described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a snow stop showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the snow stop of FIG. 1, depicted
in an upside down position;

FIG. 3 is rear view of the snow stop of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right hand side view of the snow stop of FIG. 1,
with the left hand side being a mirror image whereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the snow stop of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a top, left, rear perspective view of the snow stop
of FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of another embodiment of a snow
stop showing my new design, which is opaque but not
otherwise like the snow stop of FIGS. 1-6; and

FIG. 8 is a top, left, rear perspective view of the snow stop
of FIG. 7.

FIG. 9 is a bottom view of another embodiment of a snow
stop showing my new design, which is without grooves on
the bottom of the base but otherwise like the snow stop of
FIGS. 1-6; and

FIG. 10 is a top, left, rear perspective view of the snow stop
of FIG. 9.

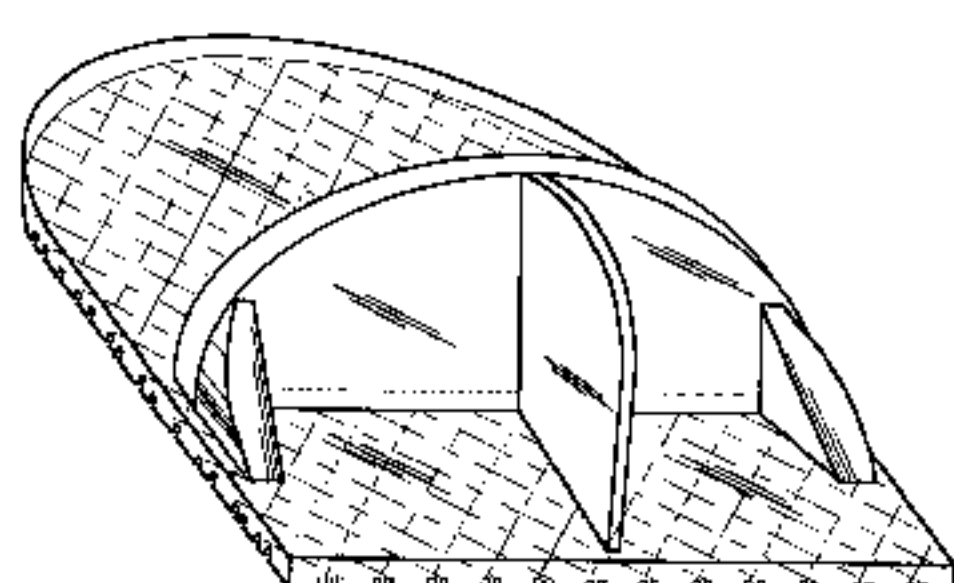
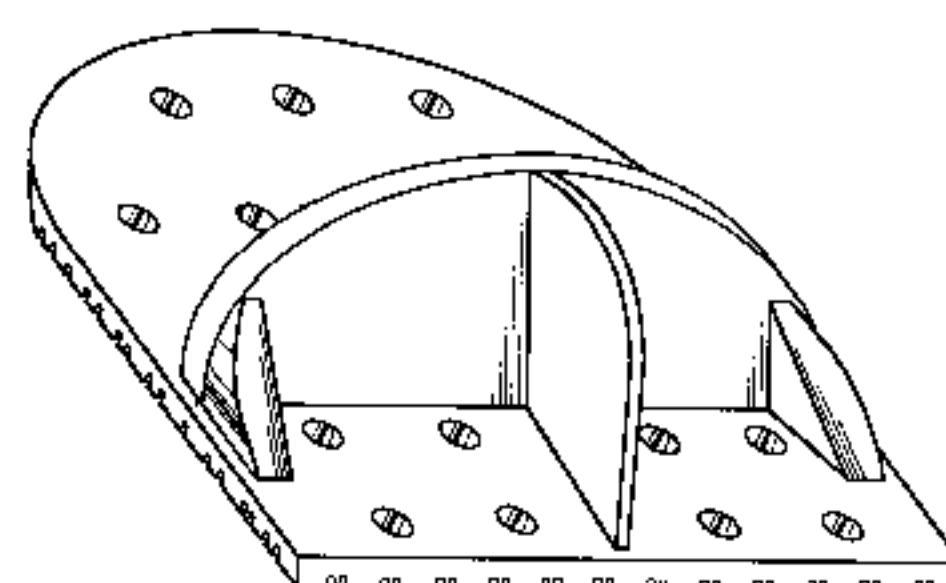
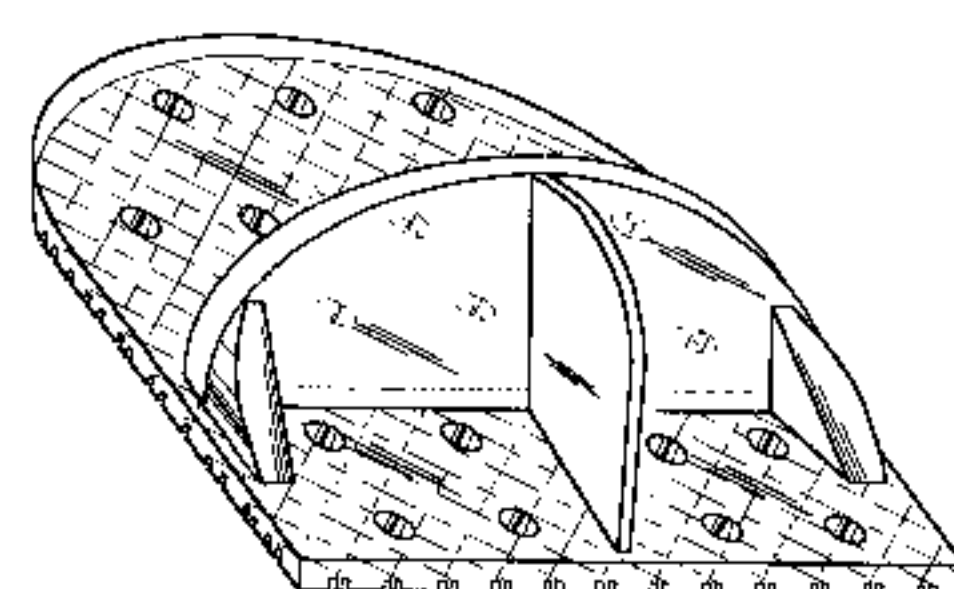
FIG. 11 is a bottom view of another embodiment of a snow

stop showing my new design, which is without holes and
without grooves in the base but otherwise like the snow stop

