DESCRIPTION

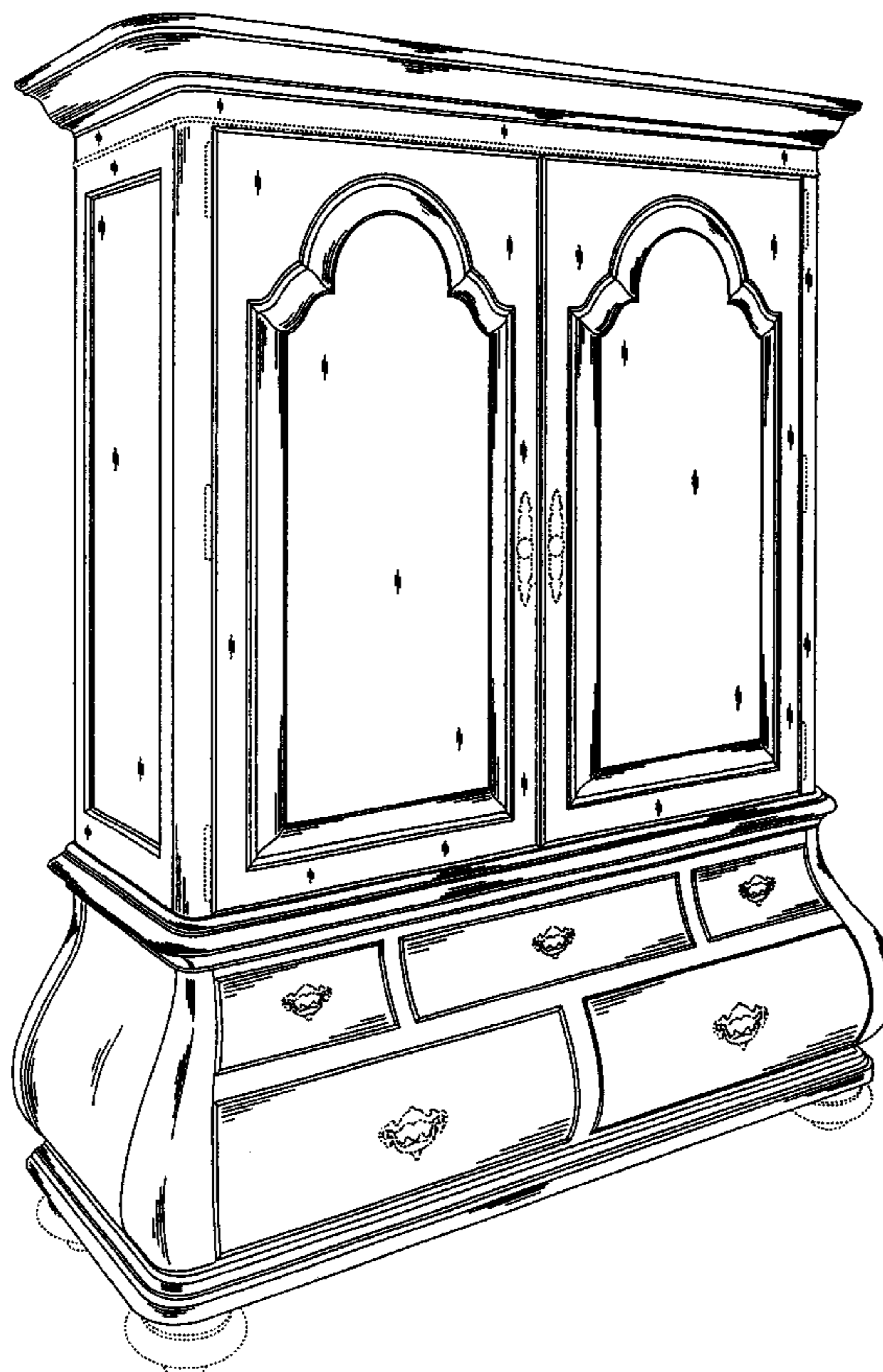
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an