(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fold-out mailer, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first unfolded perspective view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 2 is a second partially folded perspective view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 3 is a third further folded perspective view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 4 is a fourth nearly completely folded perspective view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 5 is a first unfolded front view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 6 is a second partially folded front view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 7 is a third folded front view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 8 is a first unfolded side view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 9 is a second partially folded side view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 10 is a third further folded side view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 11 is a fourth nearly completely folded side view of the fold-out mailer.

FIG. 12 is a fifth folded side view of the fold-out mailer.

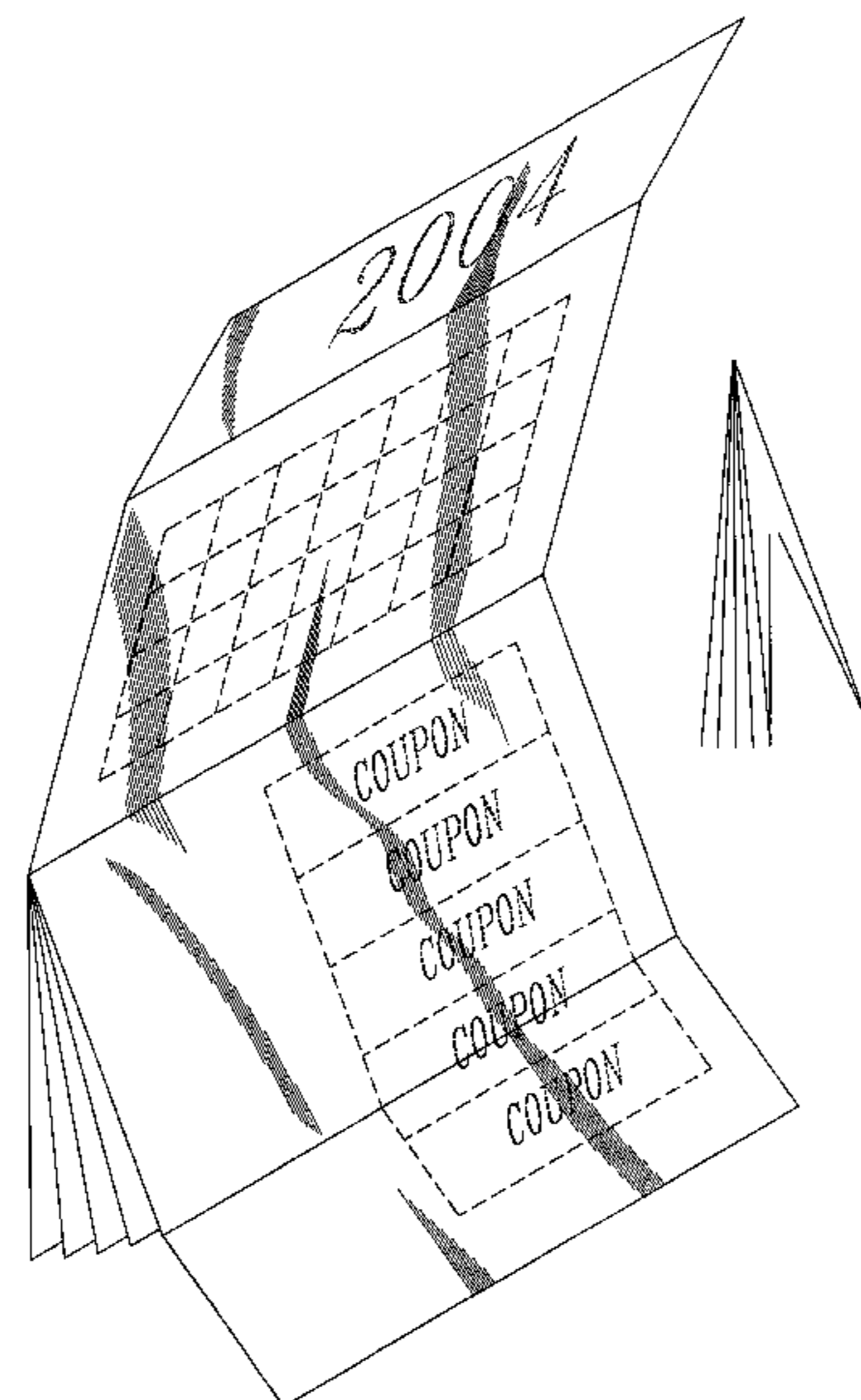
FIG. 13 is a first unfolded near view of the fold-out mailer.

