(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vehicle seat headrest cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a vehicle seat headrest cover showing our design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof; the left side view being a mirror image

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof; the rear elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.

The hatched pattern repeats continuously across the headrest cover and indicates textile fabric.

The broken line showing in FIGS. 1-4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

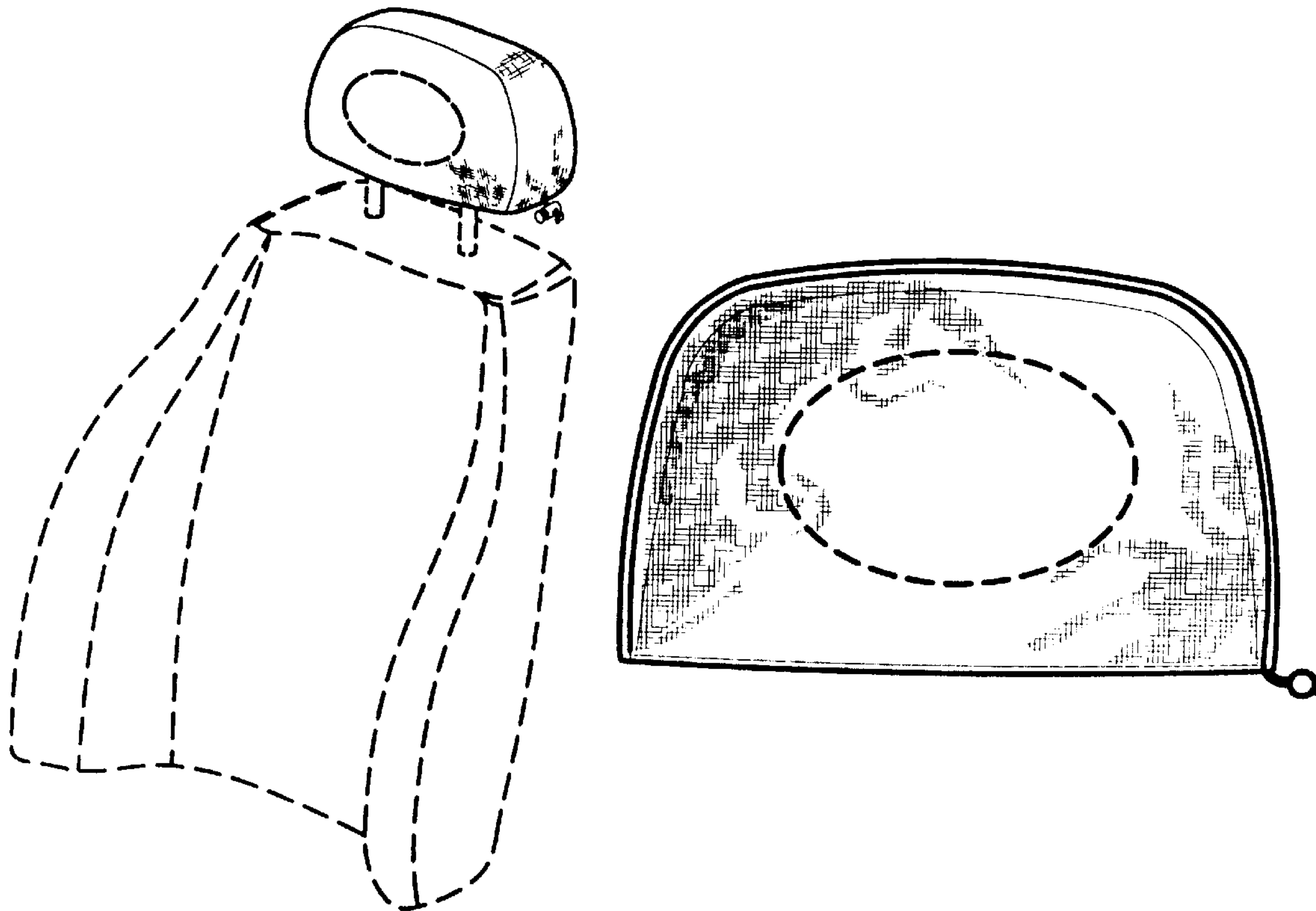

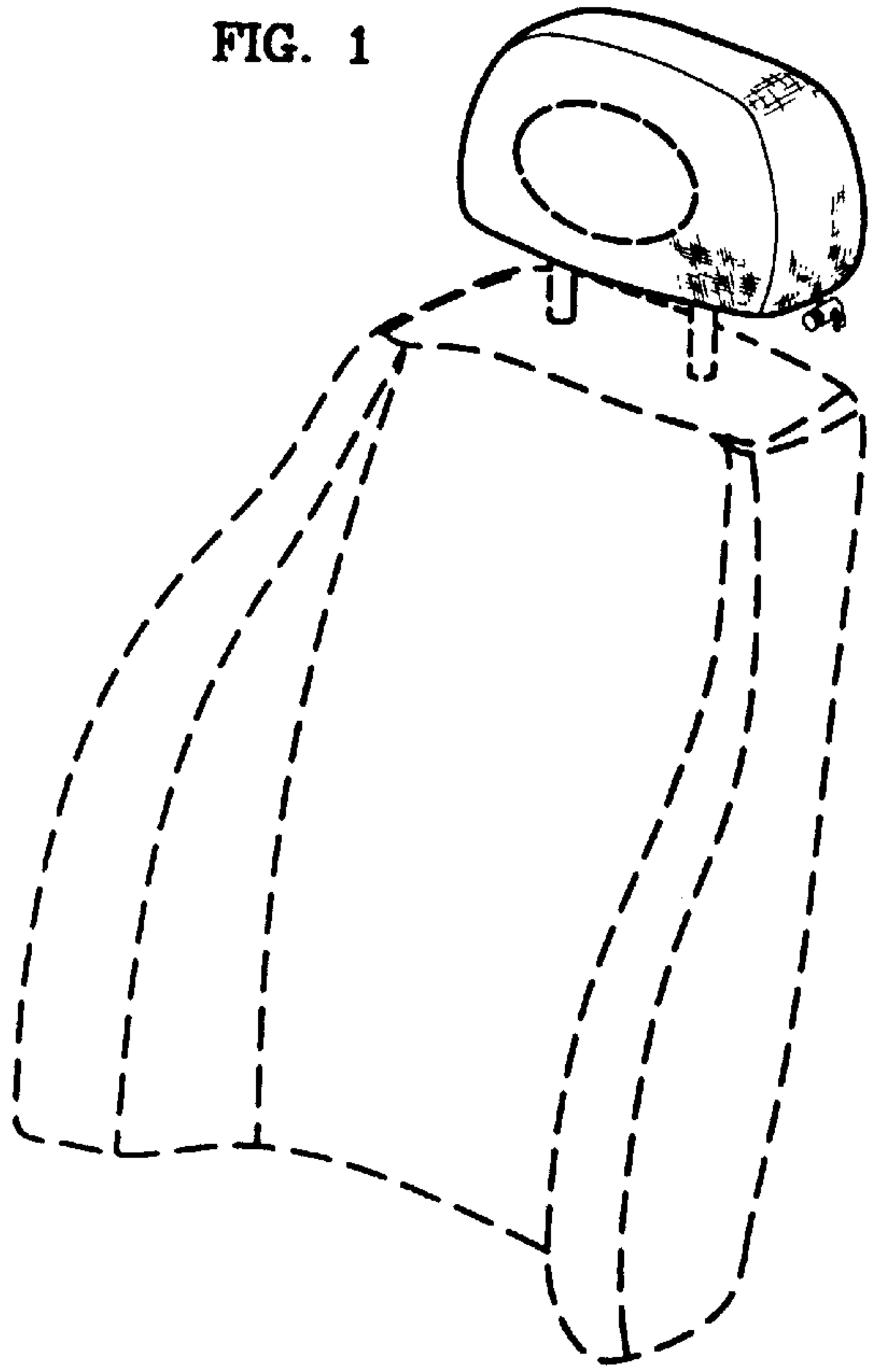