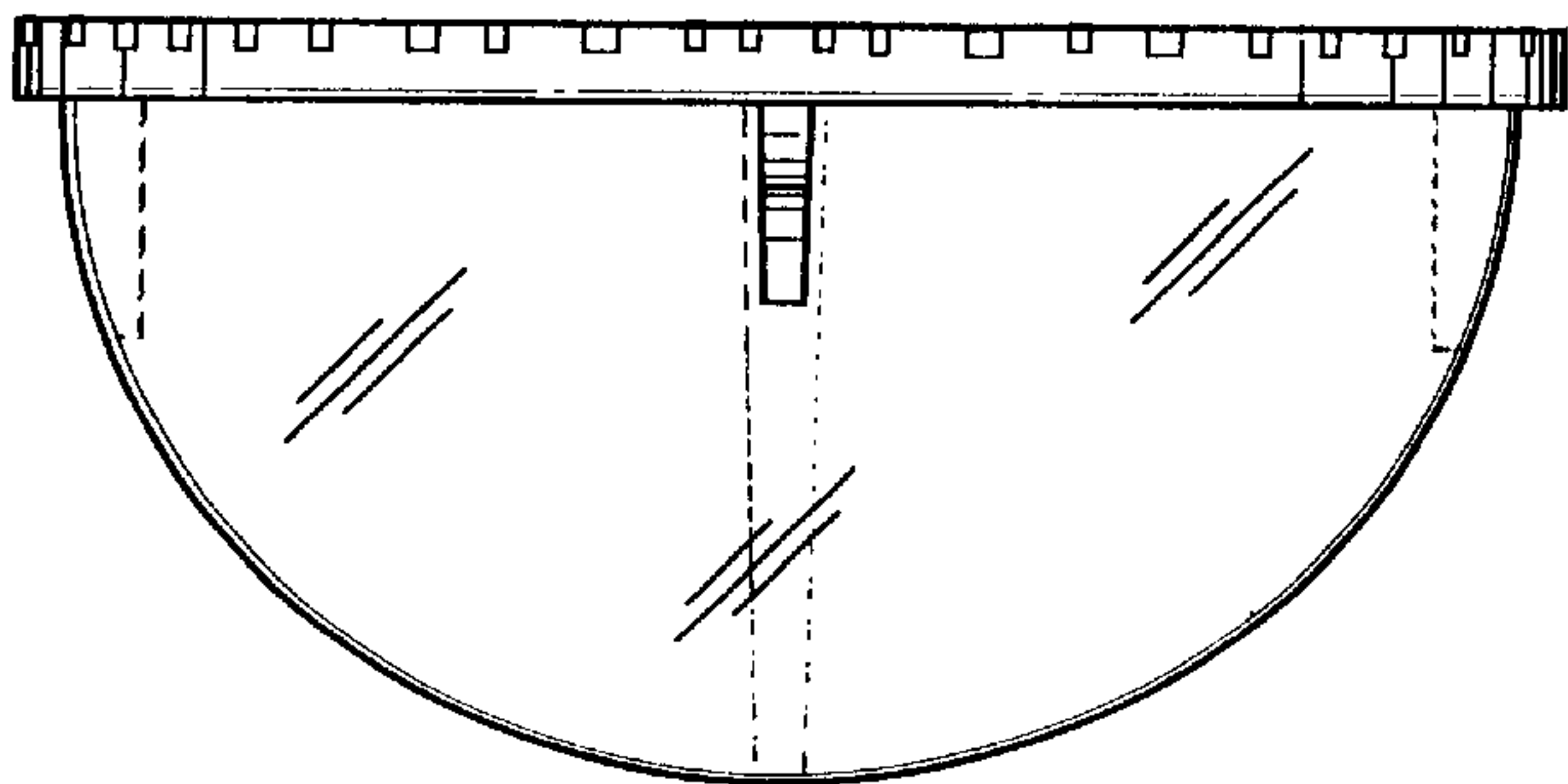

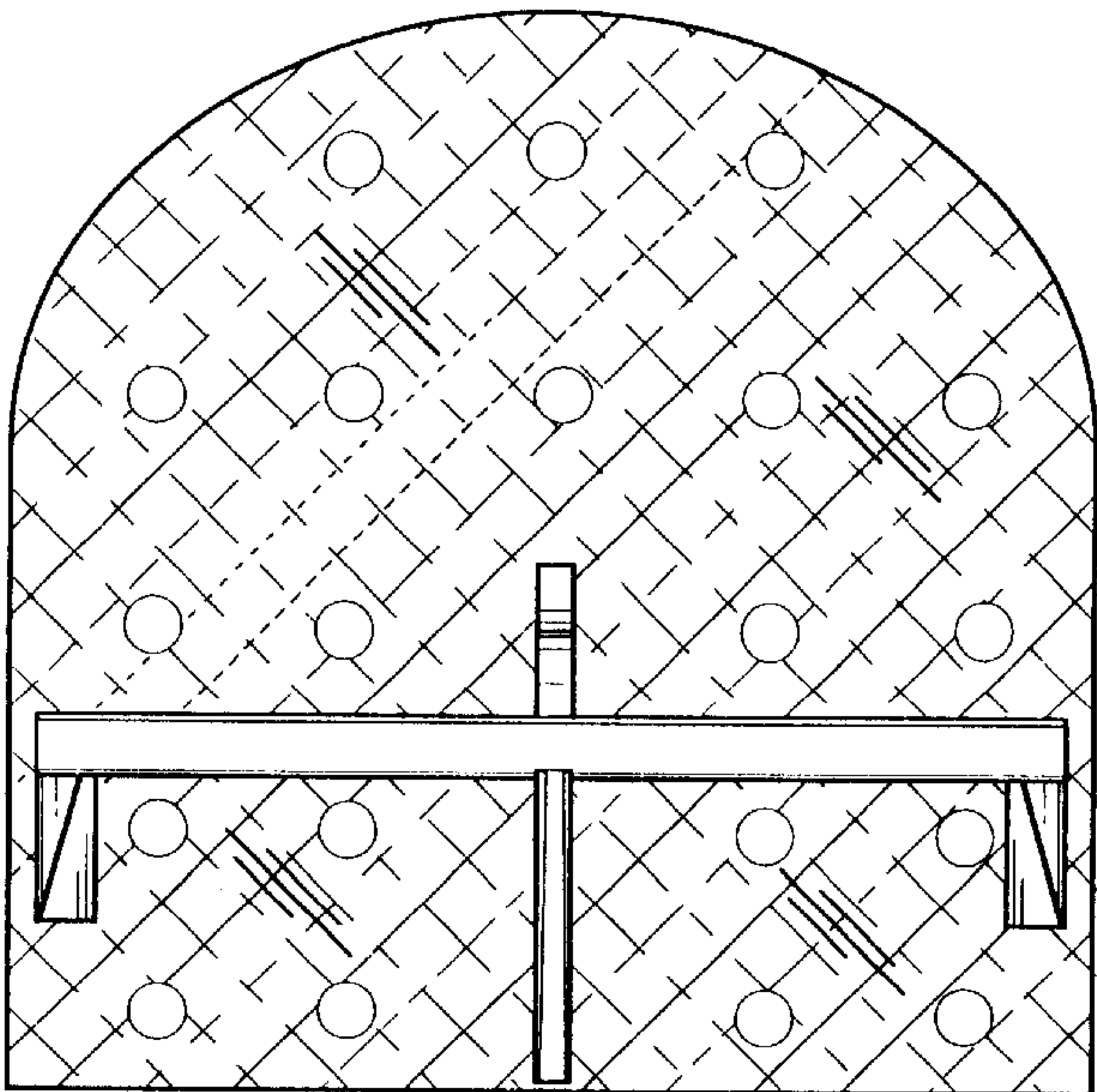

