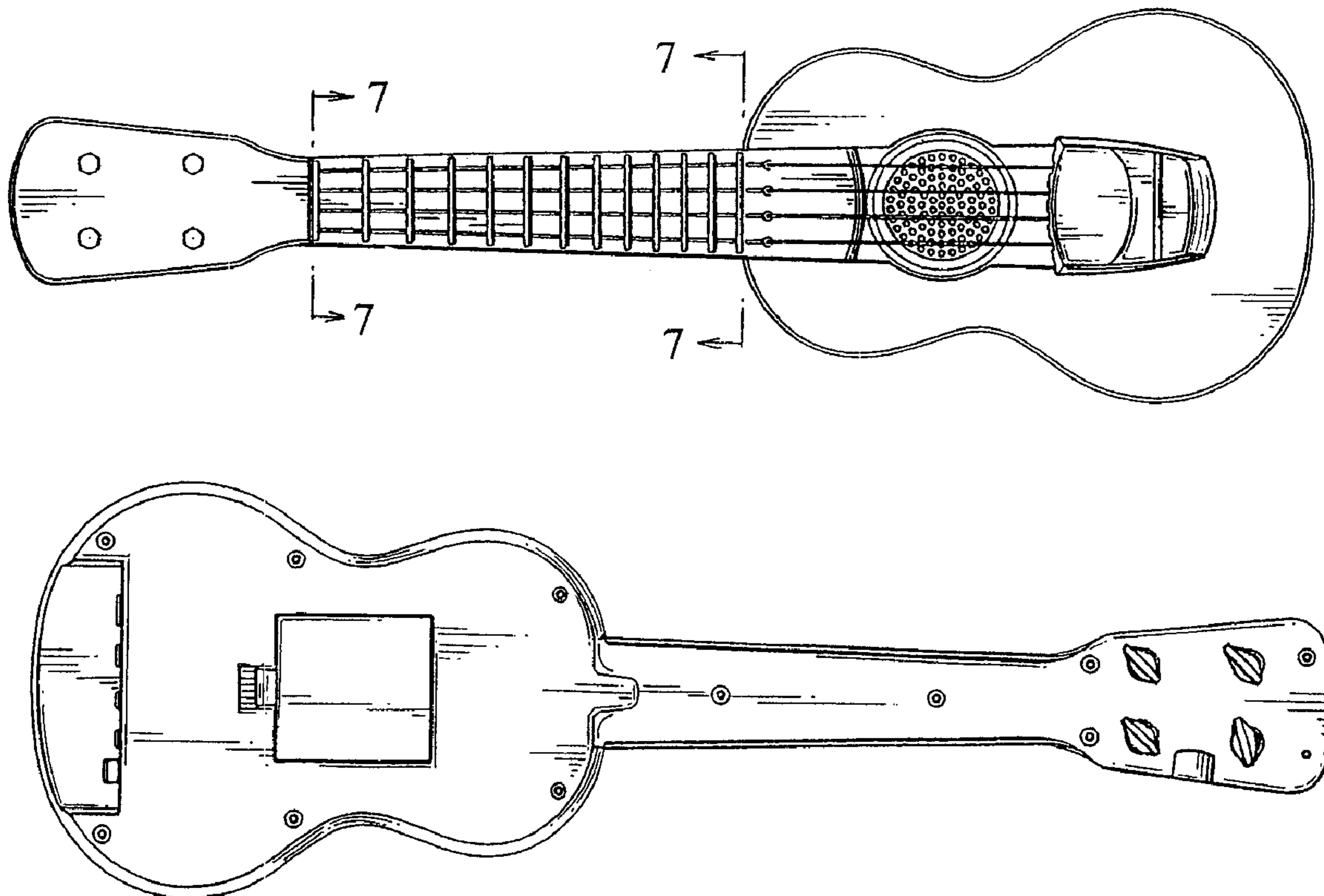
FIG. 1 is a top view of an electronic