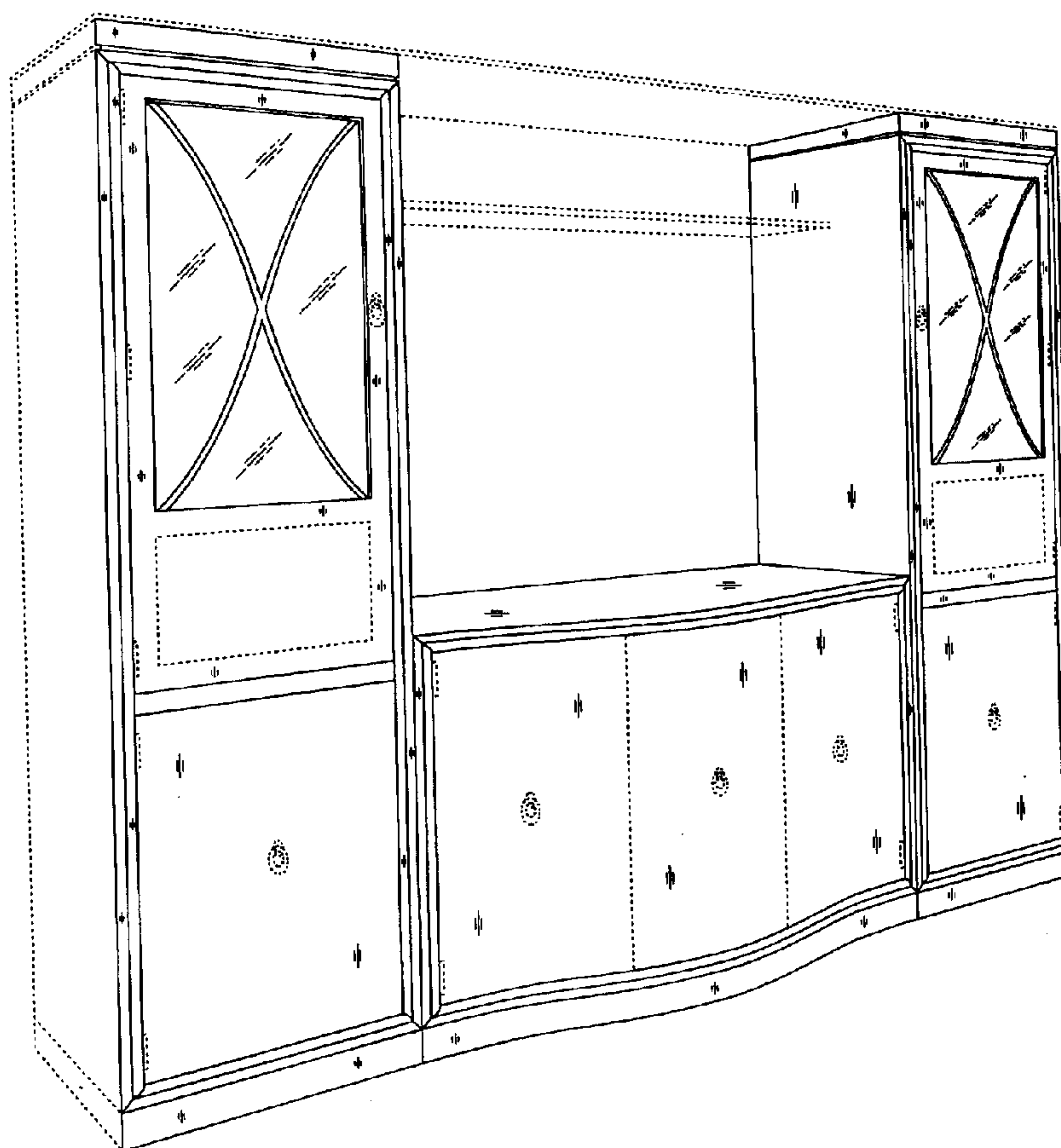