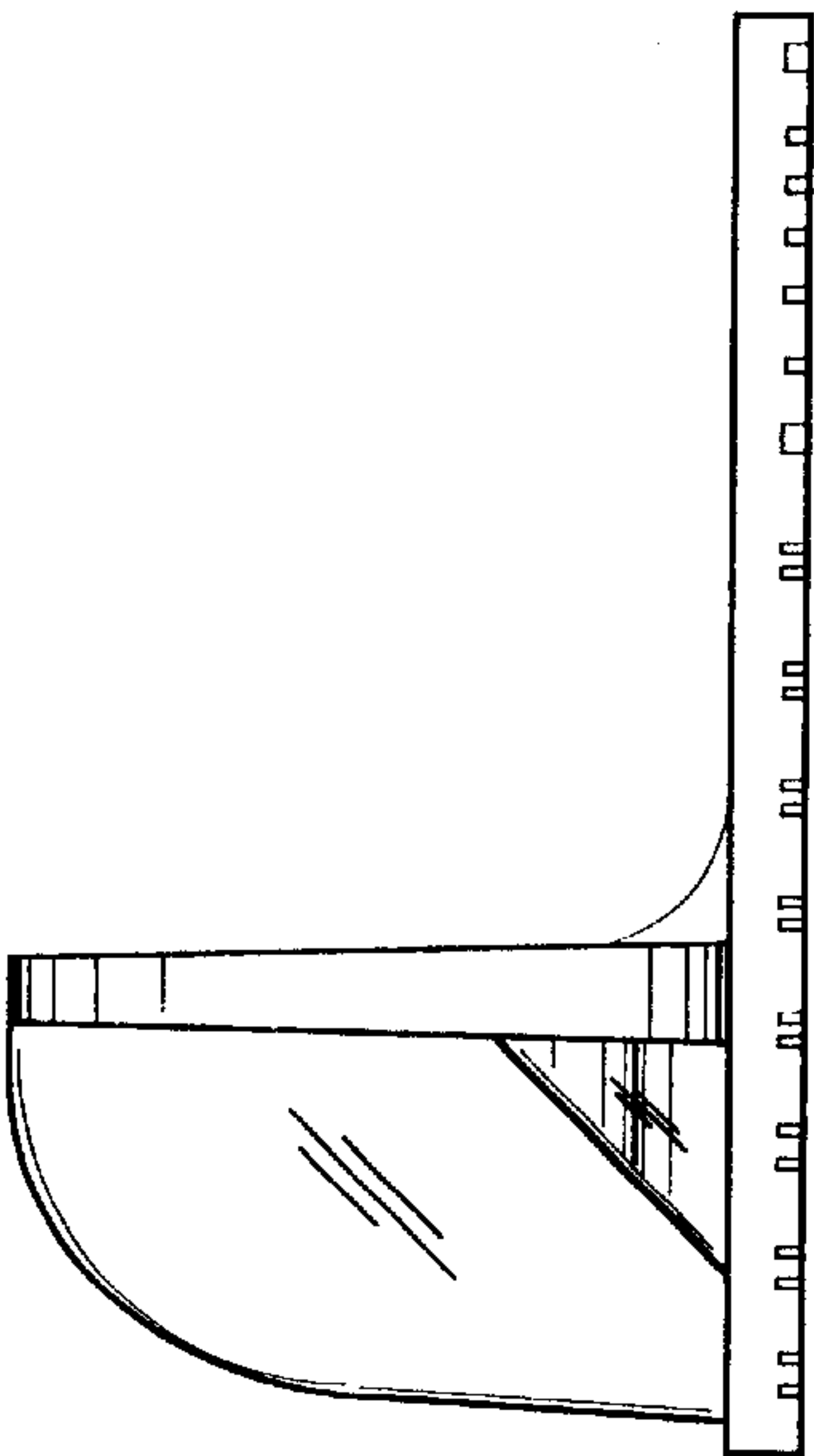

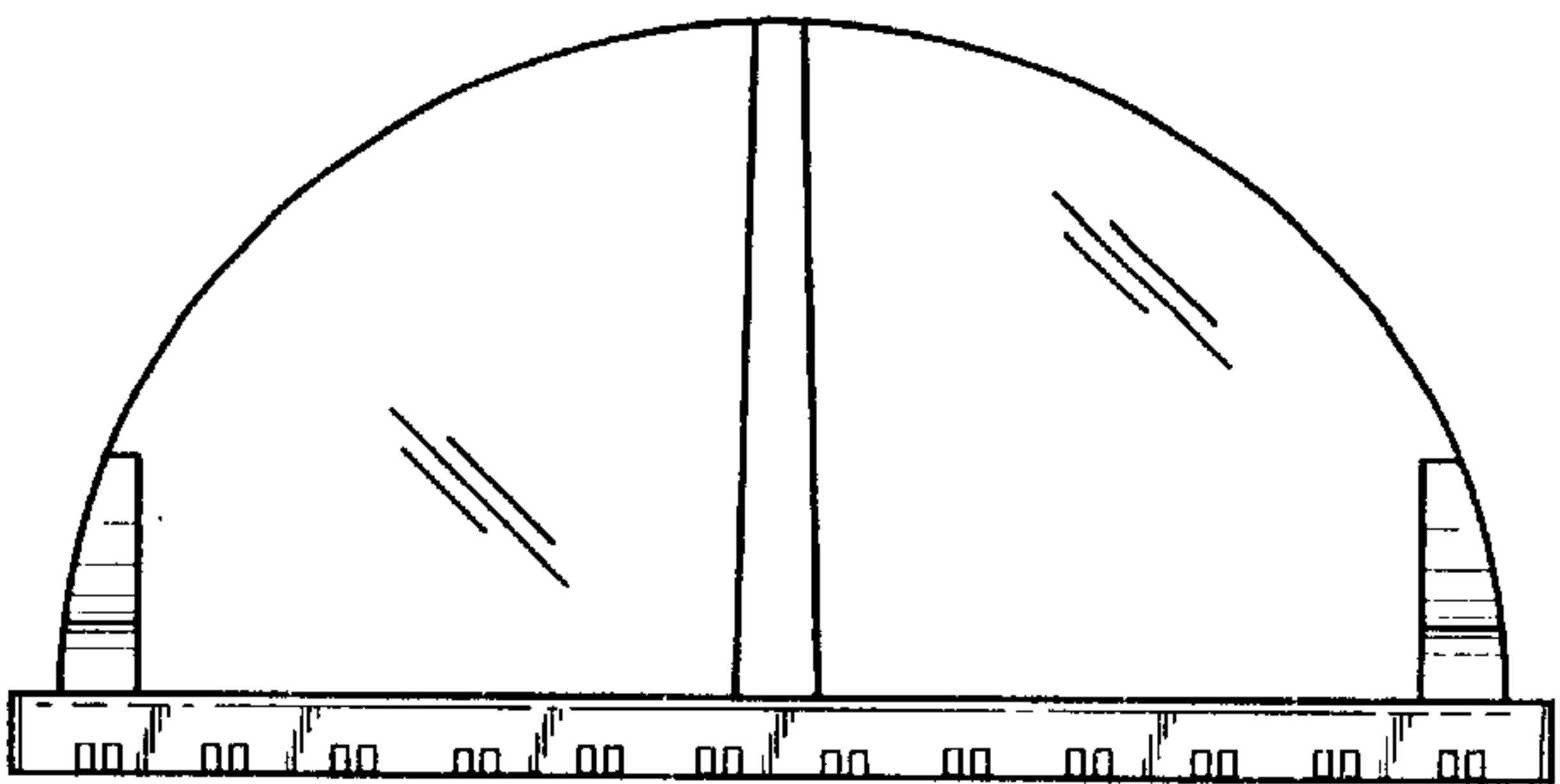

