(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf tee, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the golf tee according to my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the golf tee, rotated counter-clockwise about its longitudinal axis by approximately 130° relative to FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a magnified bottom view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side view of the golf tee, rotated about its longitudinal axis by approximately 90° relative to FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the golf tee, rotated further about its longitudinal axis by approximately 90°, and showing the side opposite from the side illustrated in FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a top-plan view thereof, illustrated with magnification similar to the bottom view of FIG. 4;

FIG. 8 is a side view of the golf tee, rotated about its longitudinal axis by approximately 180° relative to FIG. 5, showing that the opposite side of the golf tee is a mirror image of FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a top, side perspective view of a head portion of a second embodiment of my design;

FIG. 10 is a reduced scale bottom, side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a top, side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a side view of the golf tee, rotated about its longitudinal axis by approximately 180° relative to FIG. 11 and showing the opposite side thereof;

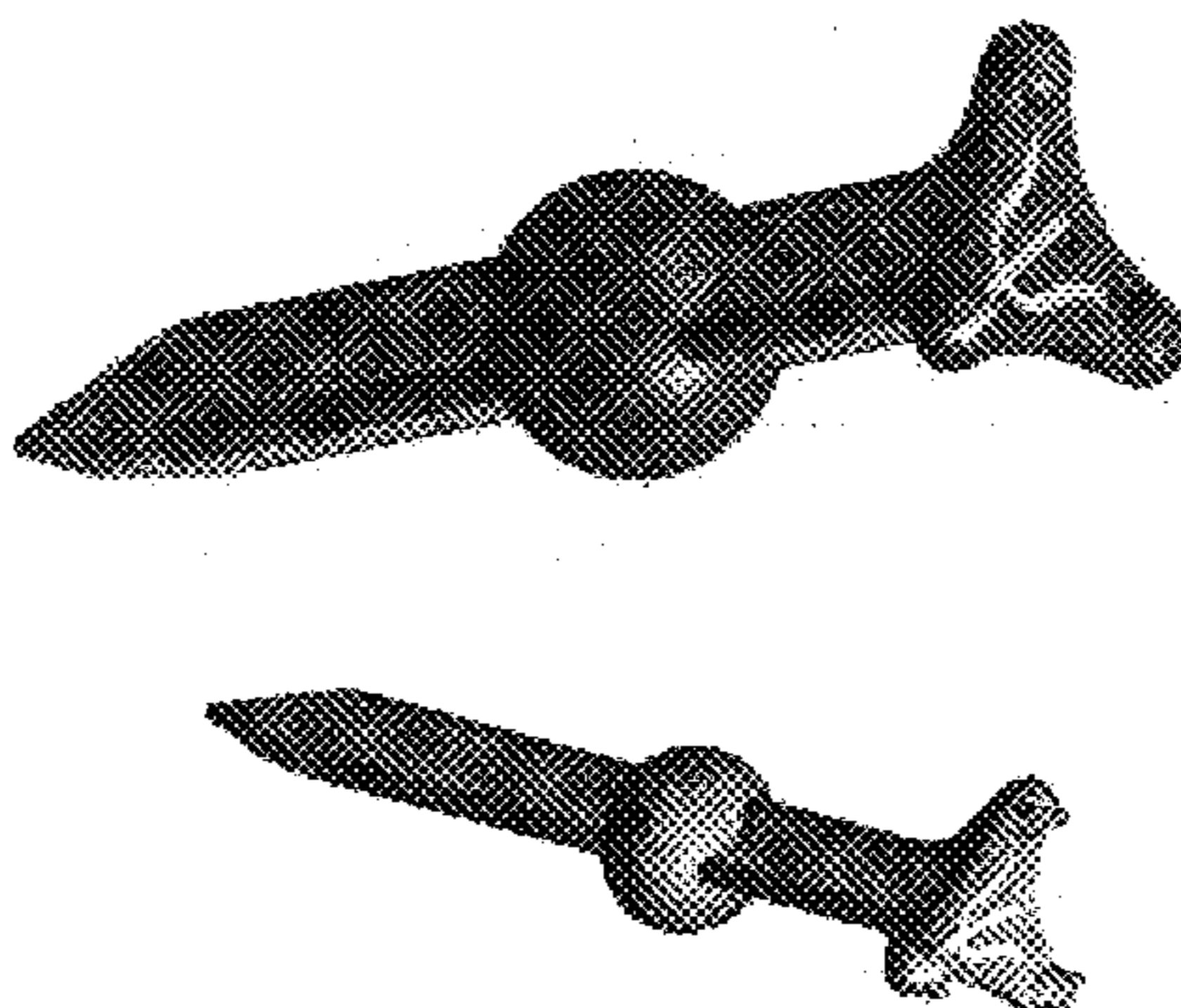
FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof, illustrated with a greater magnification than the side view figures;

FIG. 15 is a side elevational view of the golf tee, rotated about its longitudinal axis by approximately 90° relative to FIGS. 11 and 13;

FIG. 16 is a side view of the golf tee, rotated about its longitudinal axis by approximately 180° relative to FIG. 15, showing the opposite side thereof; and,

FIG. 17 is a top-plan view thereof, illustrated with magnification similar to the bottom view of FIG. 14.

