FIG. 3 is front side view thereof;

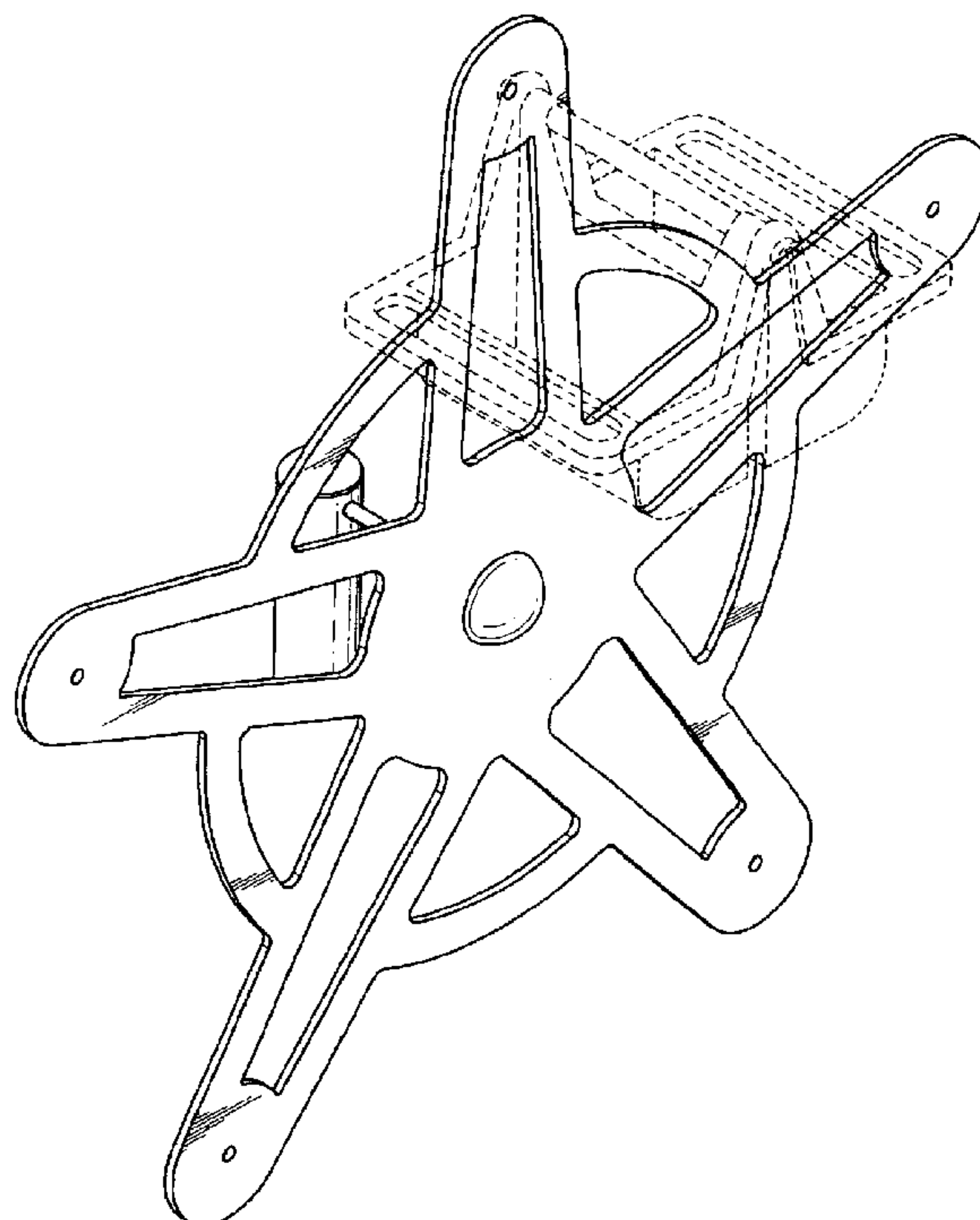