ukelele;

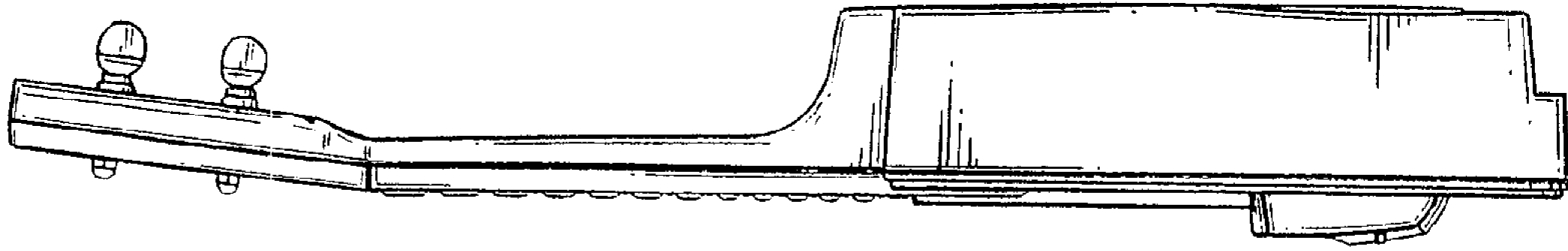

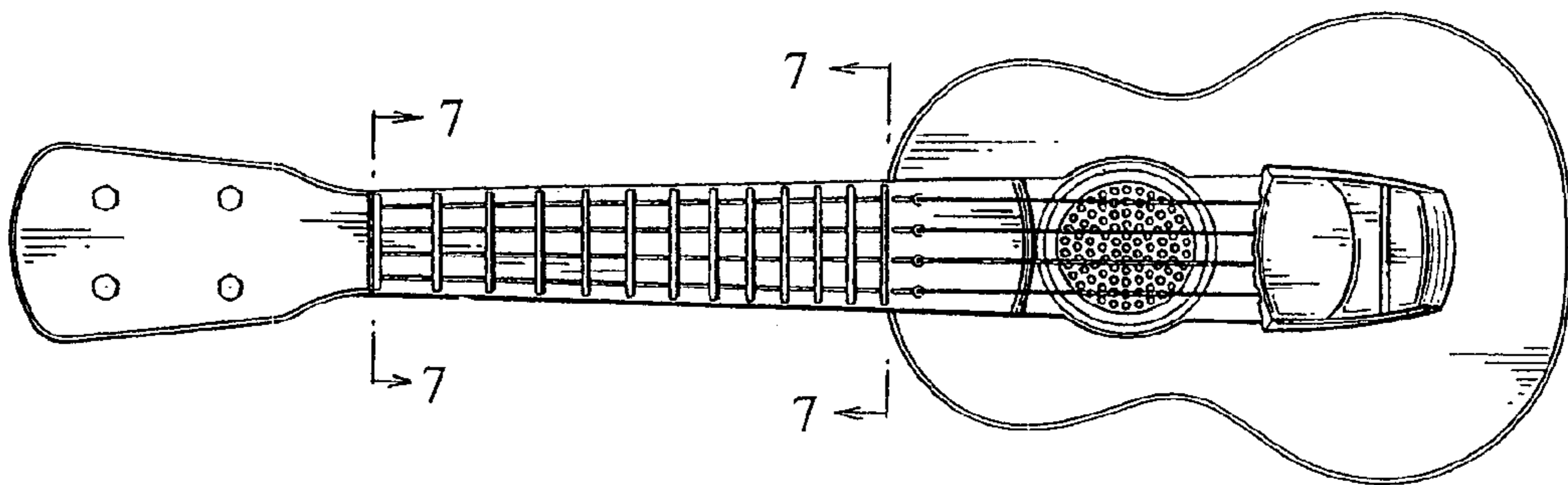