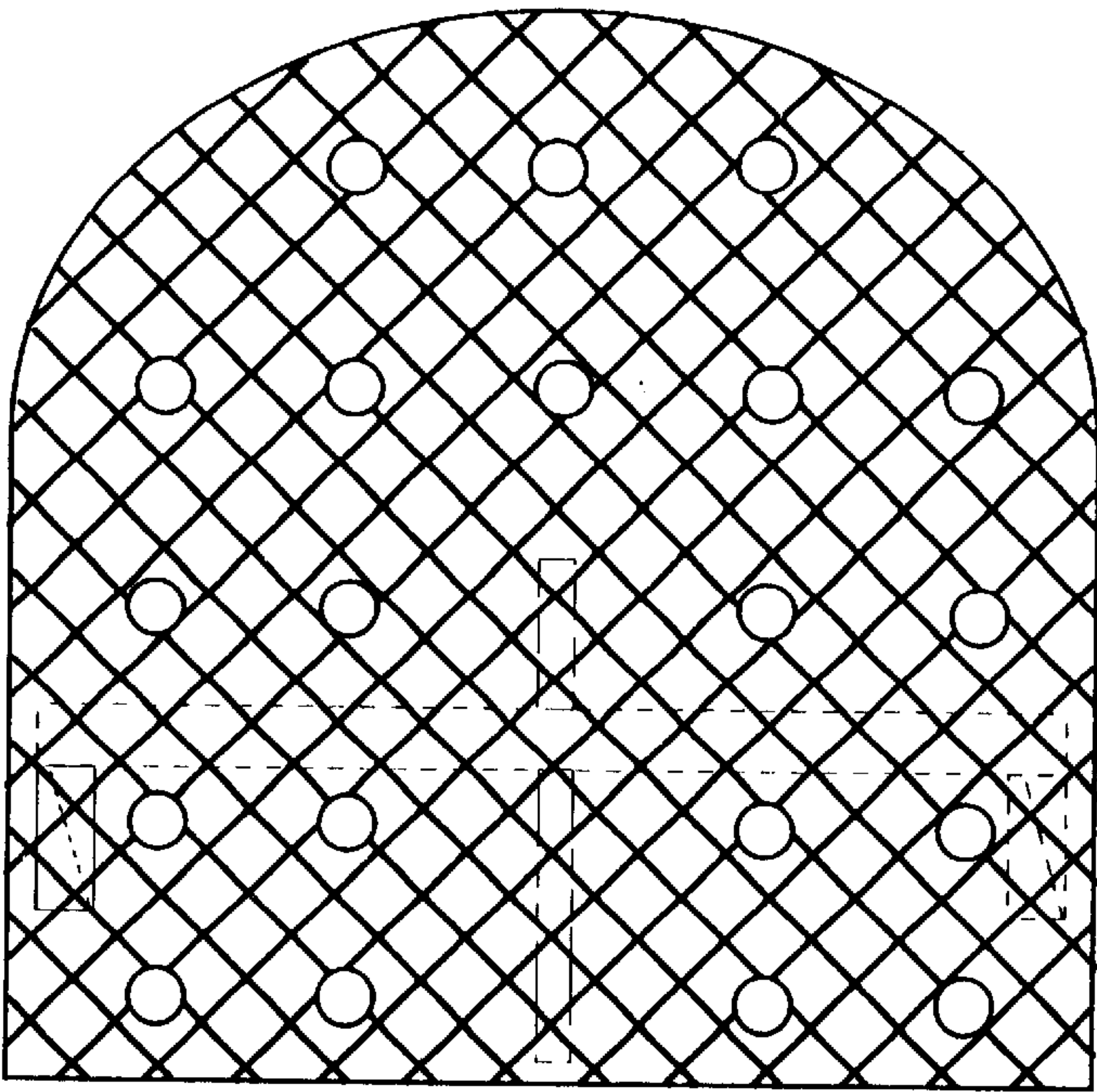

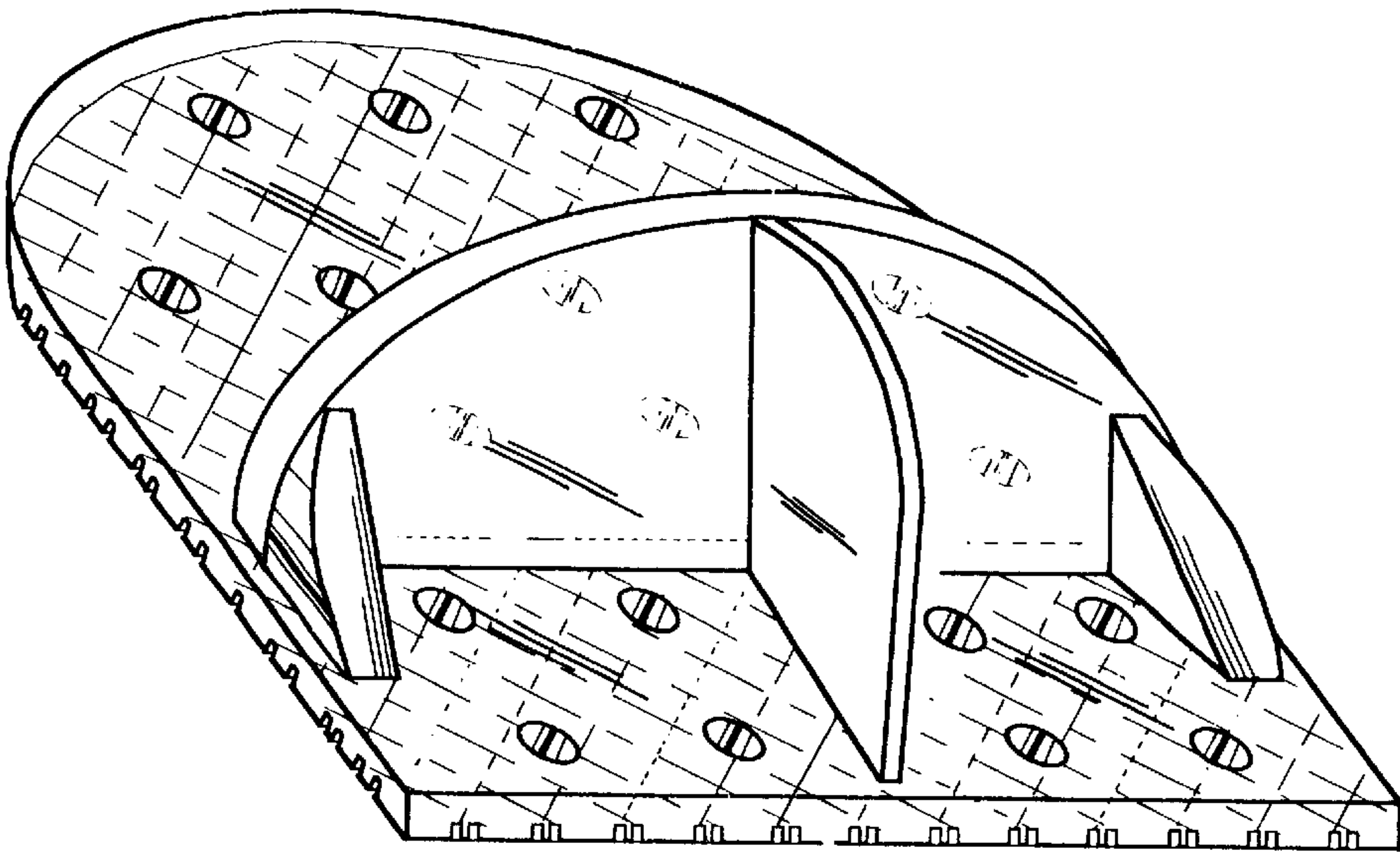

