FIG. 3 is a right side view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention.


FIG. 4 is a top view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention.


FIG. 5 is a rear view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention; and,


FIG. 6 is a front view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention.


The broken lines in all views are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.