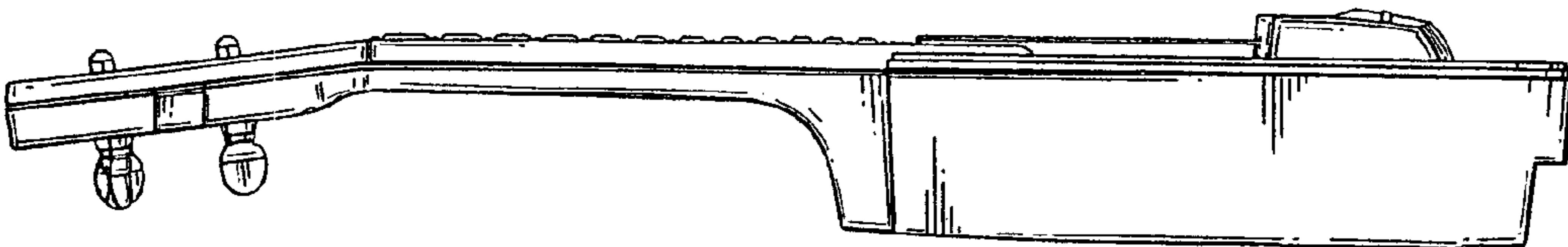

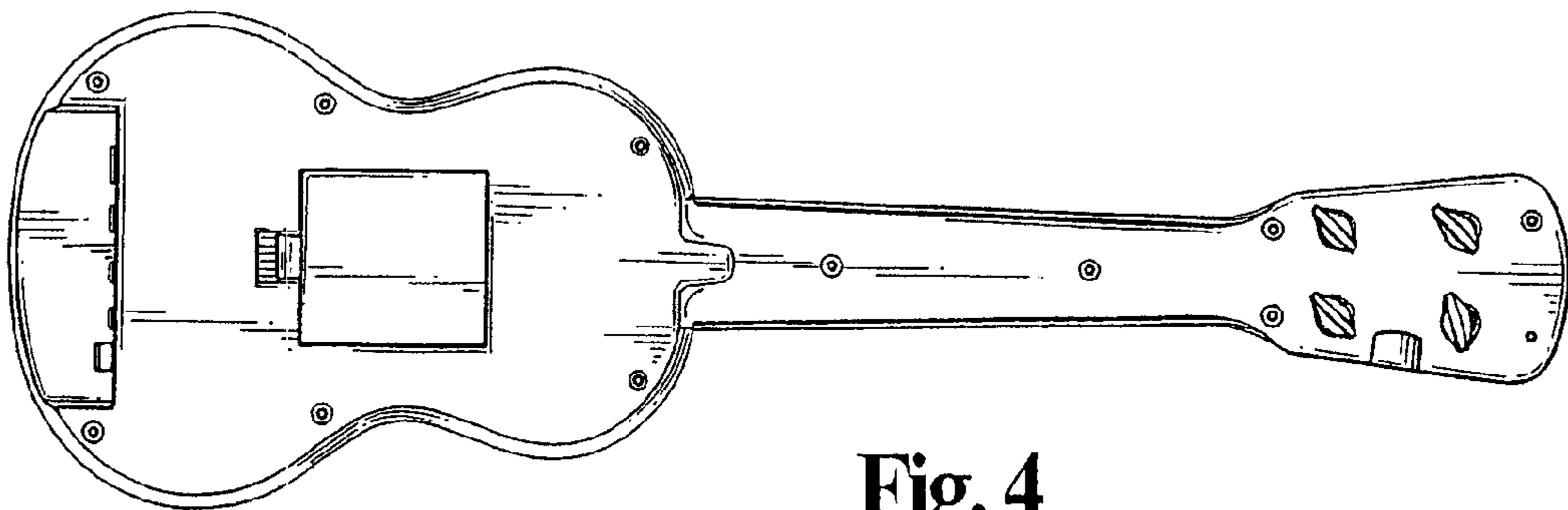

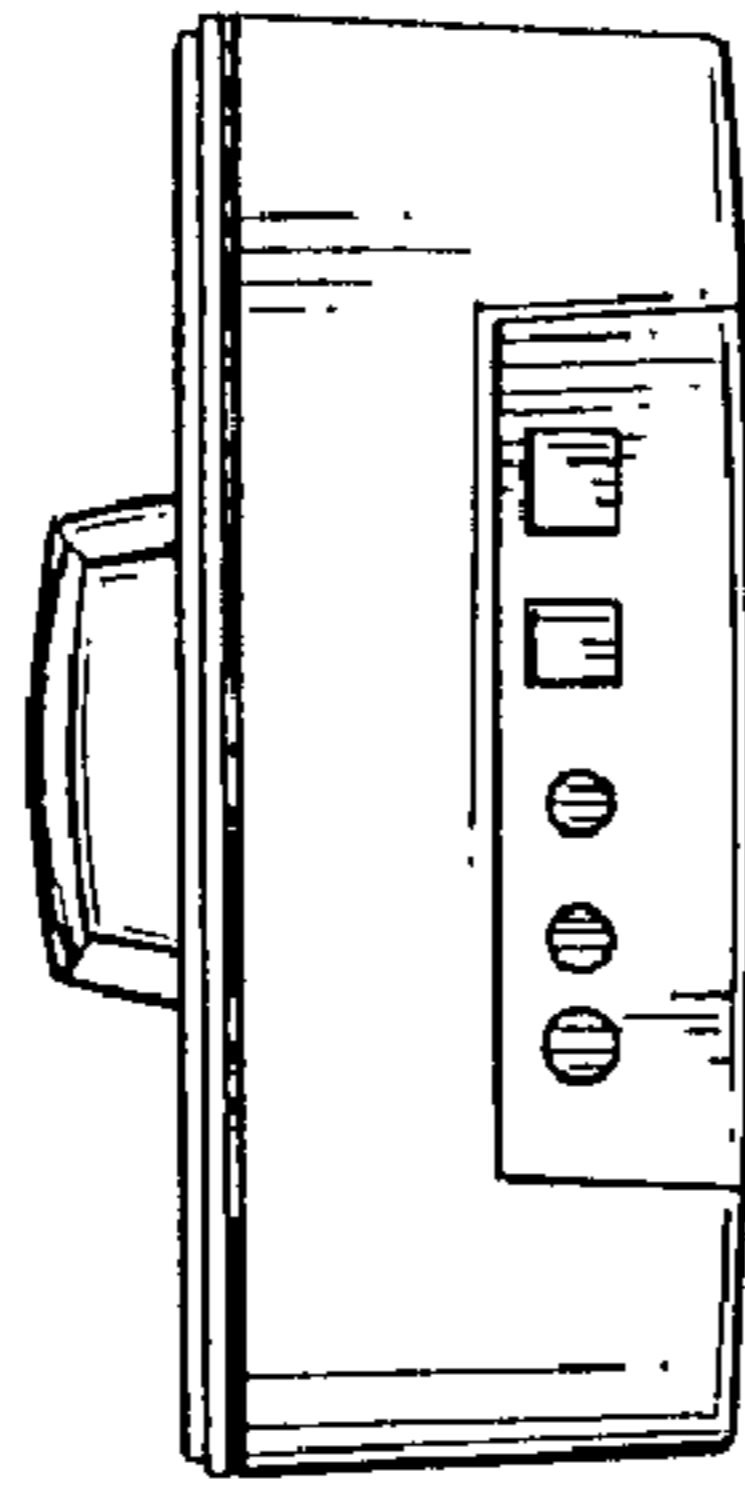

