DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the handle used with my new extension kit for adjusting louvers, with portions thereof broken away for brevity; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the handle, with portions thereof broken away for brevity; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the handle, with portions thereof broken away for brevity; and, FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view of the handle. FIG. 5 is an enlarged top plan view. The shaft of the claimed design is shown broken away to indicate indeterminate length.
