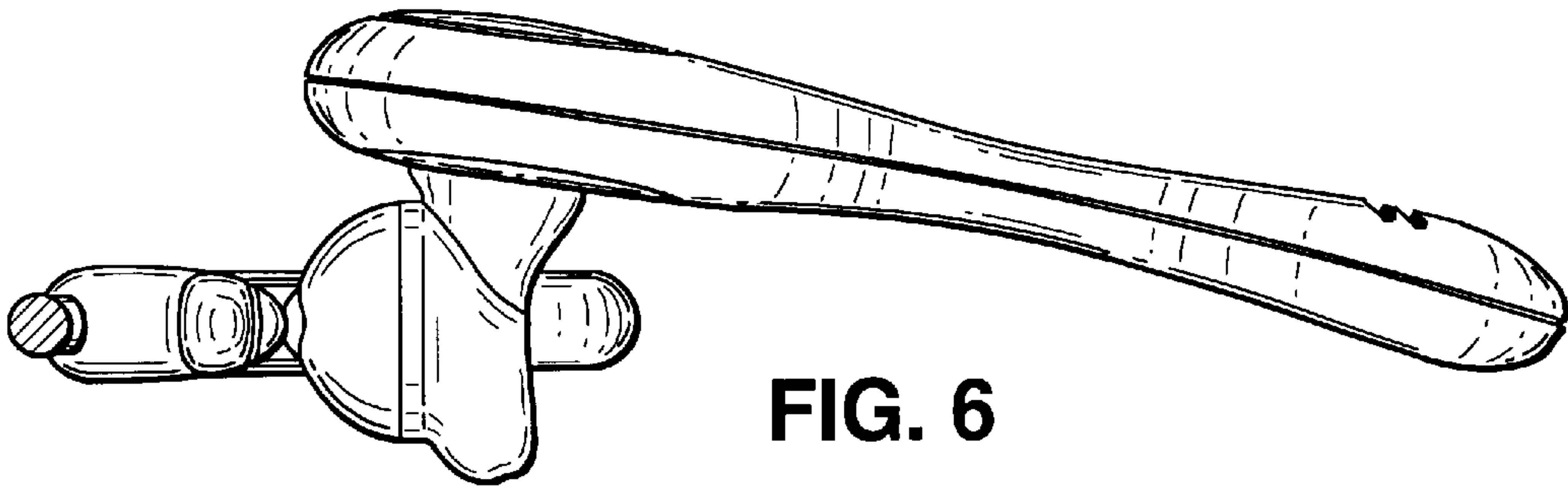