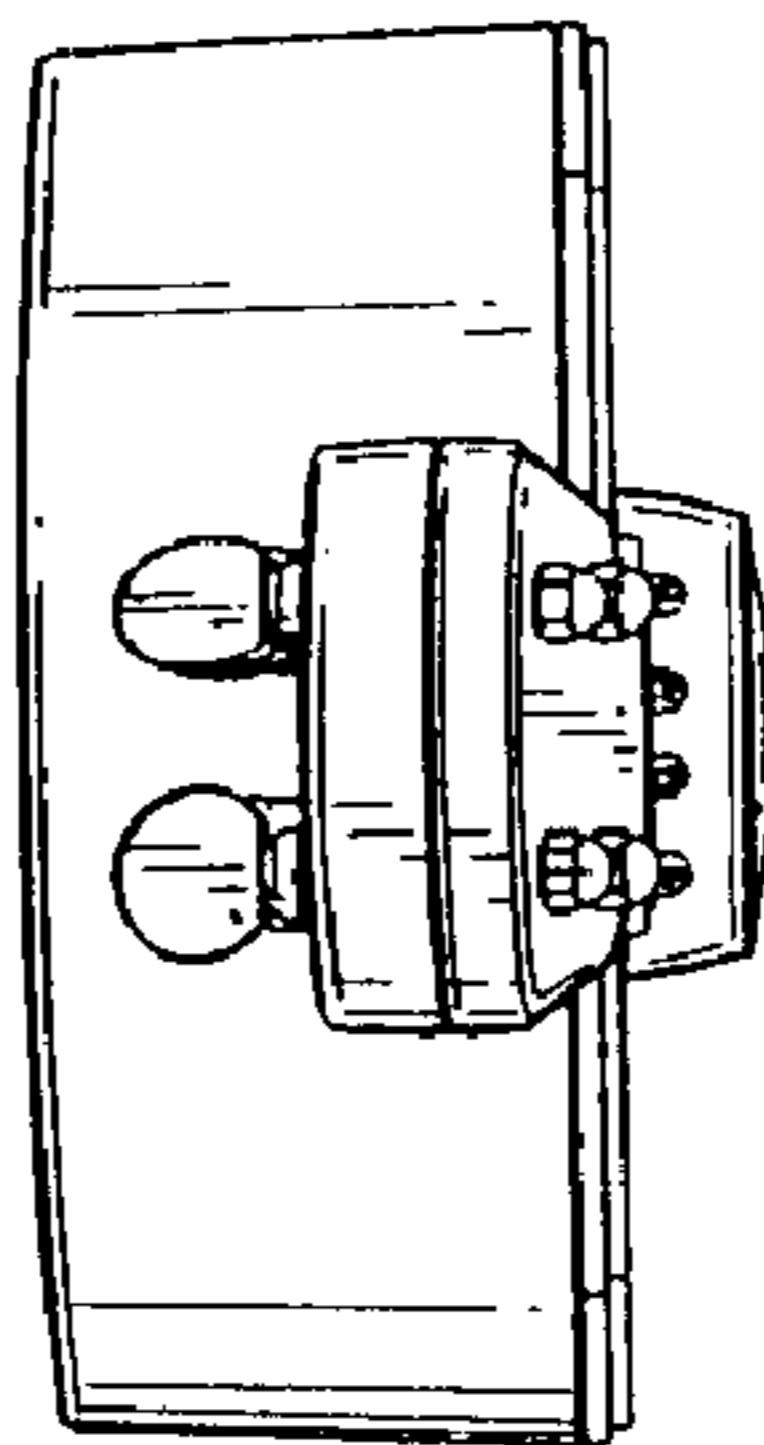

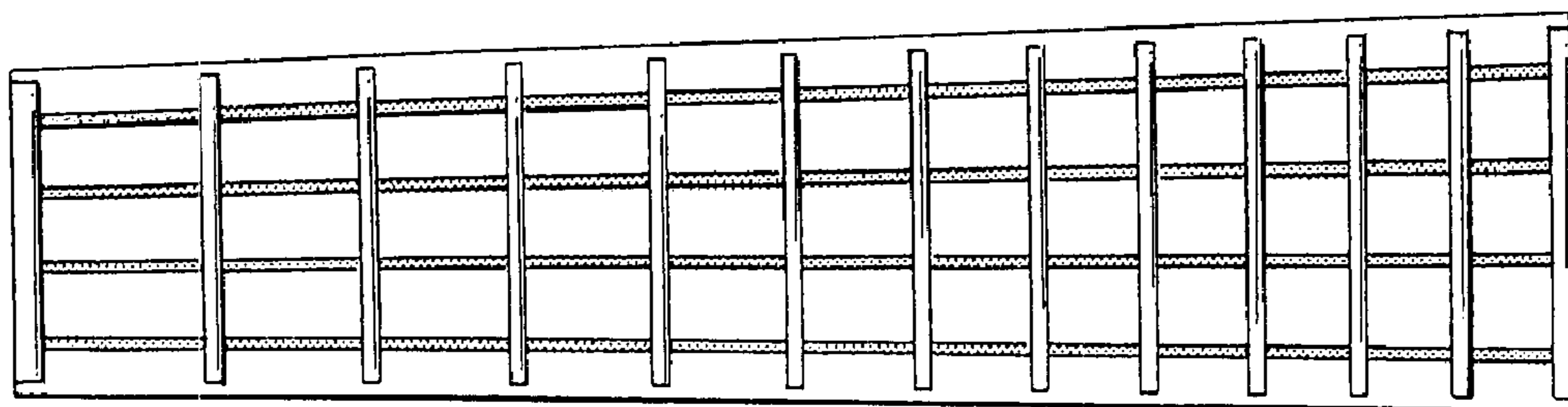