armoire showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

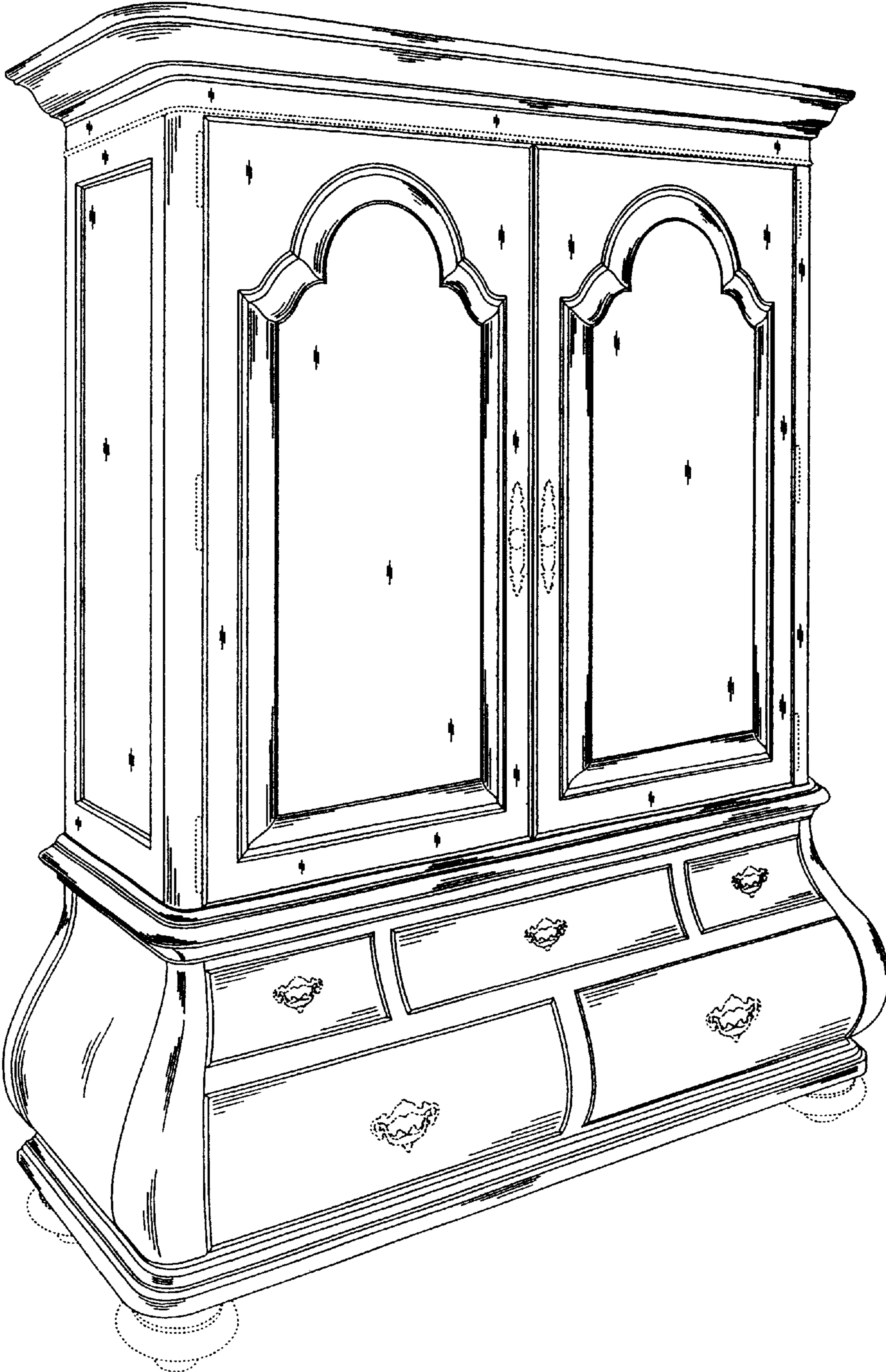