DESCRIPTION

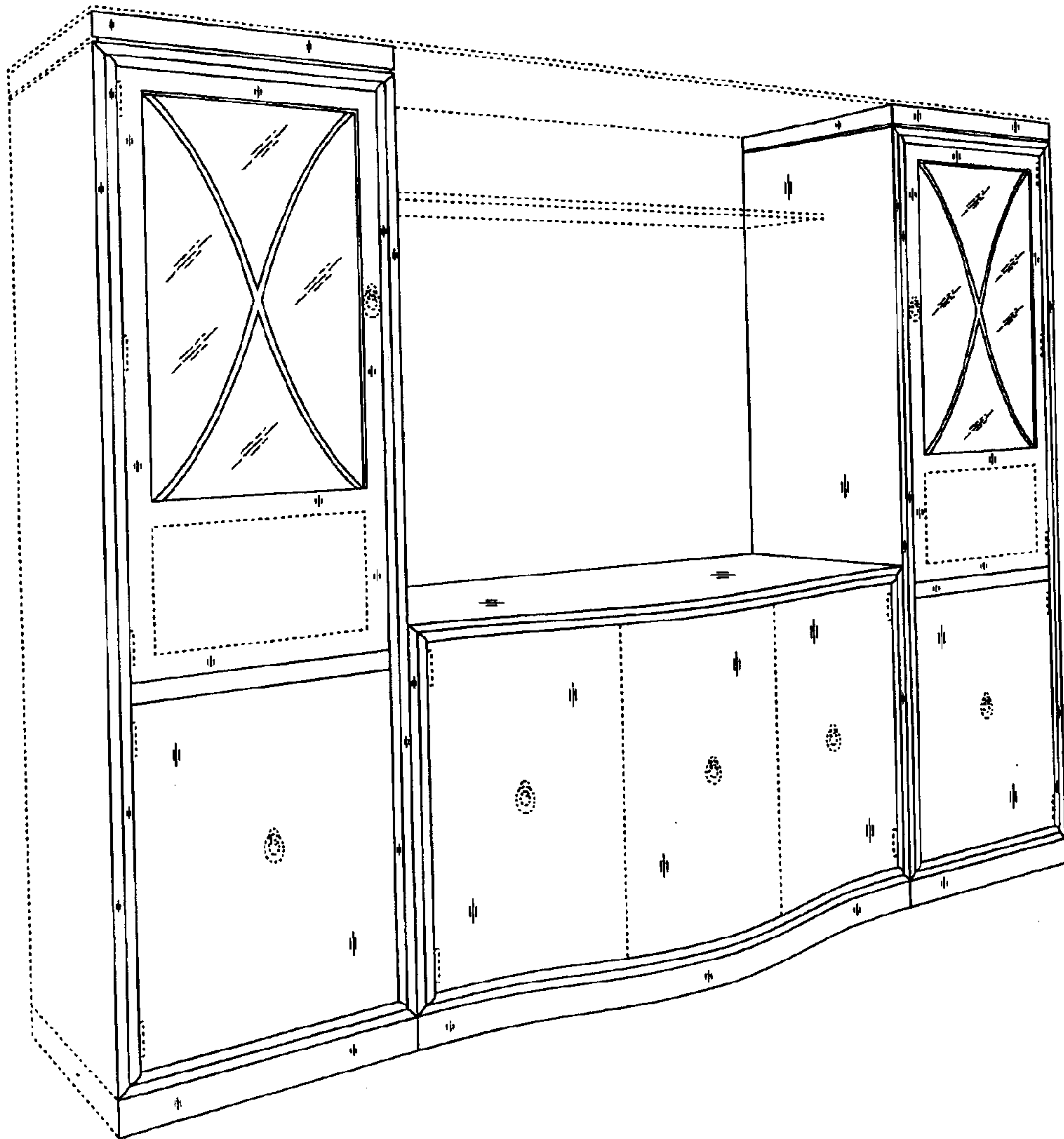