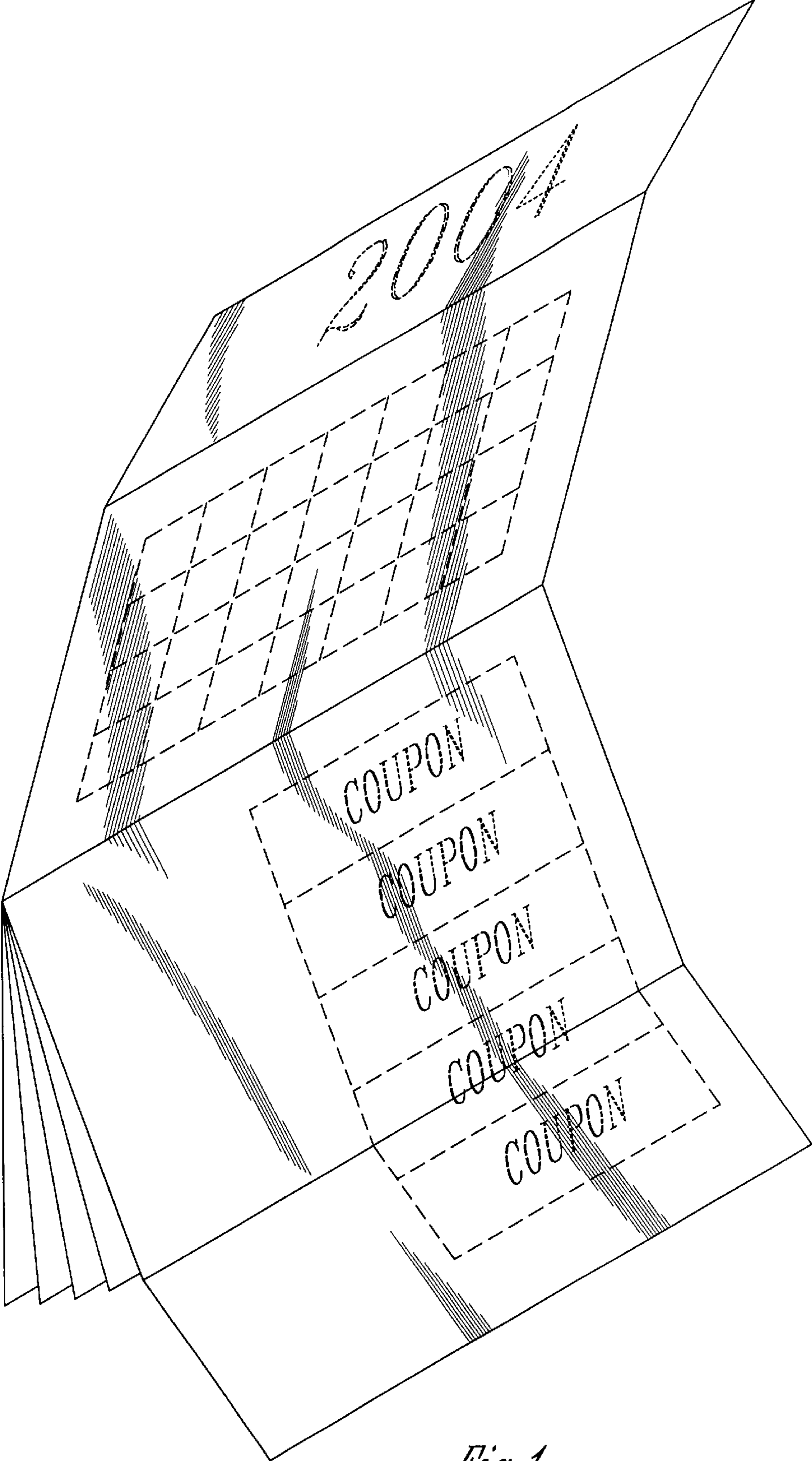

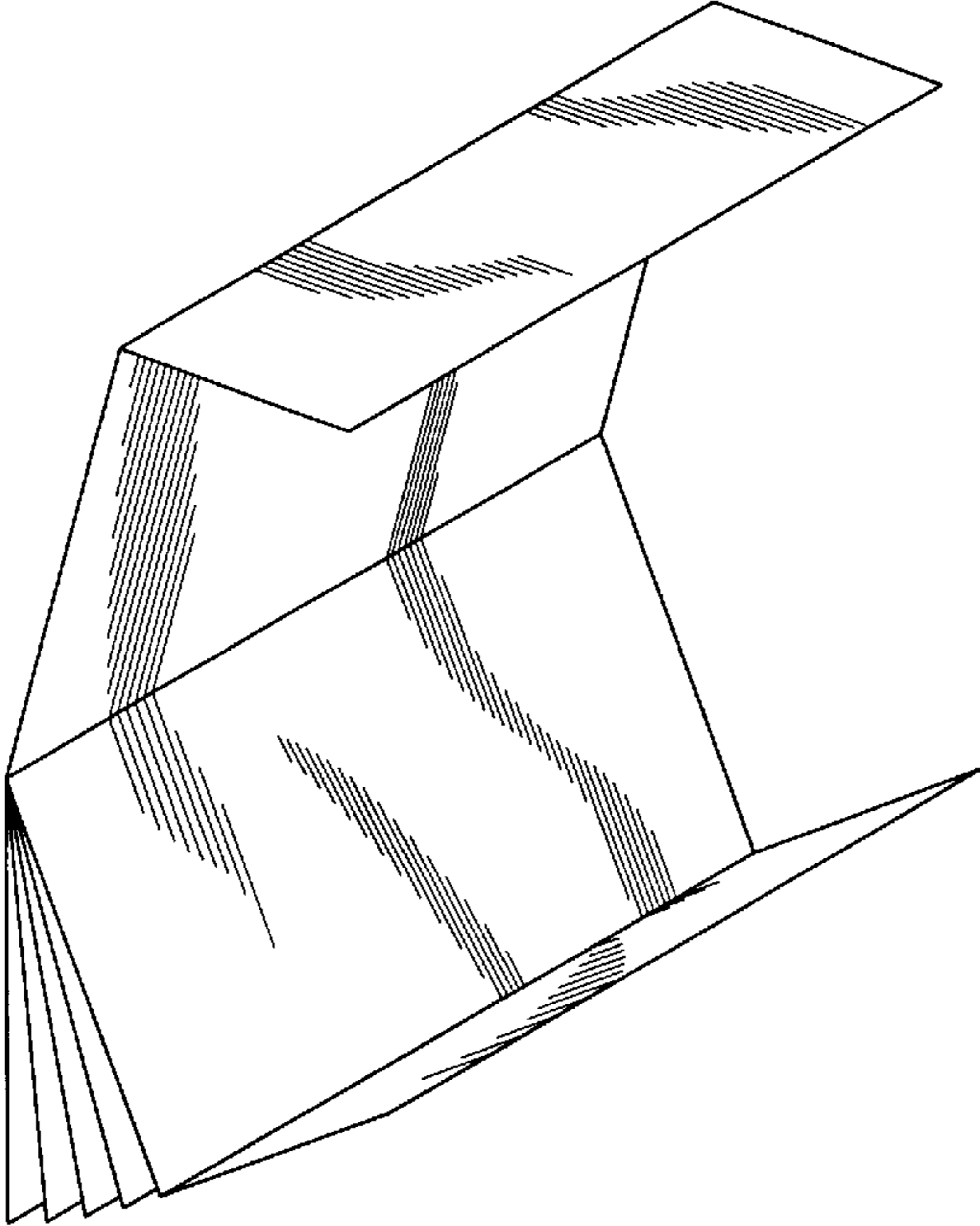