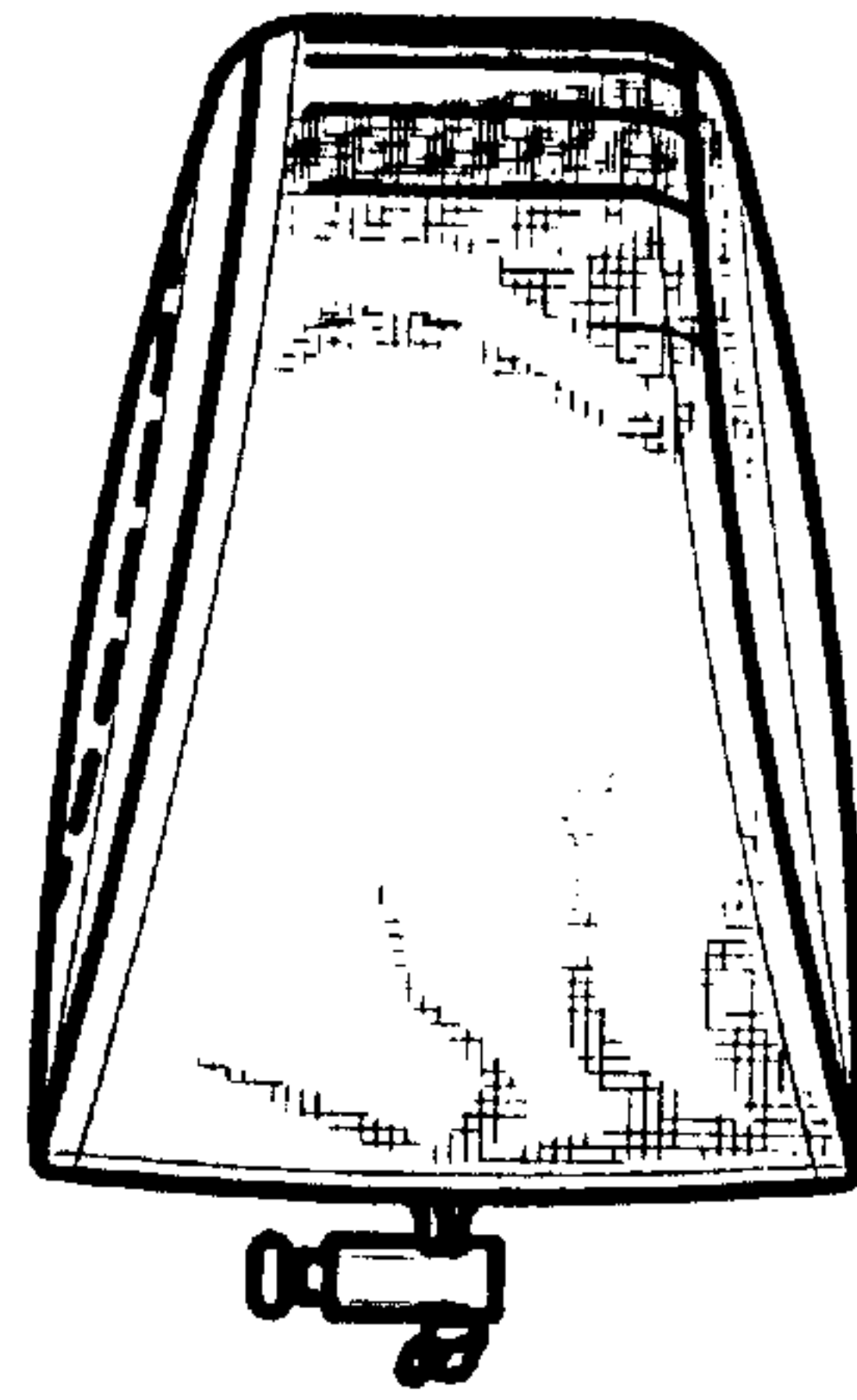

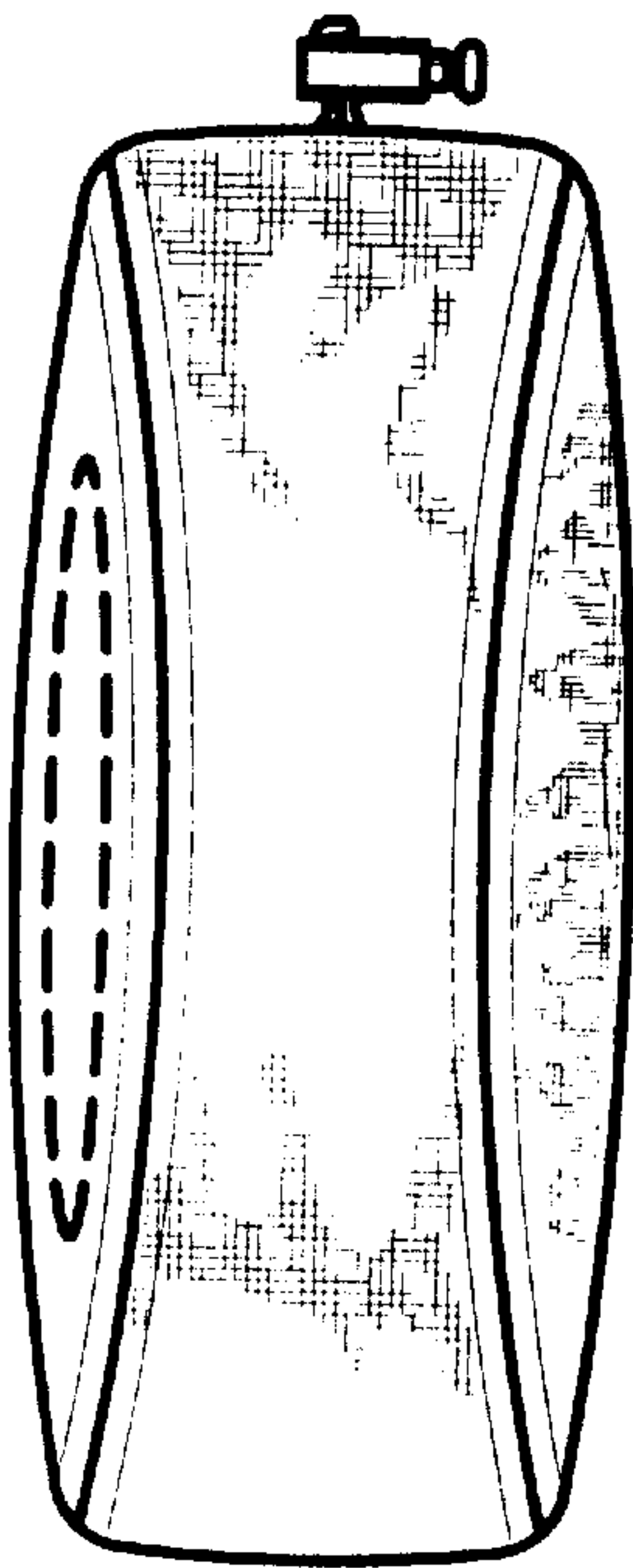
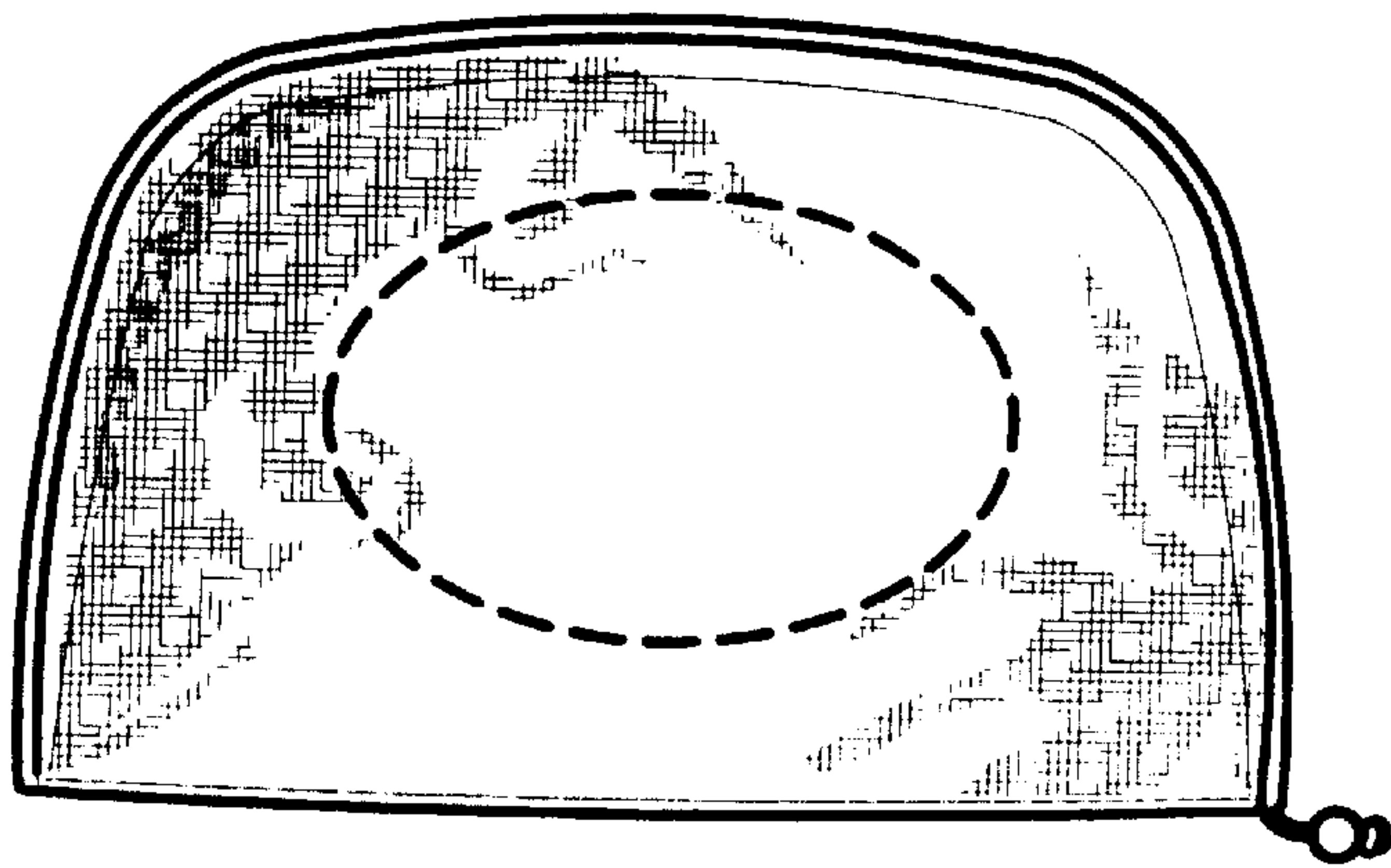

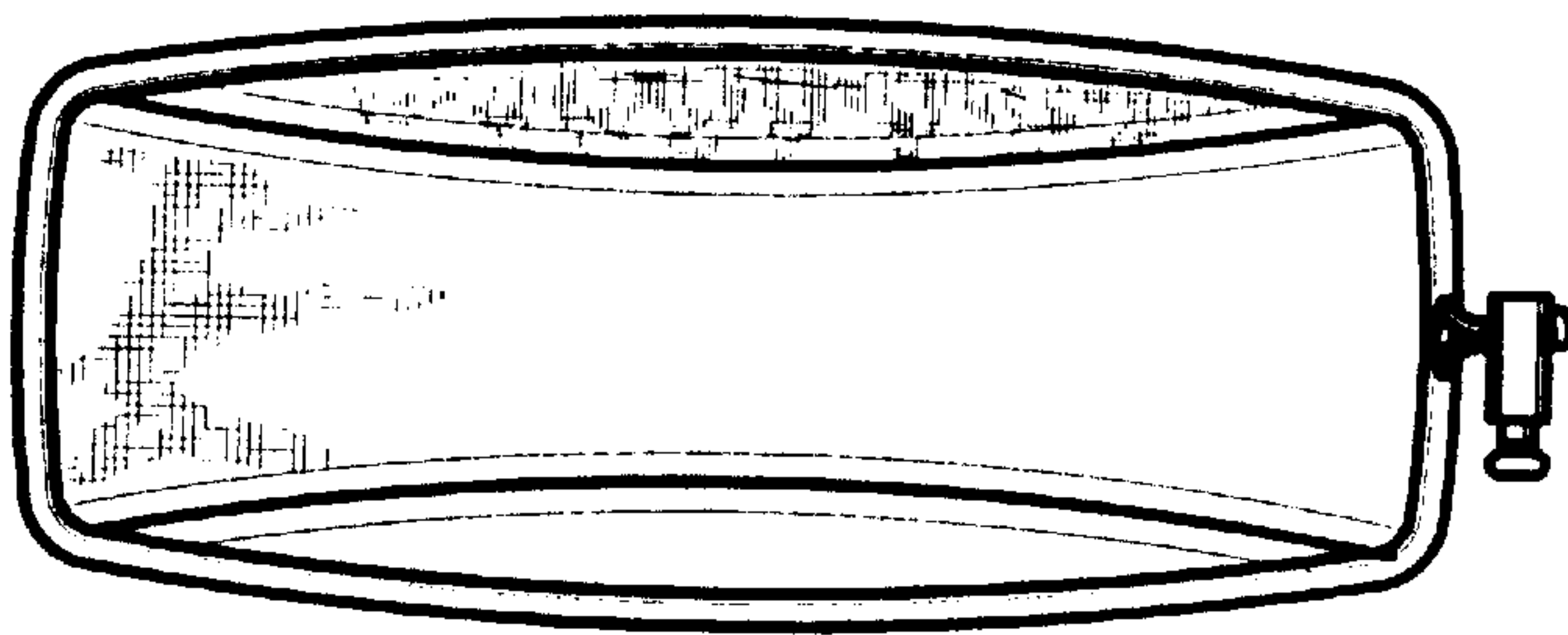