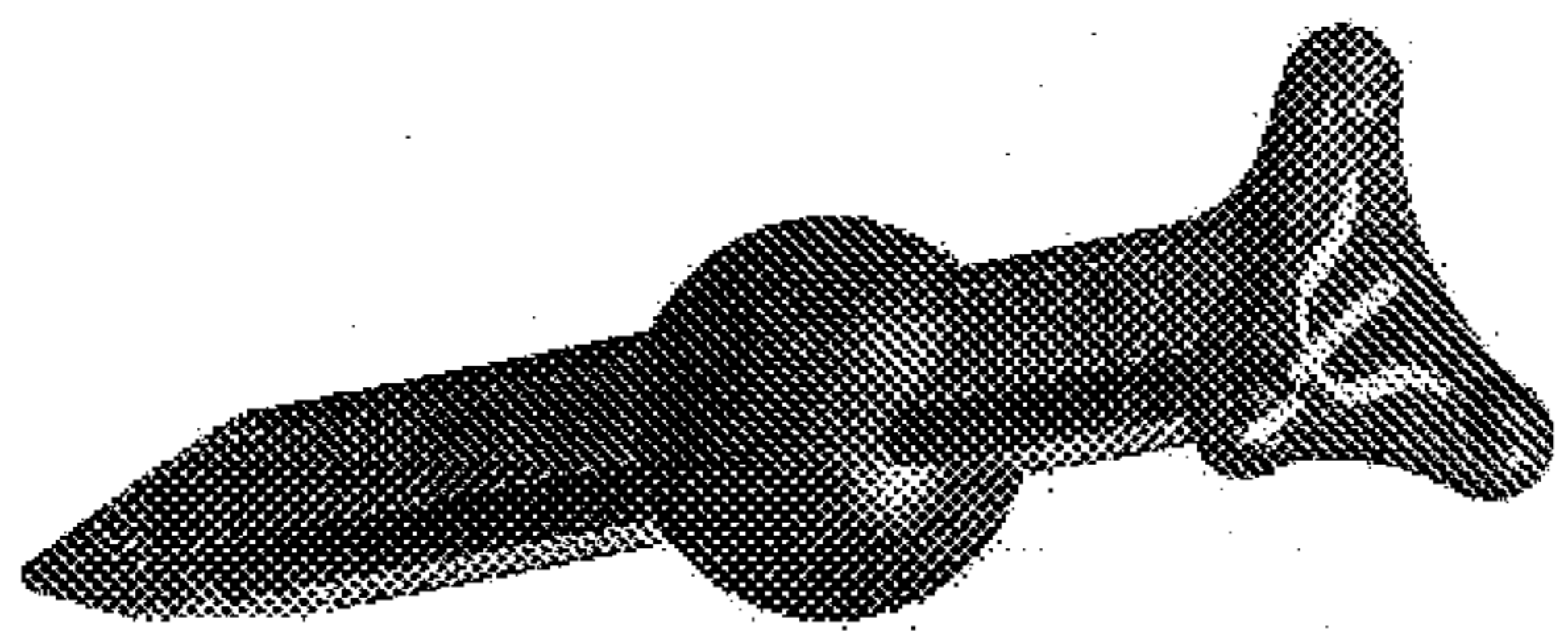

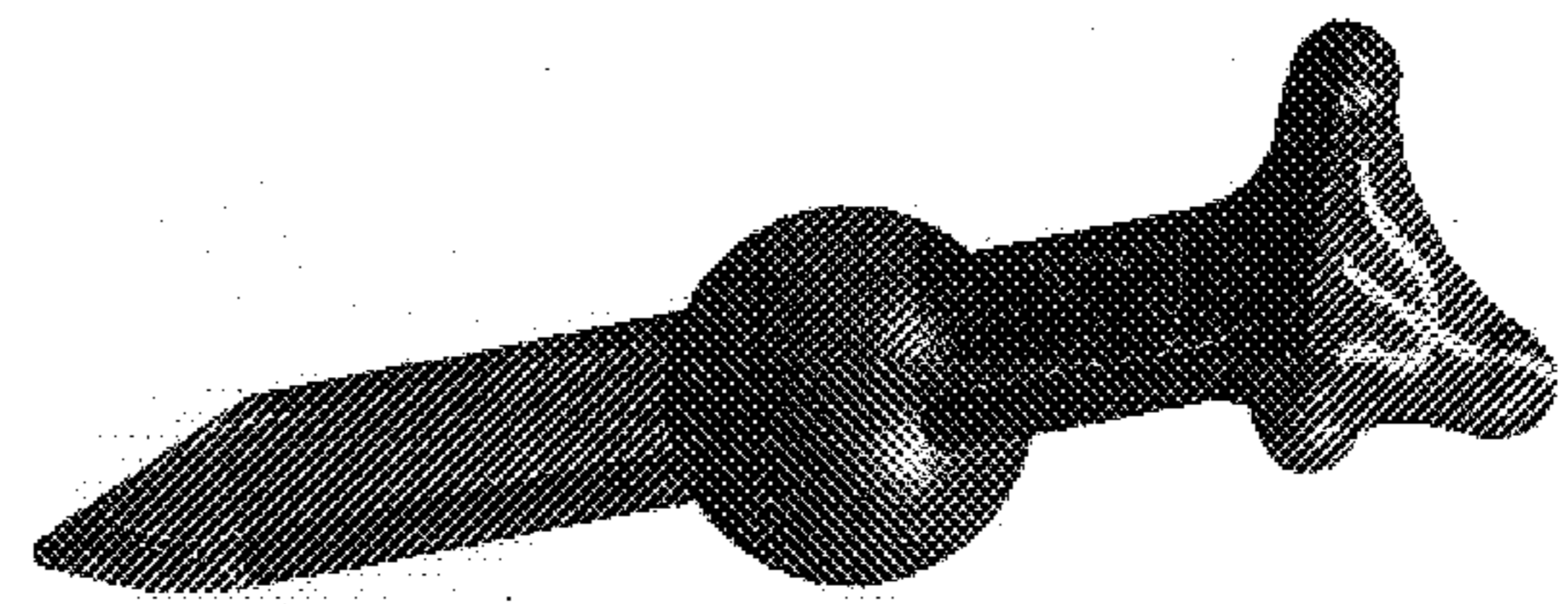