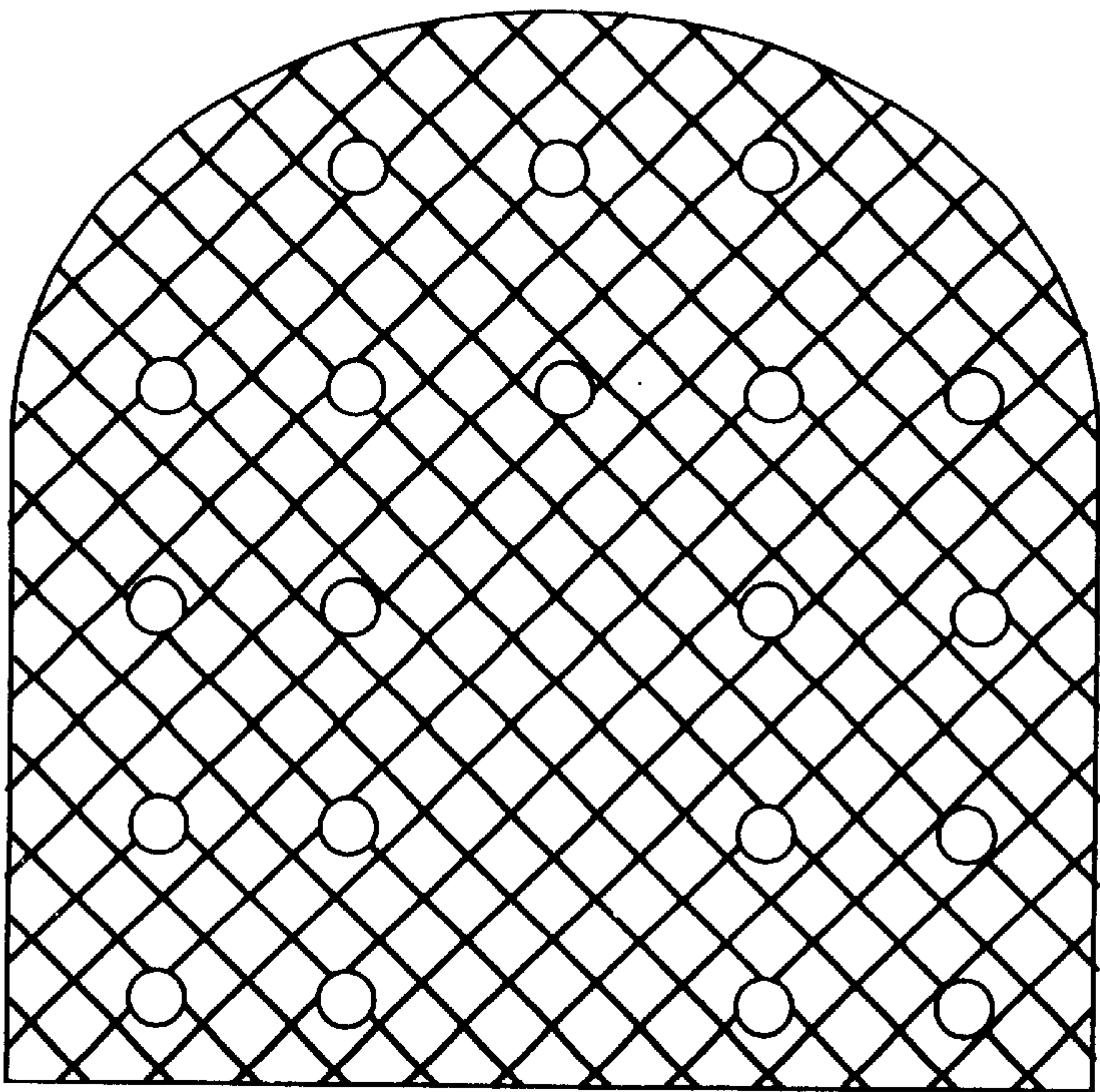

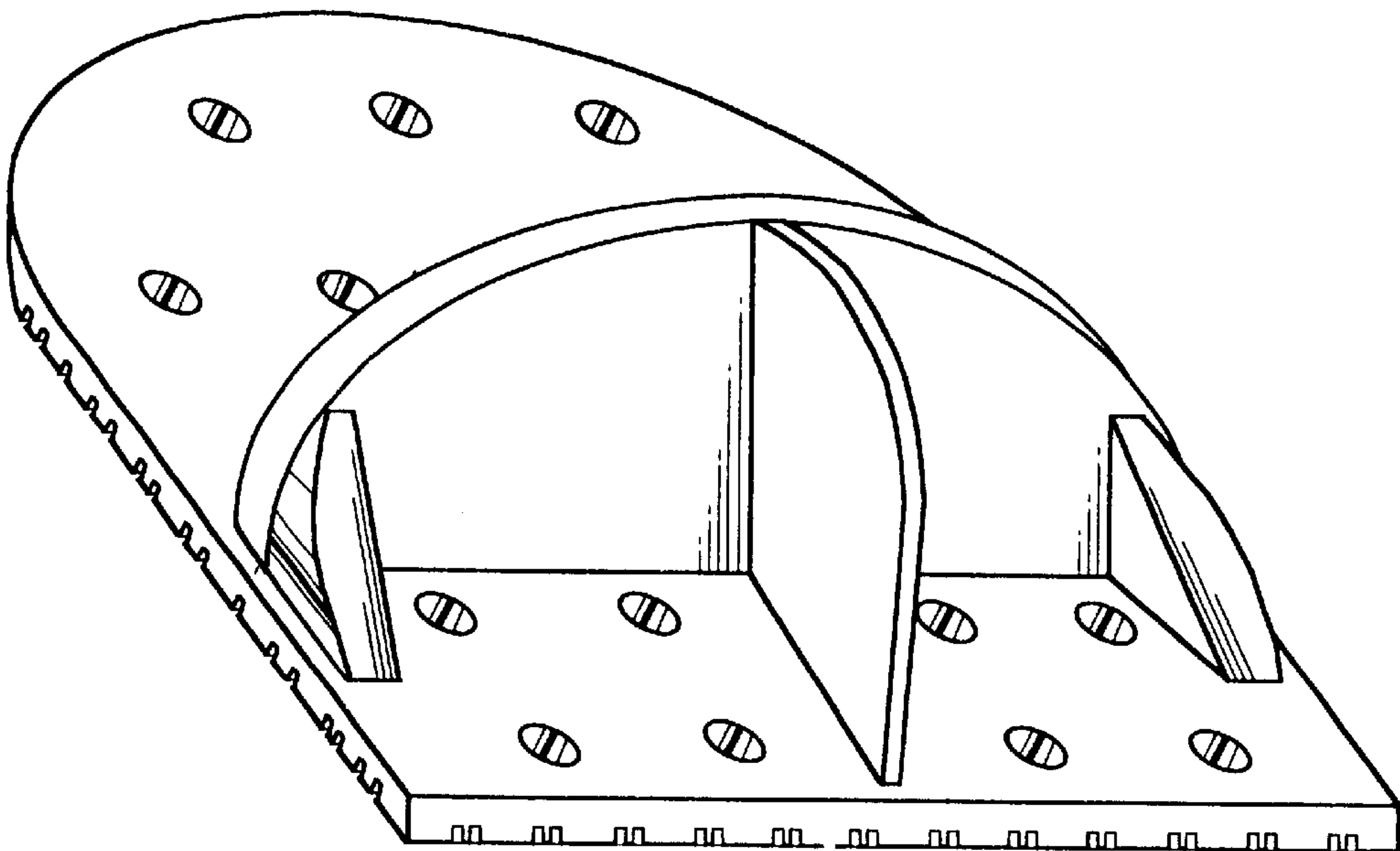