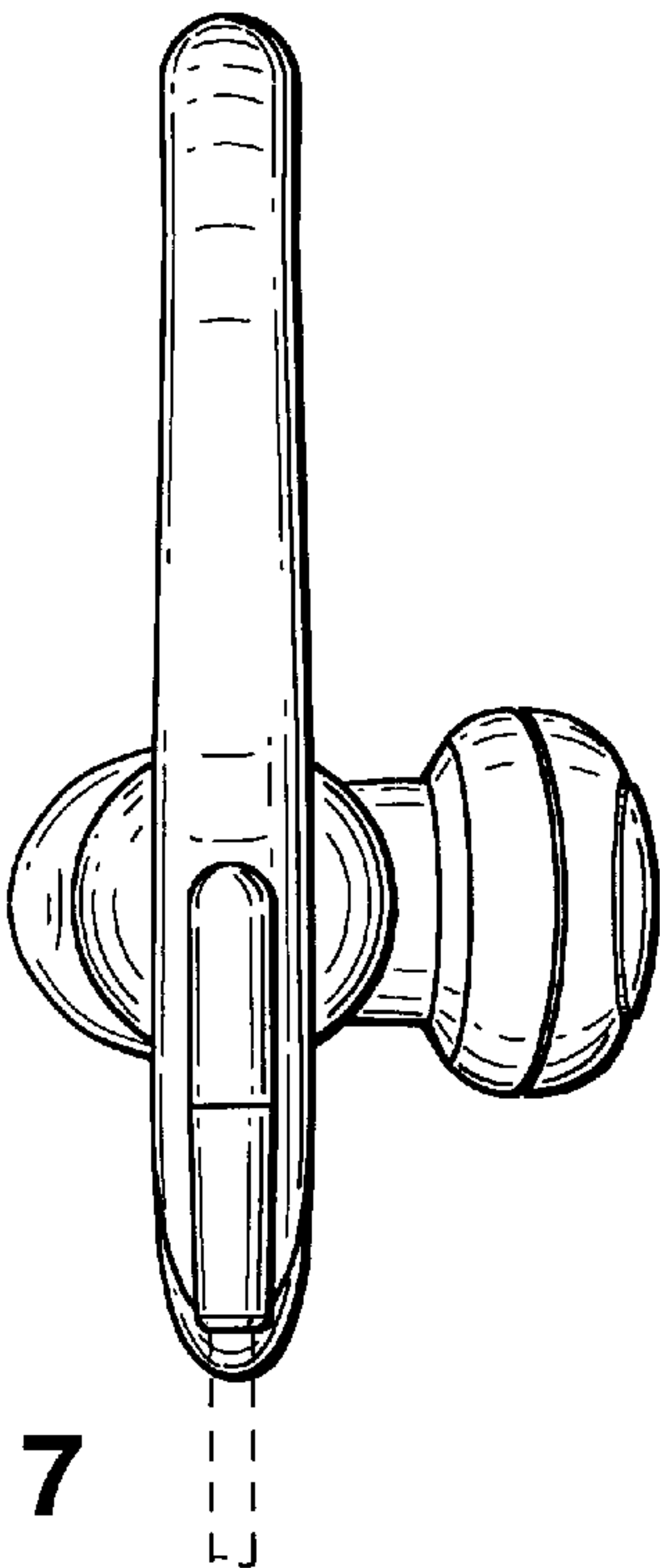