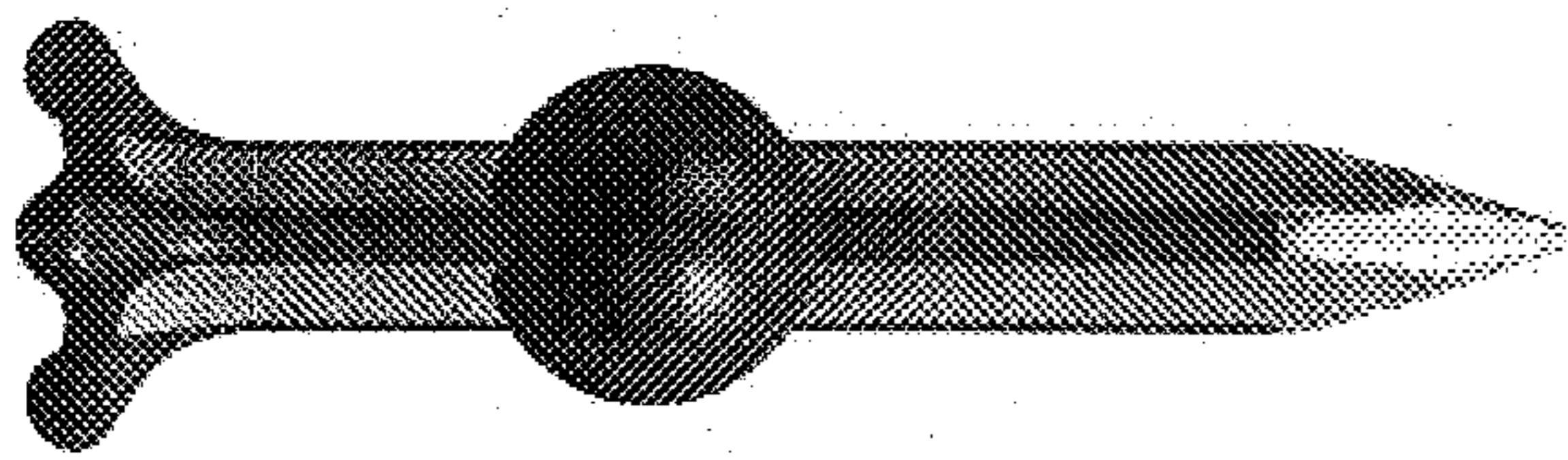

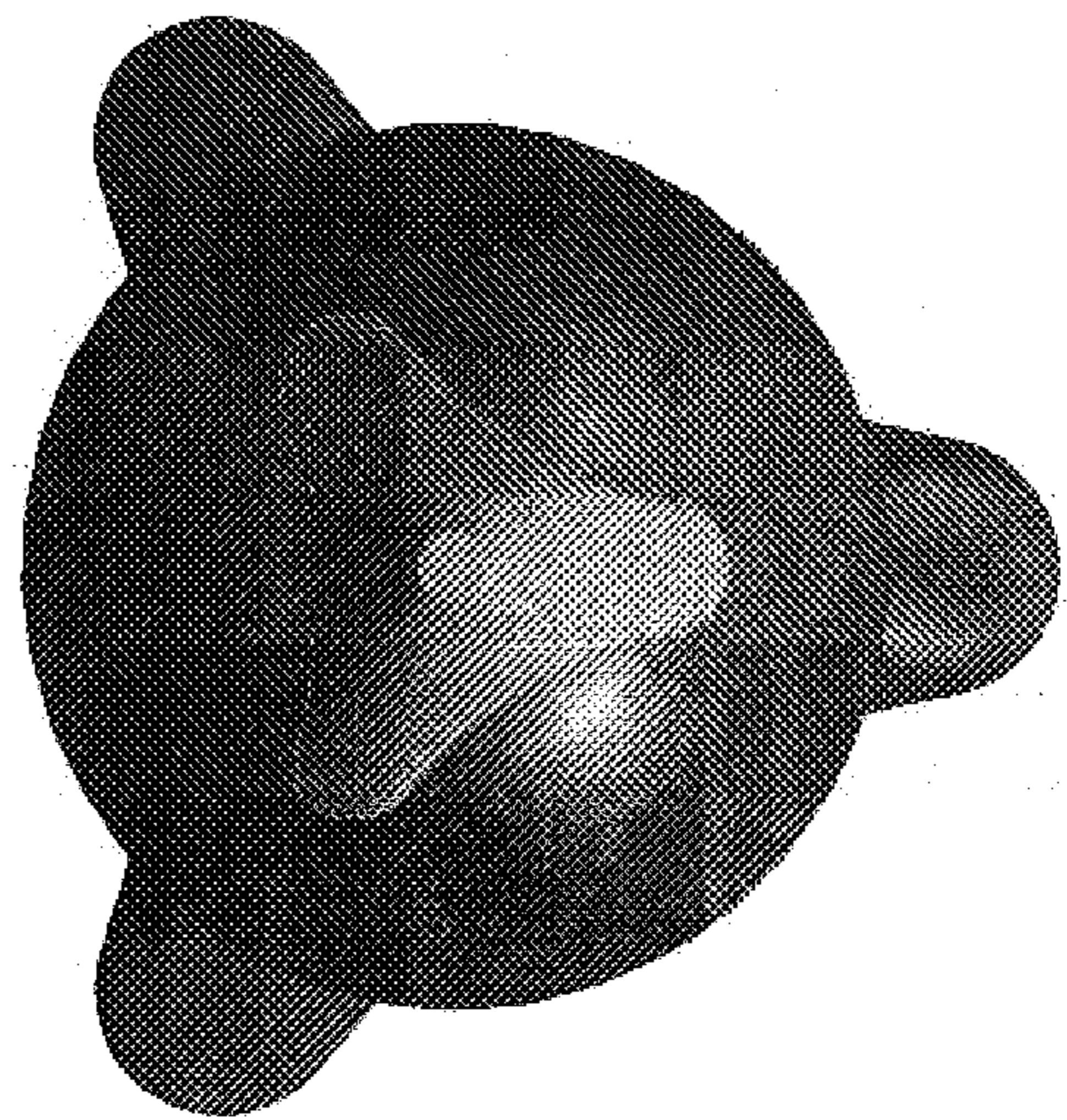

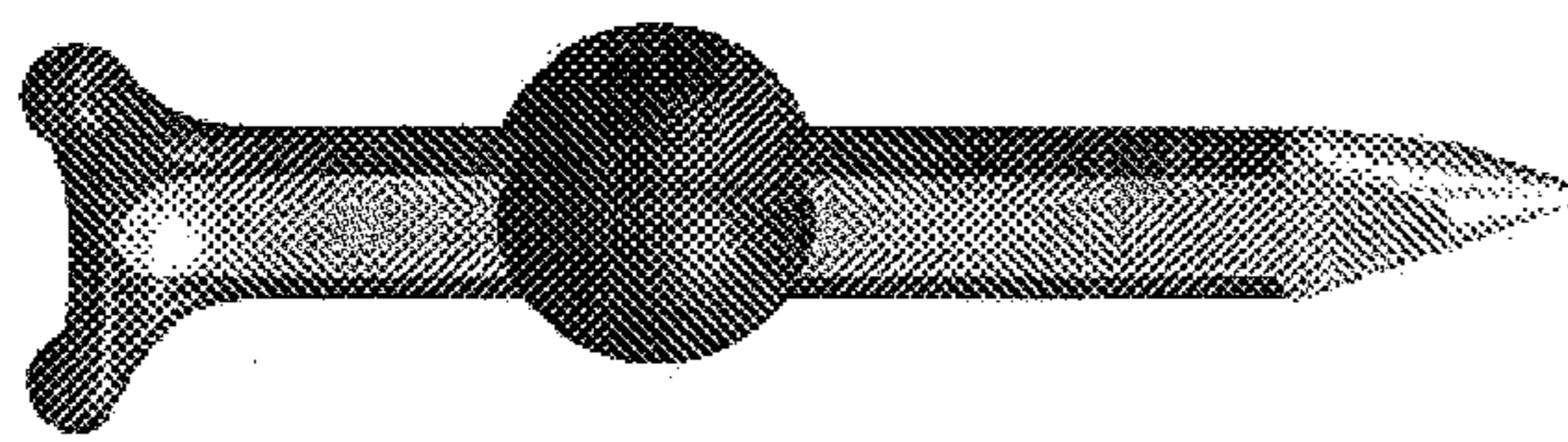

