DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the top of my inventive game board;

FIG. 2 is similar to that of FIG. 1 showing the game pieces in phantom during play of the game;

FIG. 3 is similar to that of FIG. 1 showing the location of the game pieces in their storage position;

FIG. 4 is a top perspective view of the inventive game board;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view in which the rear is a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the inventive game board;

FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof; and,


FIG. 8 is a right side view thereof.










