FIG. 4 is a side planar.

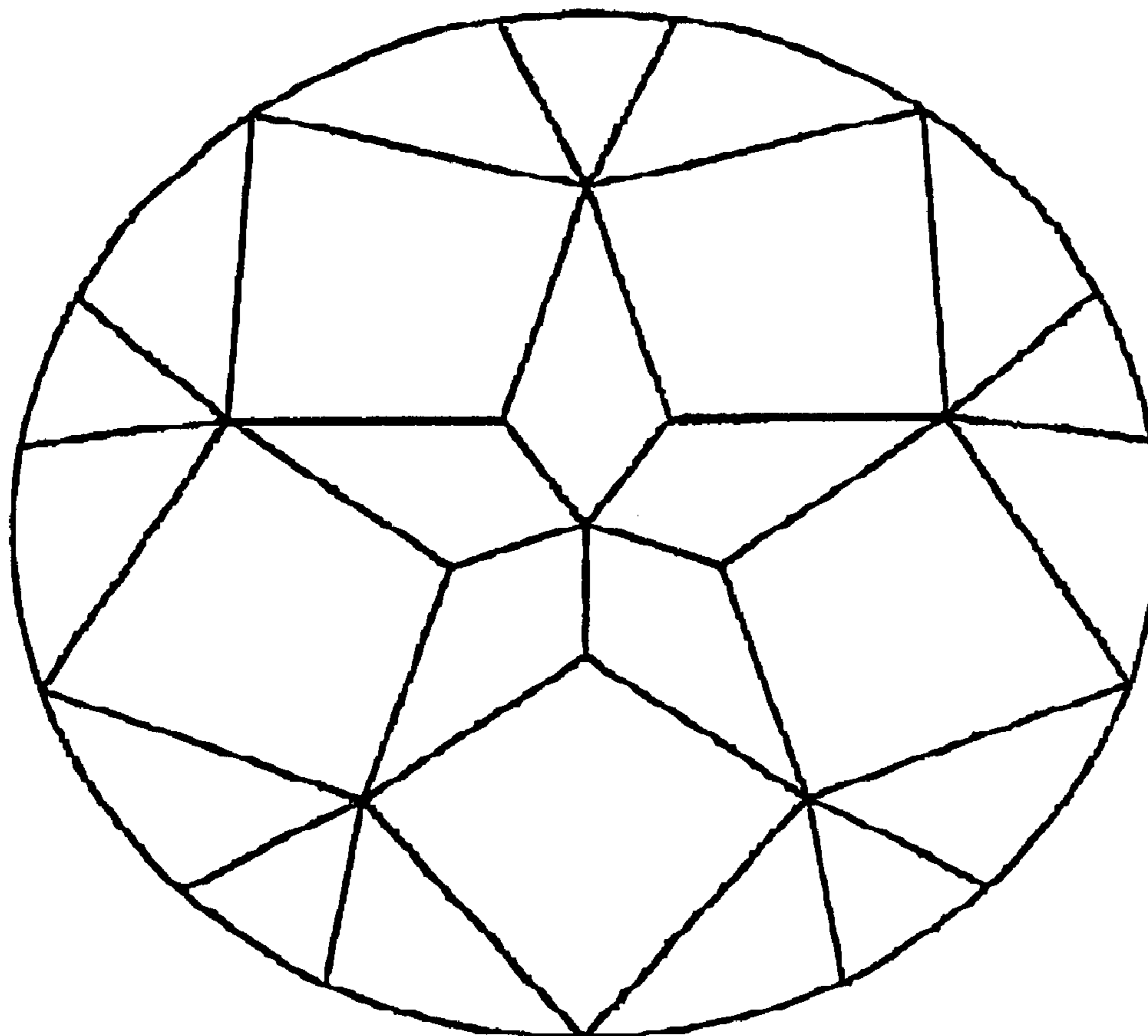