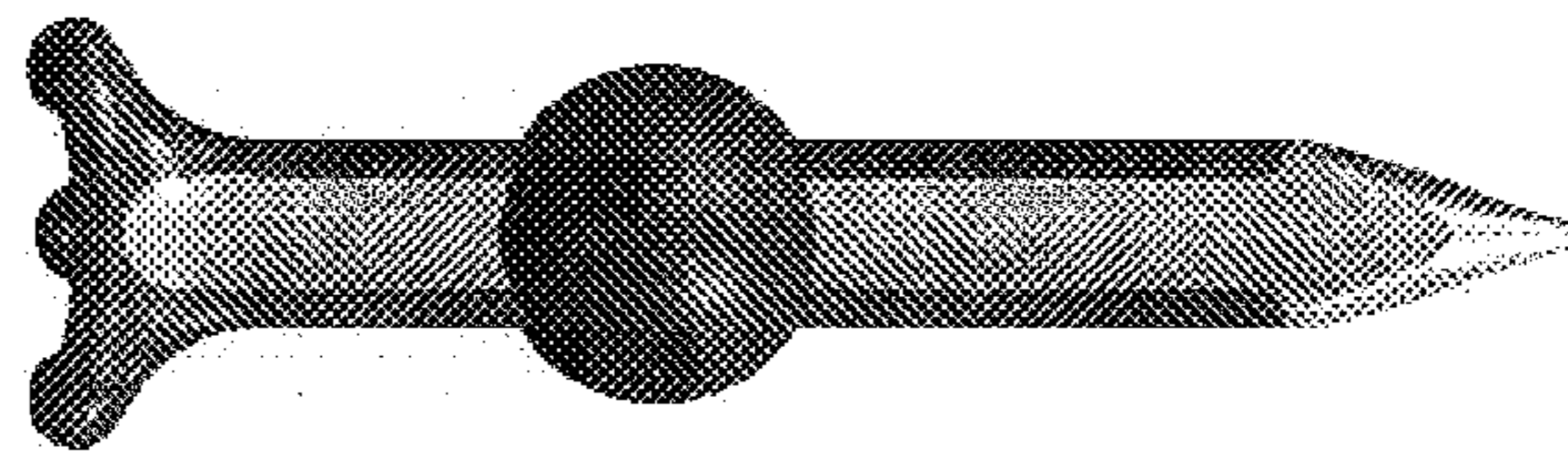

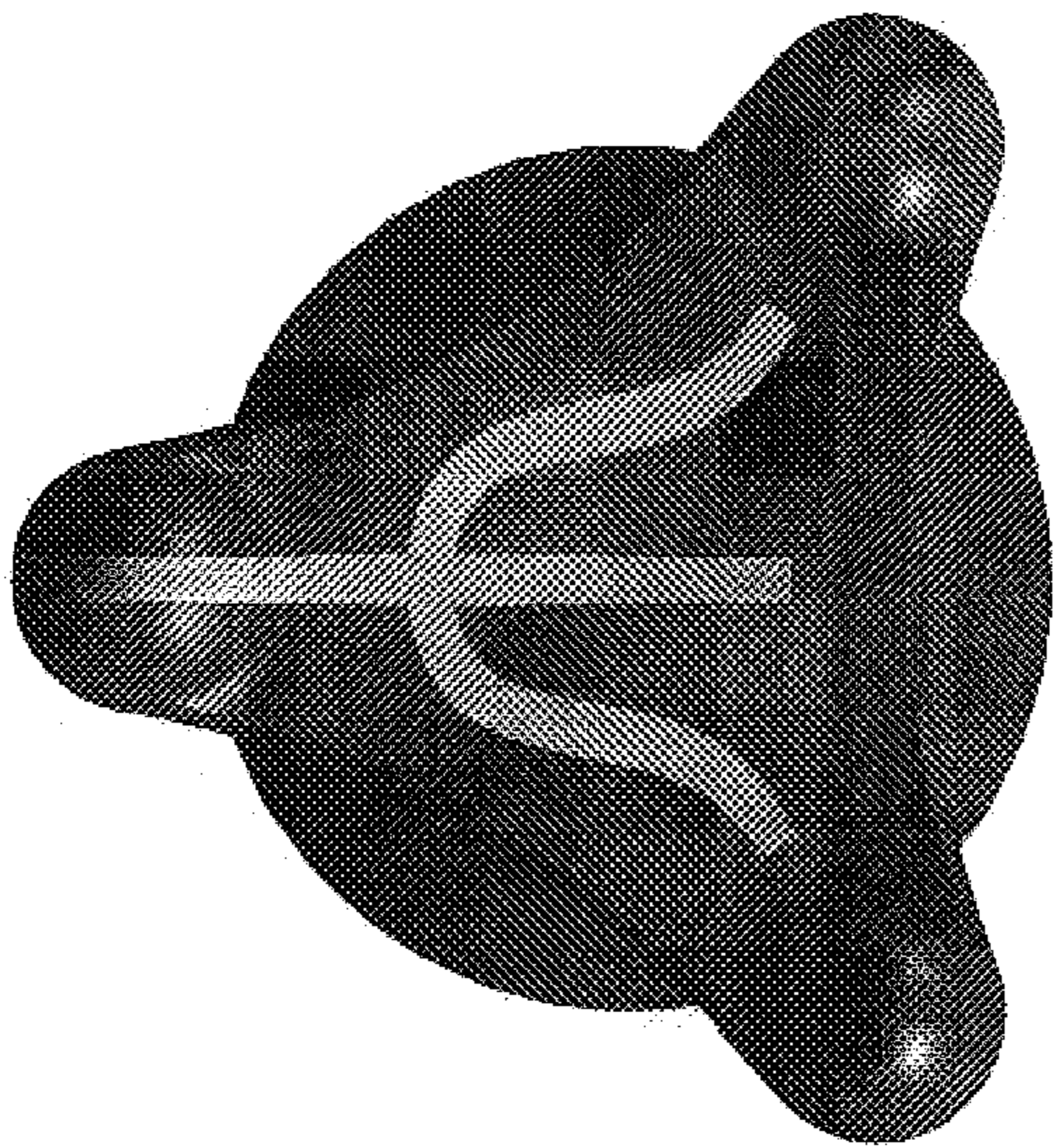