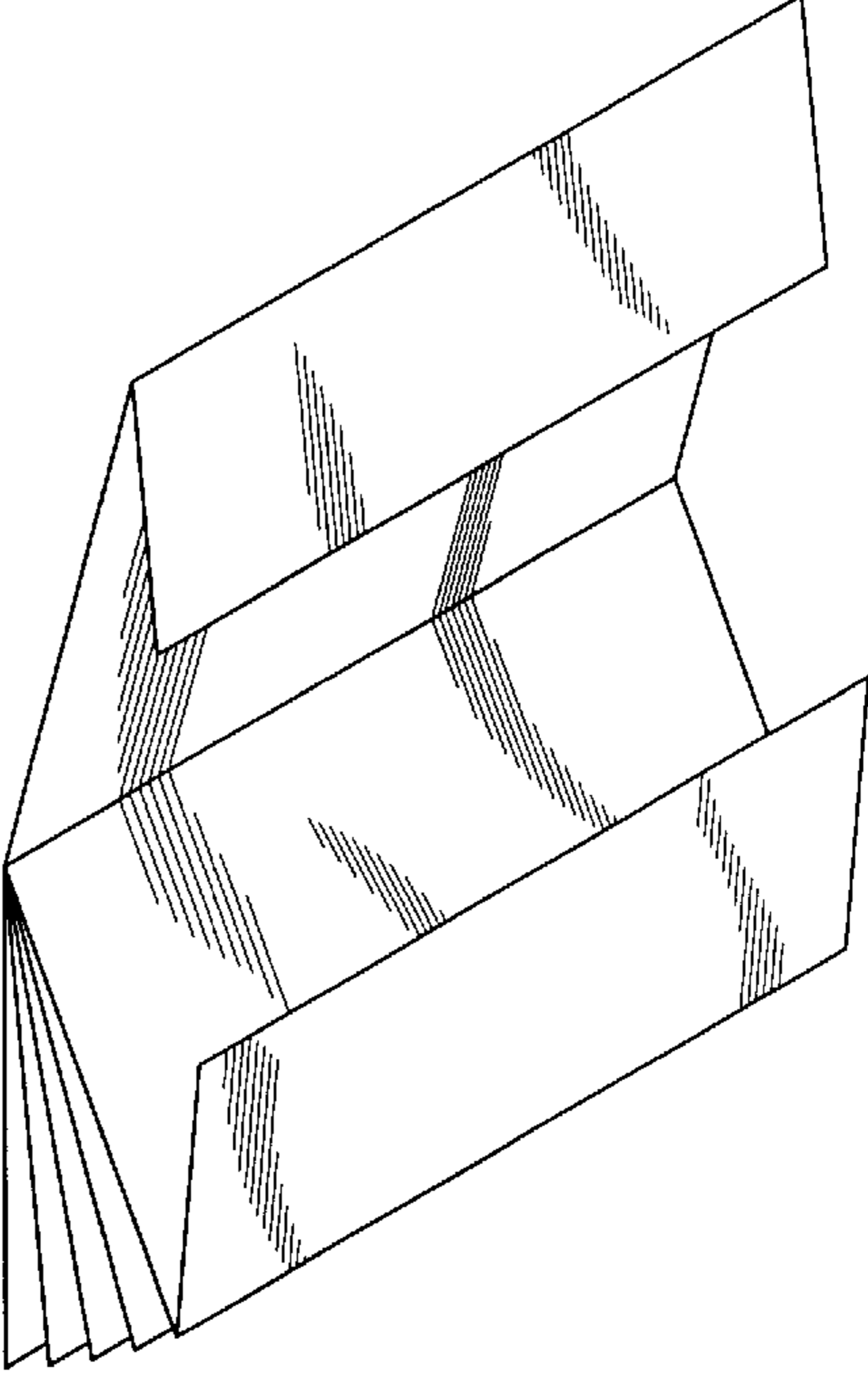

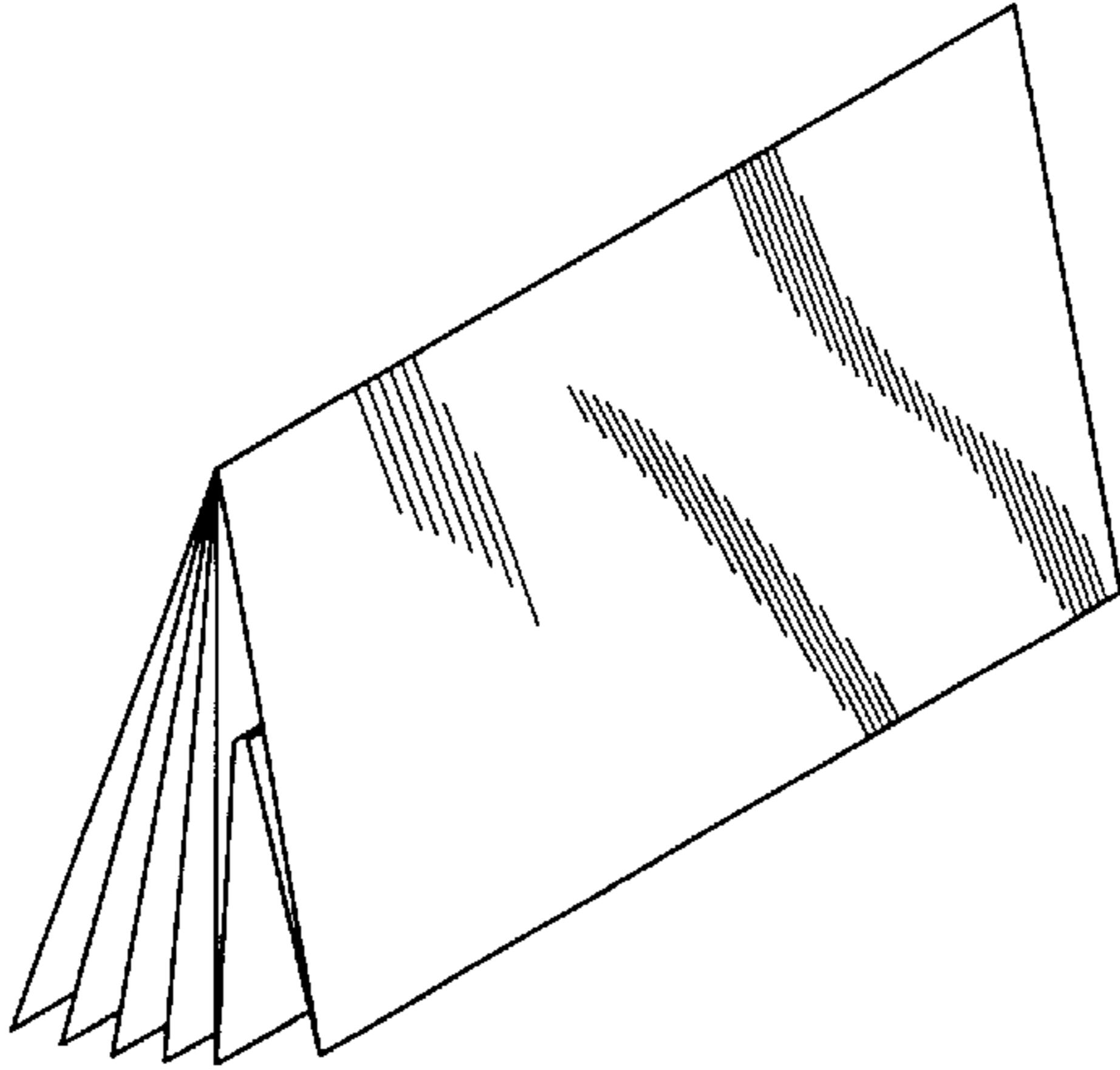