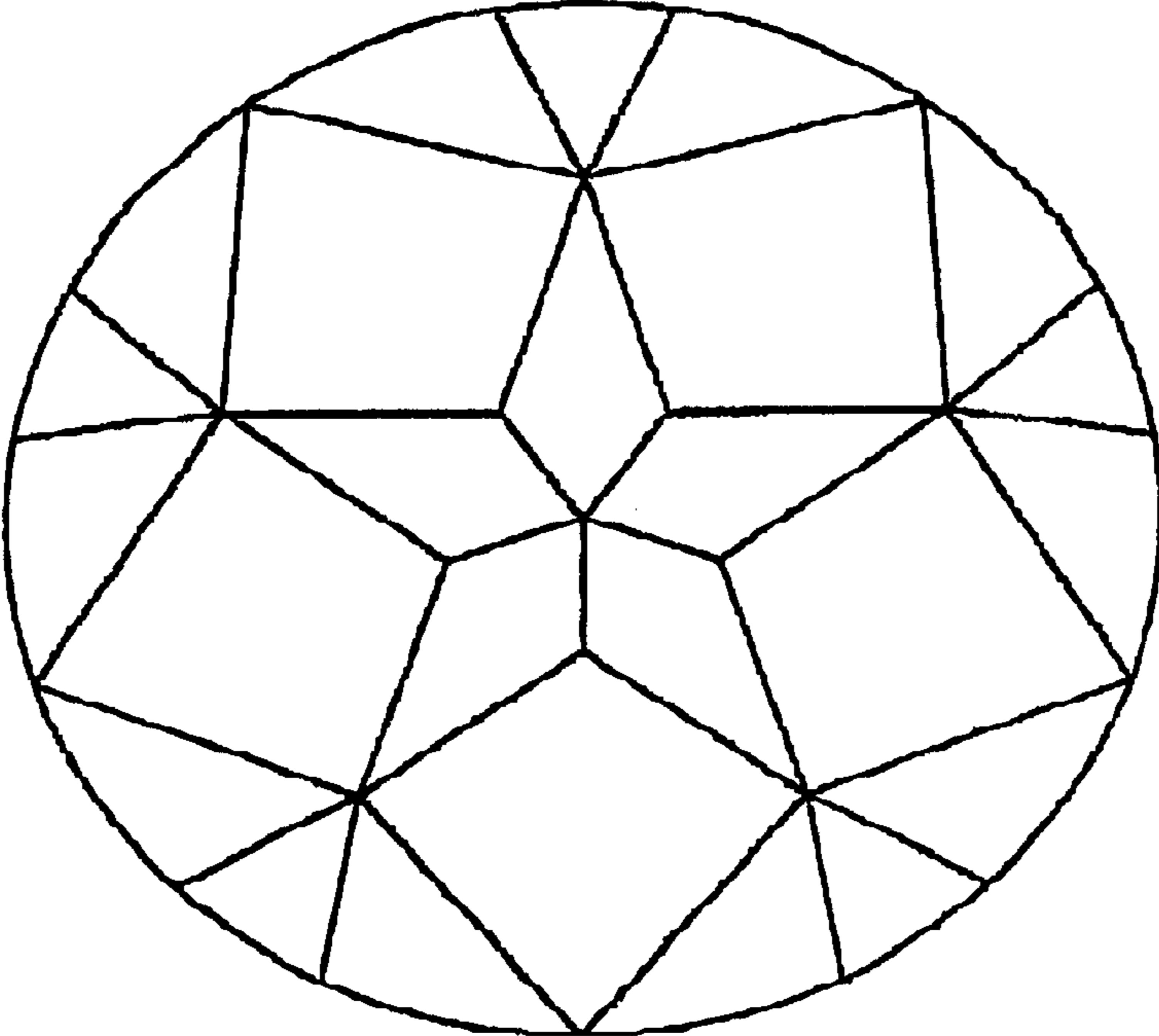