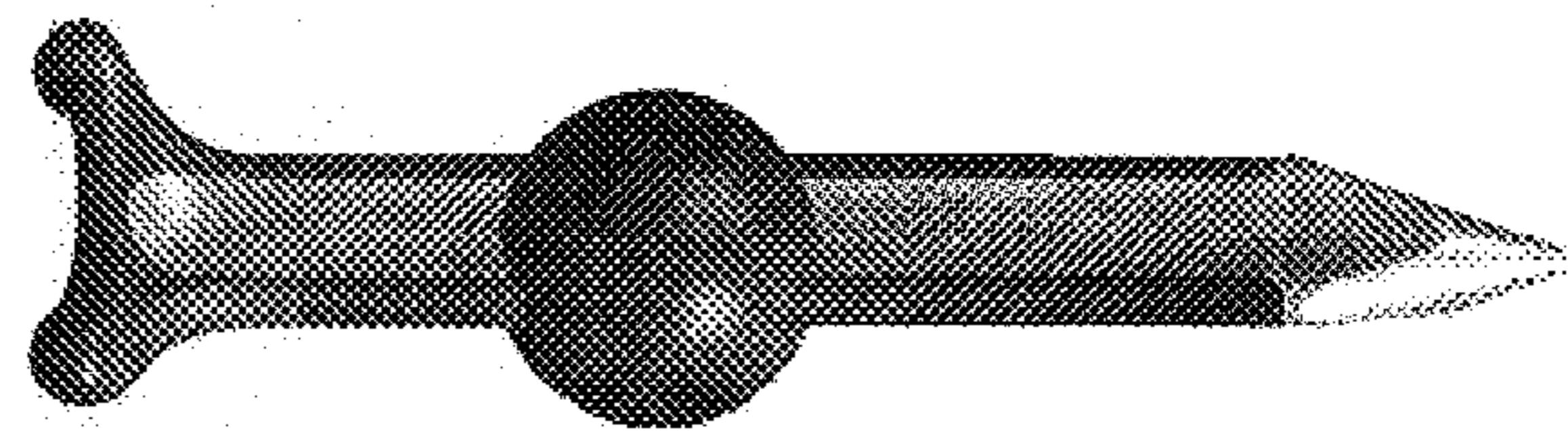

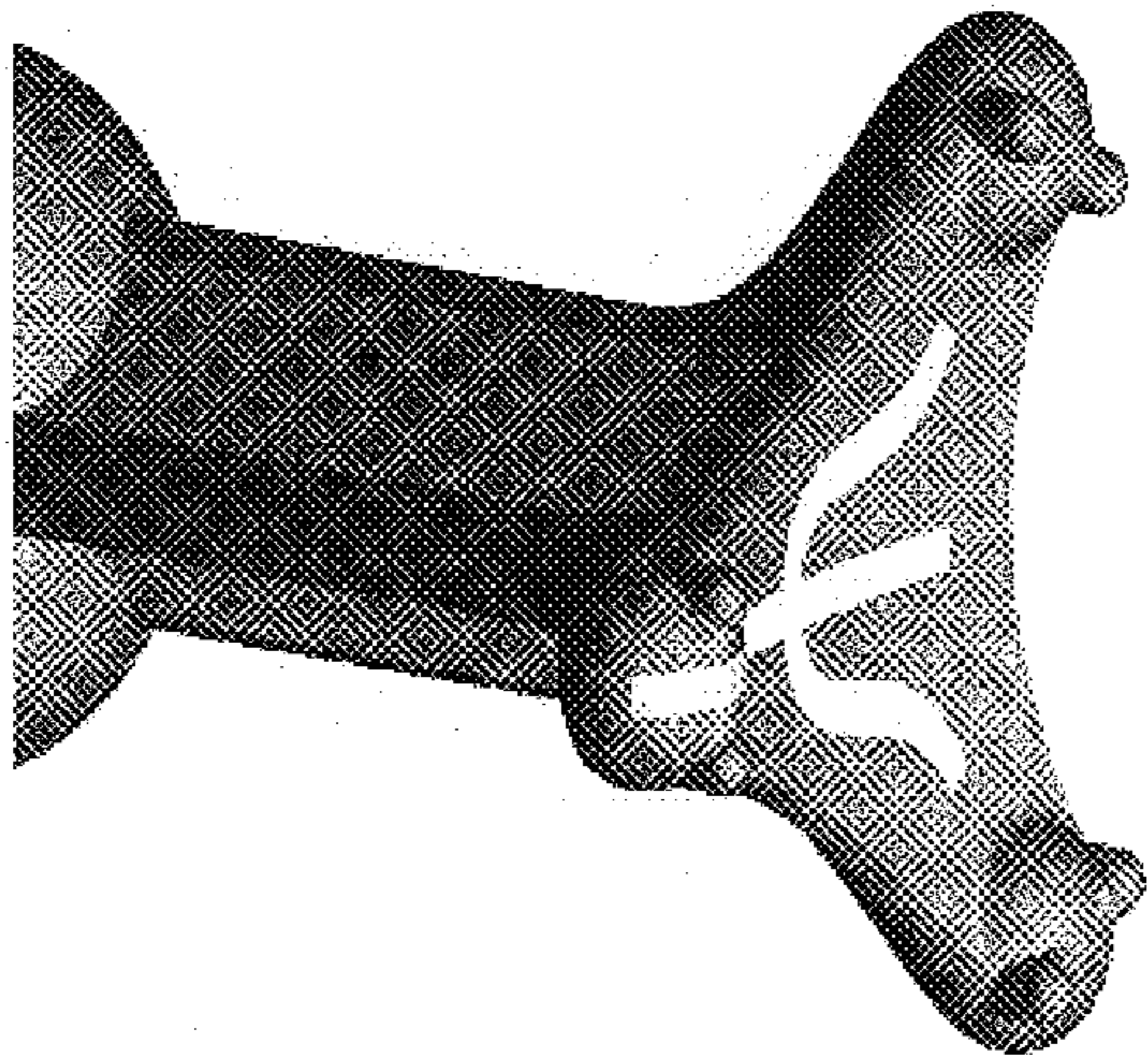

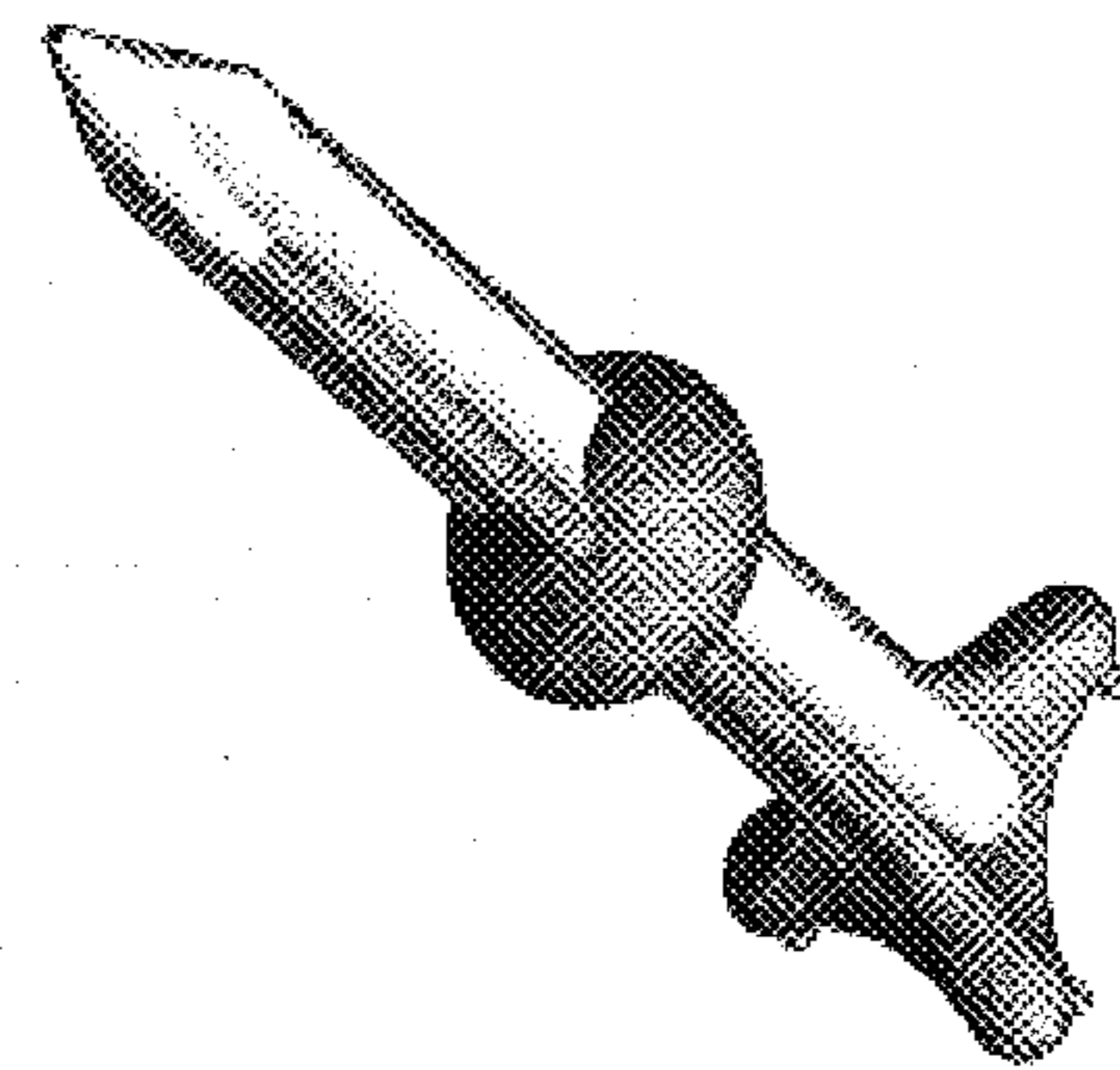