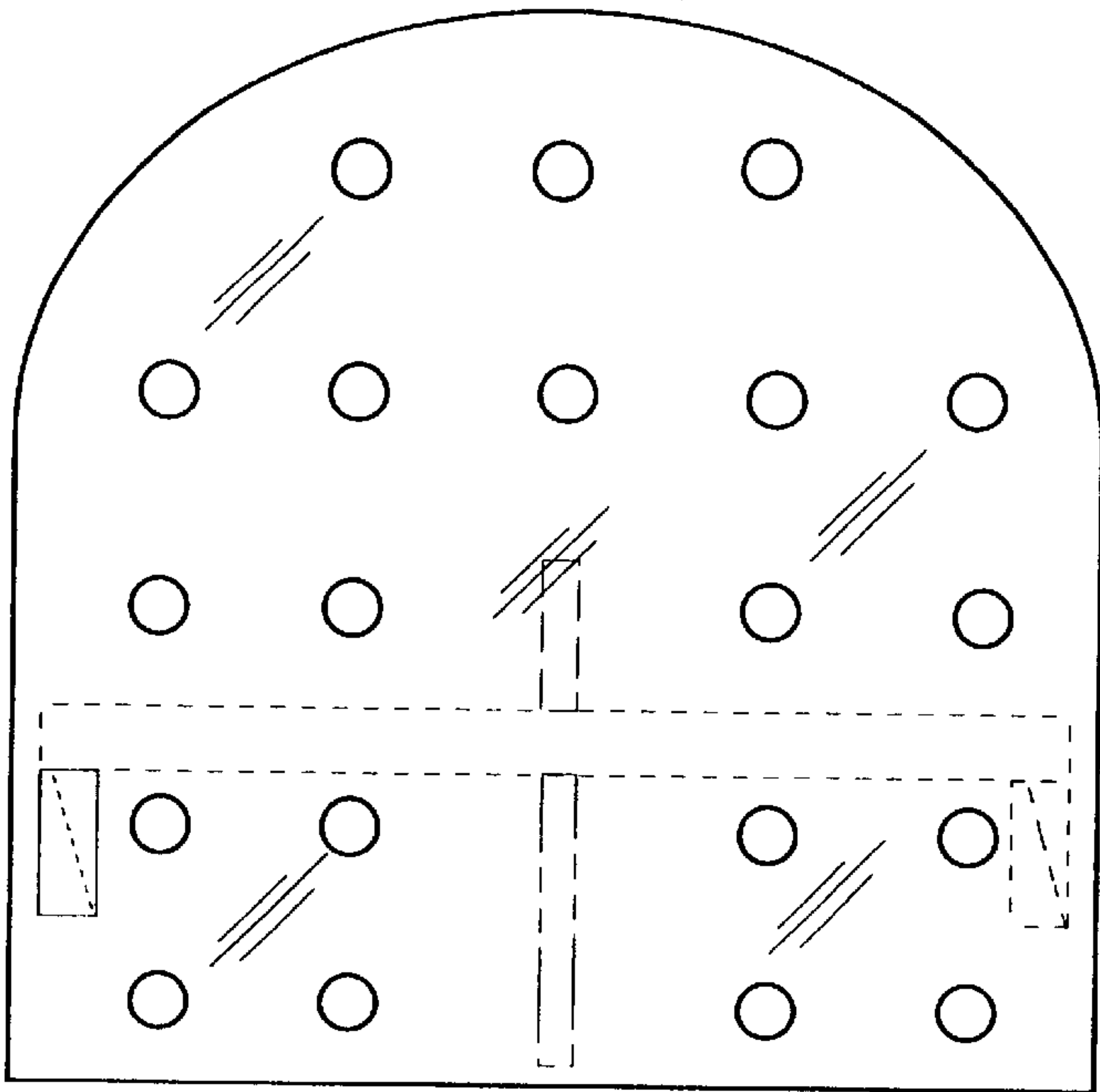

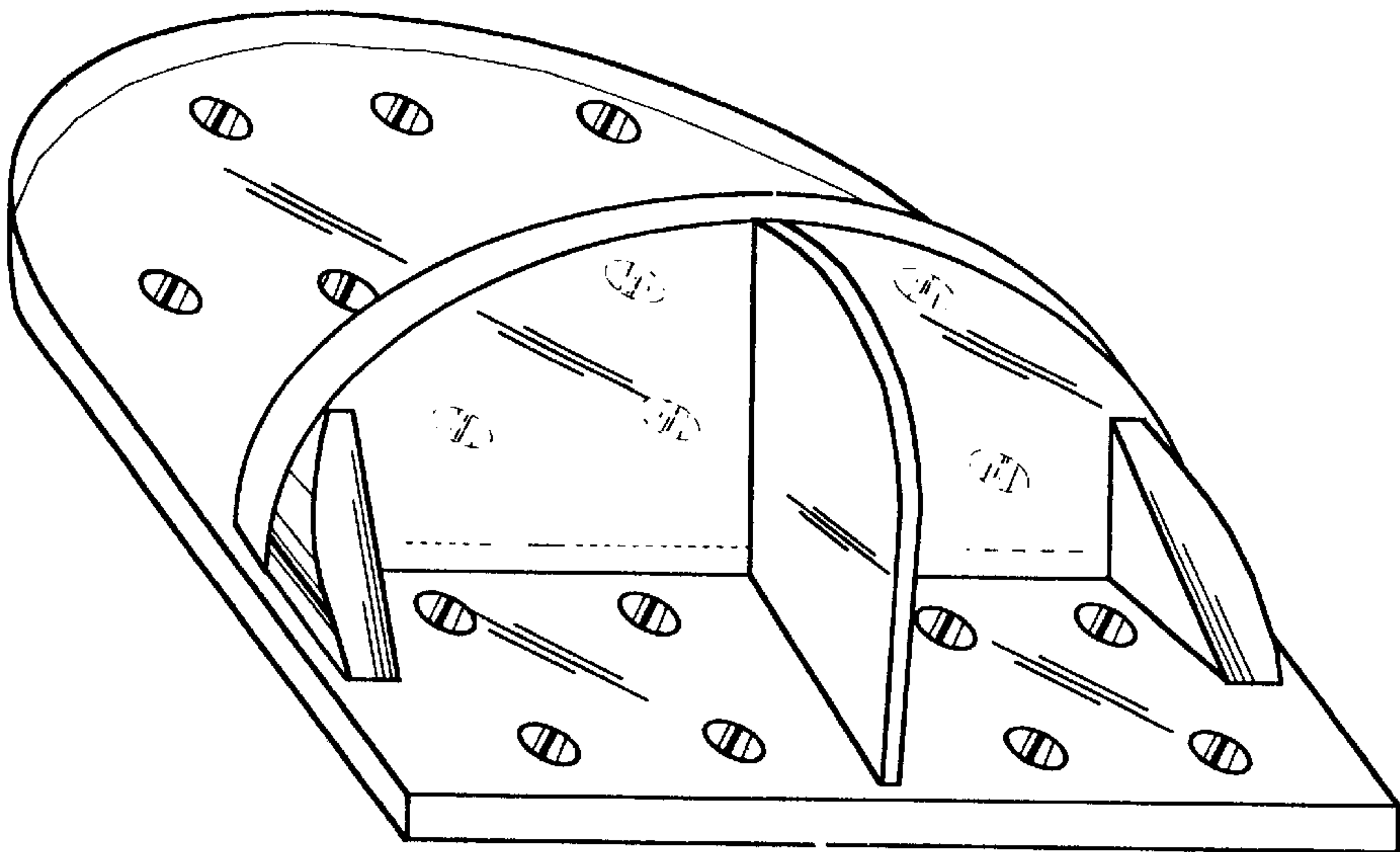