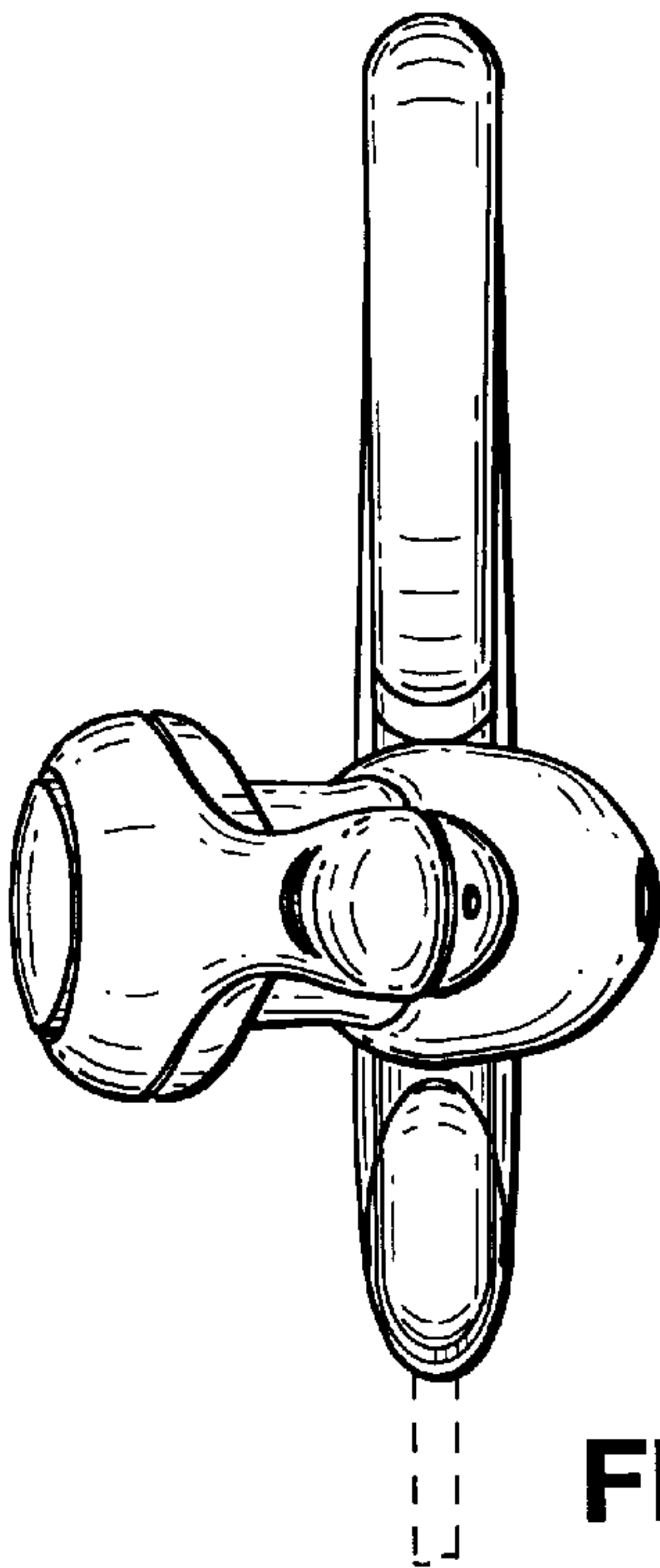

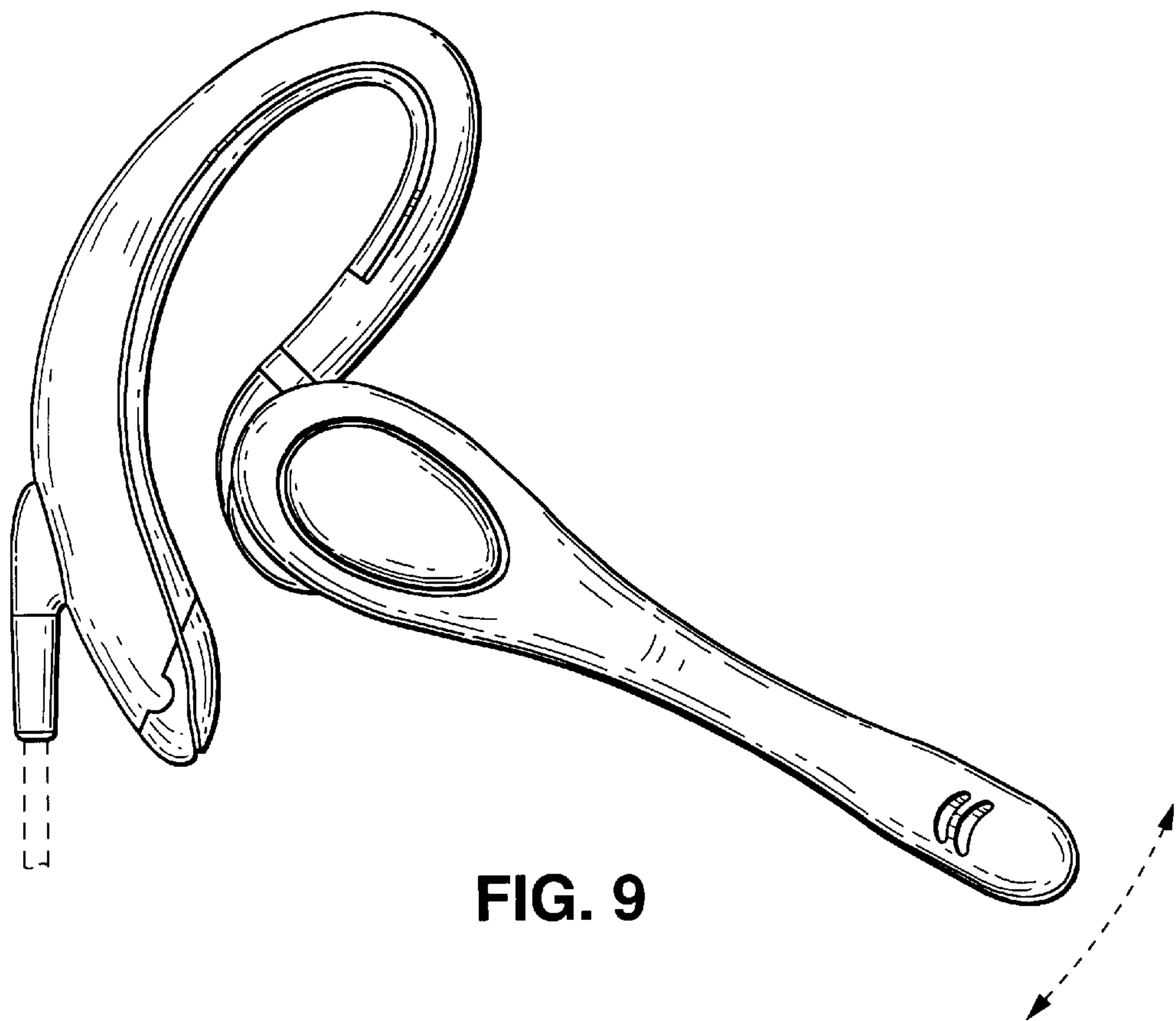