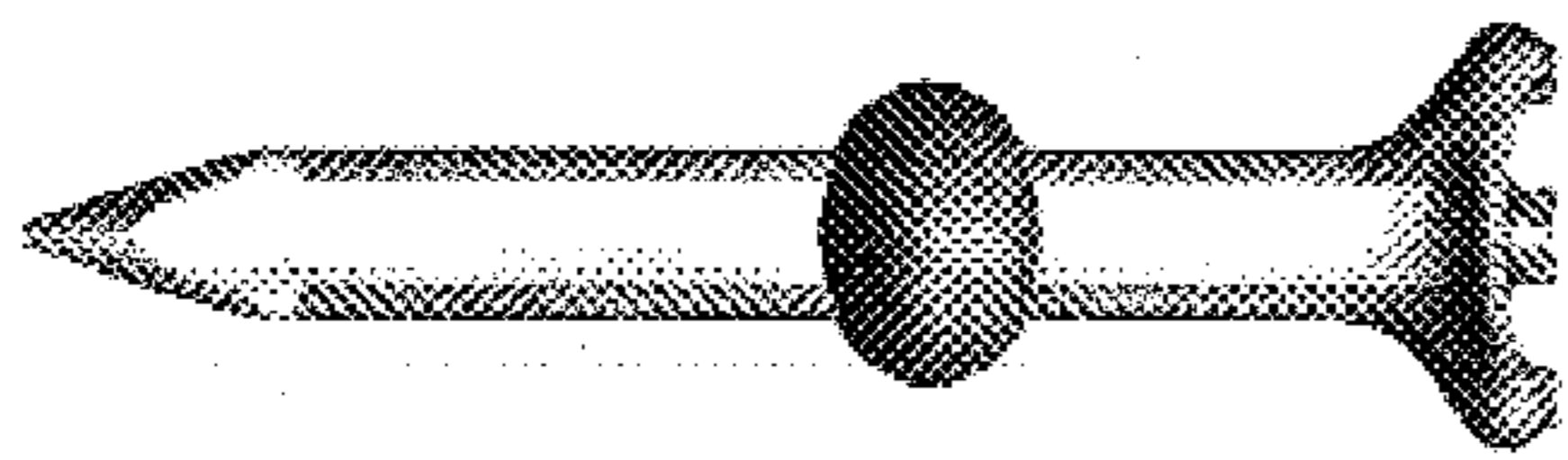

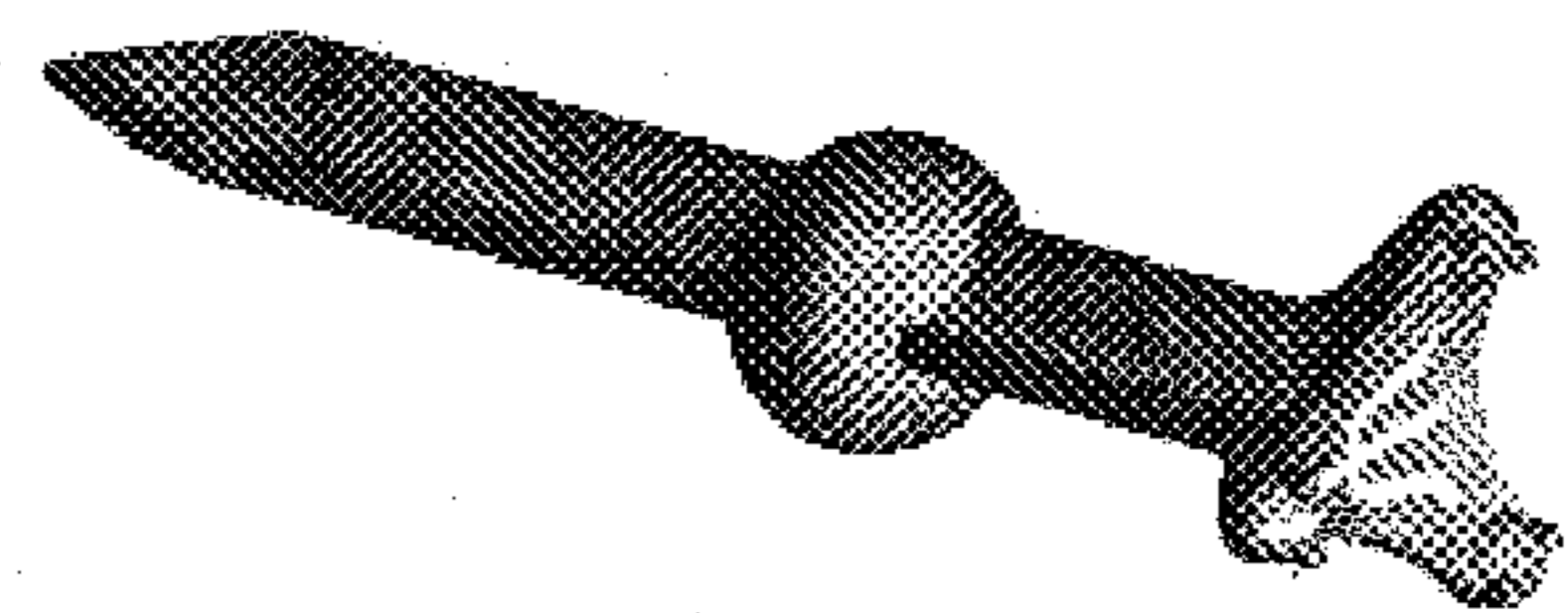