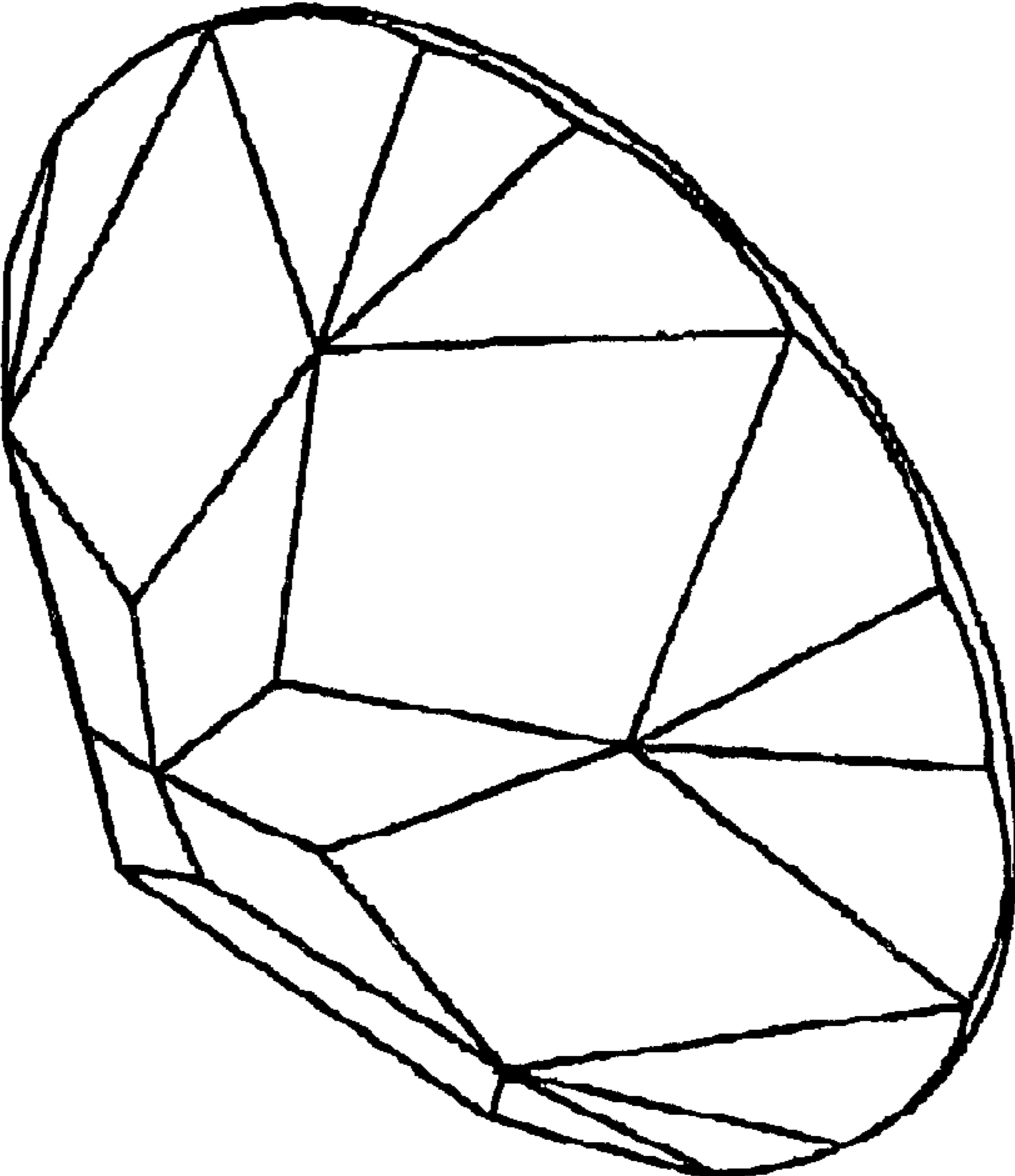

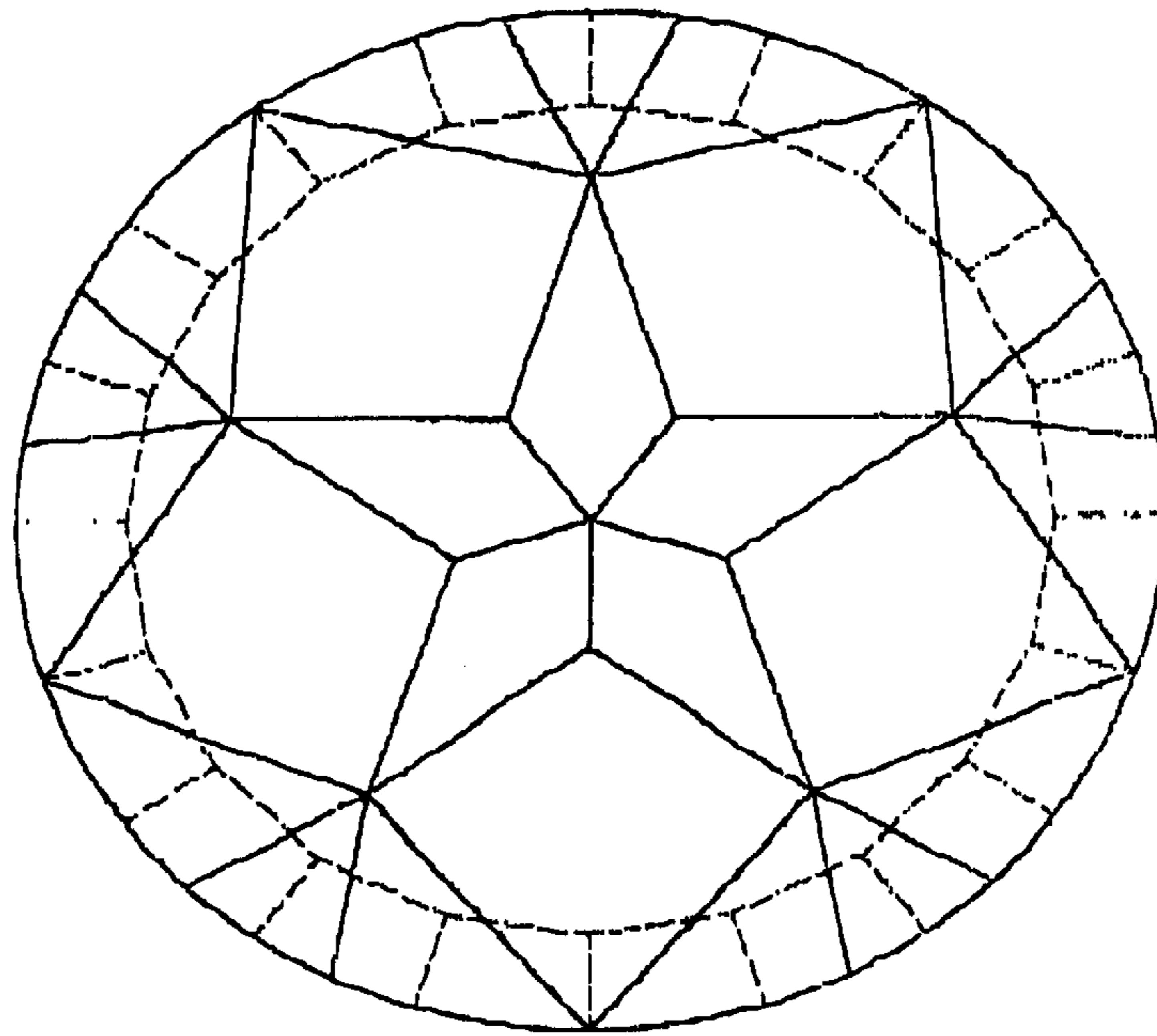