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

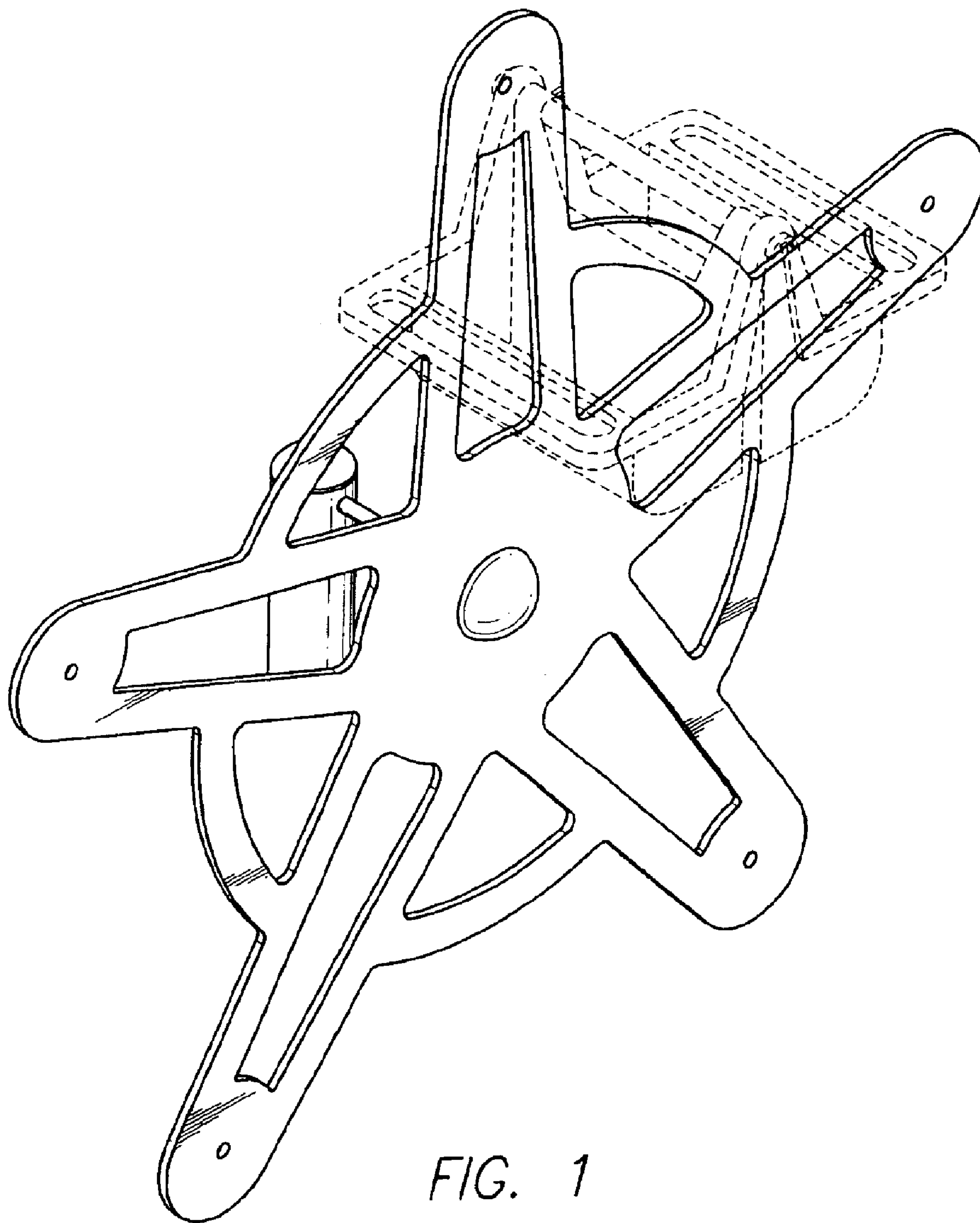
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,