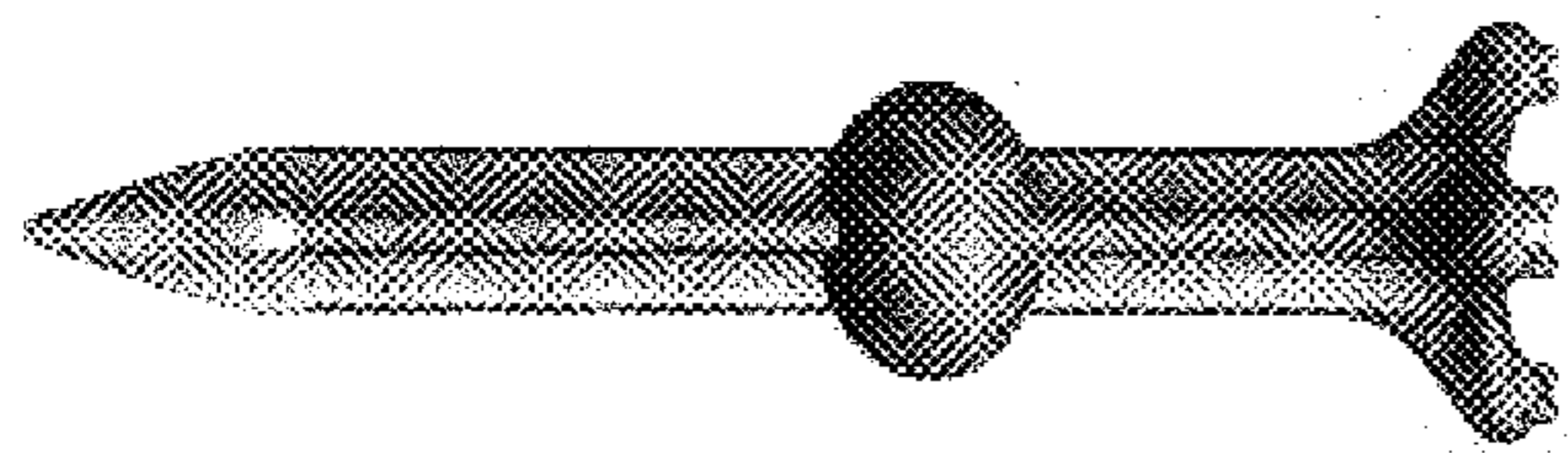

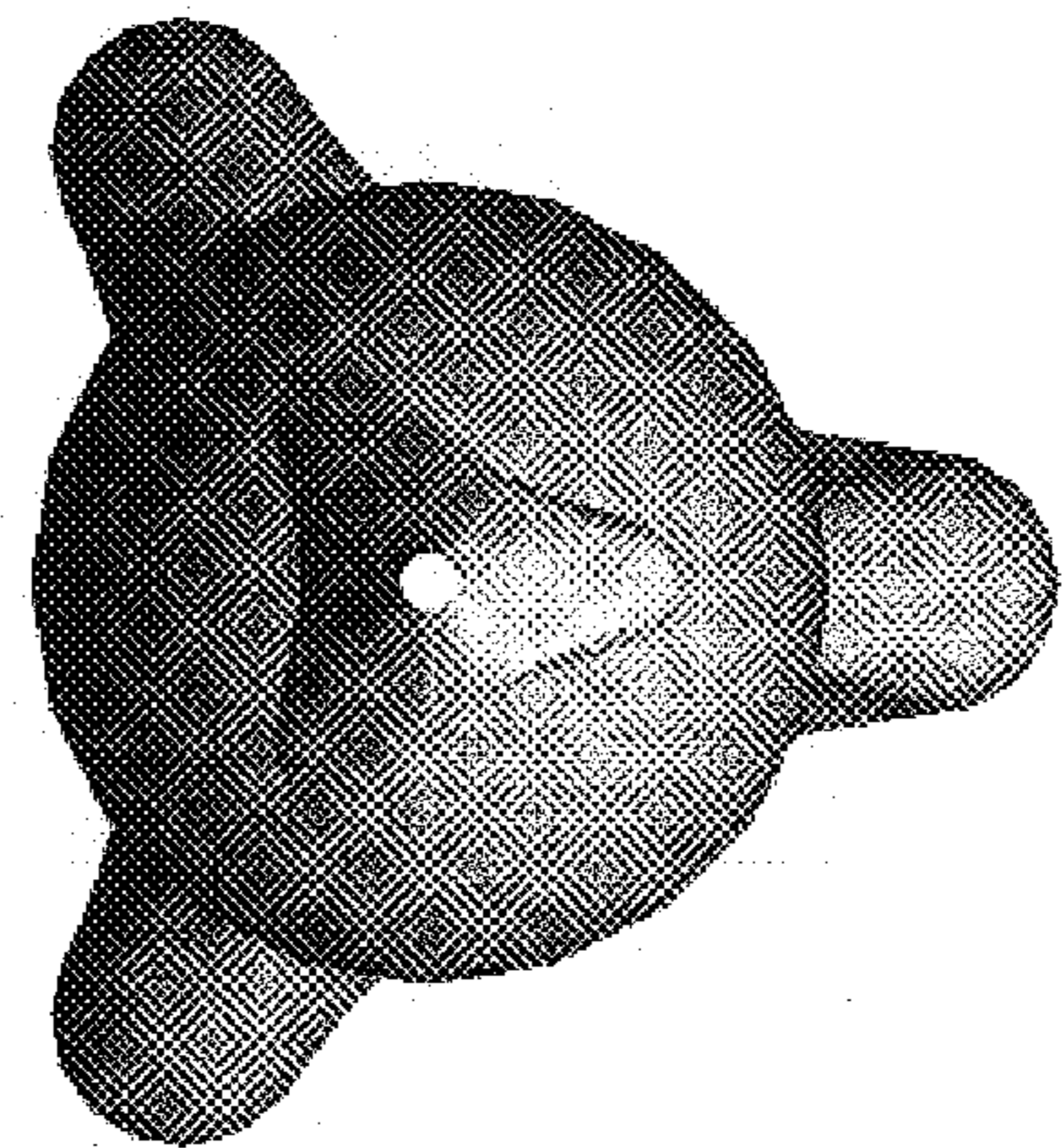

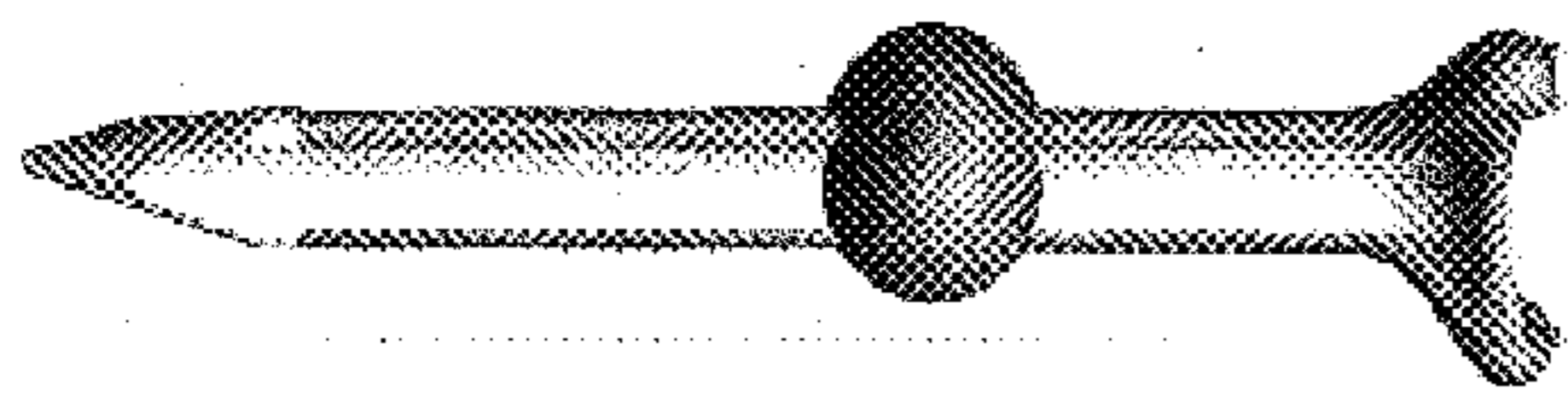