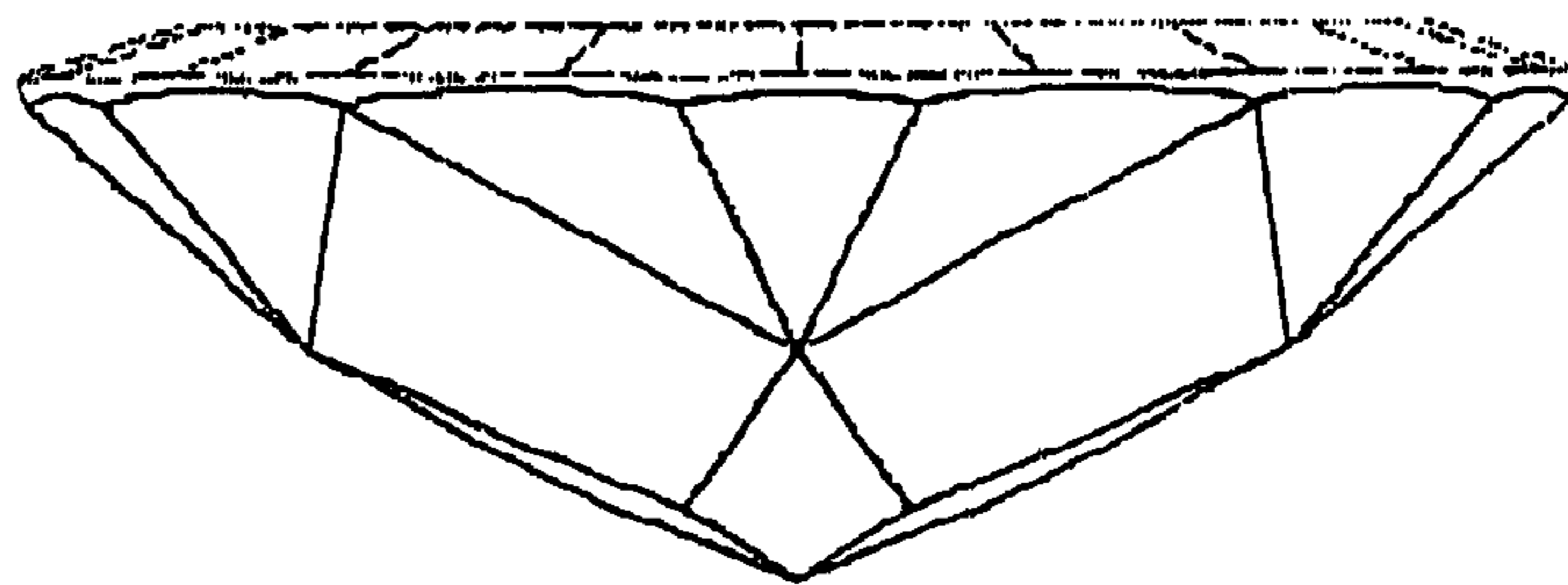