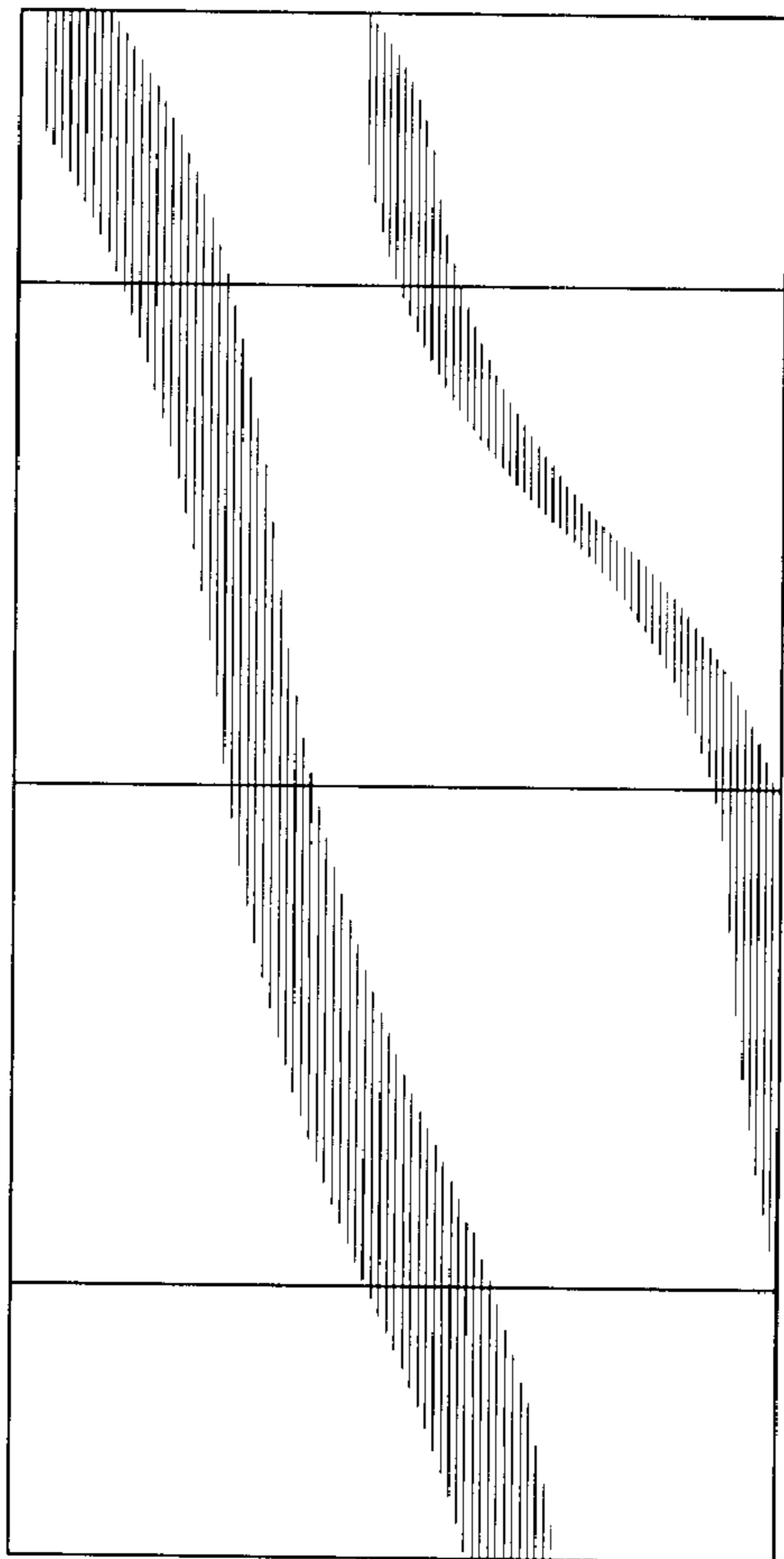

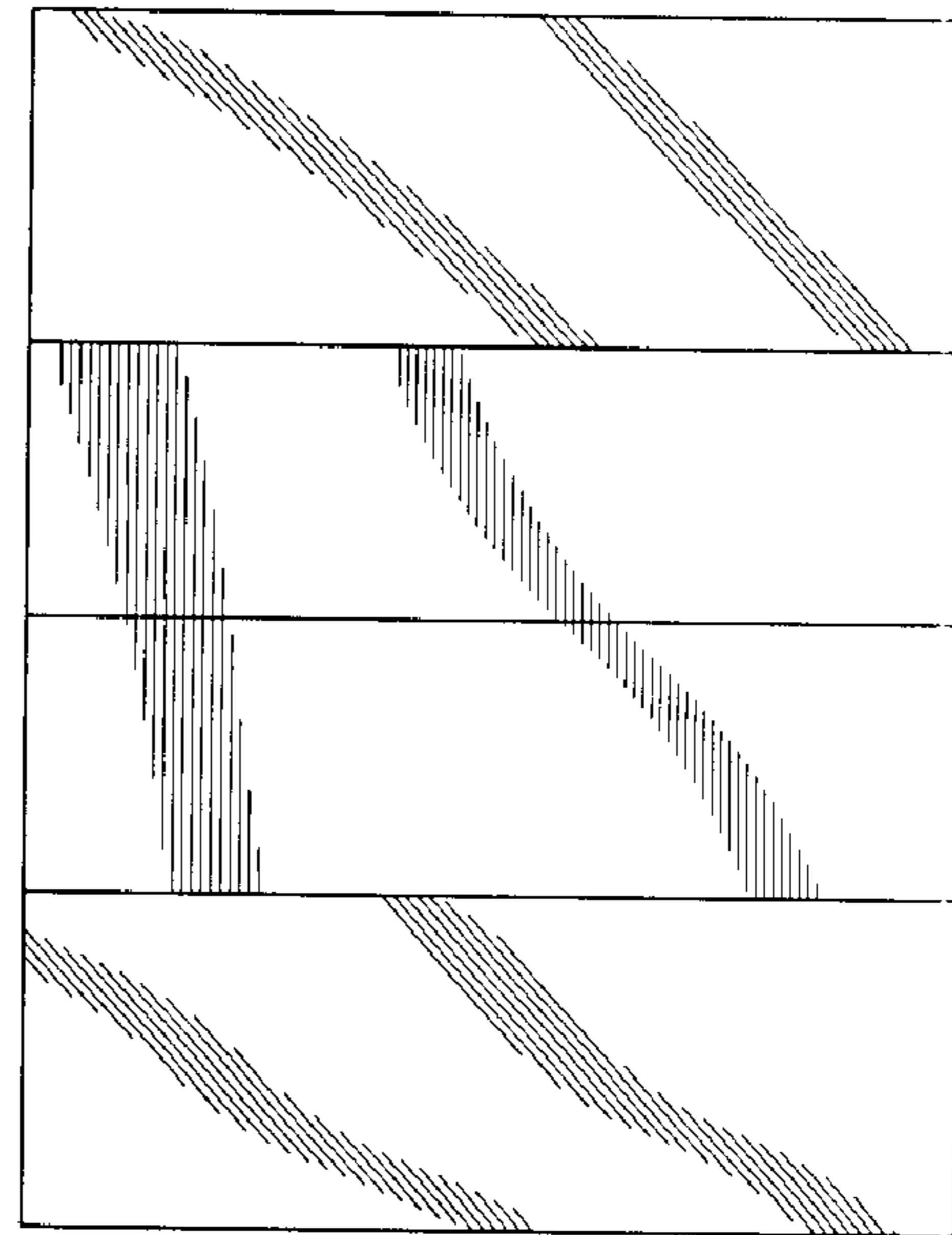