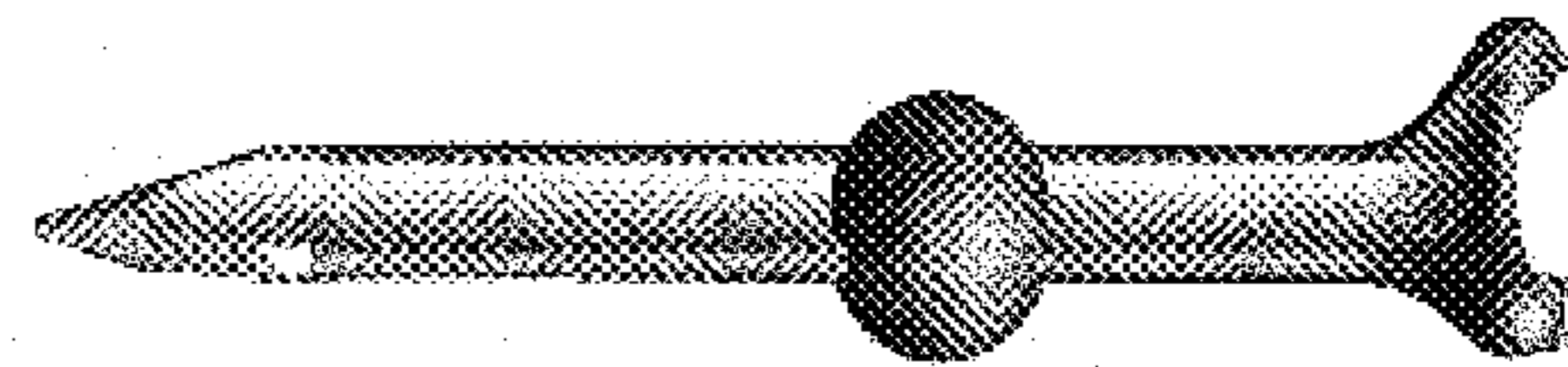

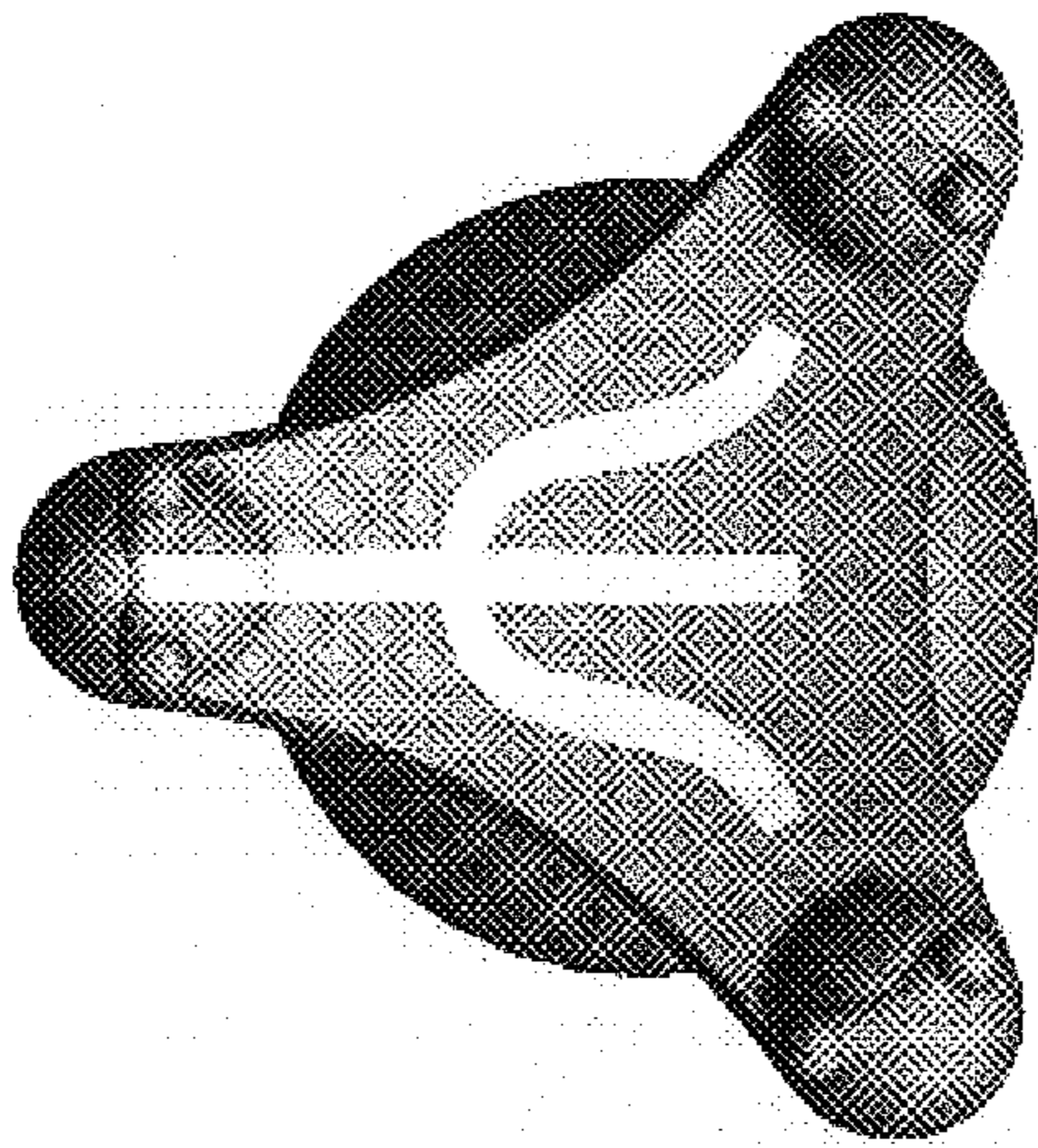