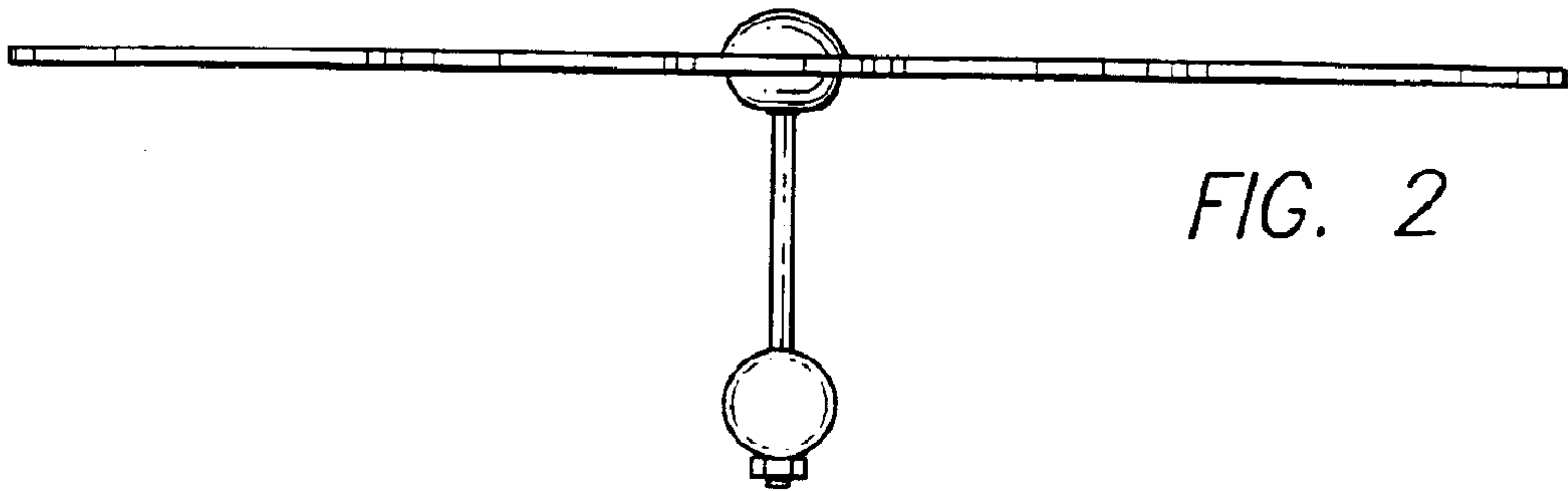

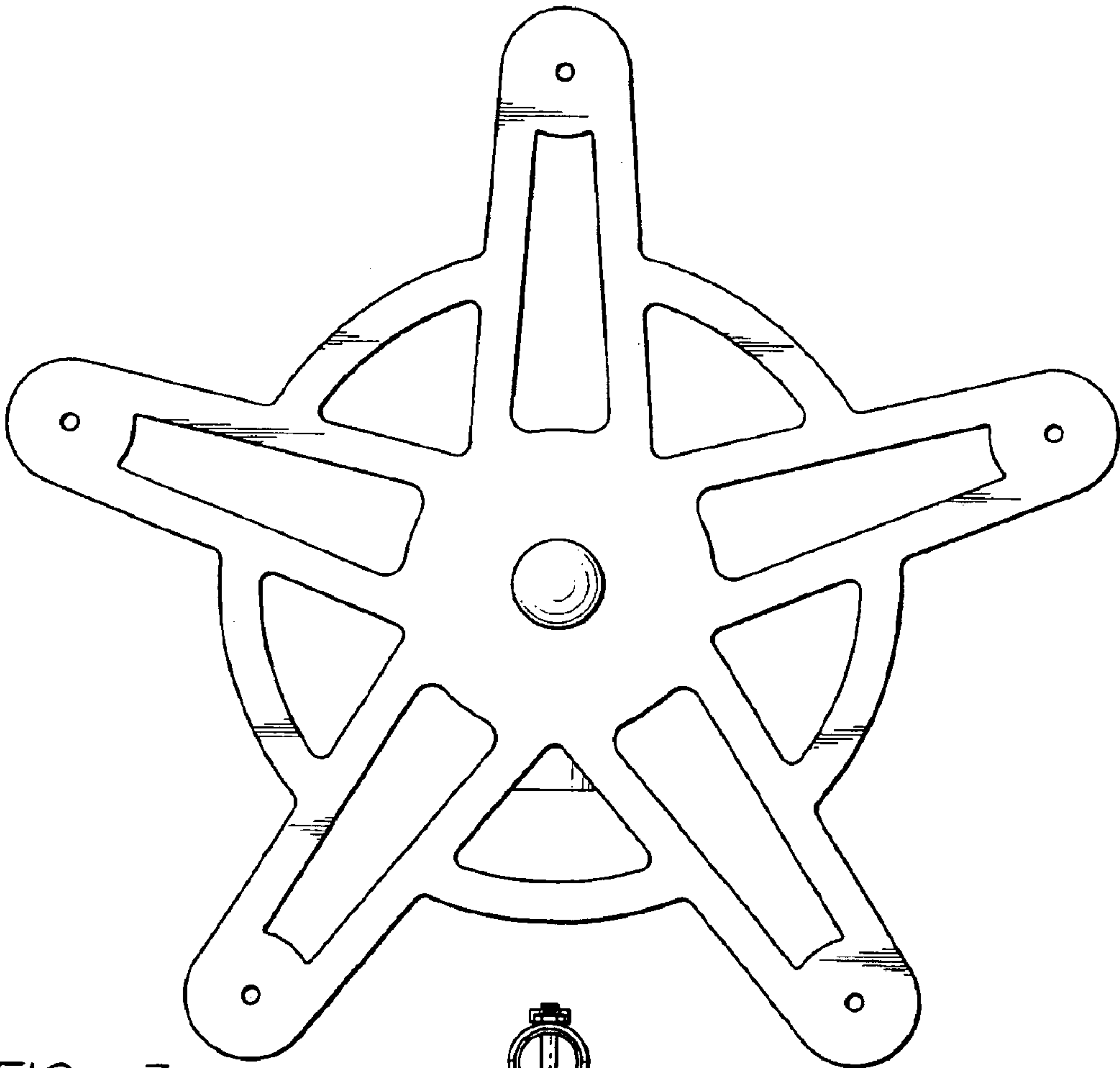