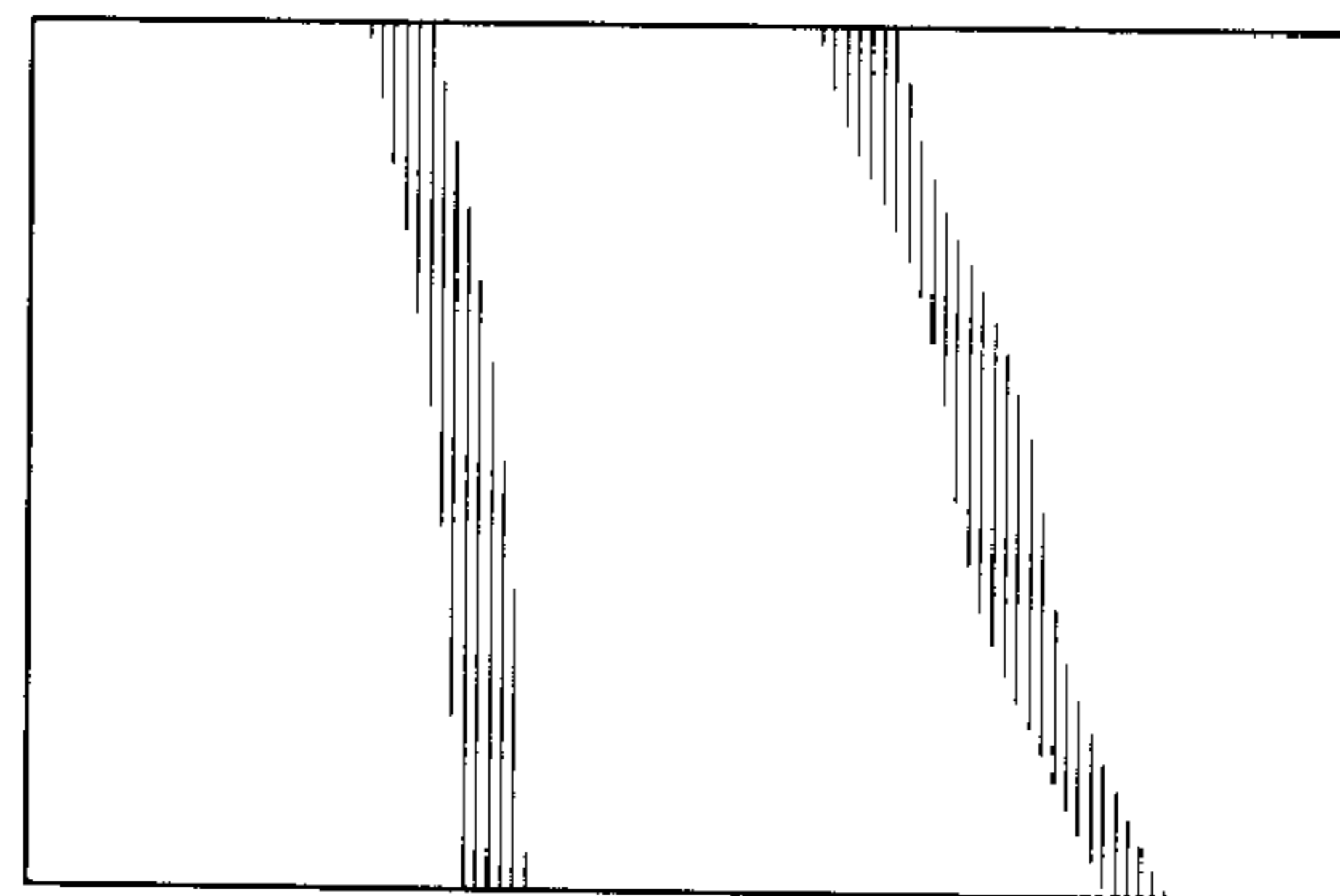

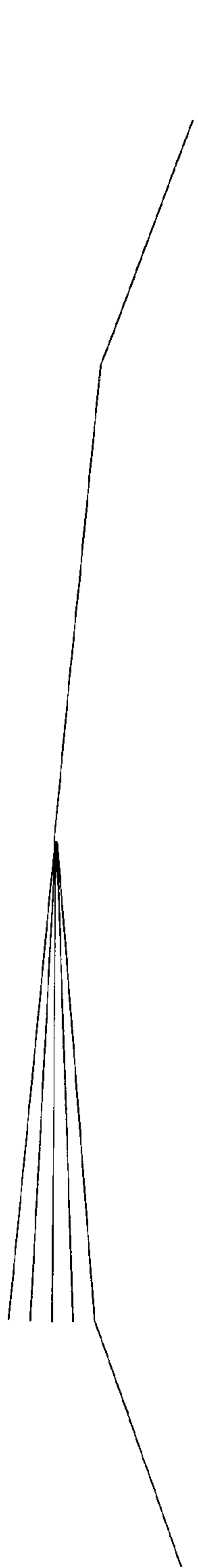

