FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the teardrop wall clock of FIG. 1.


FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the teardrop wall clock of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the teardrop wall clock of FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the teardrop wall clock of FIG. 1.


The broken lines shown in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. The views are shown drawn to different scales.