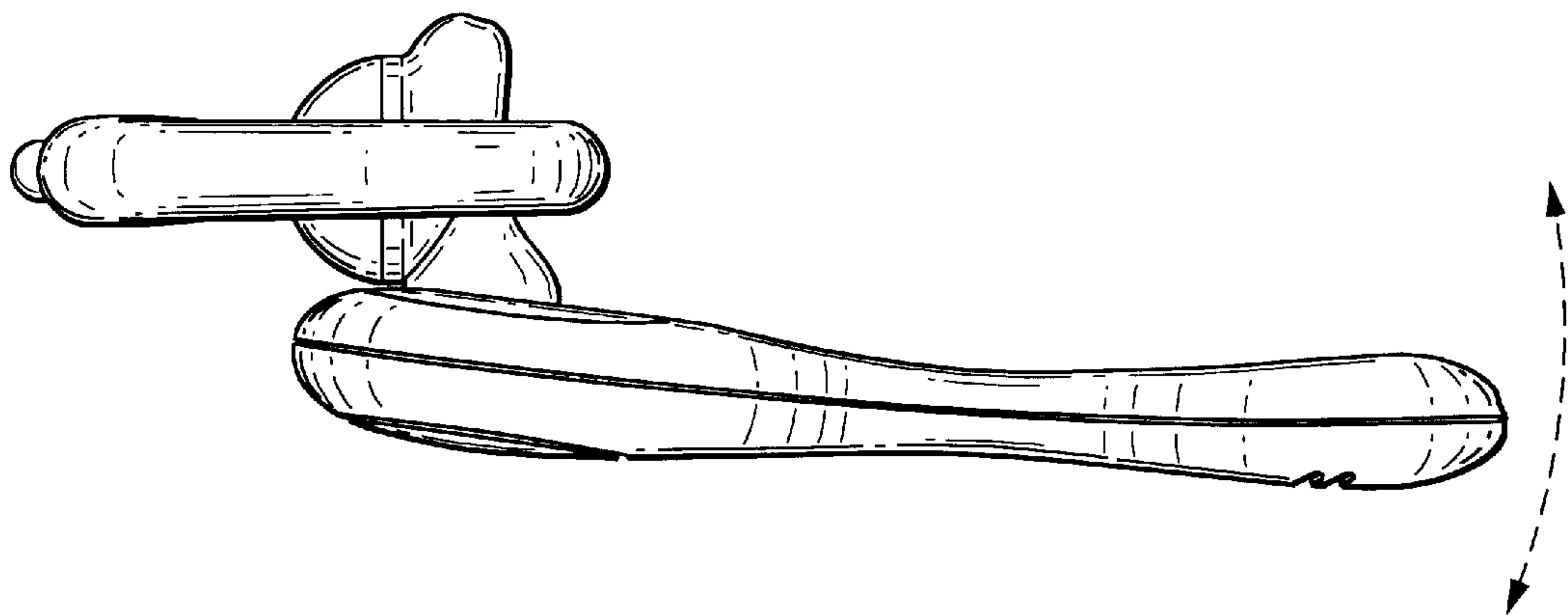