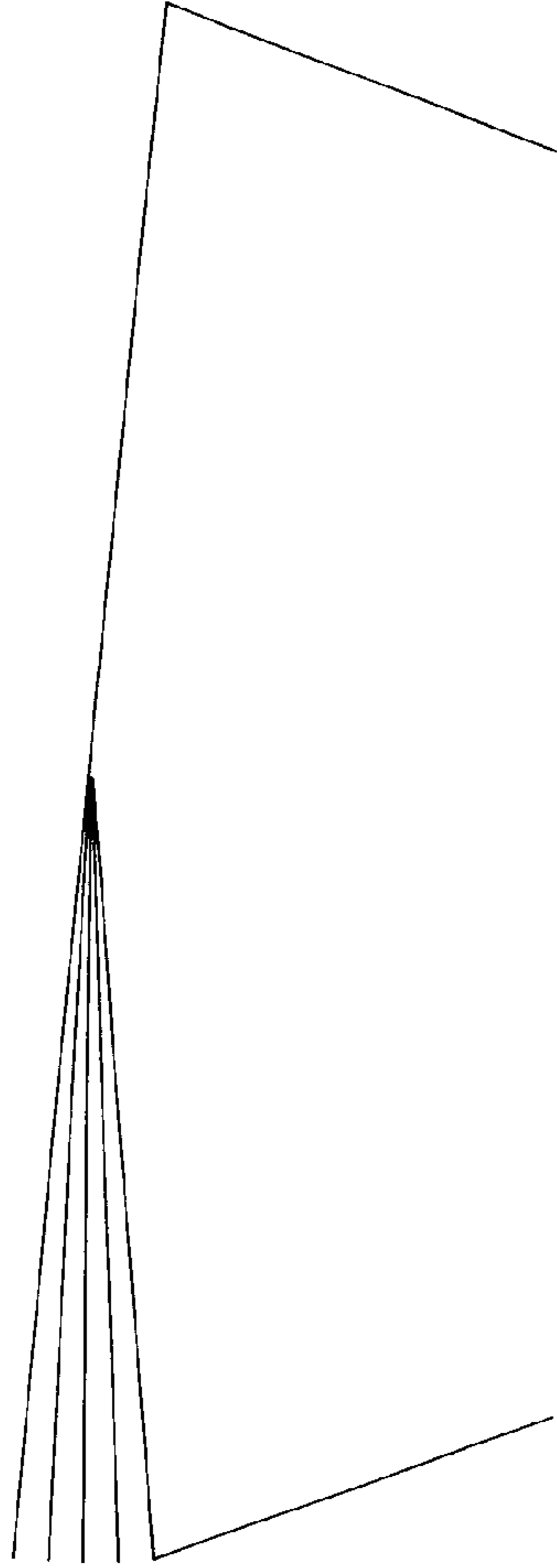

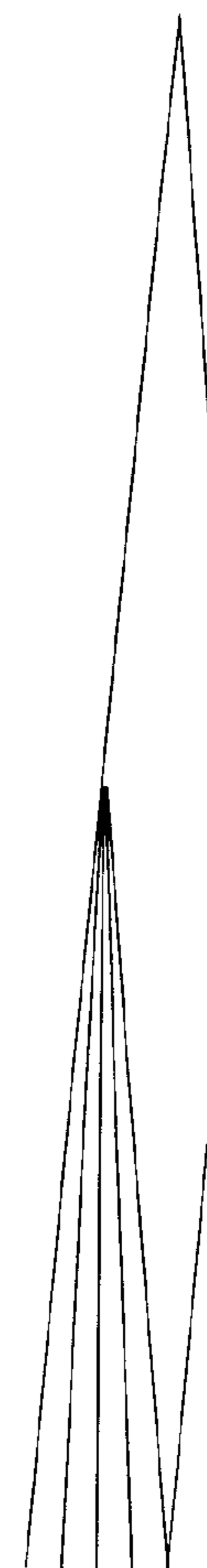