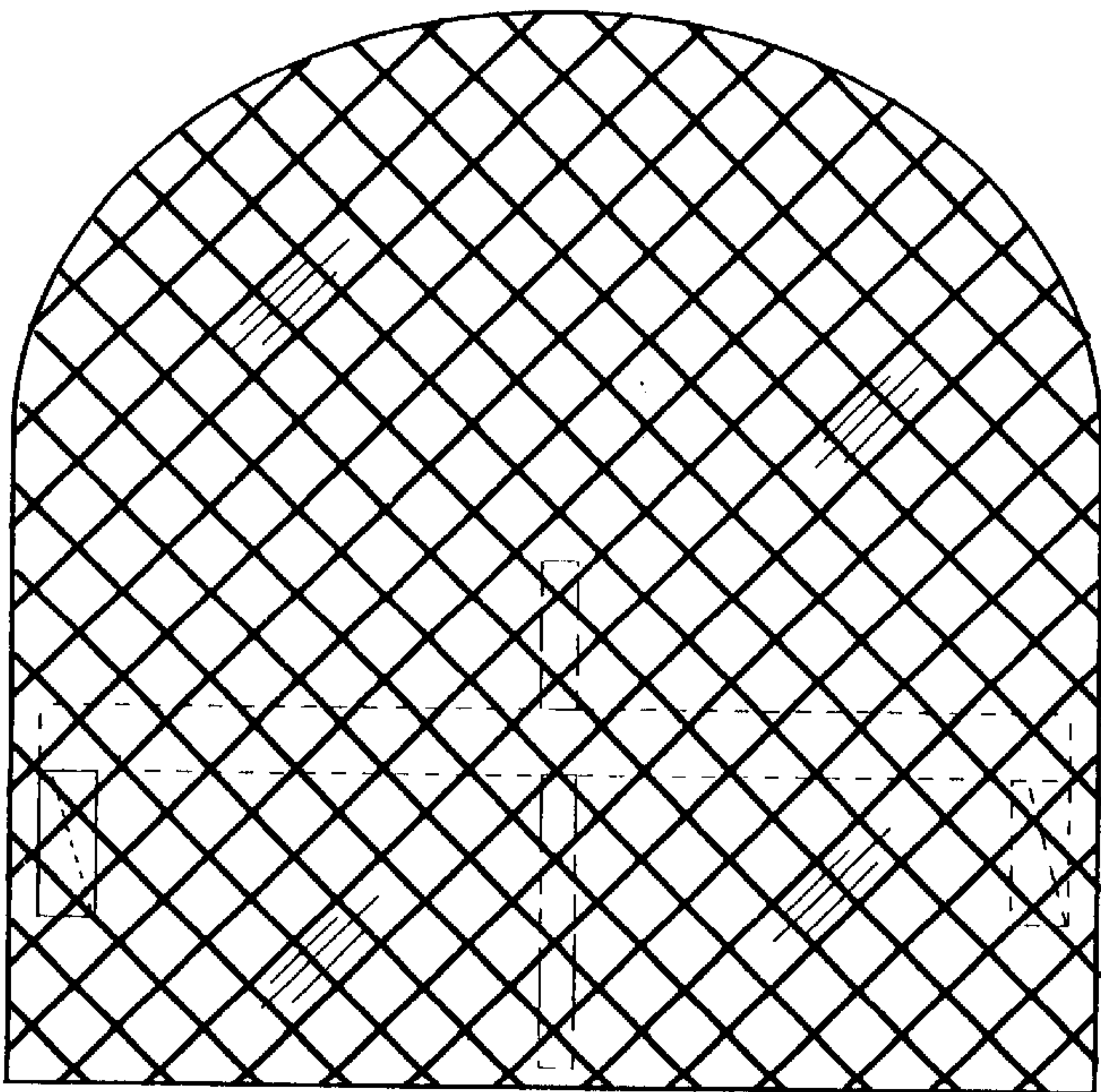

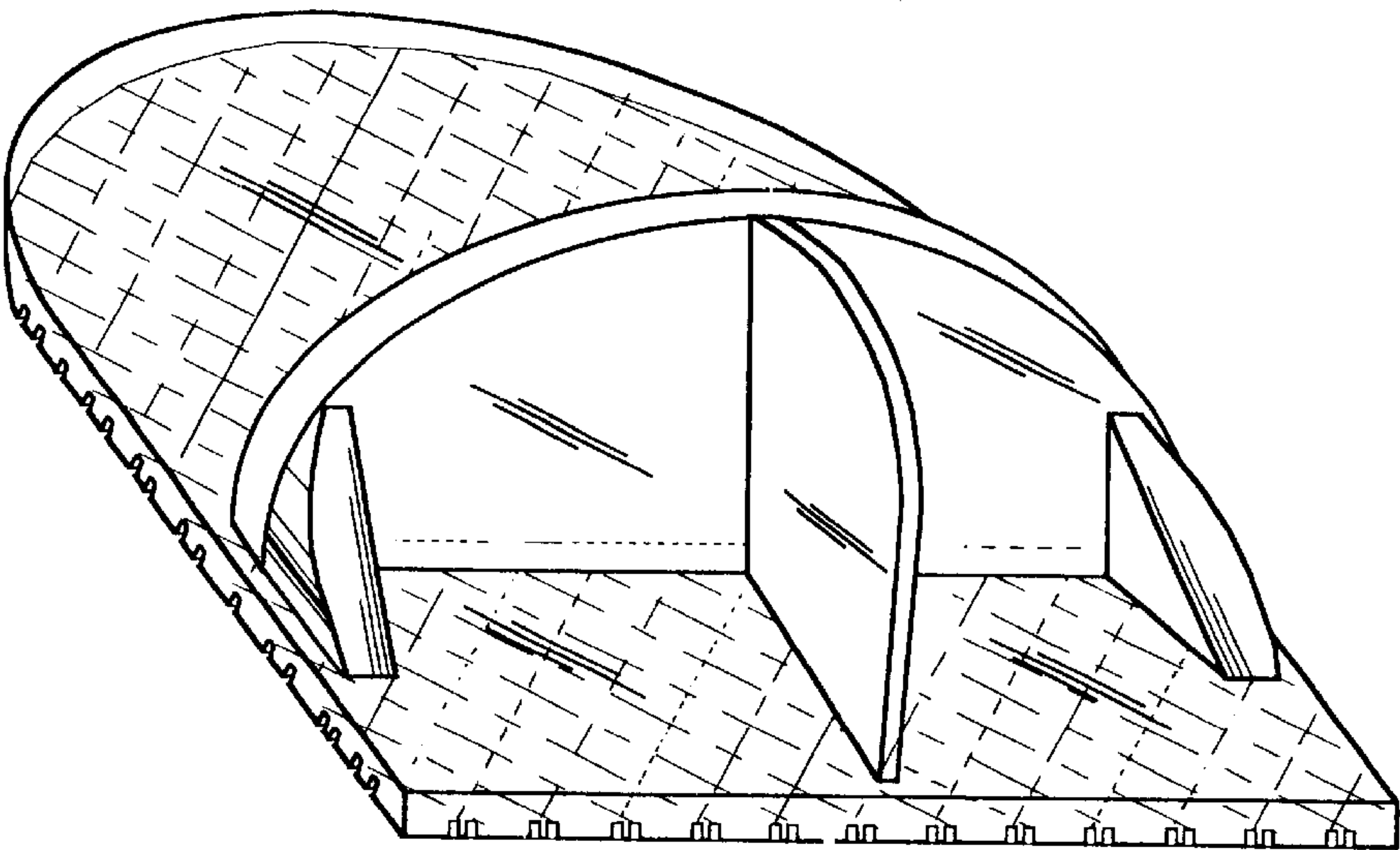