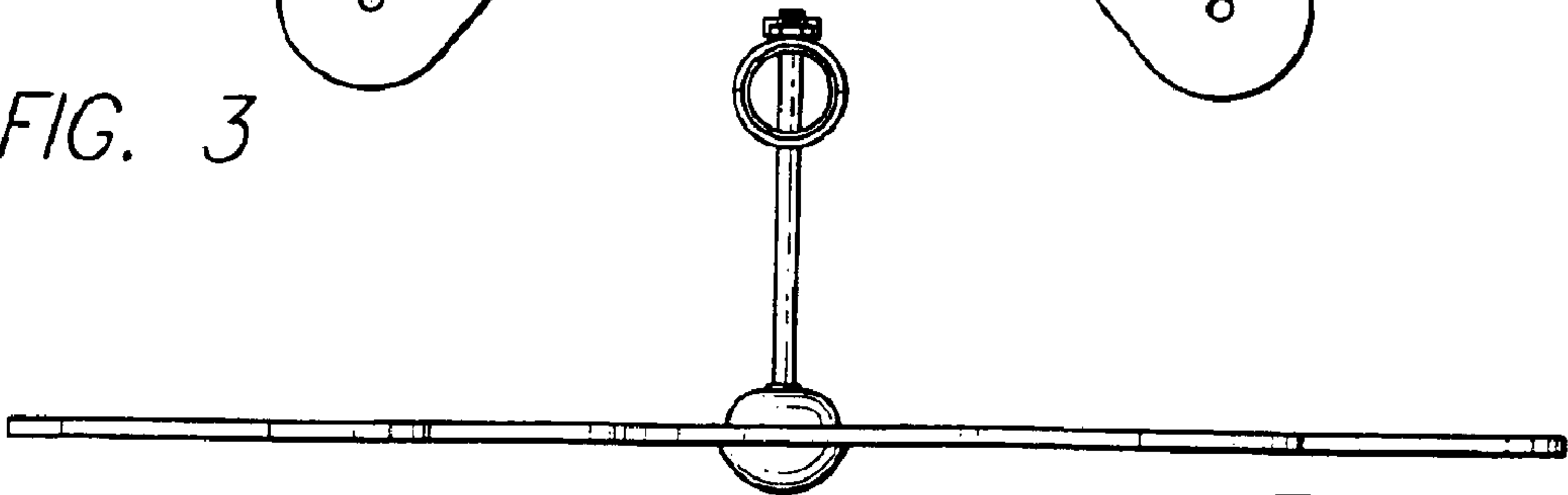