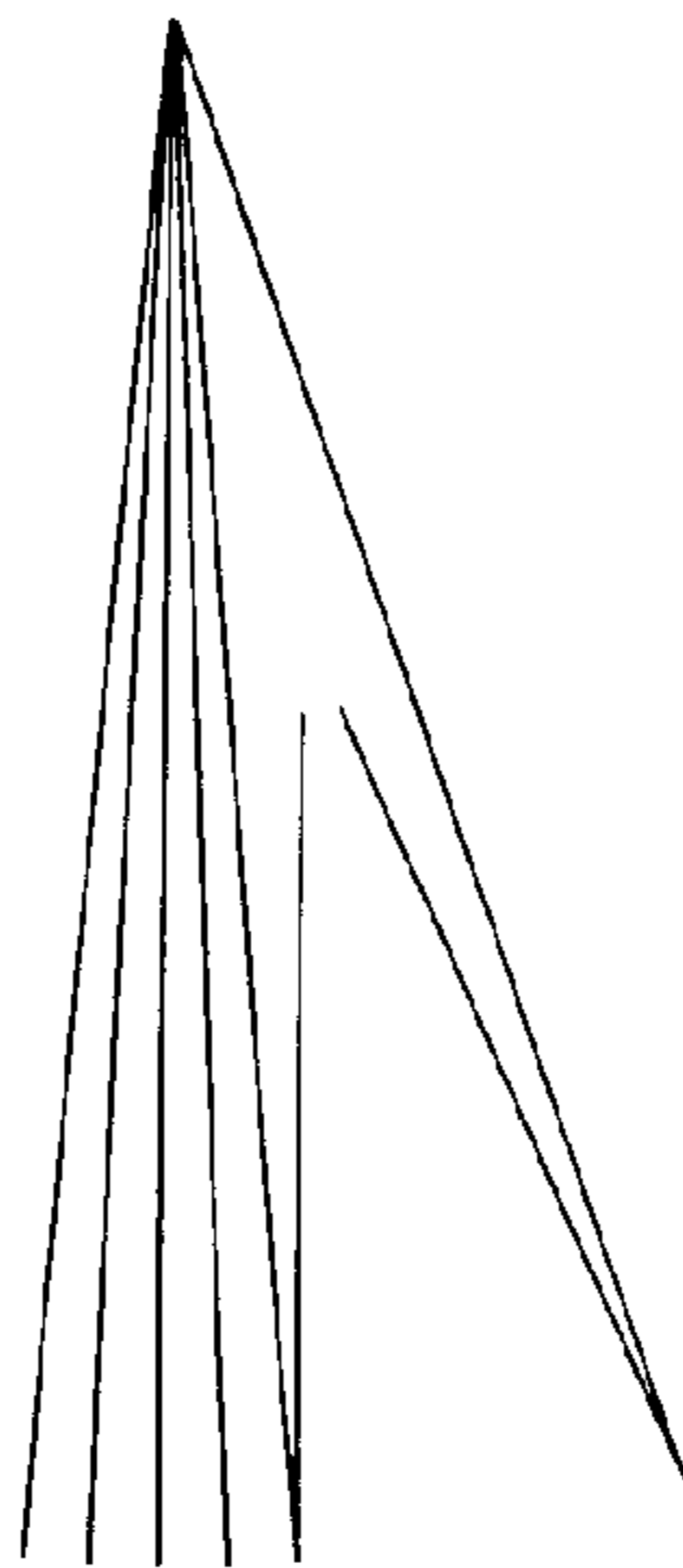

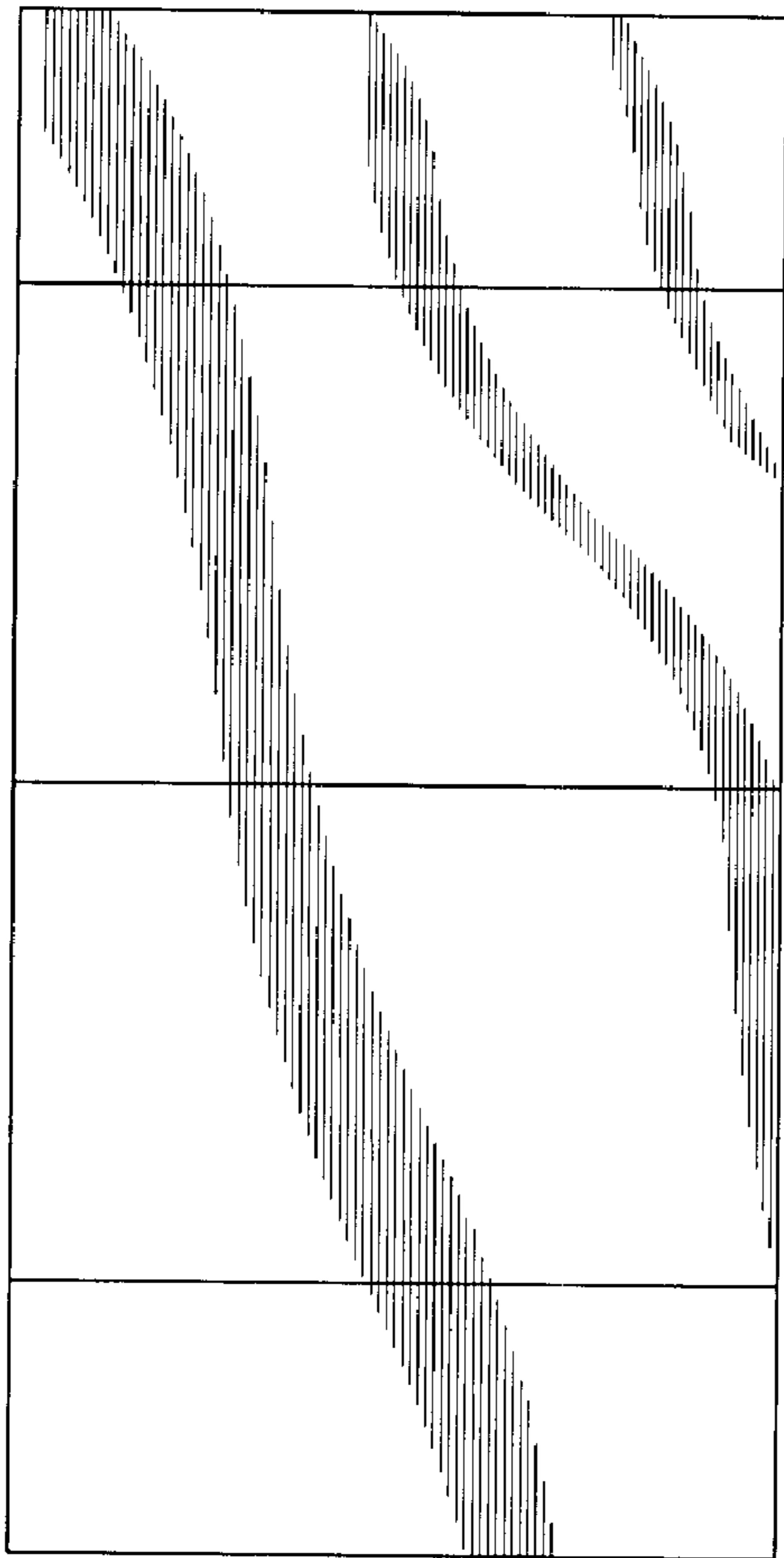