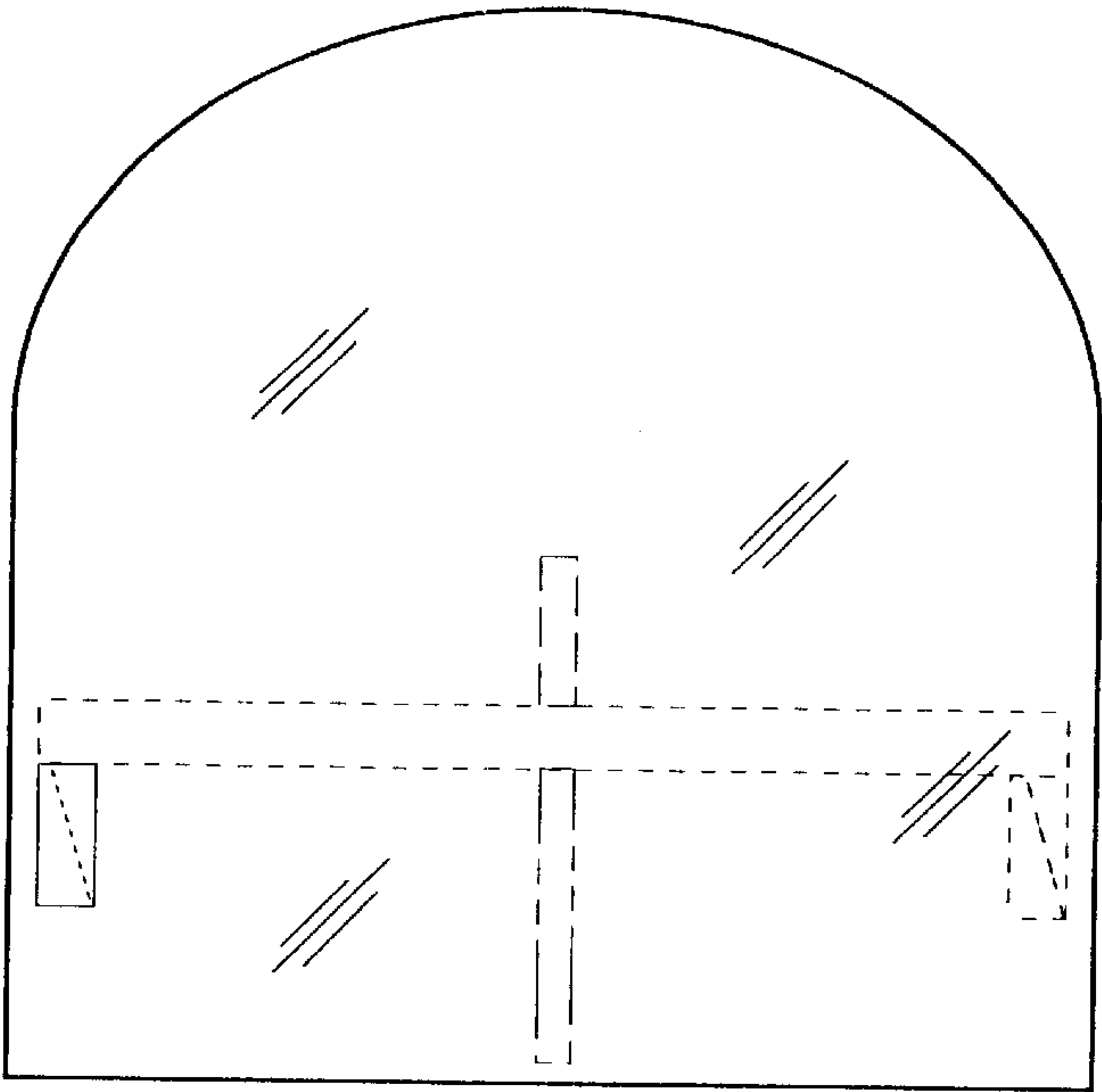

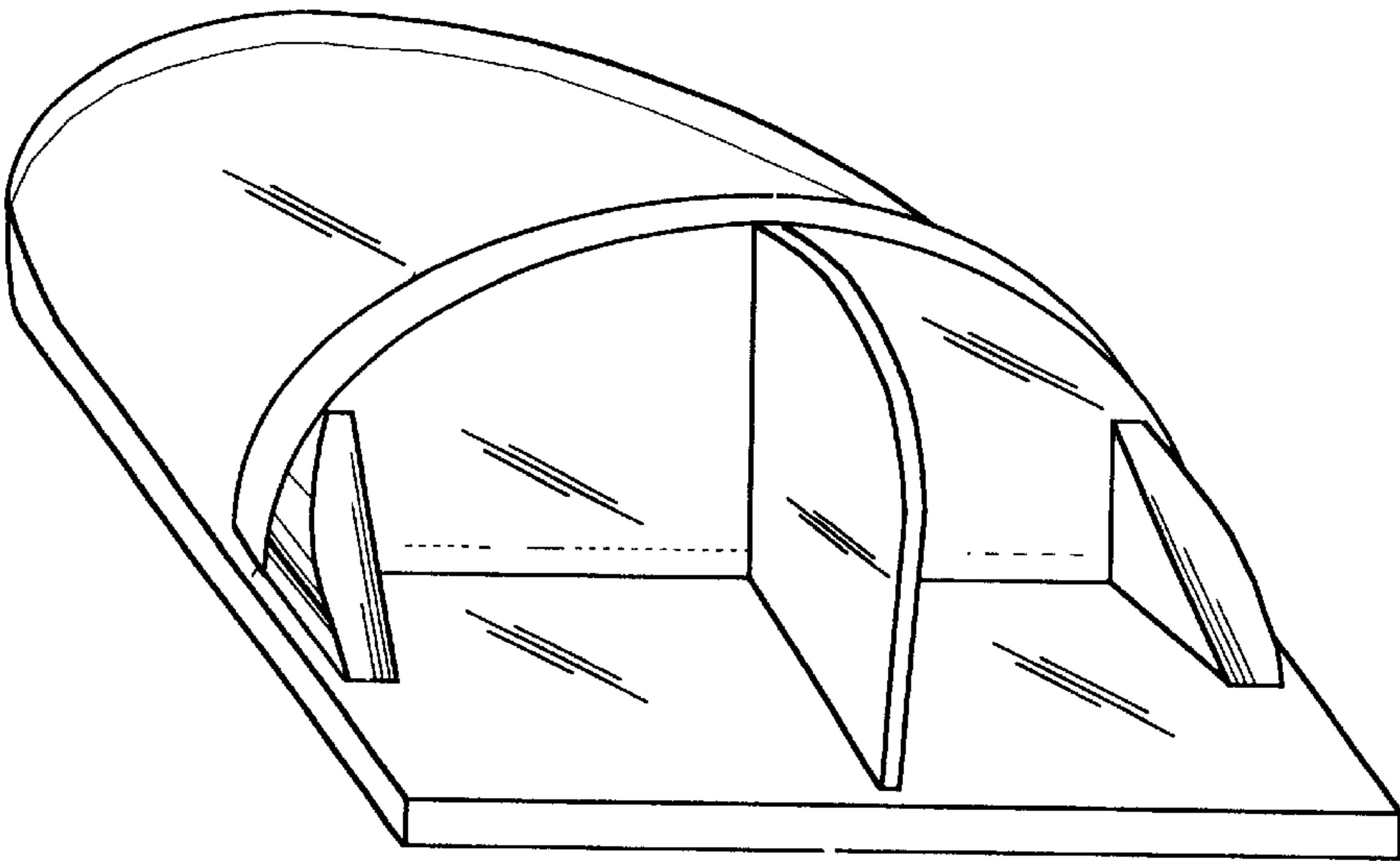