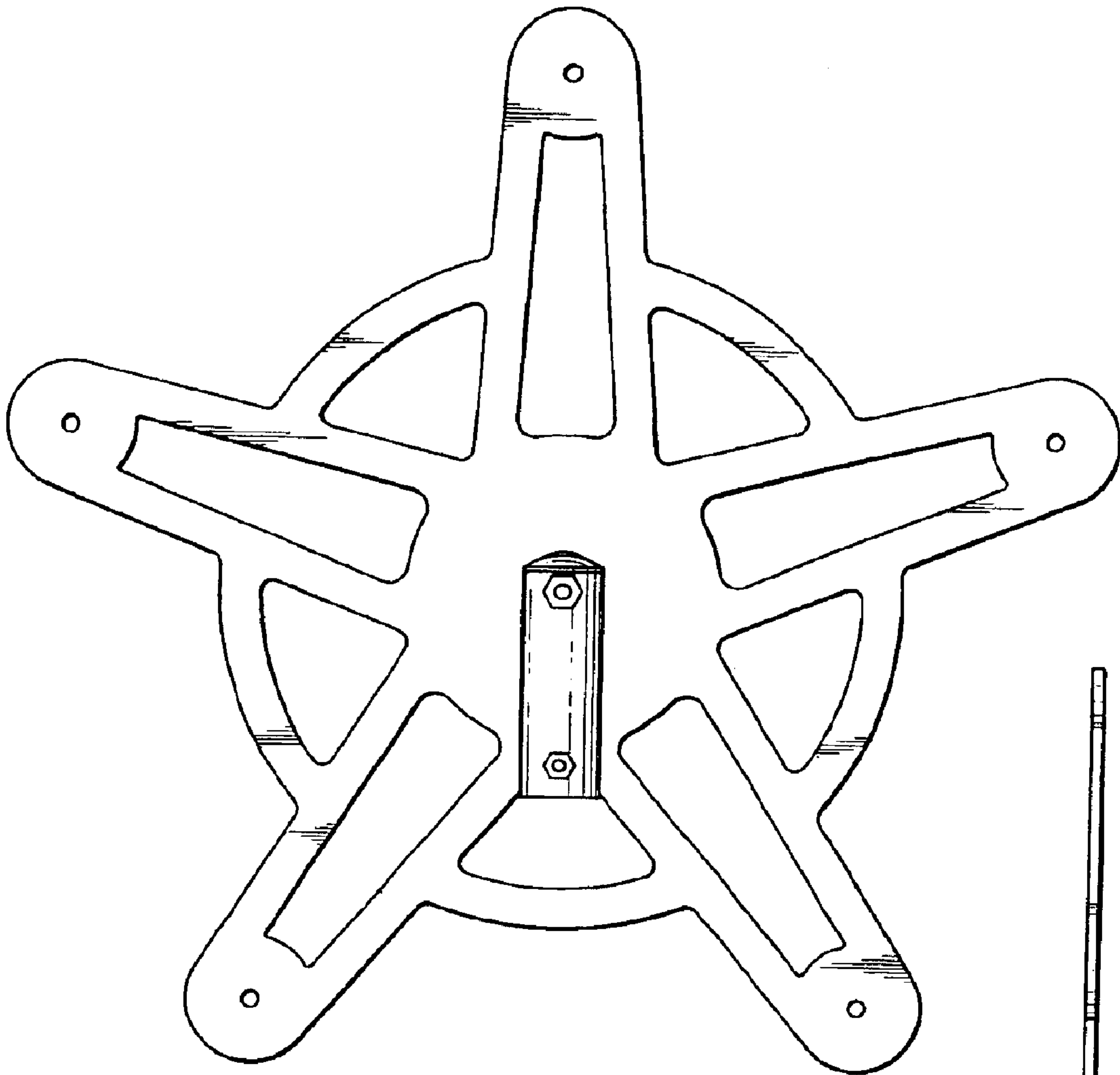

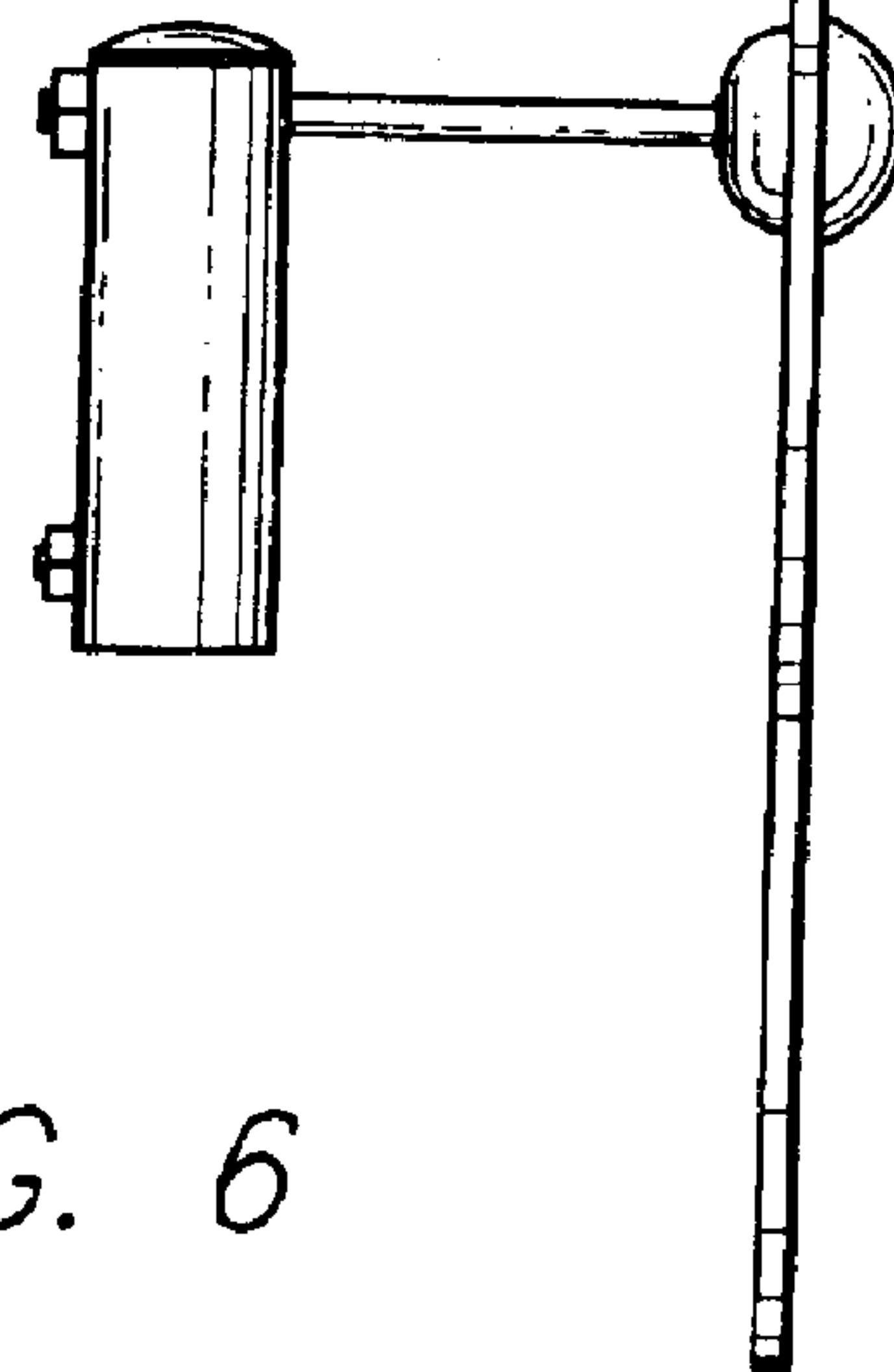