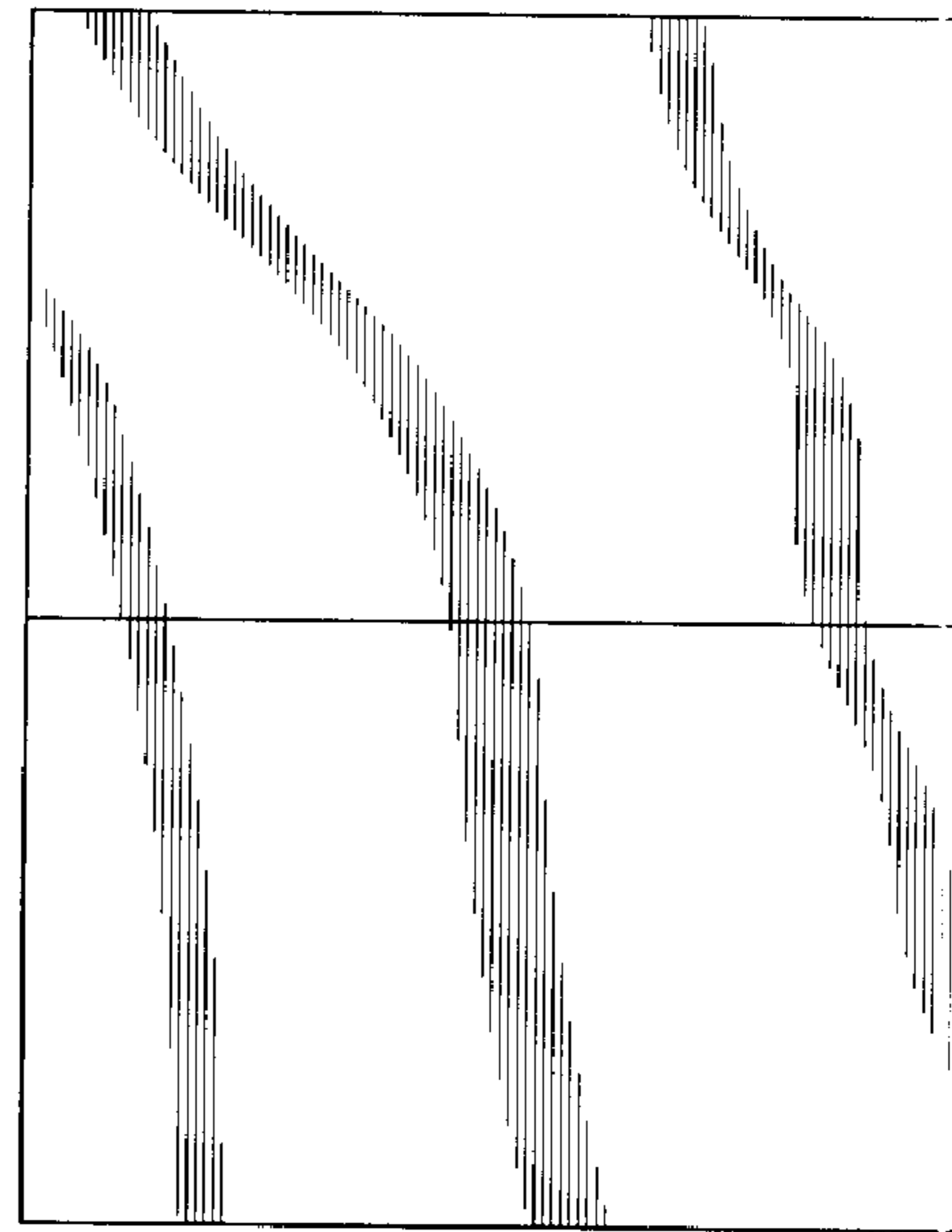

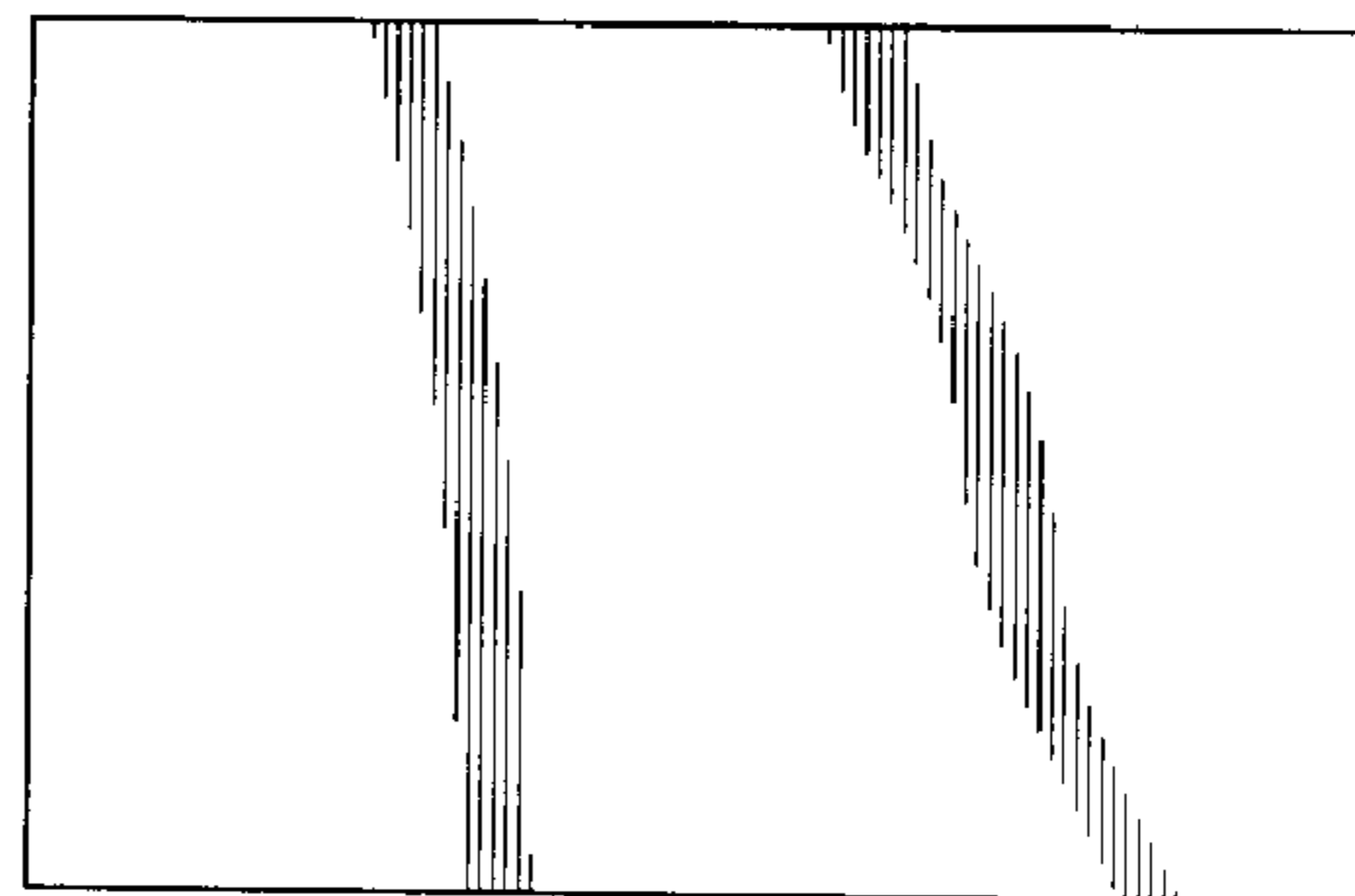