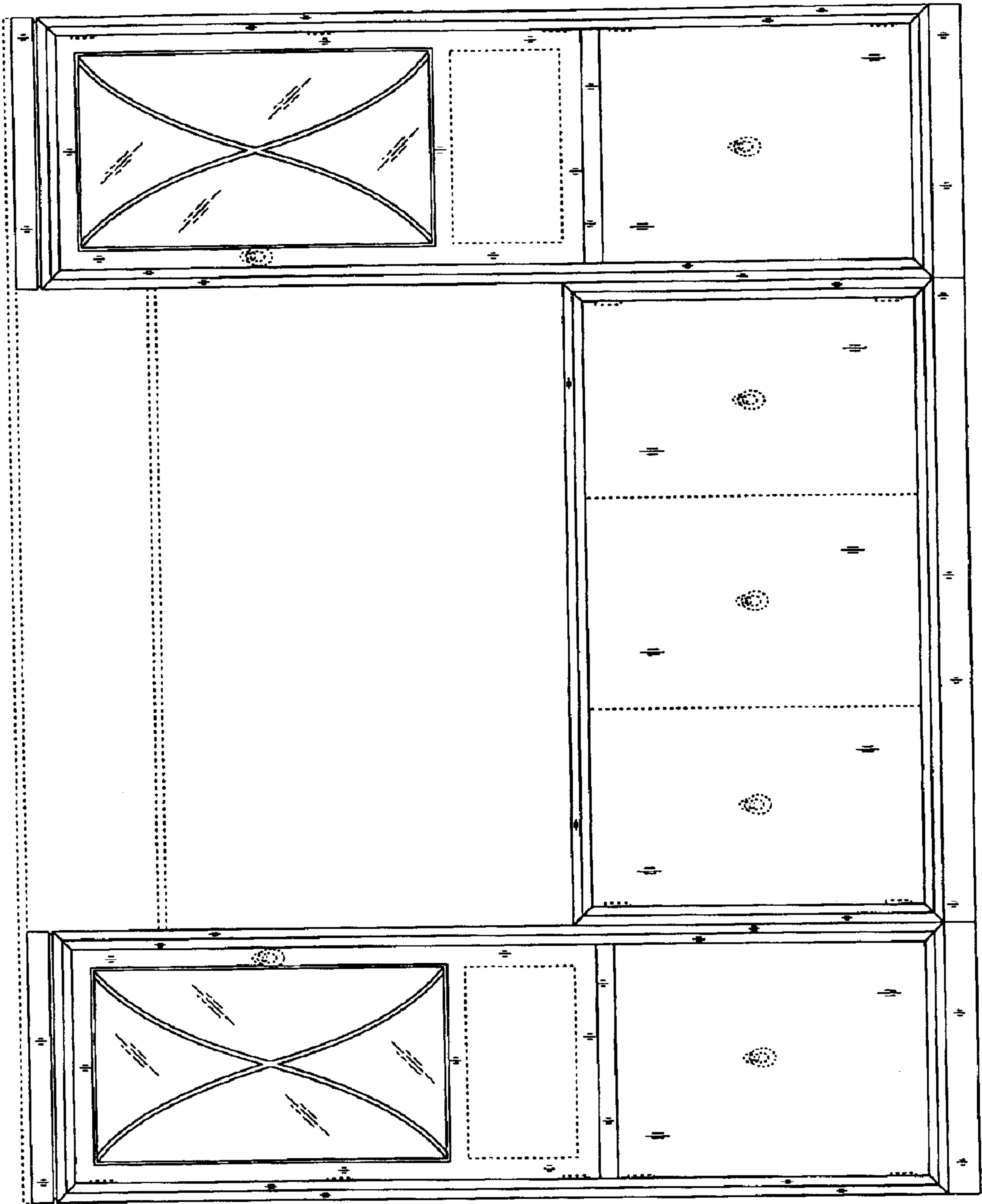