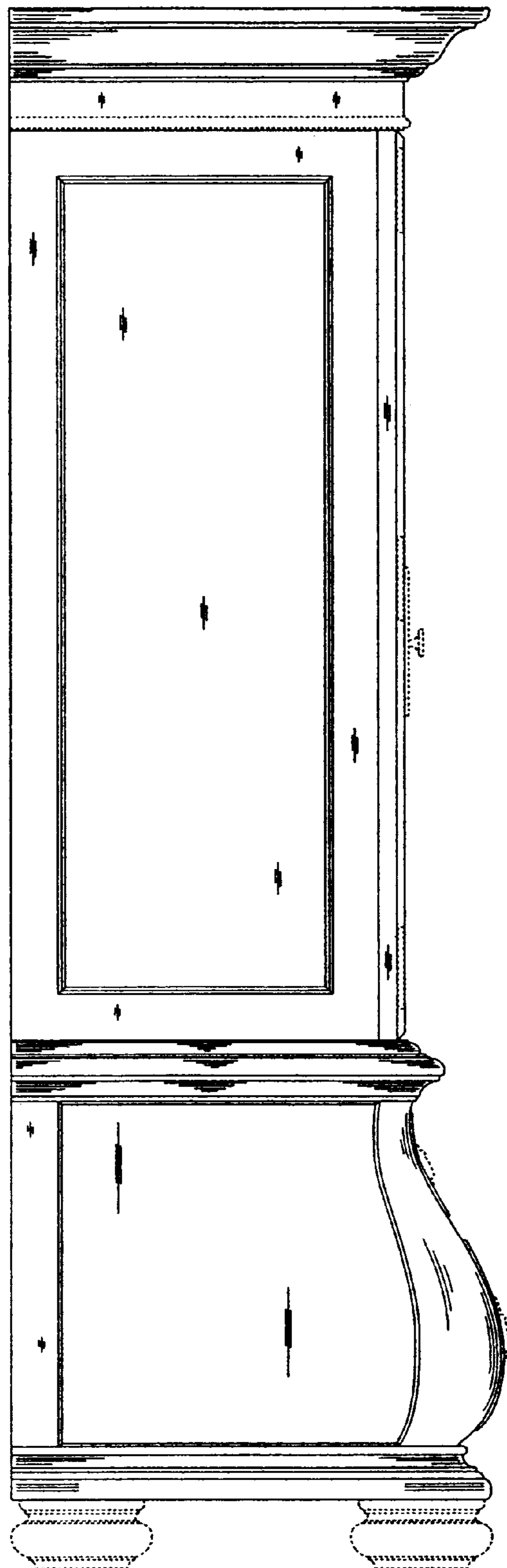

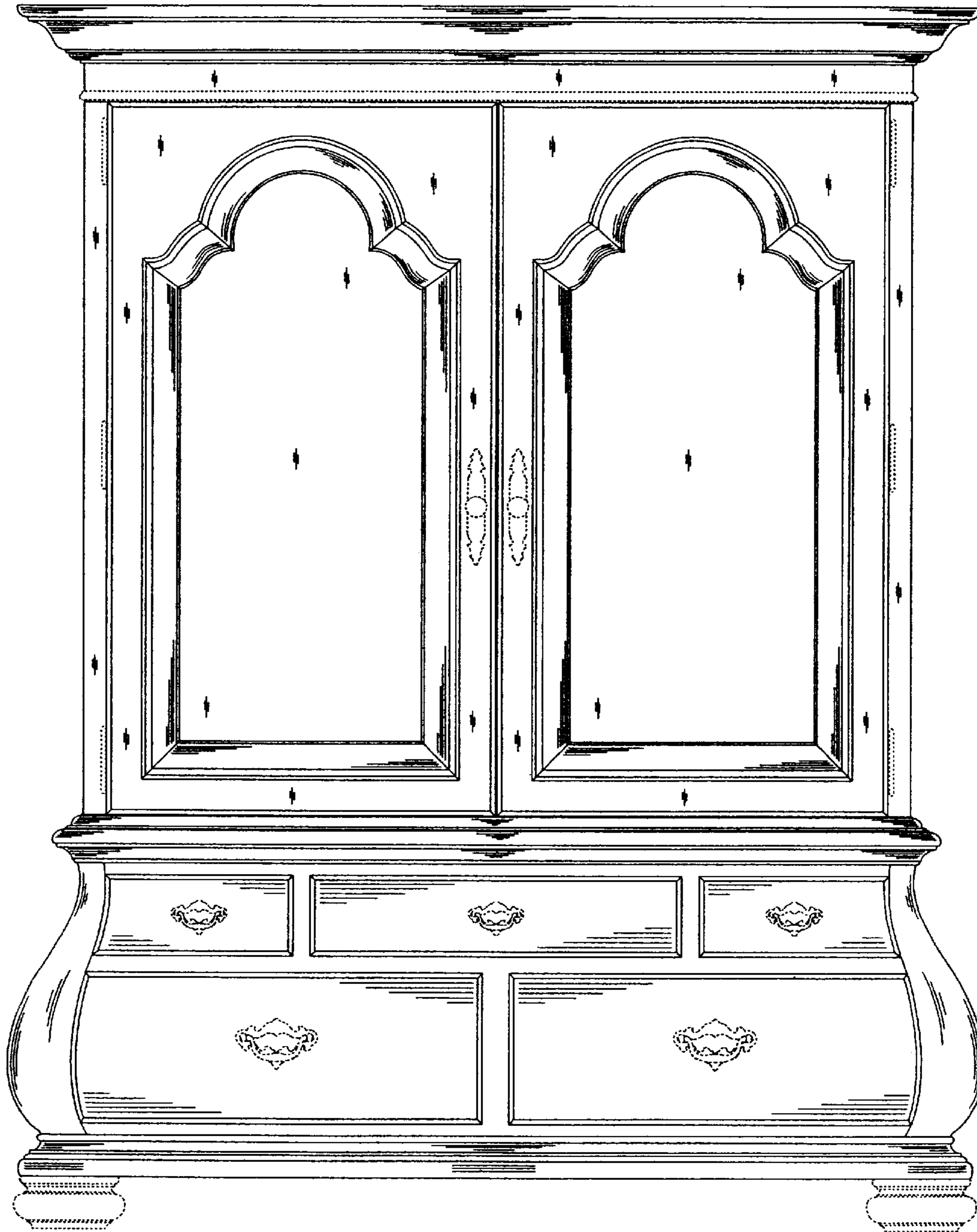
