(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fish lure, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a fish lure showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
The broken lines shown in the drawing are understood to represent a fish trailer and swivelled spinner respectively.  
The broken line showing of a fish trailer and a swiveled spinner is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
